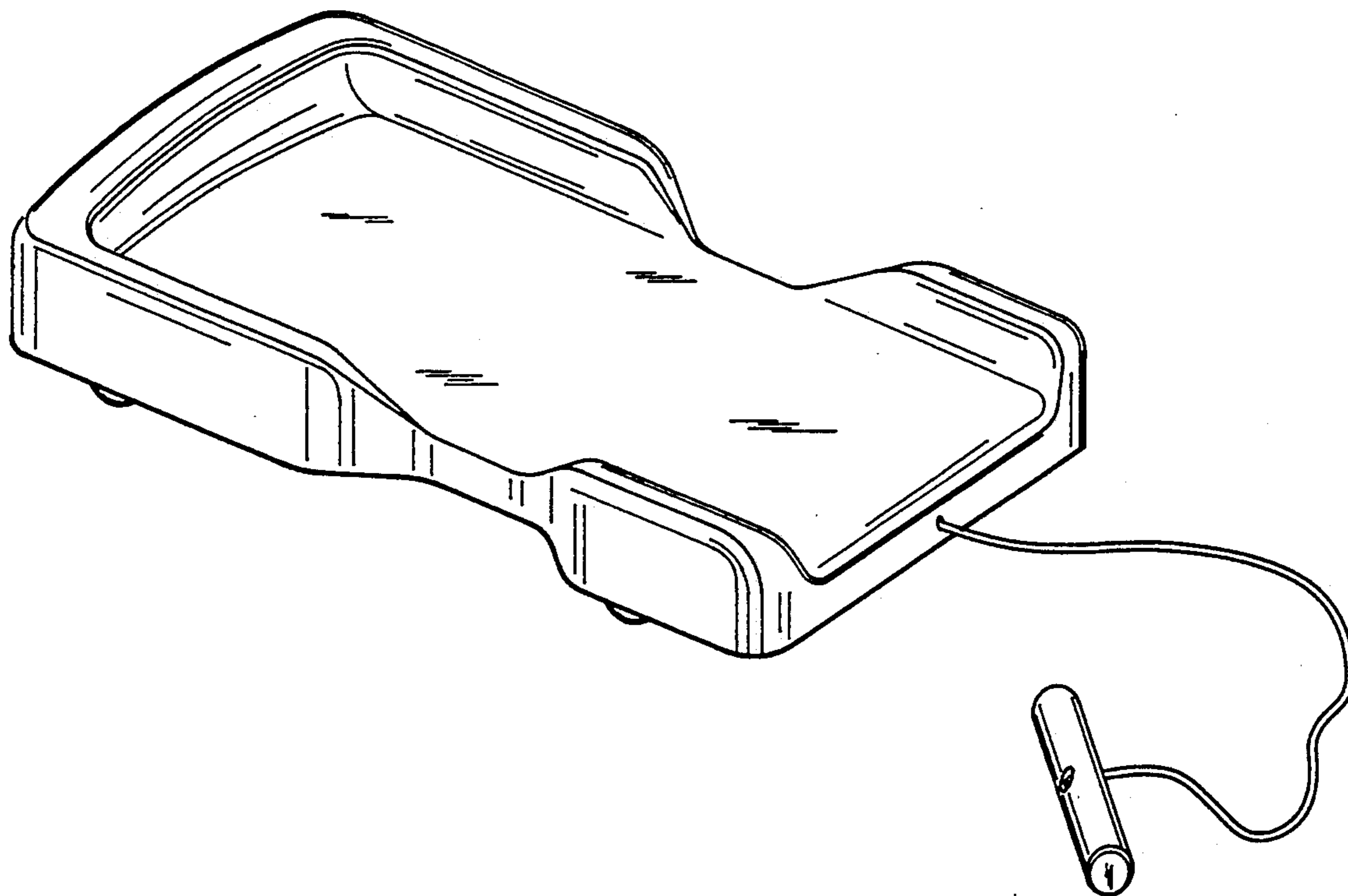
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a therapeutic foot exerciser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, side and rear perspective view of a therapeutic foot exerciser showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof.

The tether in FIGS. 2 through 6 is shown fragmentarily for ease of illustration.



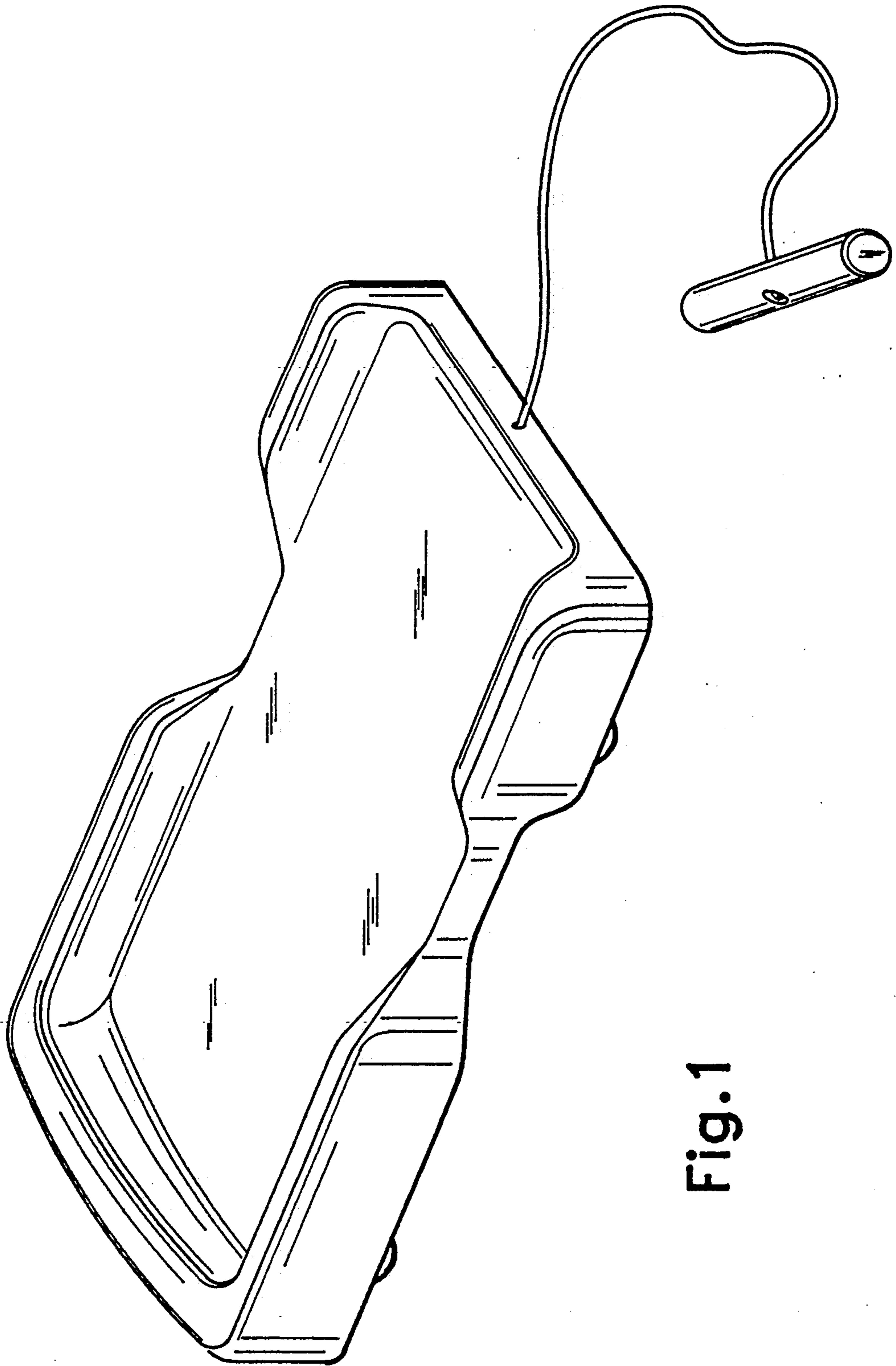

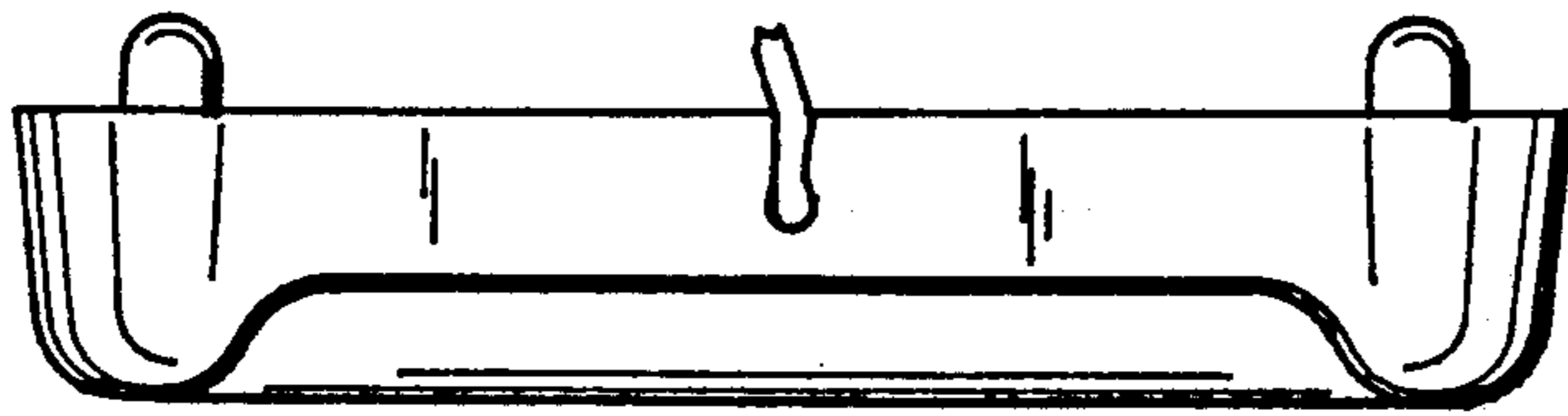

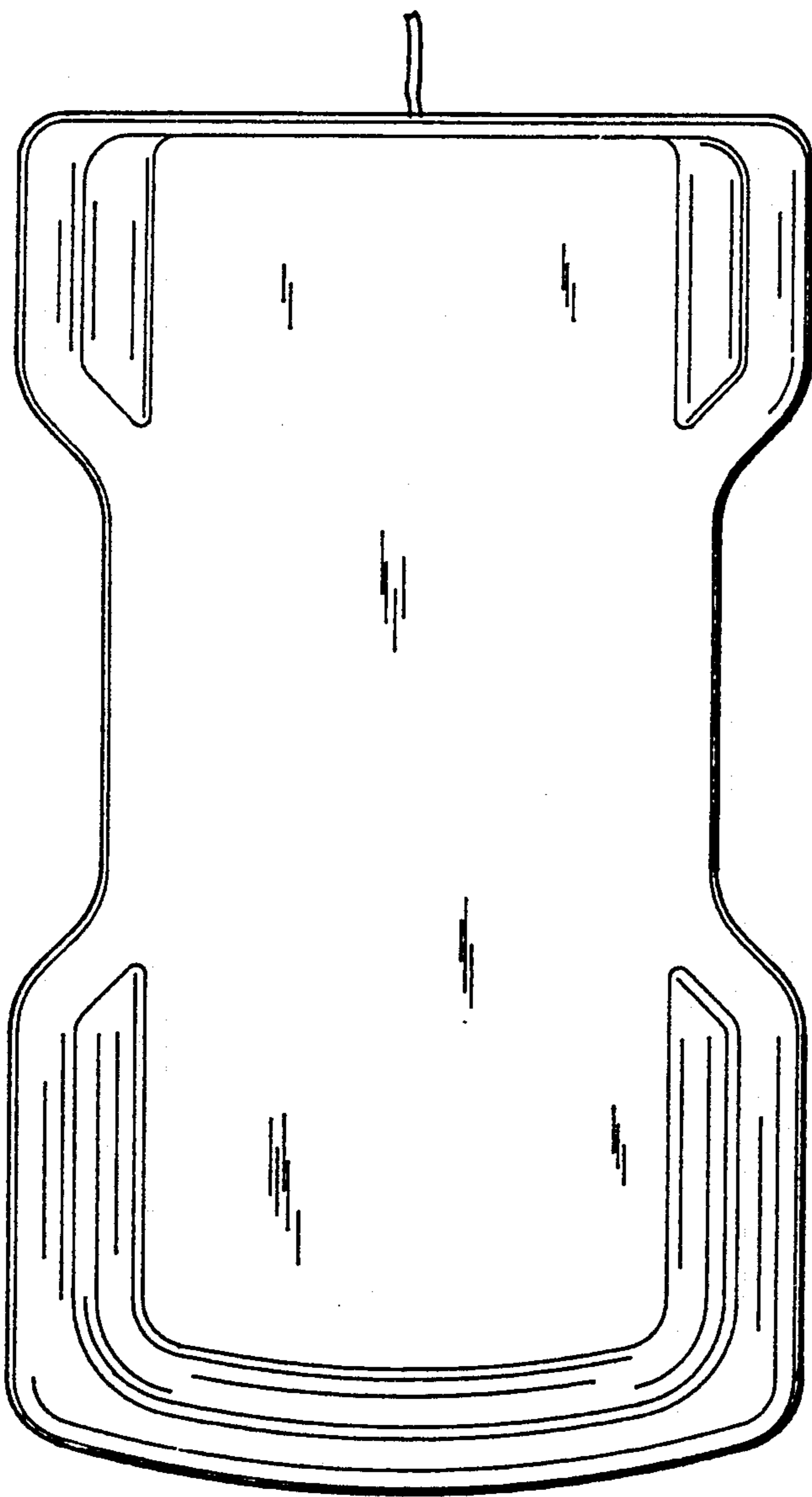

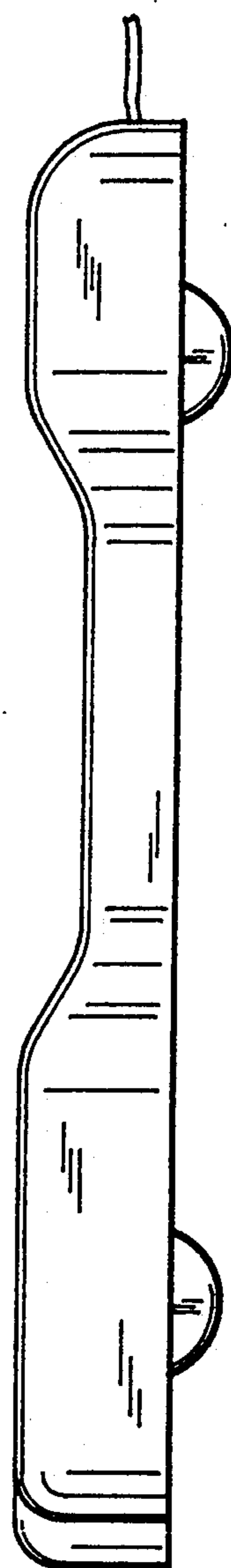

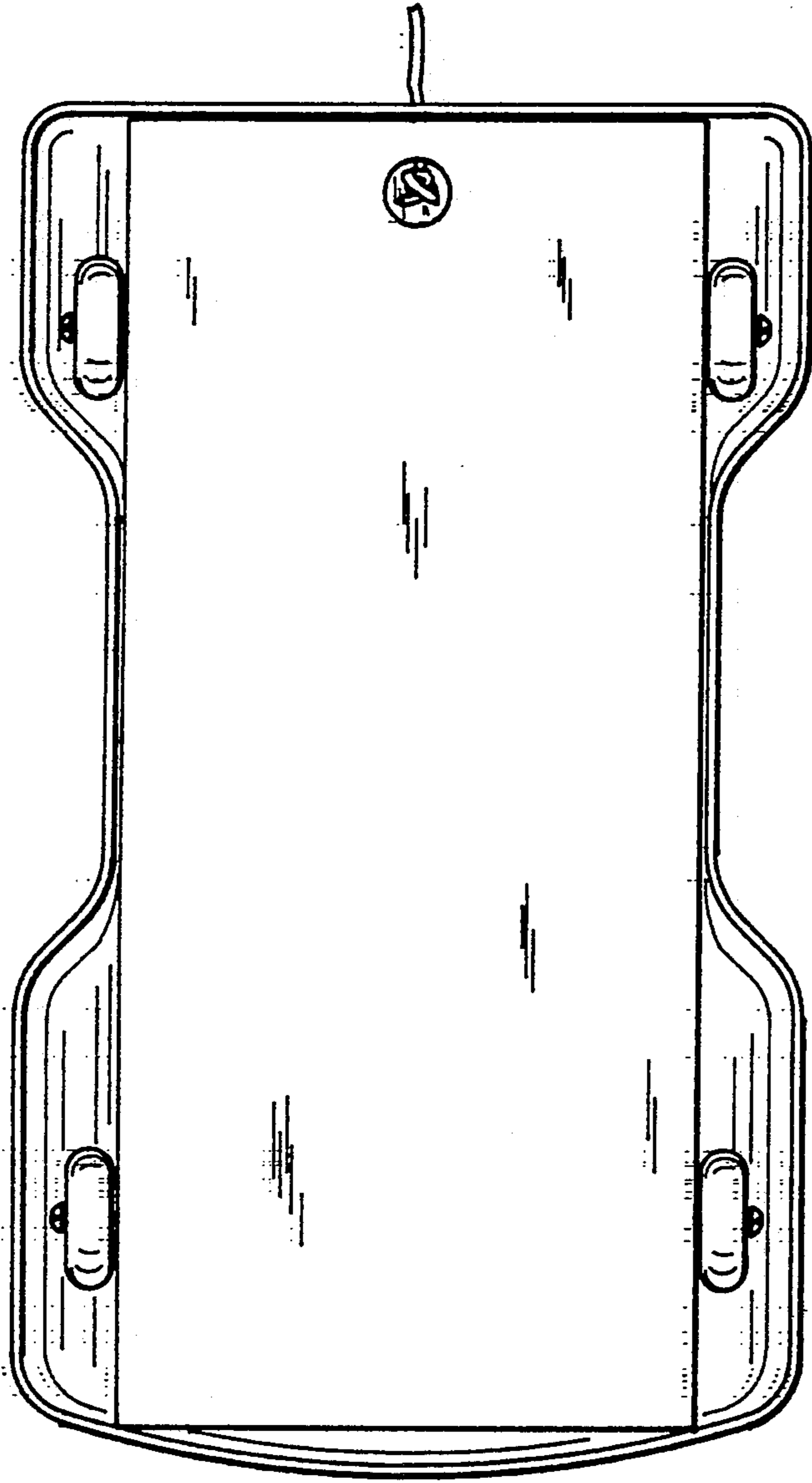

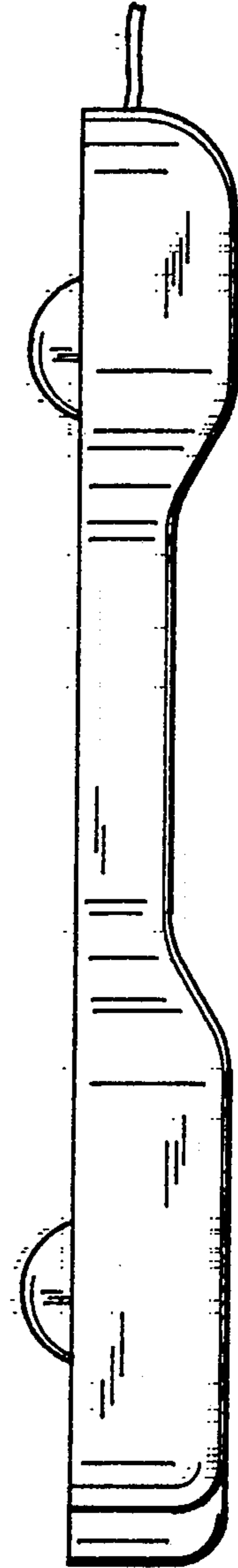

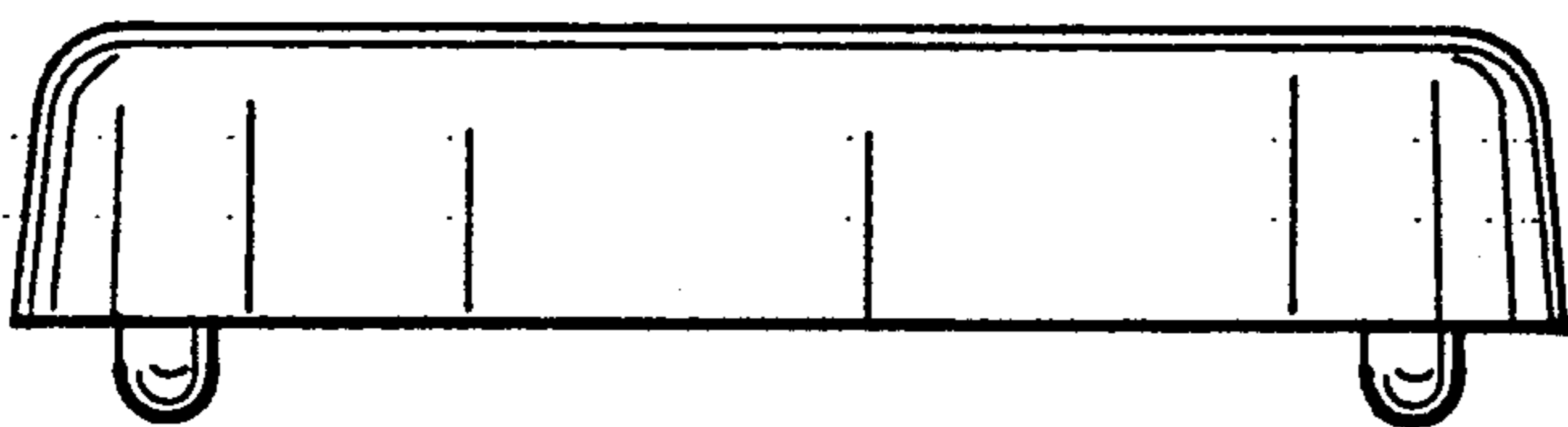
