FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a fishing lure showing my new design.

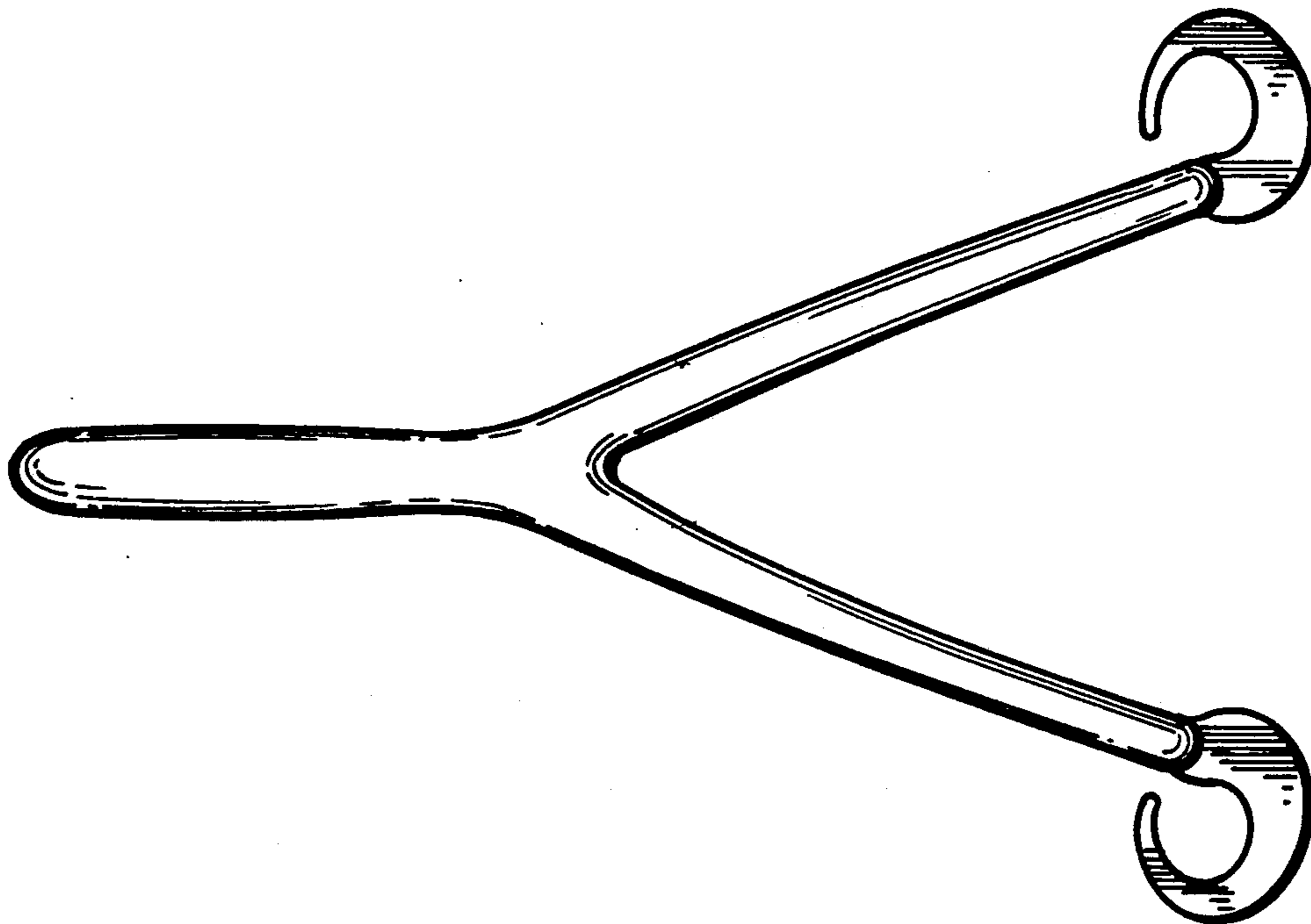
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view.

The appearance of the side opposite that of FIG. 2 is a mirror image of FIG. 2.



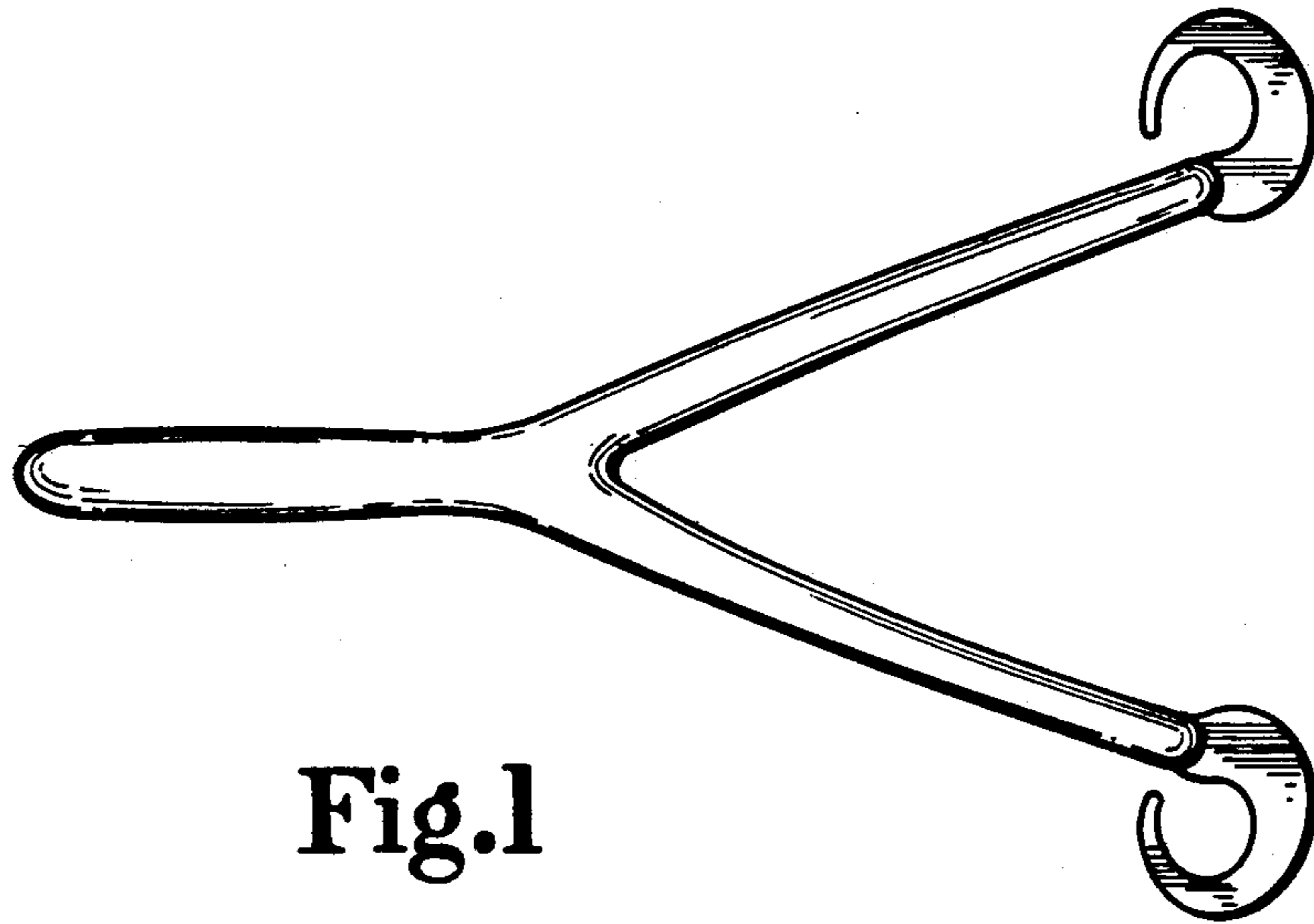
