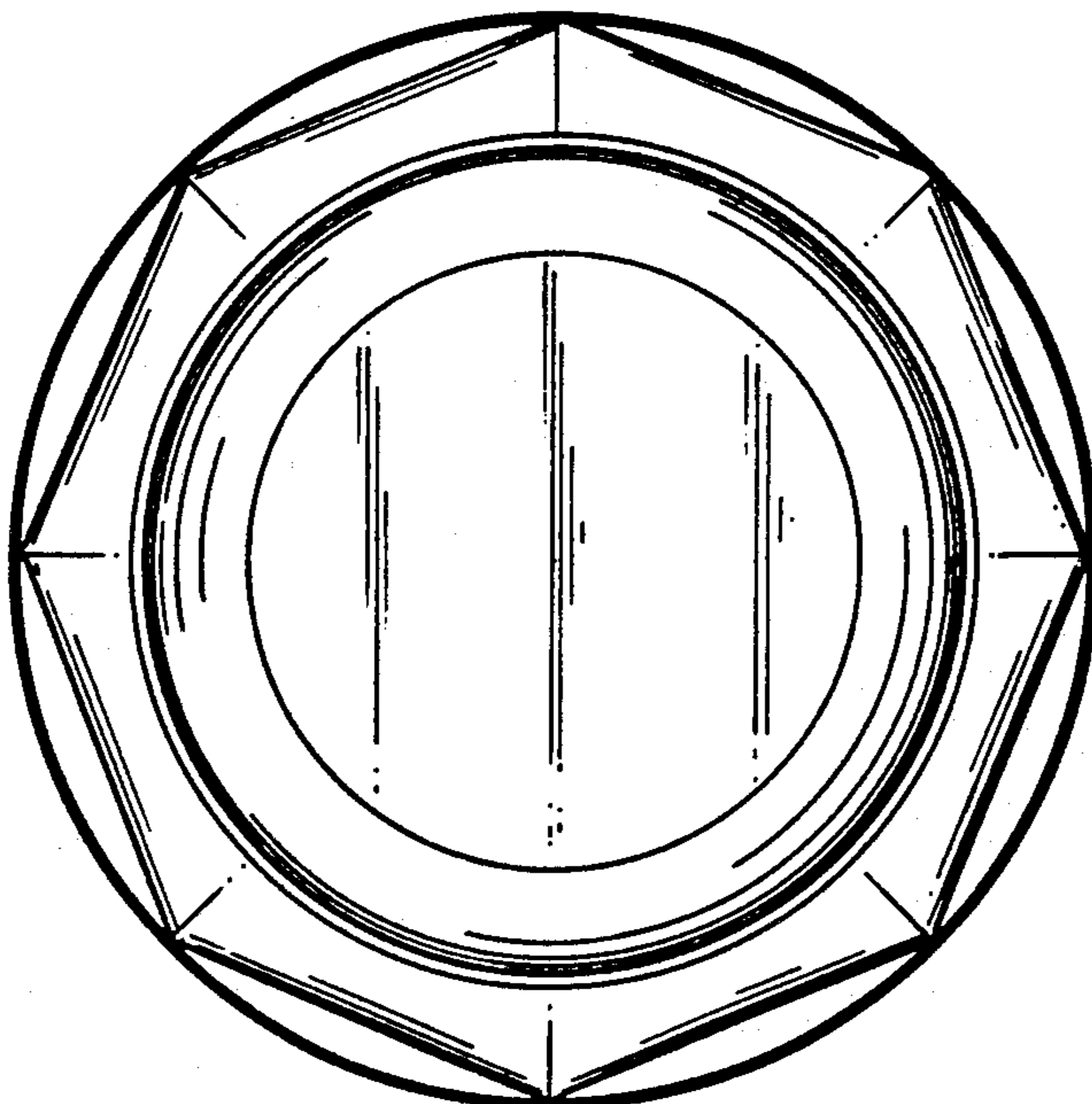
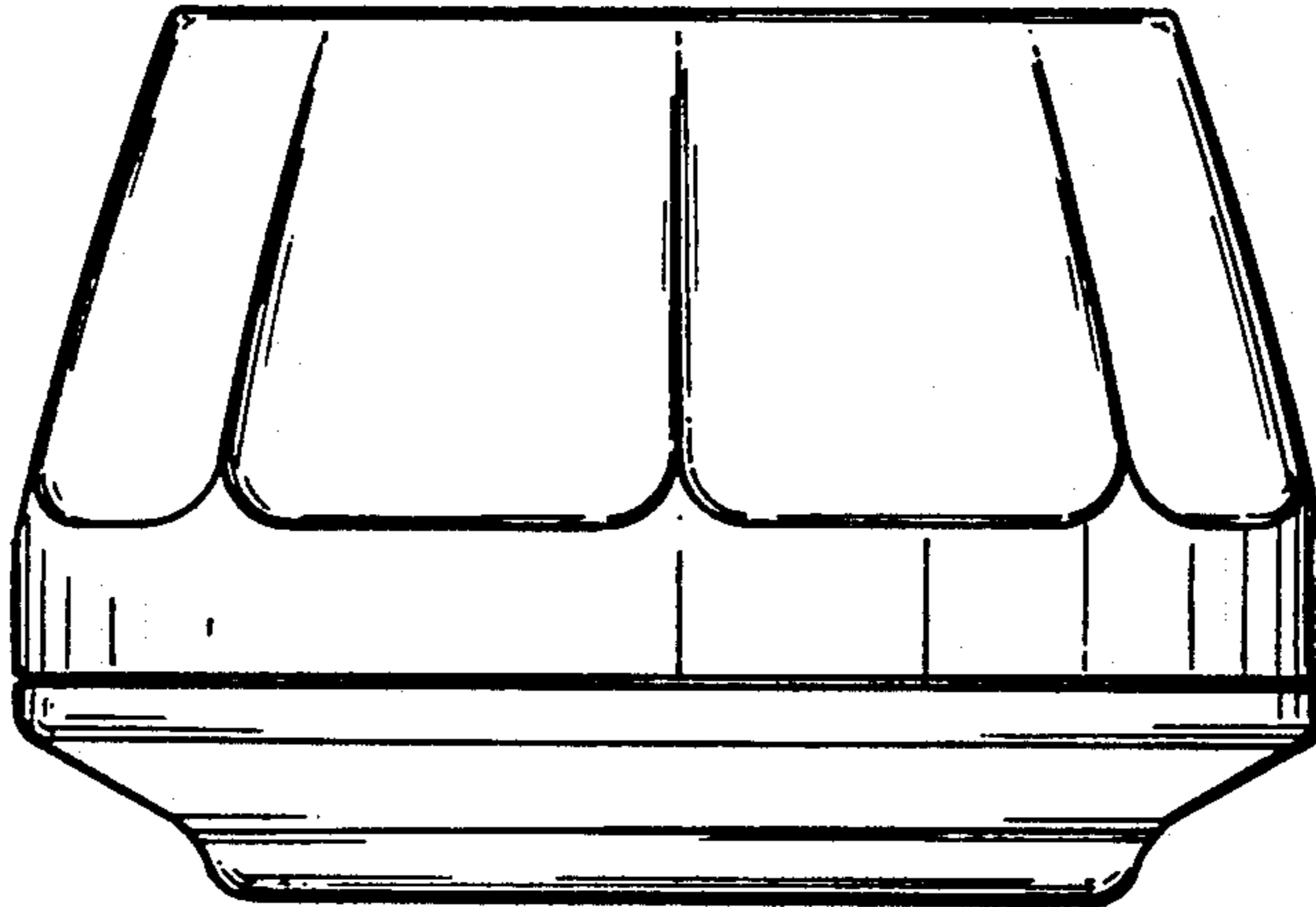

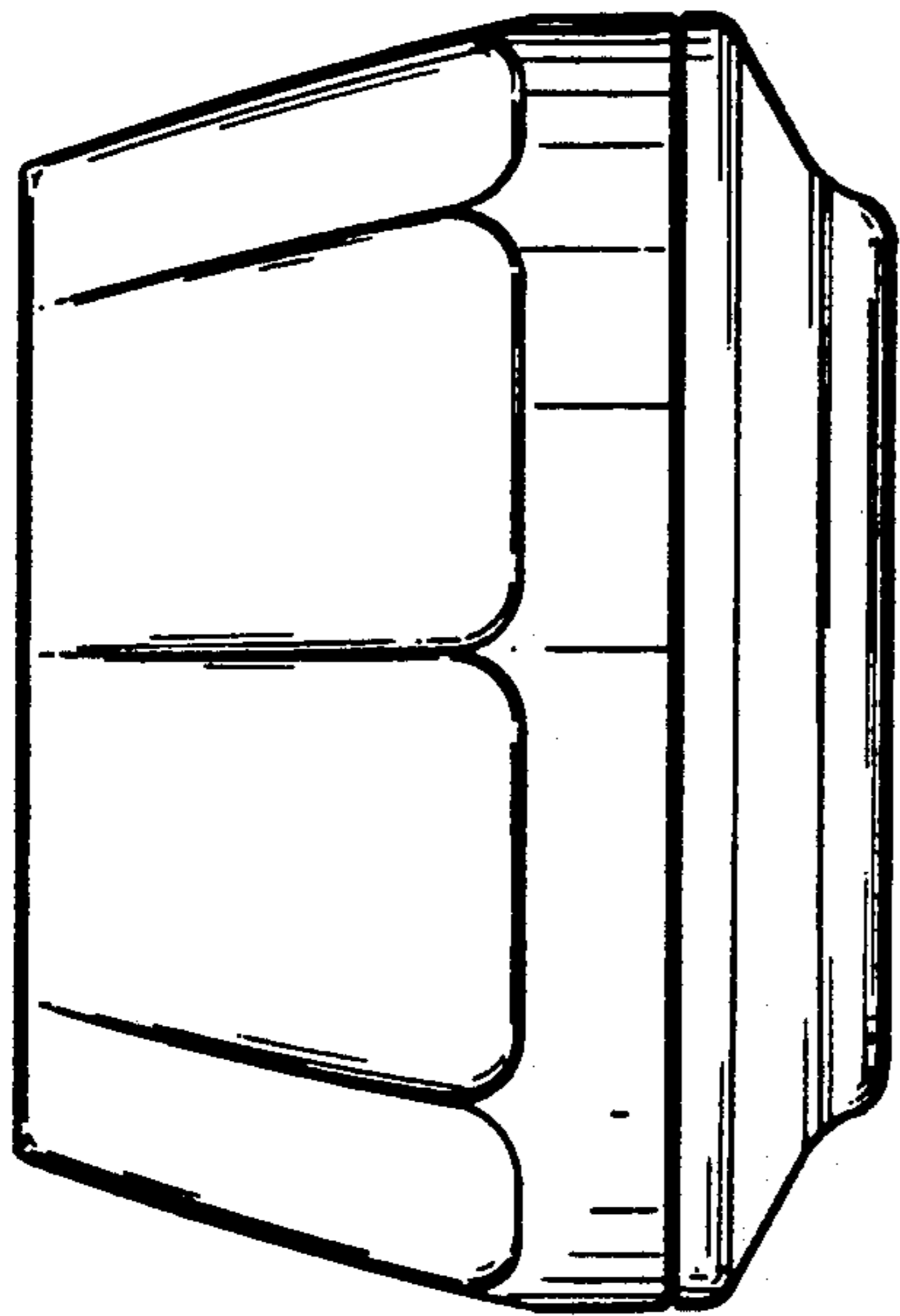
**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an insulated bowl, as shown and described.

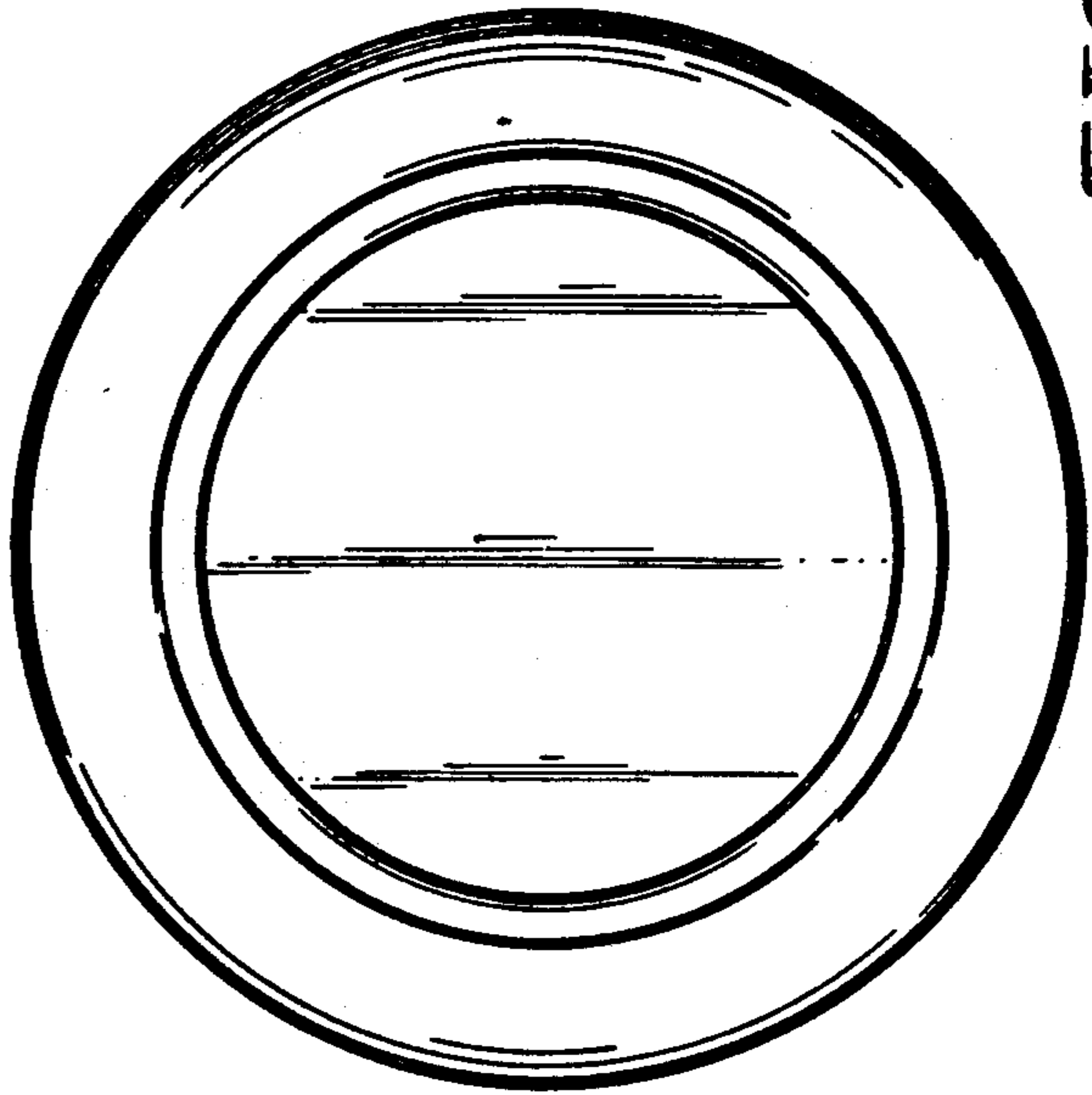
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

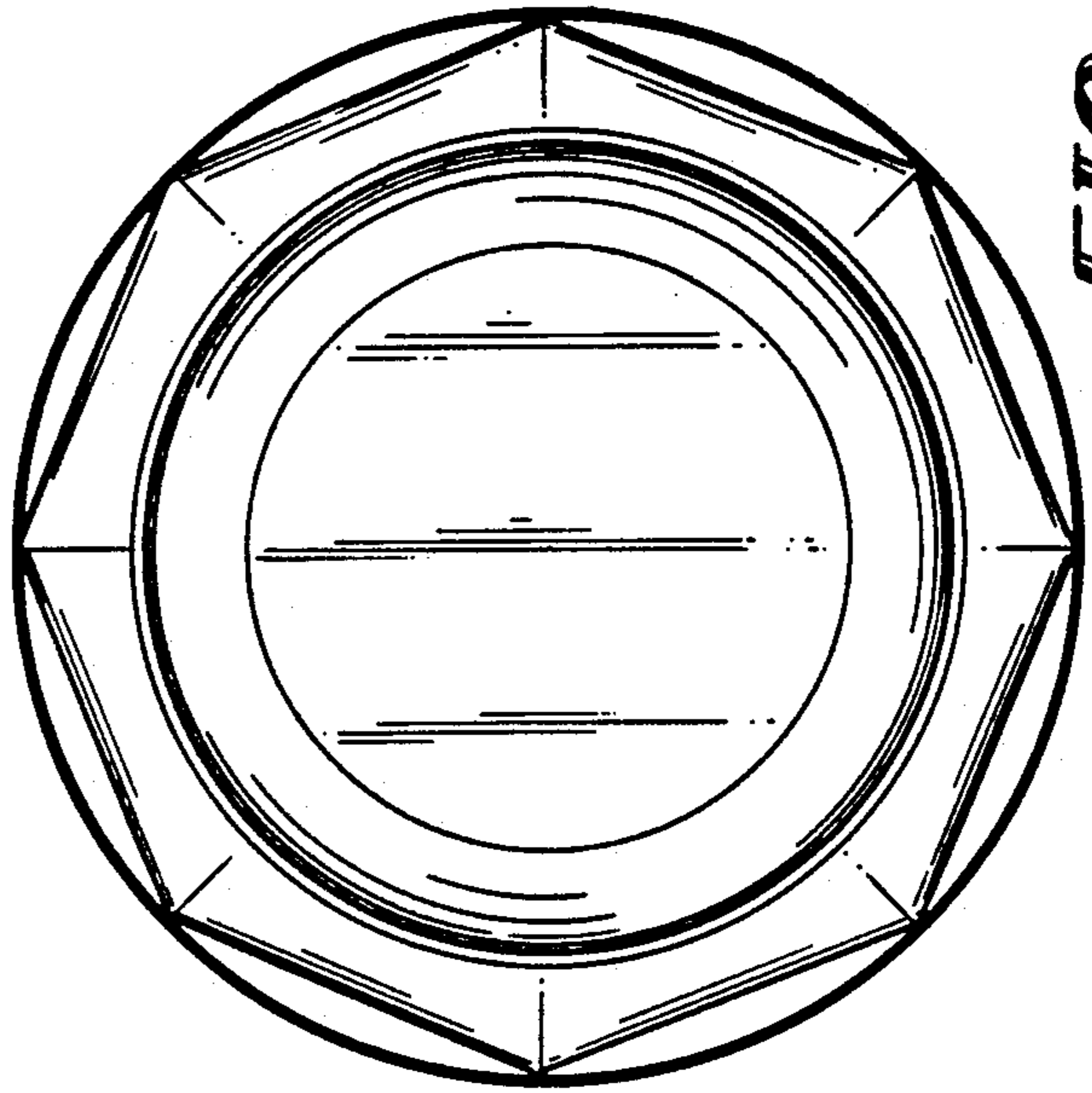
