DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top left, front perspective view of an apparatus for slitting elongated flexible tape showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

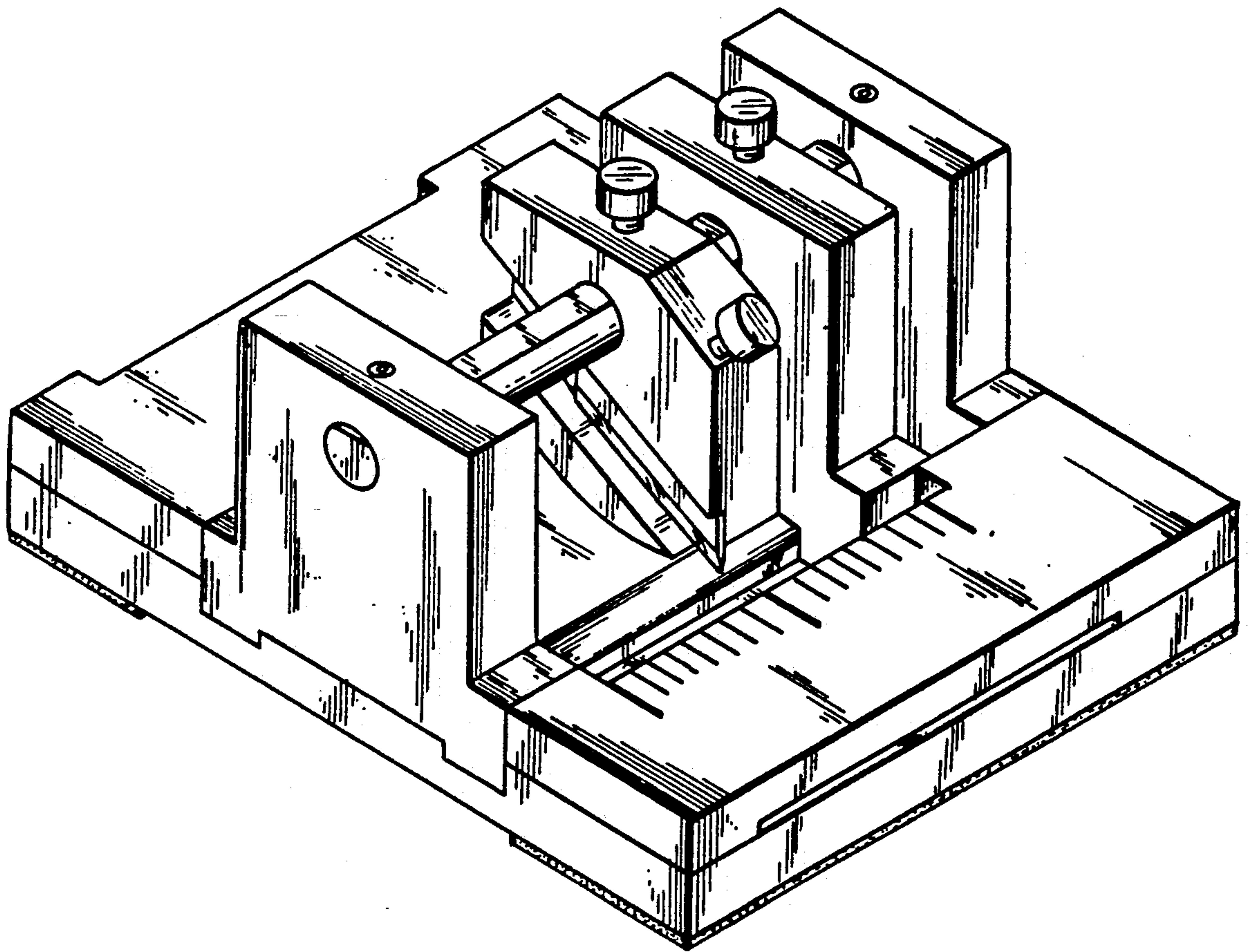

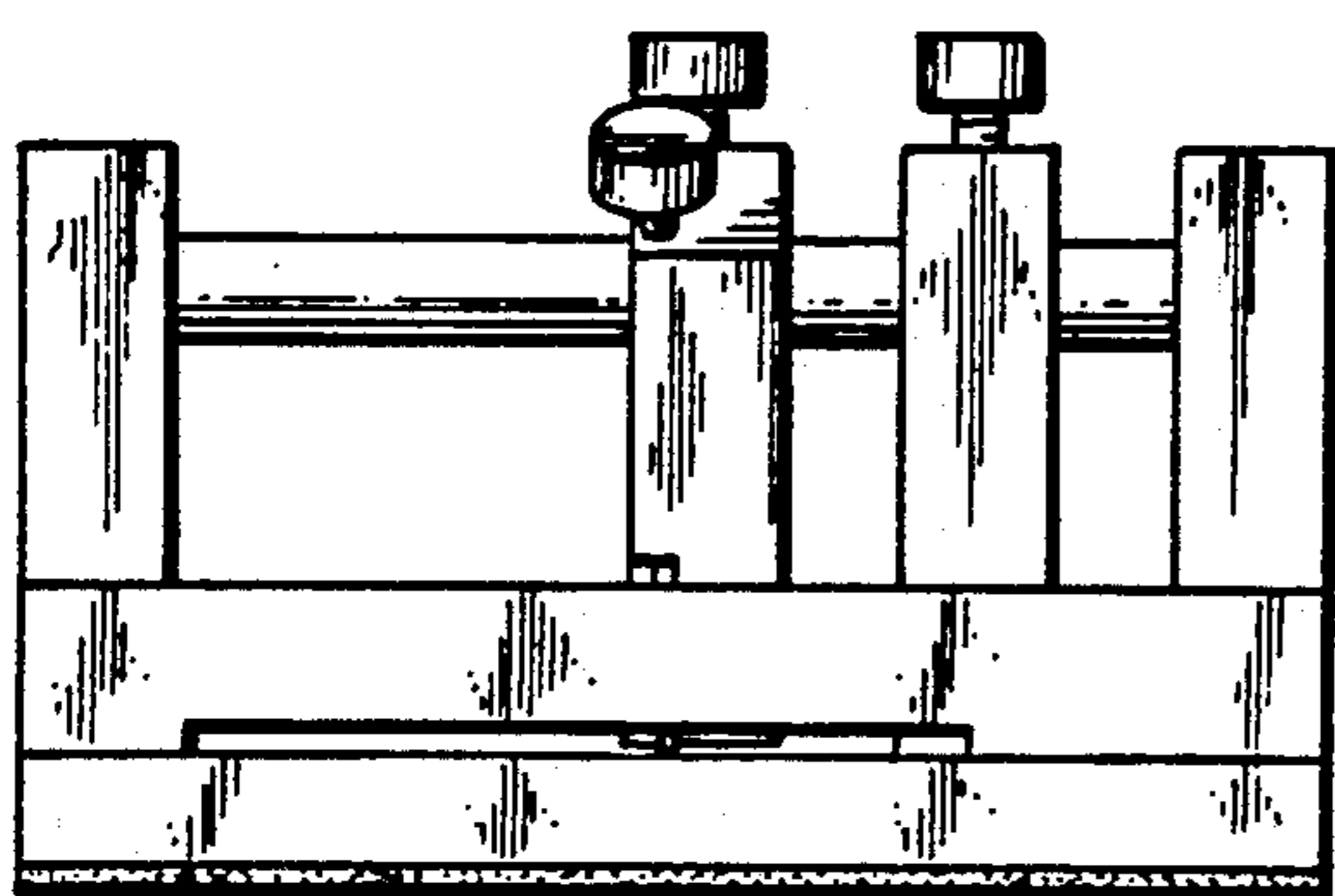
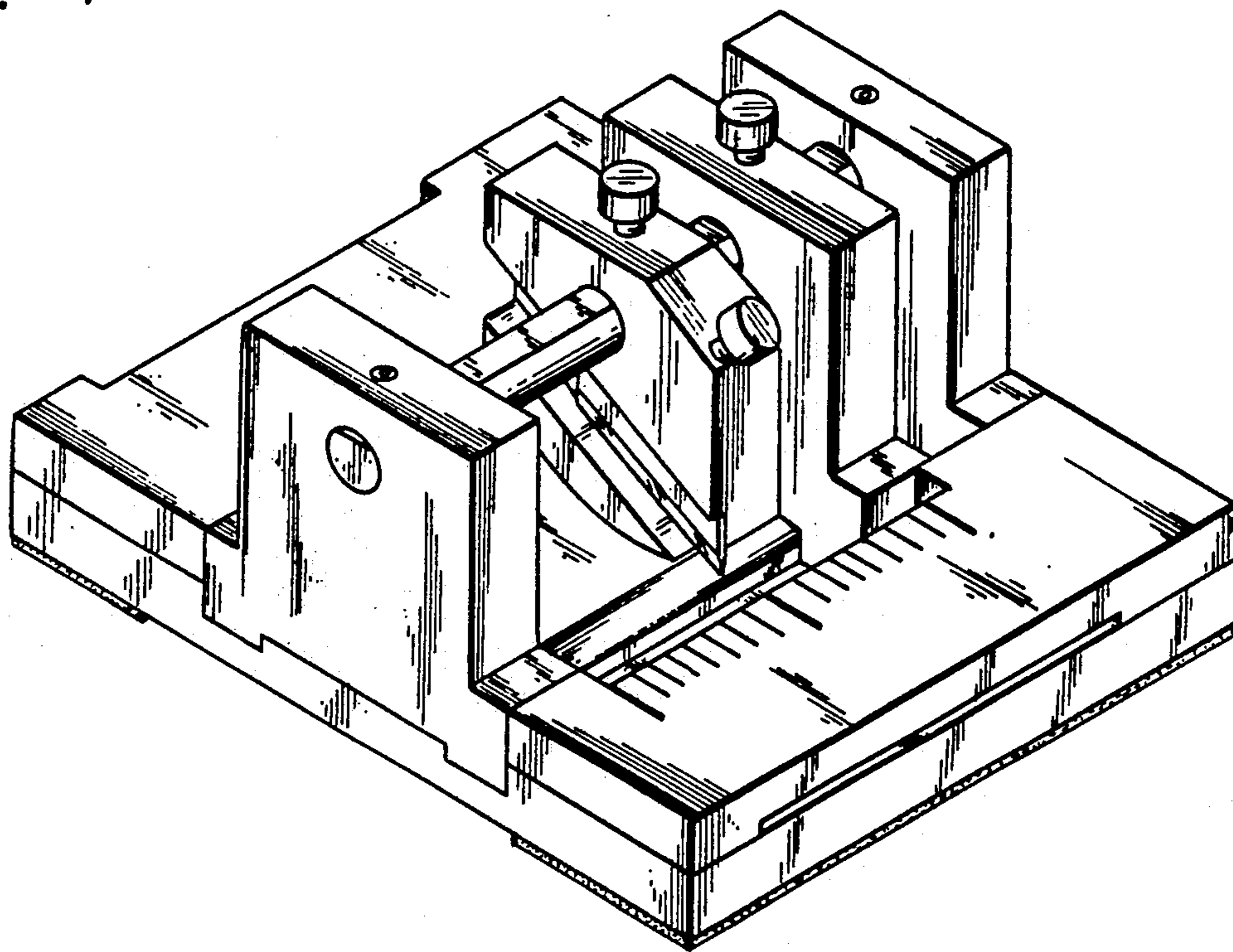

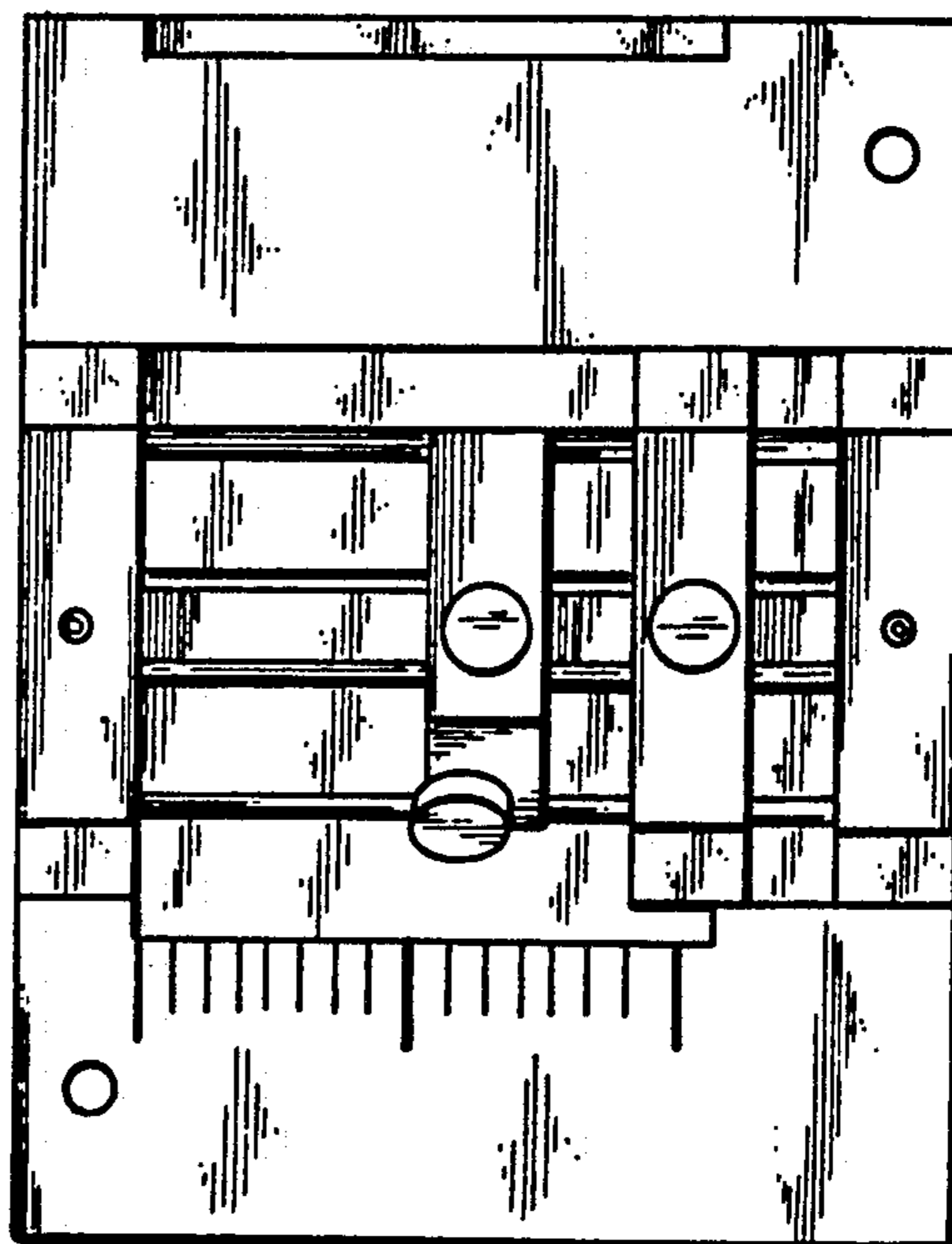

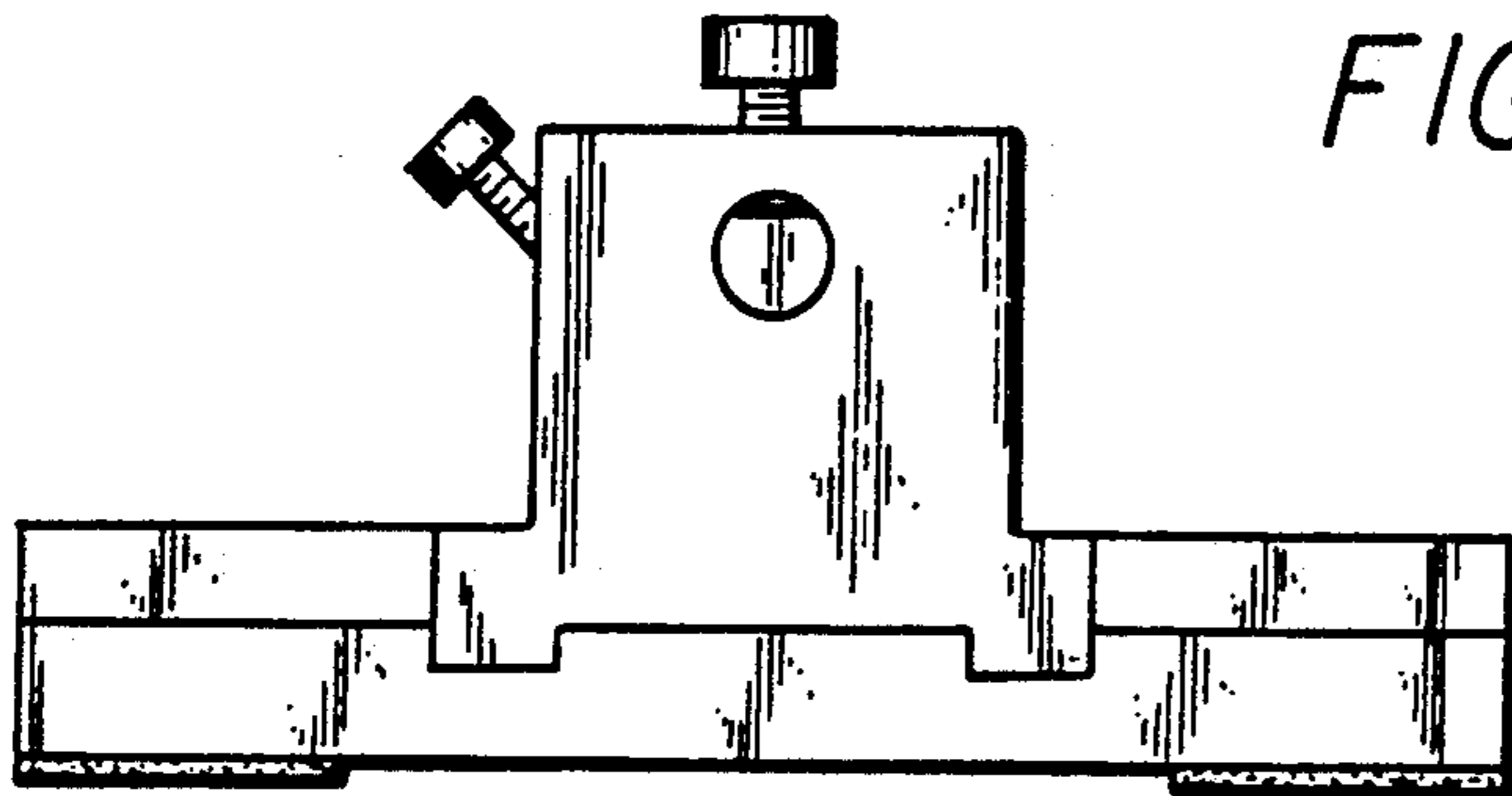

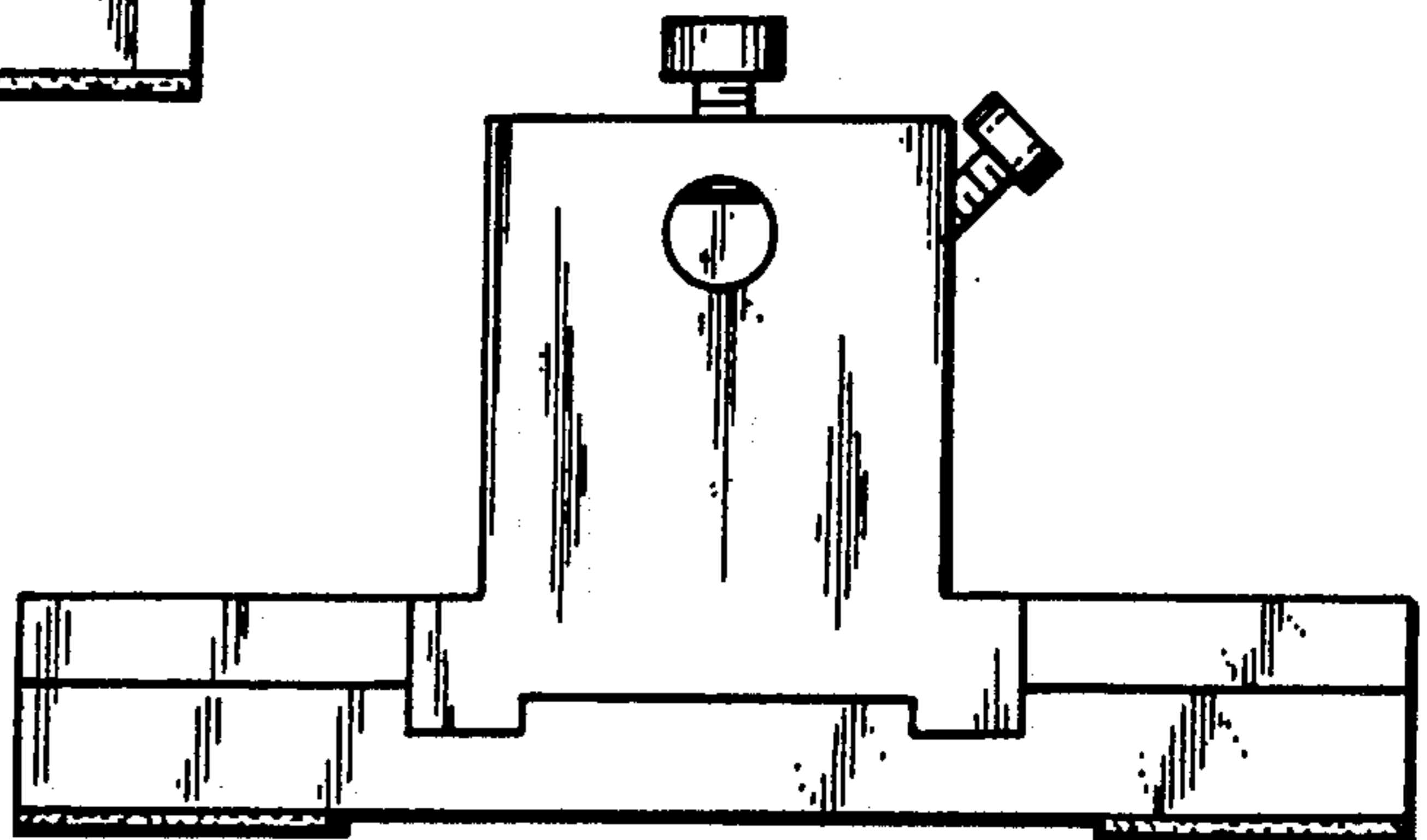

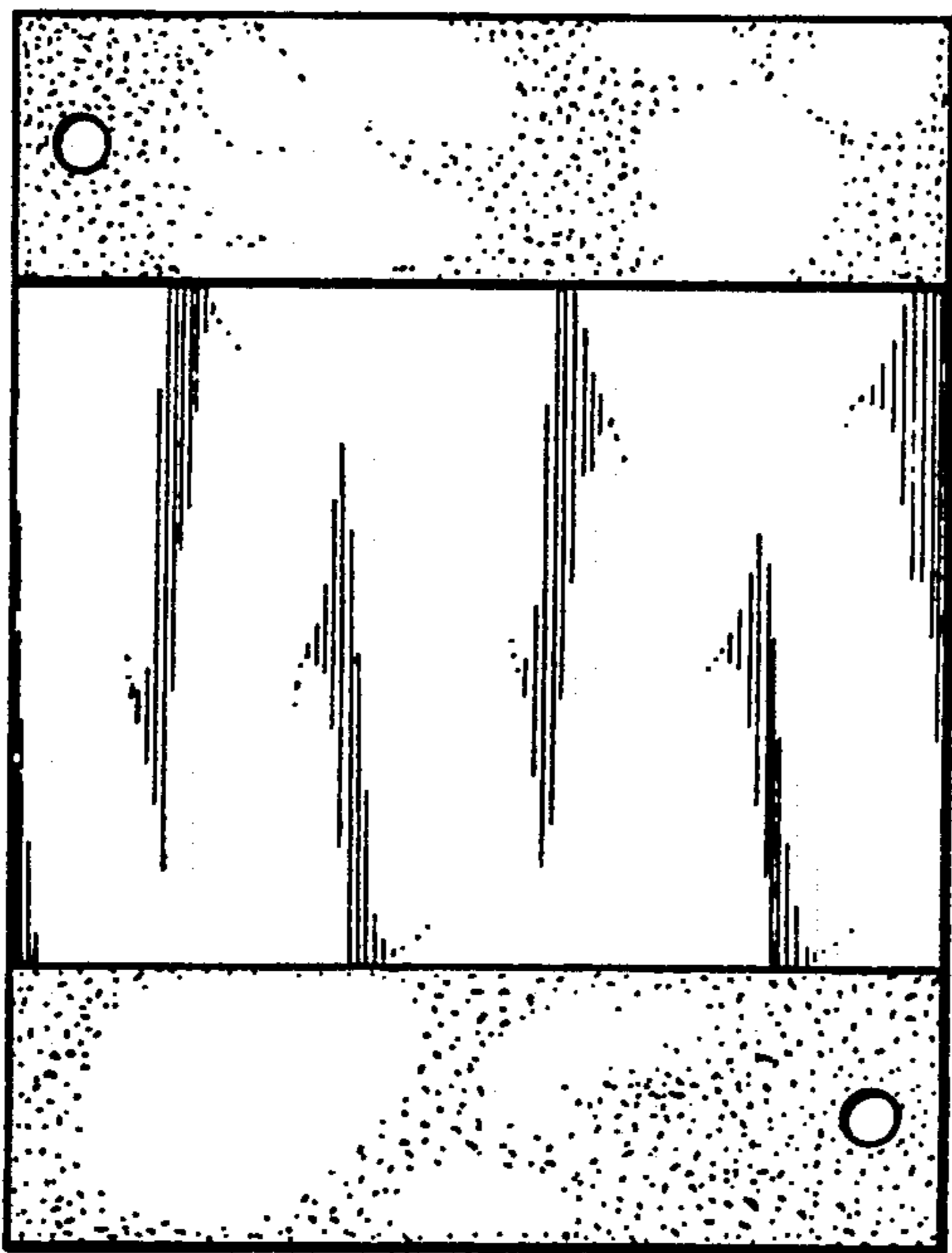

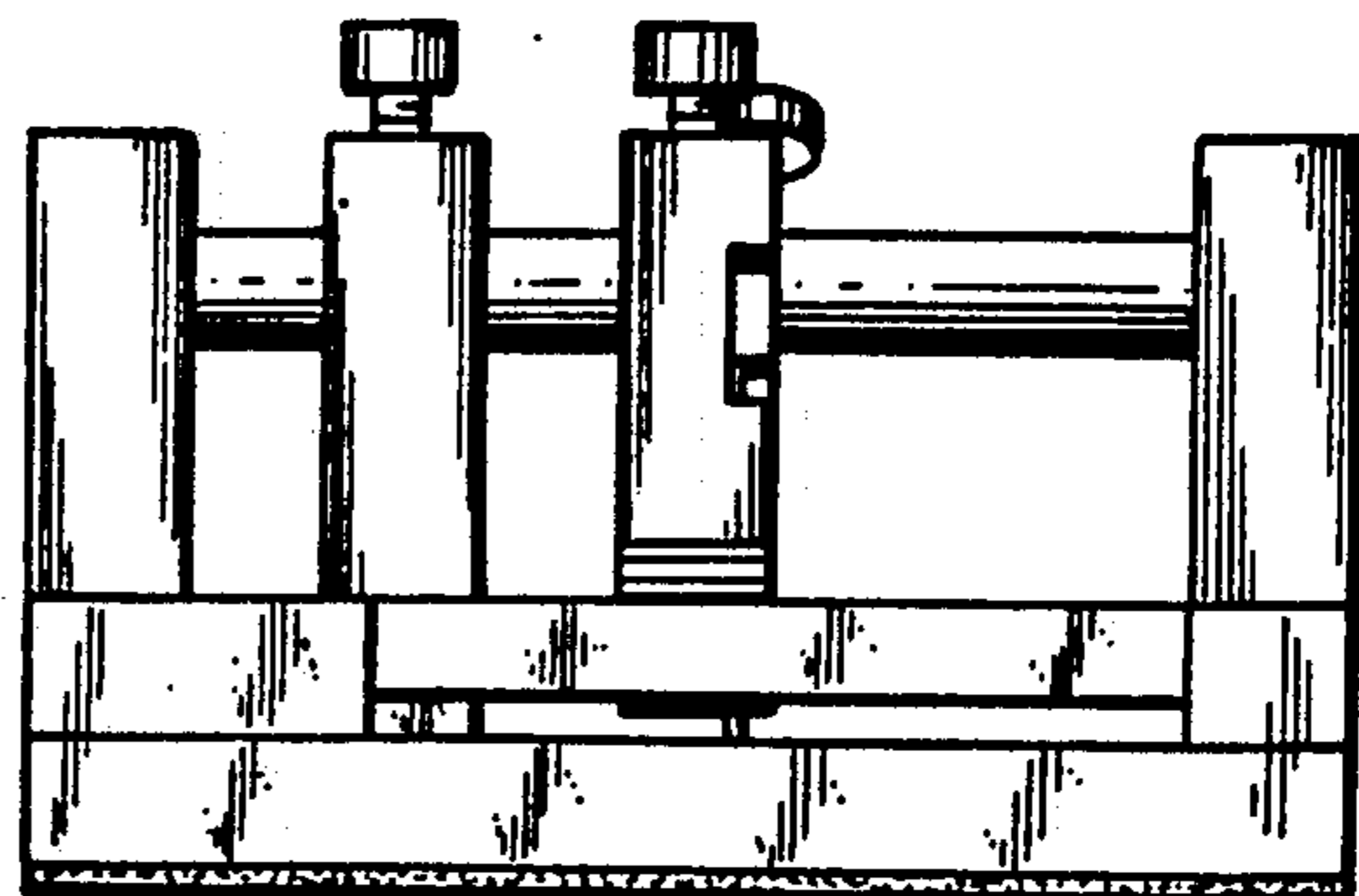
