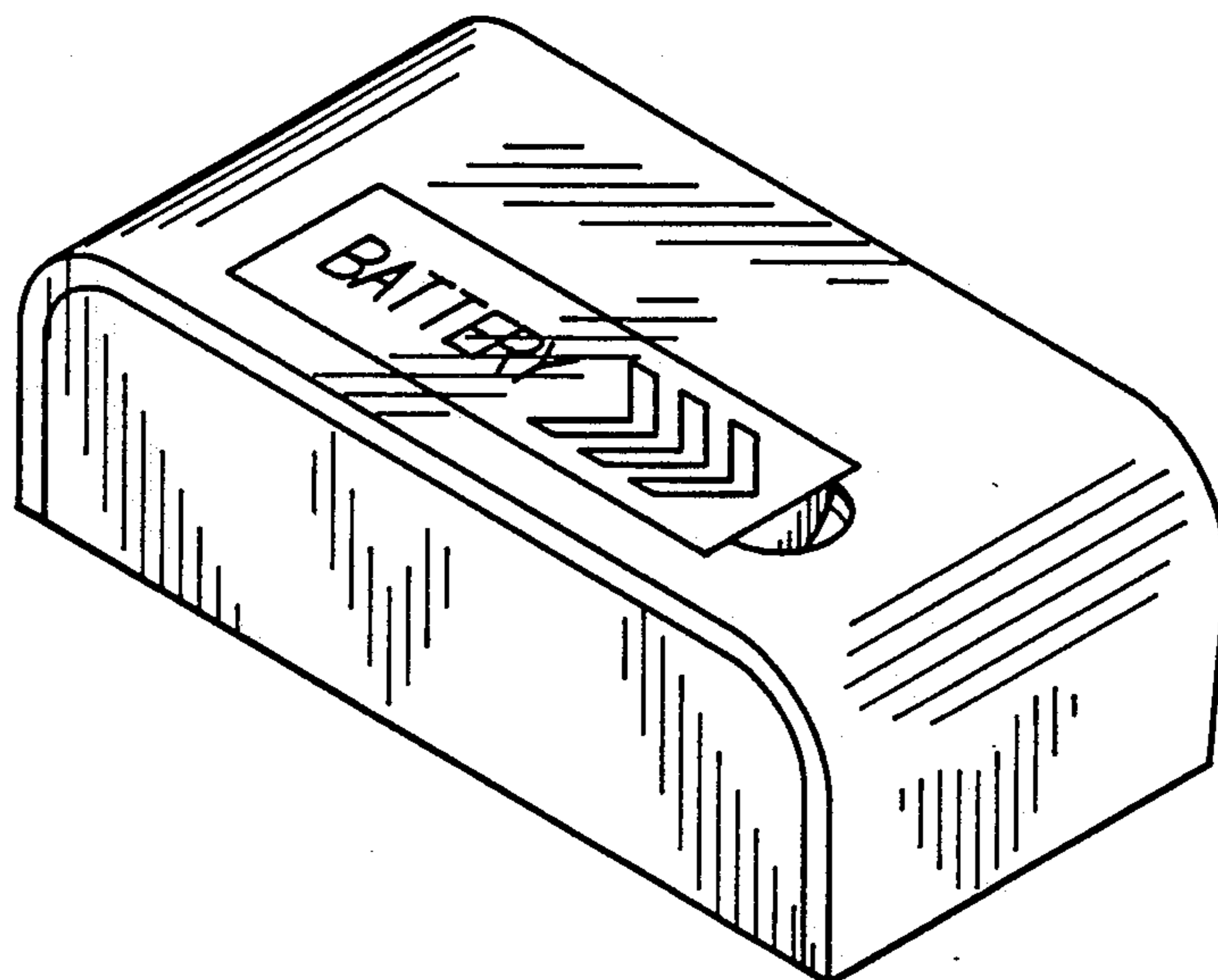
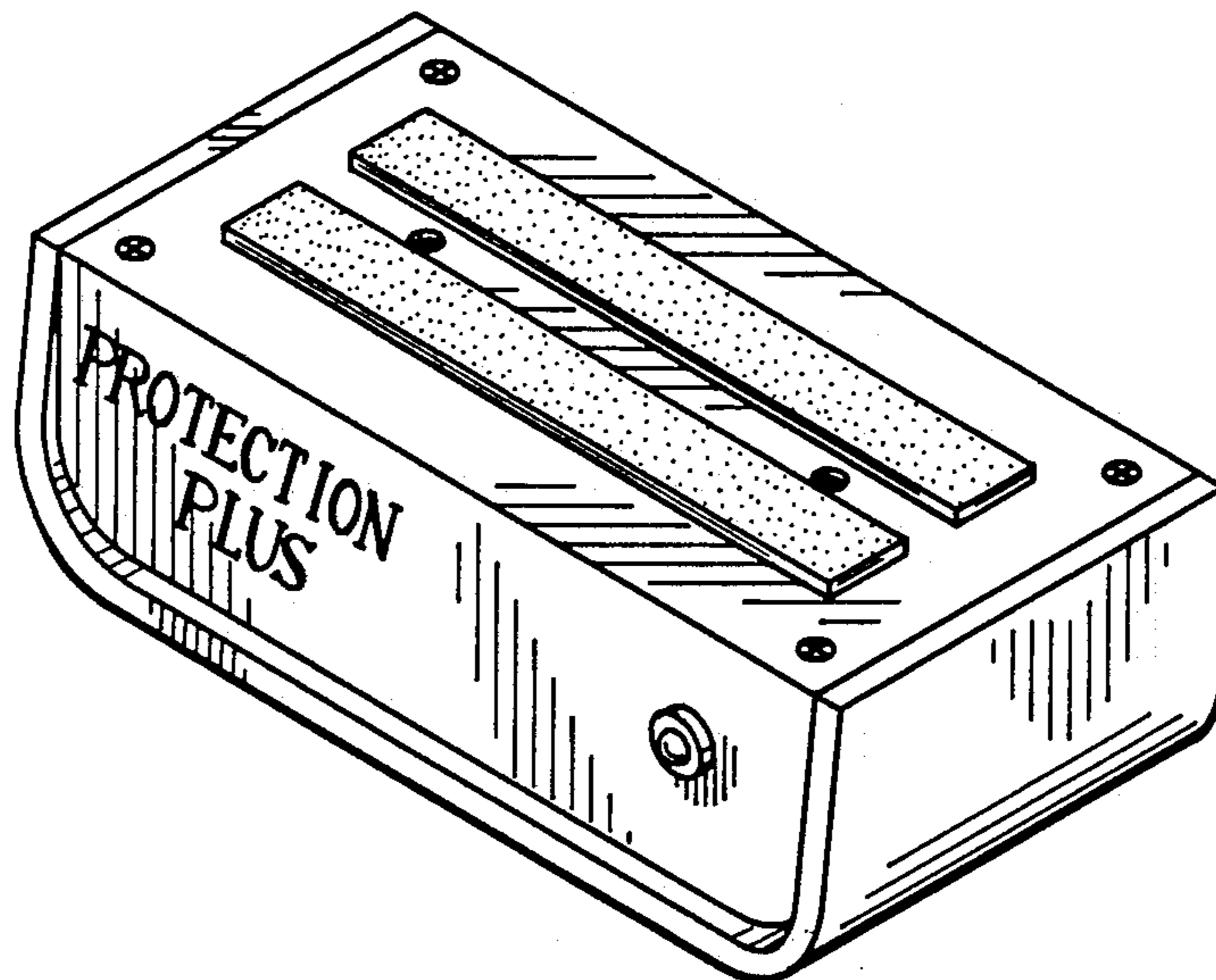

DESCRIPTION

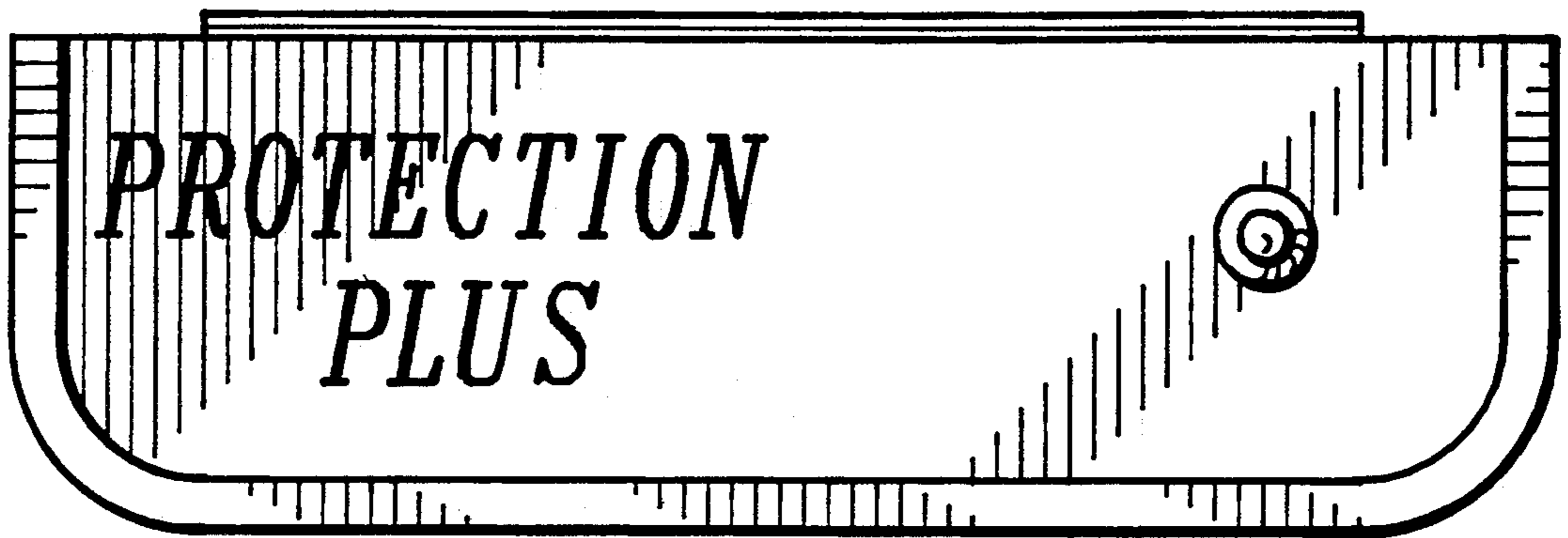

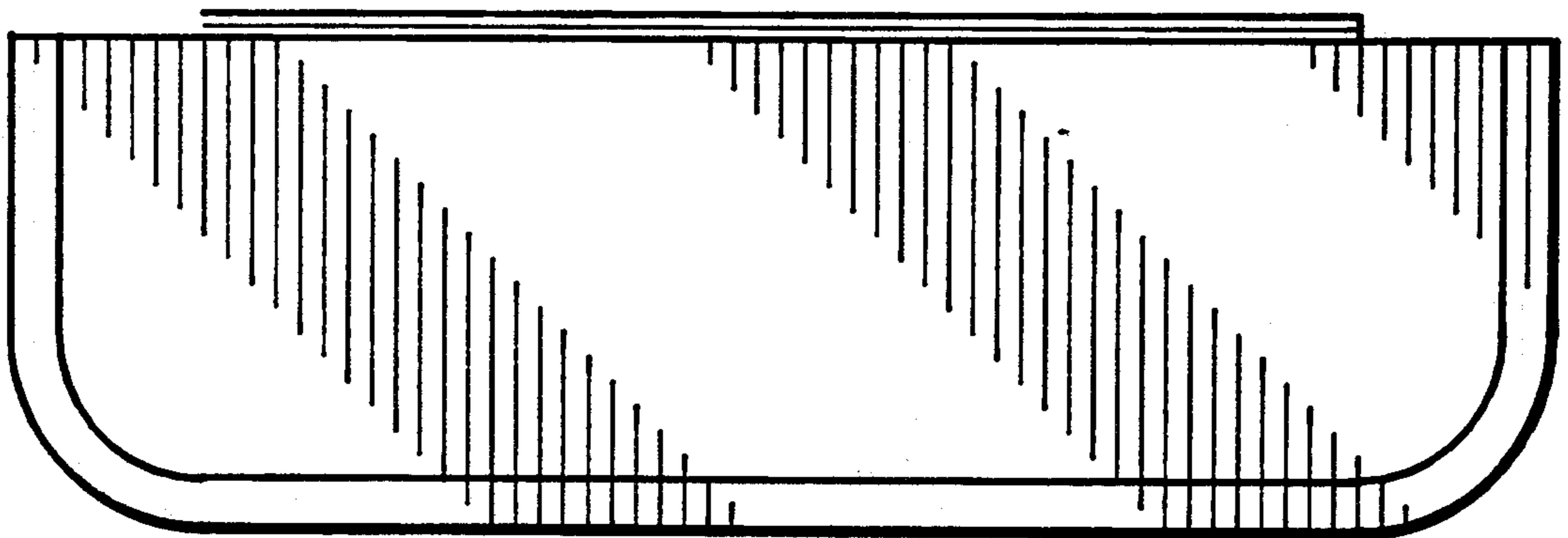

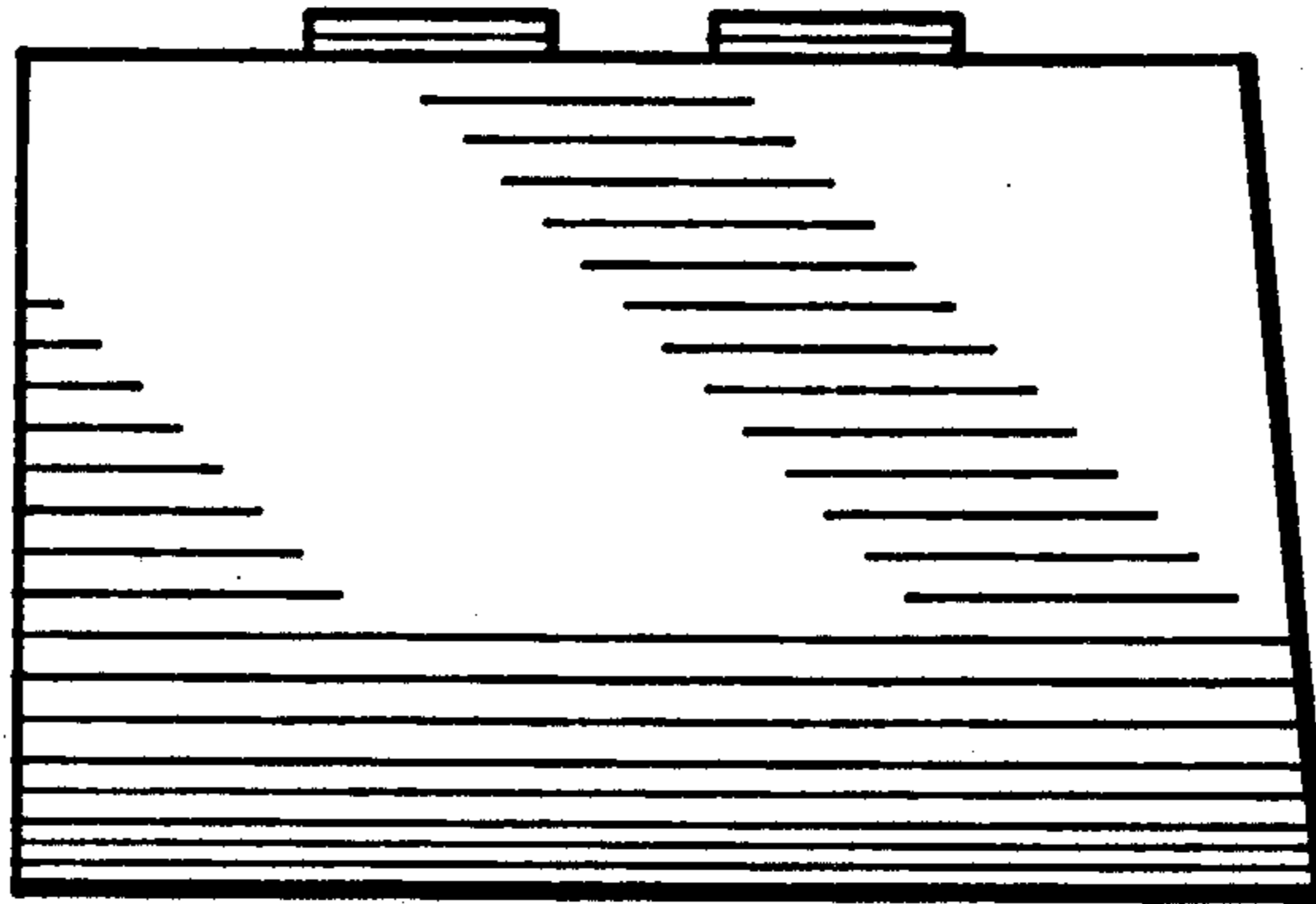

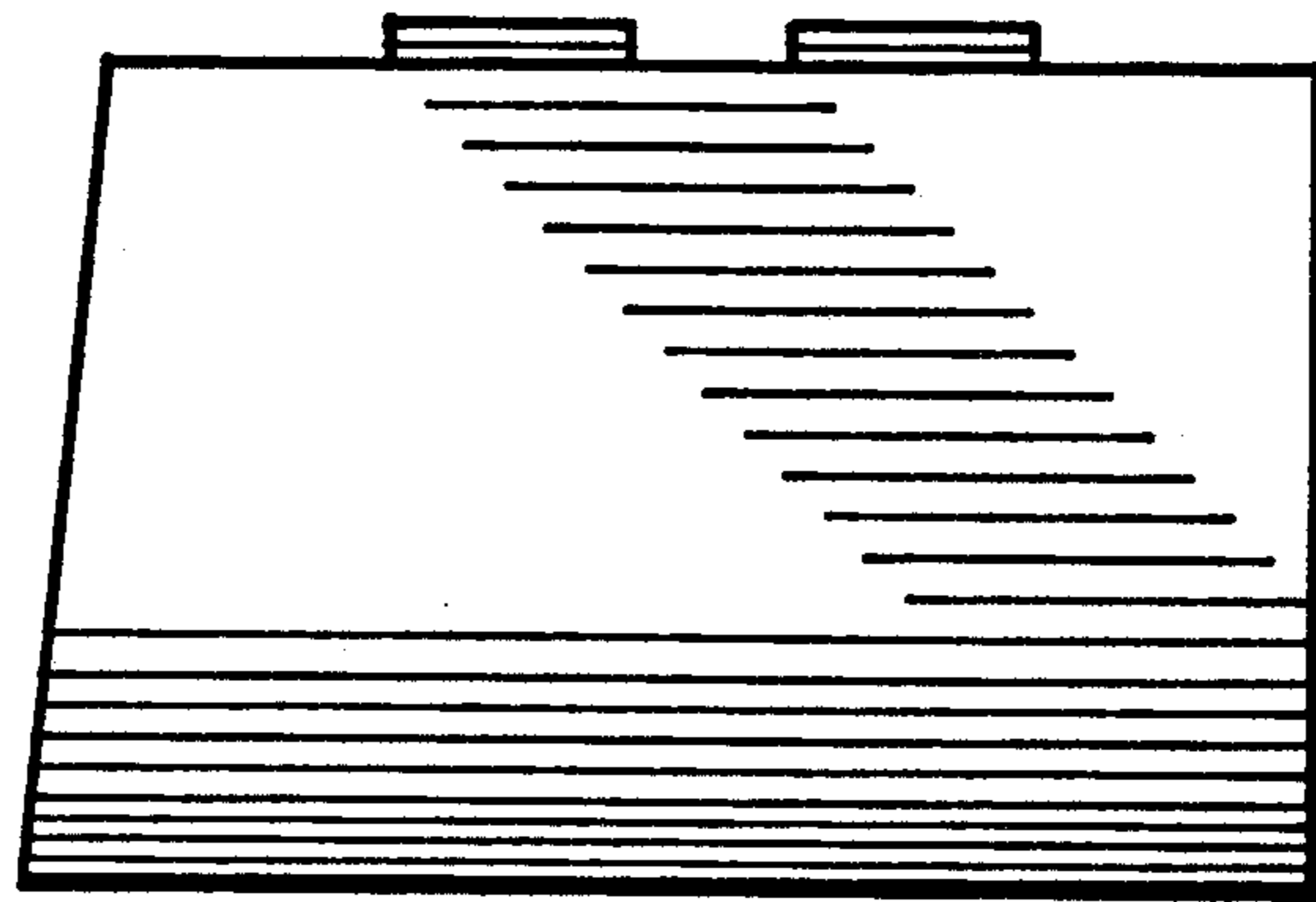

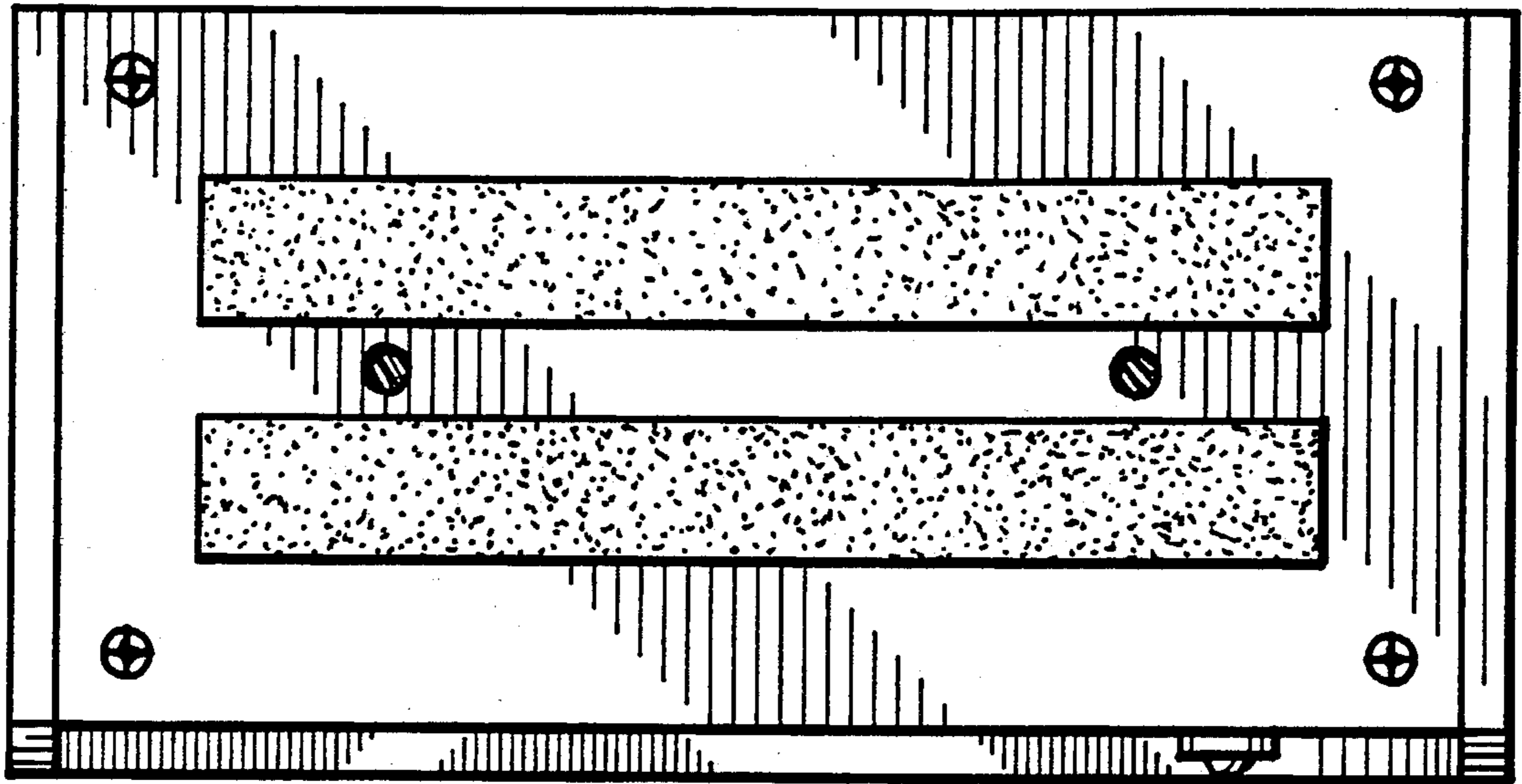

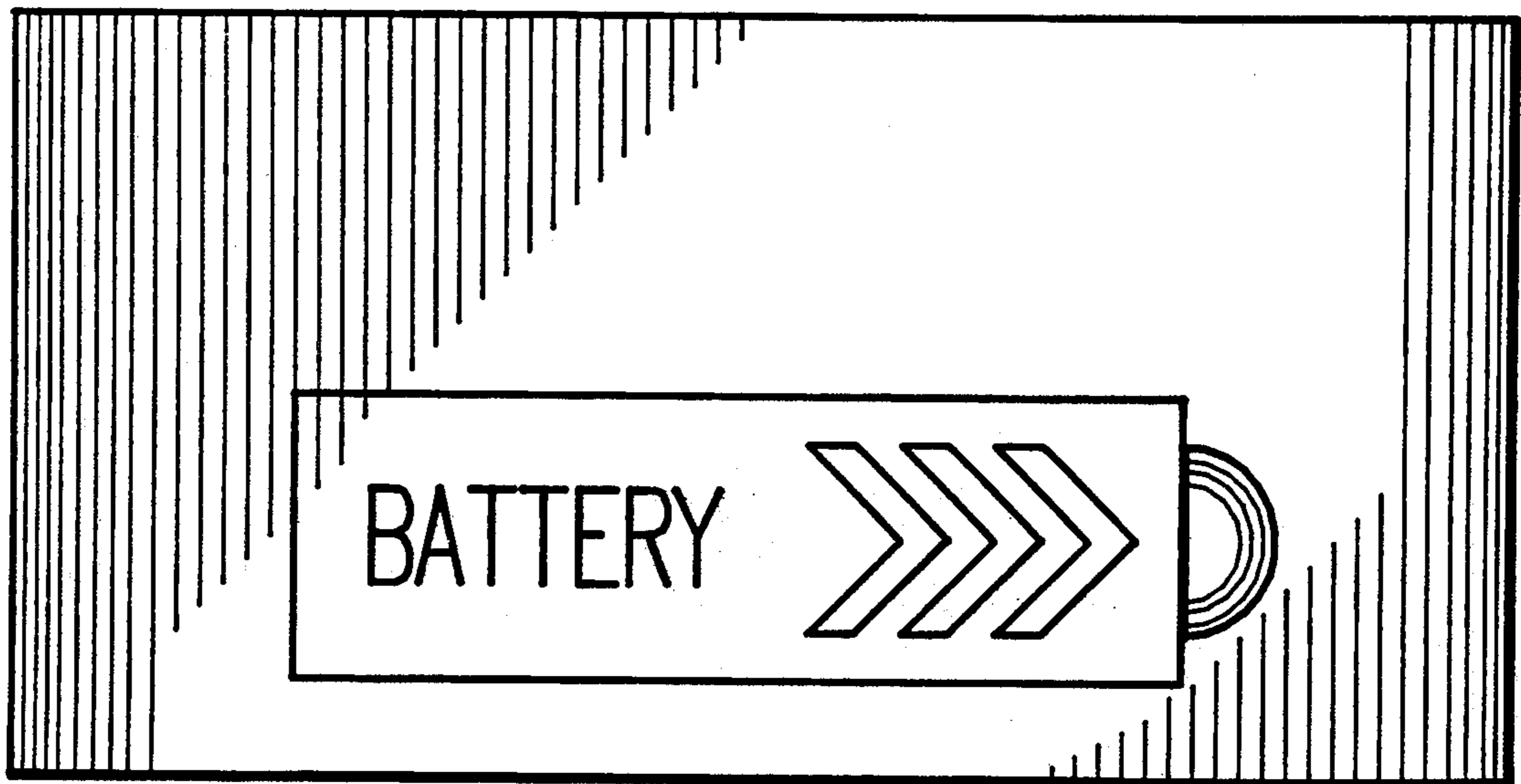

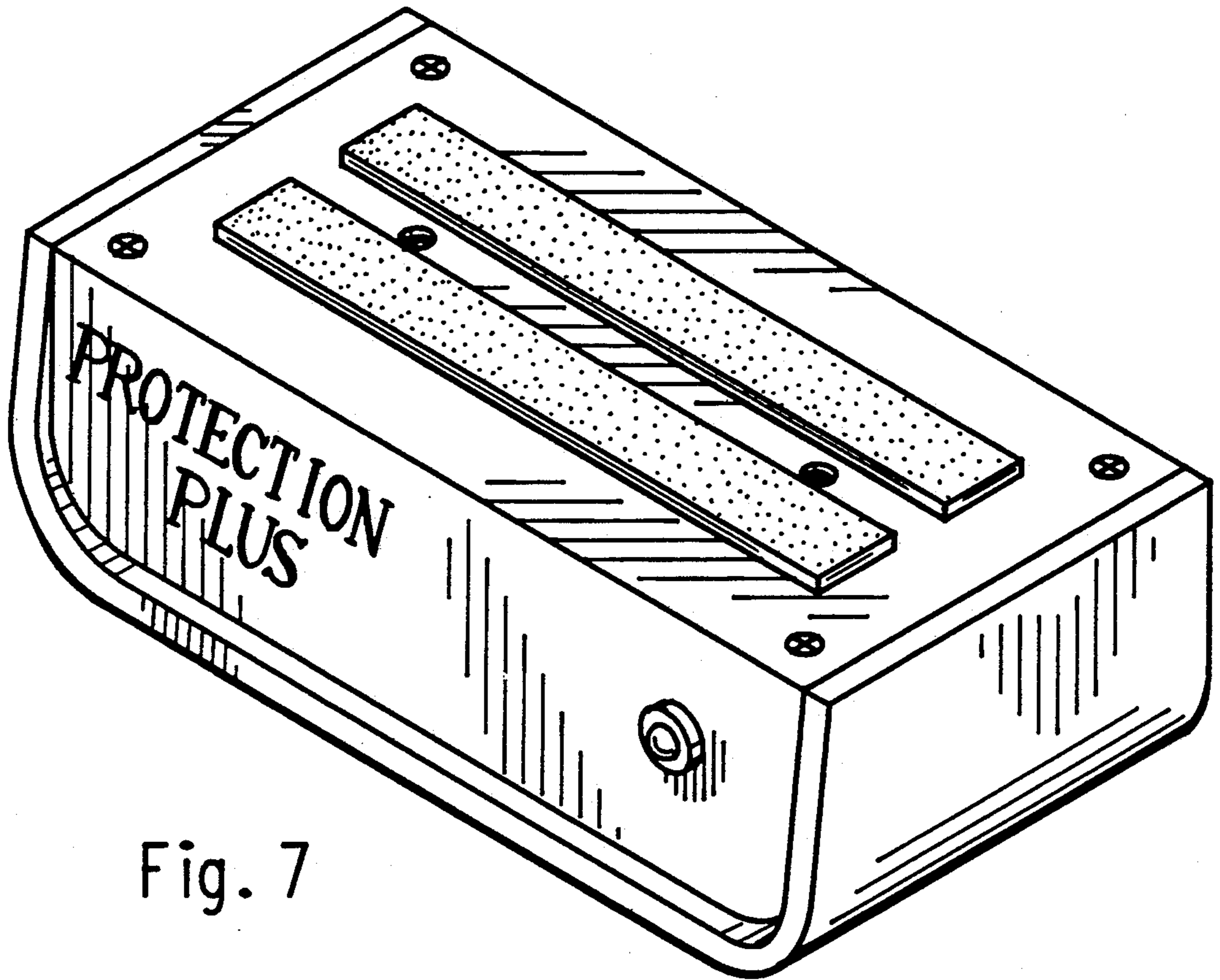

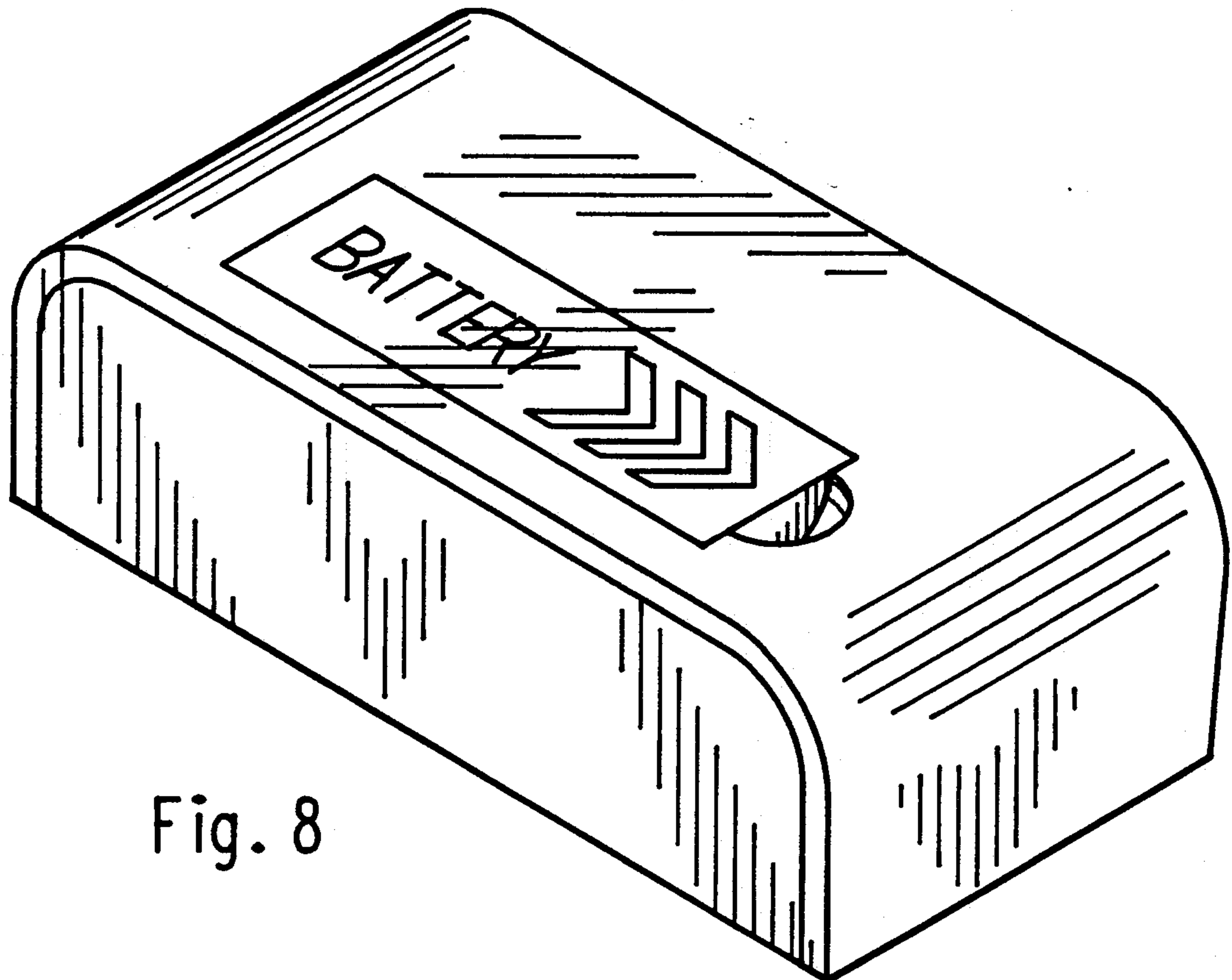
