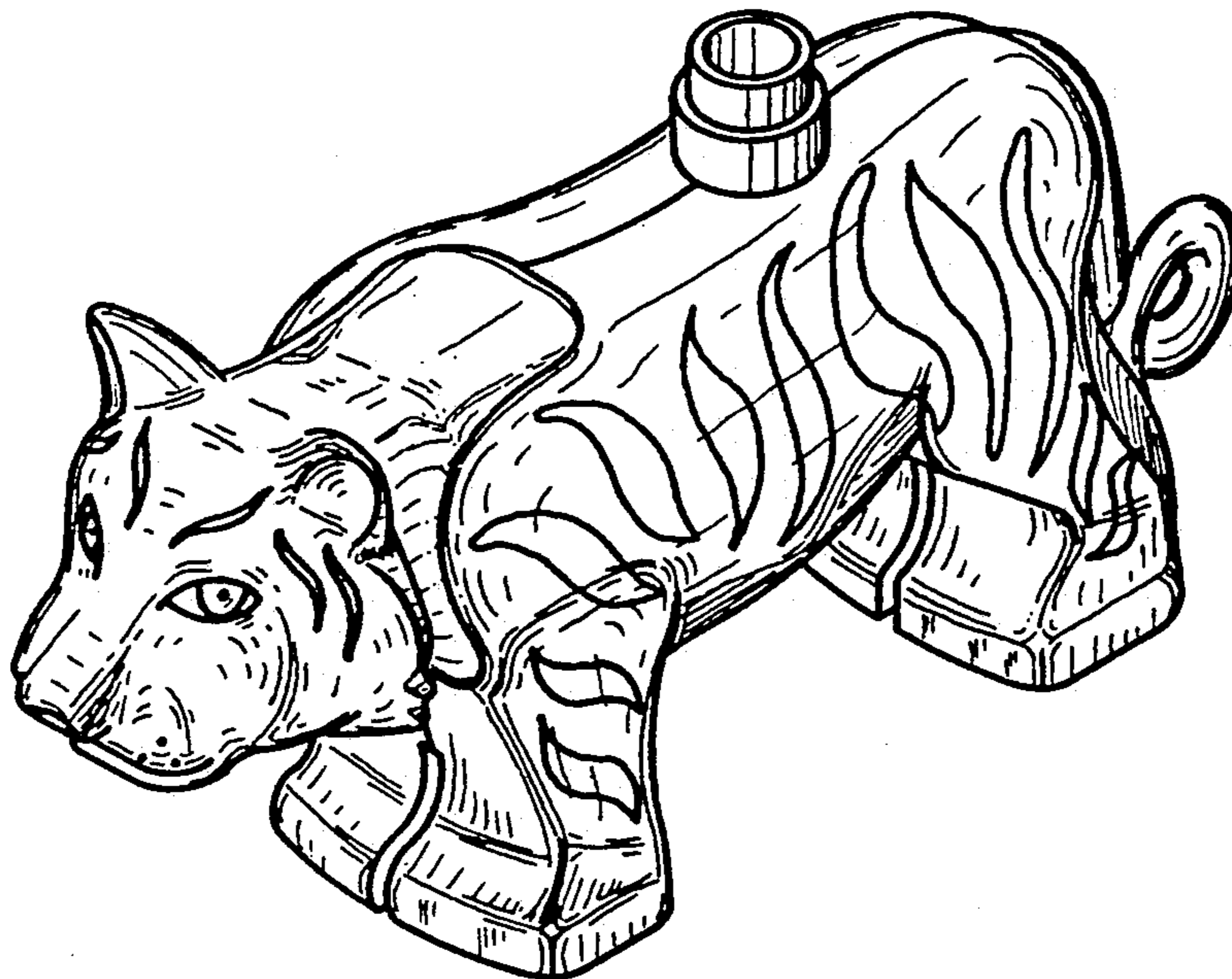

FIG. 9 is a top perspective view with the head turned downward.



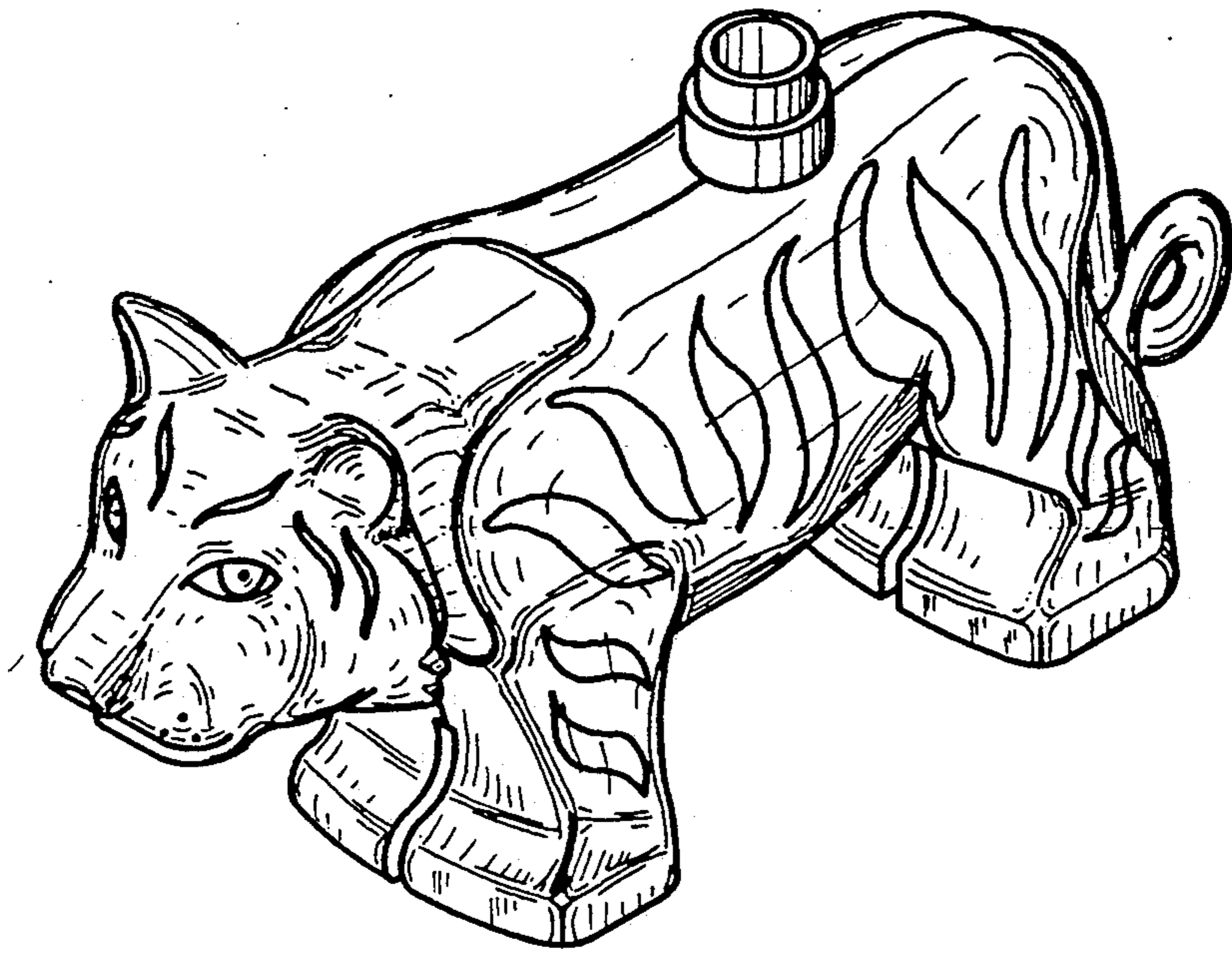

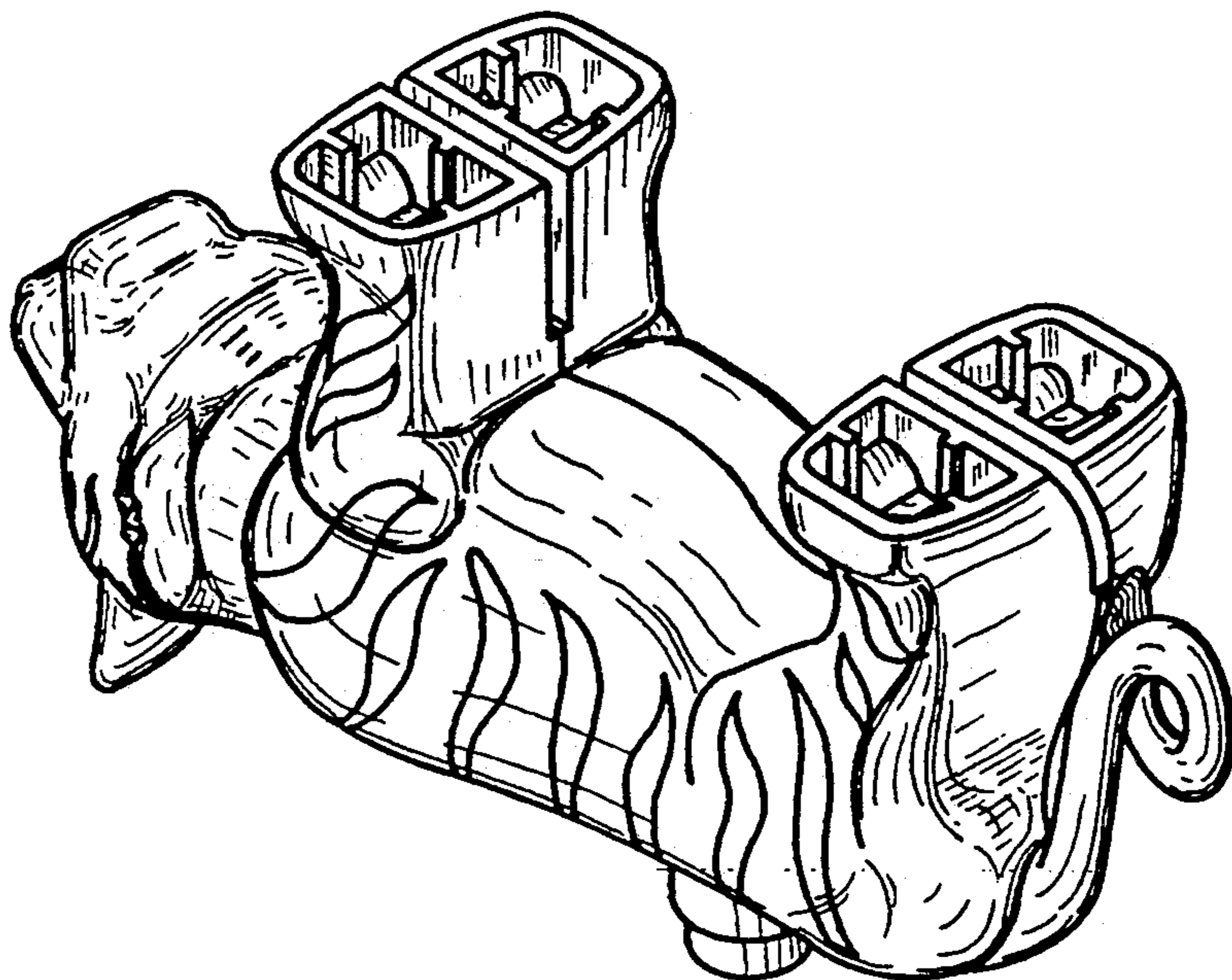

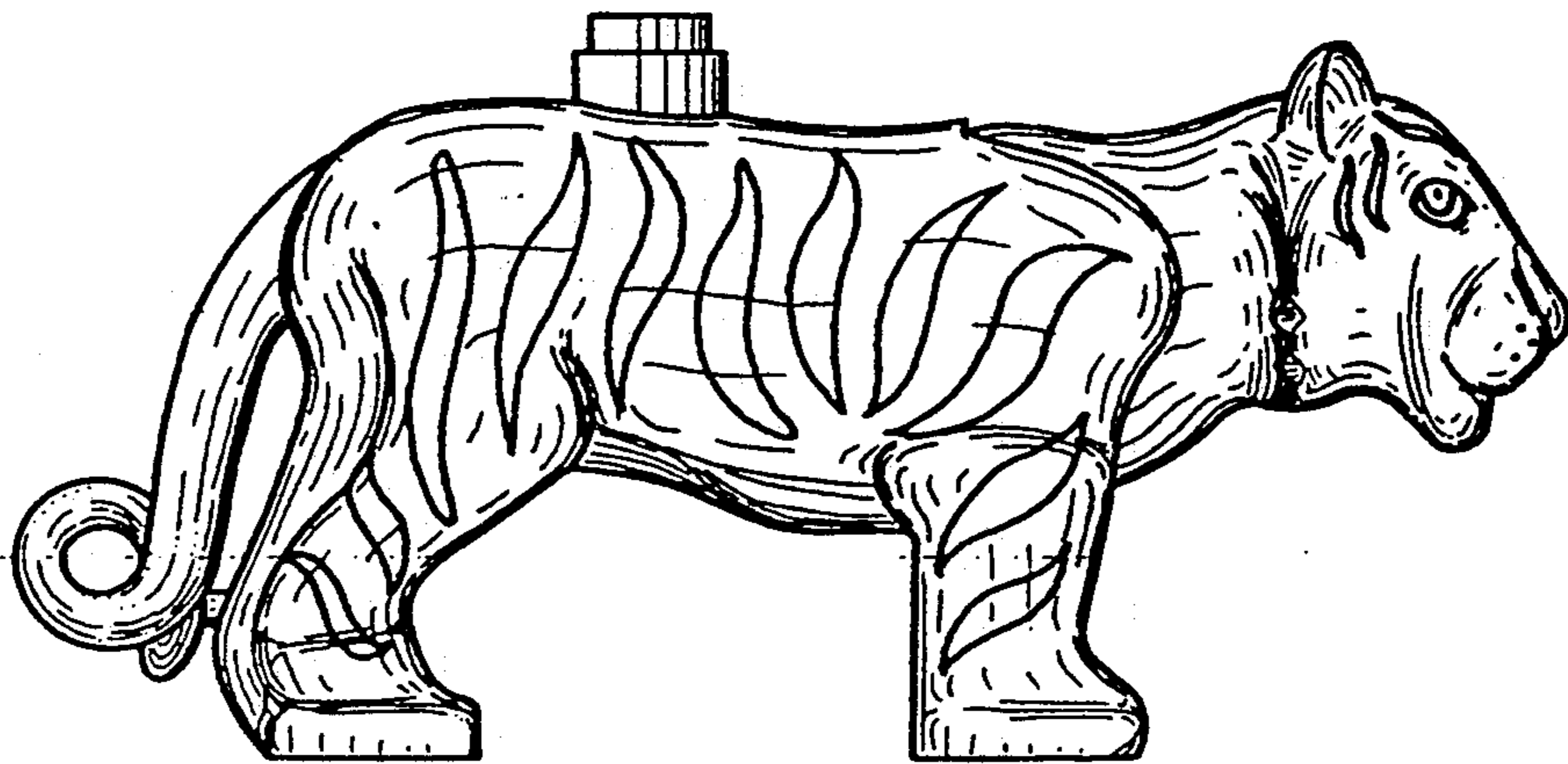

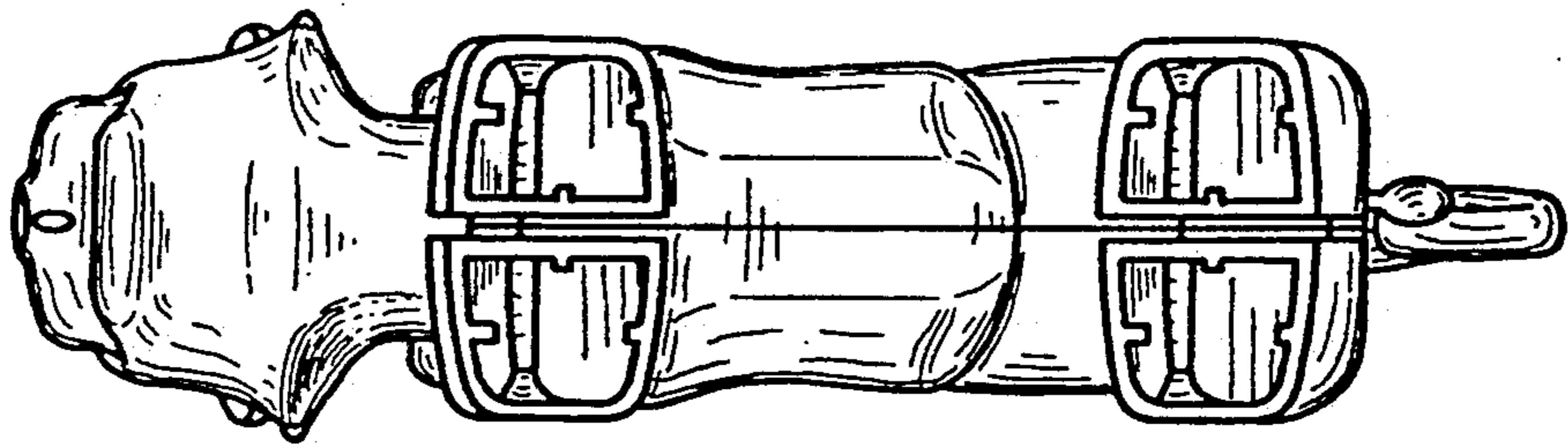

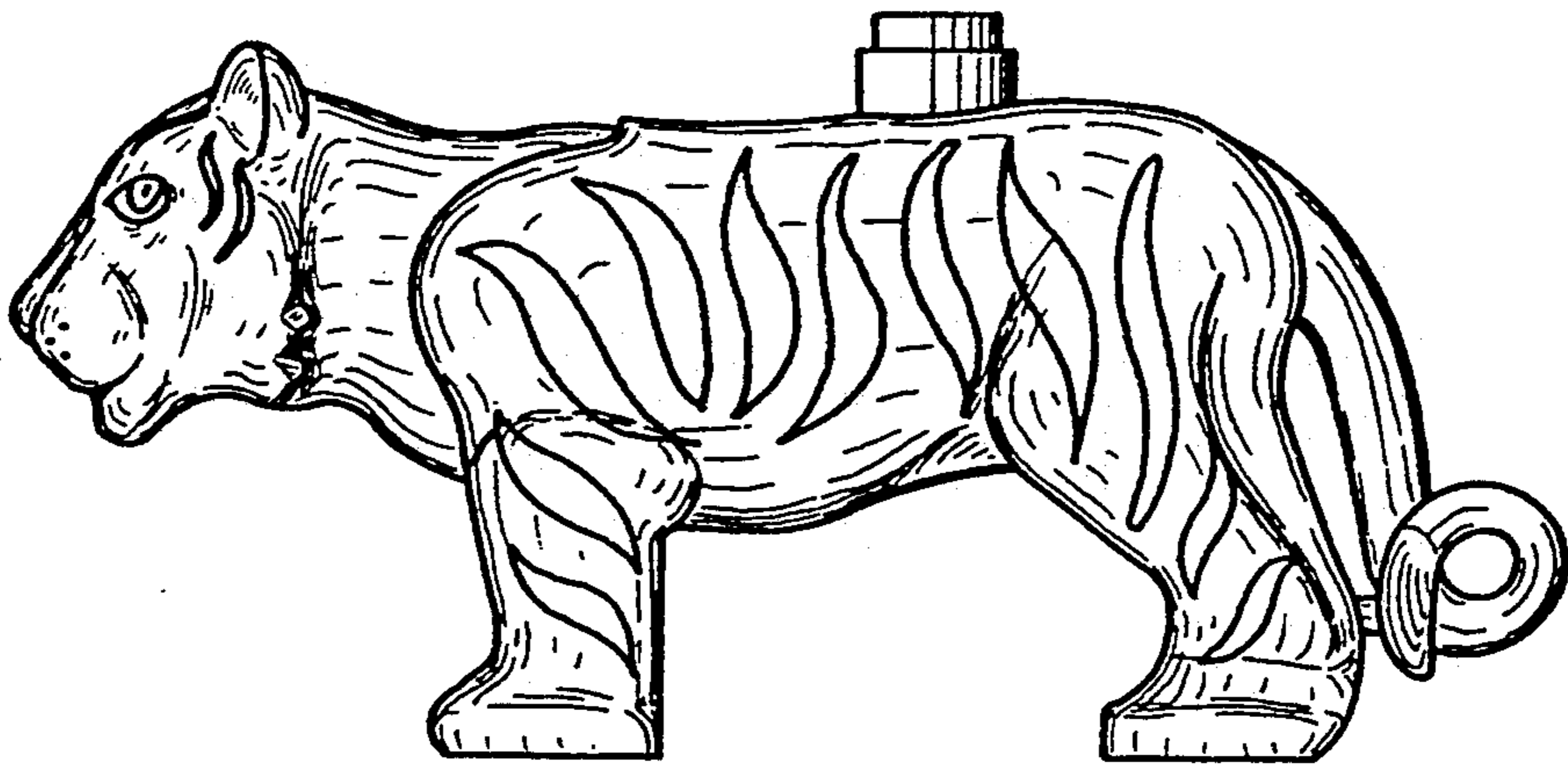

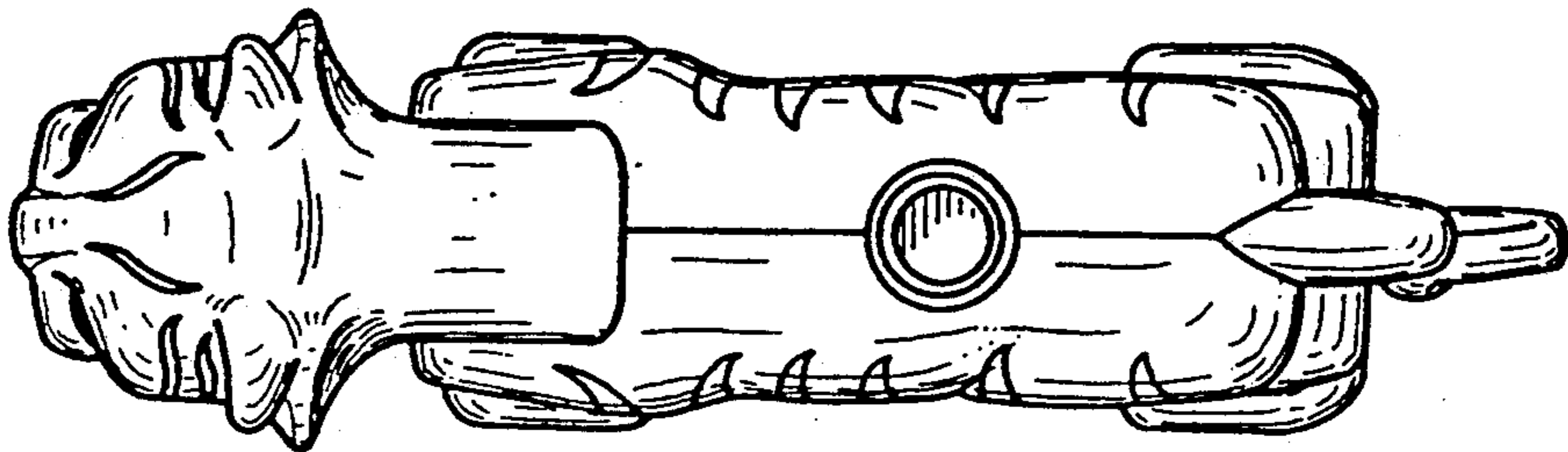

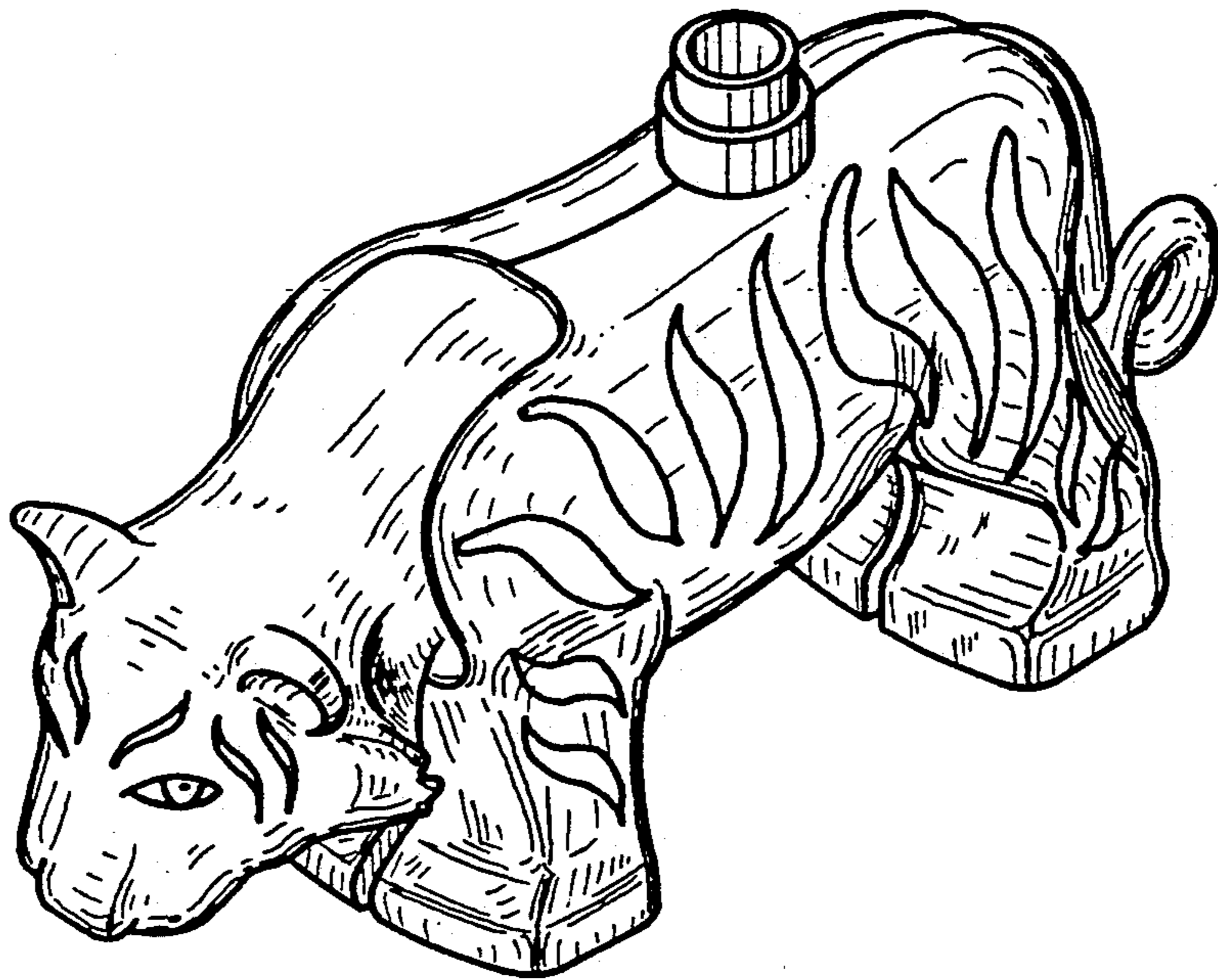
