[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a foldable chiropractic pillow, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a foldable chiropractic pillow, showing our new design; in unfolded condition;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side perspective view thereof, opposite that shown in FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top front perspective view thereof;


FIG. 9 is a side perspective thereof;

FIG. 10 is a side perspective in FIG. 9;


FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view thereof; and


FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof.















