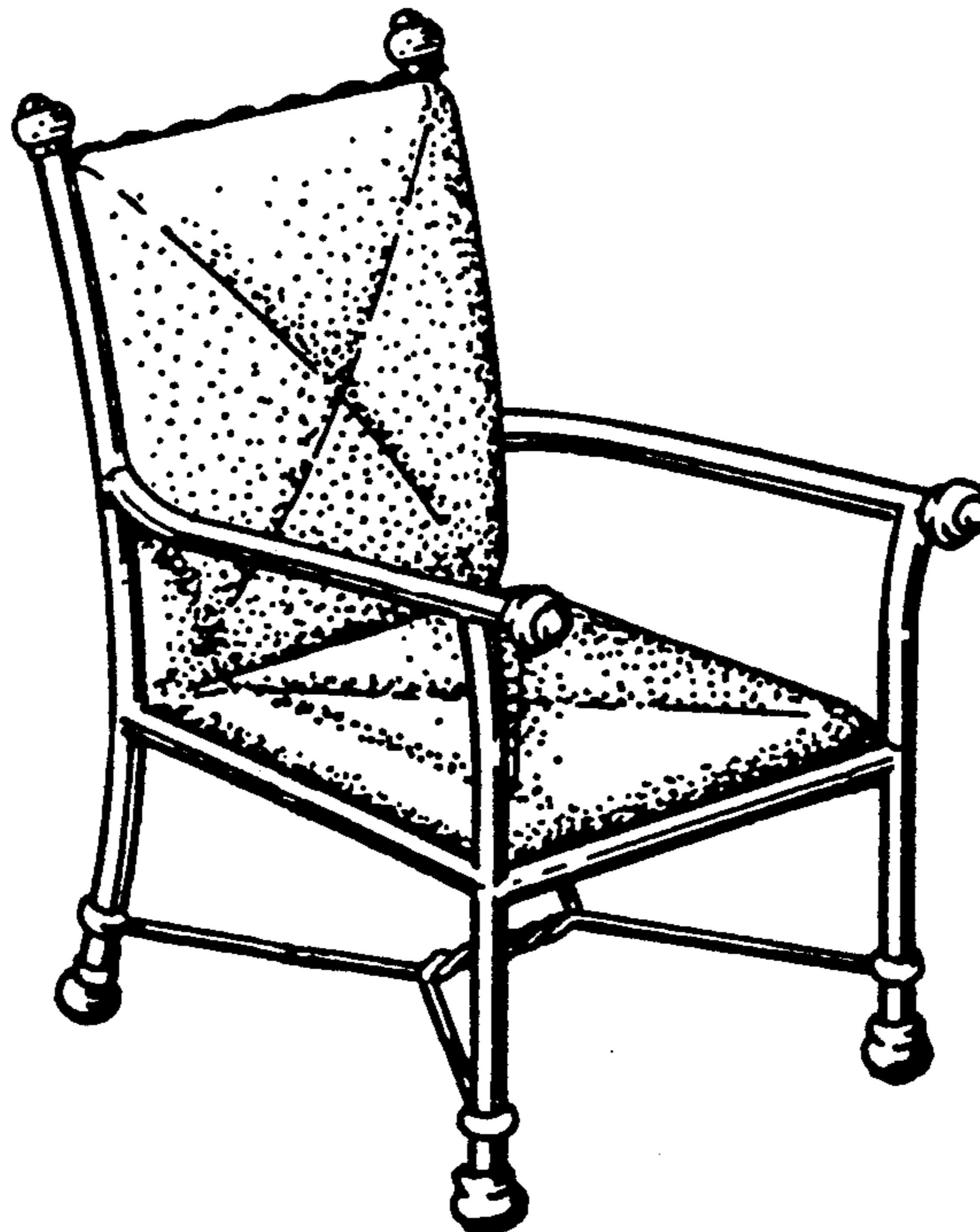

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing my new design, on a slightly reduced scale;

 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



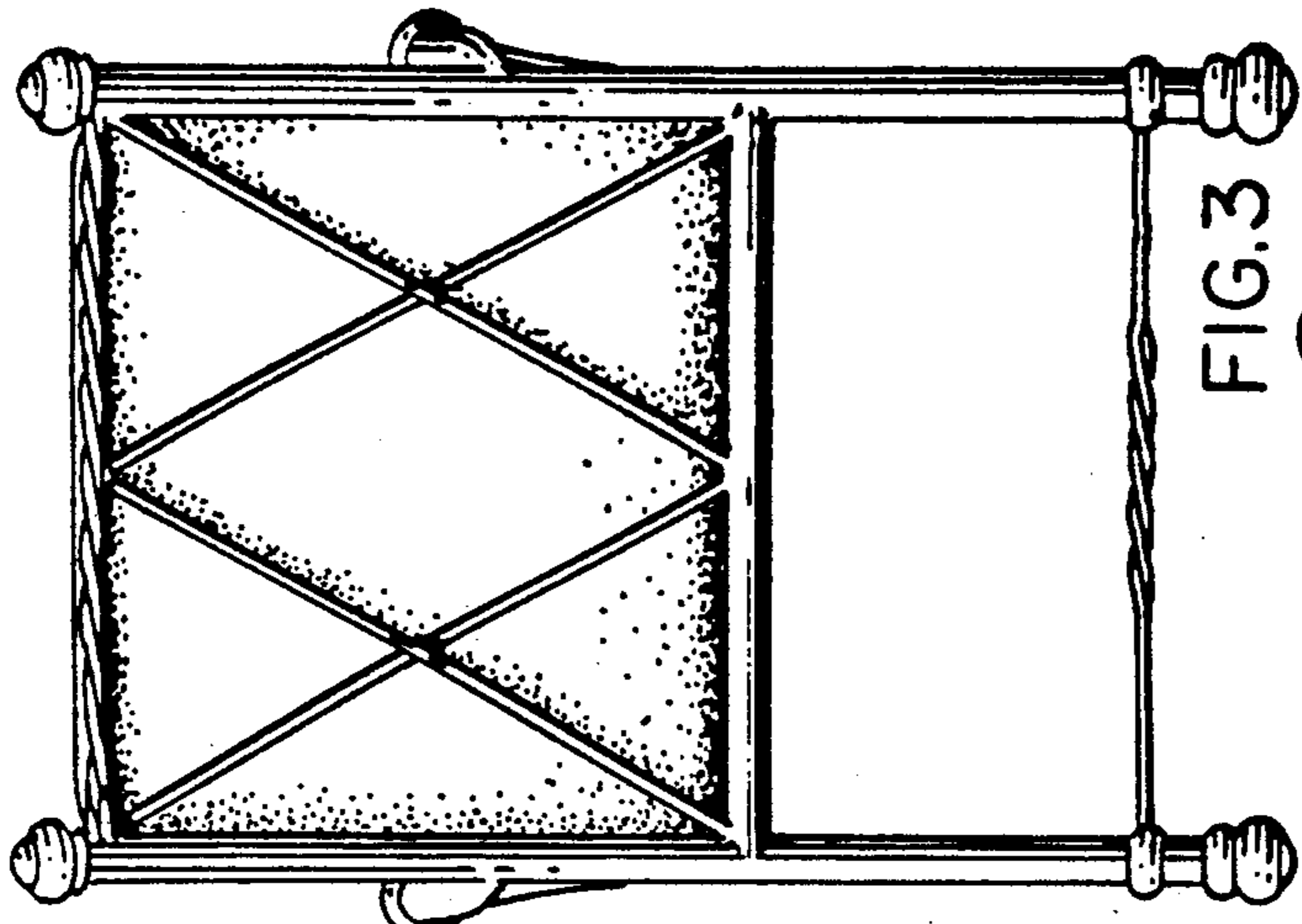

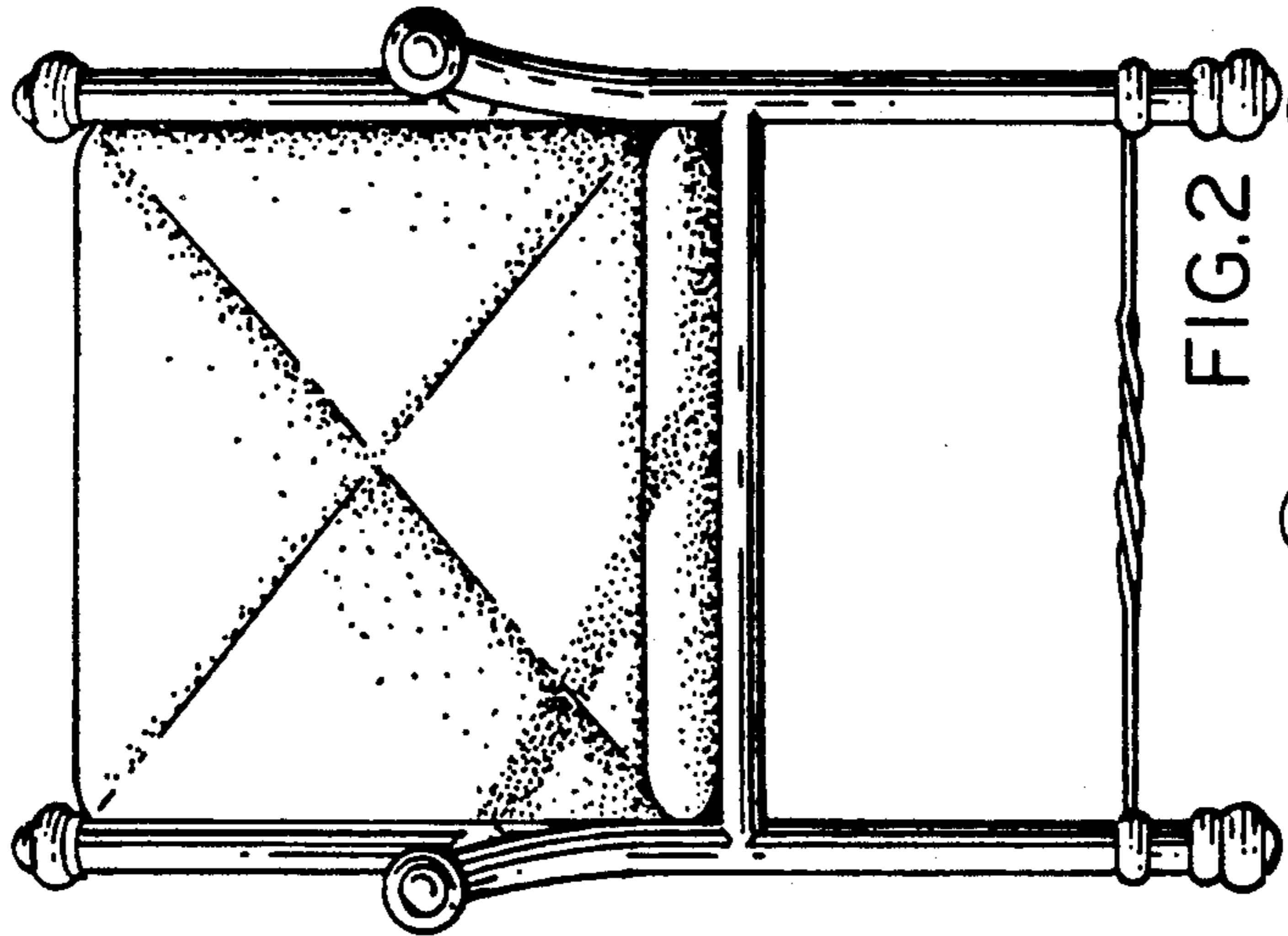

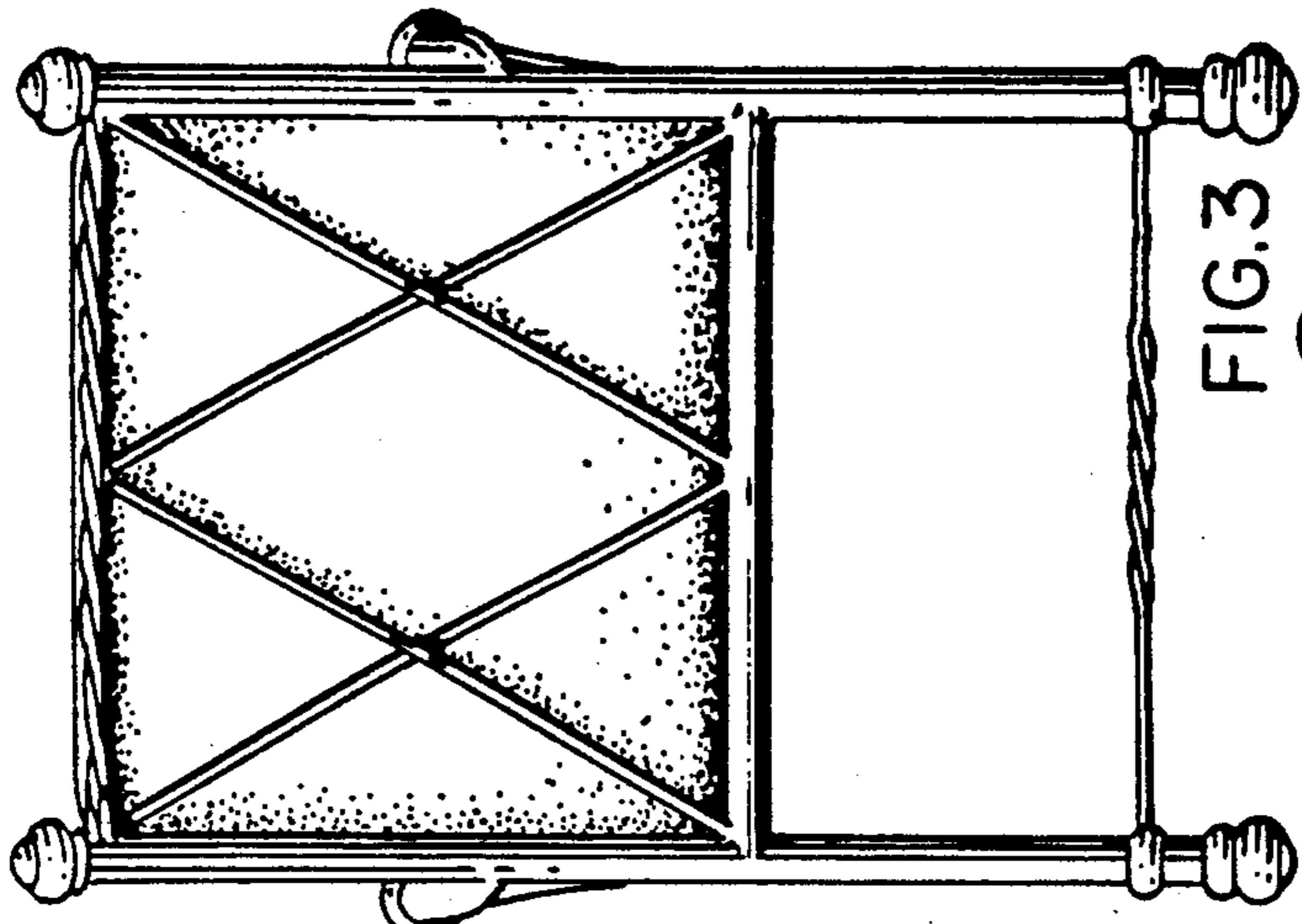

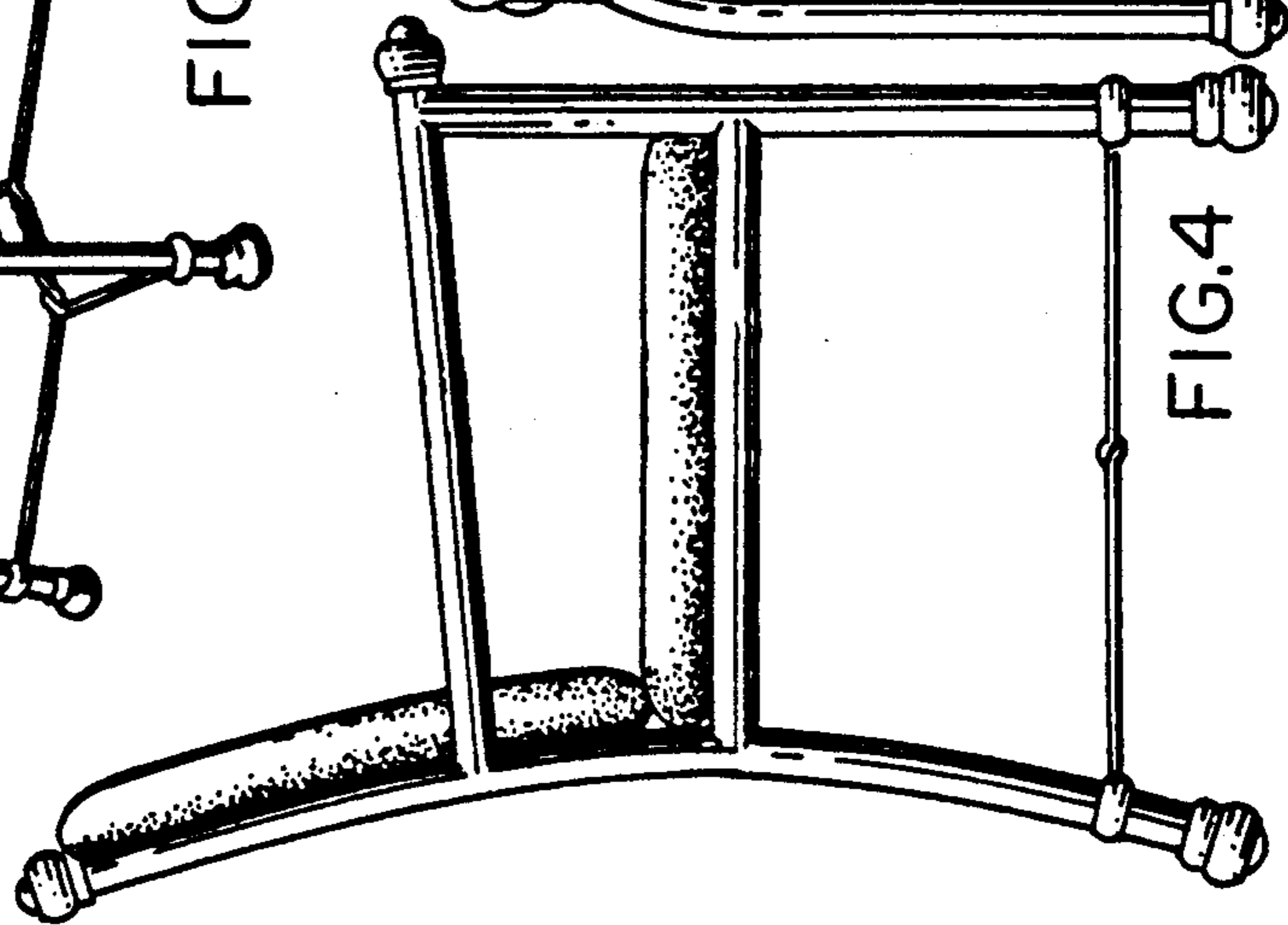

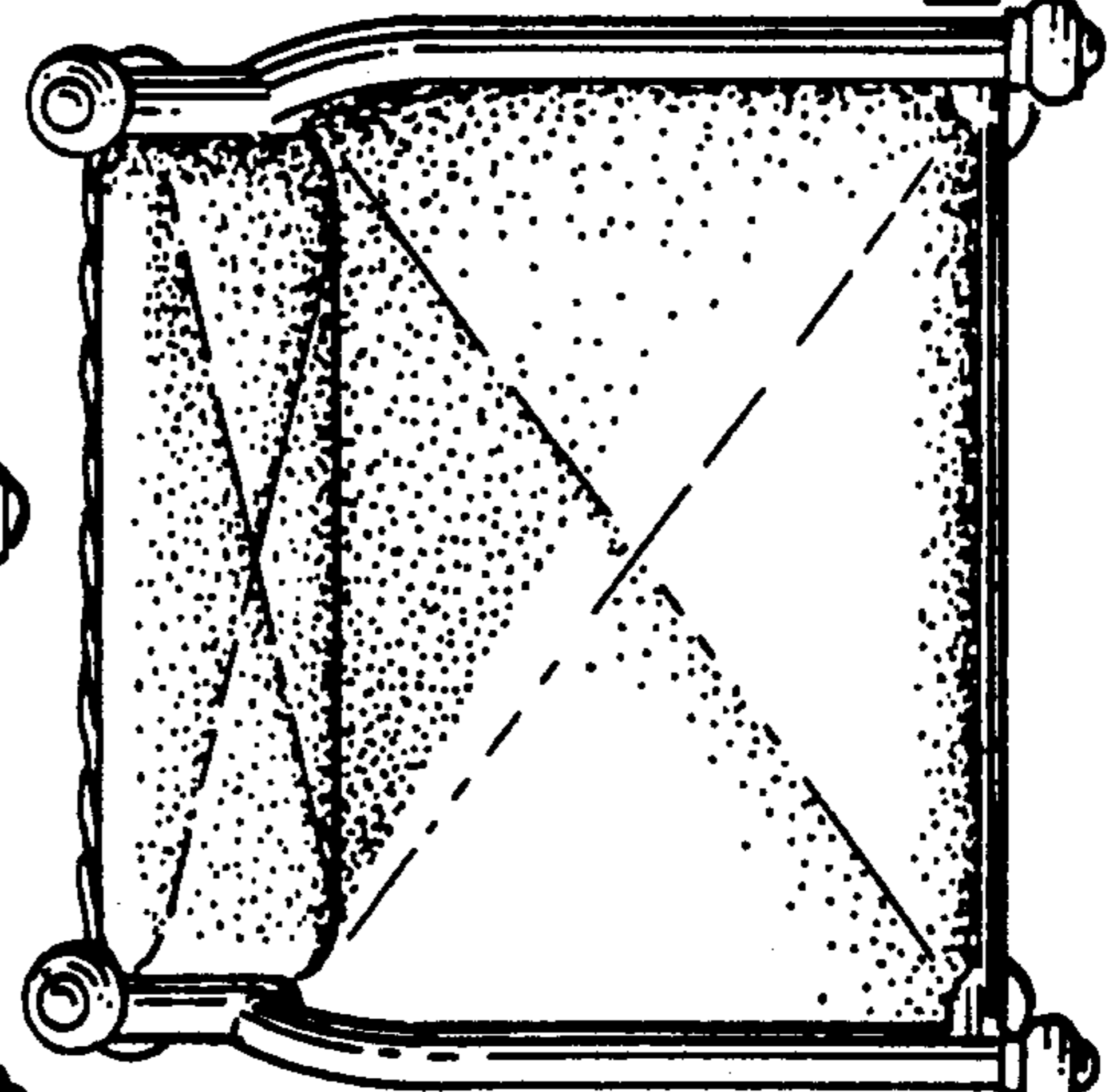

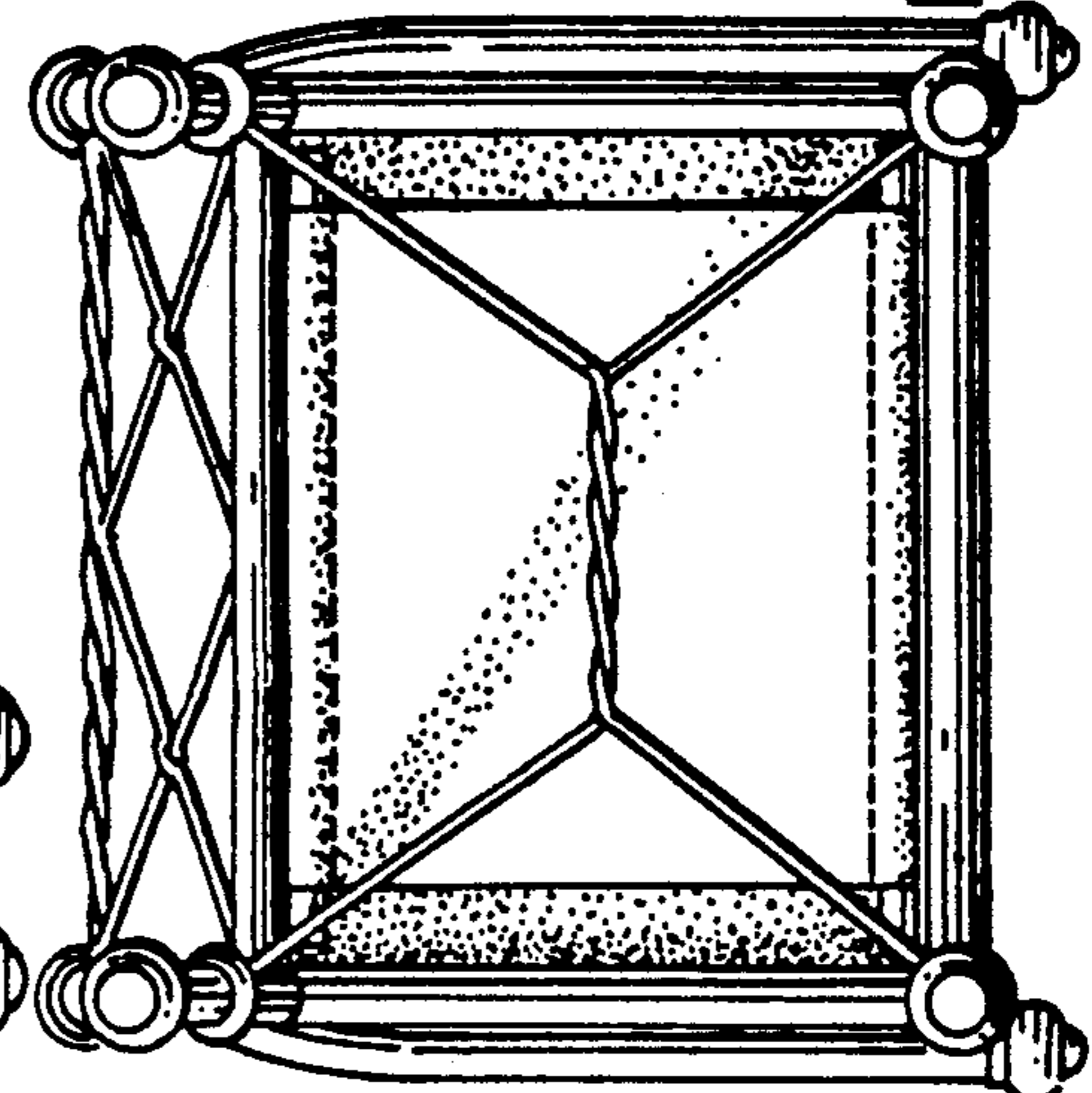
