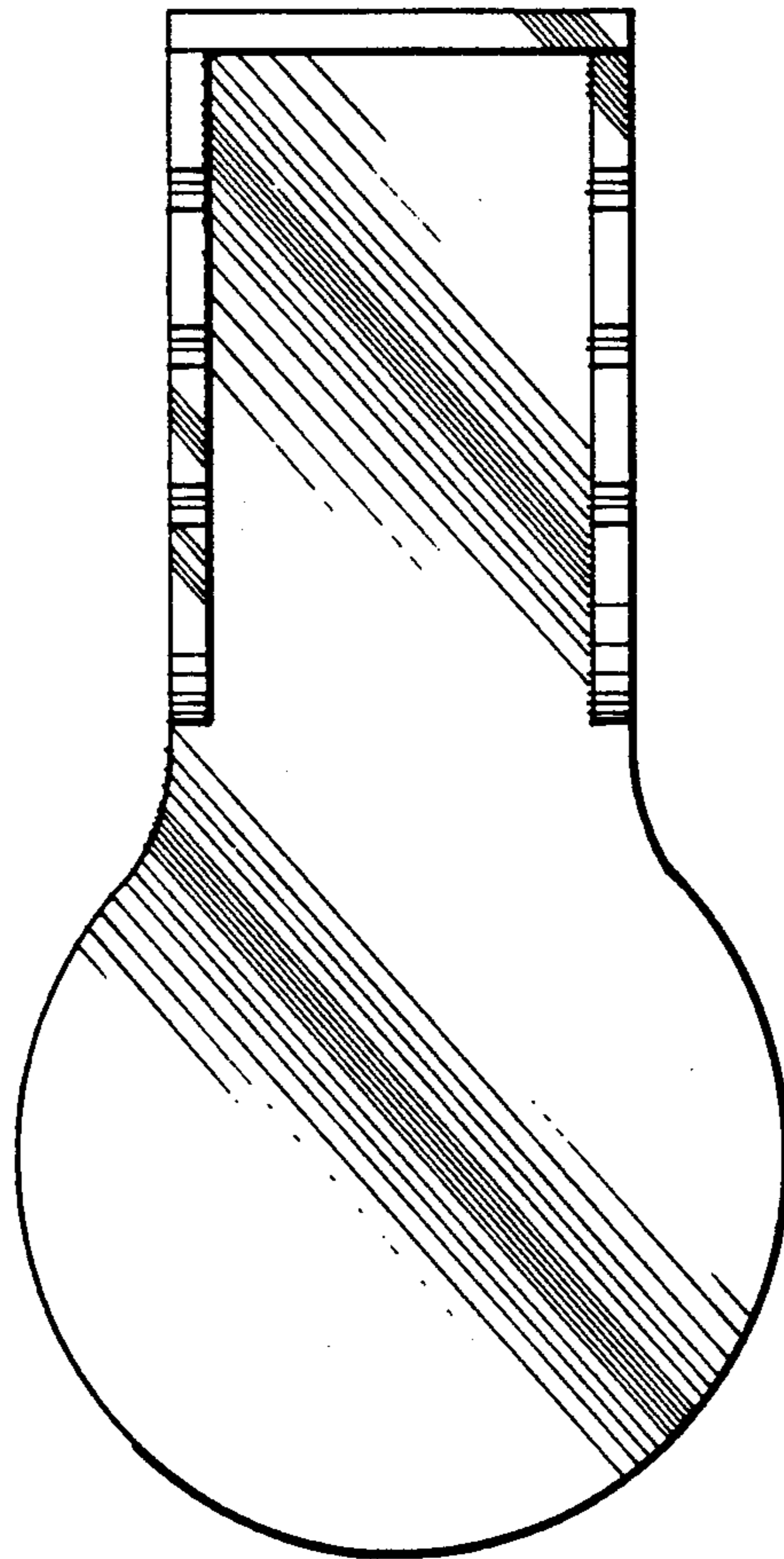
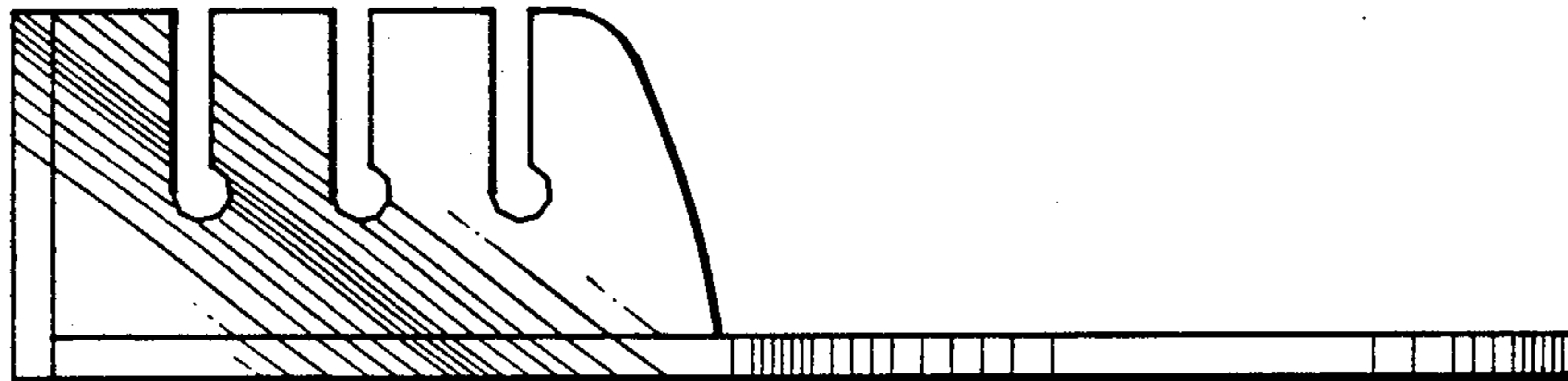

The ornamental design for a display stand for dinnerware, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a display stand for dinnerware showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



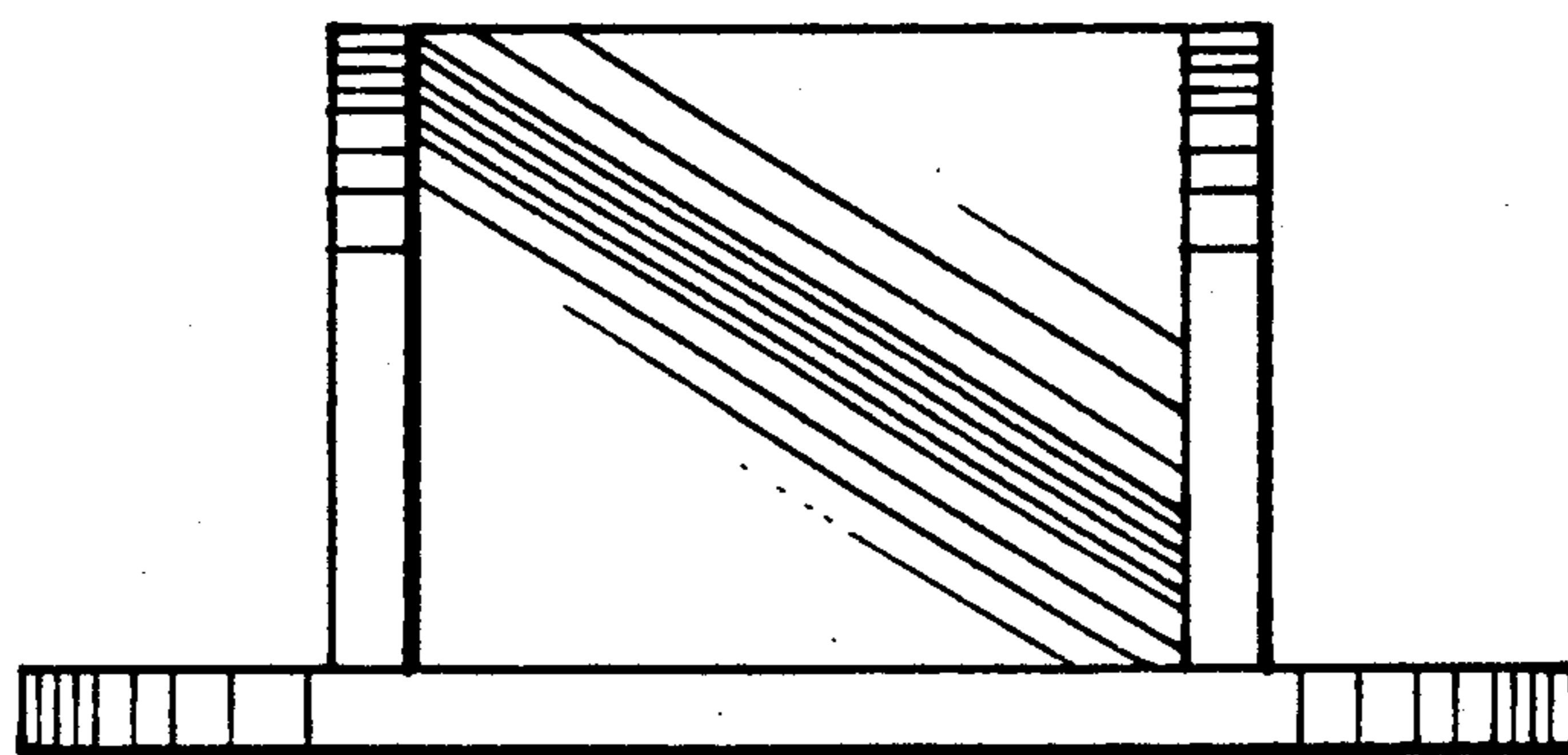

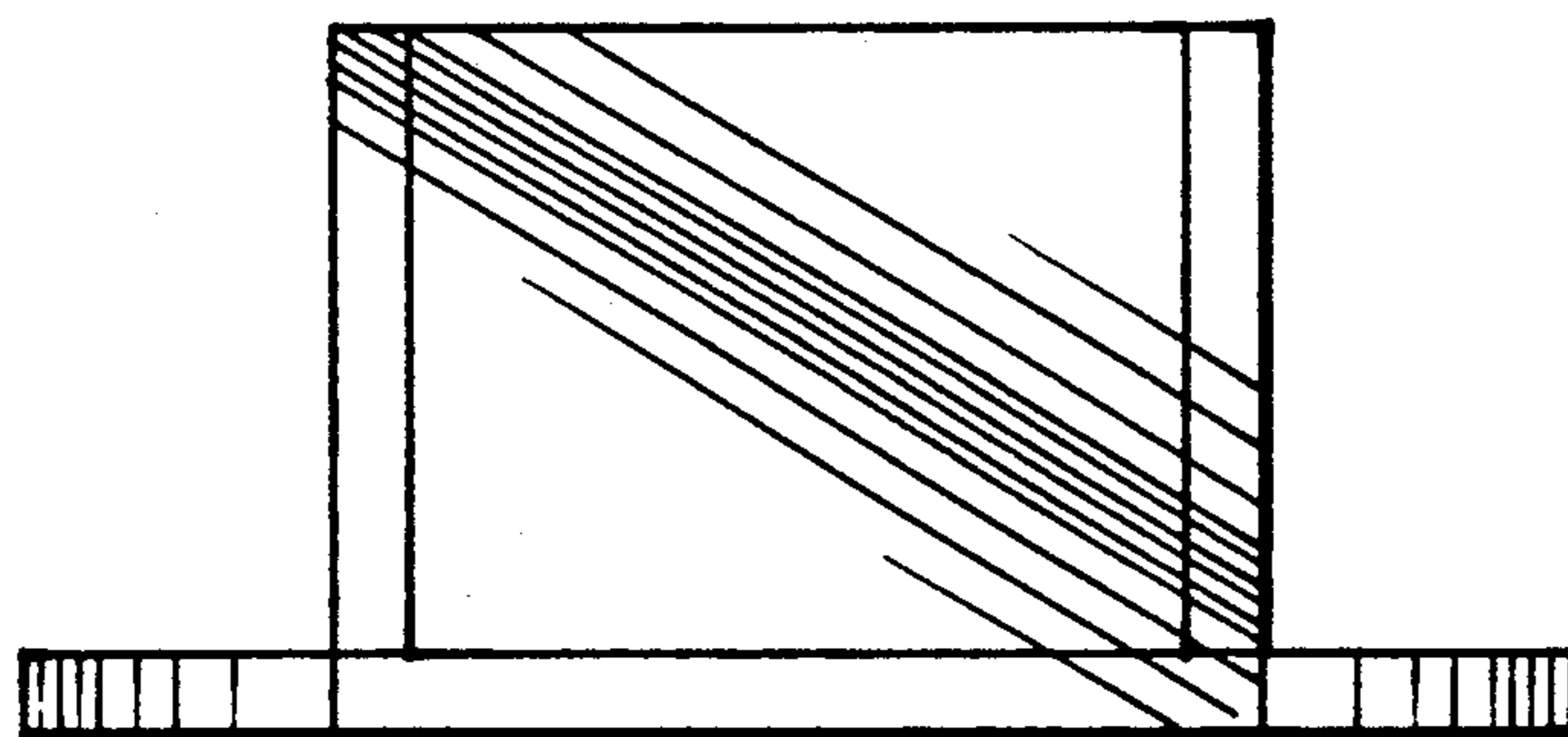

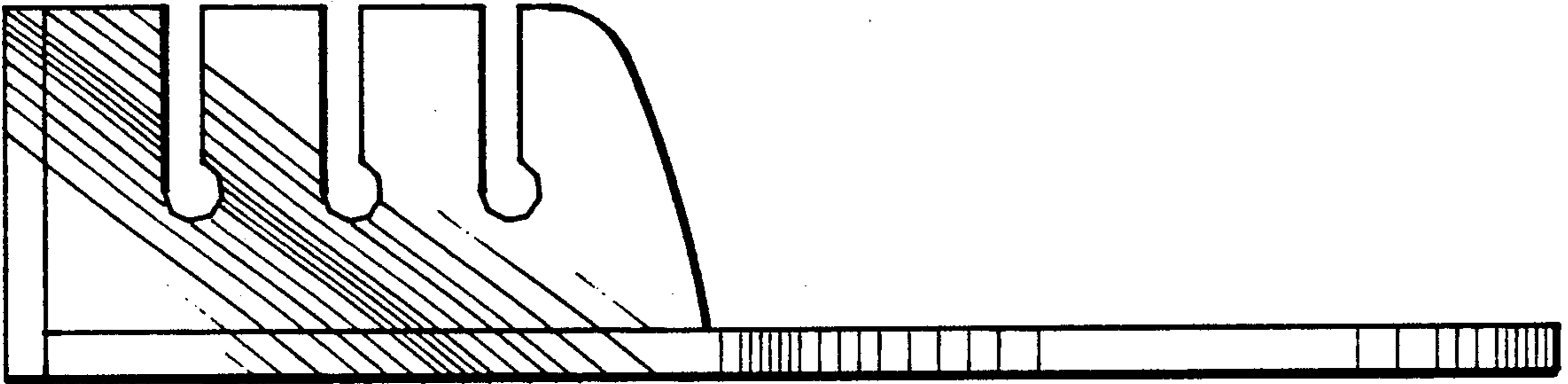

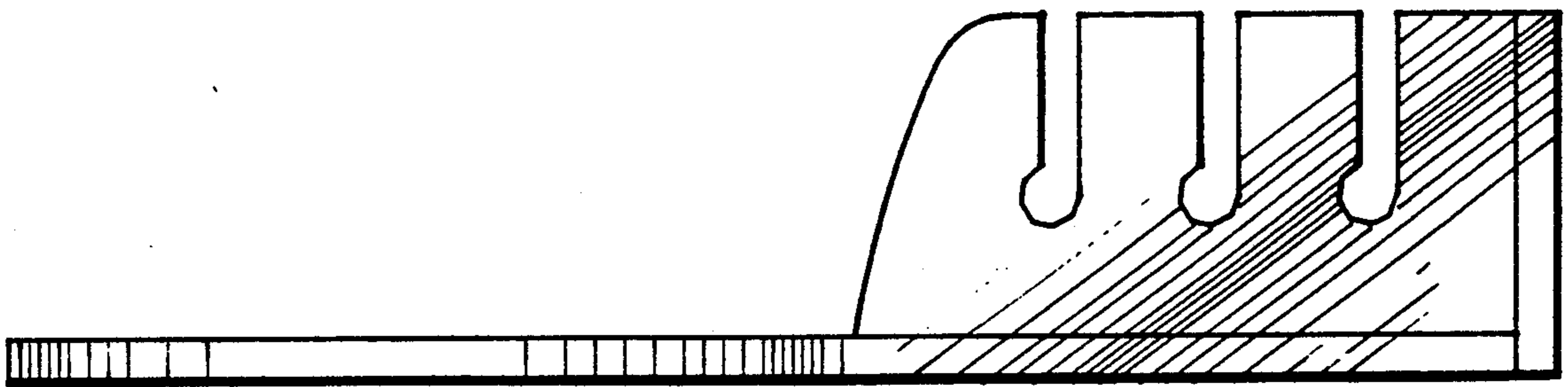

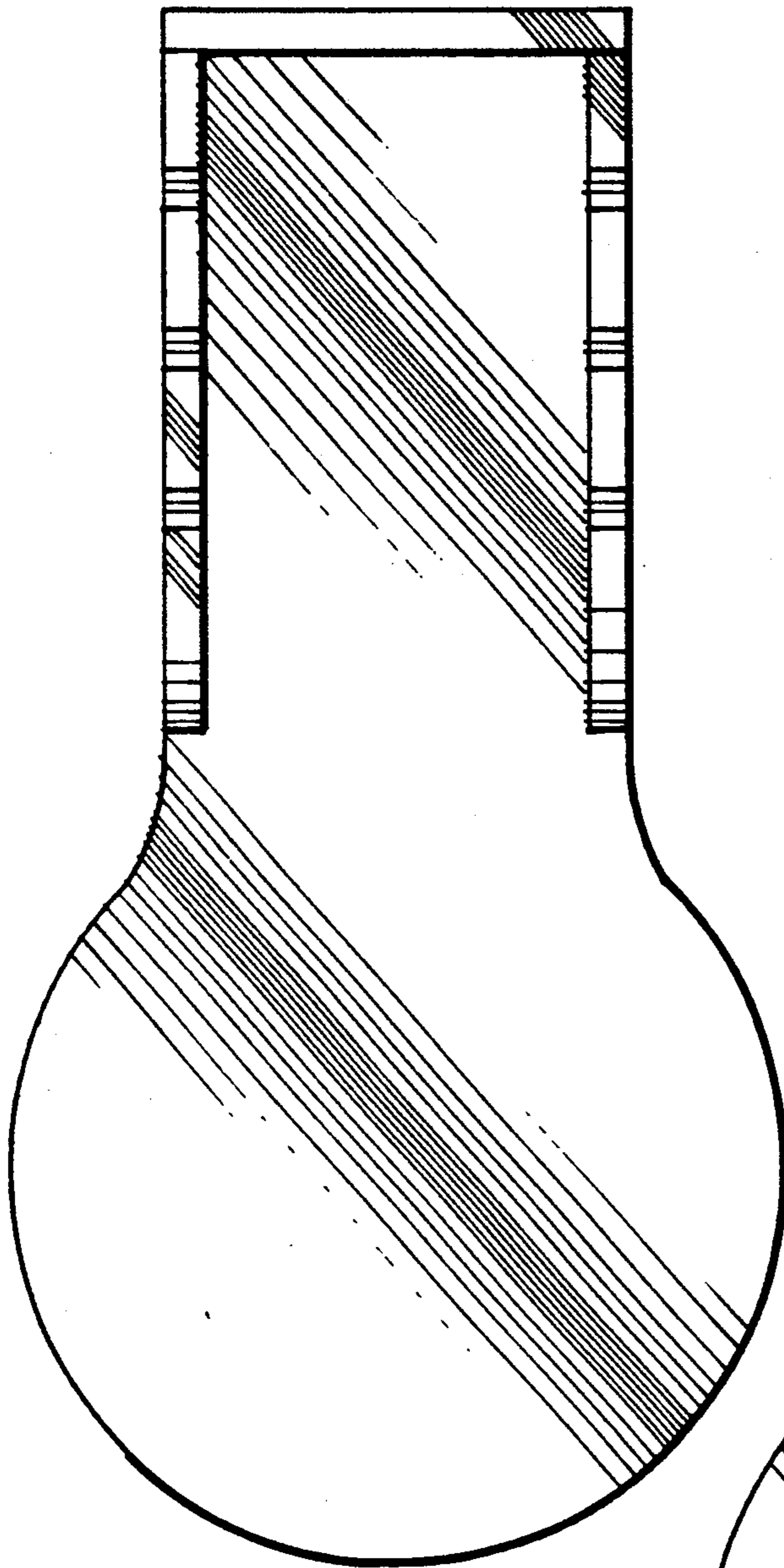

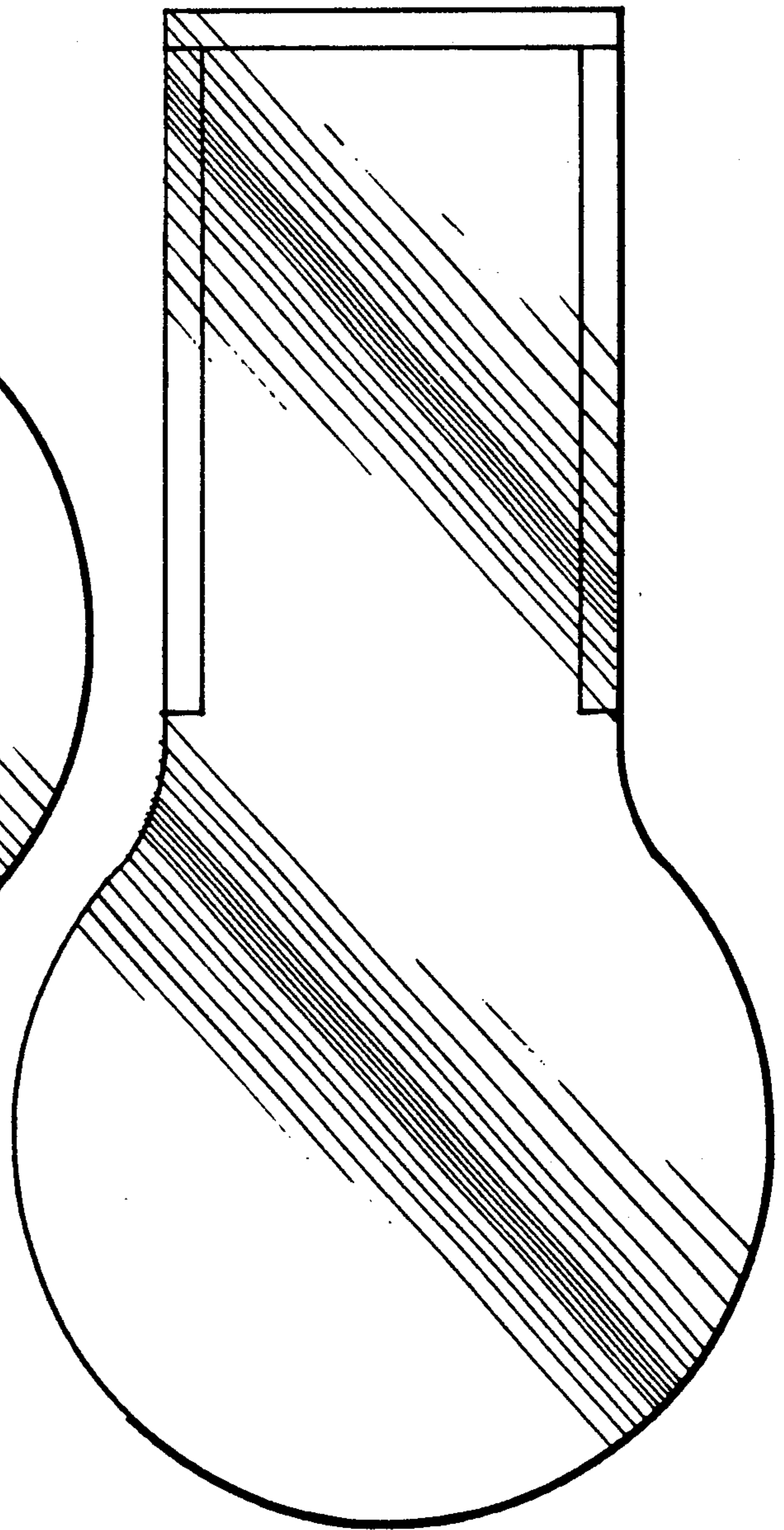
