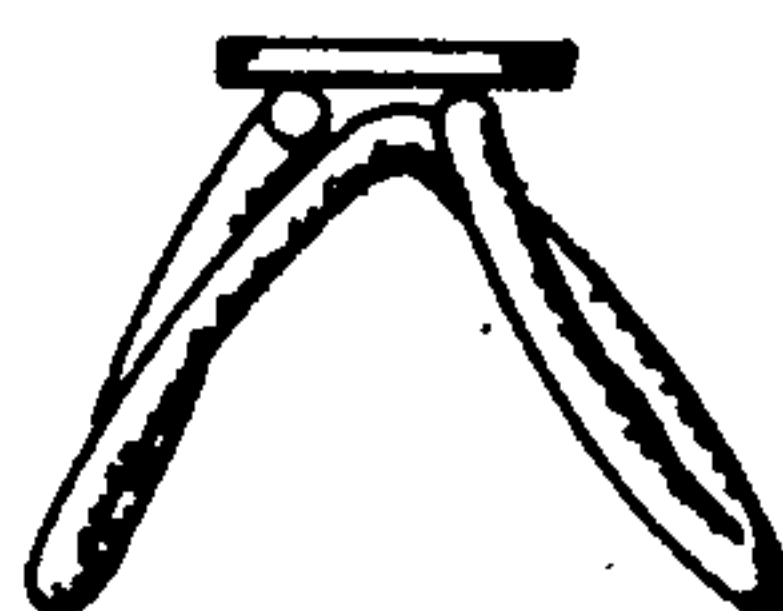
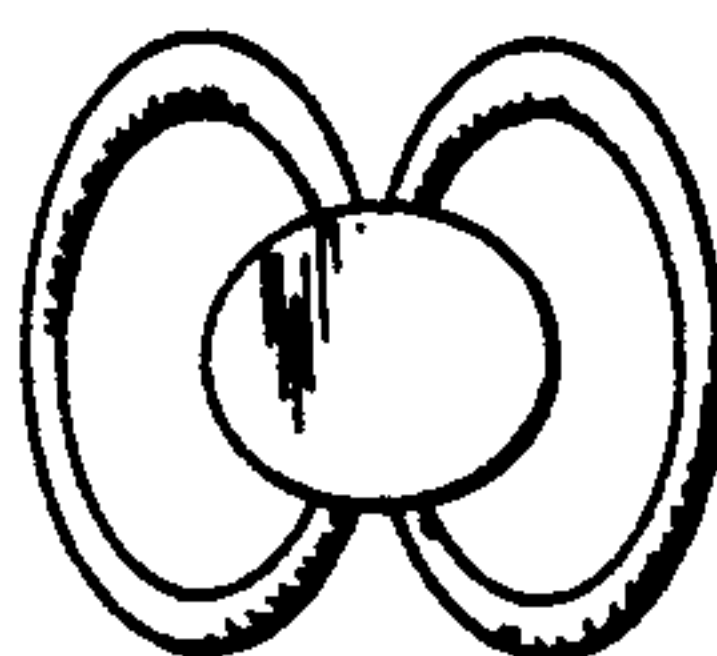
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a bow clasp showing my new design holding a bow;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view, the opposite side being identical;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a bow clasp showing a modified form of my new design;
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 11 is a top plan view, the opposite side being identical.
The broken line showing of a bow in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



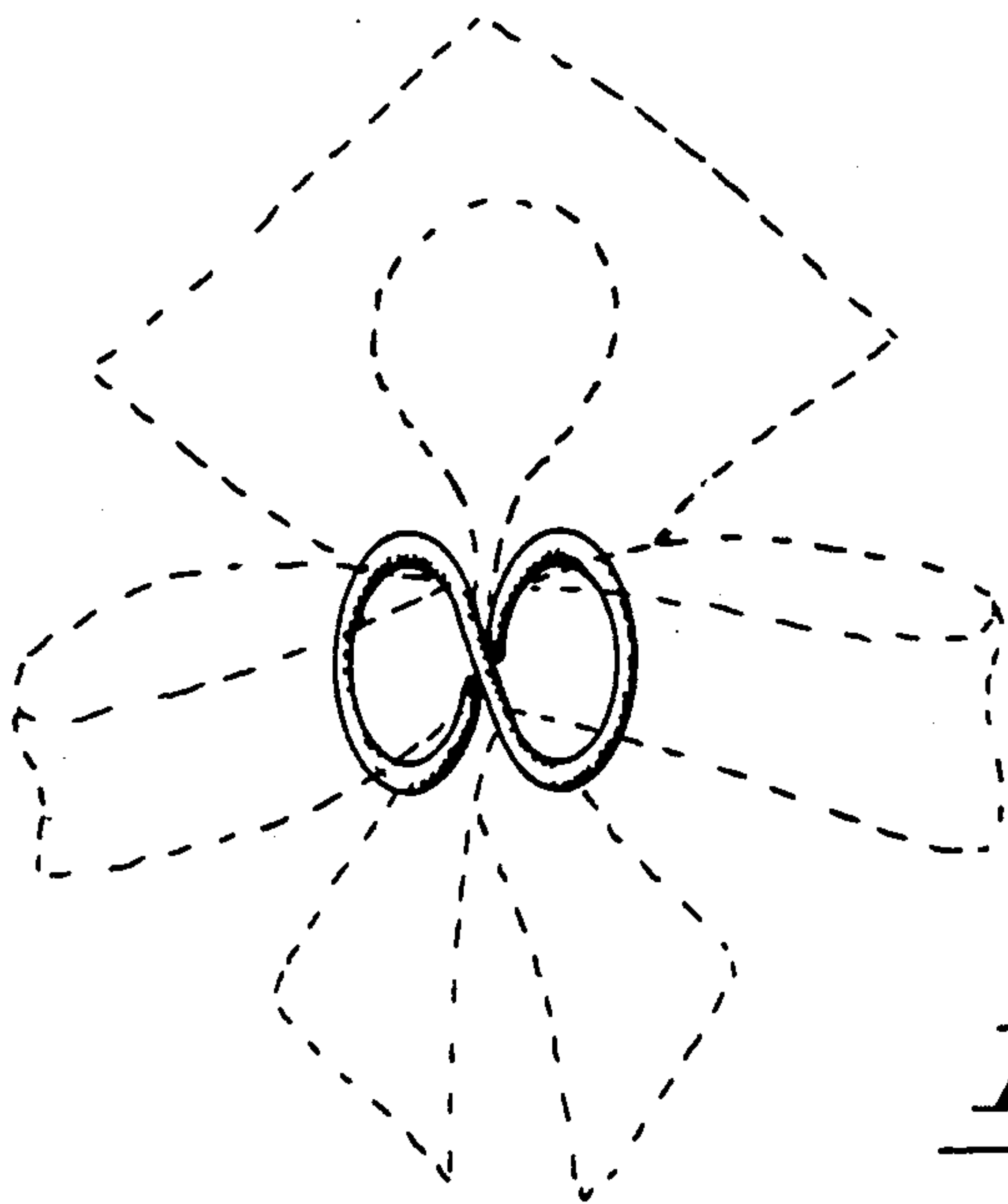

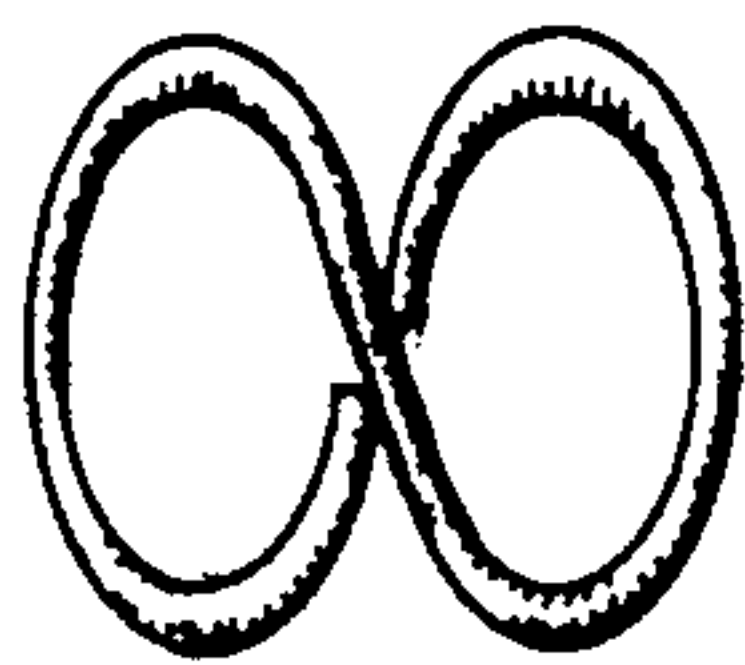

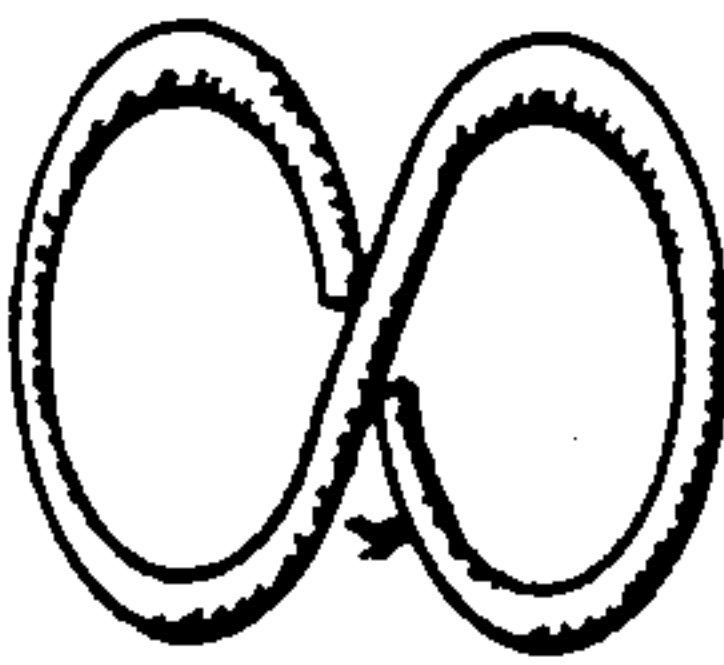

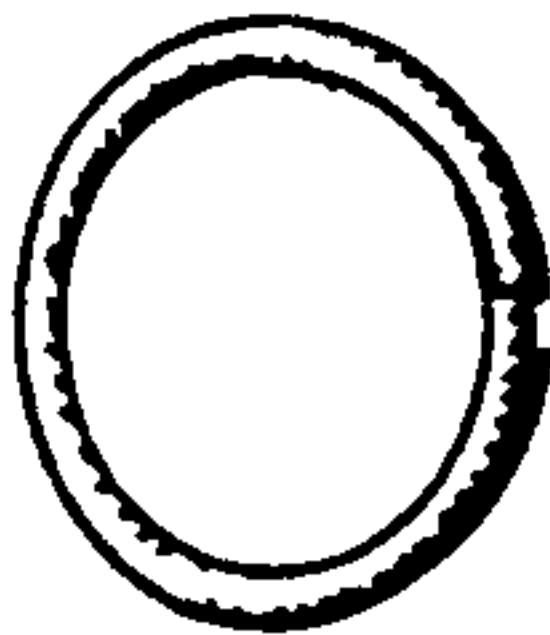

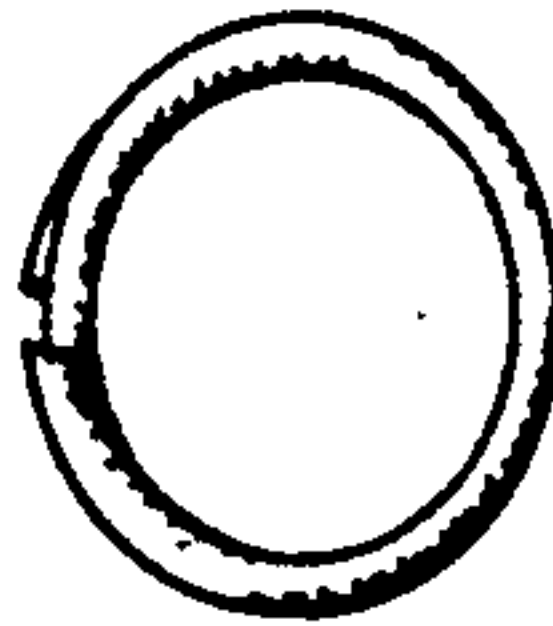
