The ornamental design for a light bulb attachment for supporting scented fragrant oil or the like, as shown and described.

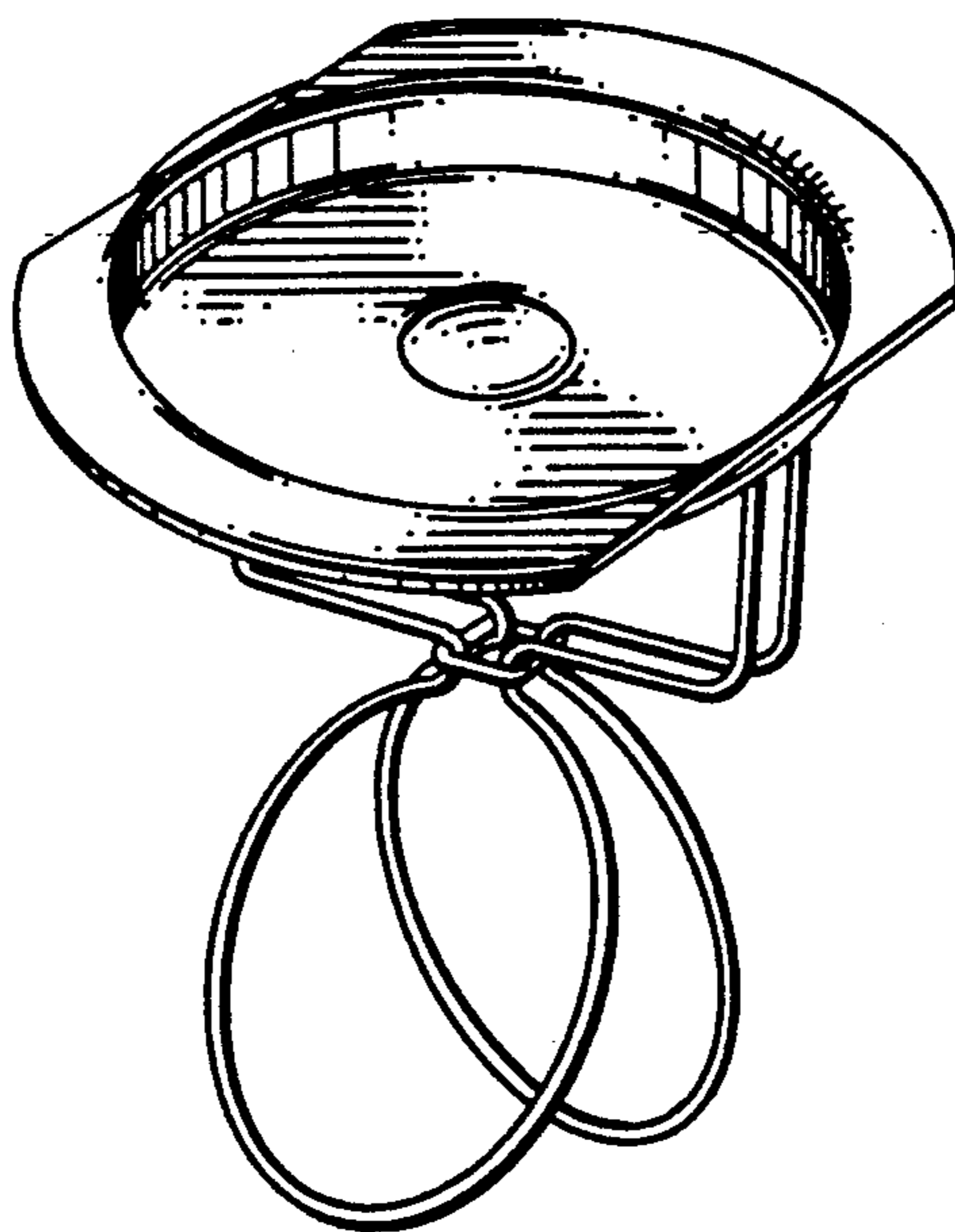
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of a light bulb attachment for supporting scented fragrant oil or the like showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, with the rear being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, with the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

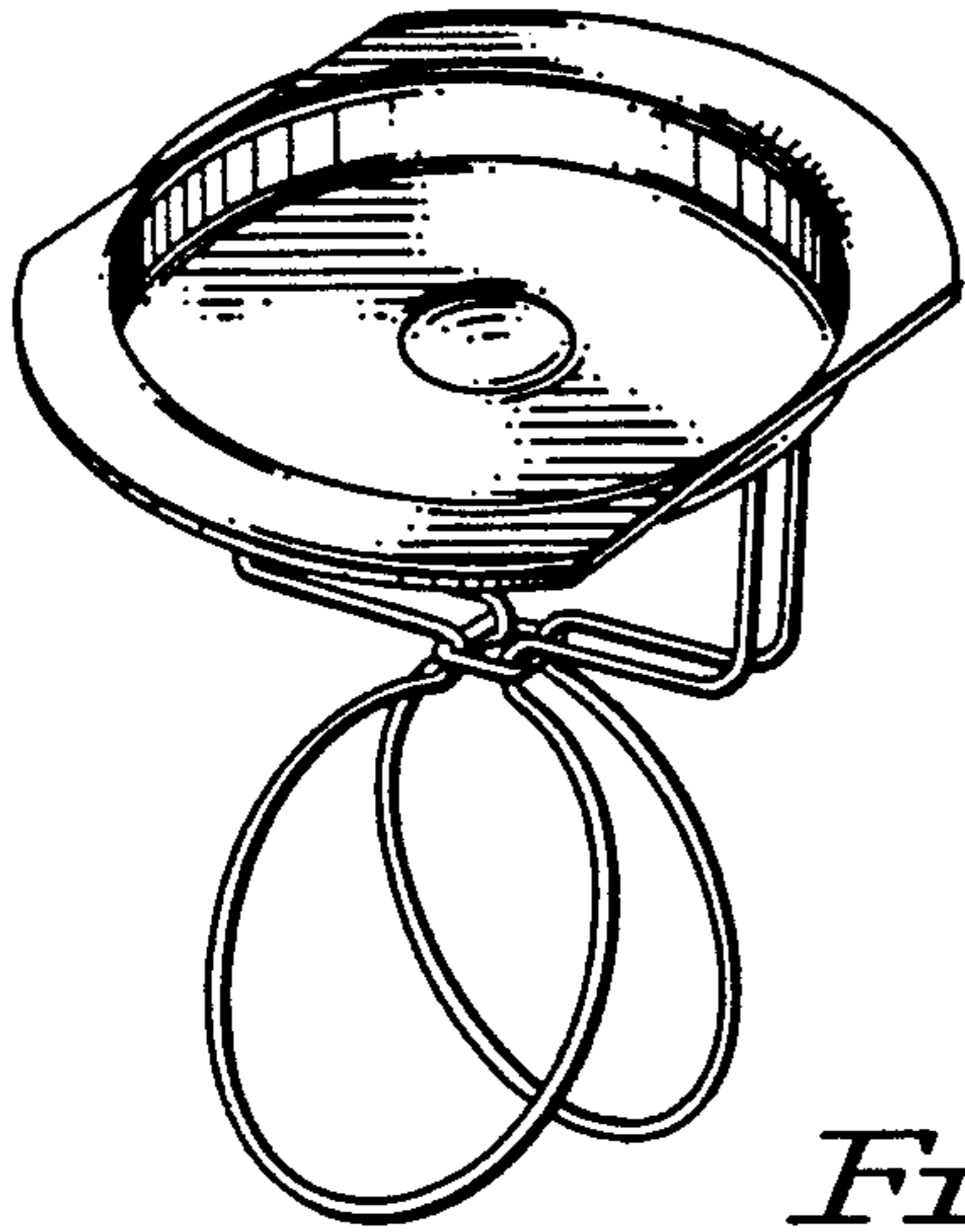

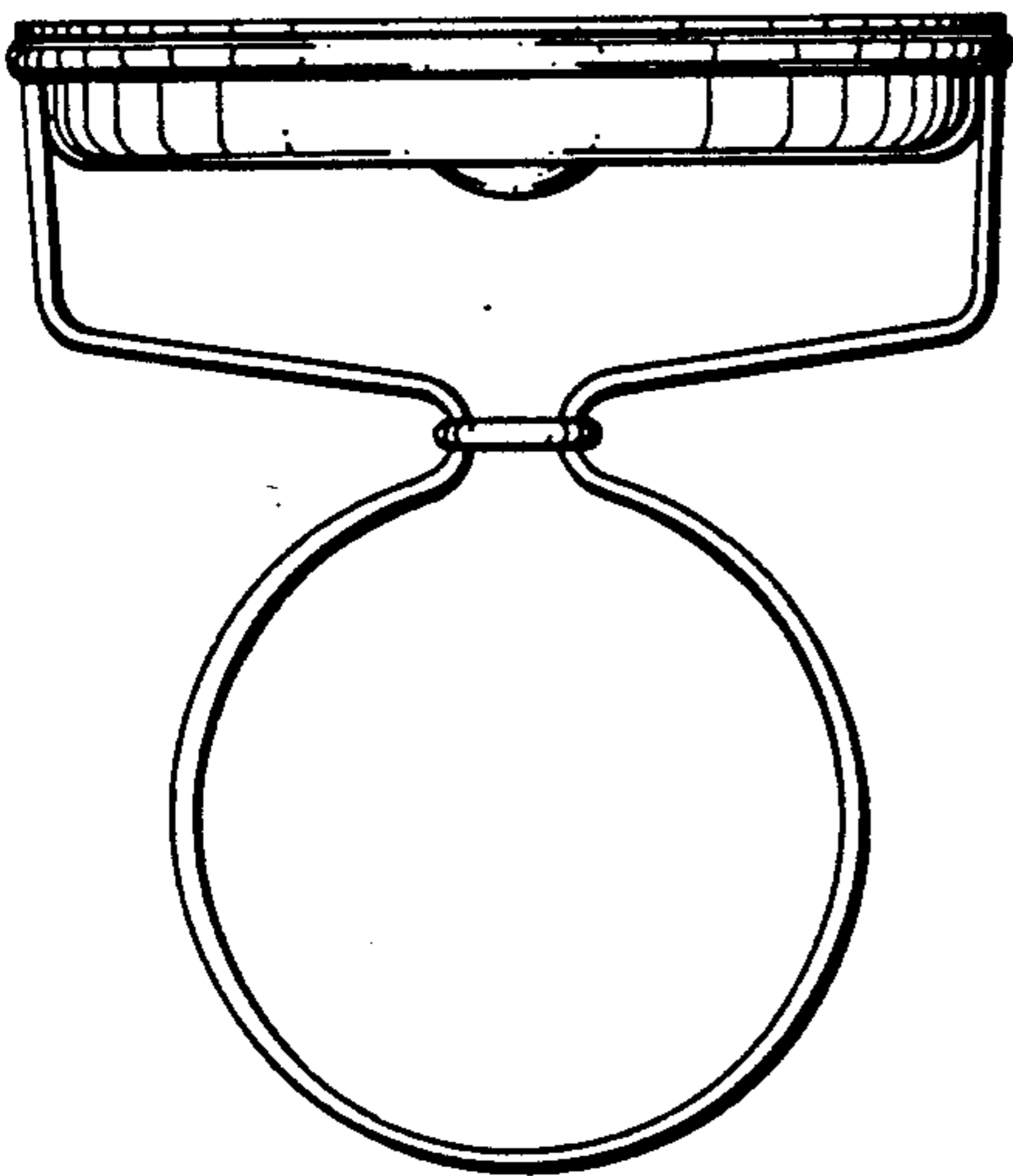
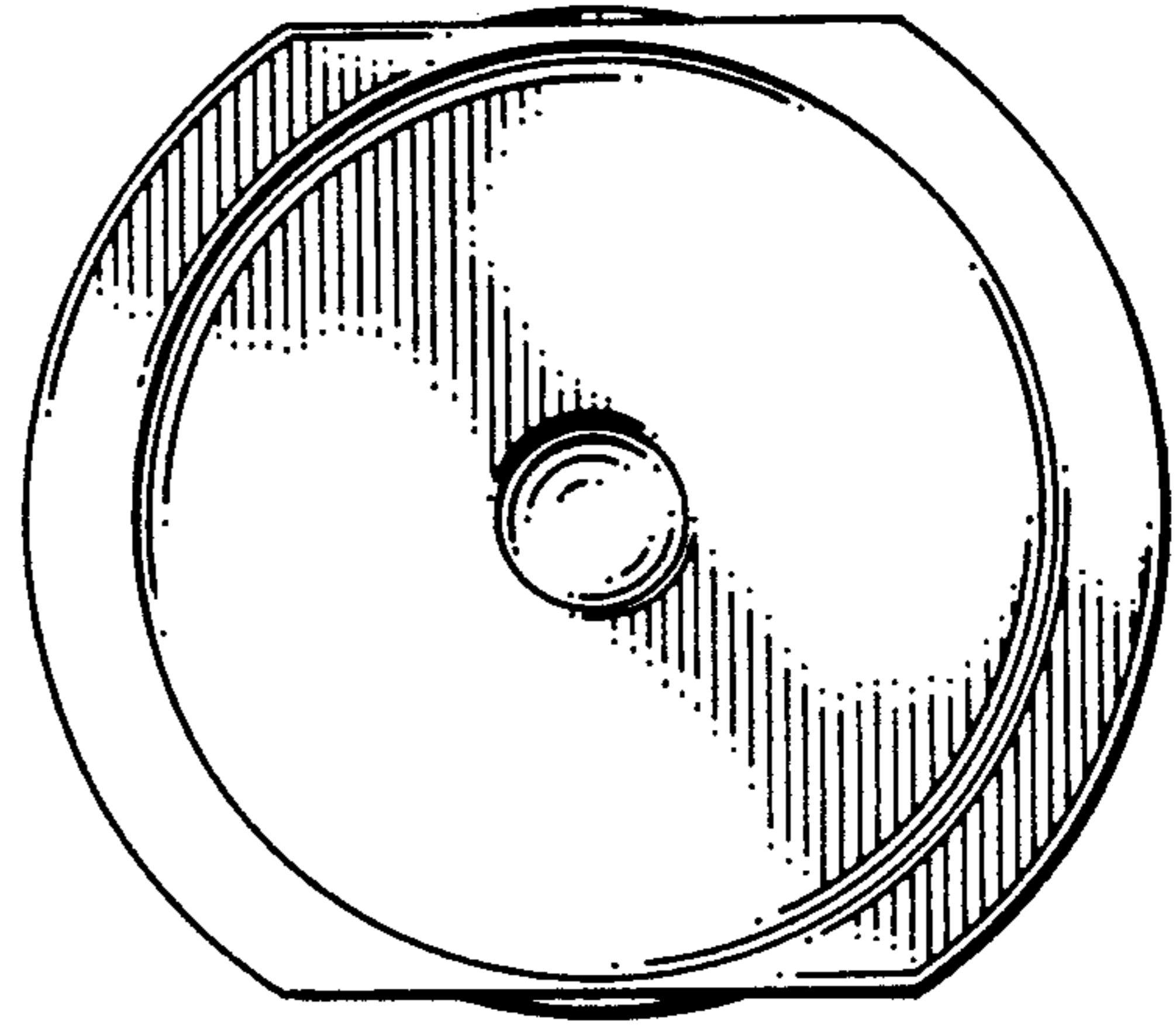

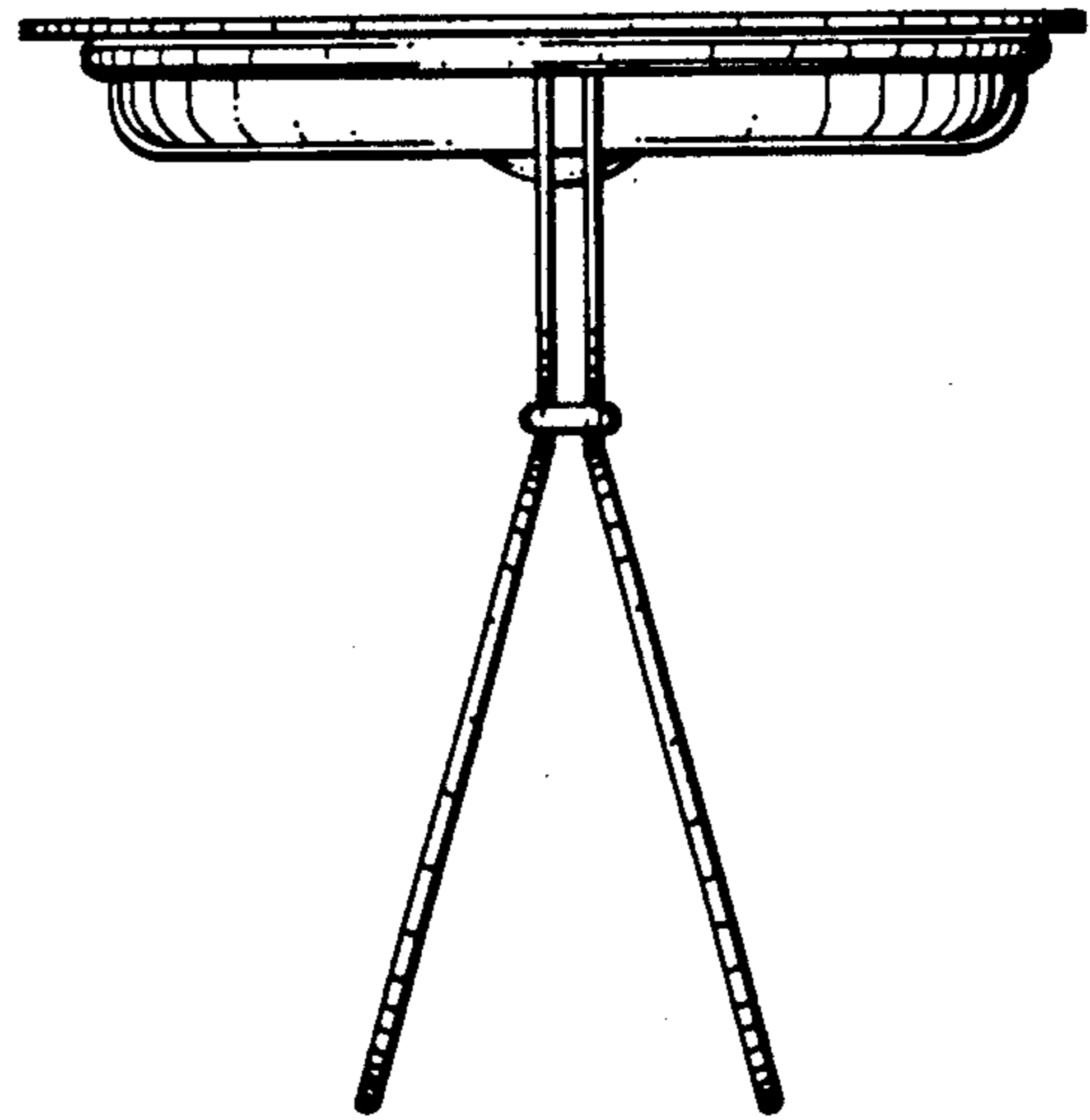

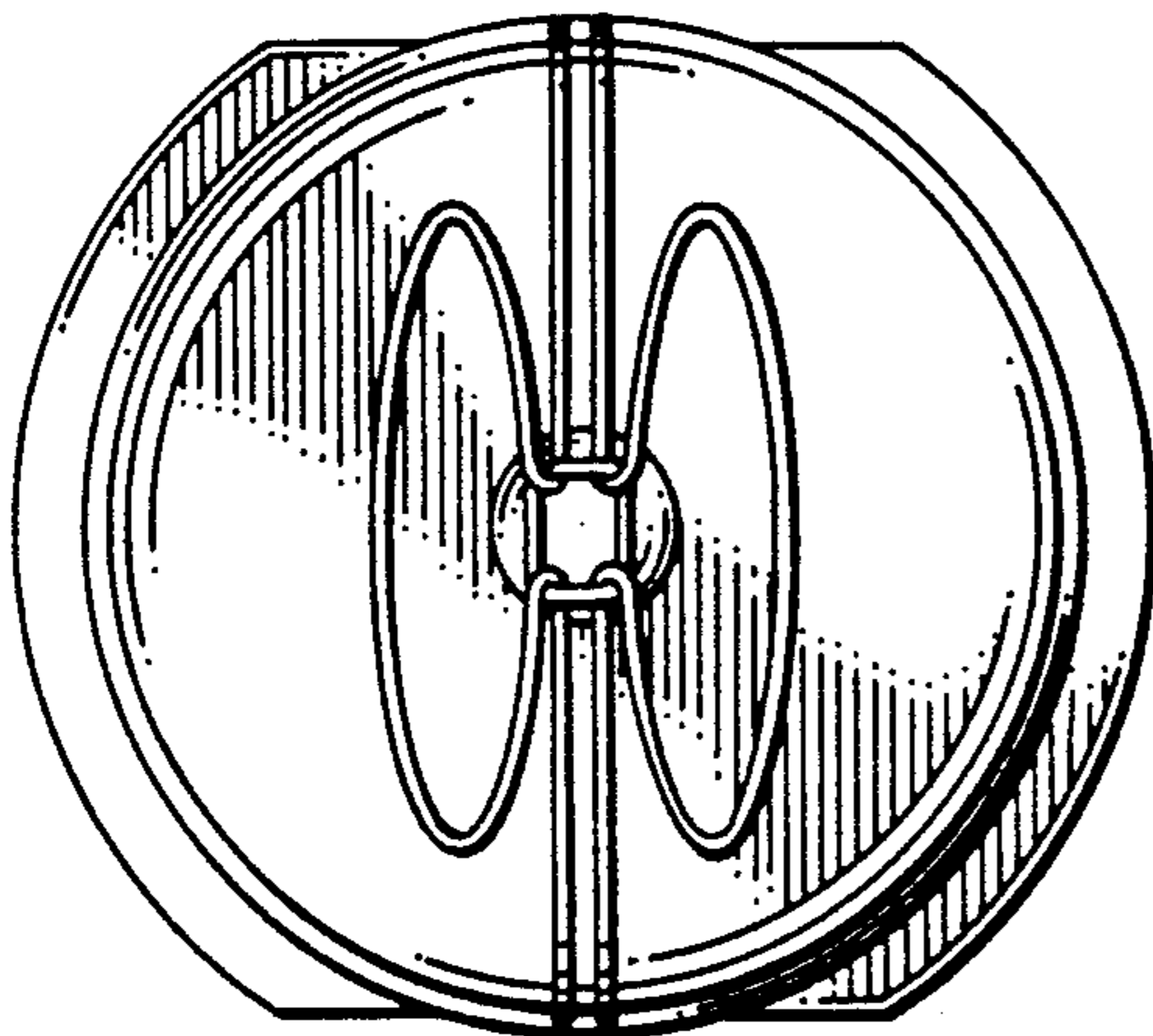
