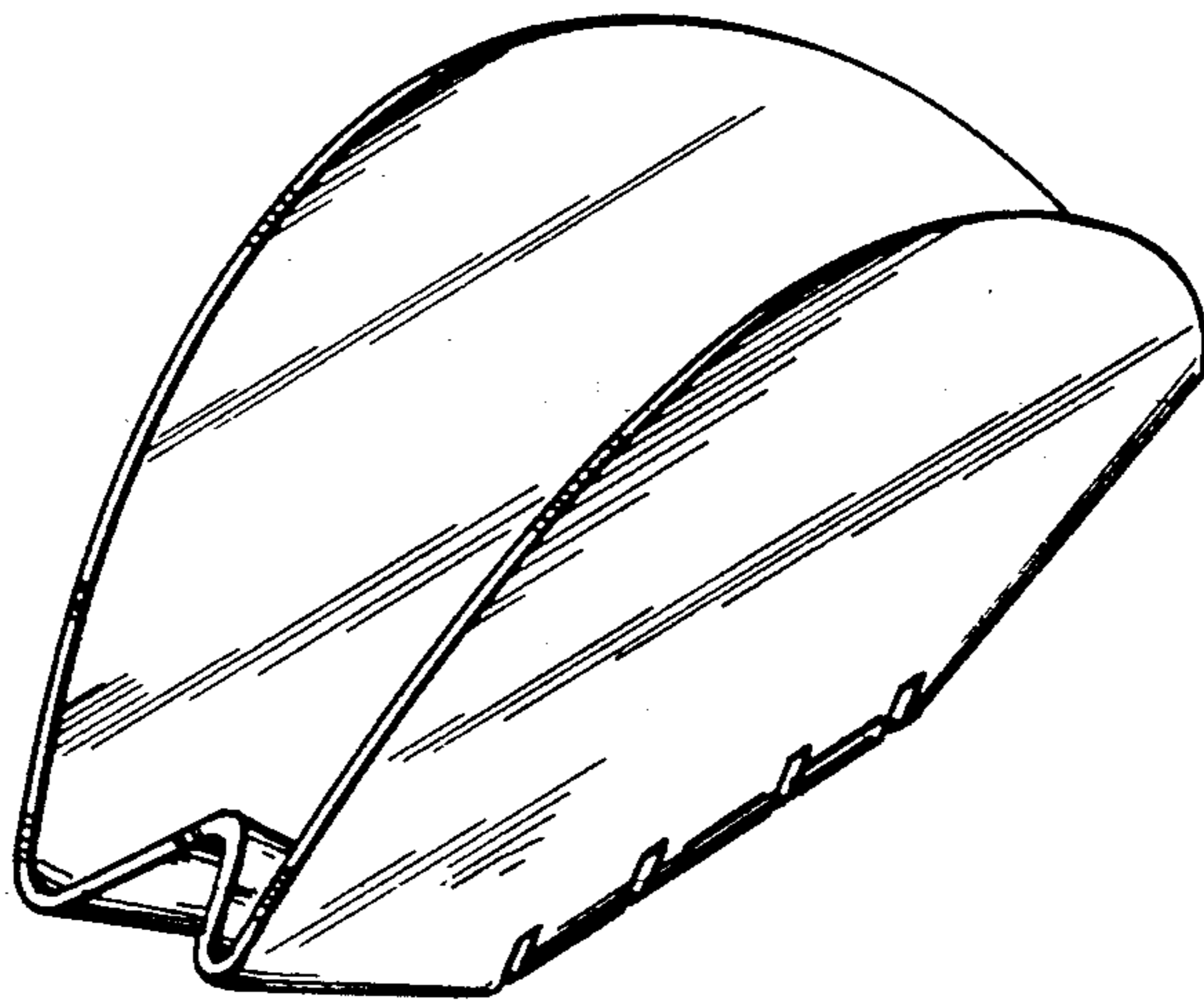
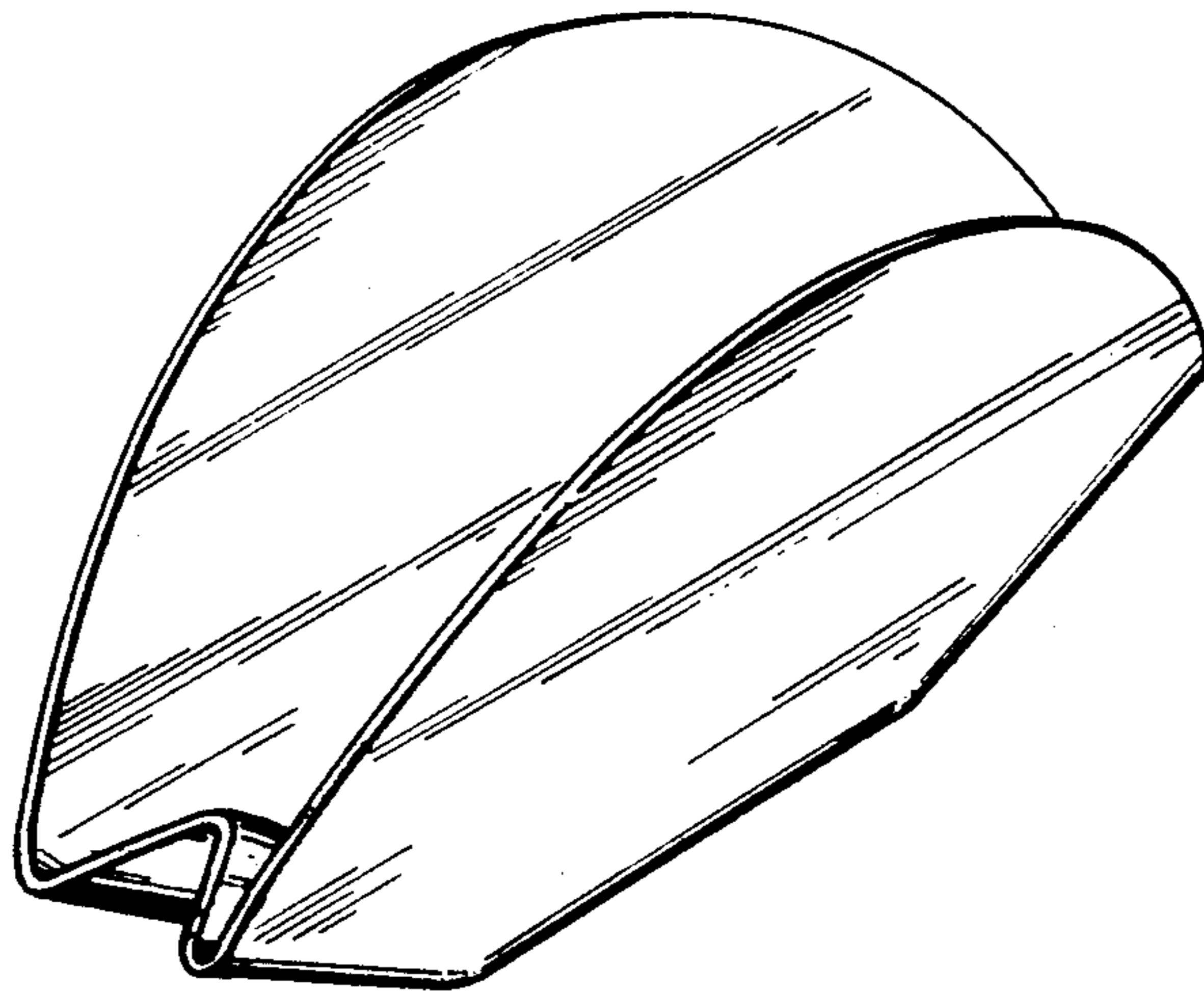

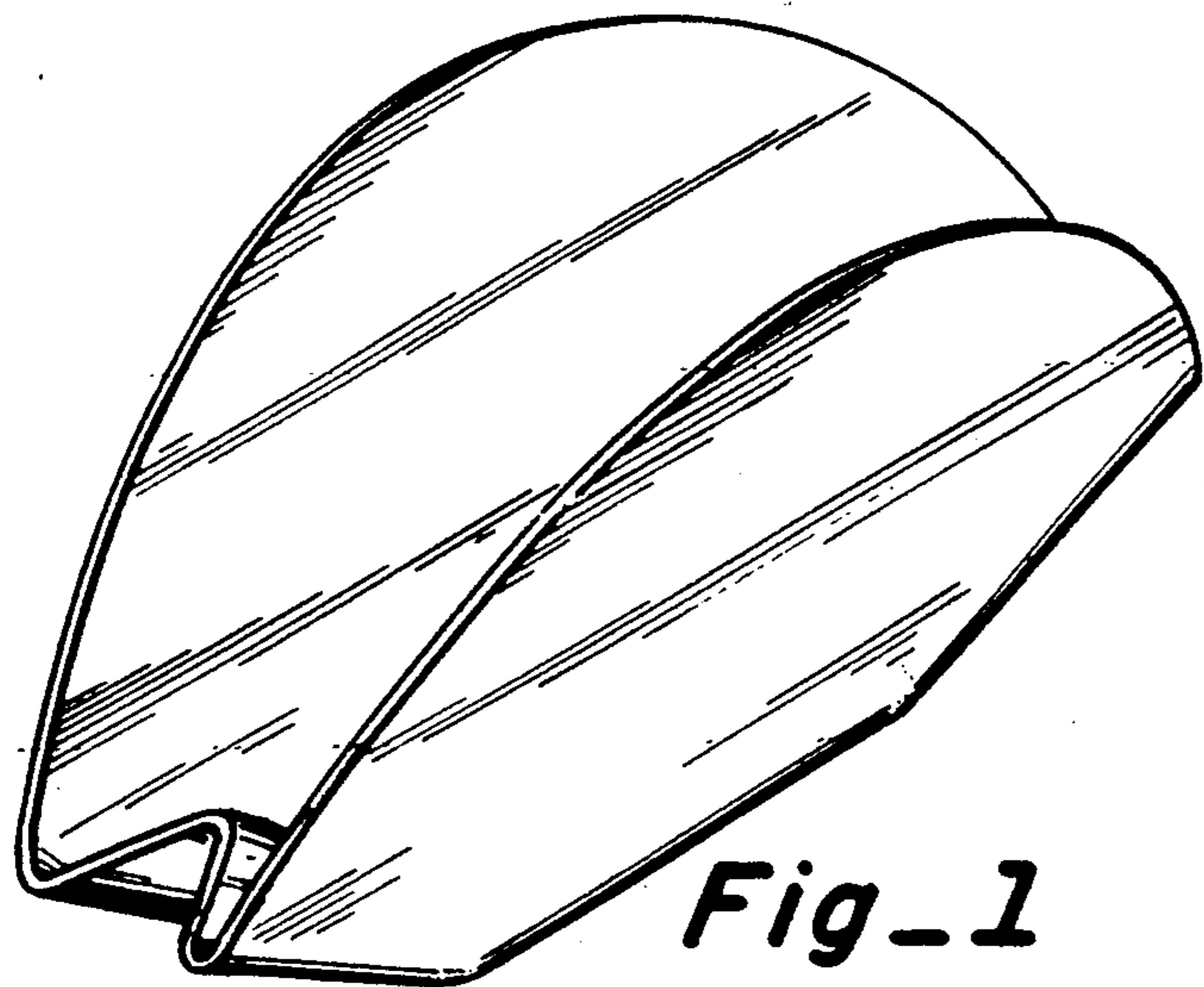
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an edible pastry shell, as shown and described.

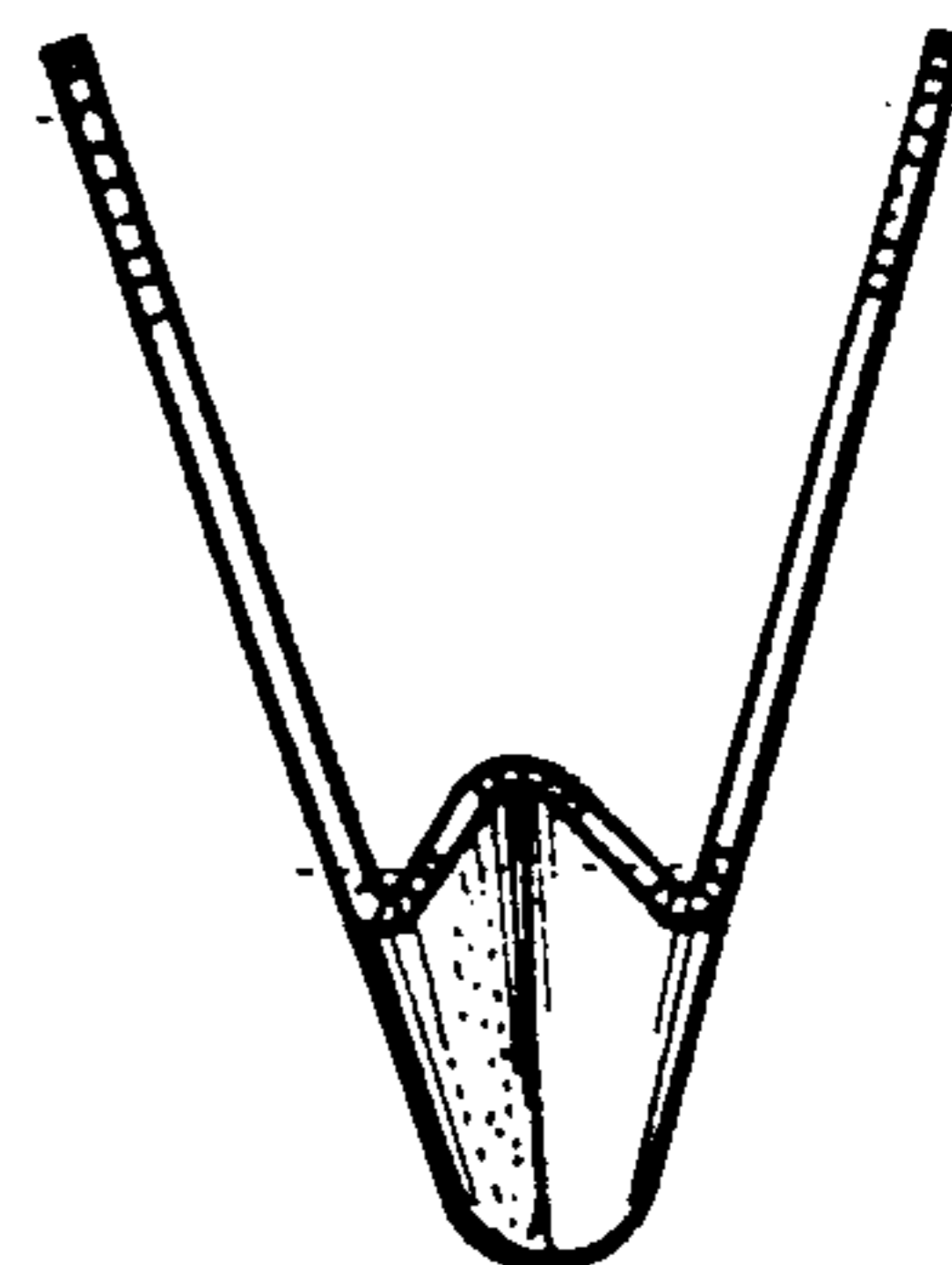
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a pastry shell showing my new design;

 FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof.

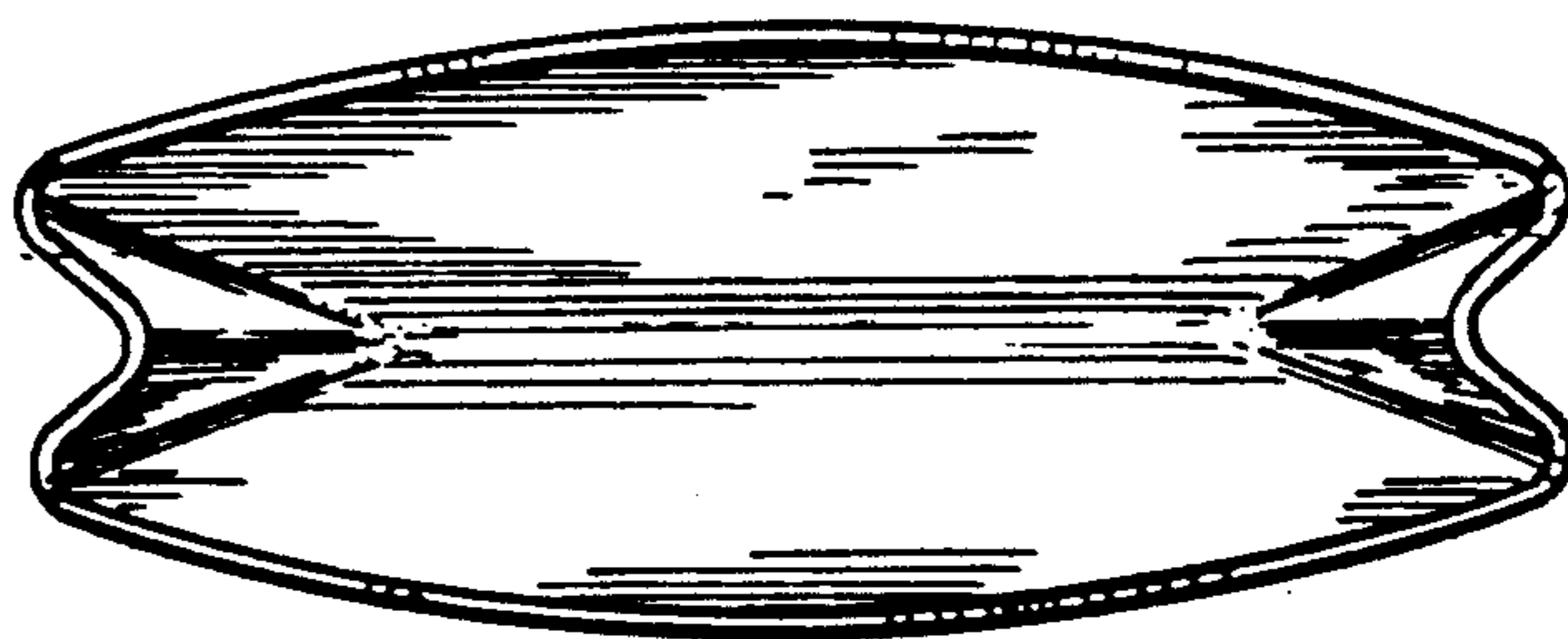




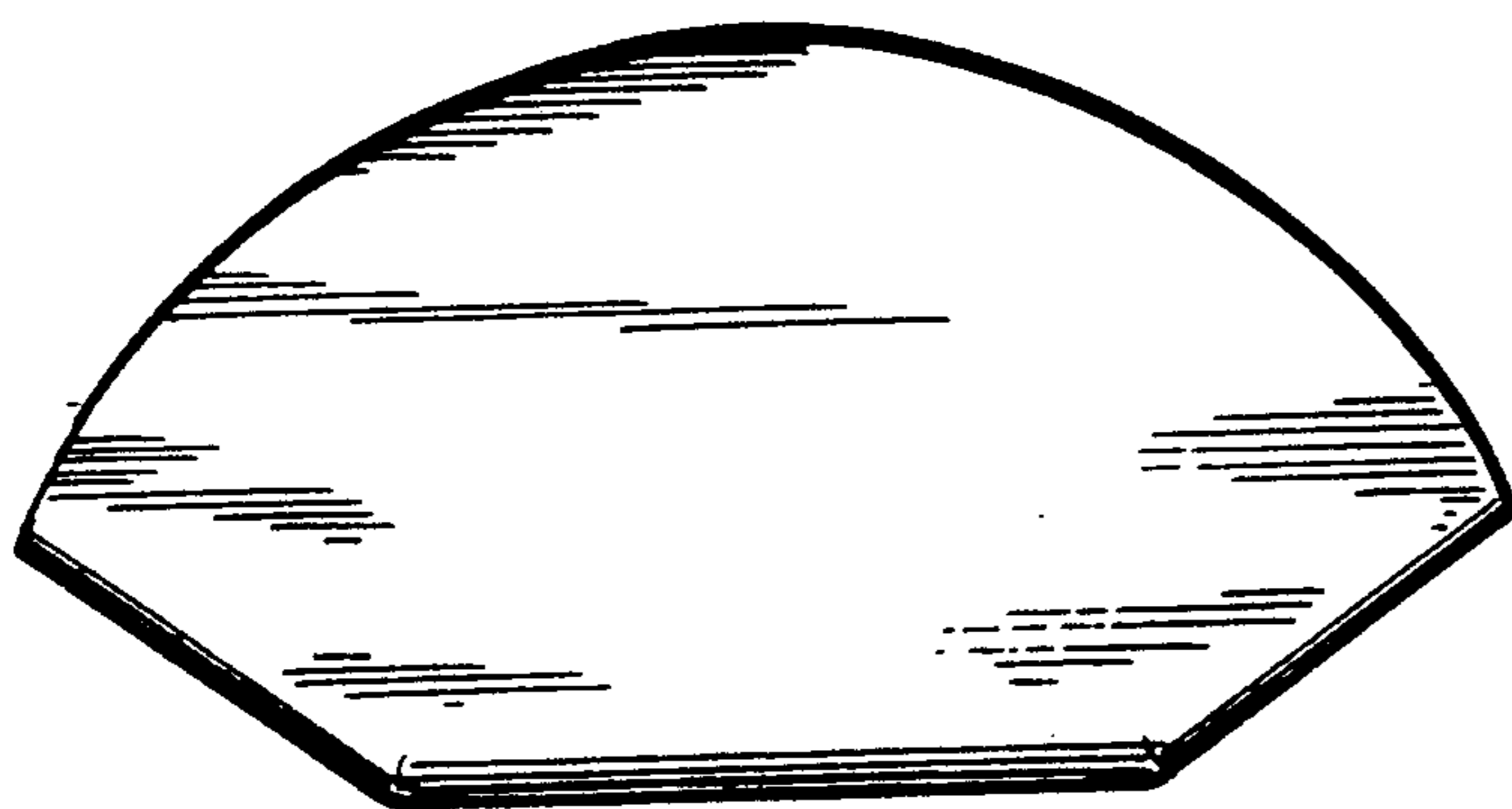

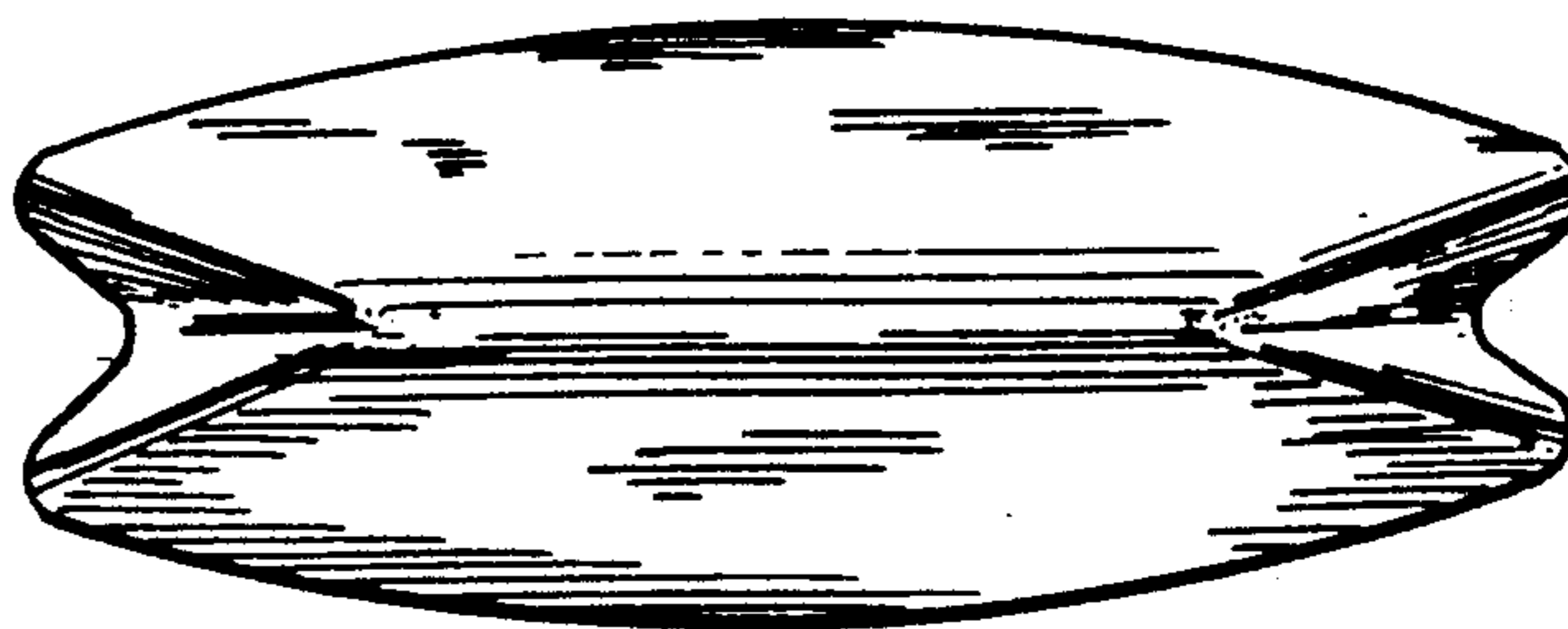

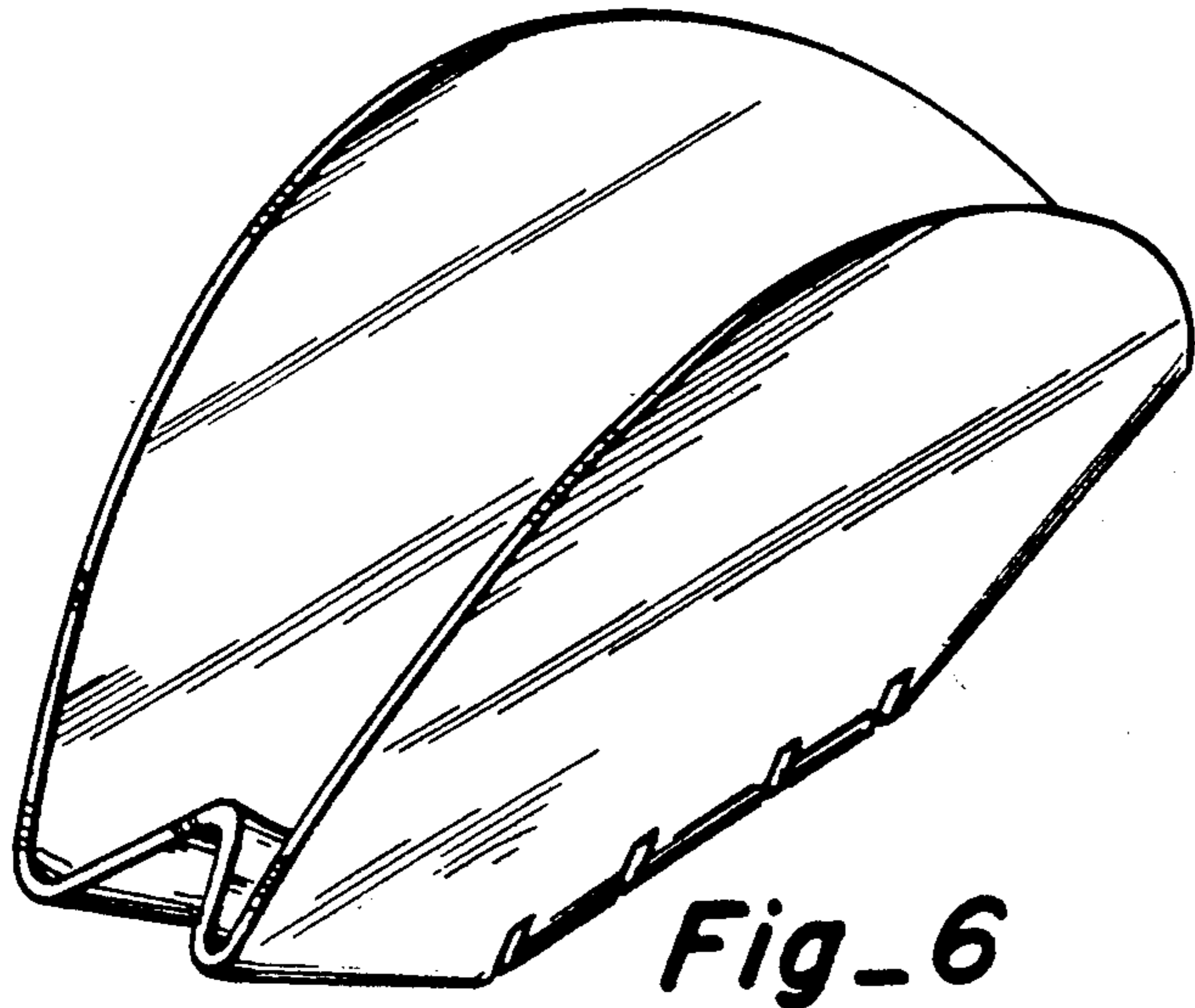

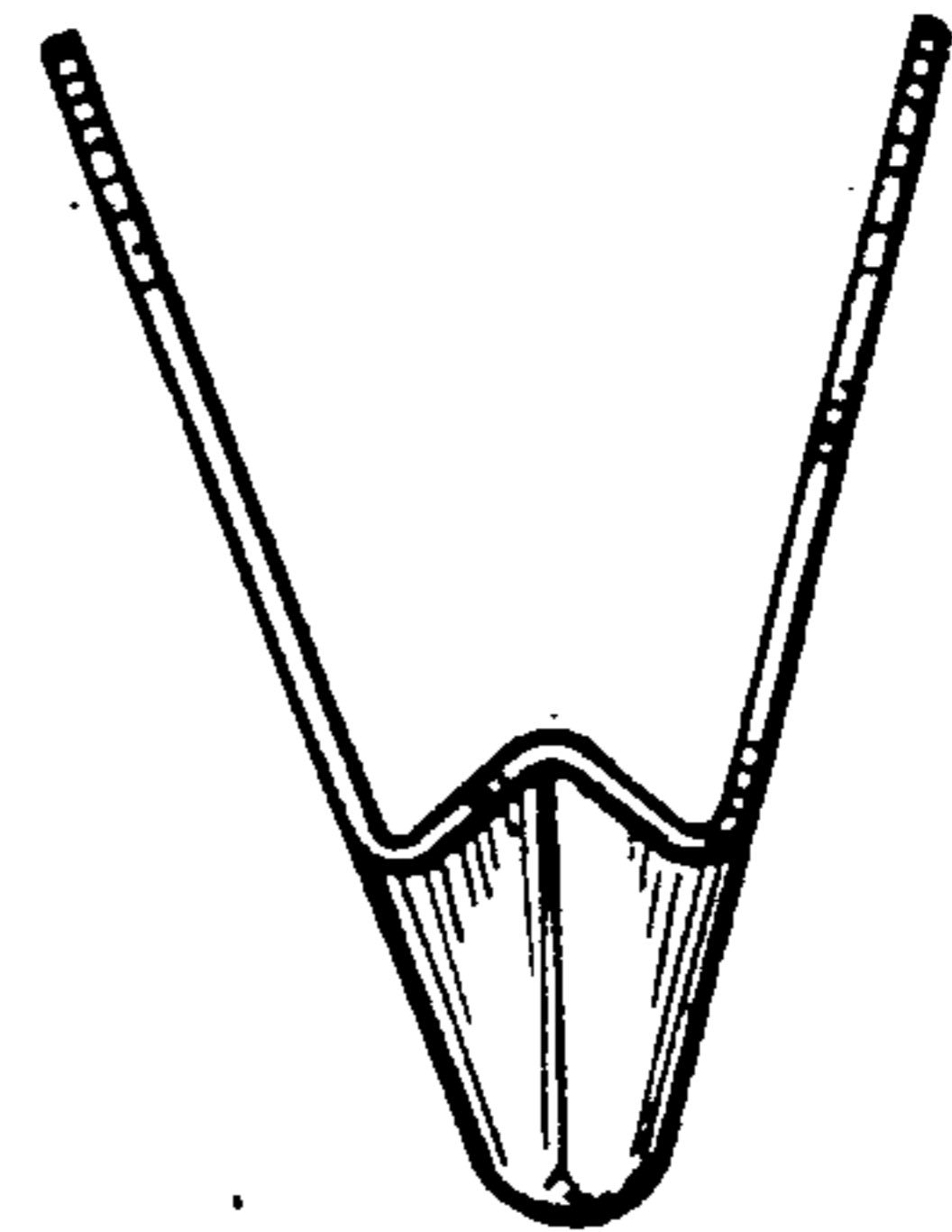

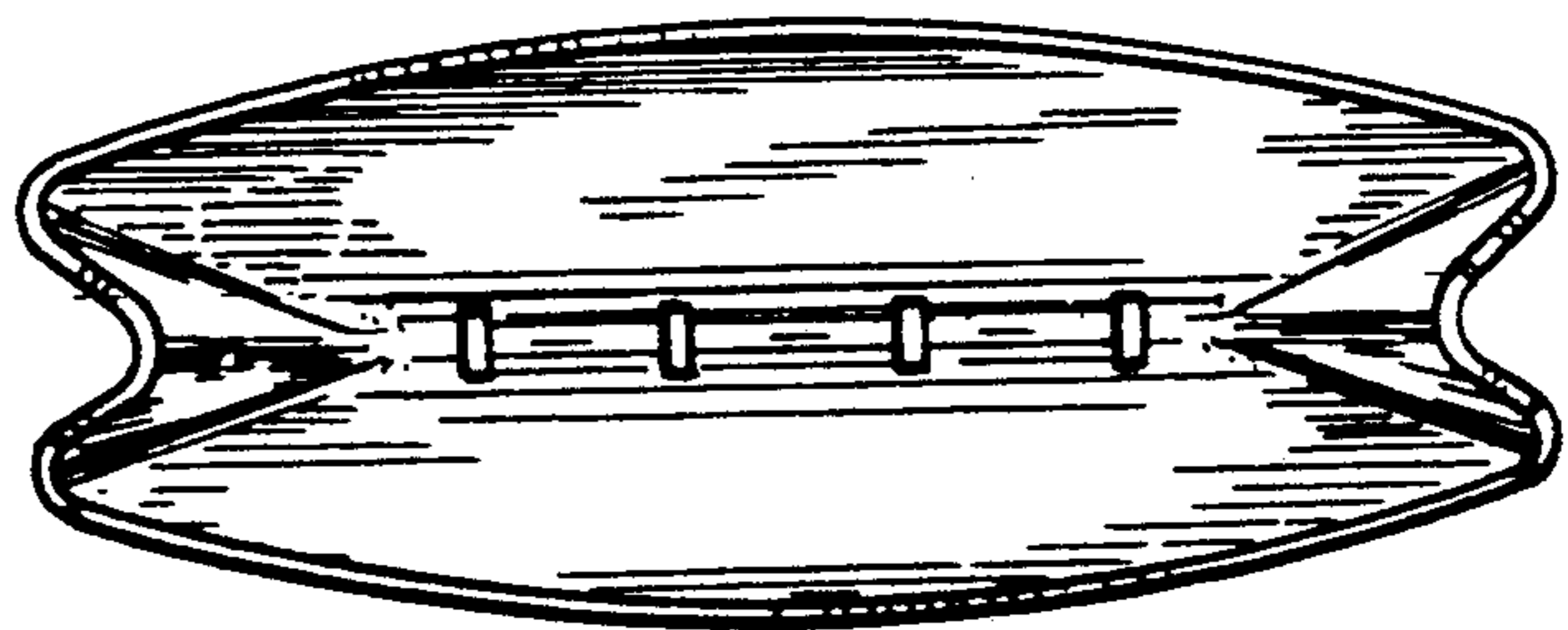

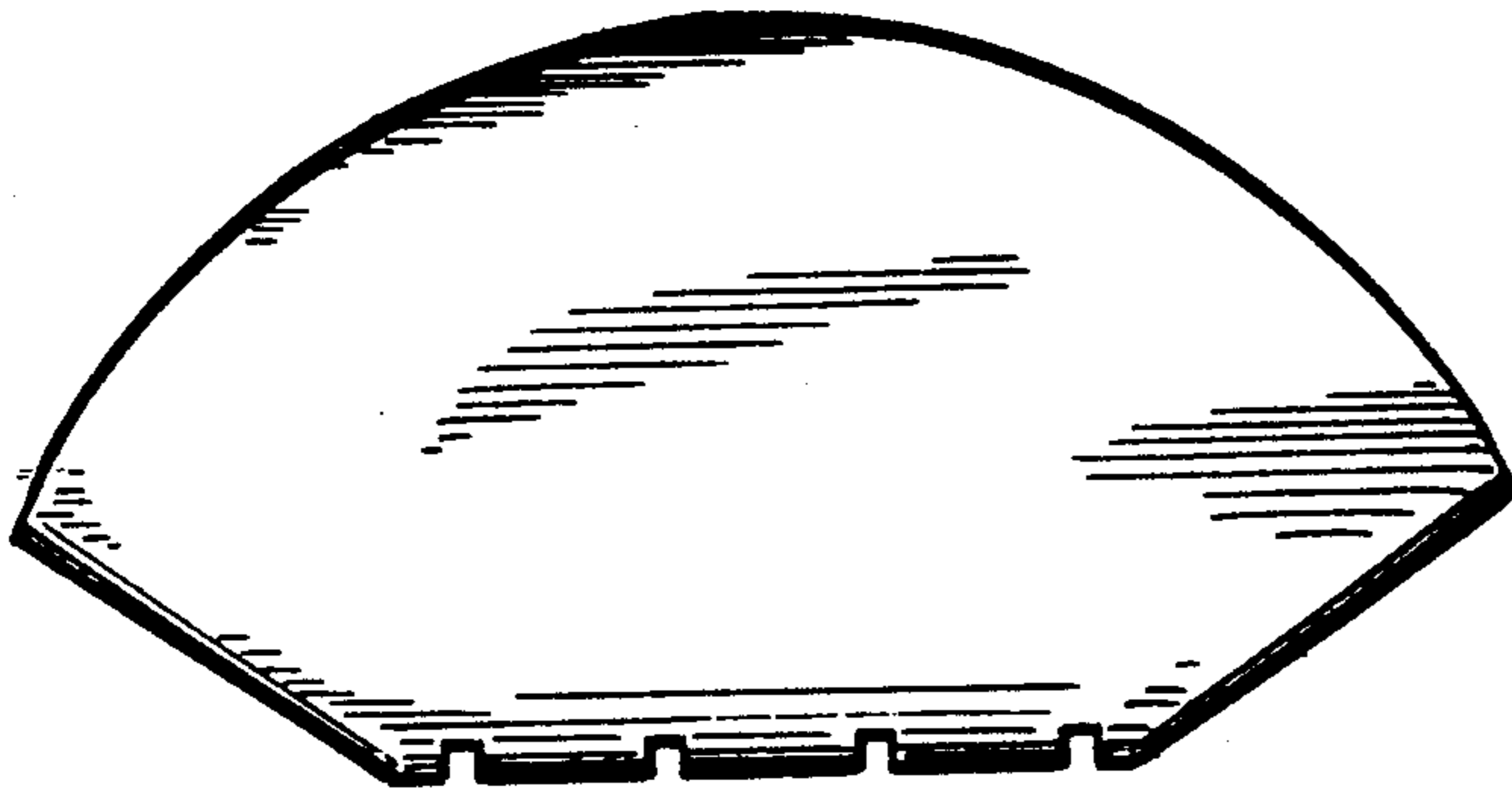

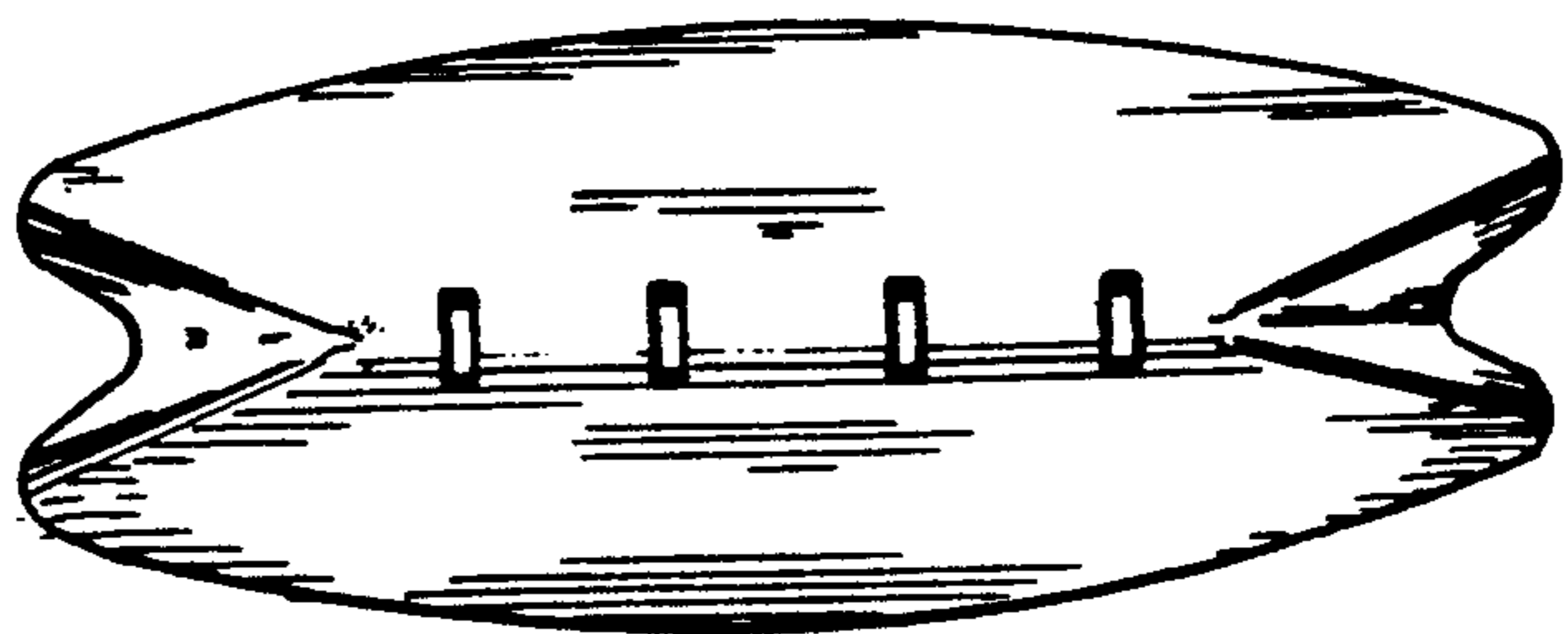
