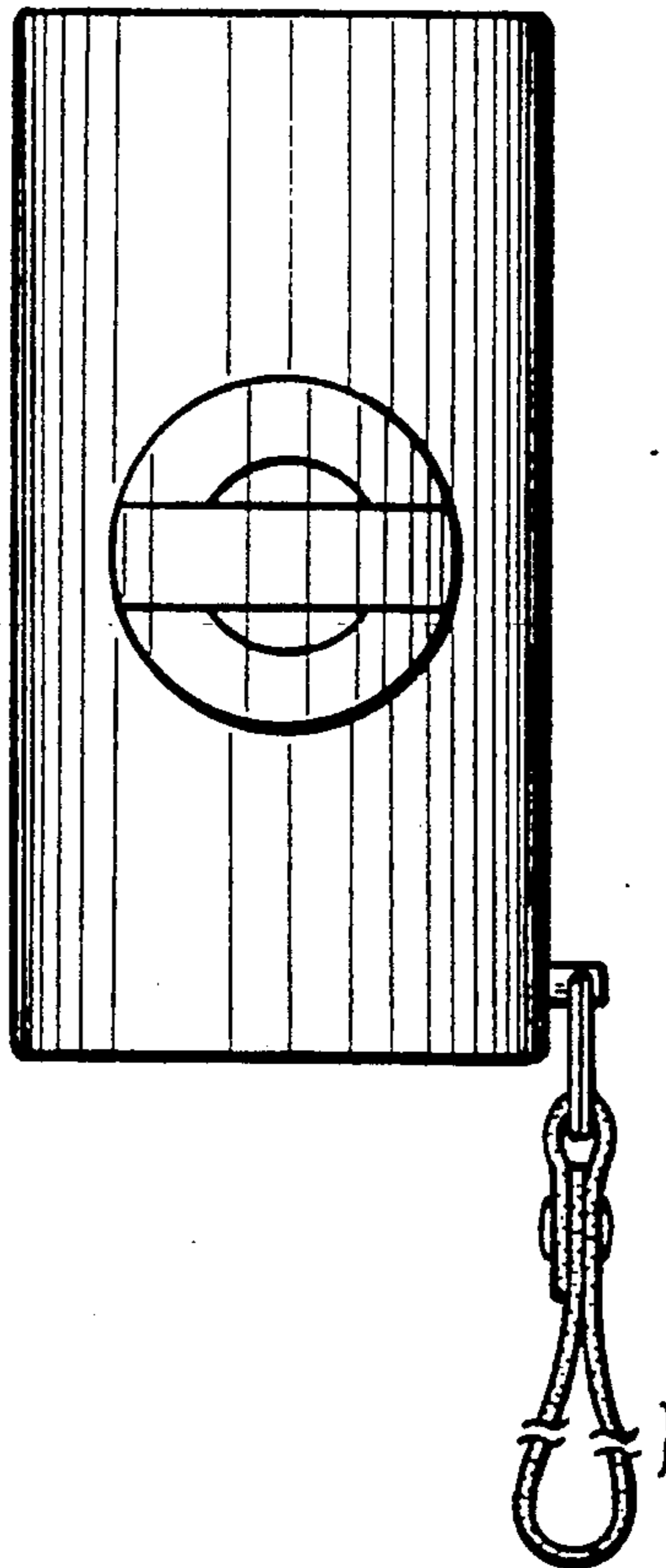

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an umbrella handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of one embodiment of an umbrella handle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the handle shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the handle shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the handle shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the handle shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the handle shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of an umbrella handle showing my new design;
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of the handle shown in FIG. 7, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the handle shown in FIG. 7;
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the handle shown in FIG. 7;
FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the handle shown in FIG. 7;
FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment of an umbrella handle showing my new design, the left side elevational view, right side elevational view, rear elevational view, bottom plan view and top plan view being the same as for the same relative views illustrated for that embodiment shown in FIGS. 1-6 except that the lines are omitted from the handle's disc.



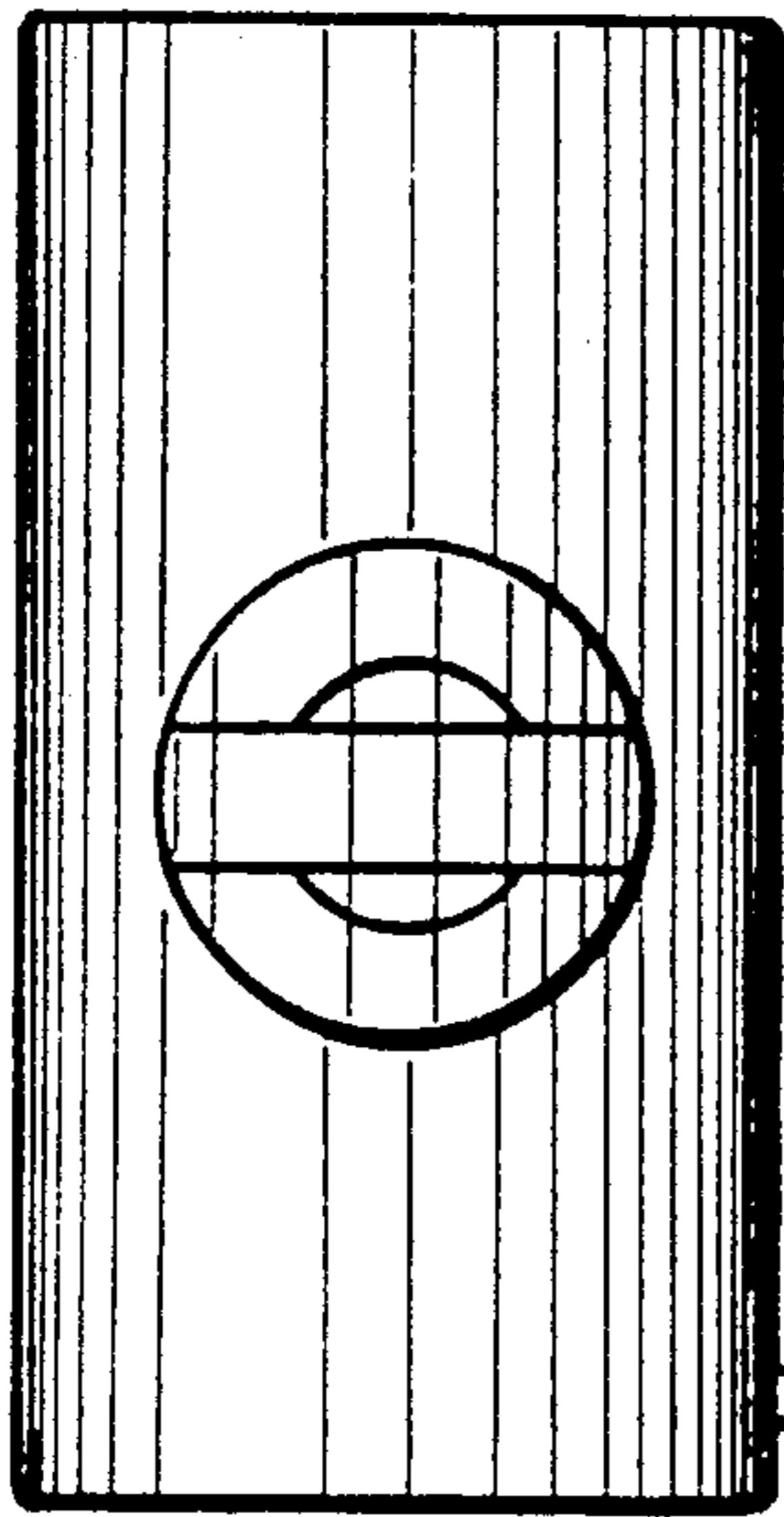

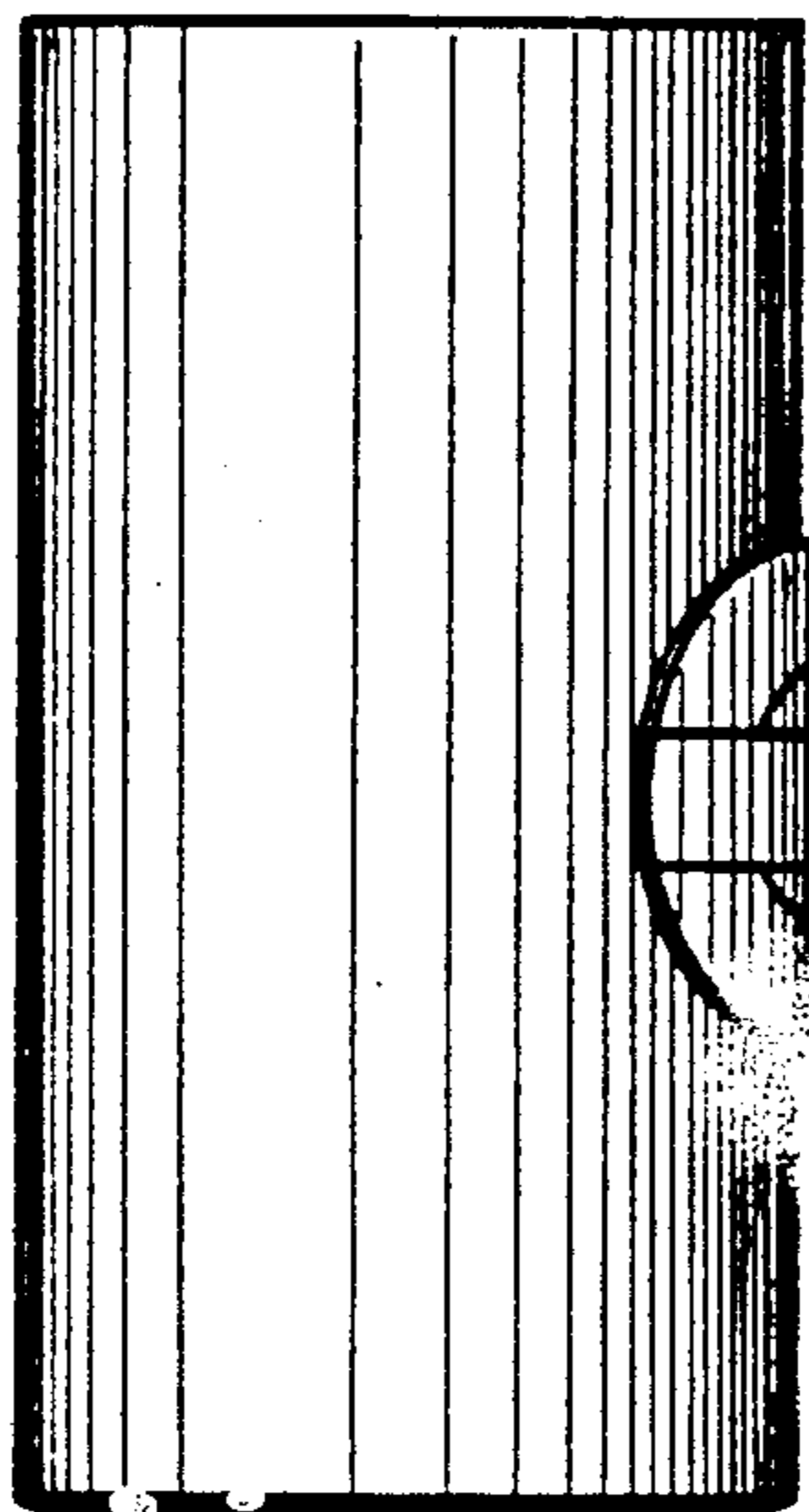

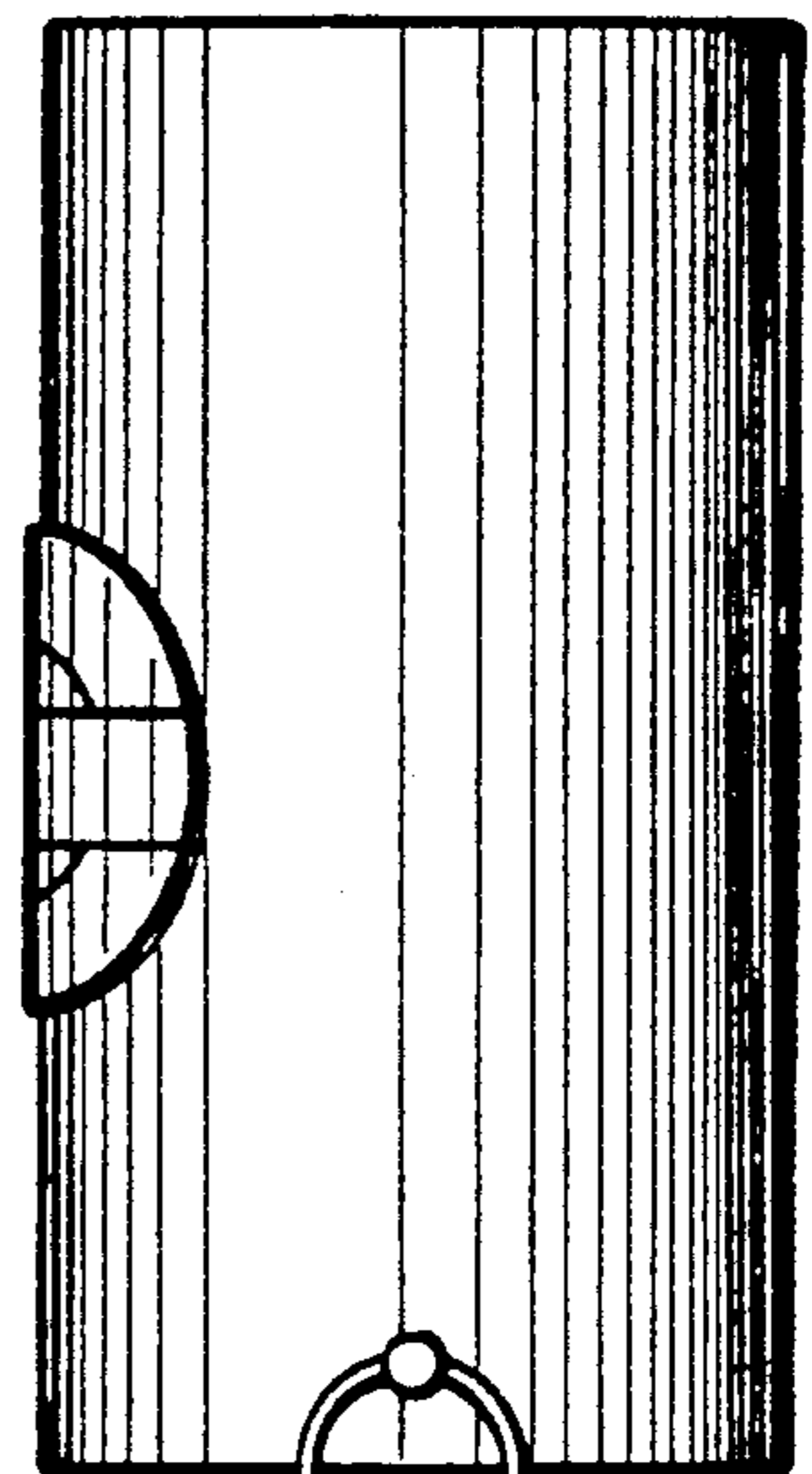

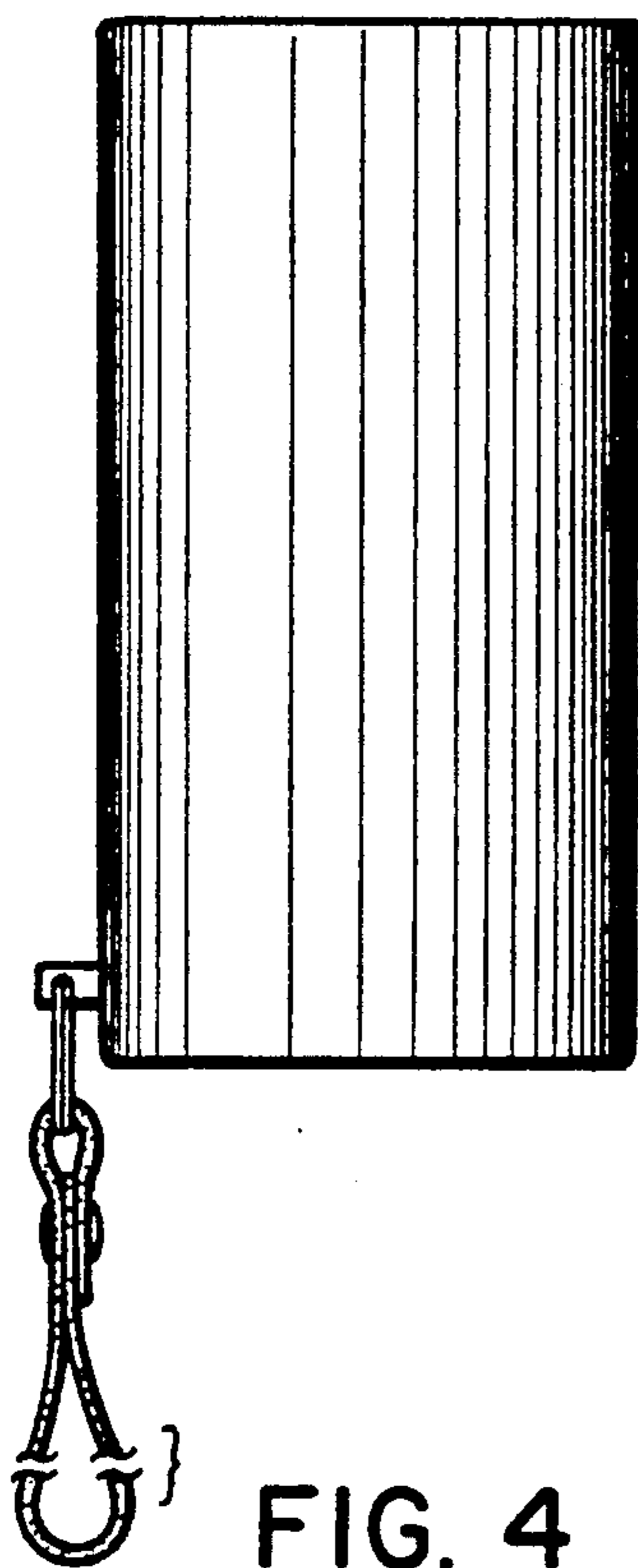

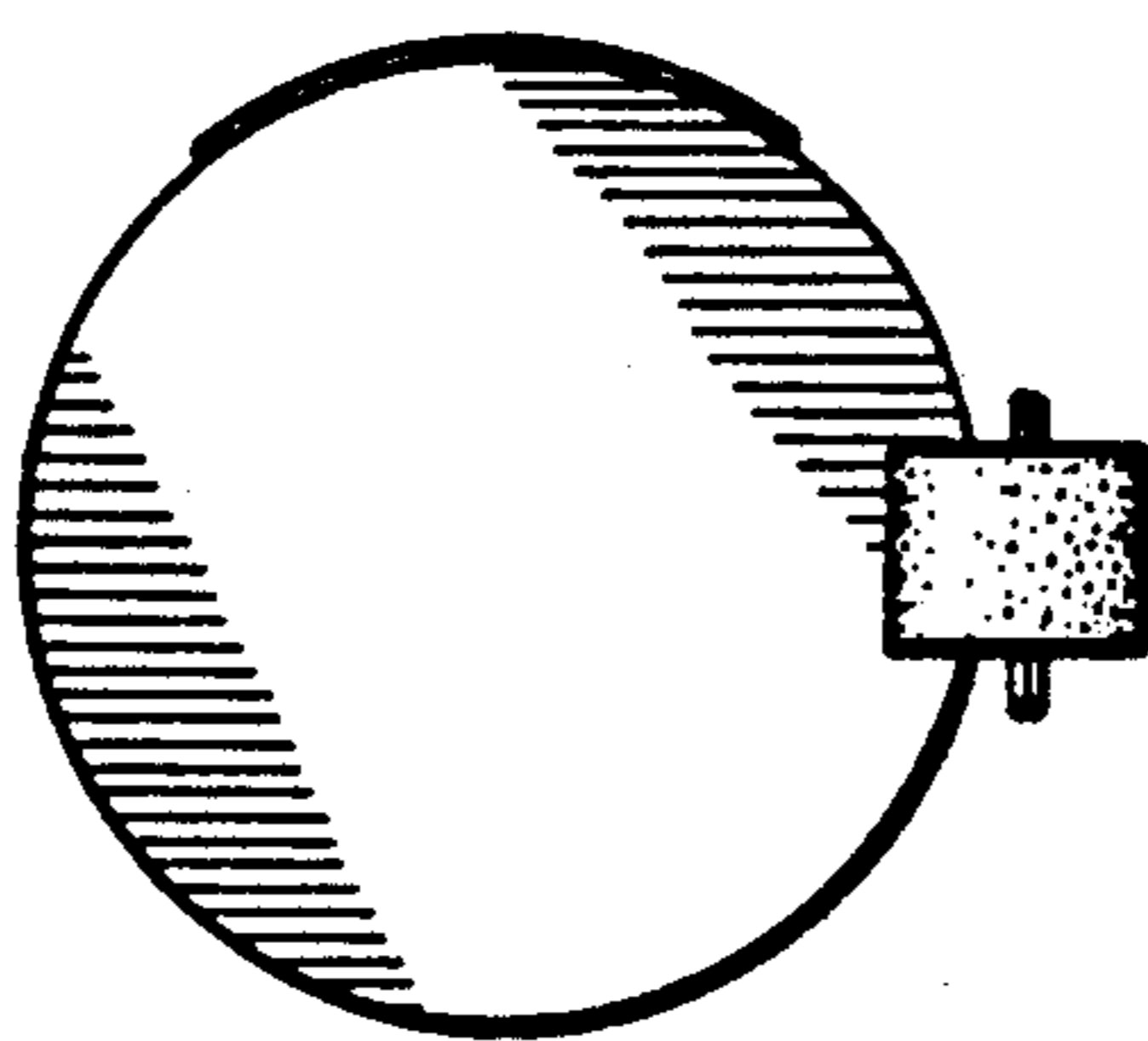

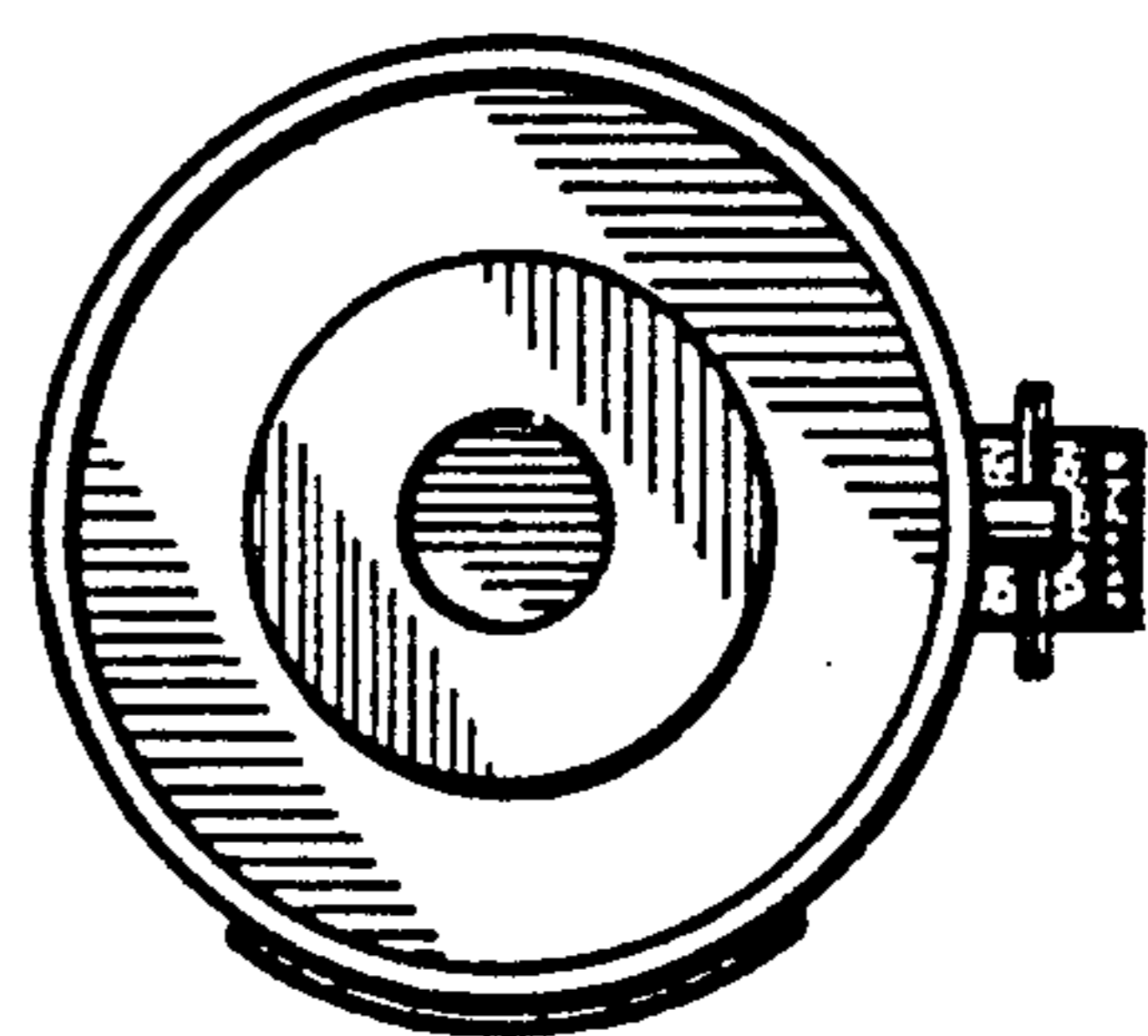

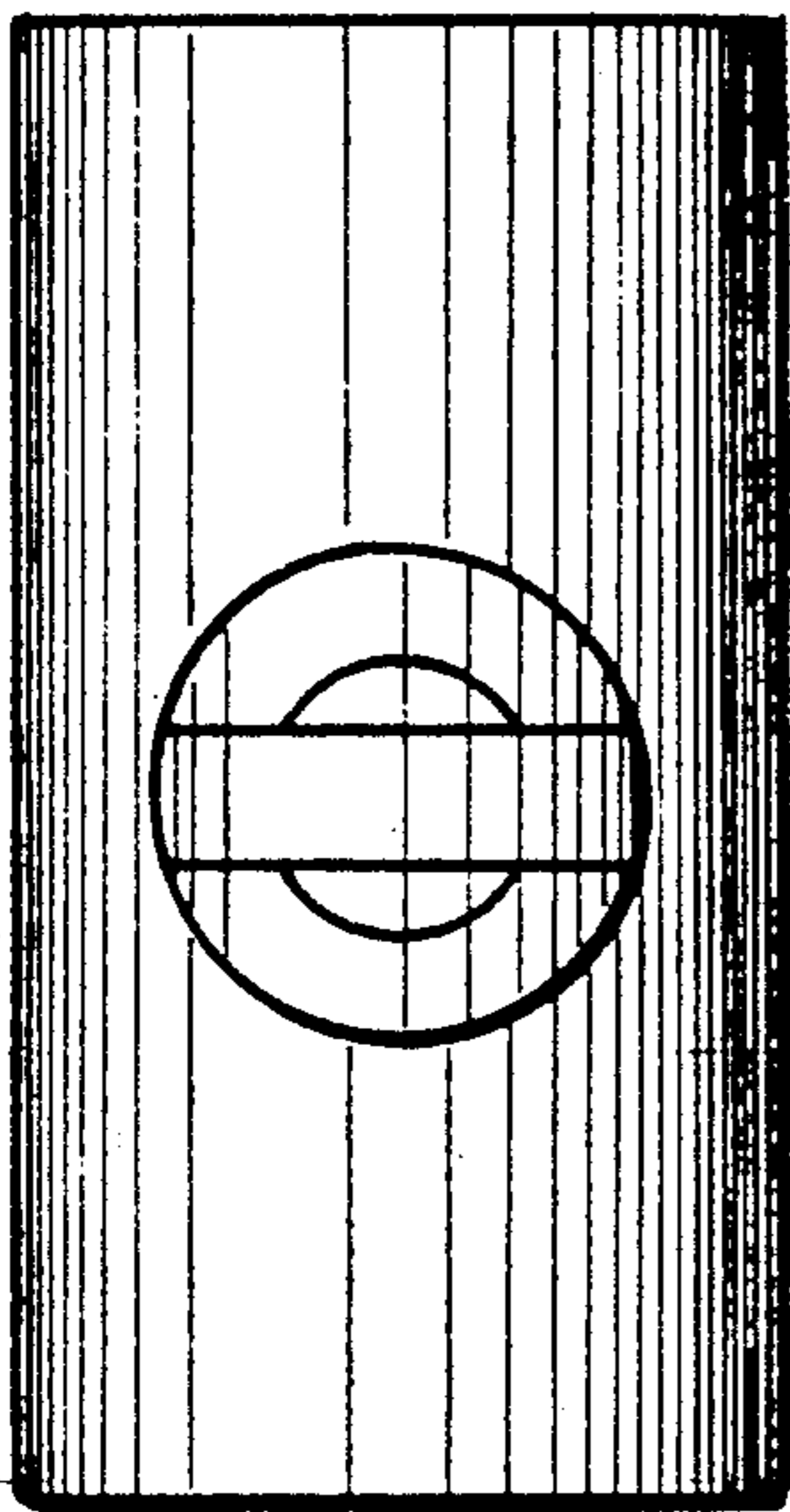

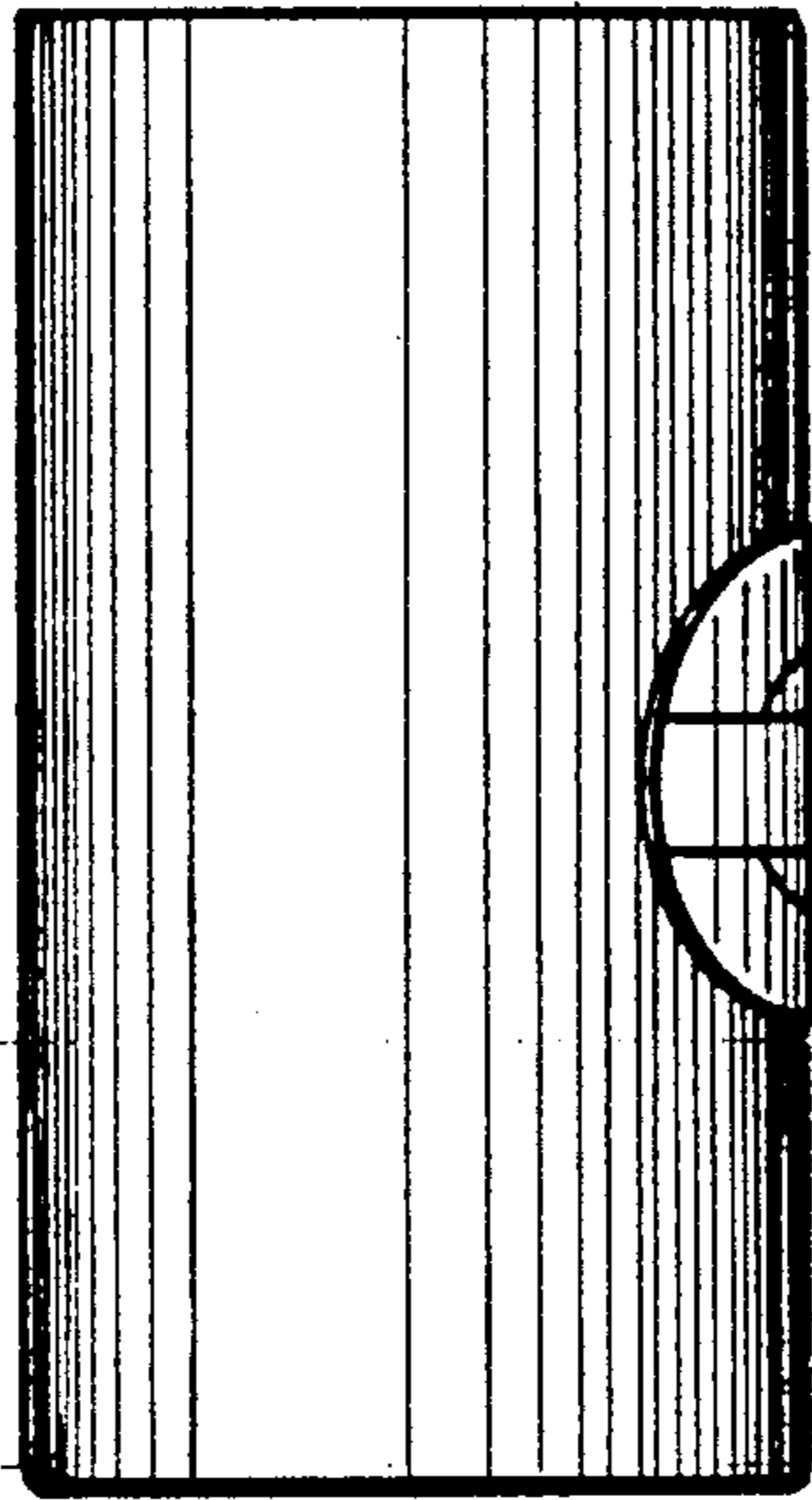

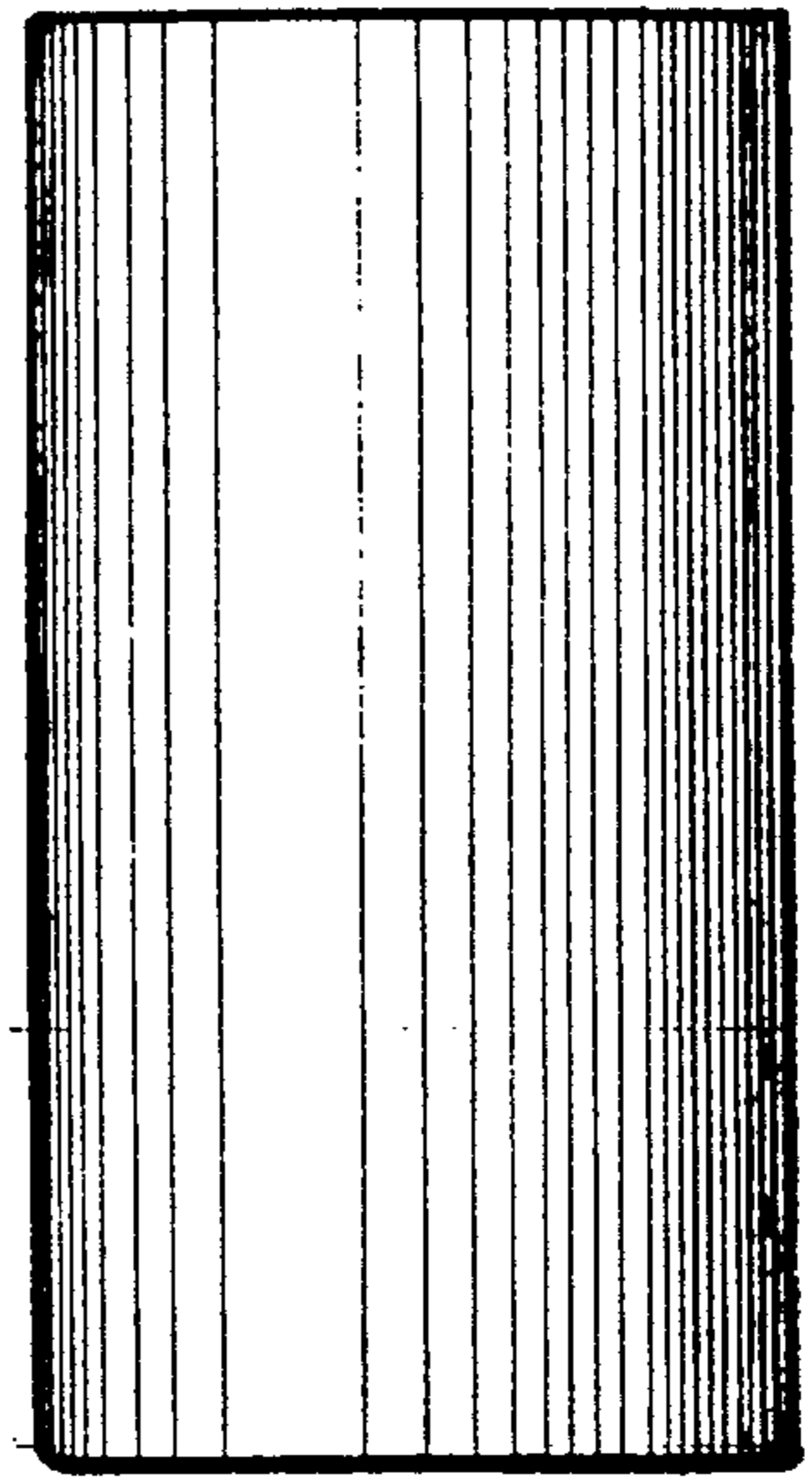

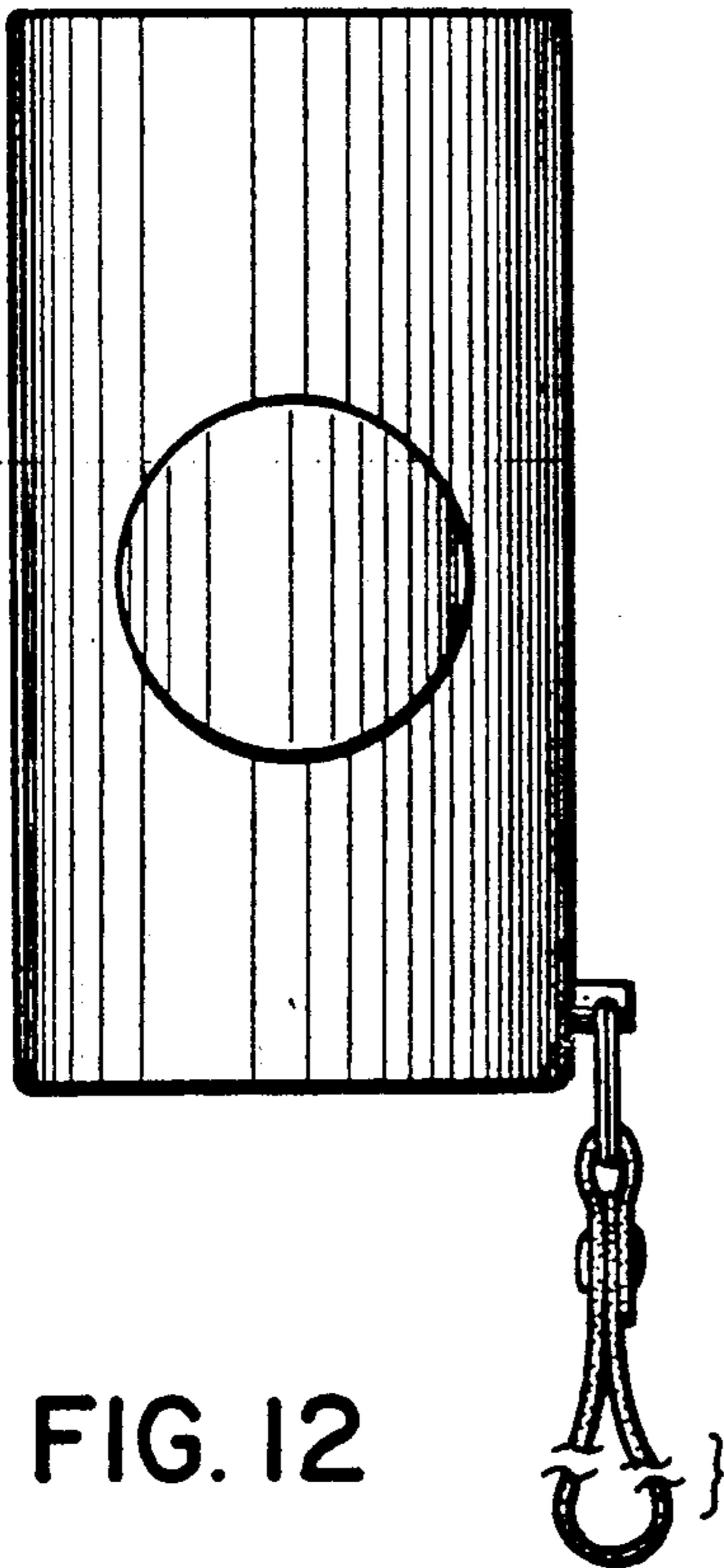

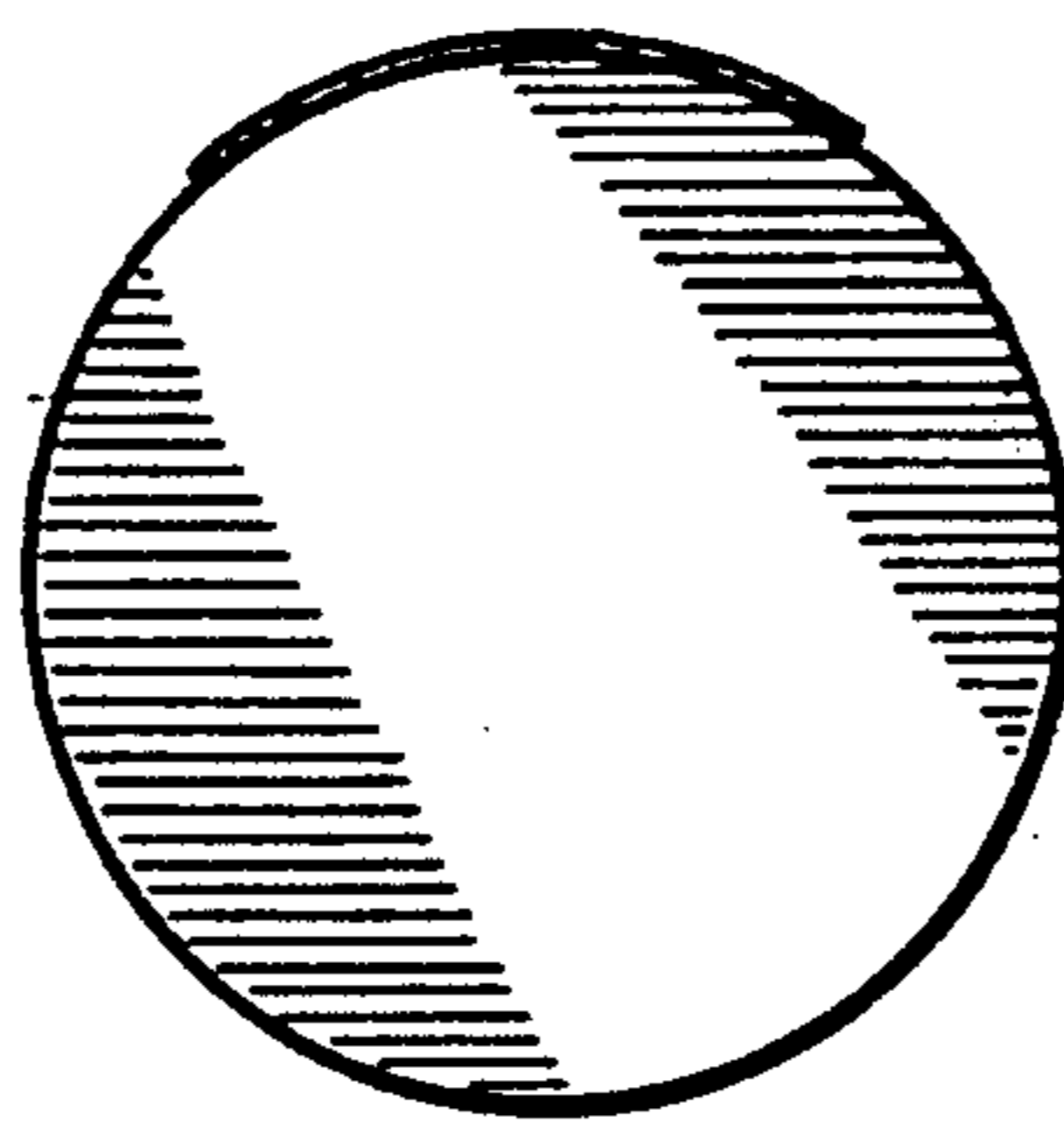

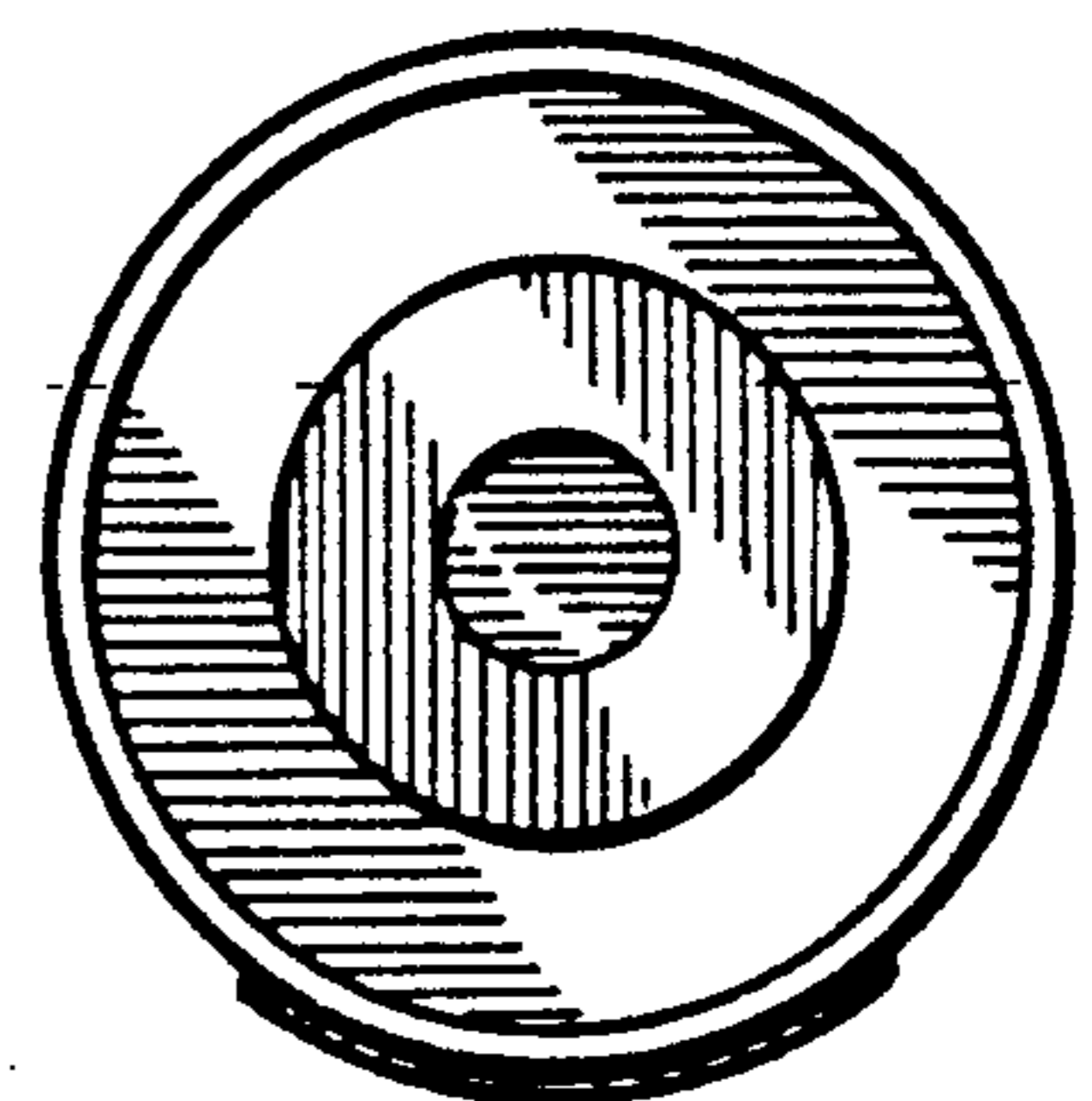
