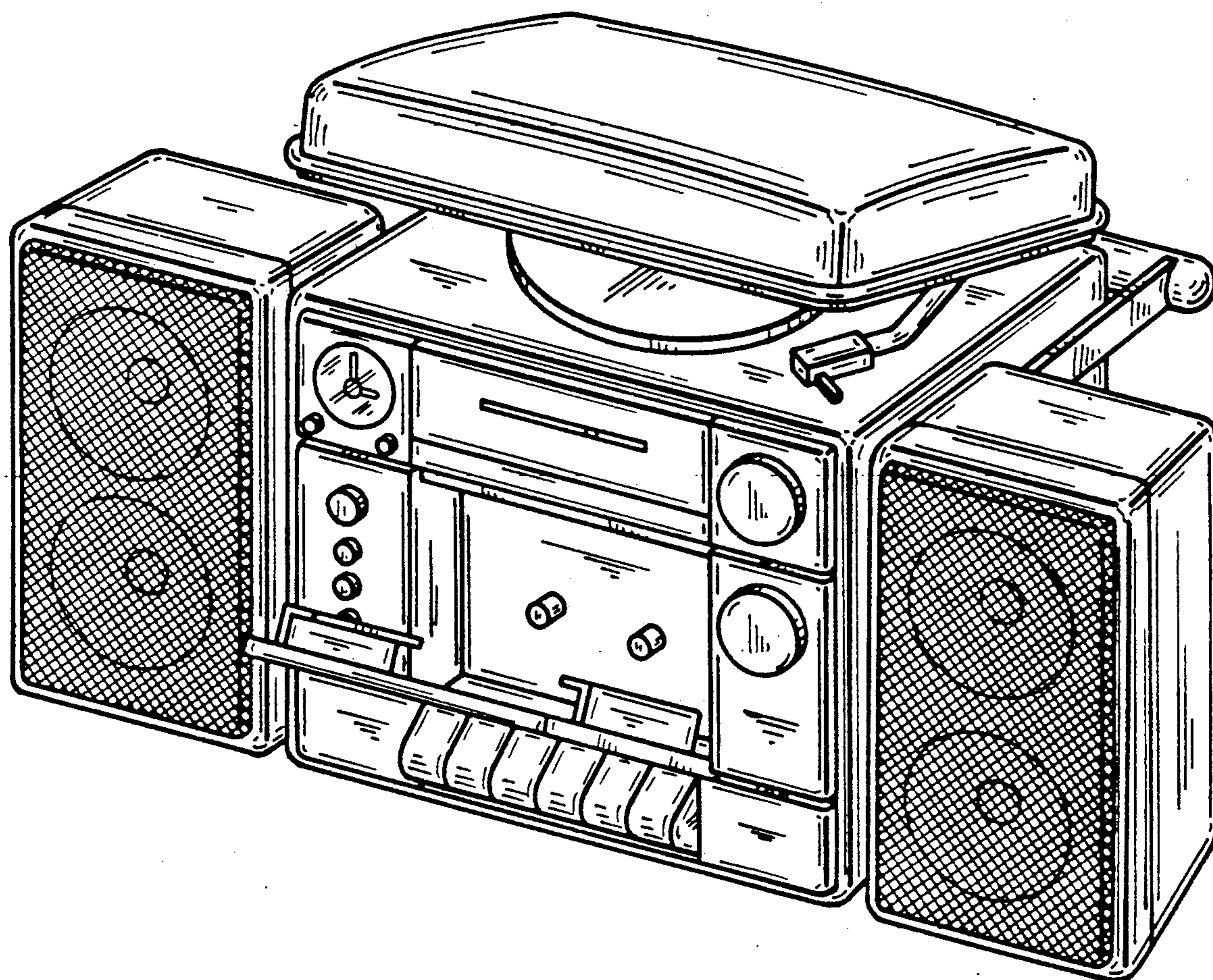

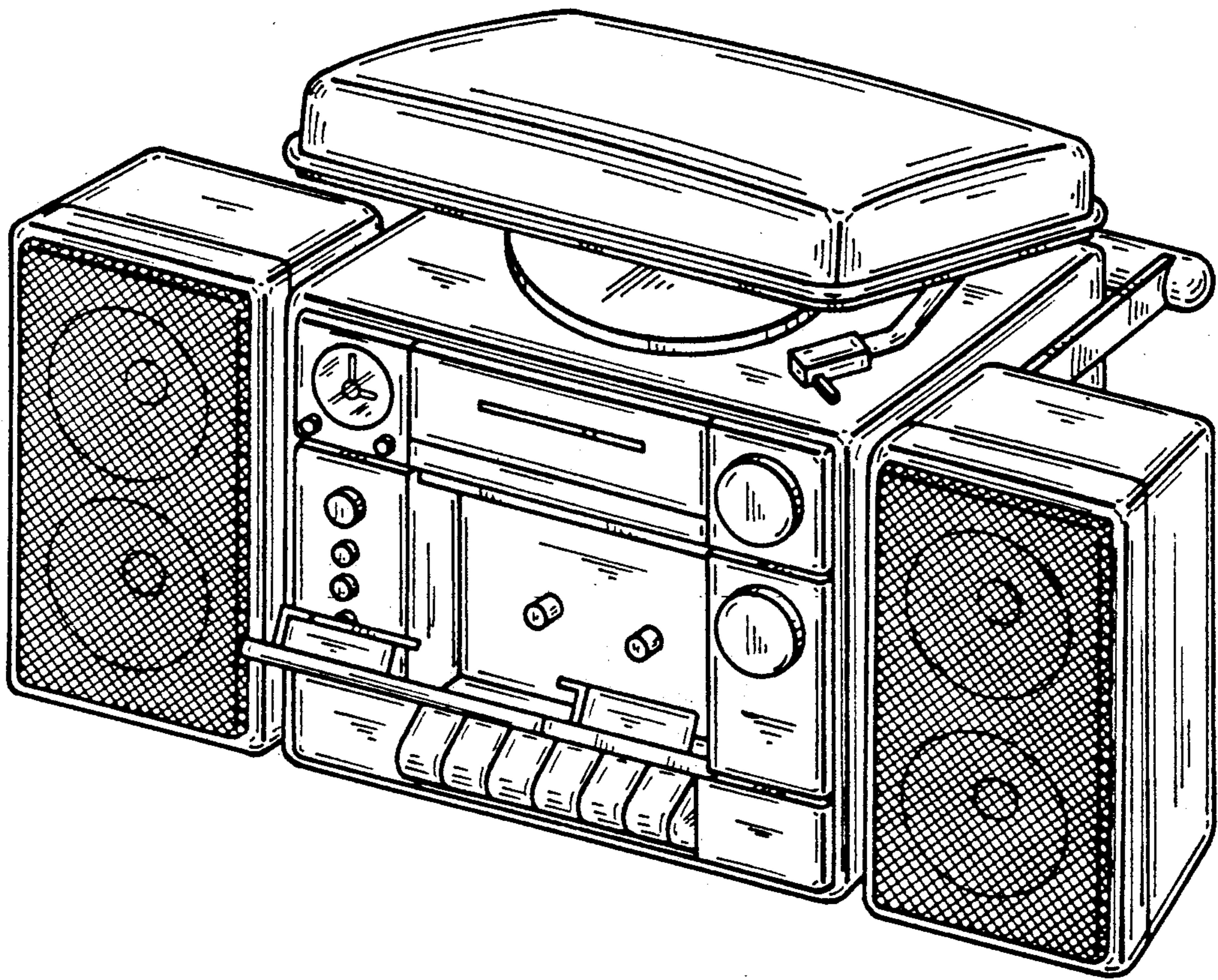
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined record player, radio and tape recorder, as shown and described.

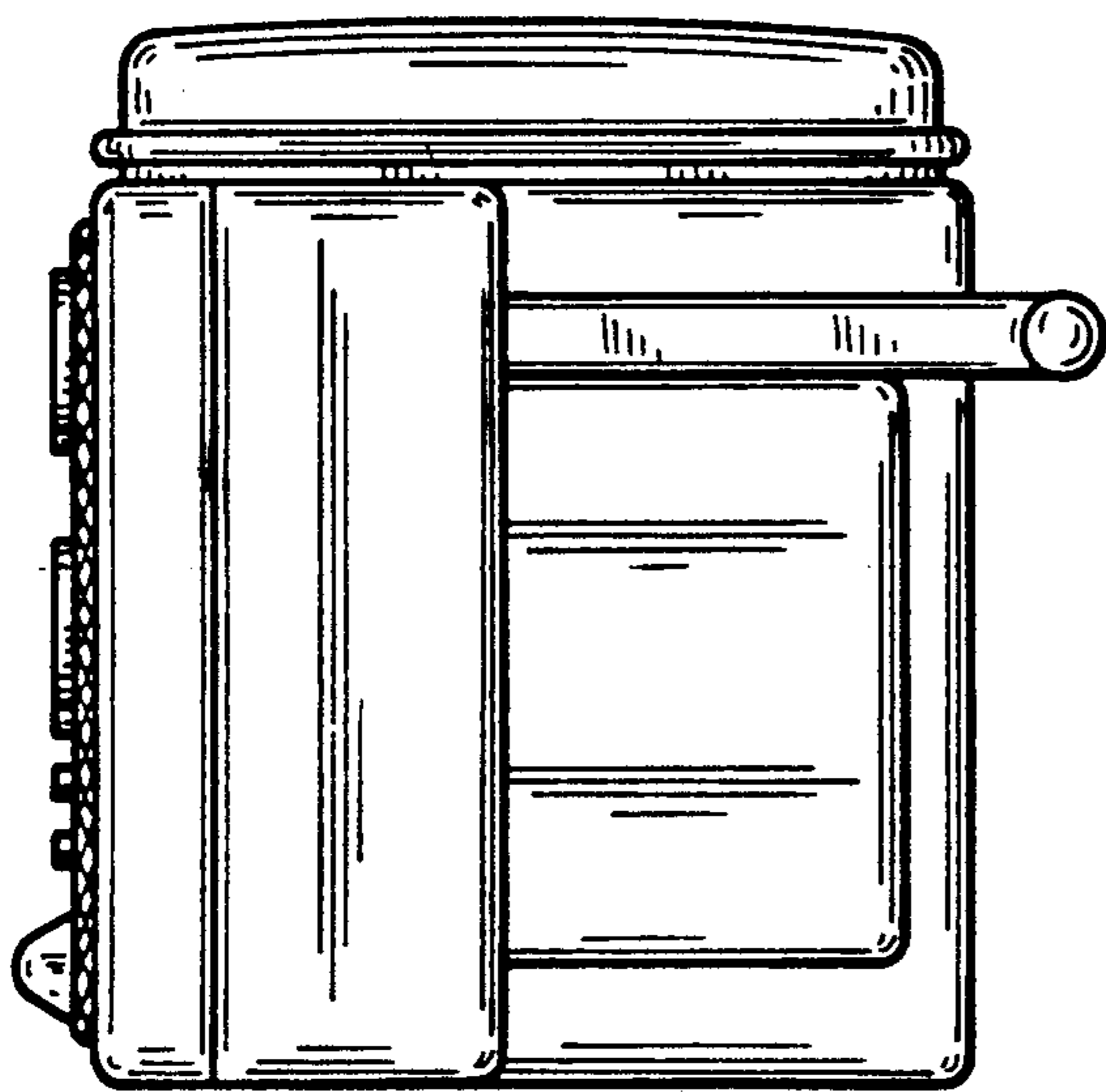
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the combined record player, radio and tape recorder showing my new design with the dust cover open and cassette holder extended; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is left side elevational view thereof.

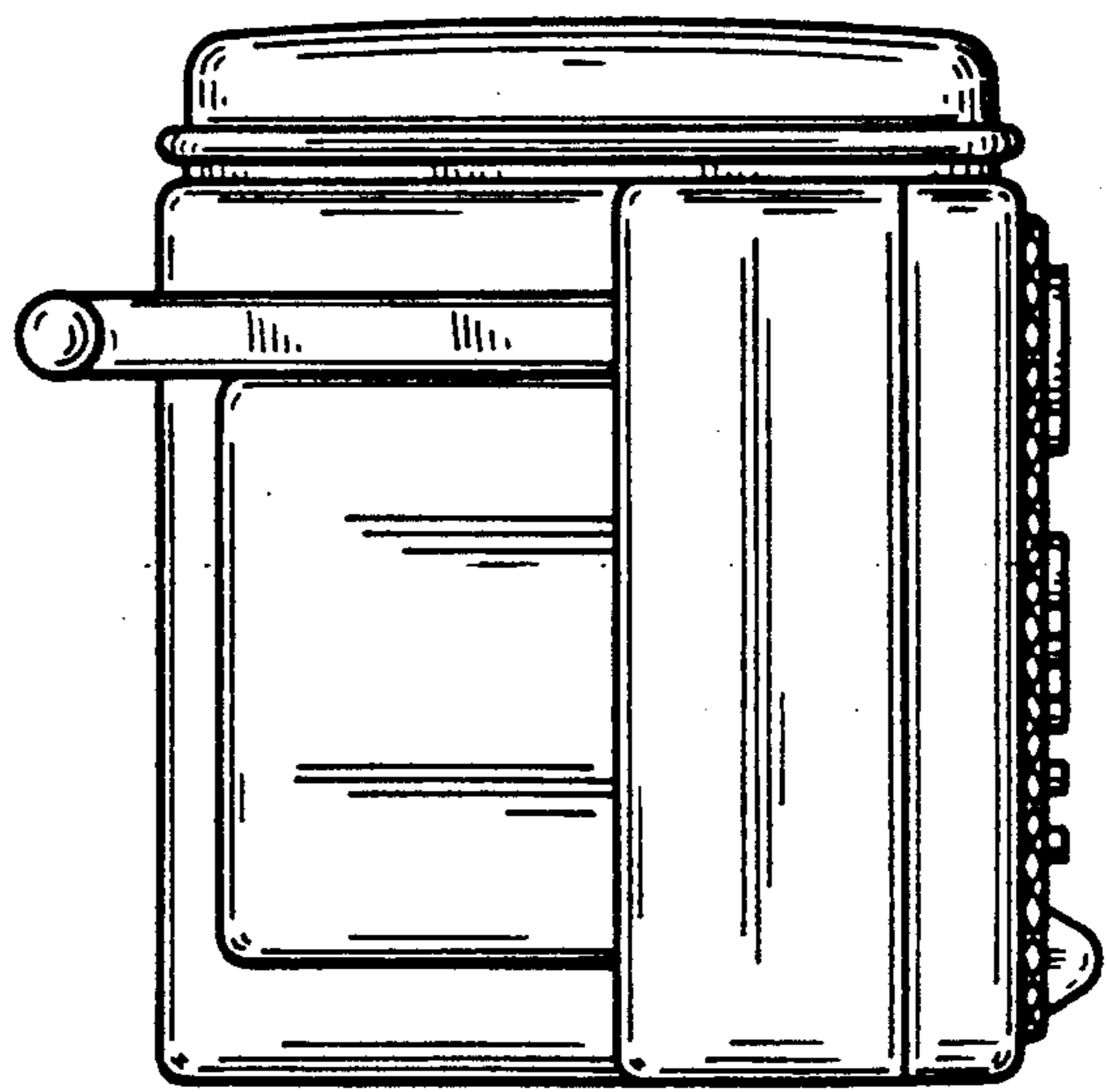




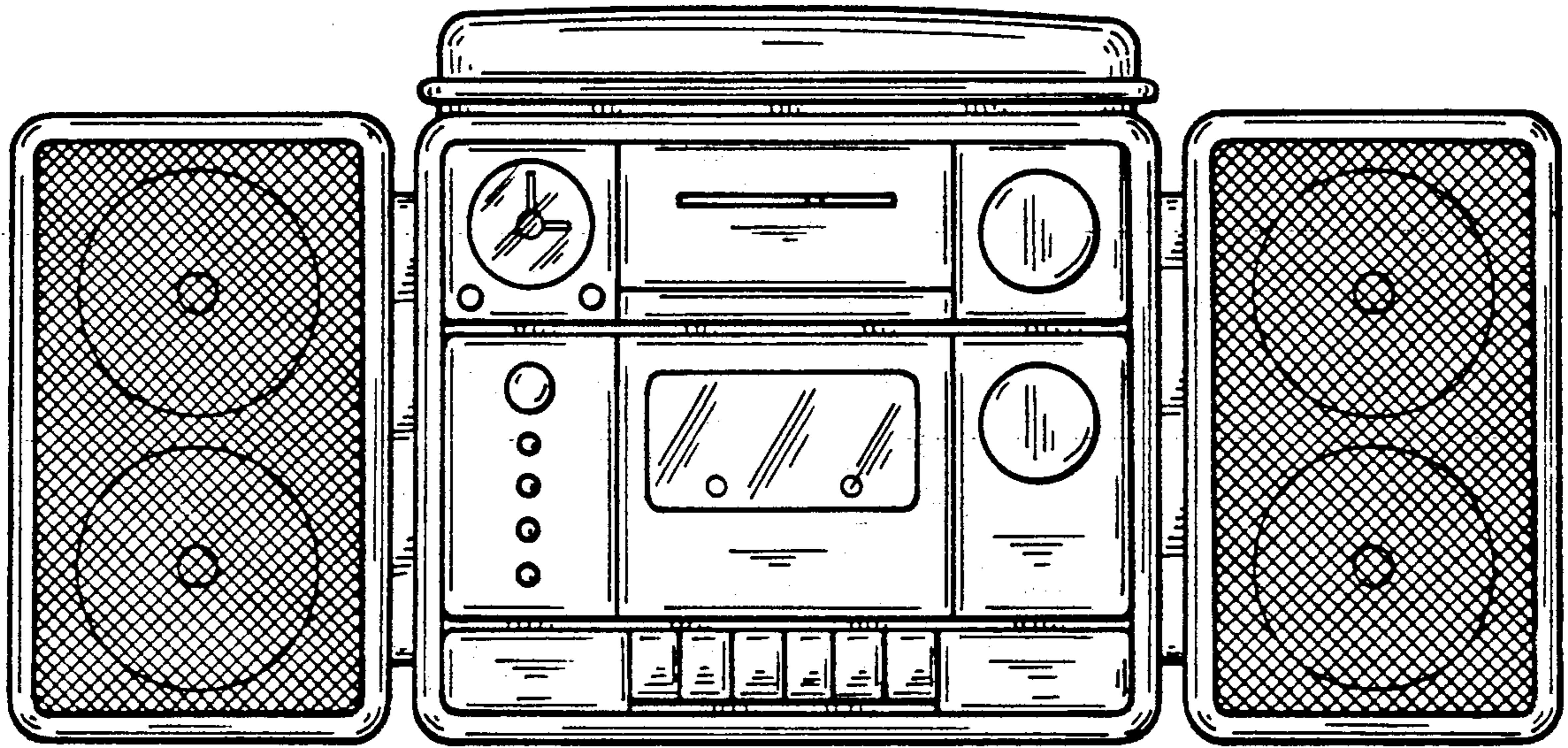

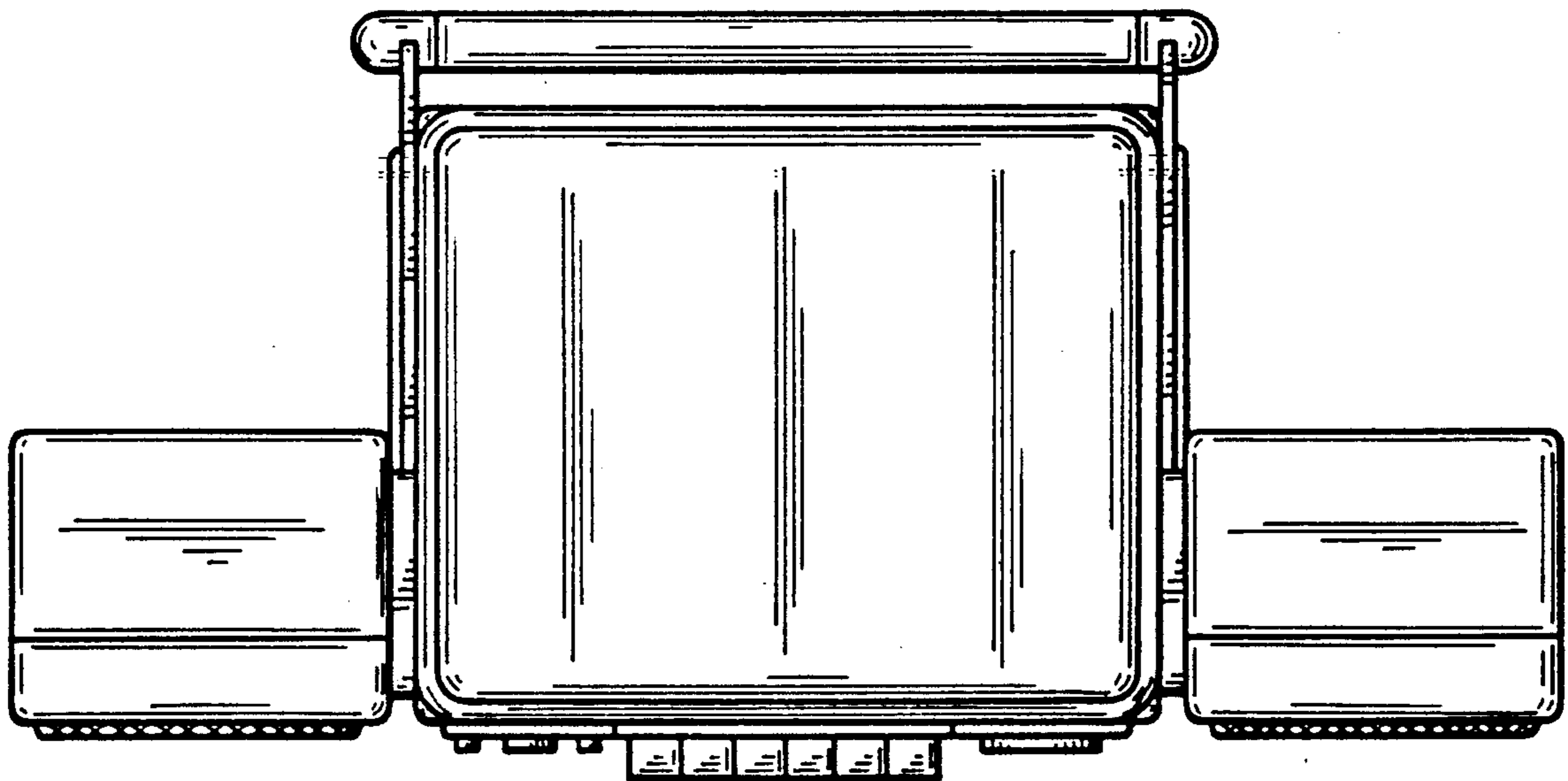

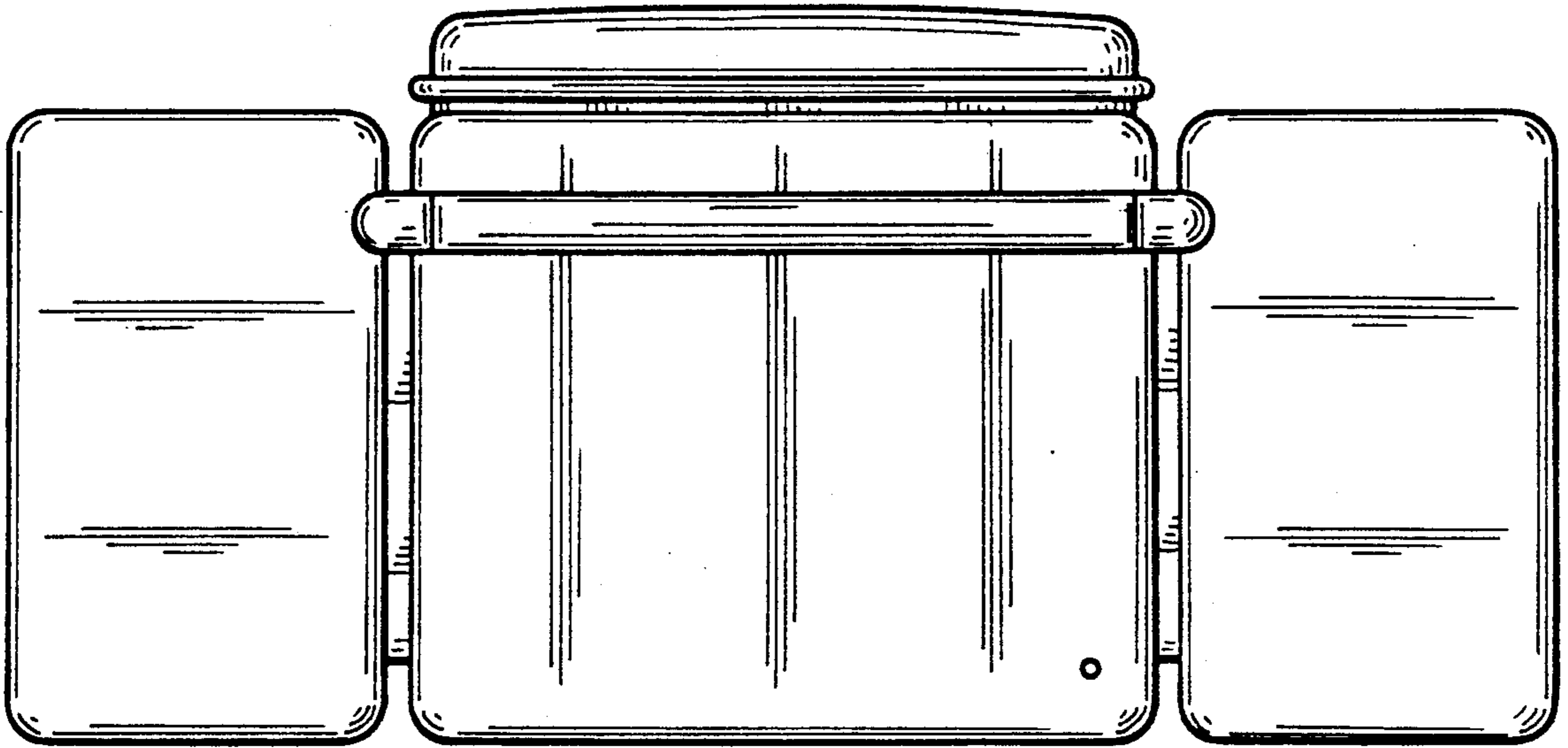

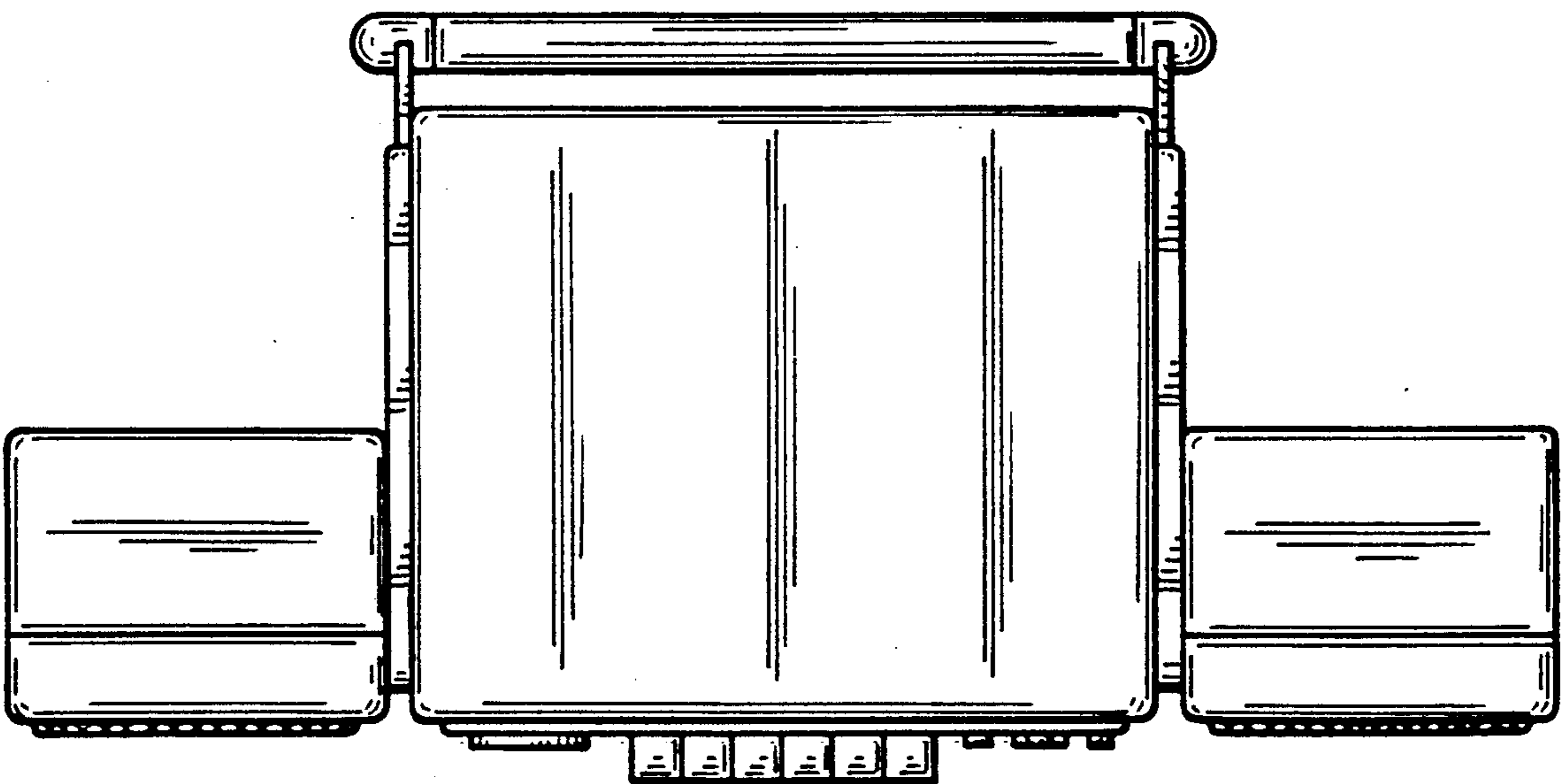
