The ornamental design for a combined pegboard merchandise display hook and label holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a pegboard merchandise display hook and label holder showing my new design;

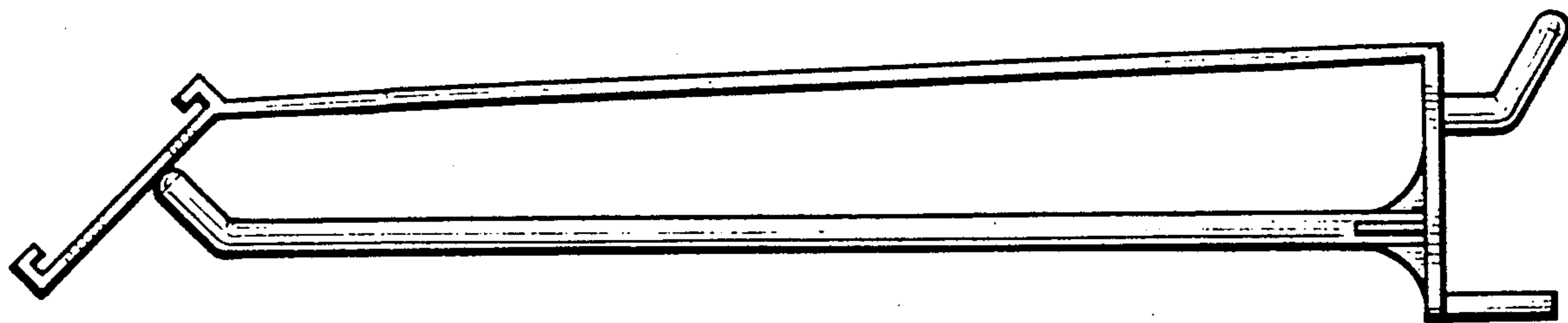
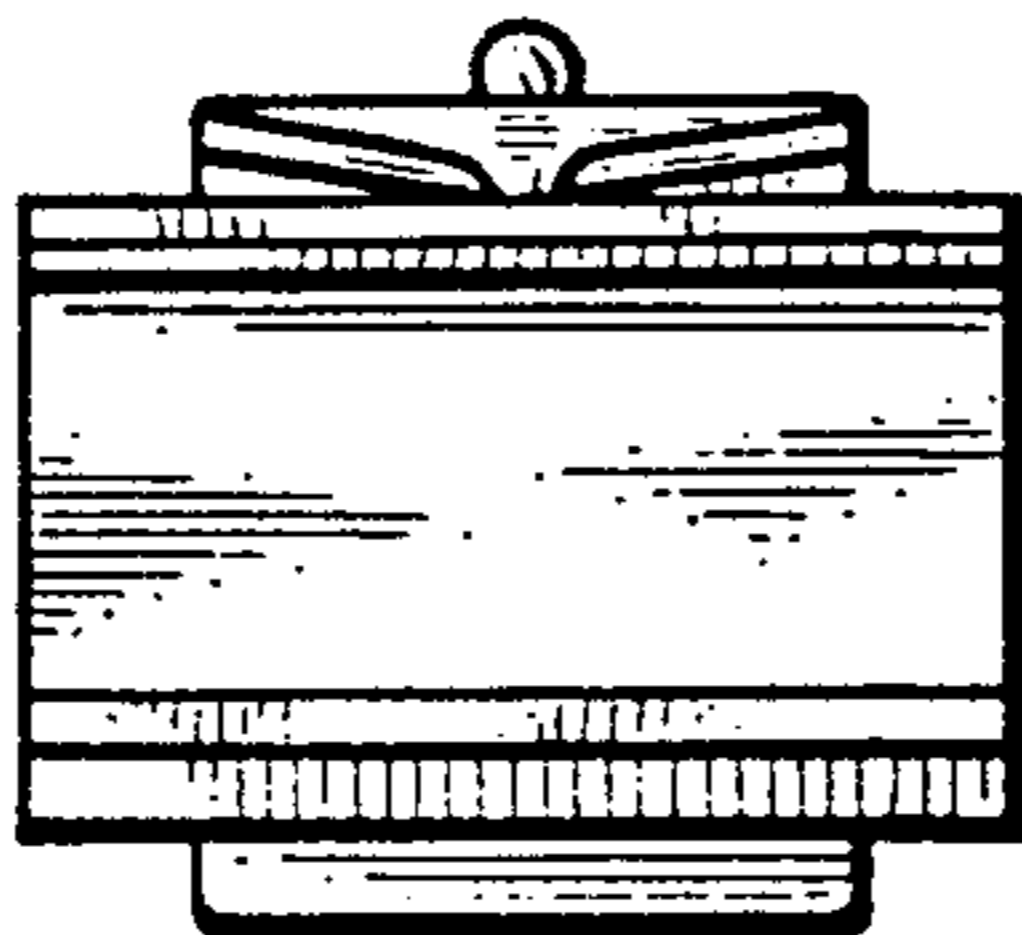
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, with the left side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of an alternate embodiment with the only difference residing in the angle or slant of the hook mounting rectangular plate.



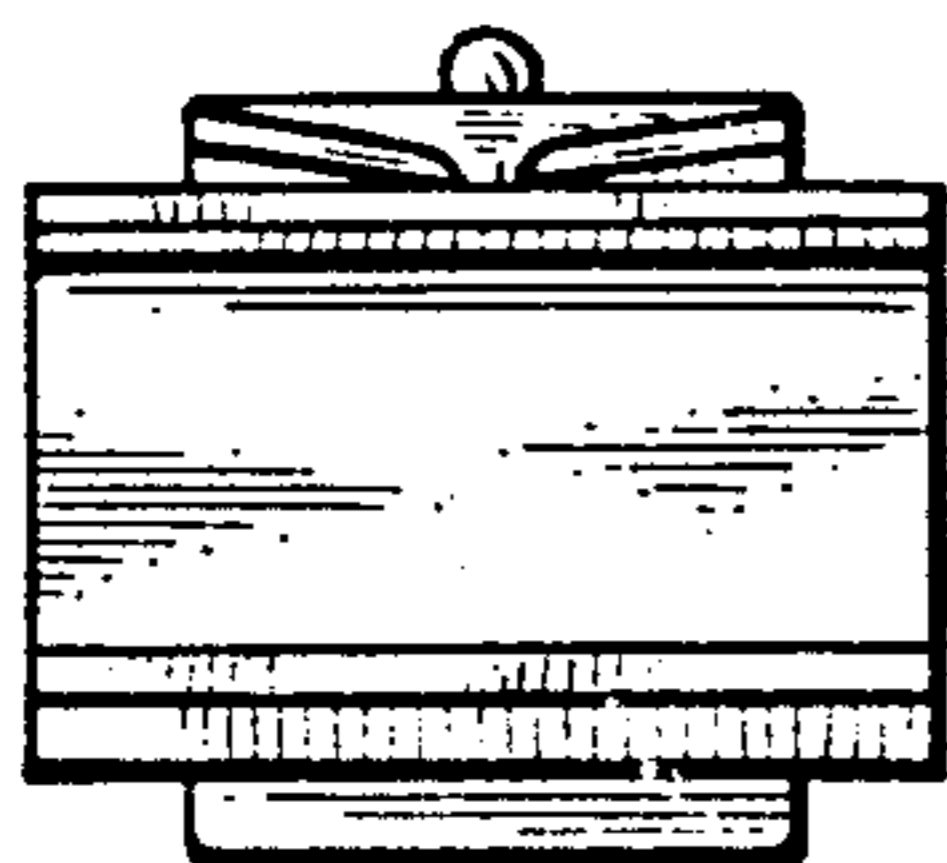

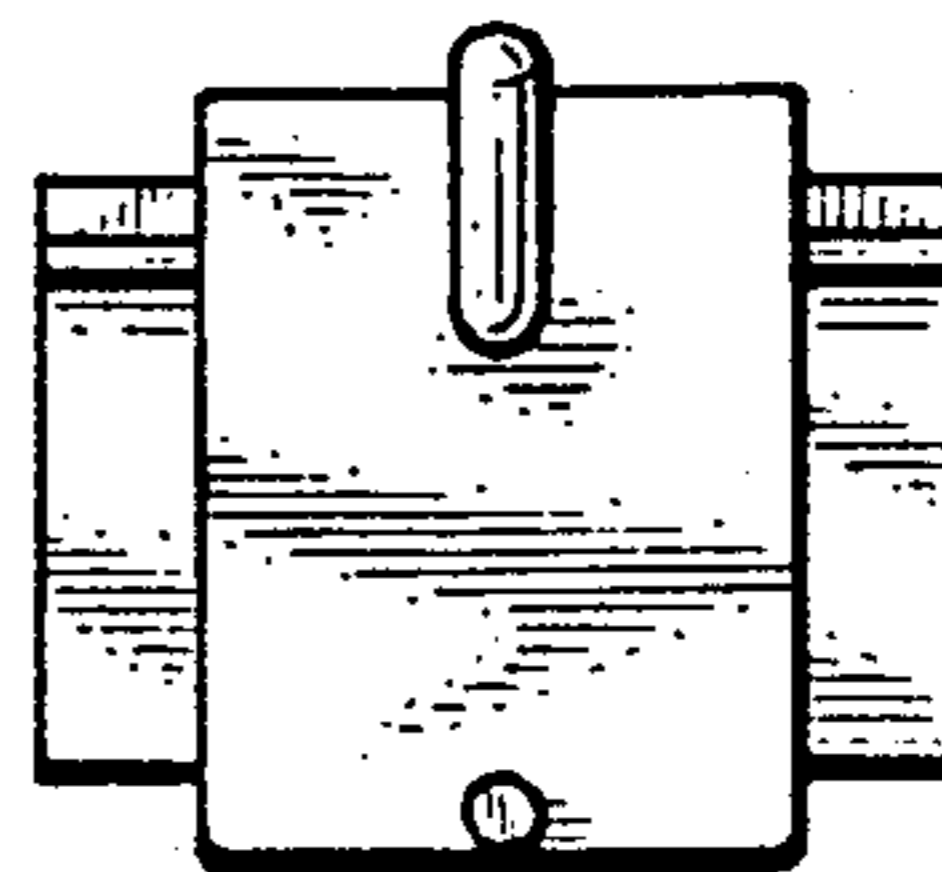

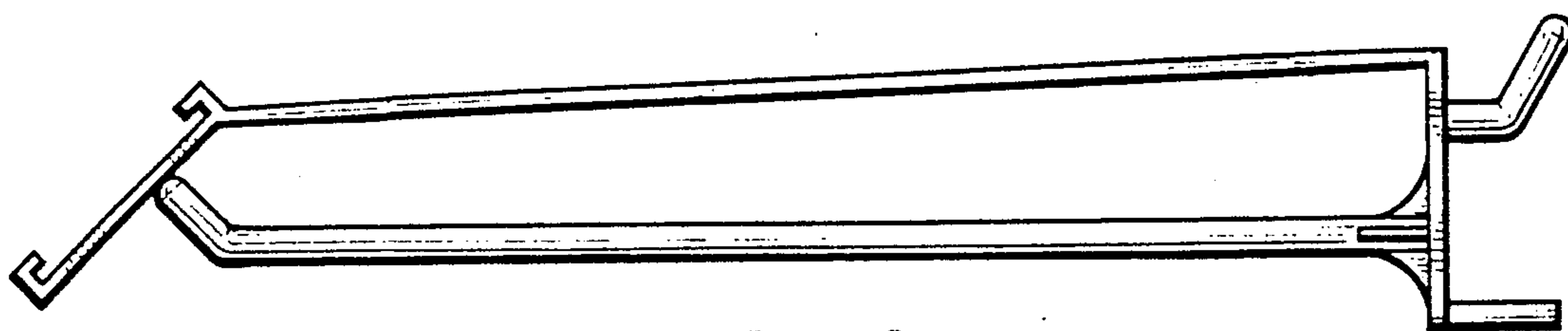

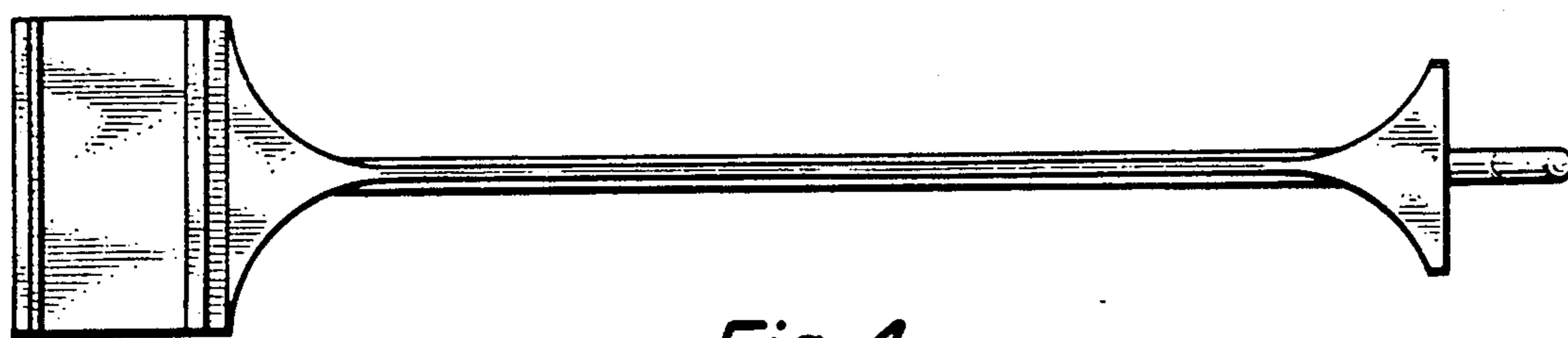

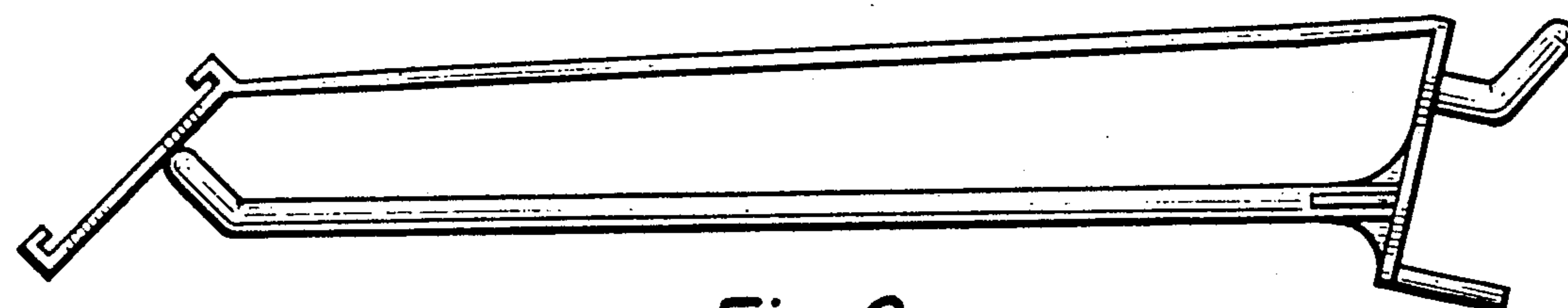
