[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an infant head support for attachment to a child's car seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an infant head support for attachment to a child's car seat showing my new design, with the flap portion wrapped around the child's car seat shoulder belt, which is shown in broken-lines to indicate that it is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

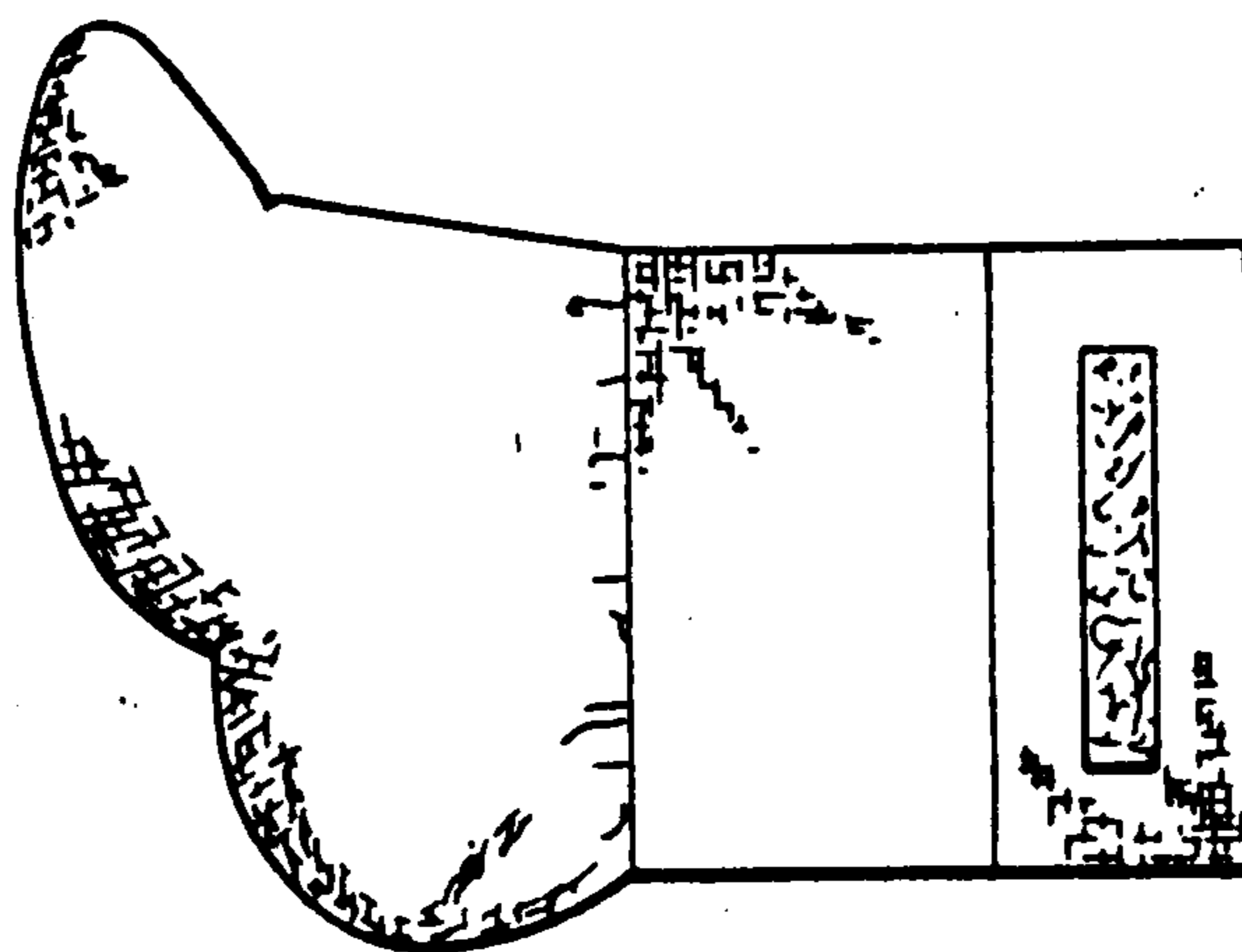
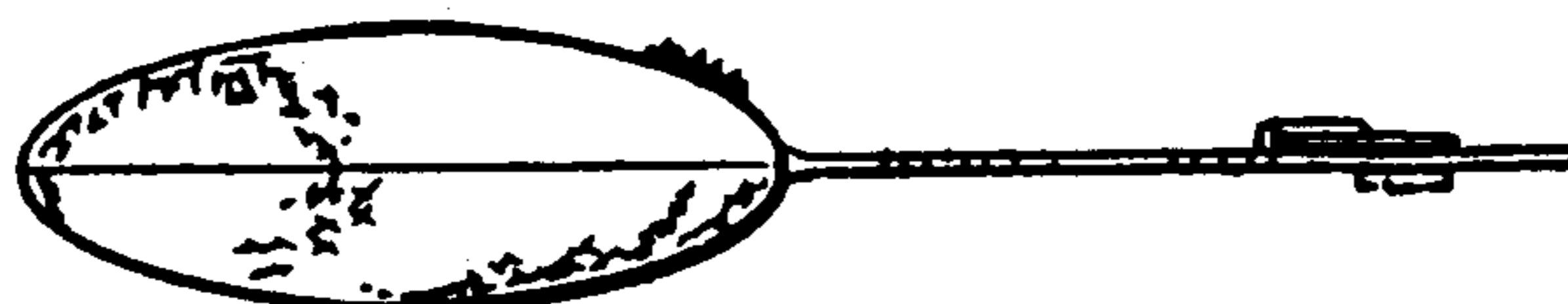
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

The cross-hatching shown in the views if understood to represent conventional cloth fabric.



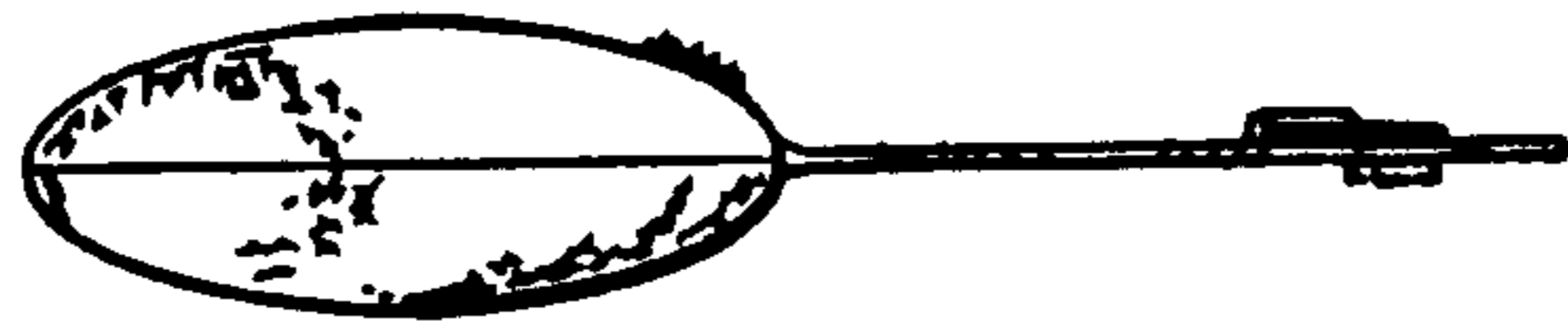

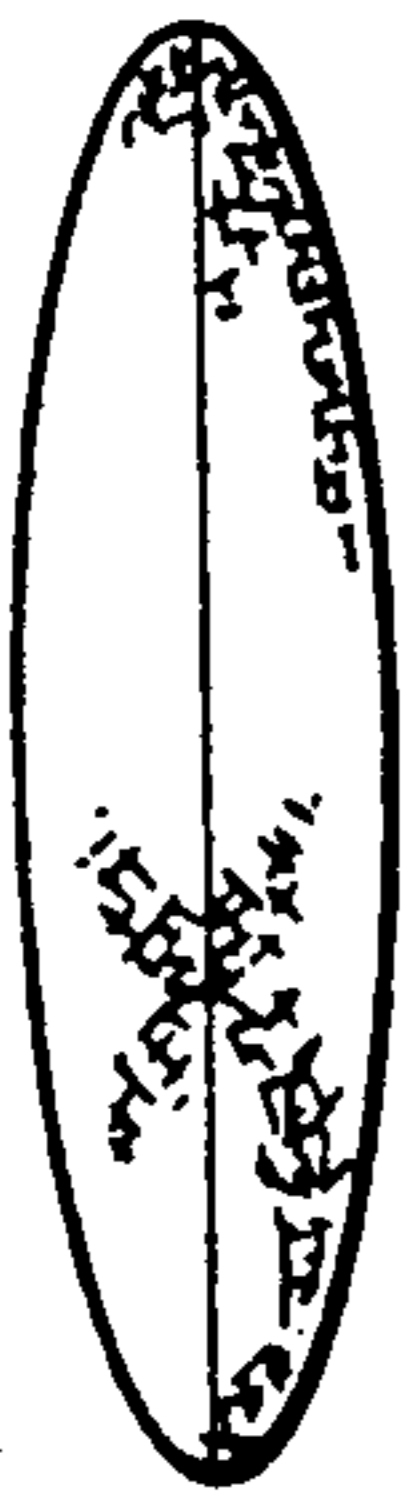

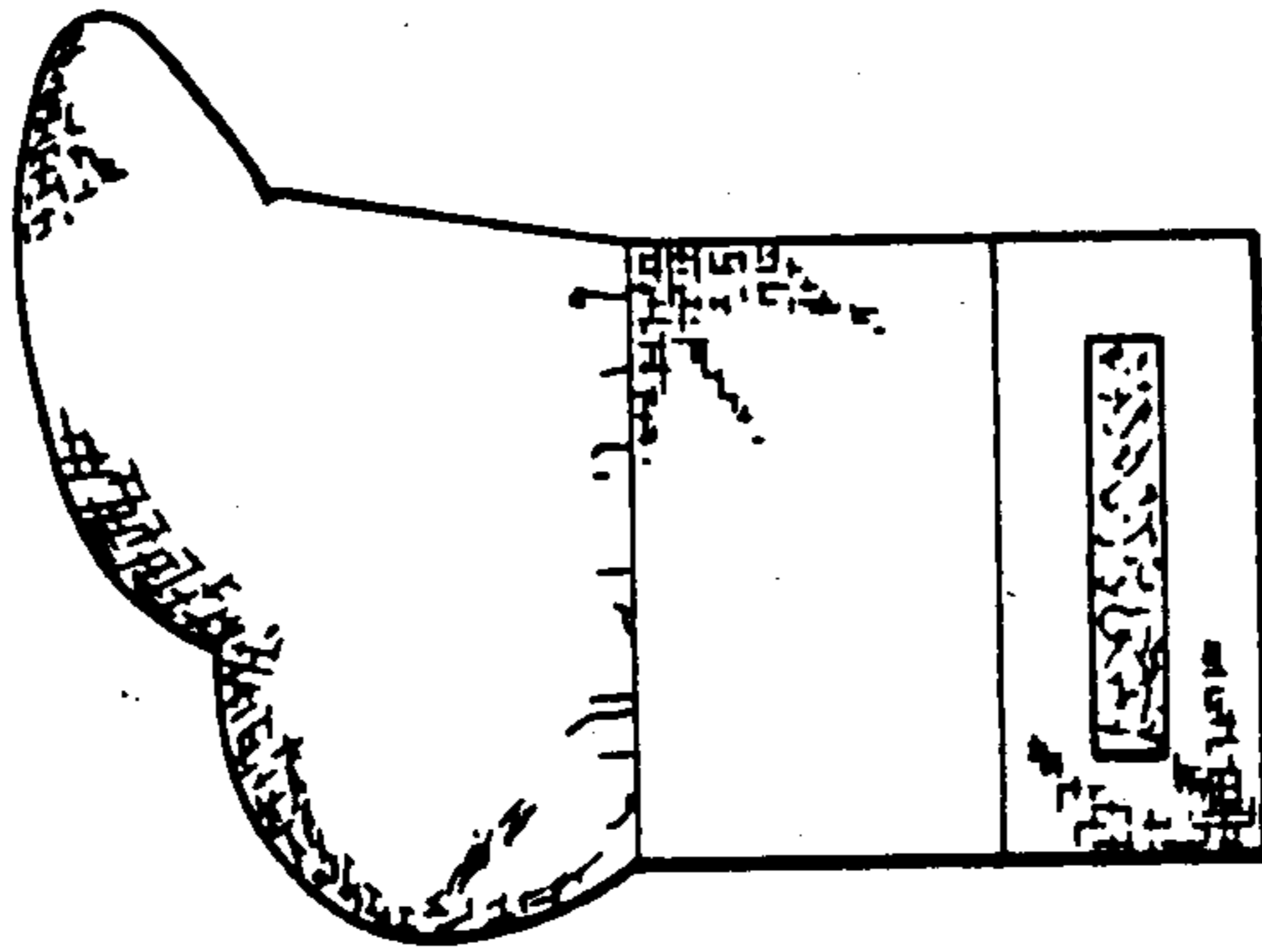

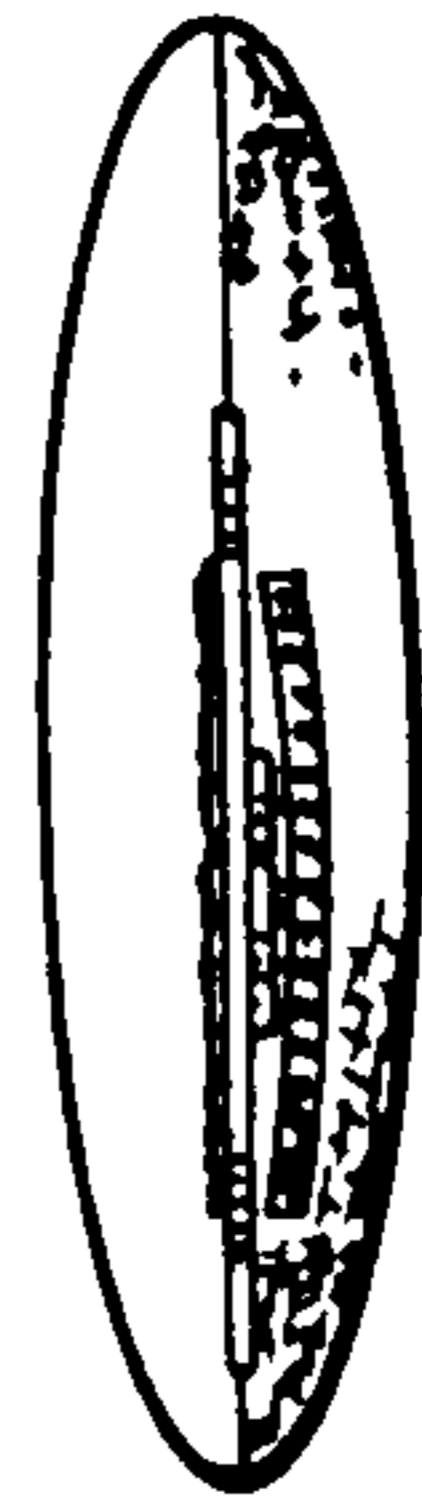

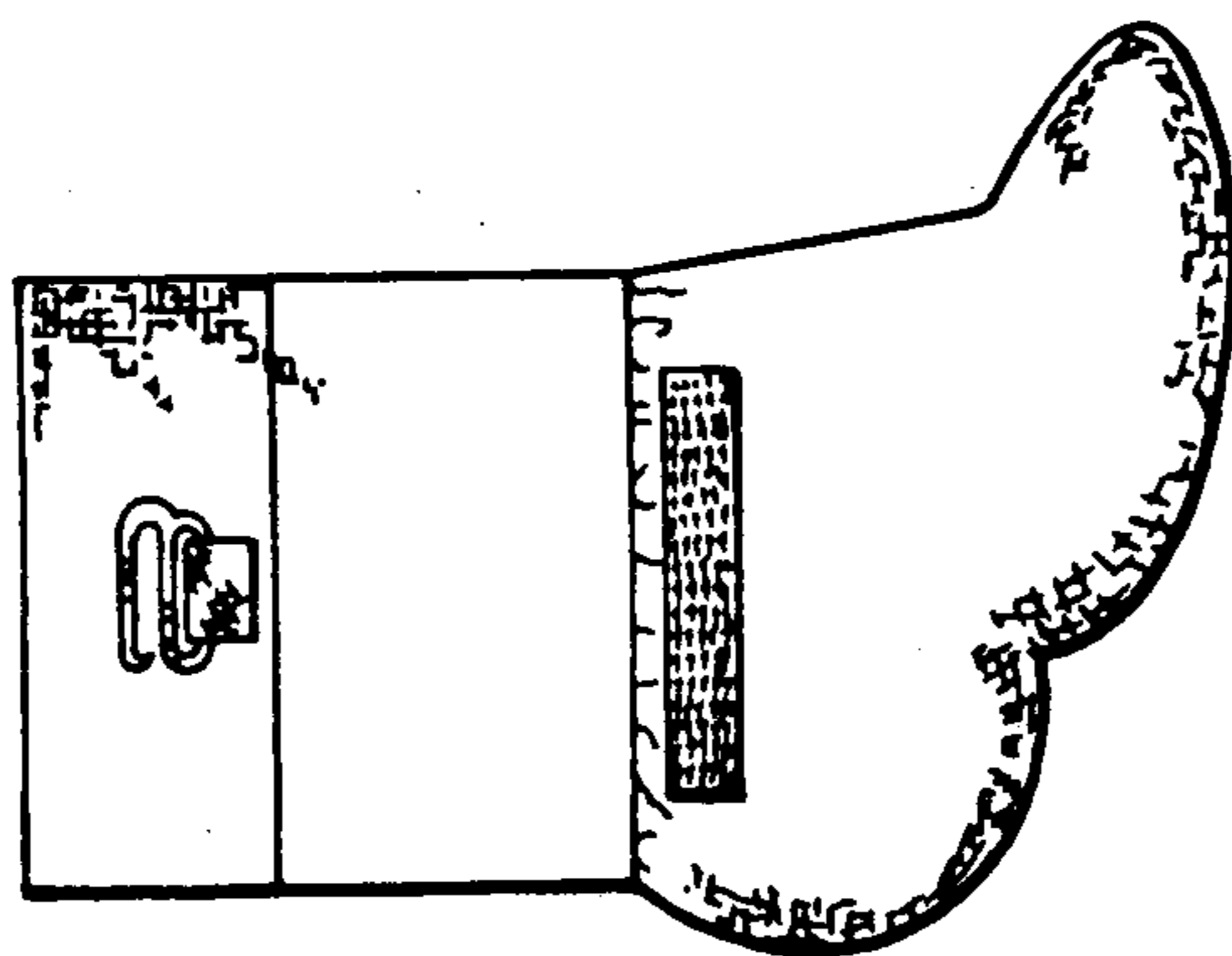
