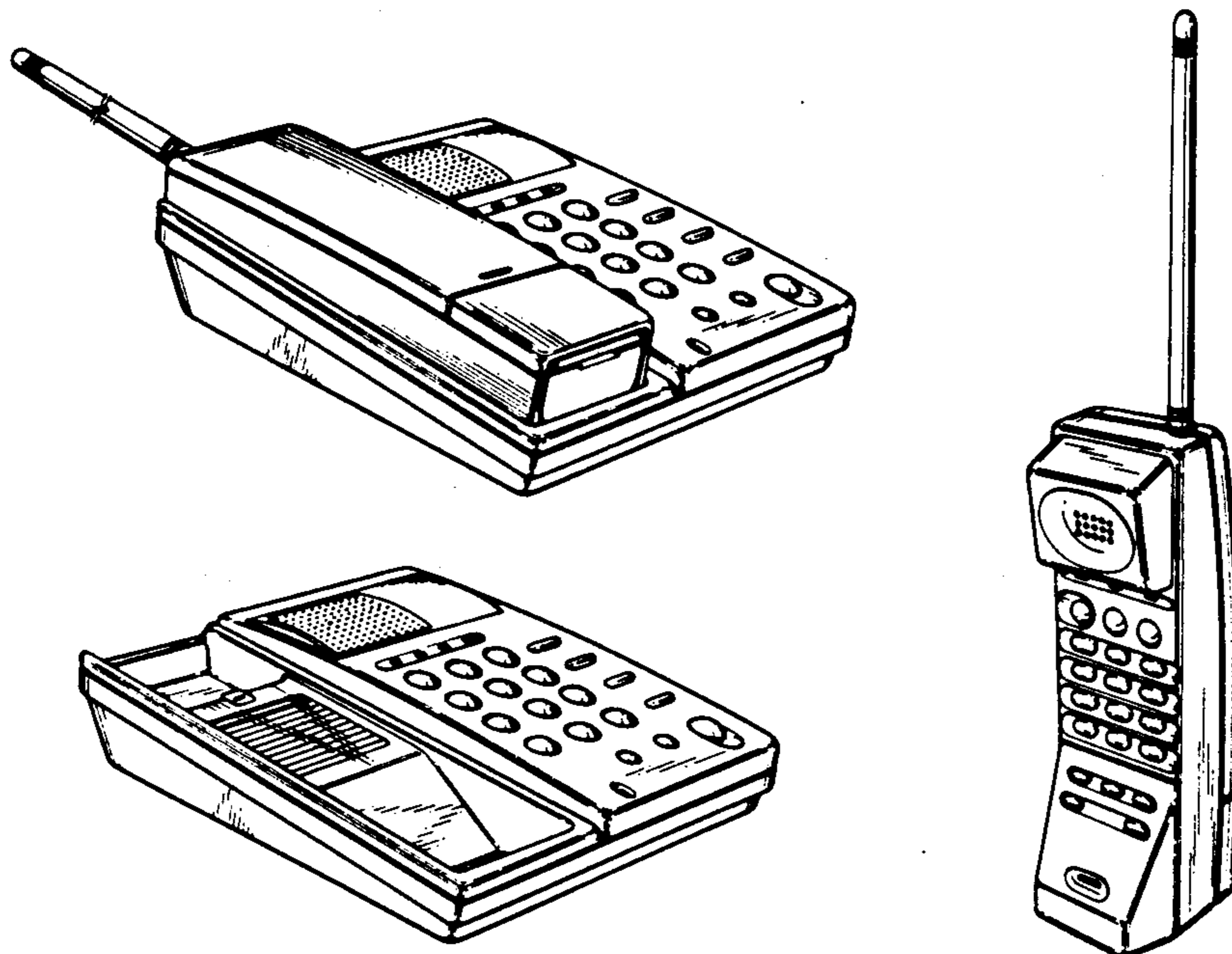

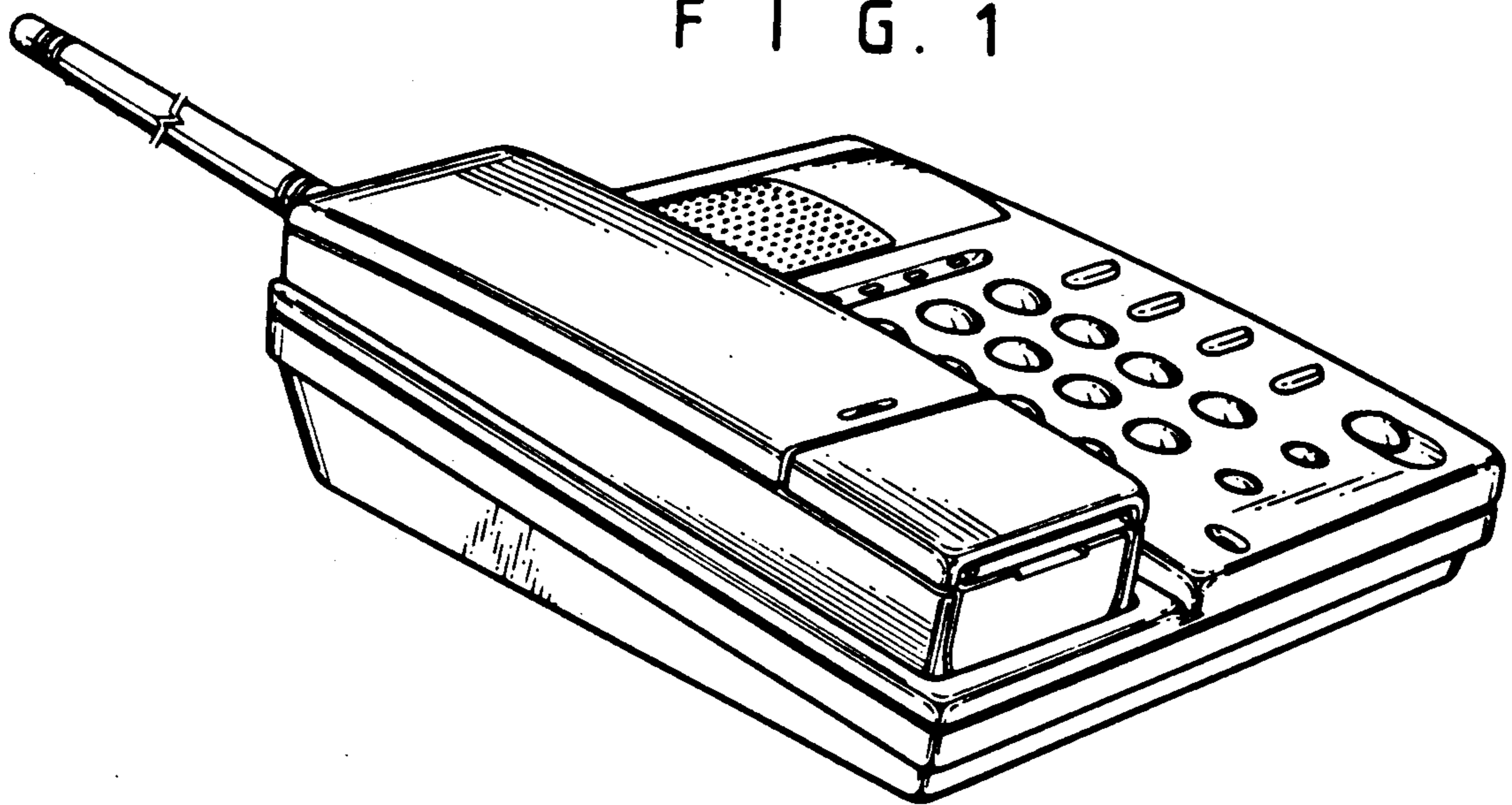
The ornamental design for a combined cordless handset, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

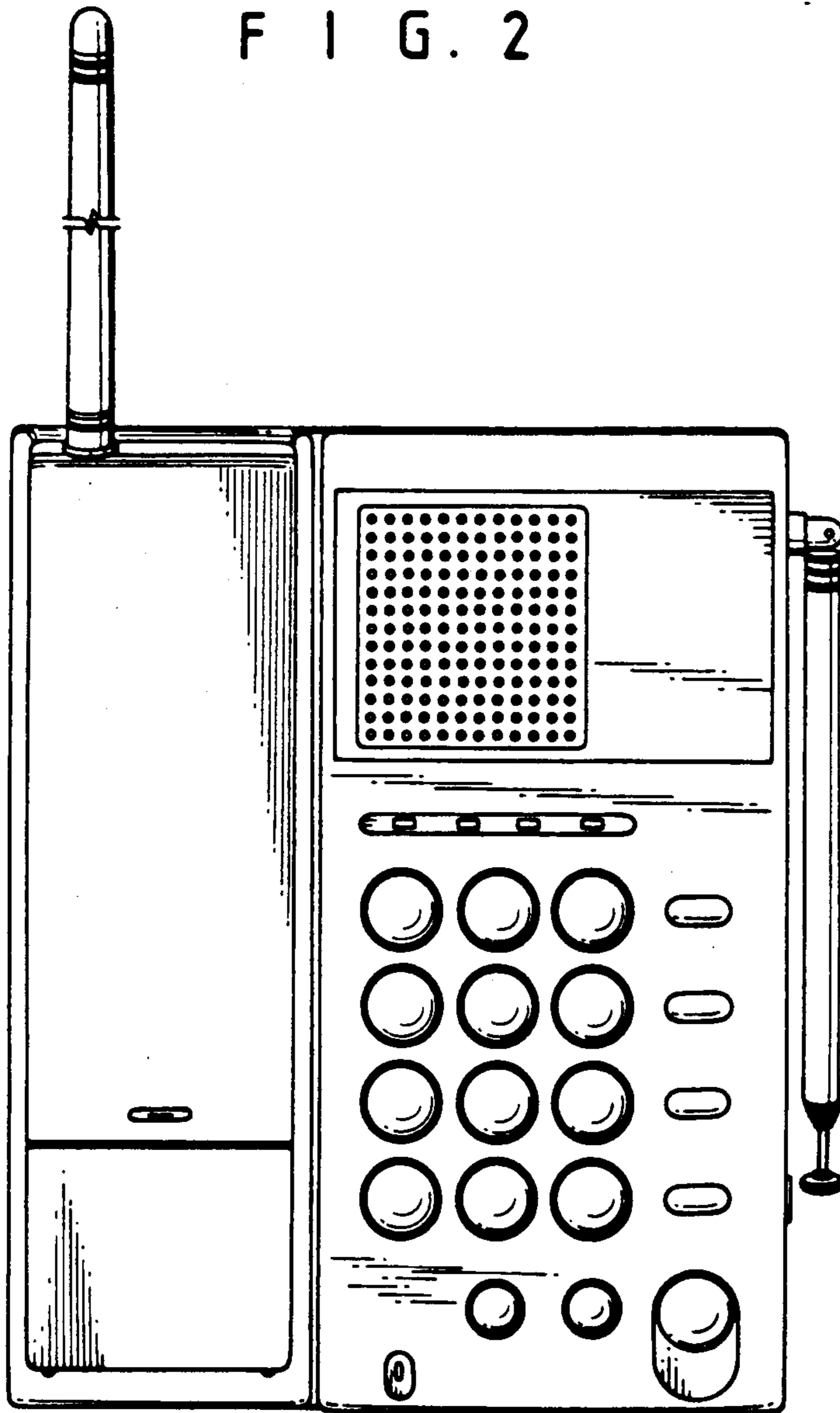
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined cordless handset set showing my new design in cradled relationship;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the set in cradled relationship;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIGS. 6 and 7 are respectively right and left elevational views thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a left side, top and front perspective view of the base unit of the set with the handset unit removed;
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the base unit shown alone;
 FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the base unit shown alone;
 FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of the base unit alone;
 FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIGS. 13 and 14 are respectively right and left side elevational views of the base unit alone;
 FIG. 15 is a front, top and right side perspective view of the handset telephone unit shown alone in vertical position;
 FIGS. 16 and 17 are respectively top and bottom plan views of the handset telephone shown alone;
 FIGS. 18 and 19 are respectively right and left side elevational views thereof; and
 FIGS. 20 and 21 are respectively top and rear plan views thereof, of the handset telephone unit of the set shown alone in horizontal position.



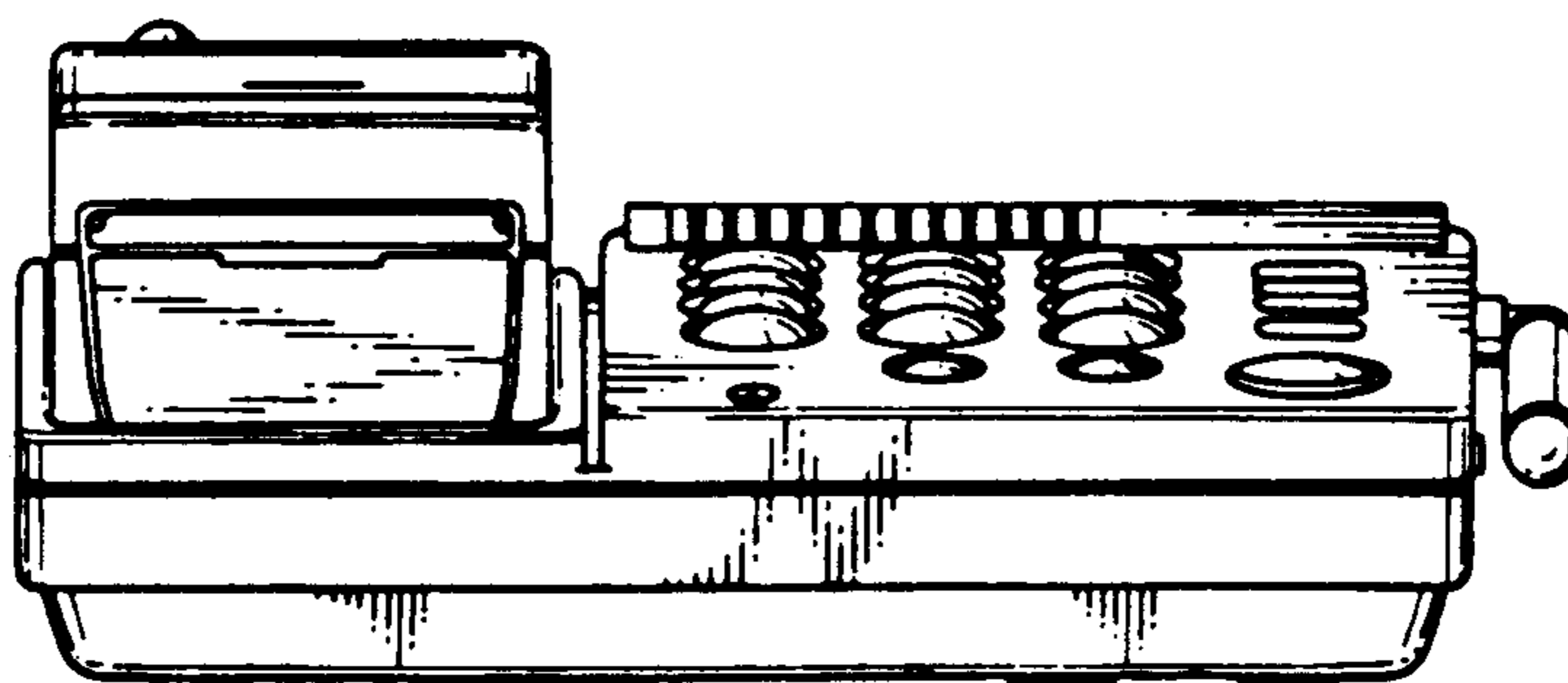

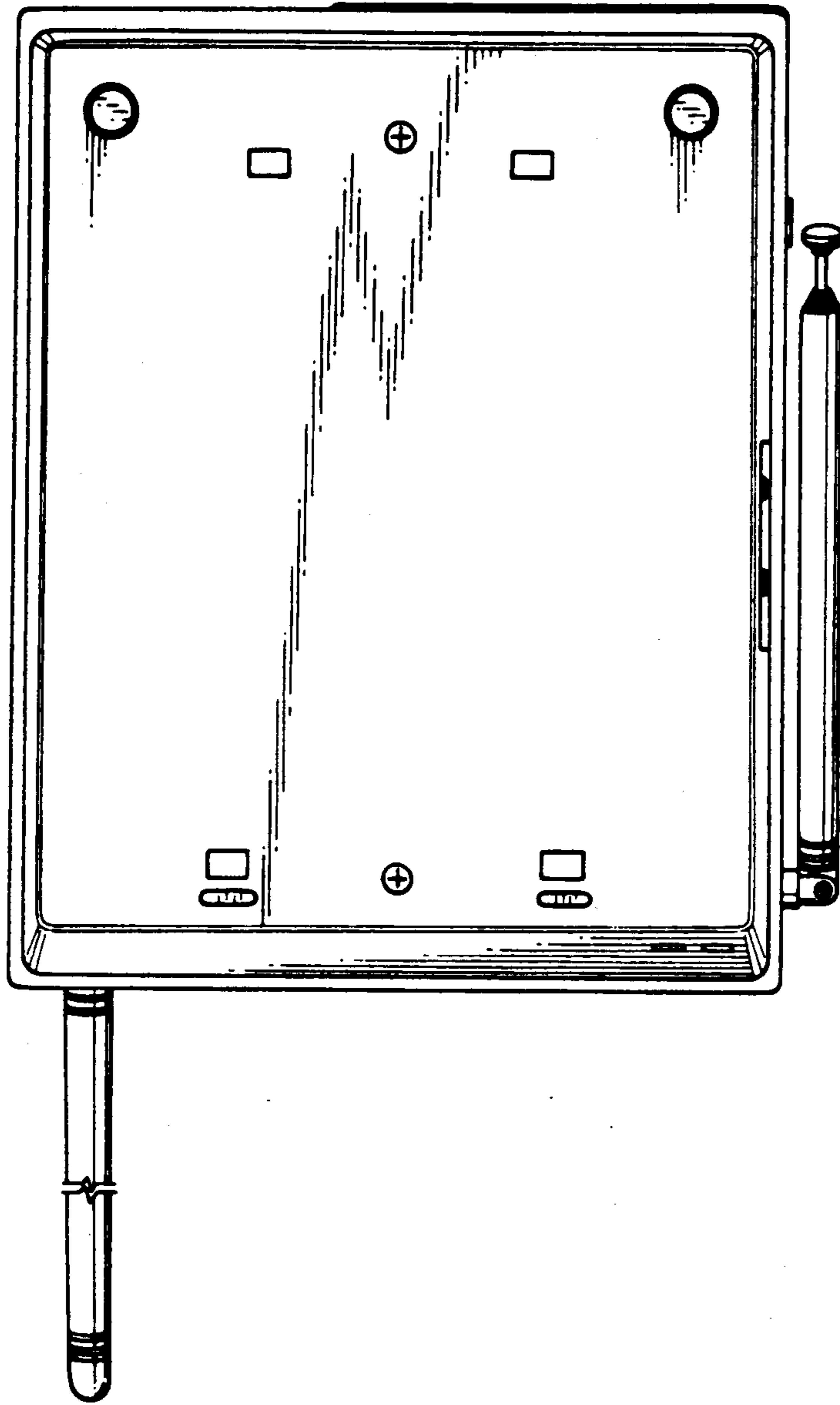

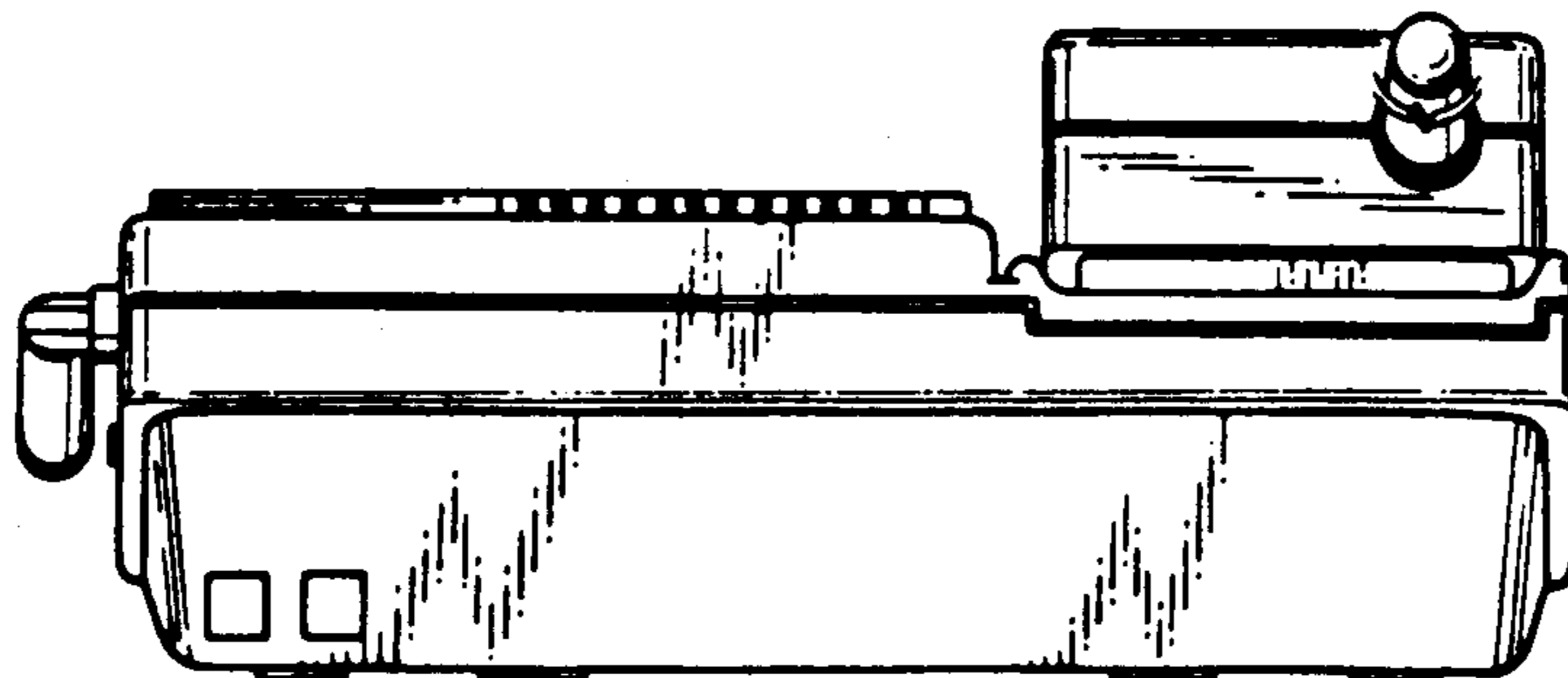

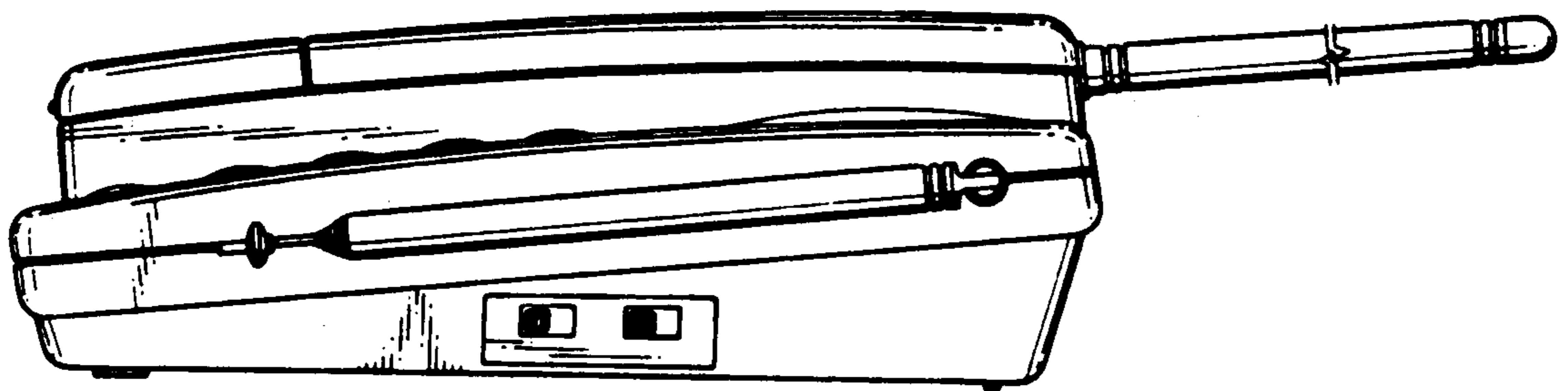

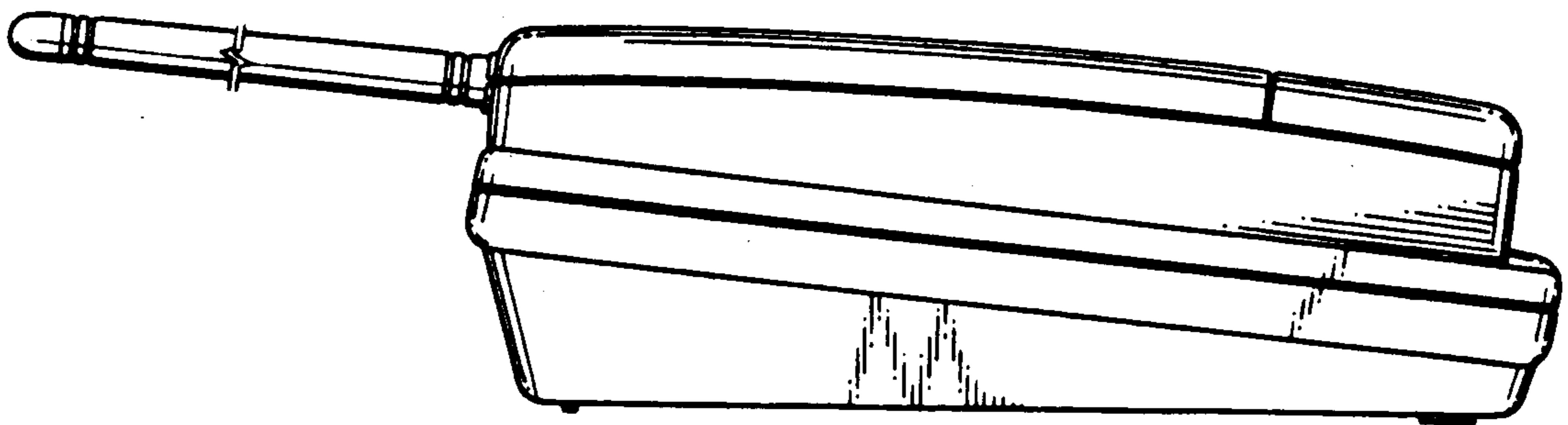

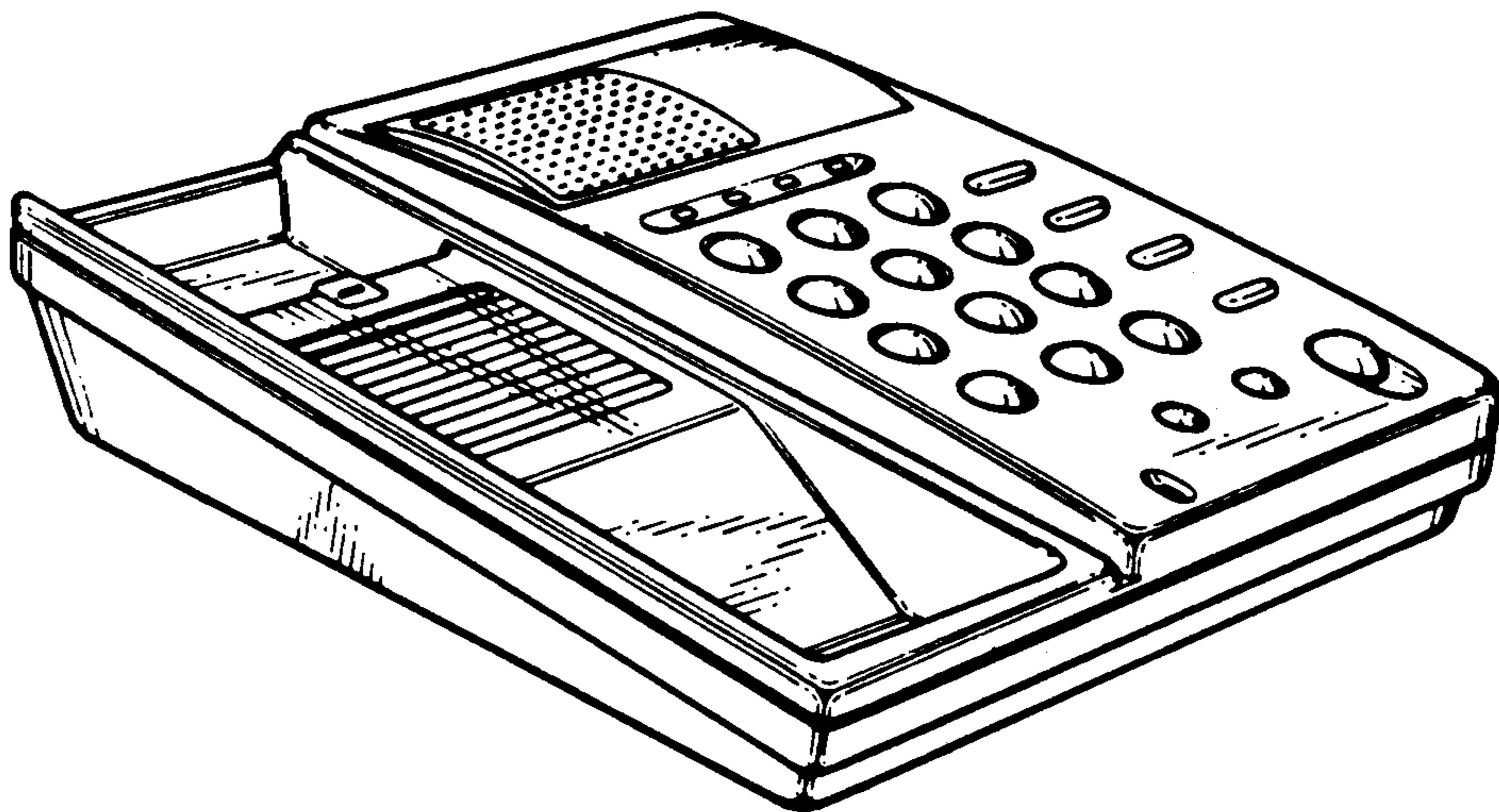

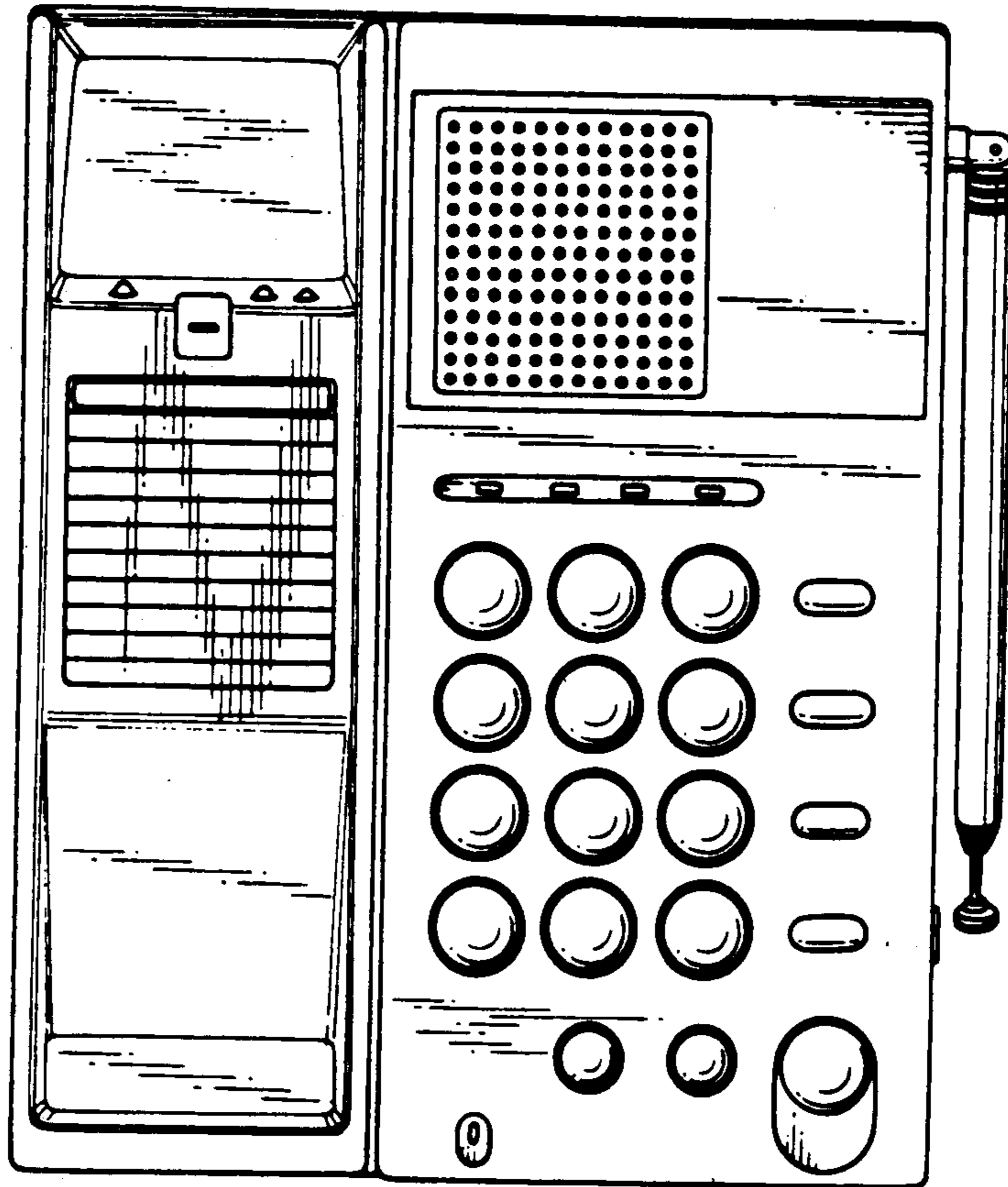

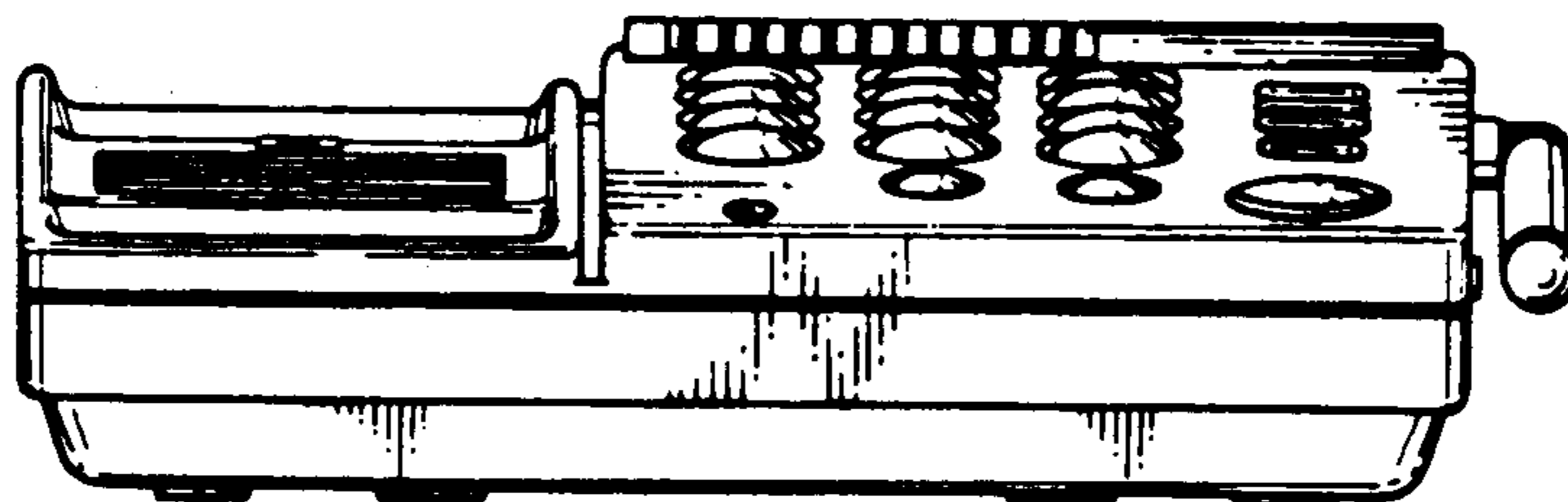

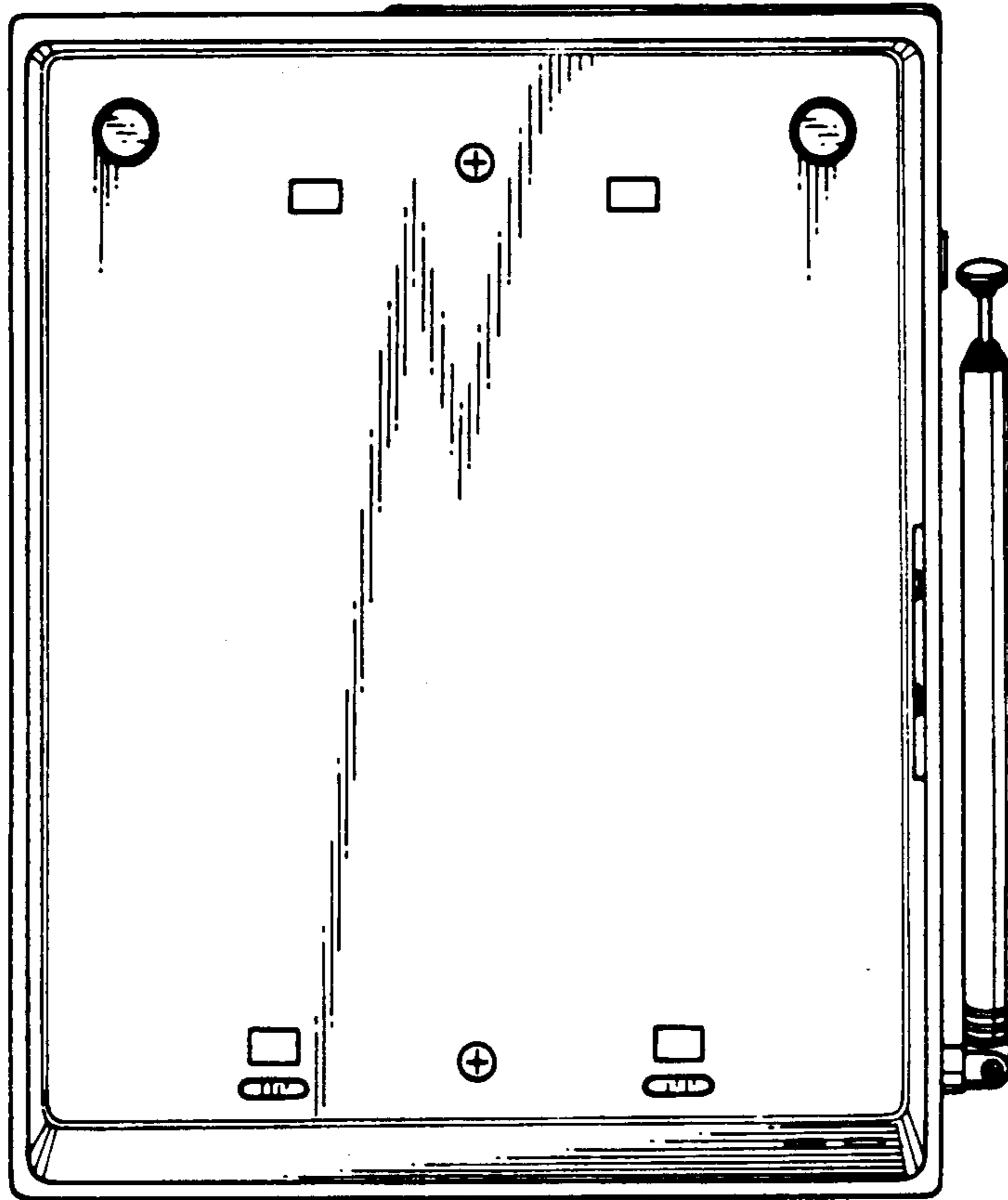

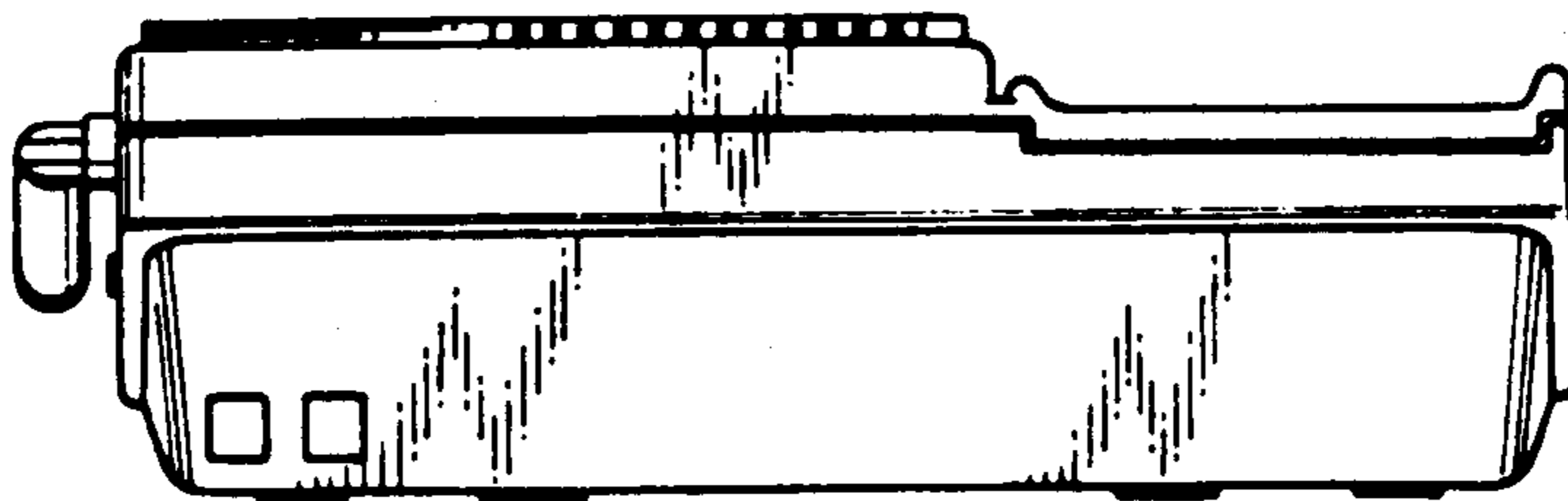

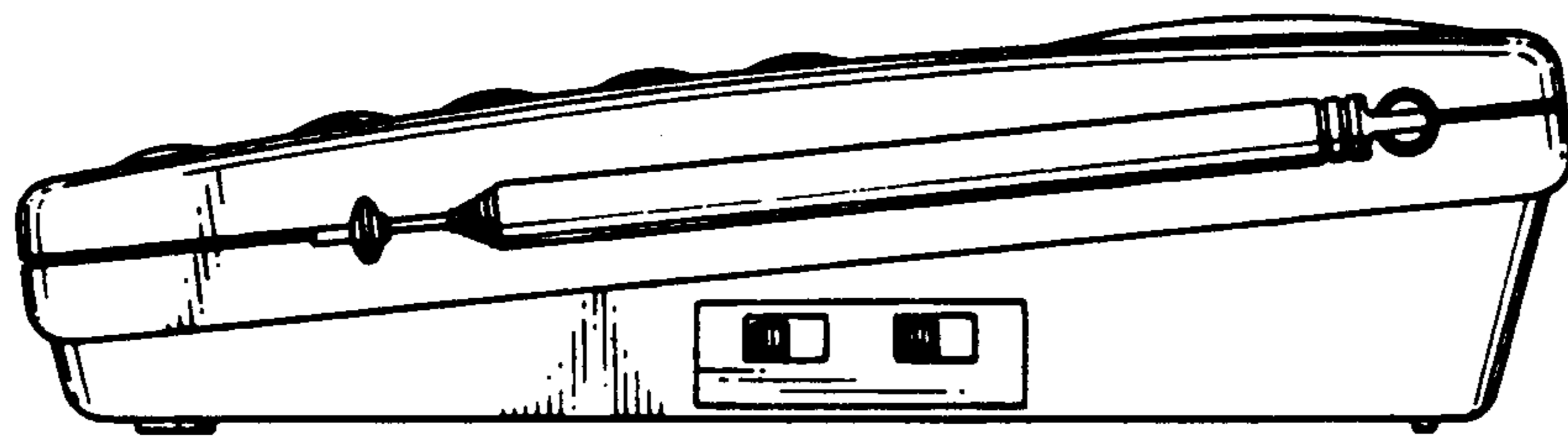

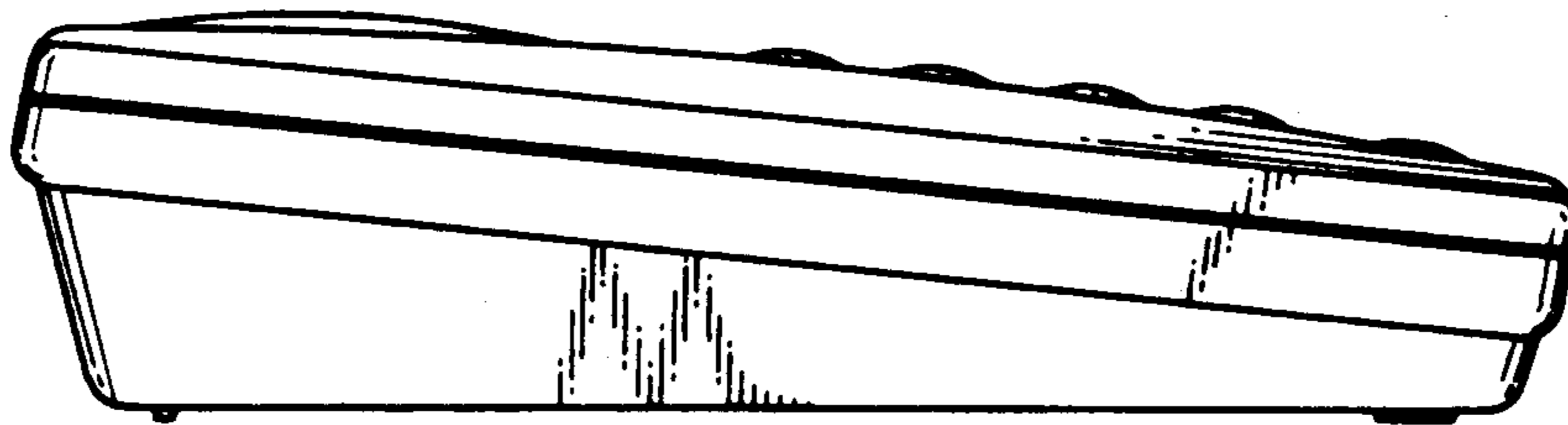

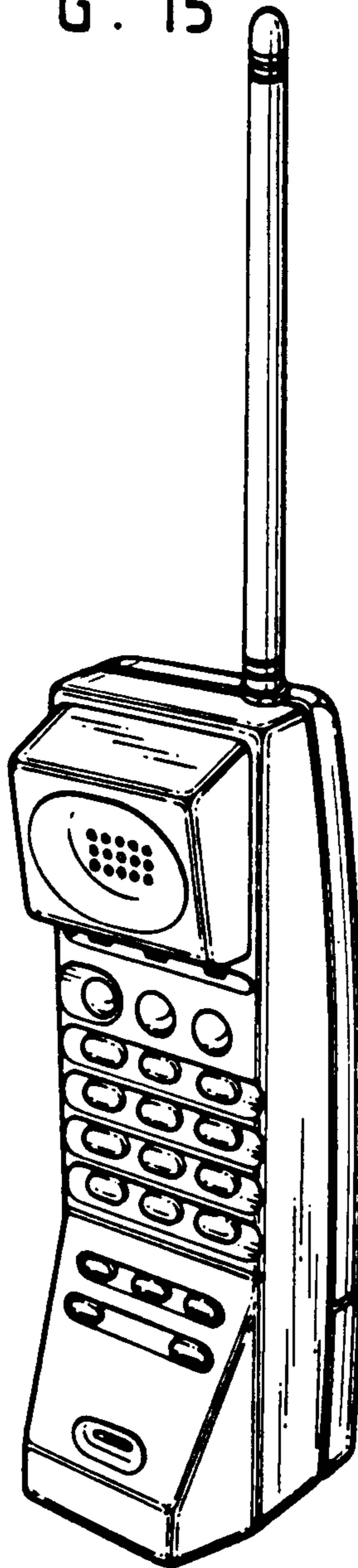

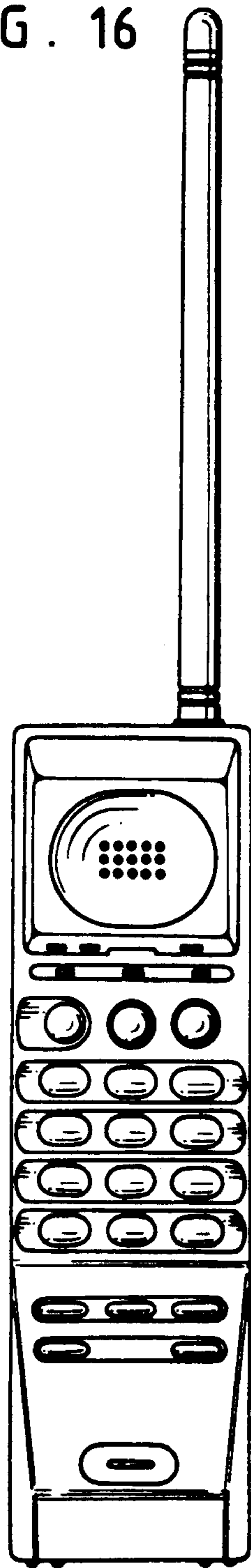

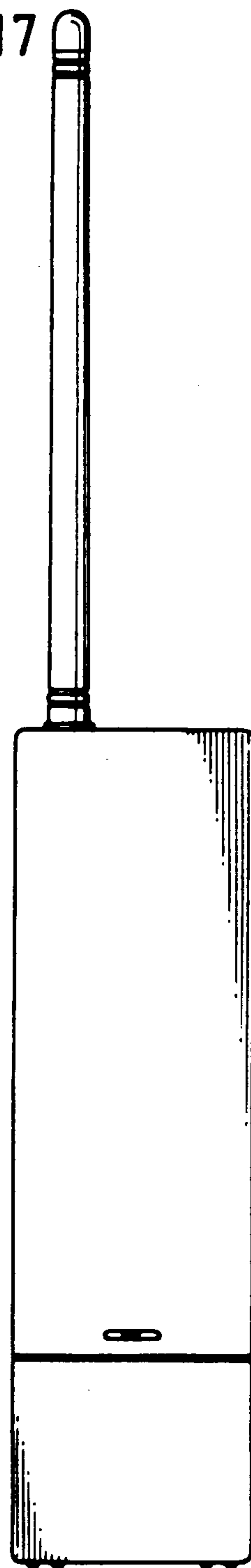

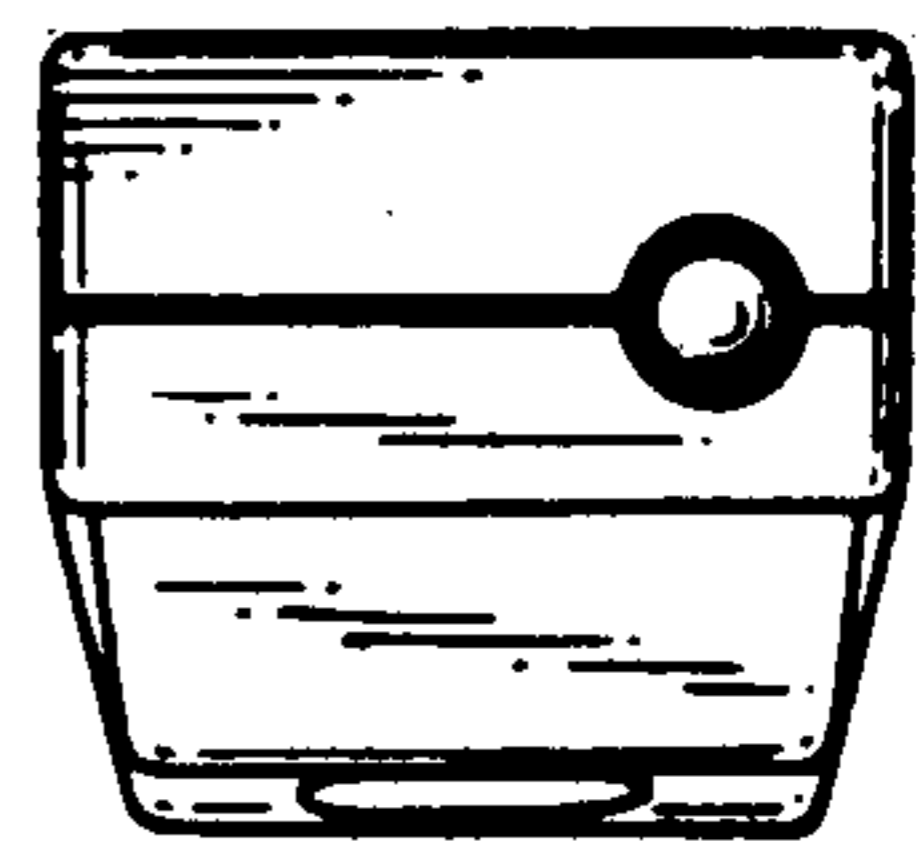
