DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a suppository, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

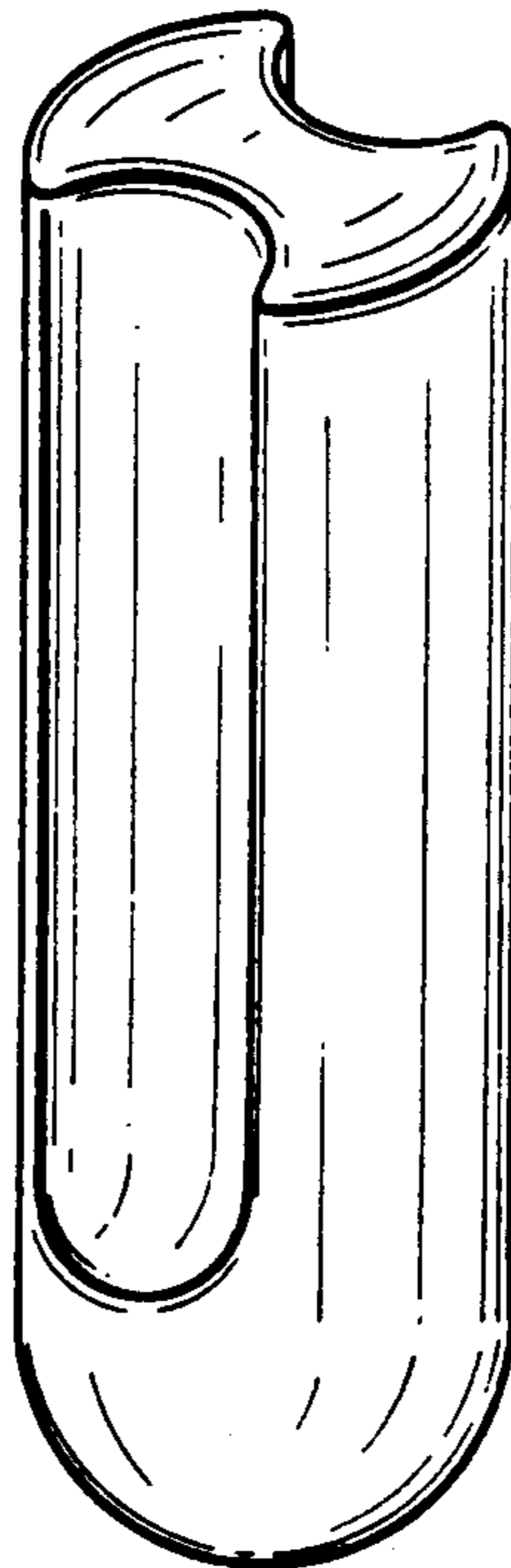

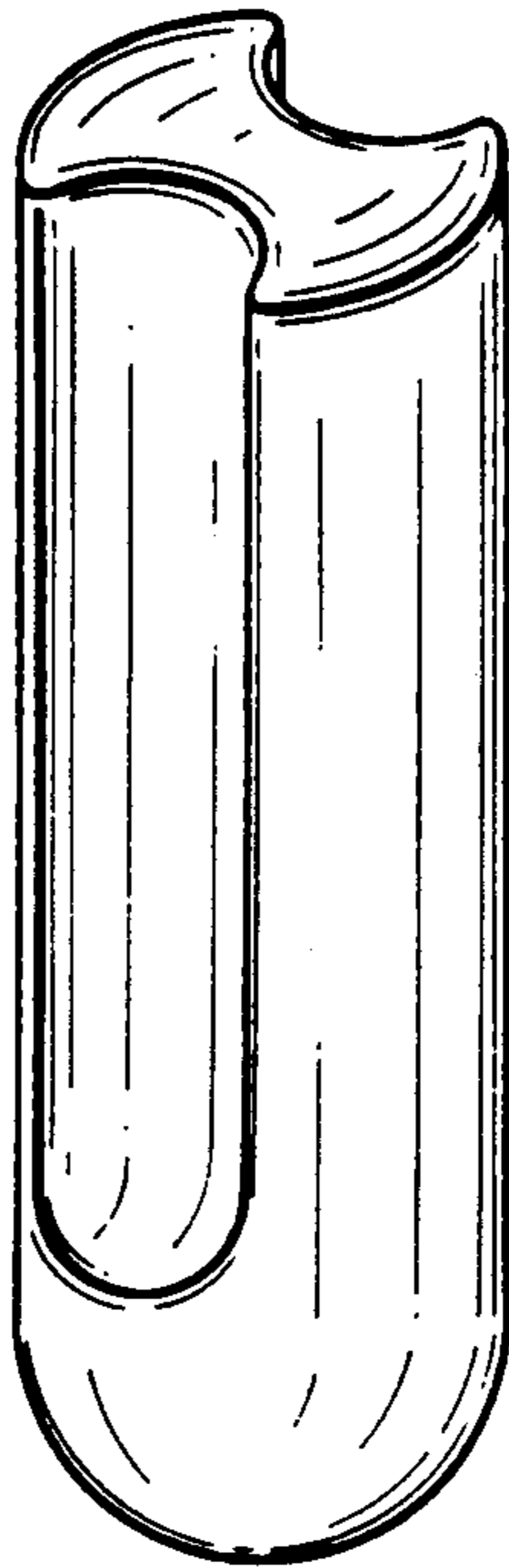

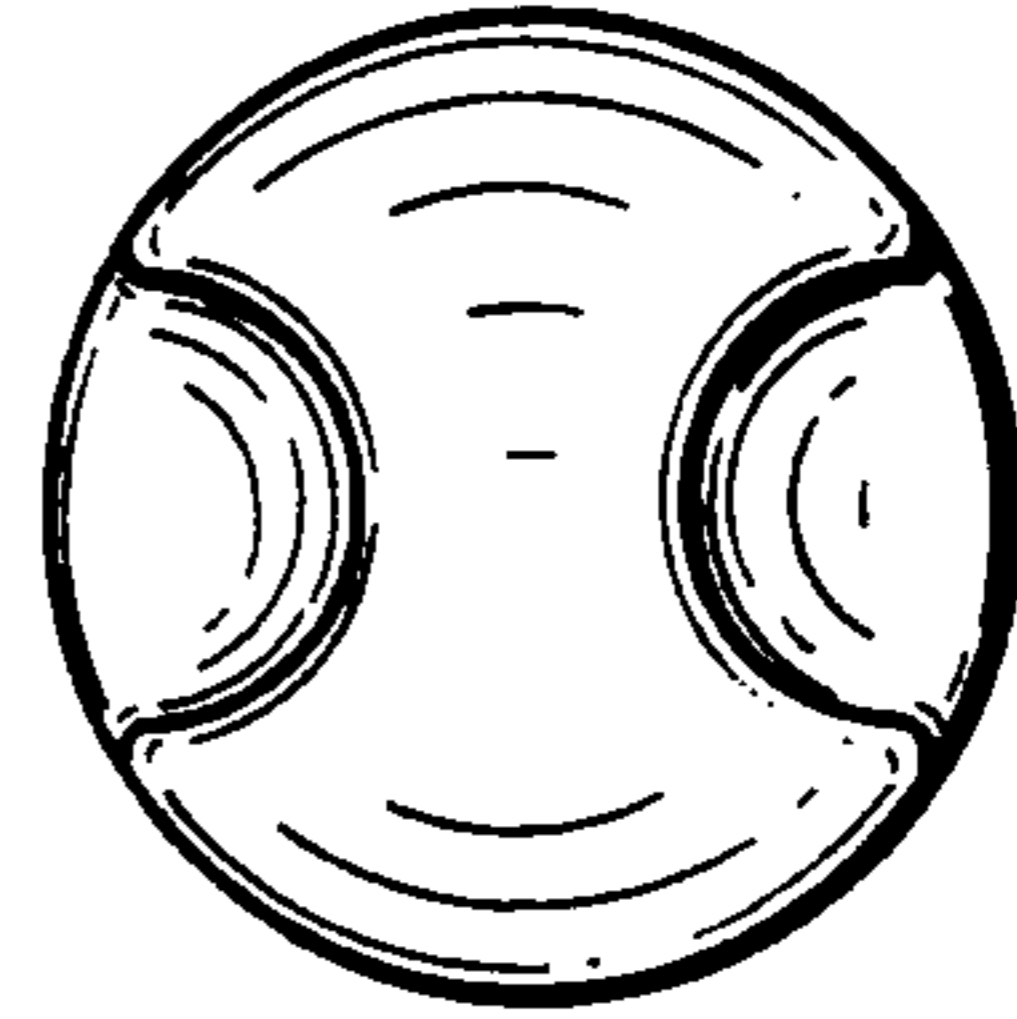

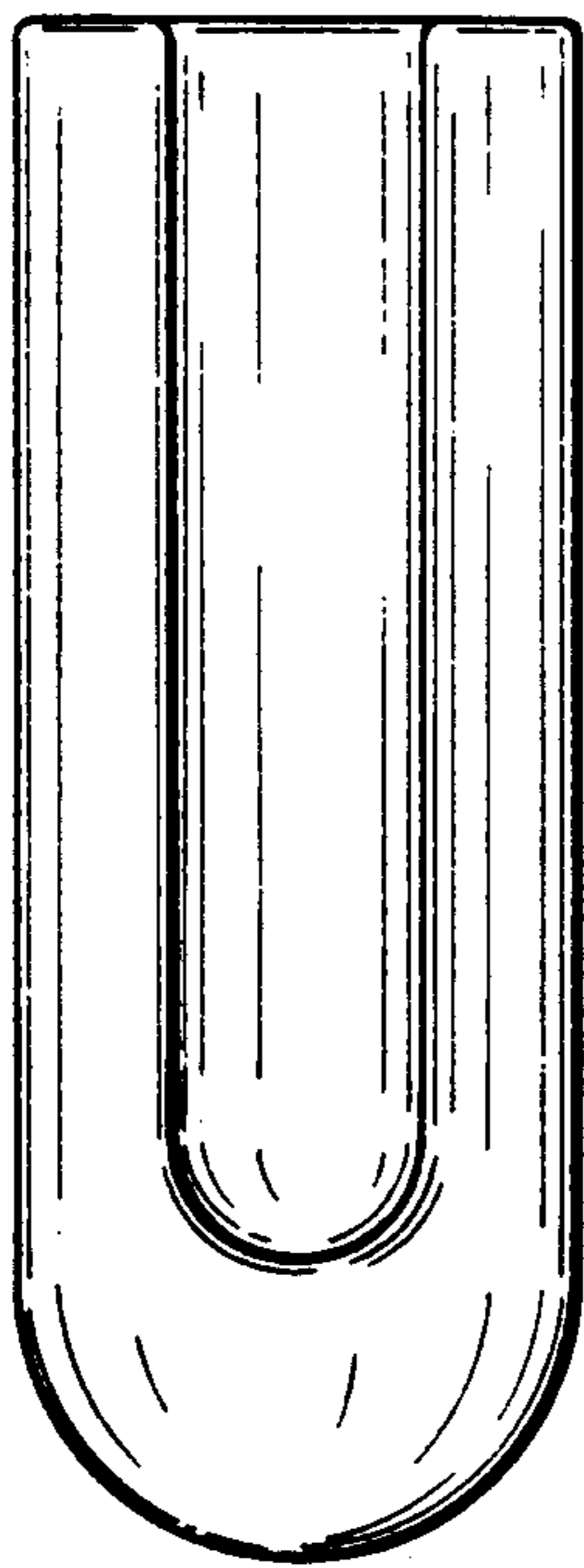

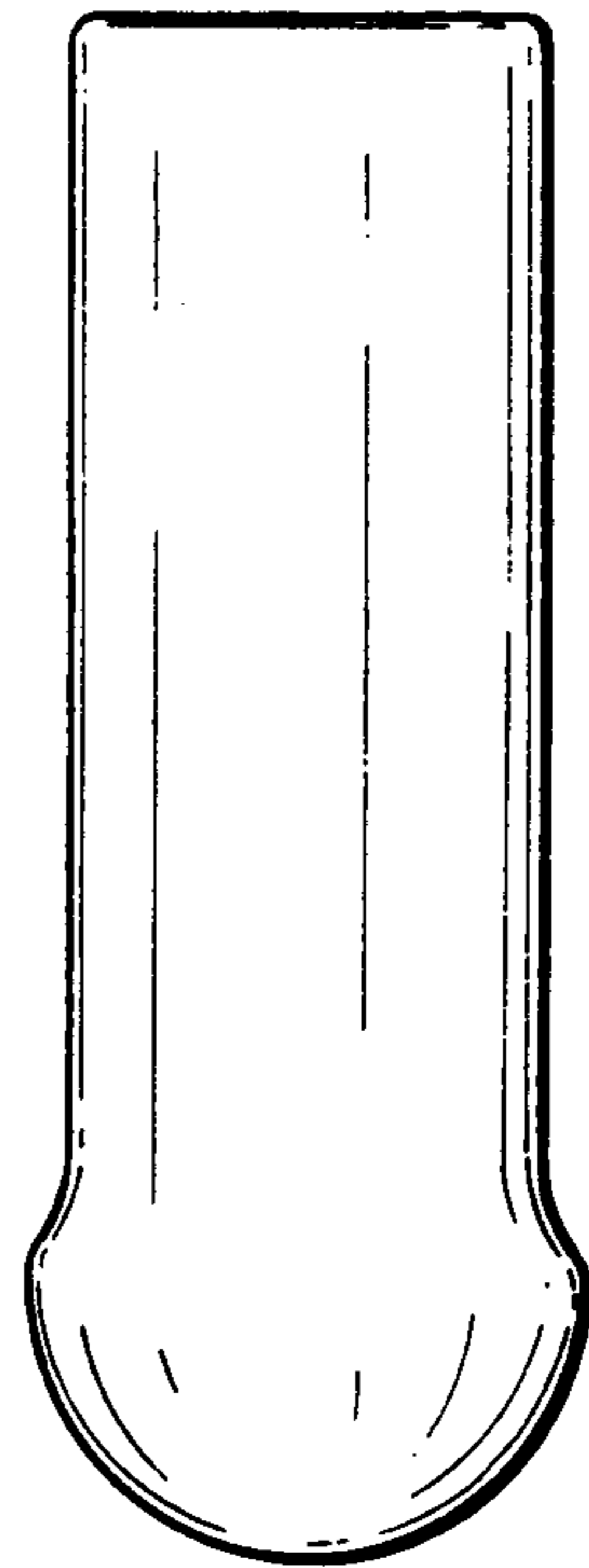
