DESCRIPTION

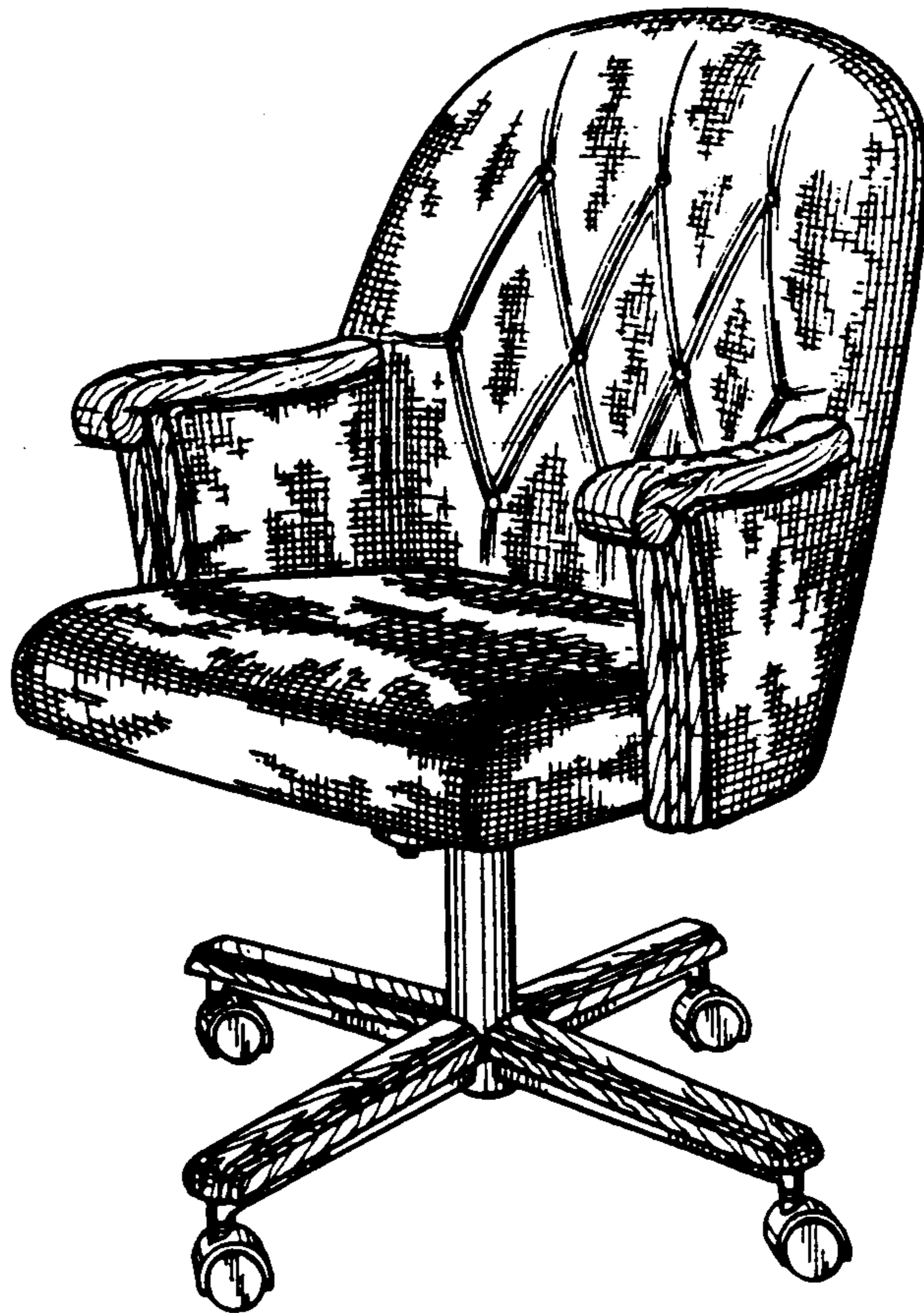
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

The pattern of the fabric does not form part of the invention.



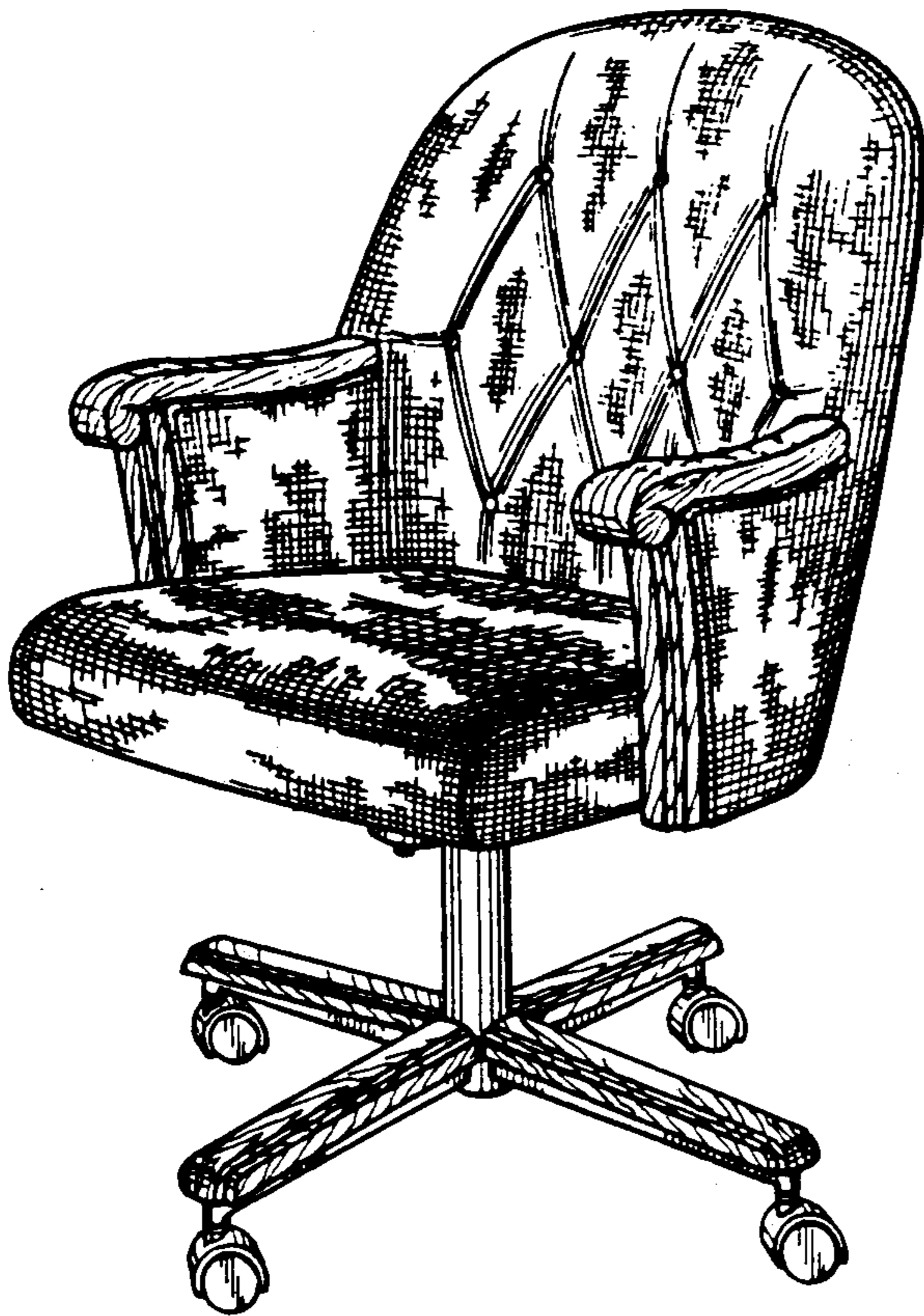

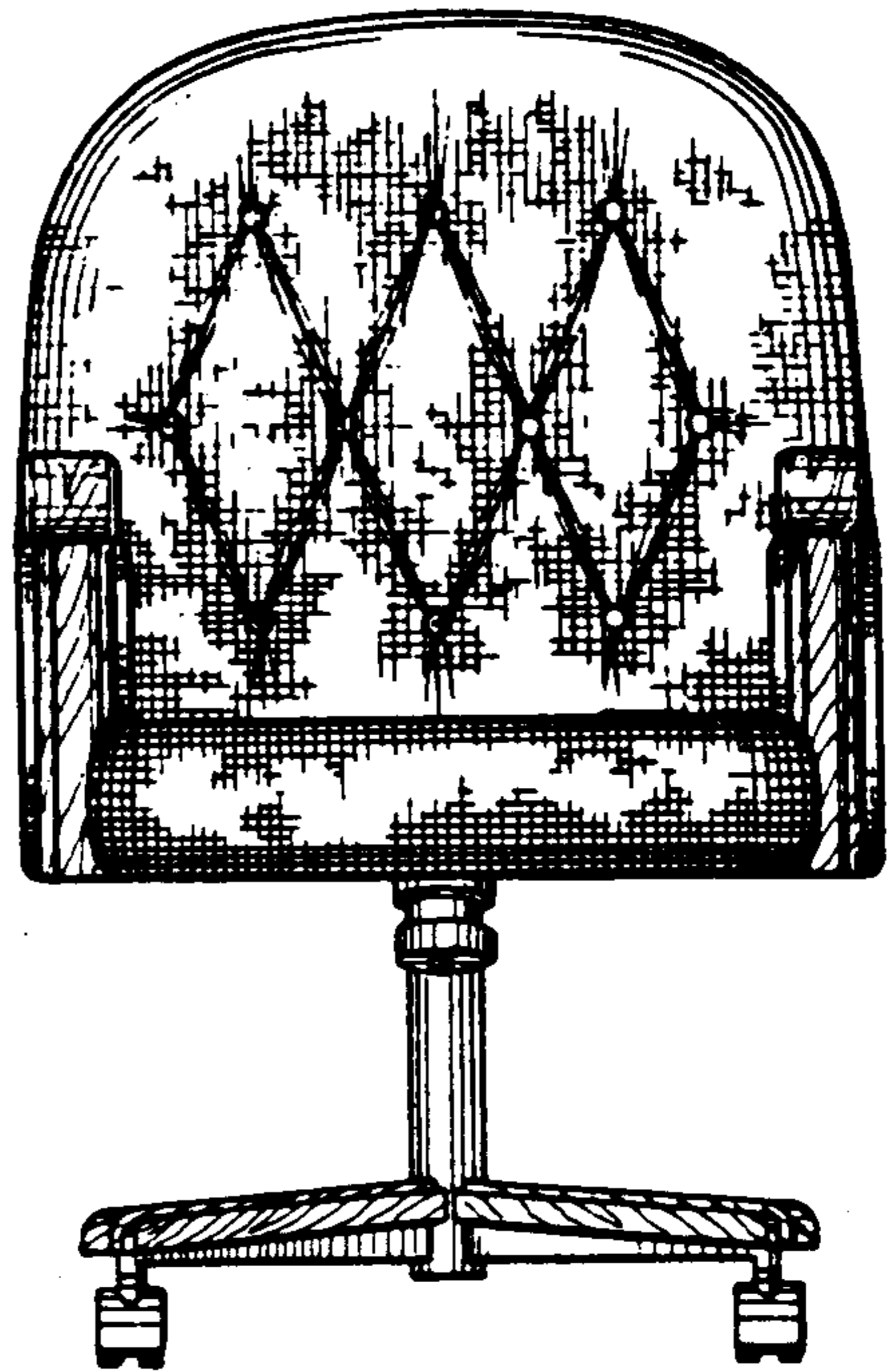

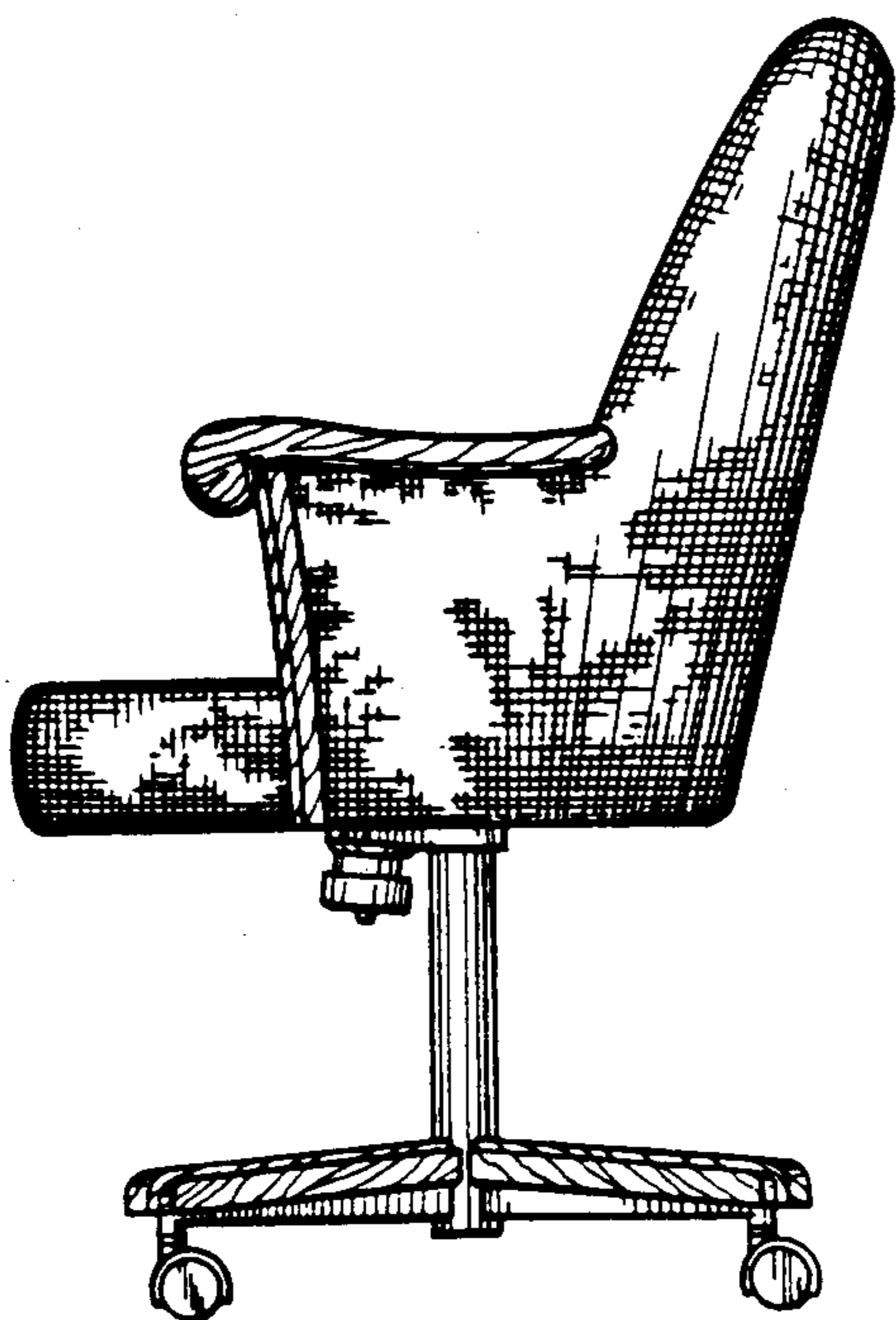

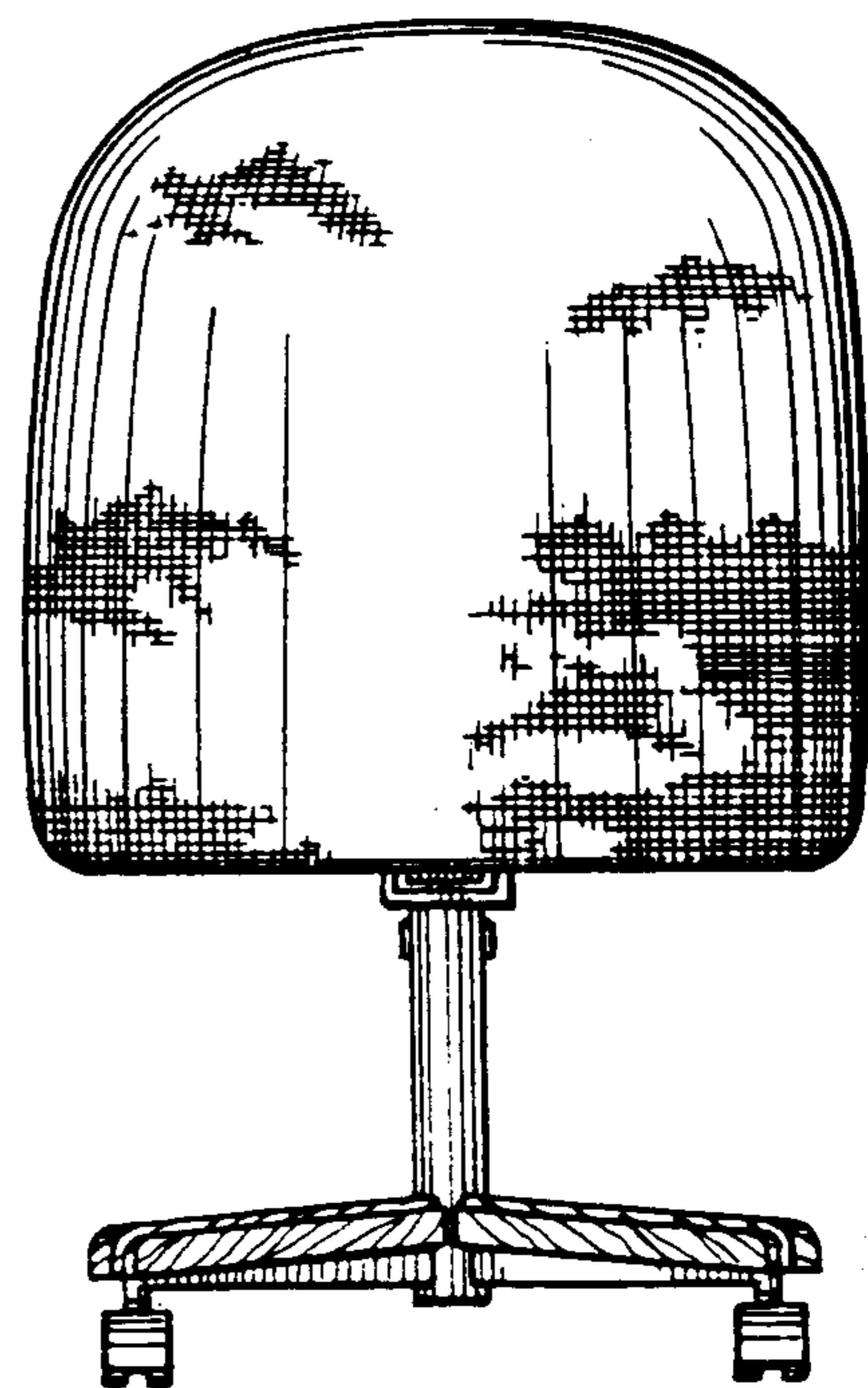
