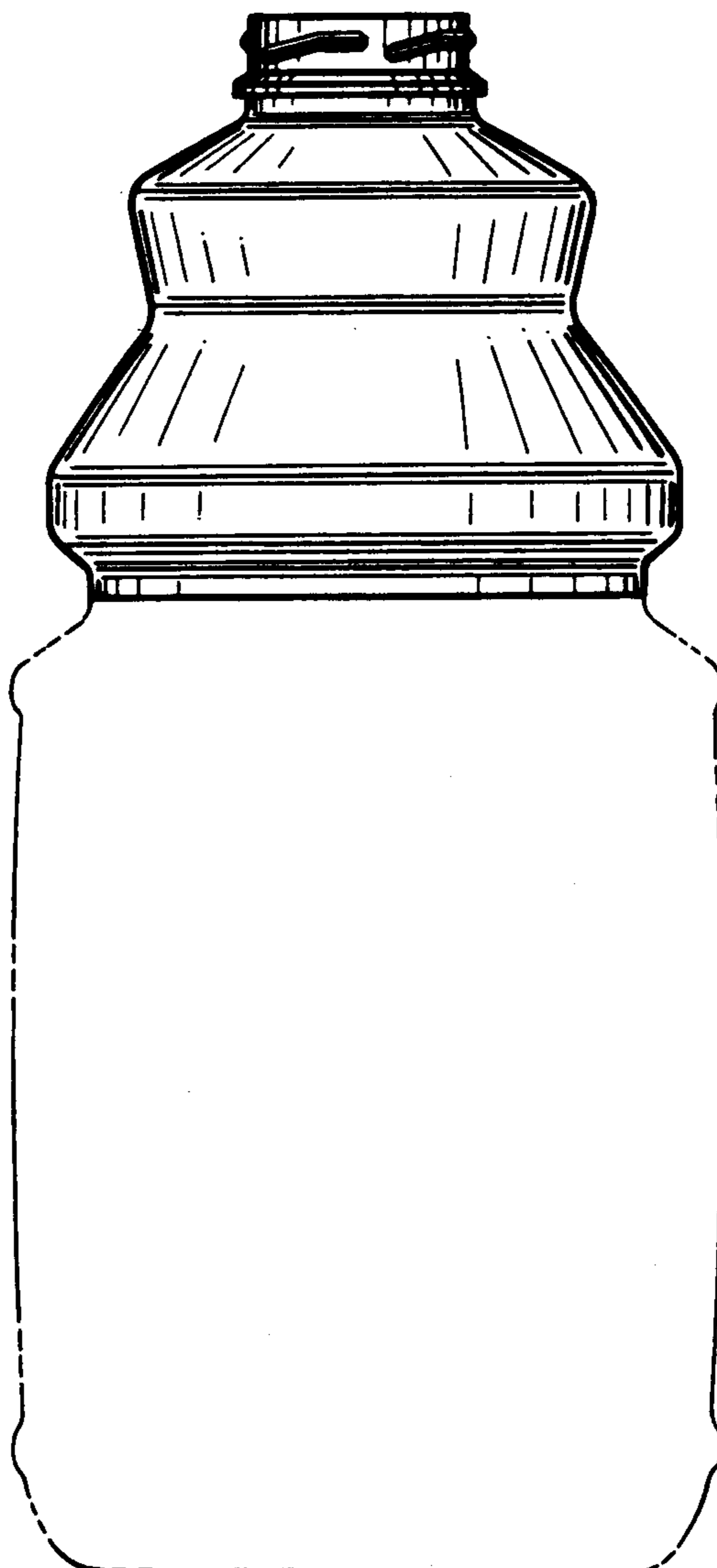

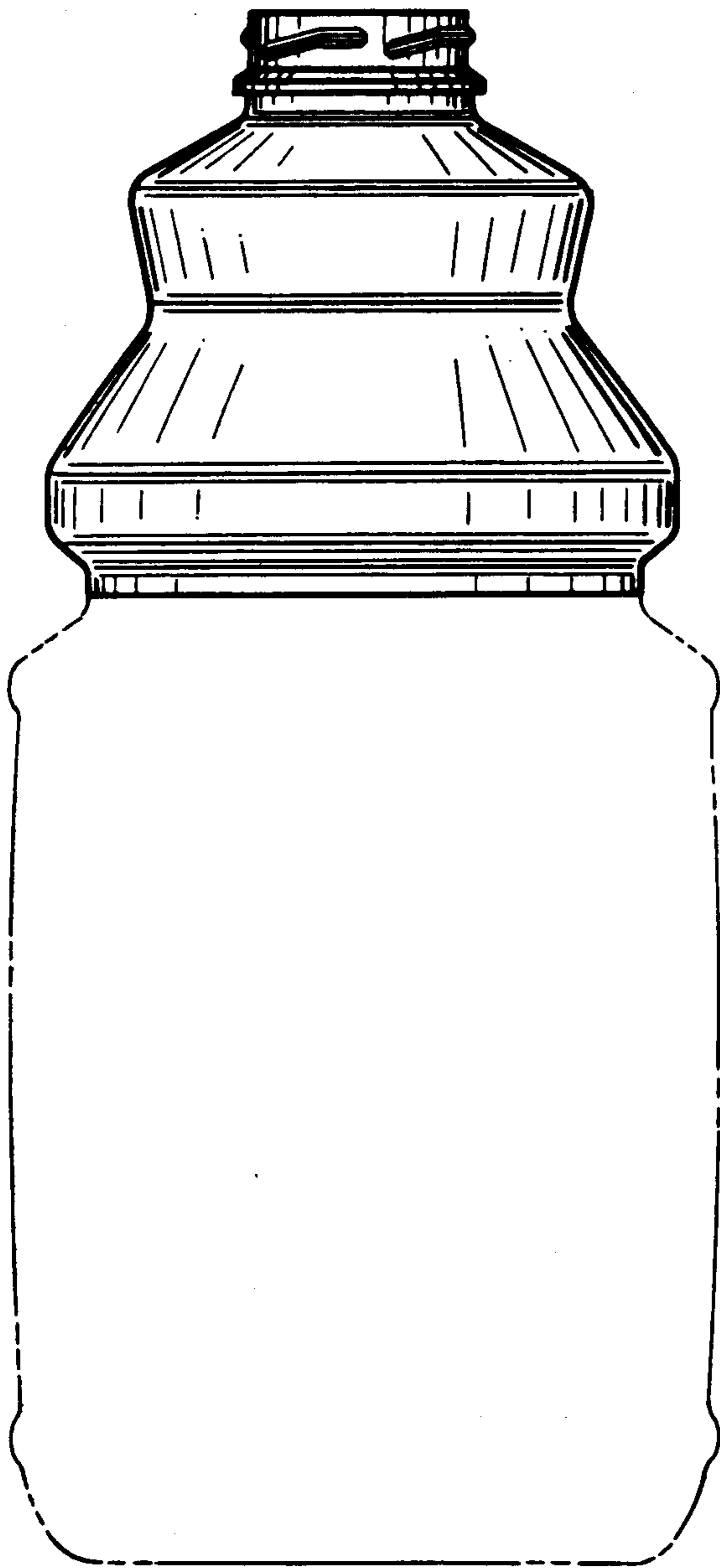
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an upper portion of a bottle, as shown and described.

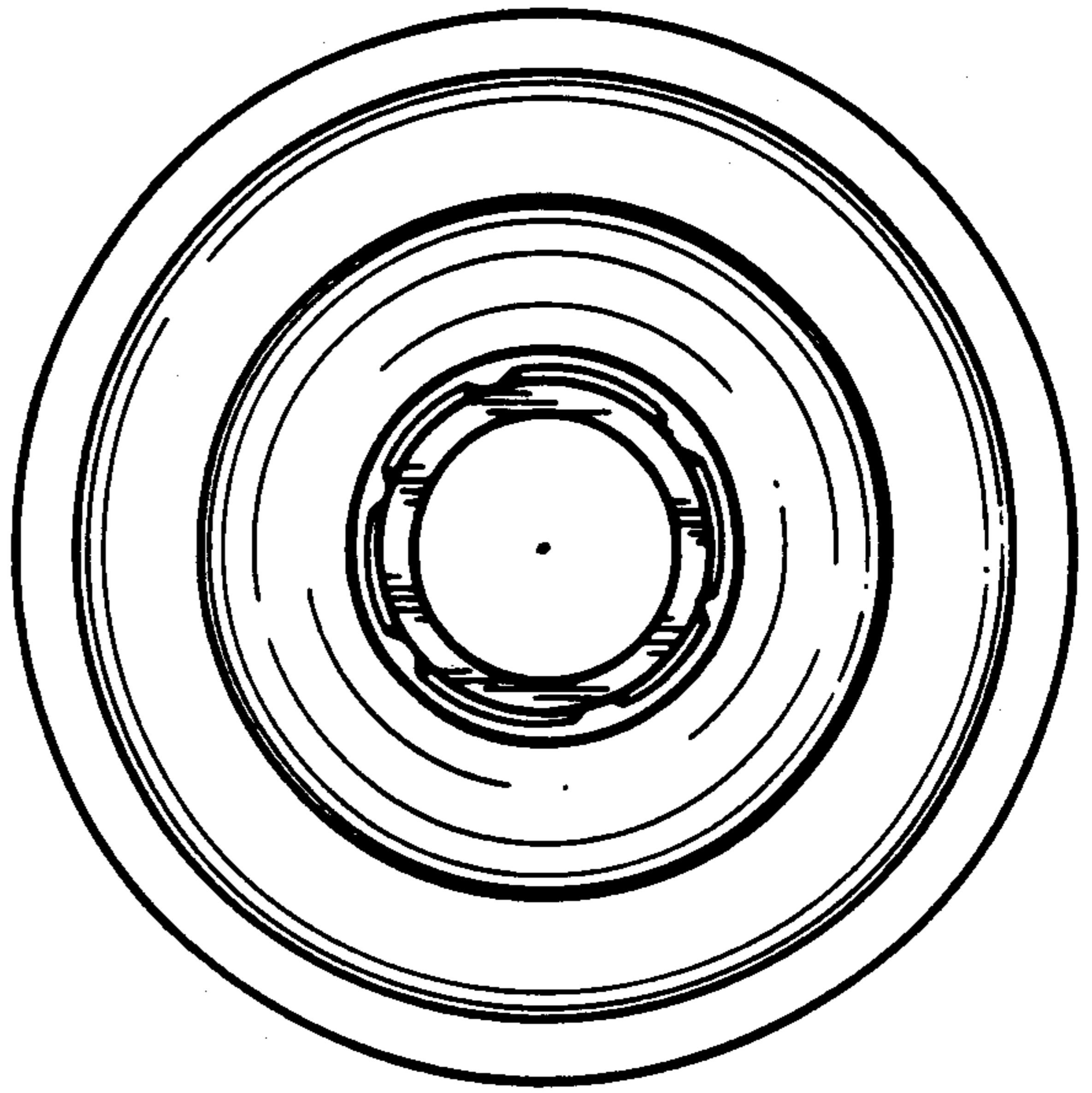
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an upper portion of a bottle showing my new design, the opposite side being the same in appearance; and FIG. 2 is a top plan view. The broken lines showing the lower portion of a bottle in FIG. 1 are for the purpose of showing environmental structure only.
