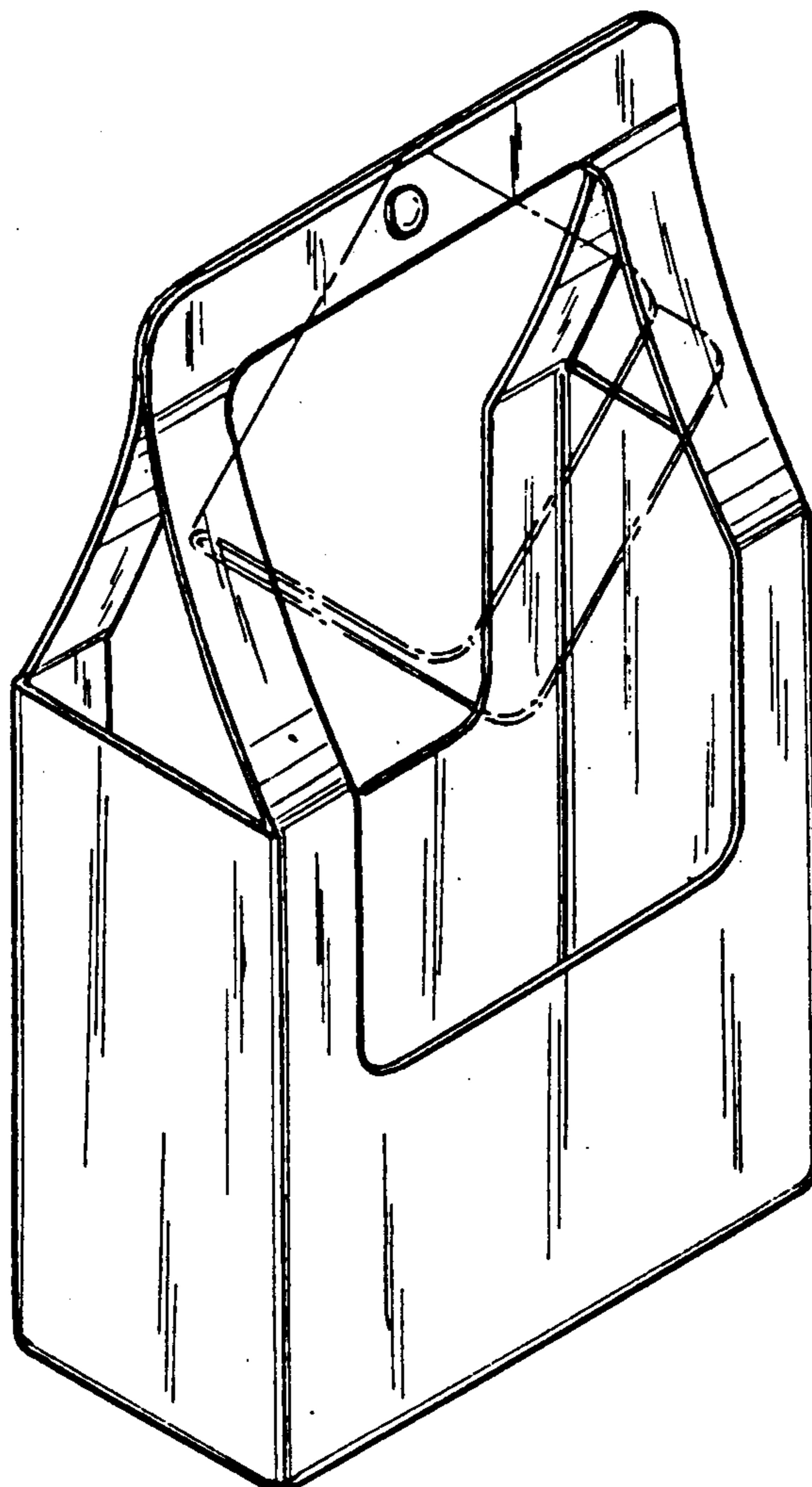
The ornamental design for gift box, as shown and described.

The broken lines showing of a personalized gift card is for illustrative purpose only and forms no part of the claim.



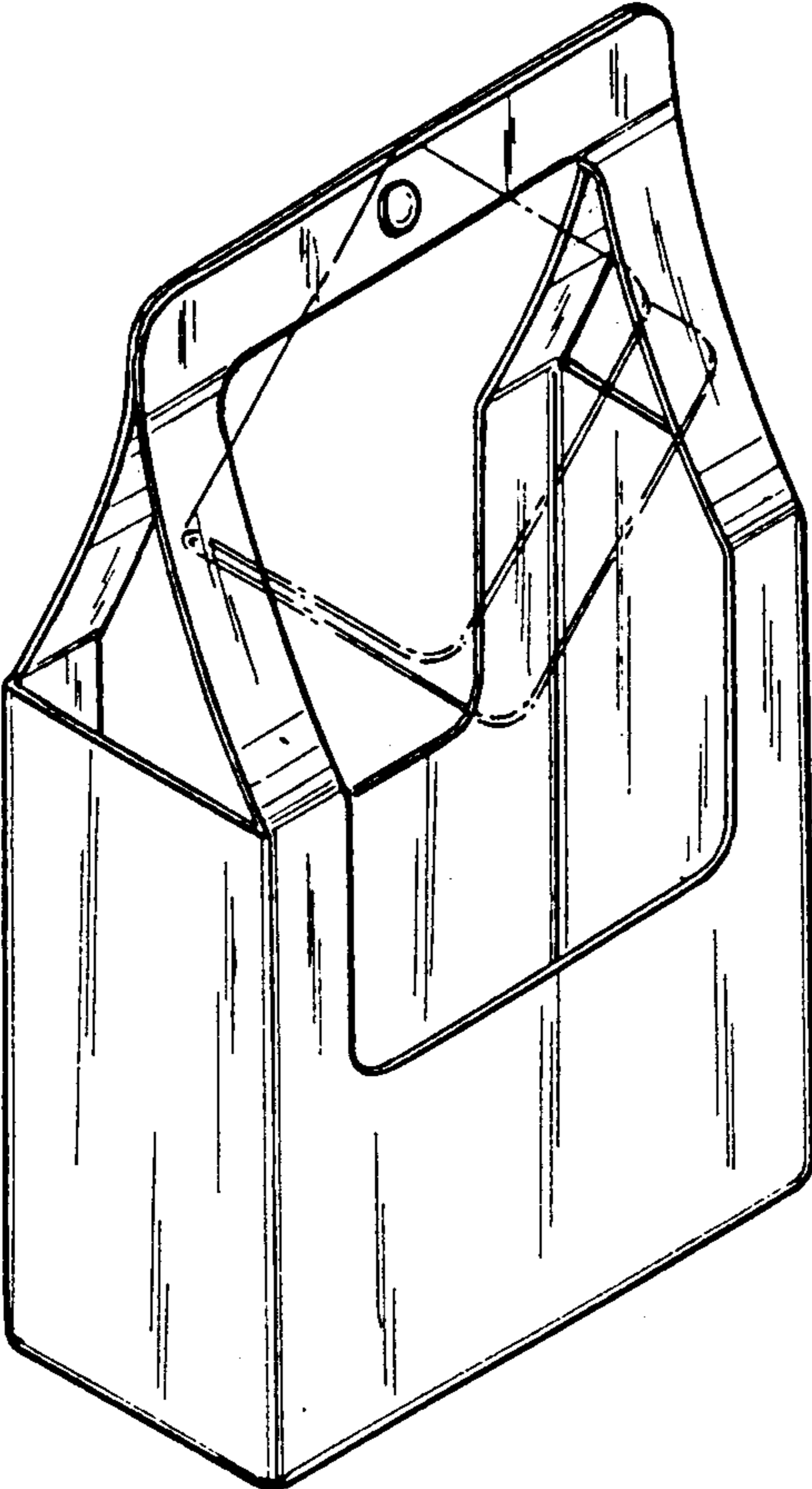

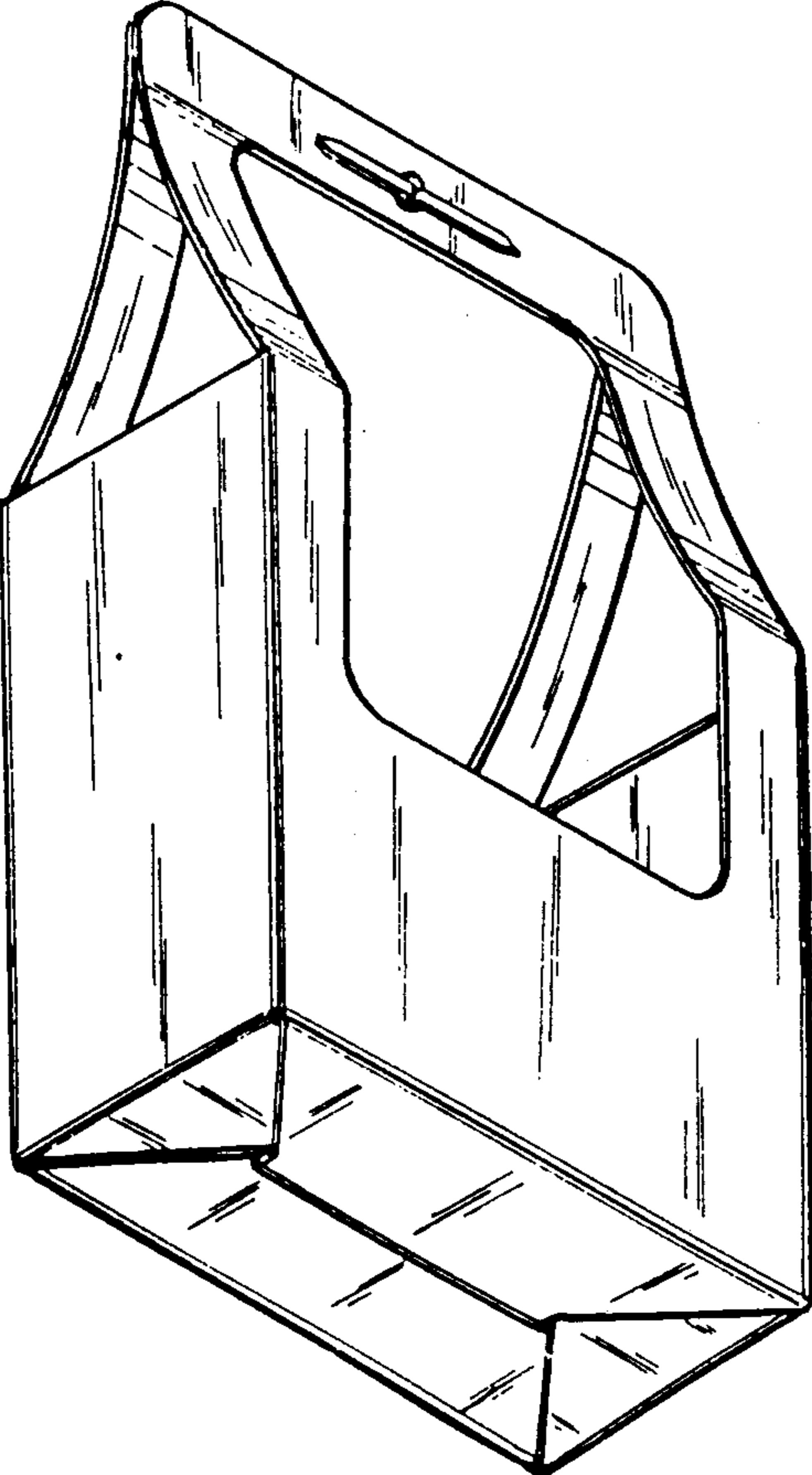
