**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a rear elevation view of an outside mirror for a motor vehicle embodying my novel design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view taken from the top thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a side perspective view taken from the top and rear thereof.

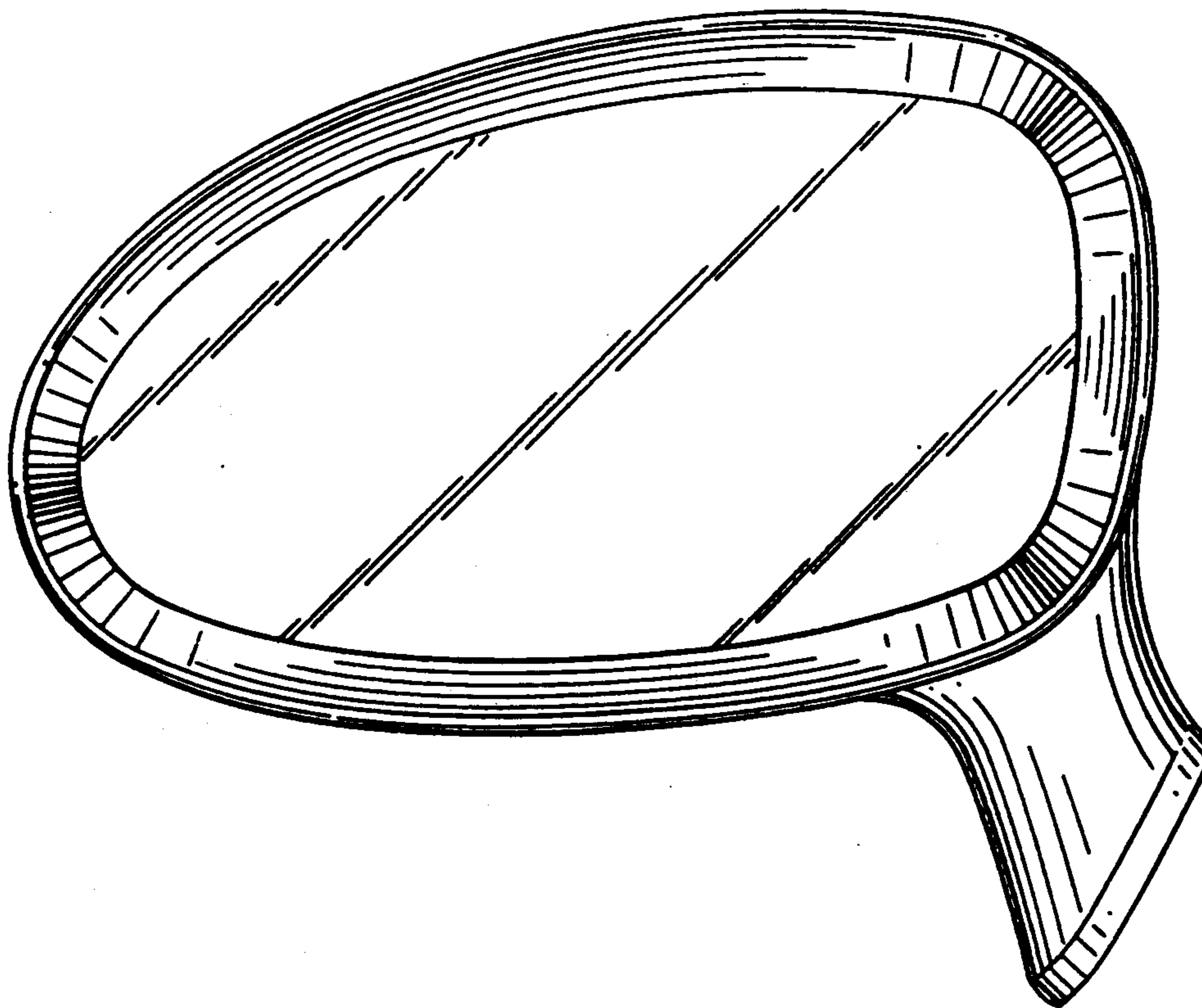

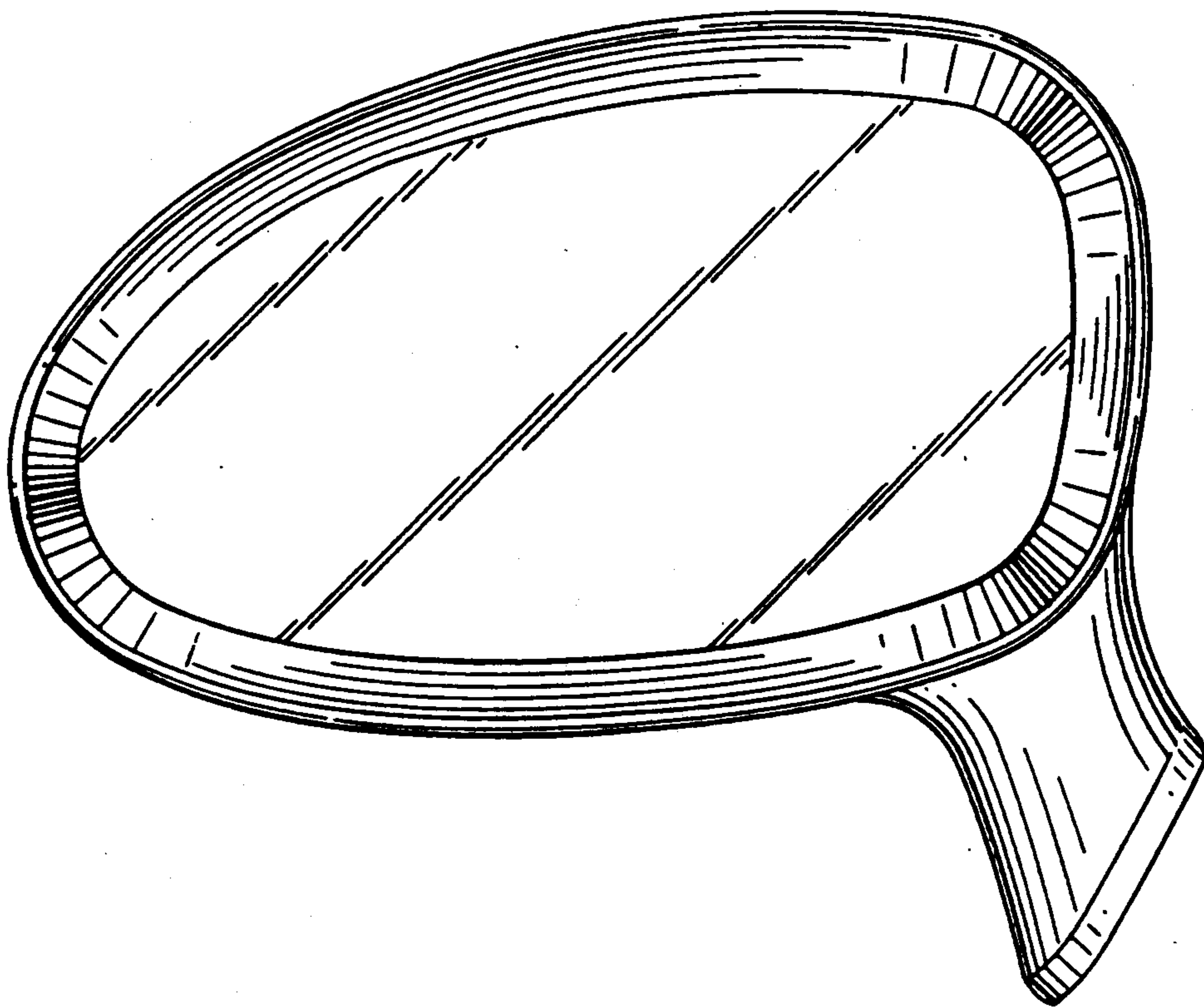

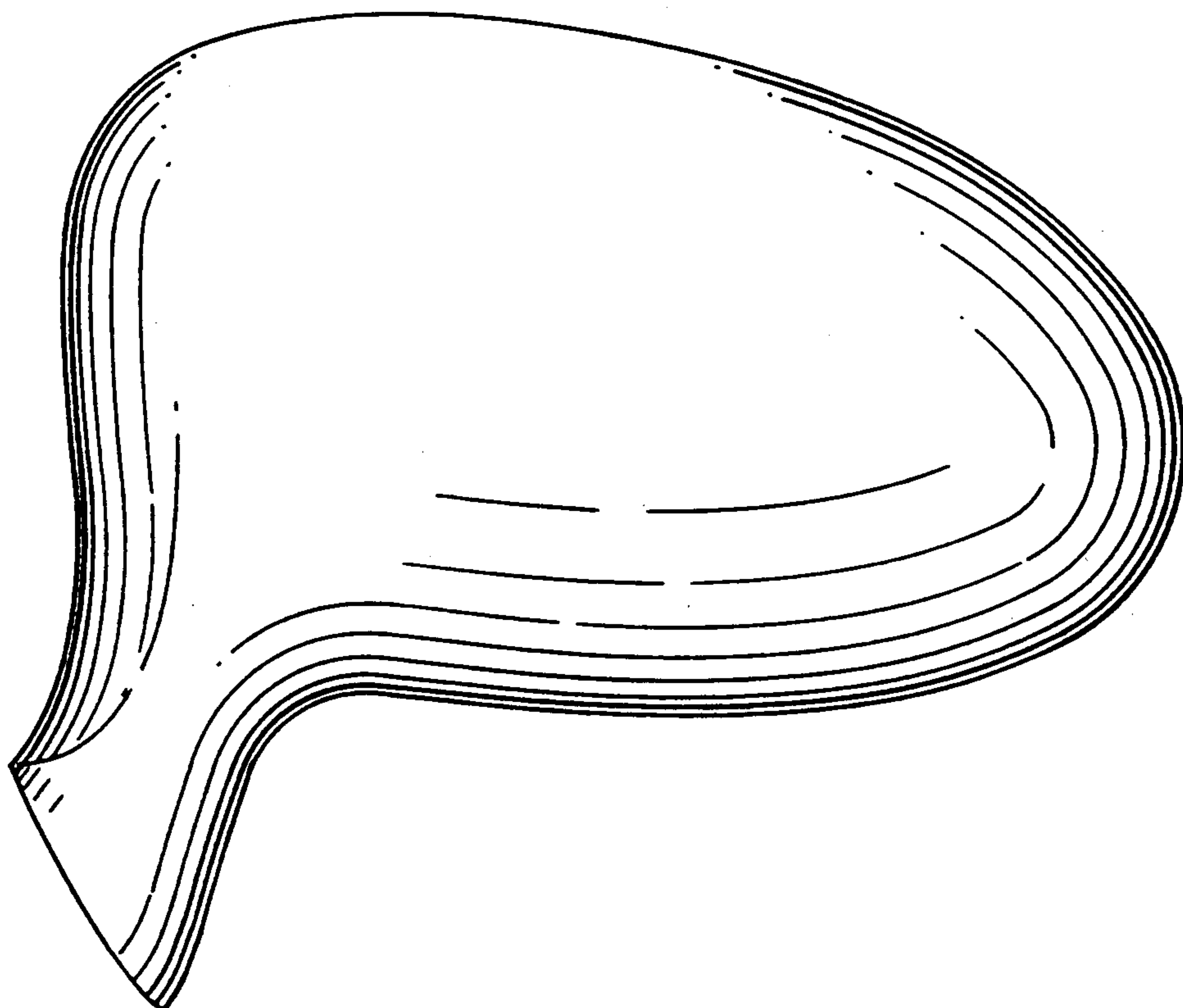

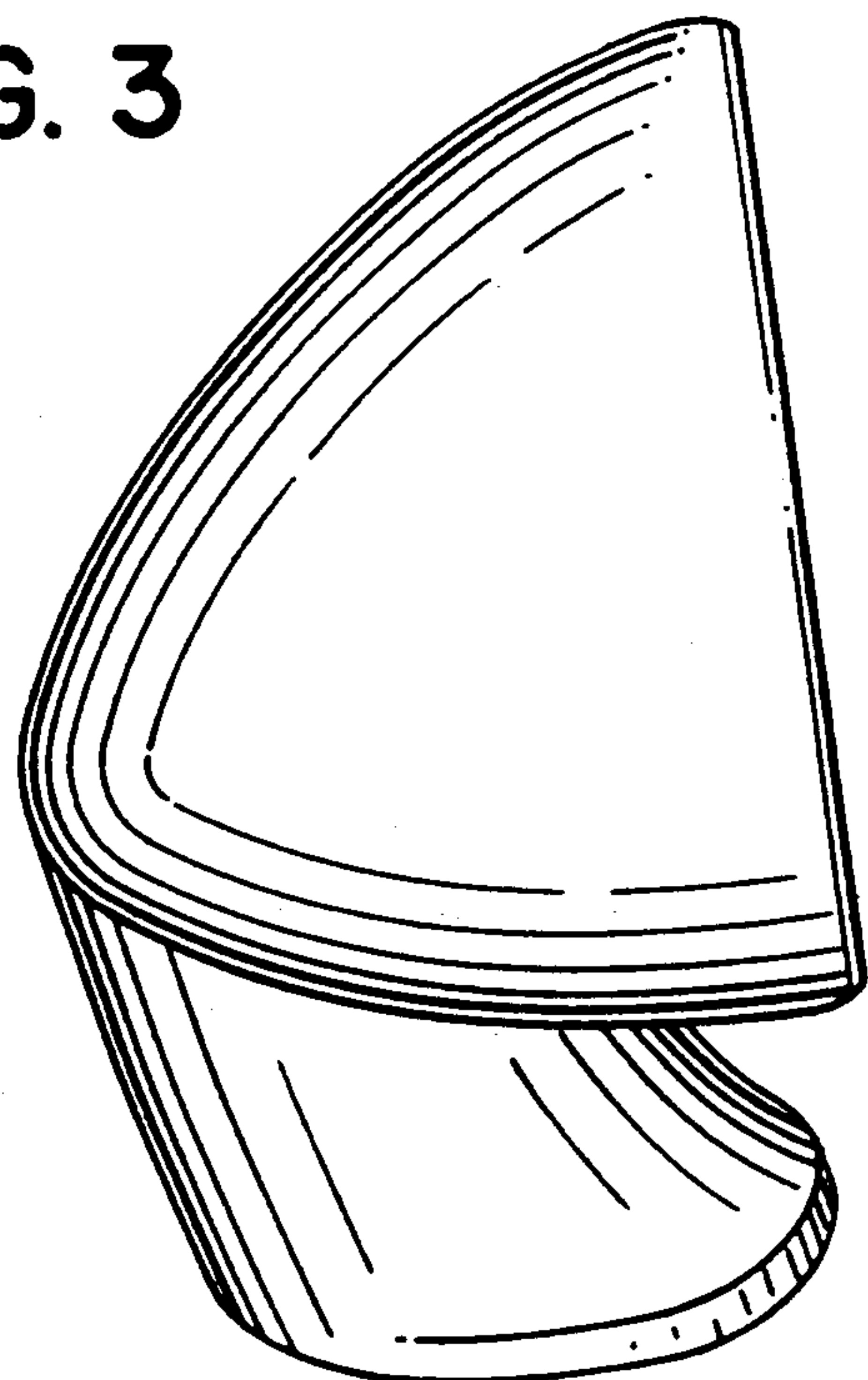

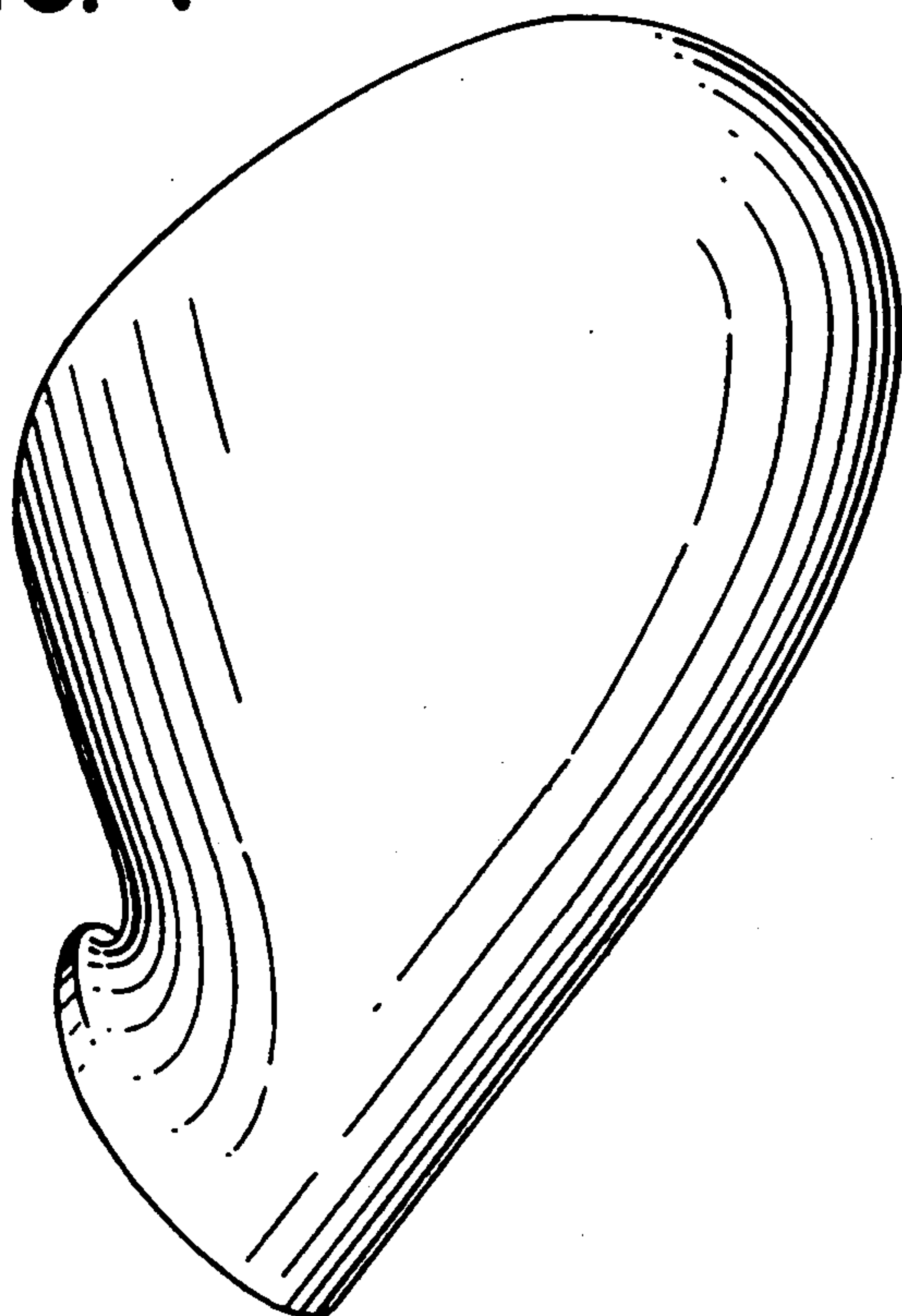
