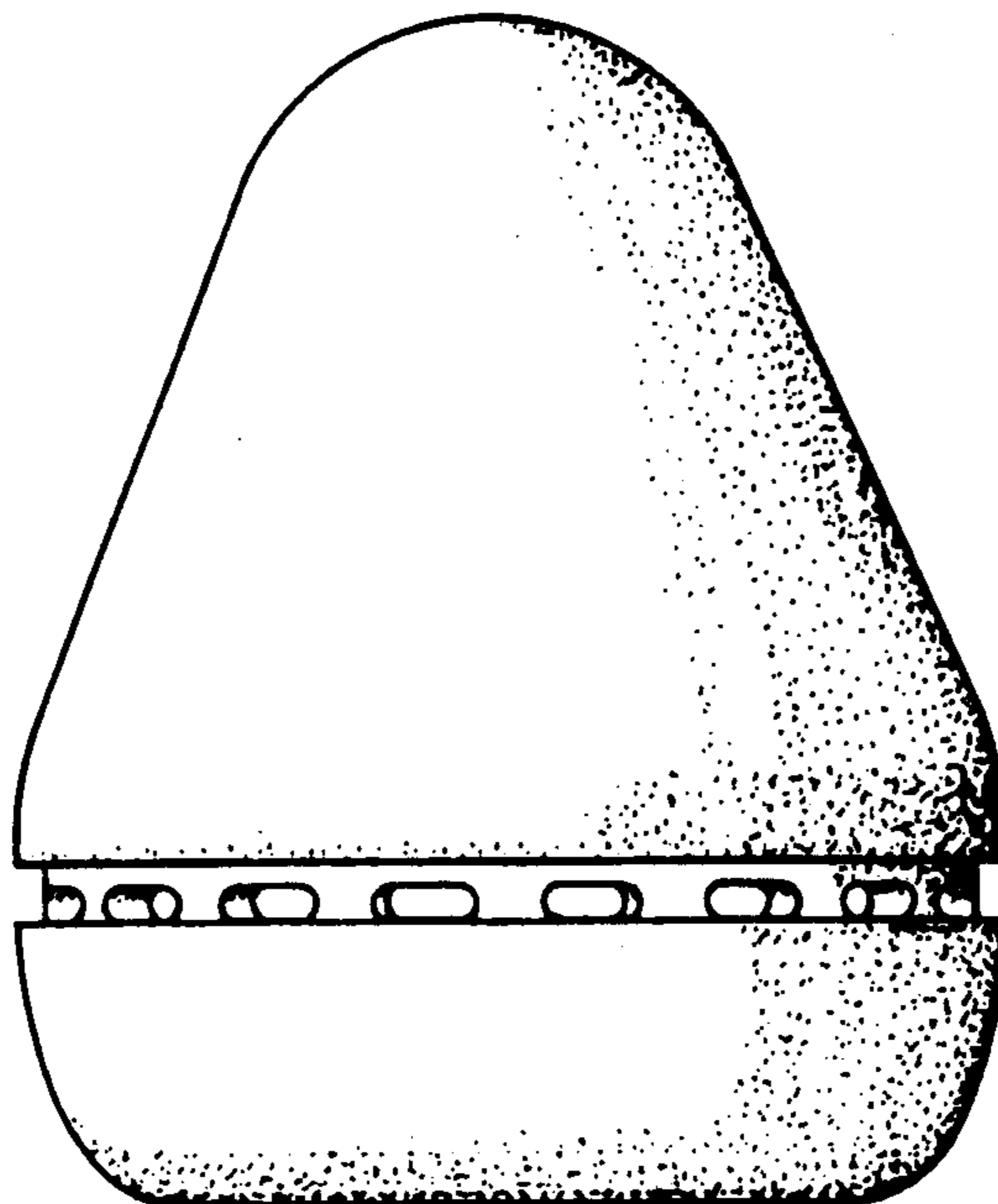

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container for an air freshener, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a container for an air freshener, showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof.



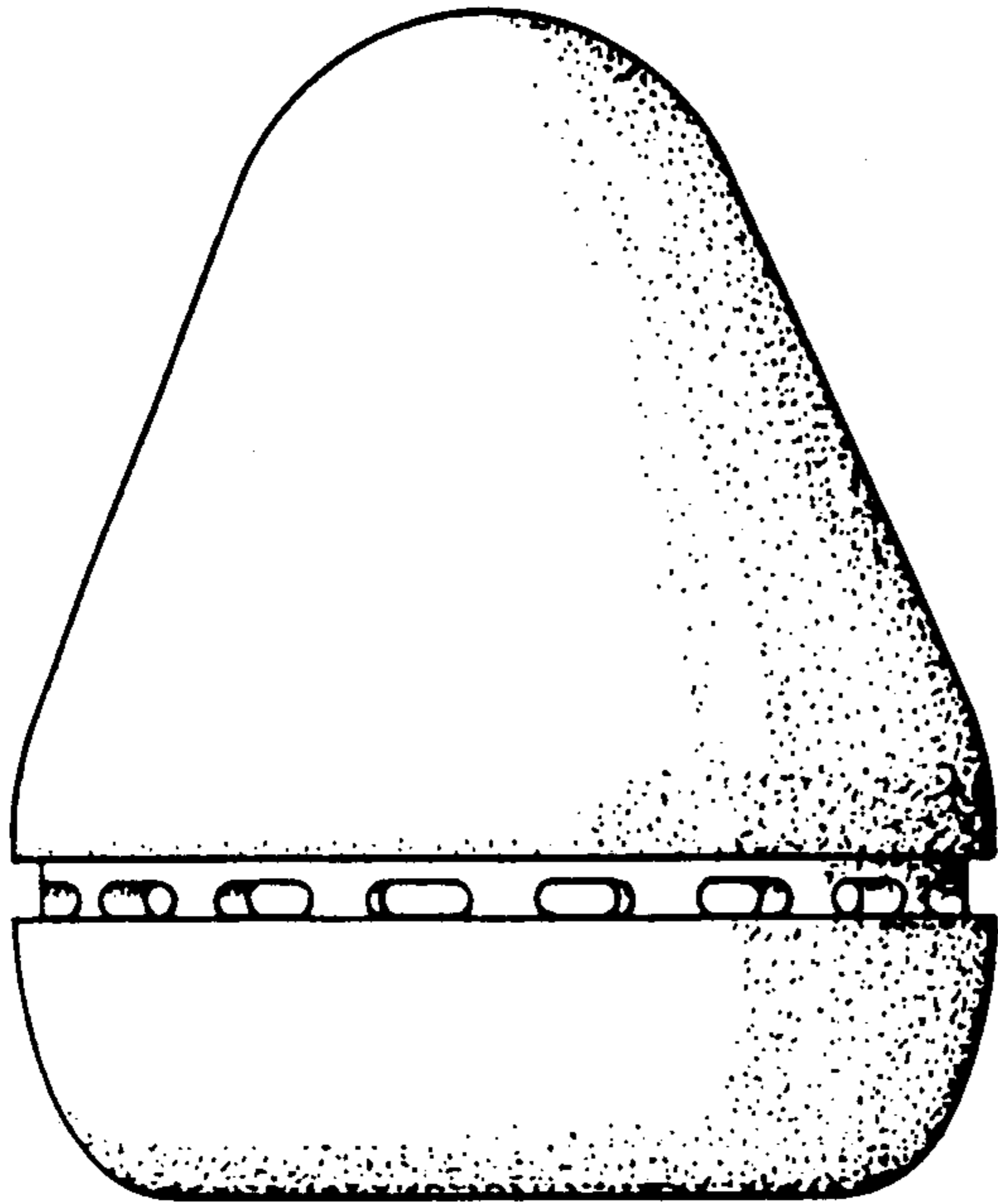

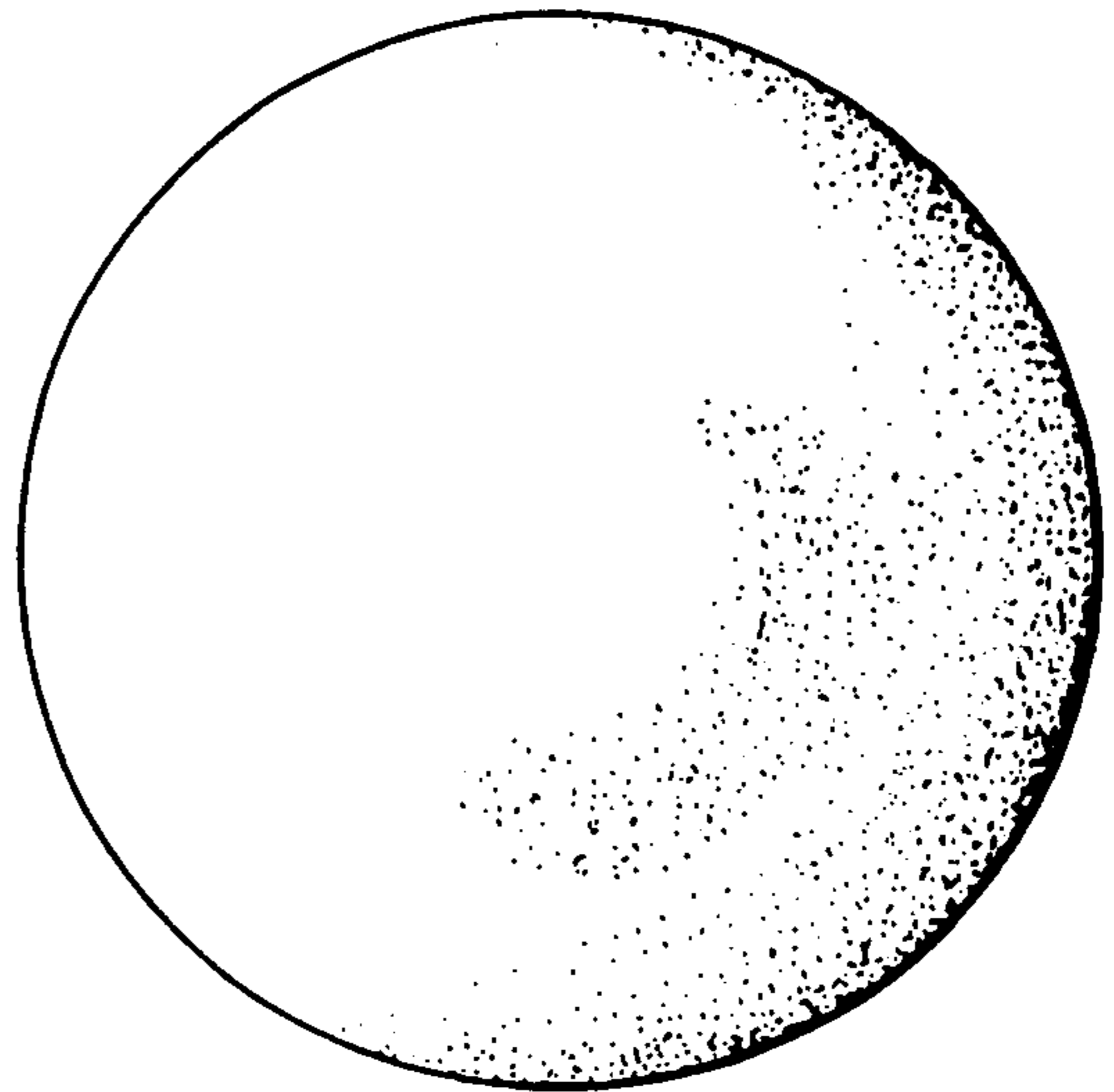

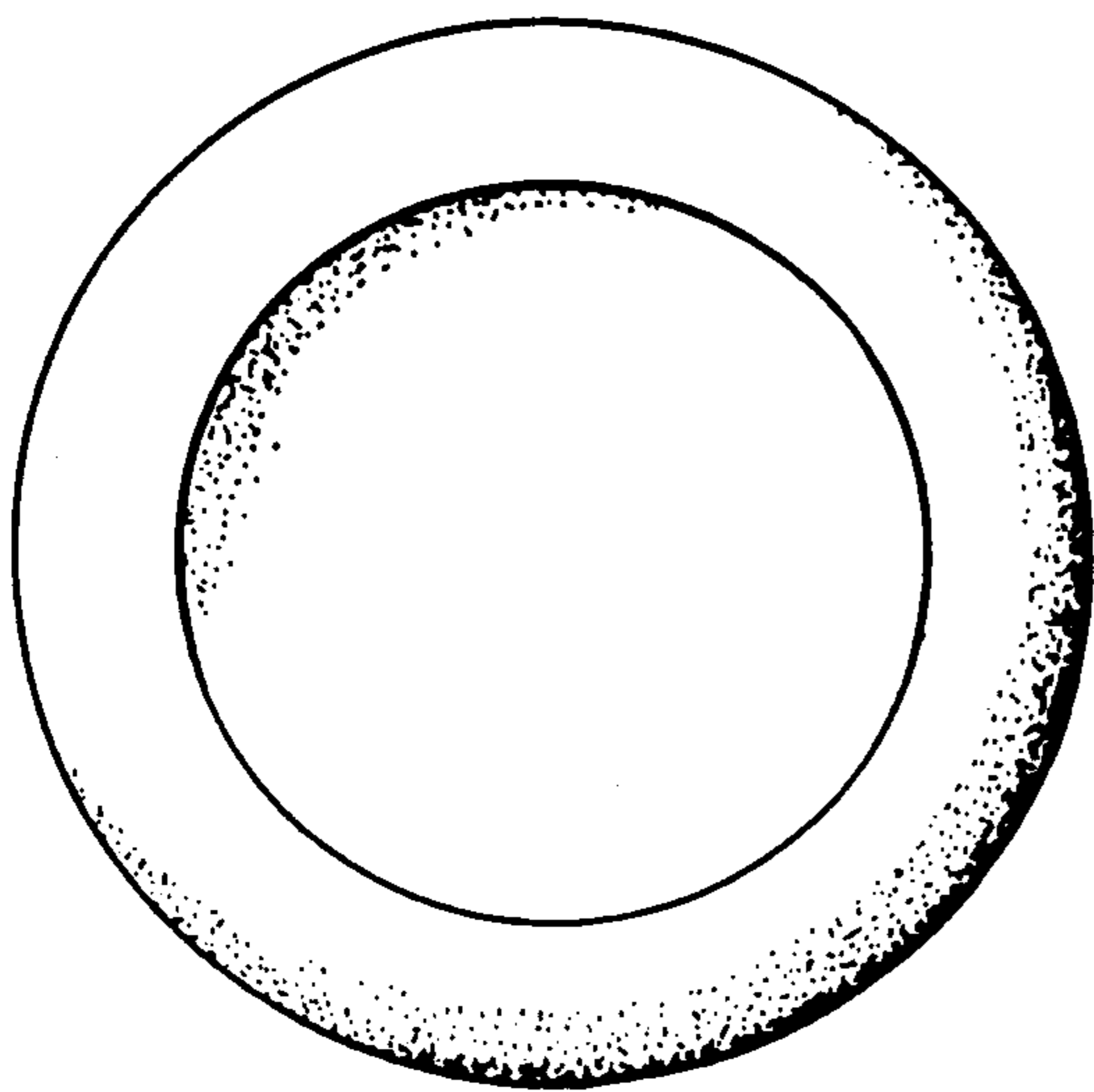
