DESCRIPTION

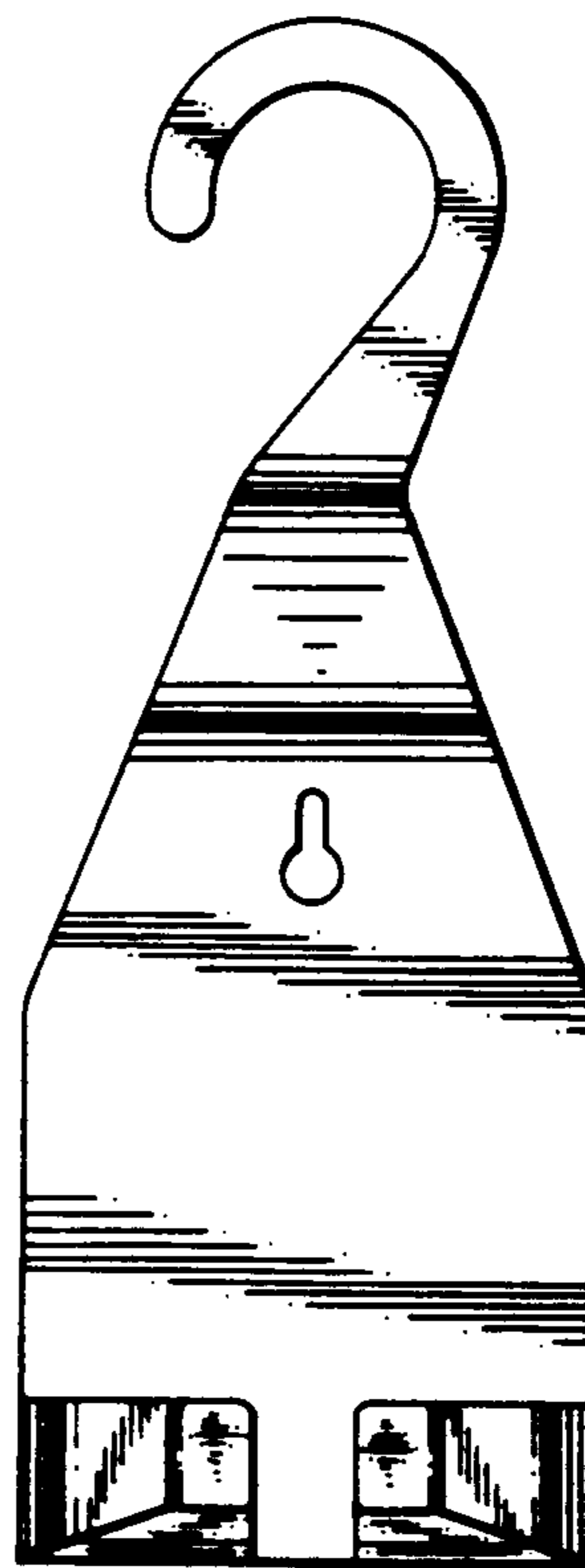
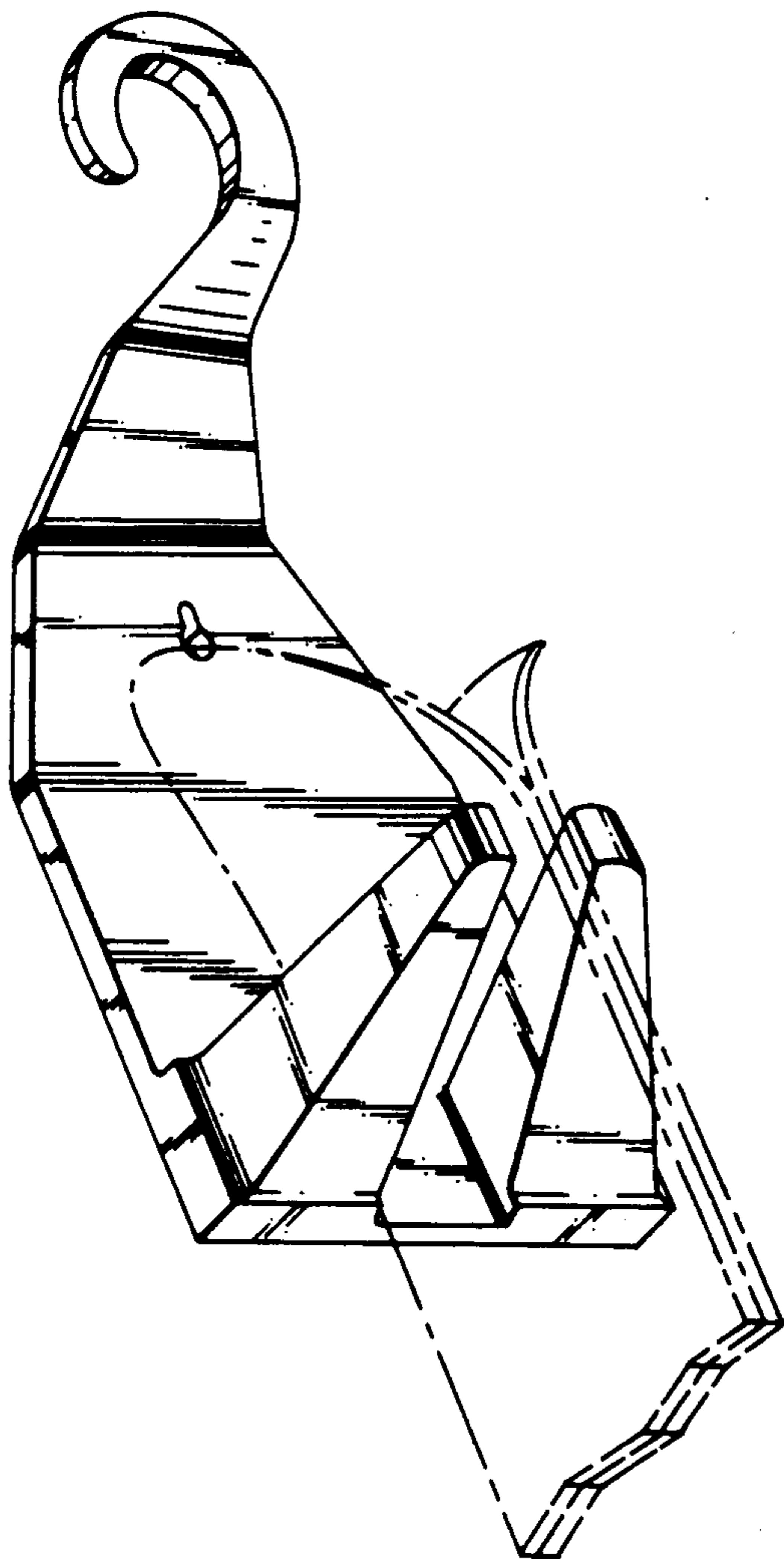
FIG. 1 is a bottom, left side and front perspective view of a hook holder for supporting a ski set or similar article;

FIGS. 2 and 3 are respectively front and rear elevational views thereof;

FIGS. 4 and 5 are respectively bottom and top plan views thereof; and

FIGS. 6 and 7 are respectively left and right side elevational views thereof.

The broken line showing of tips of a pair of ski in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



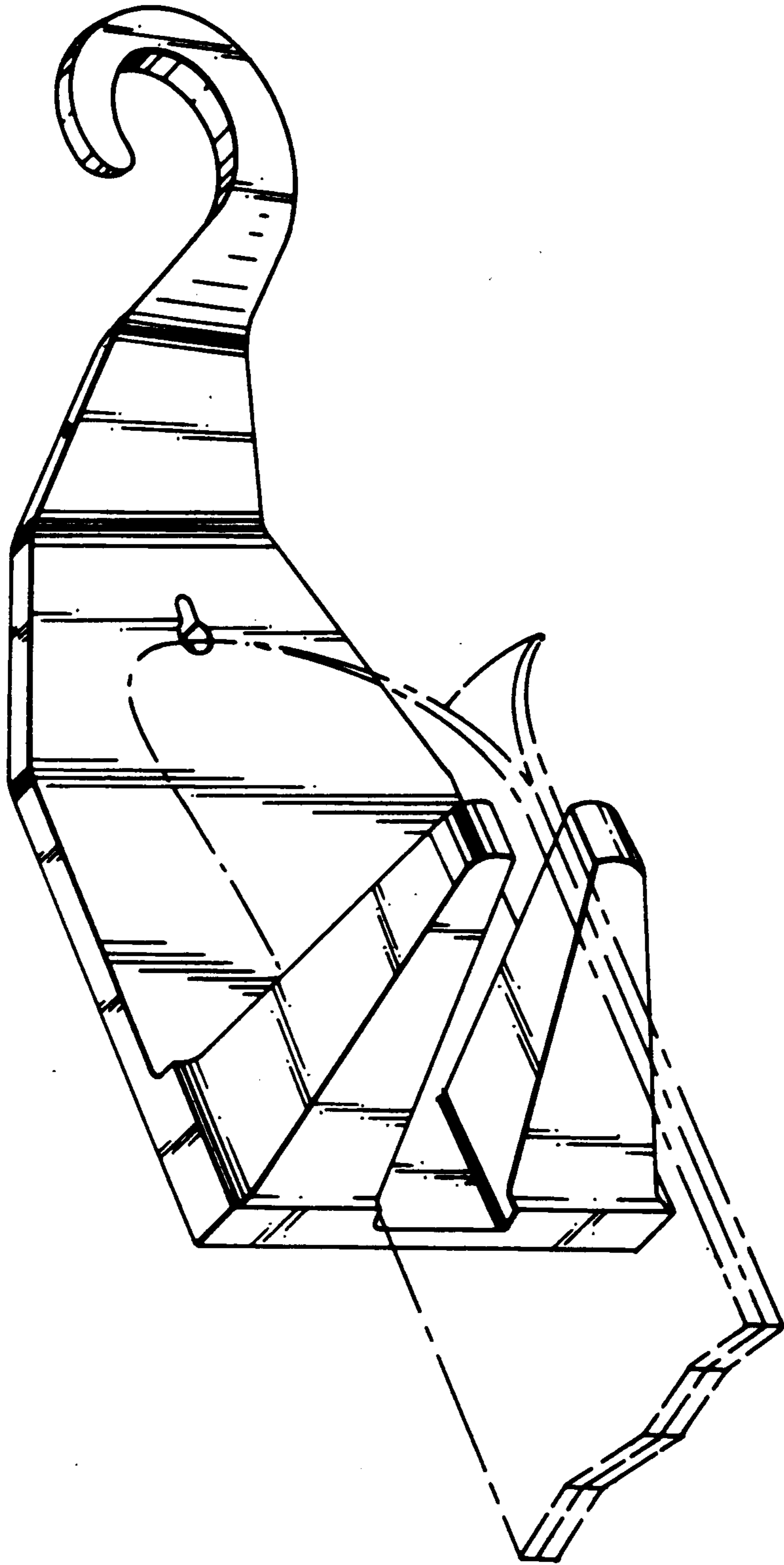

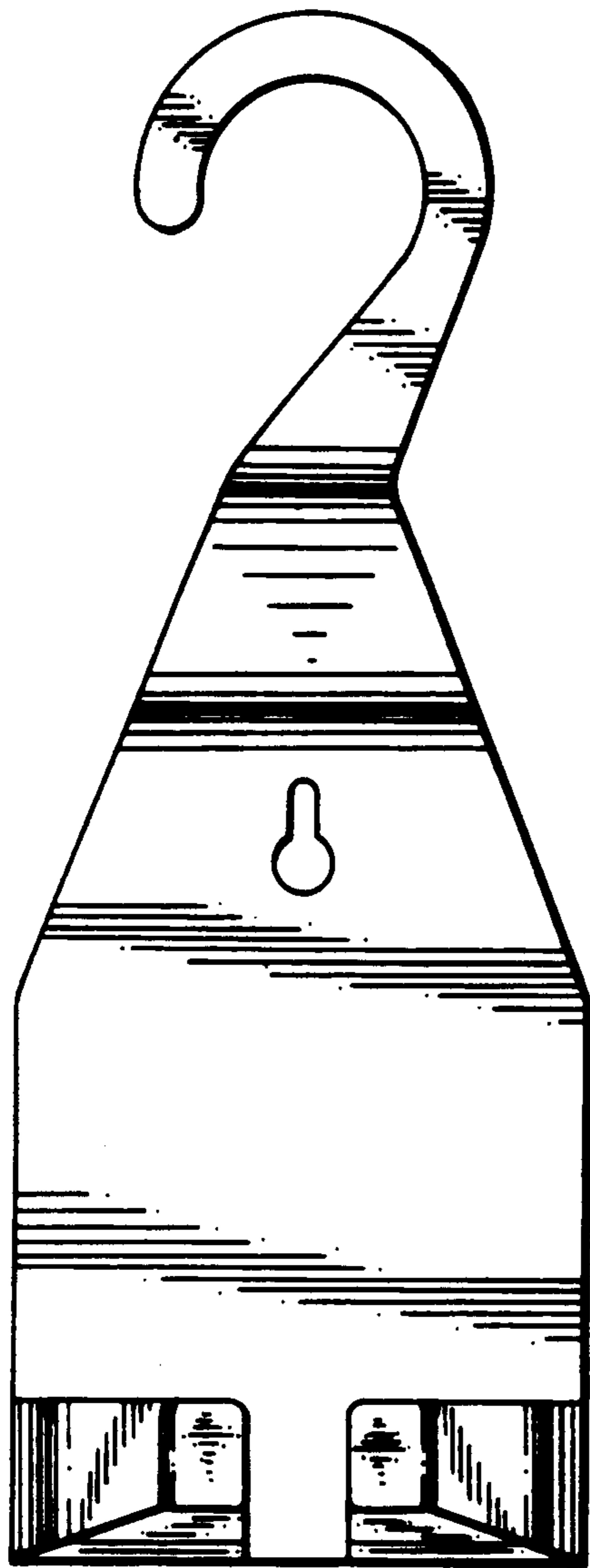

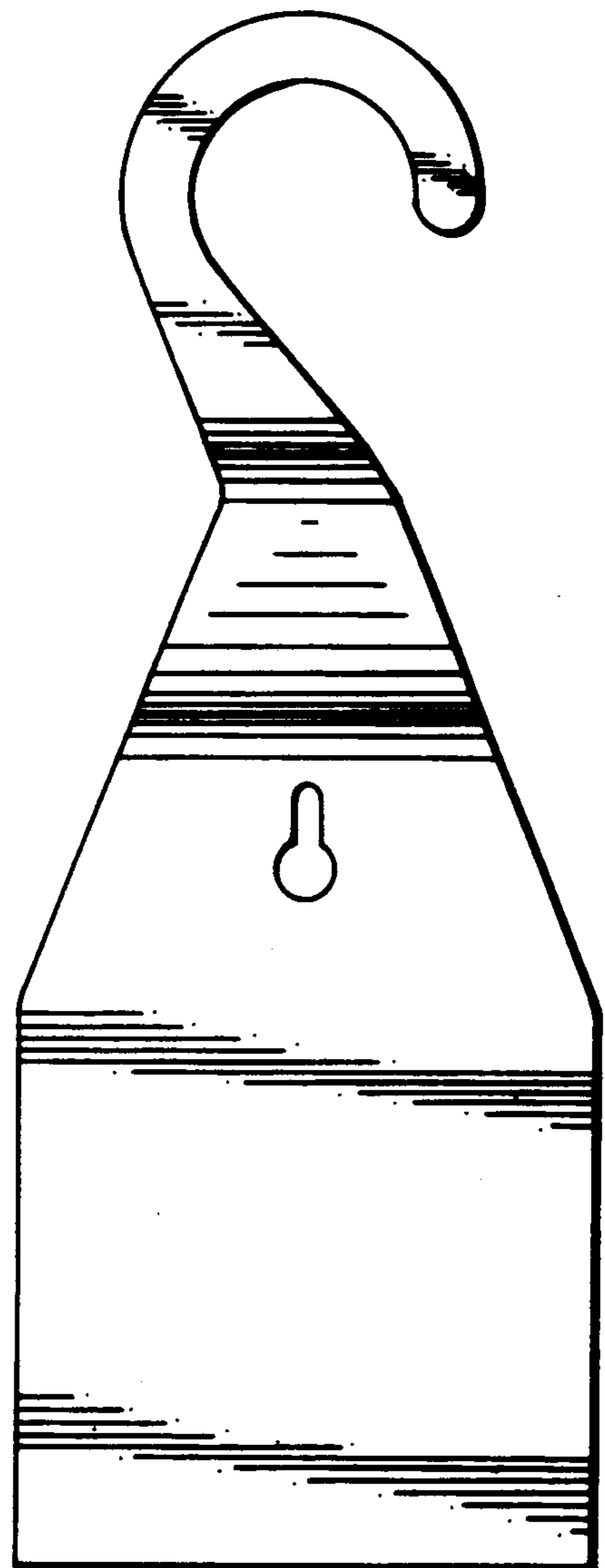

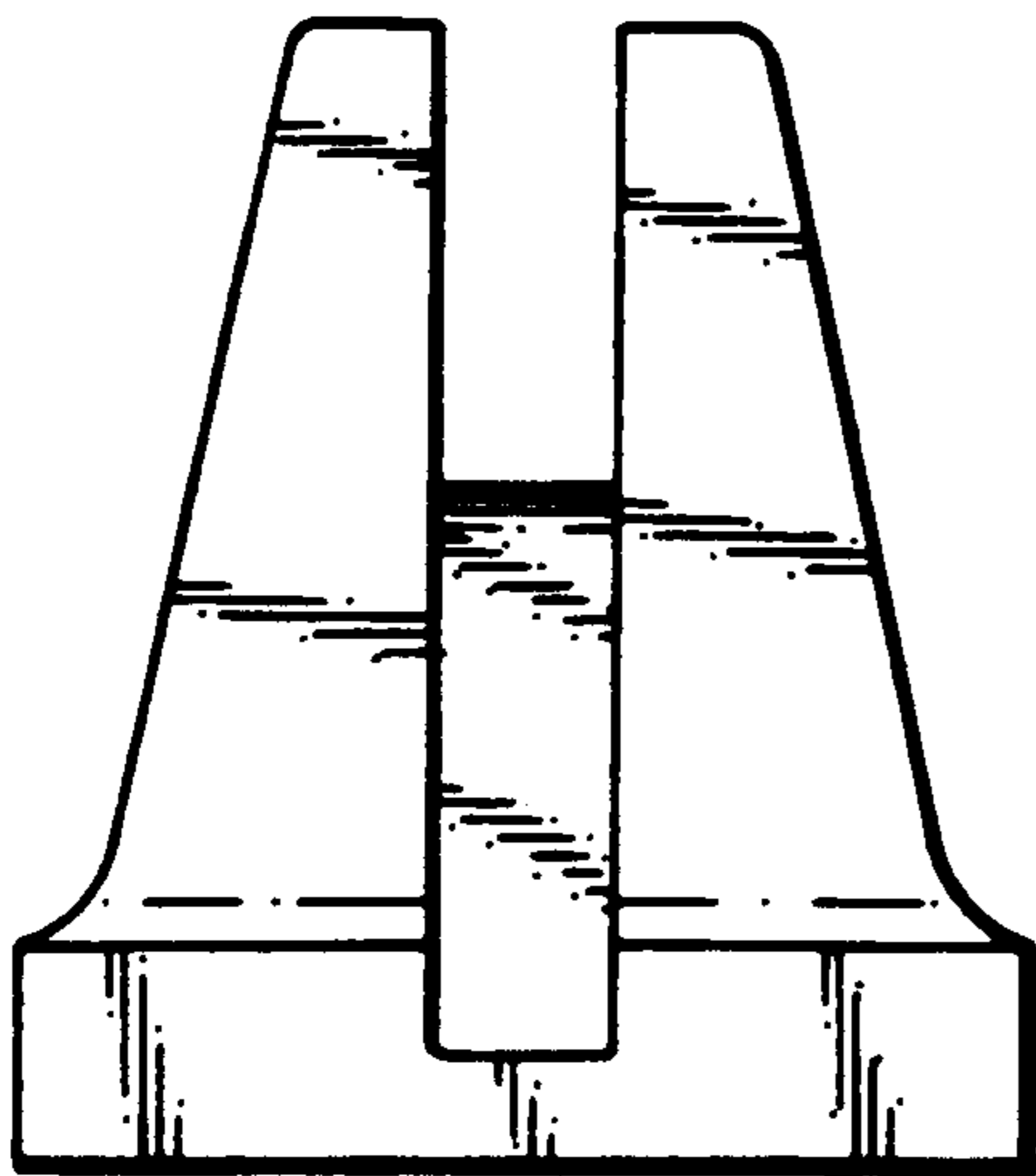

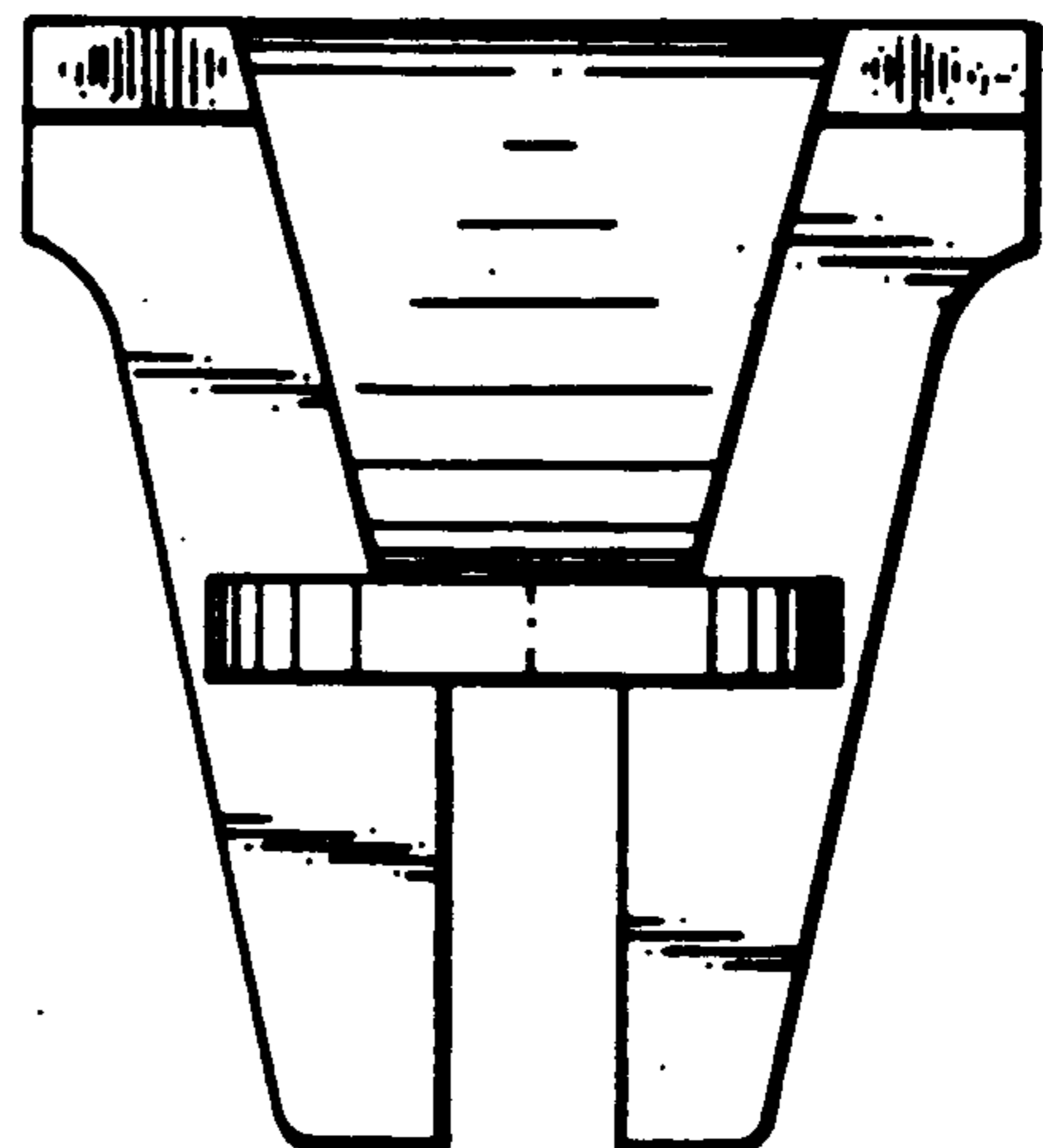

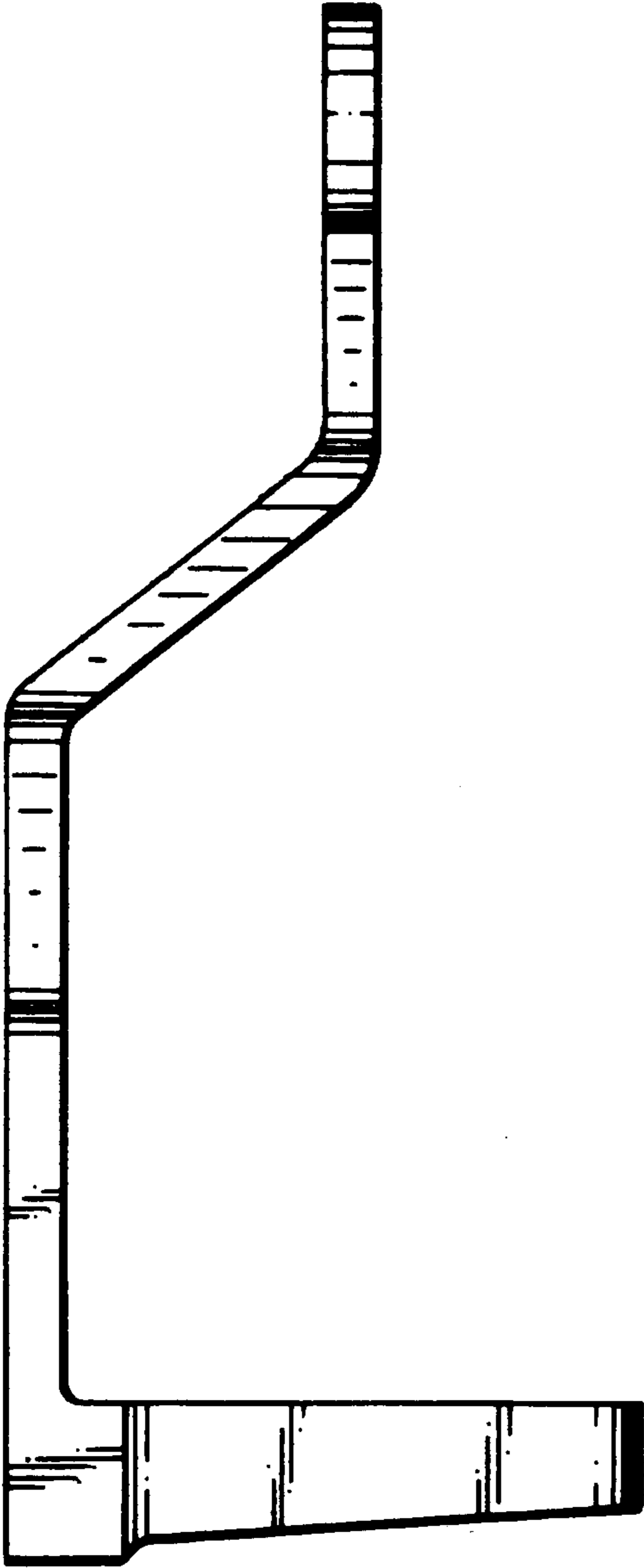

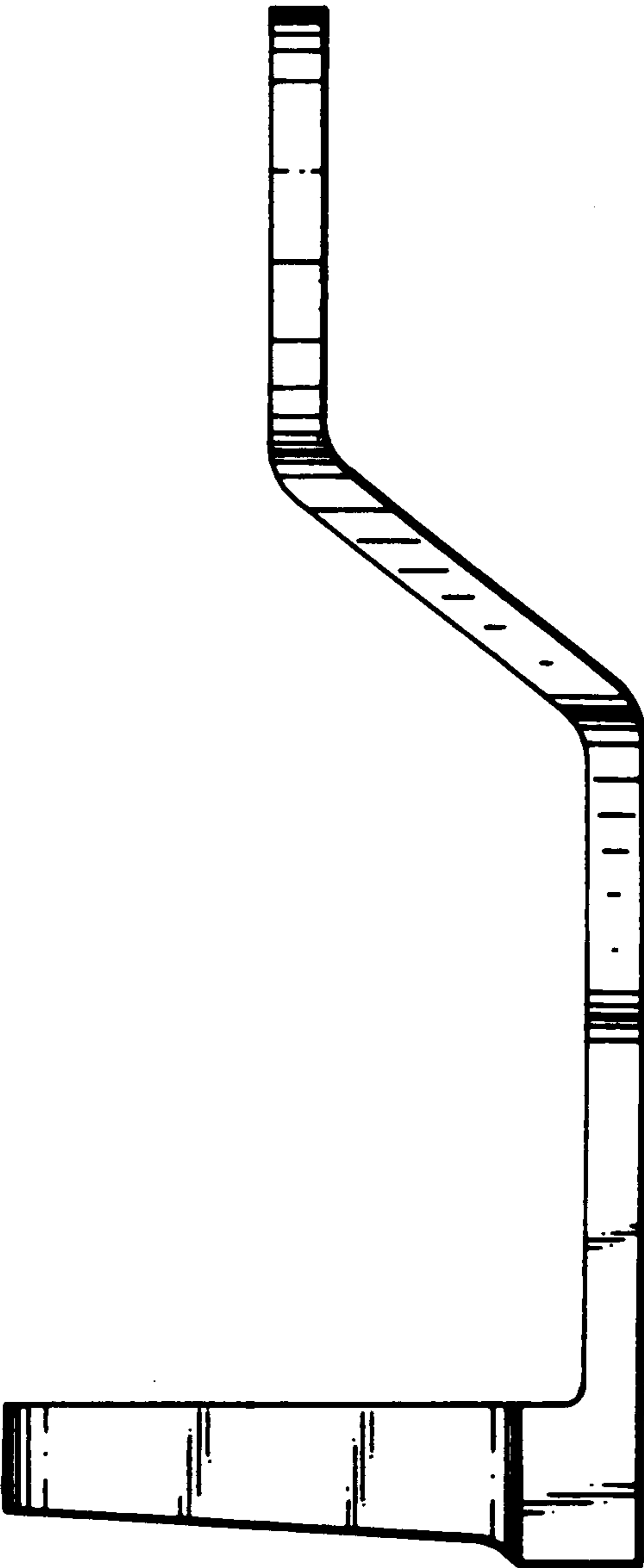
