DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, bottom end, left side perspective view of a computer mouse showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a top end elevational view thereof.

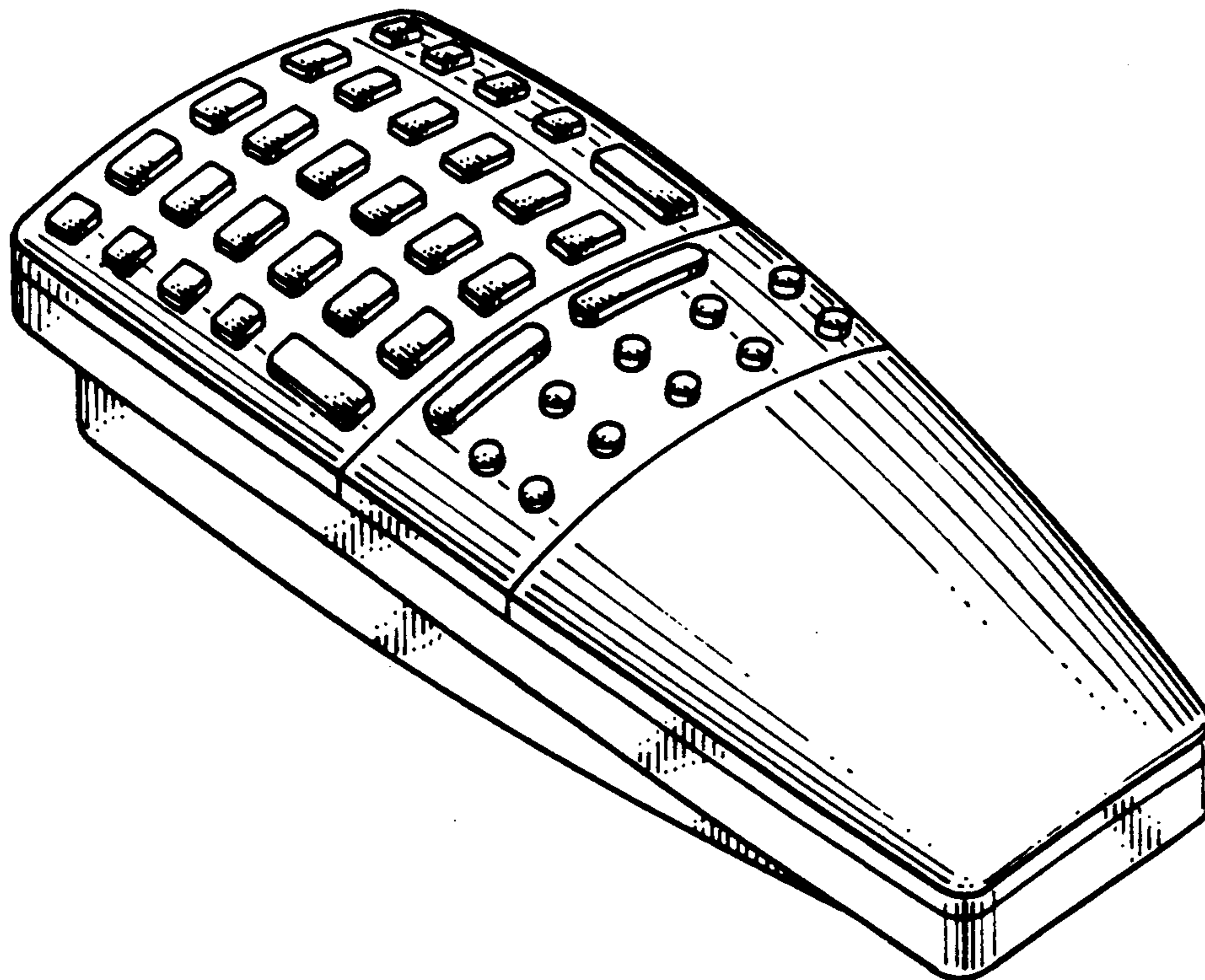

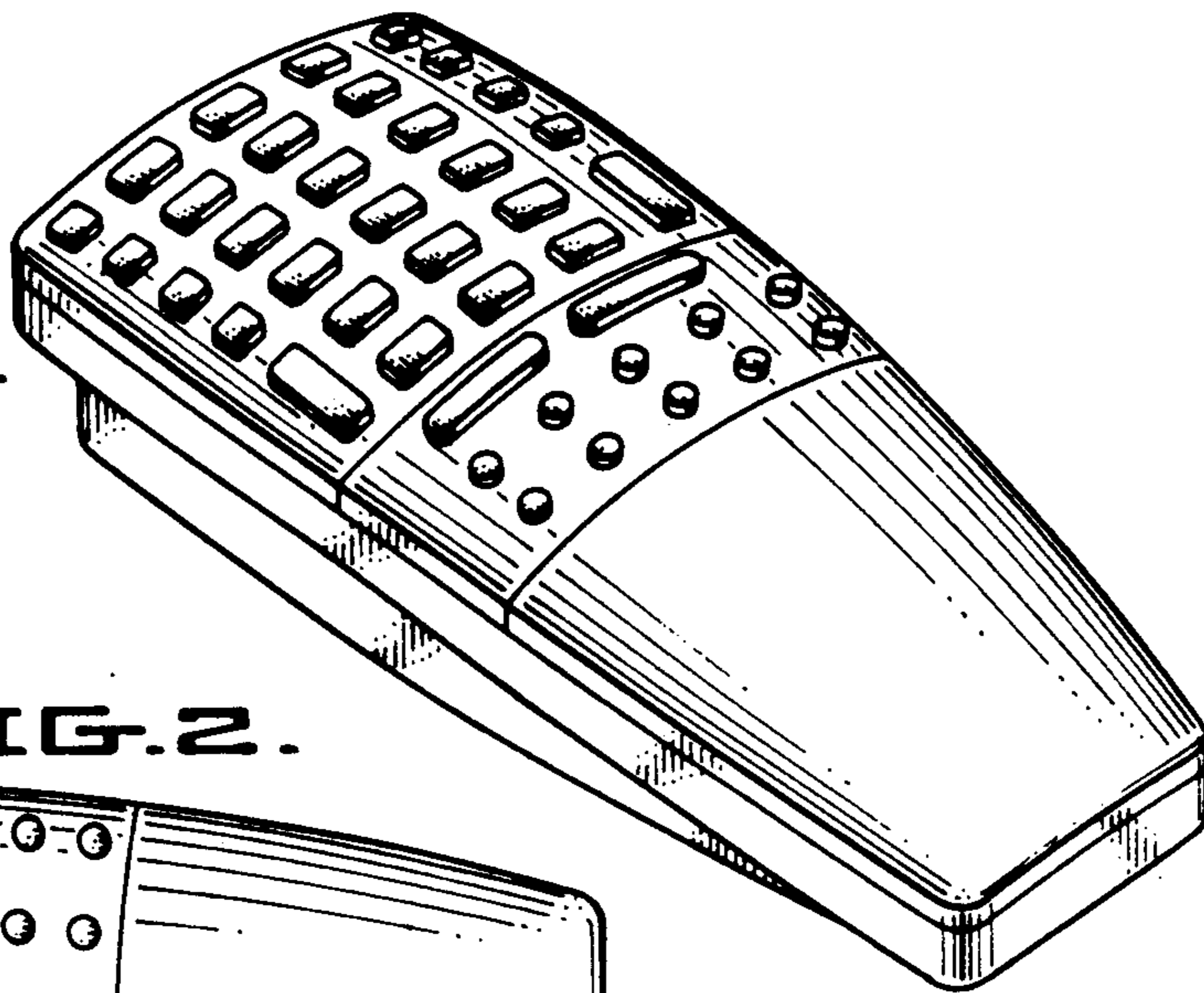

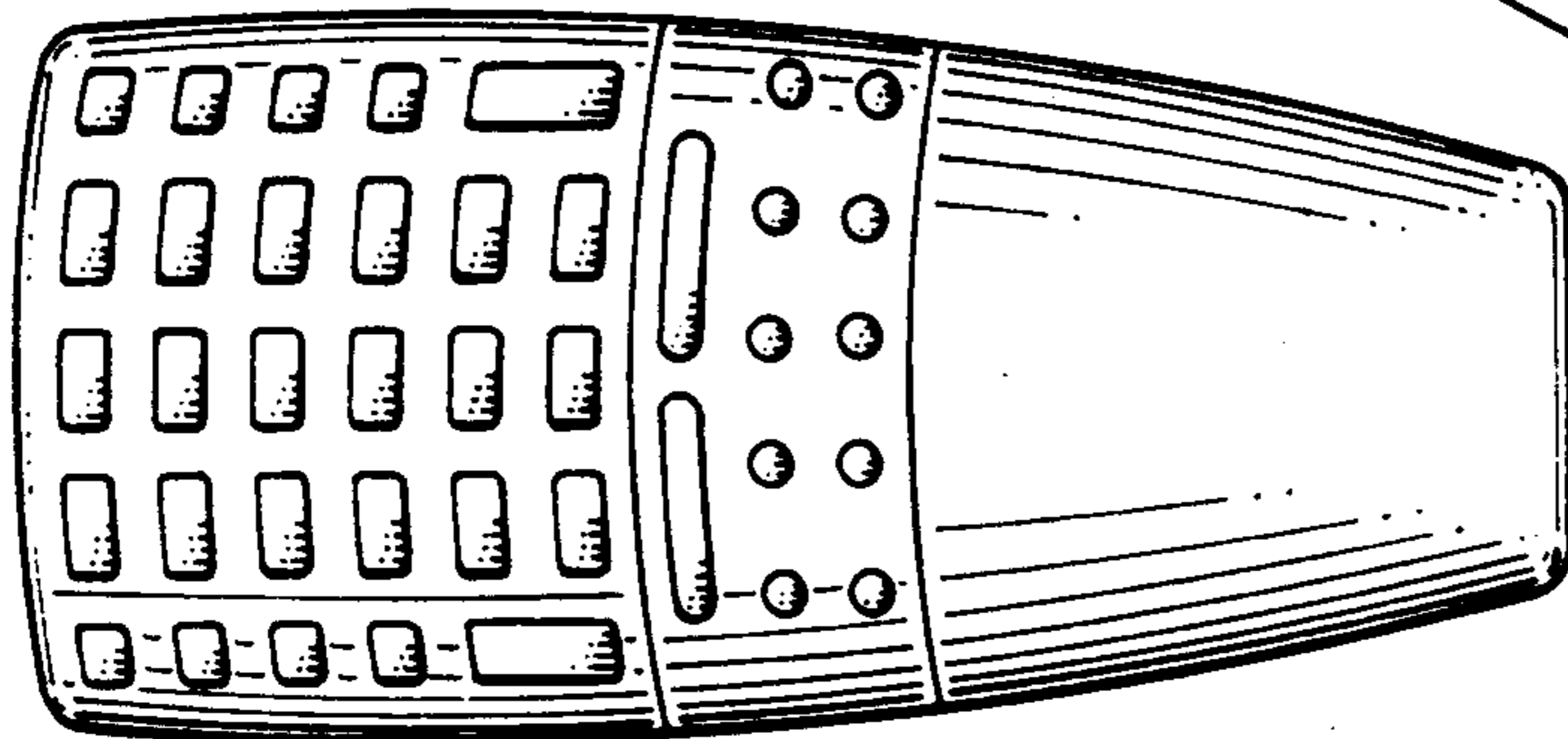

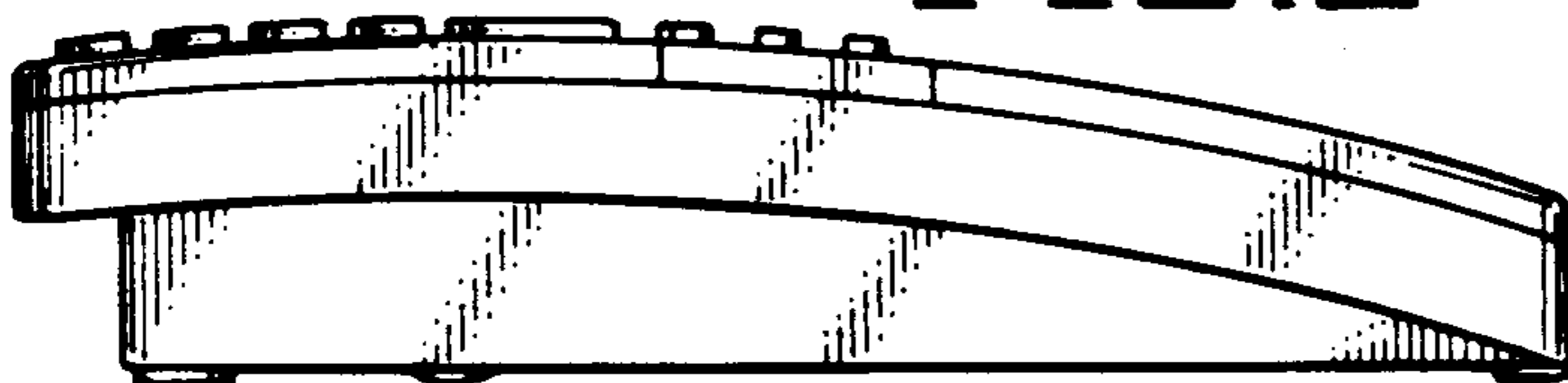

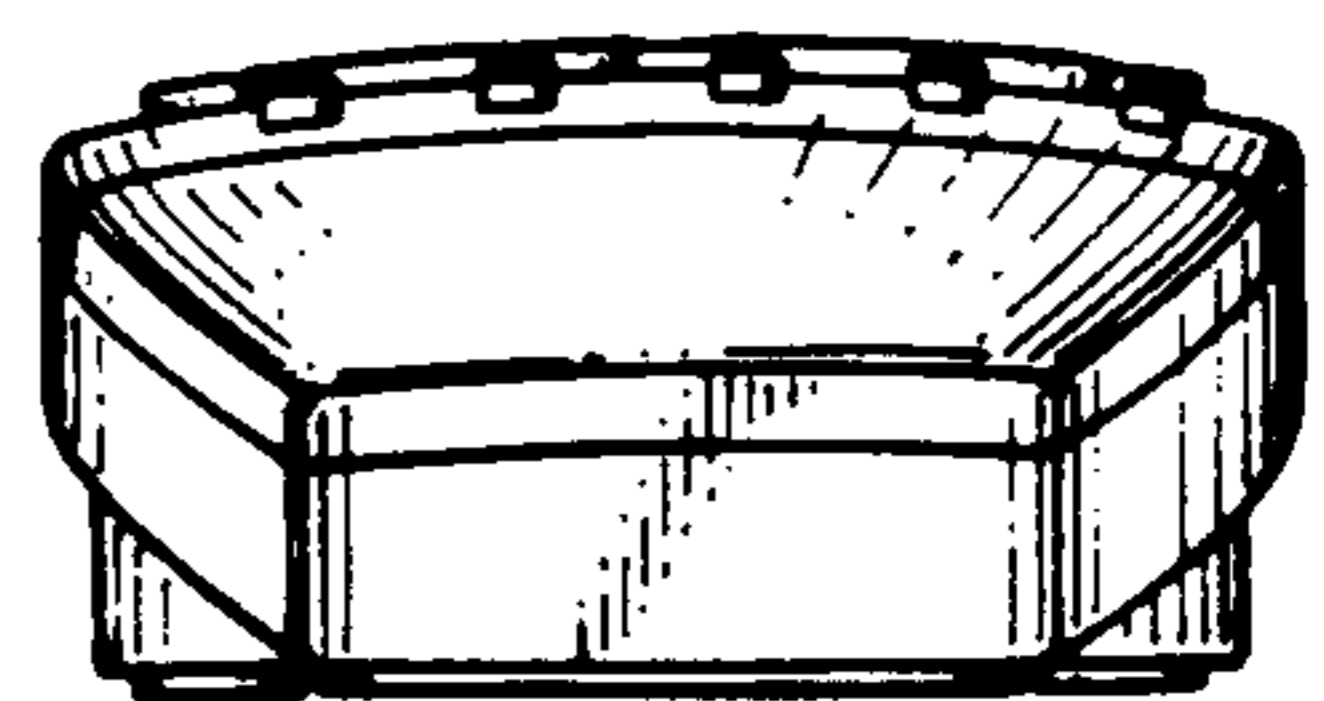

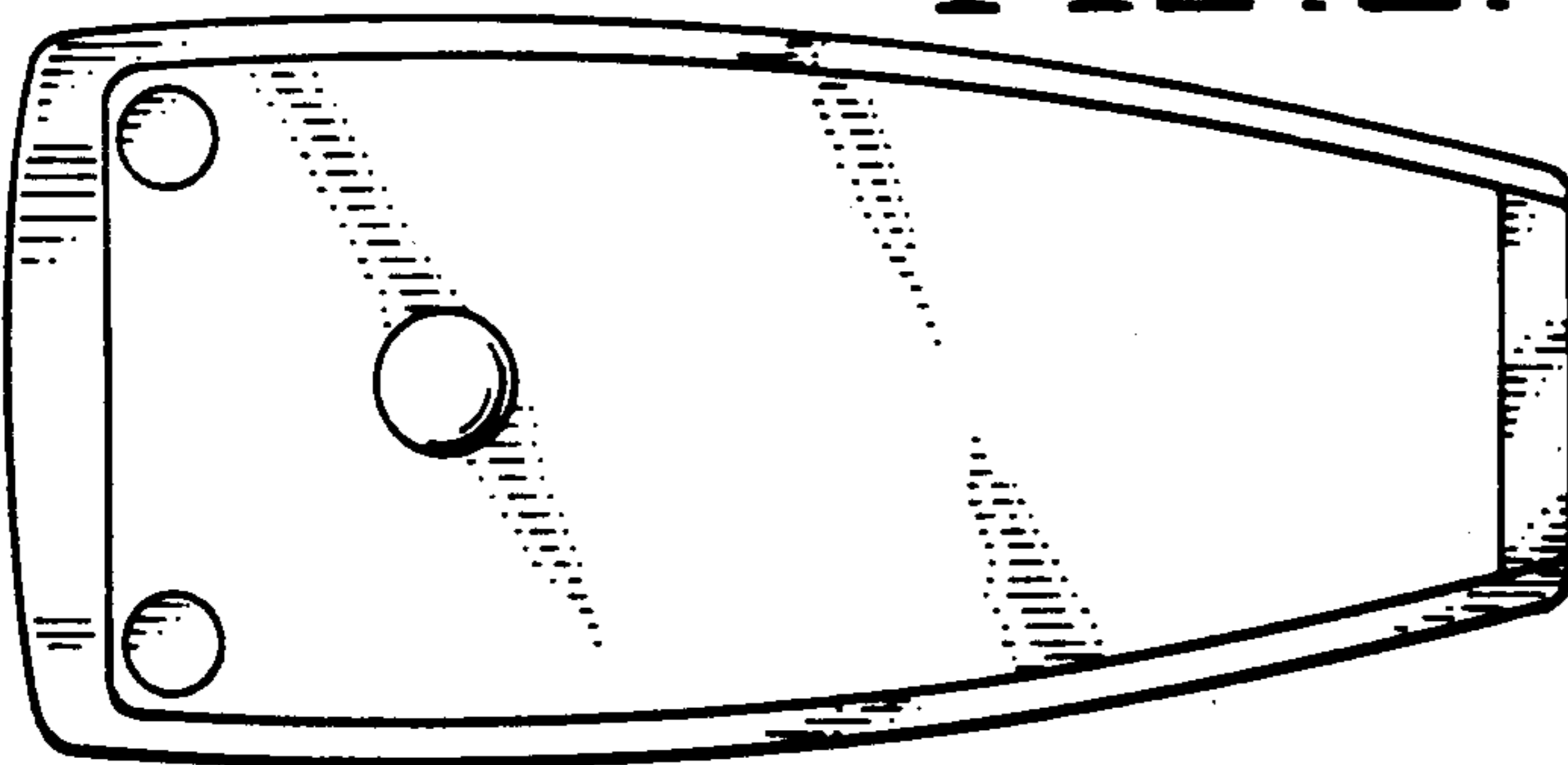

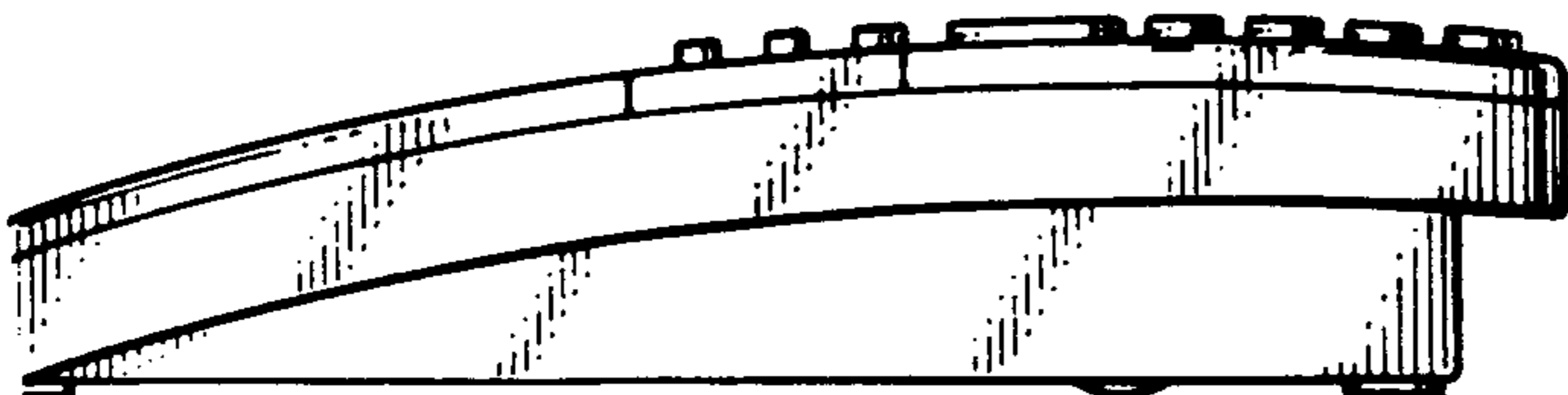
