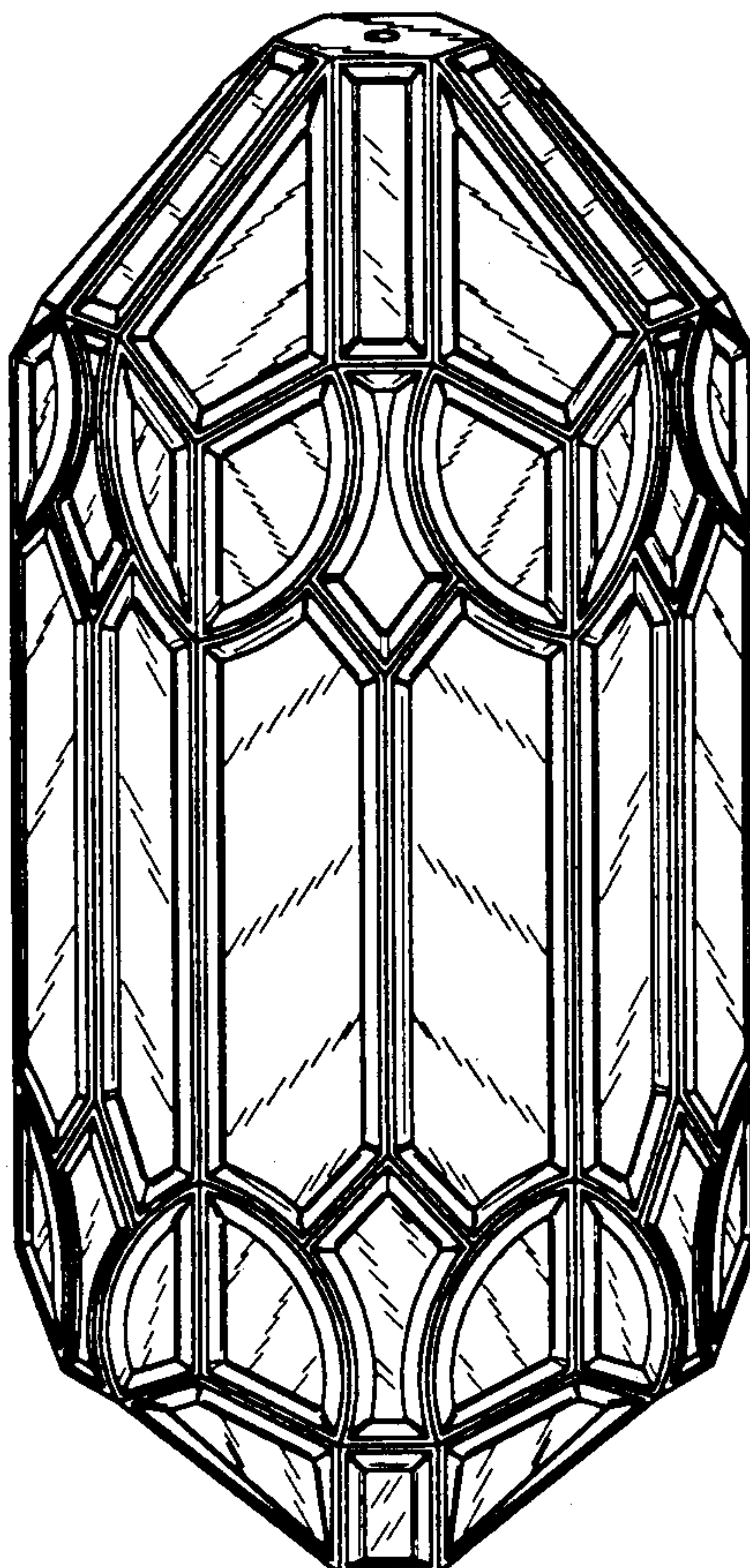

 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale, the bottom being identical.



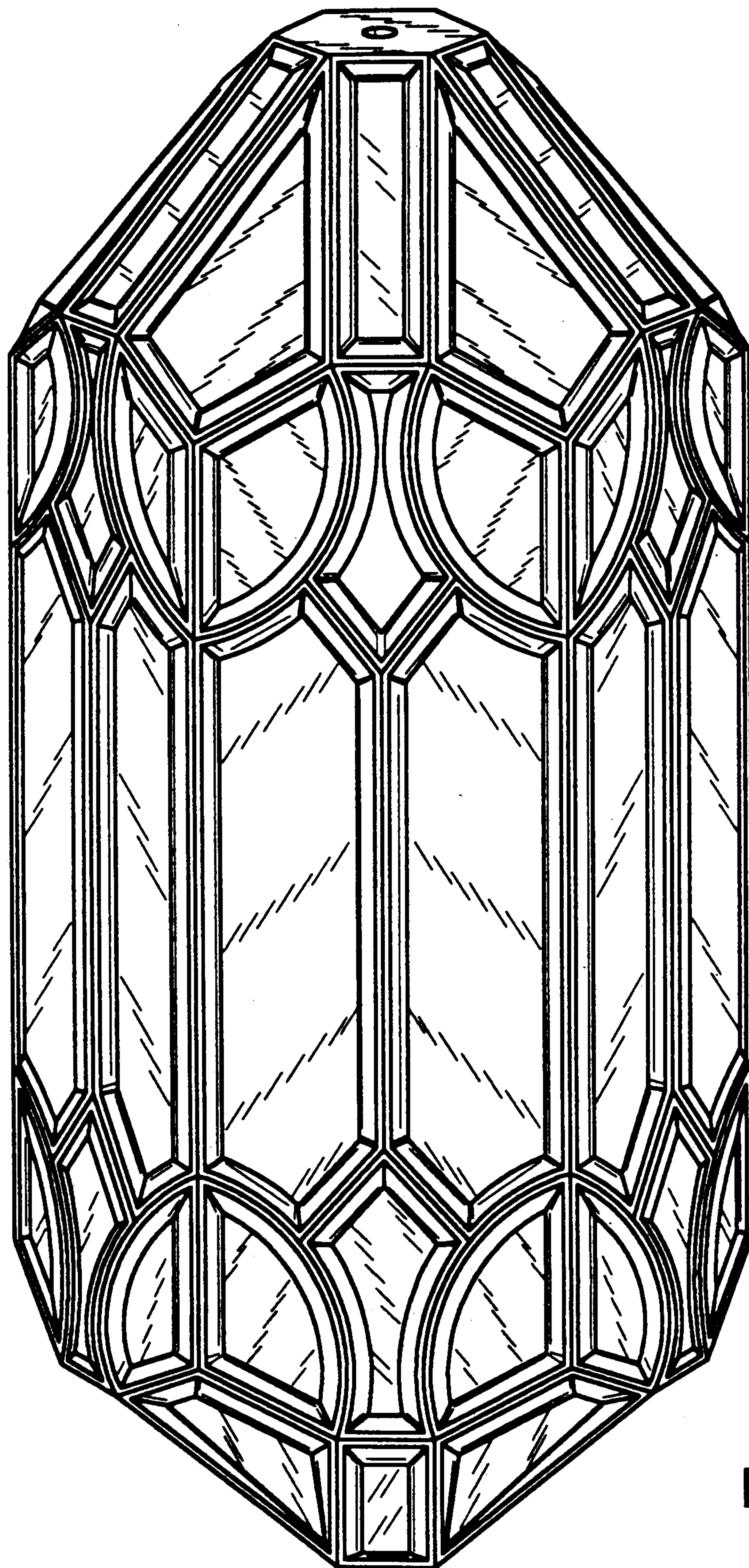

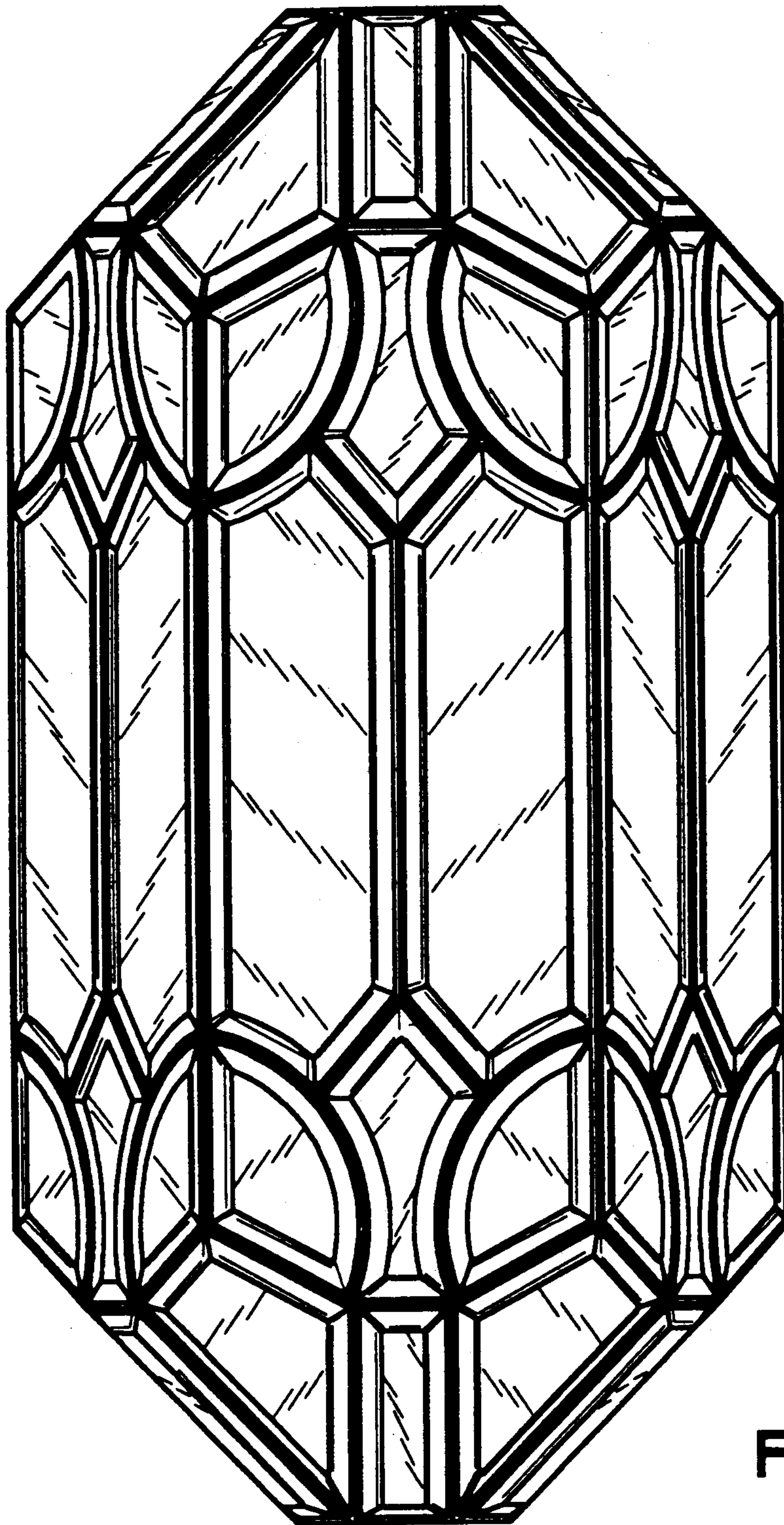

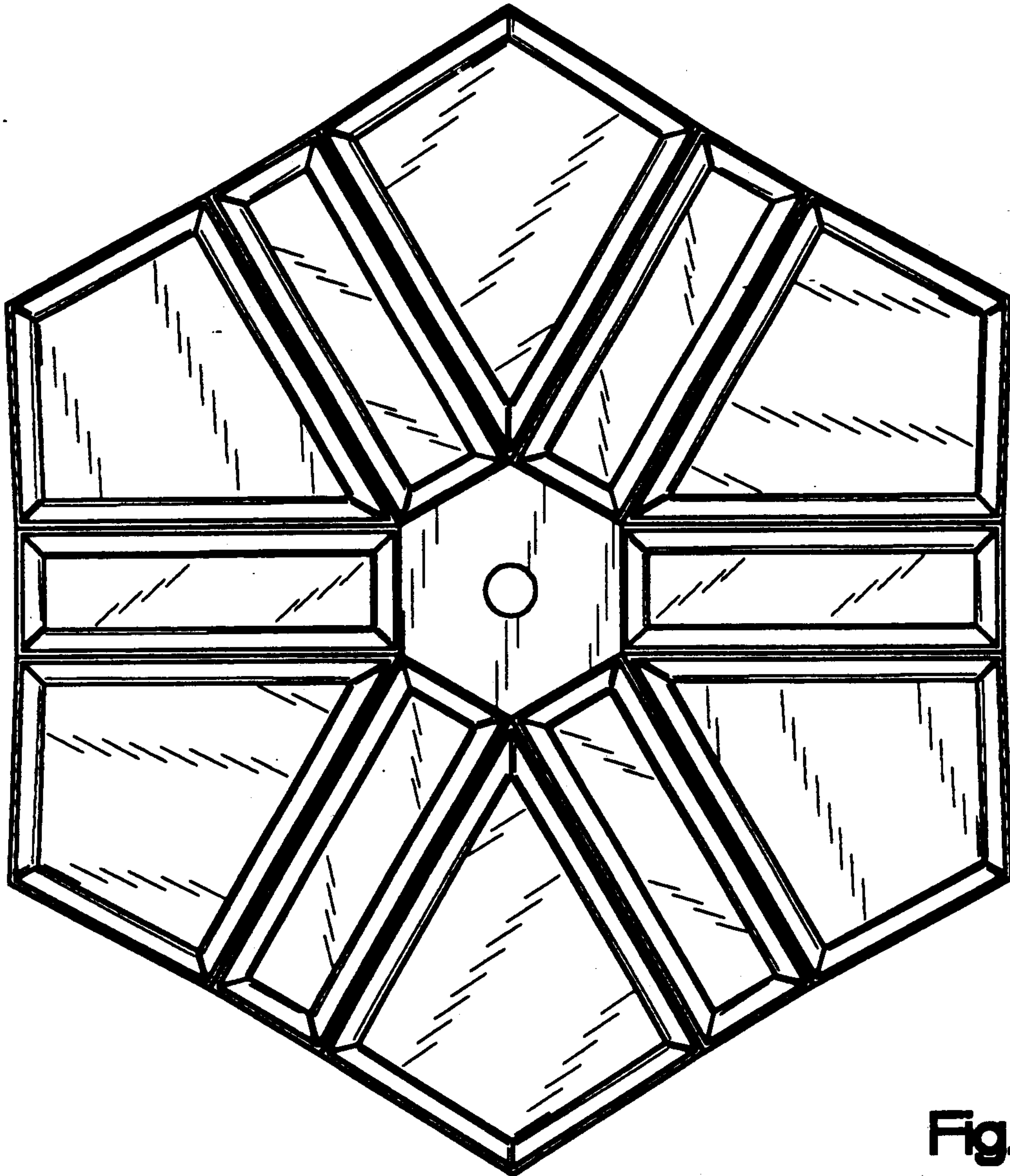
