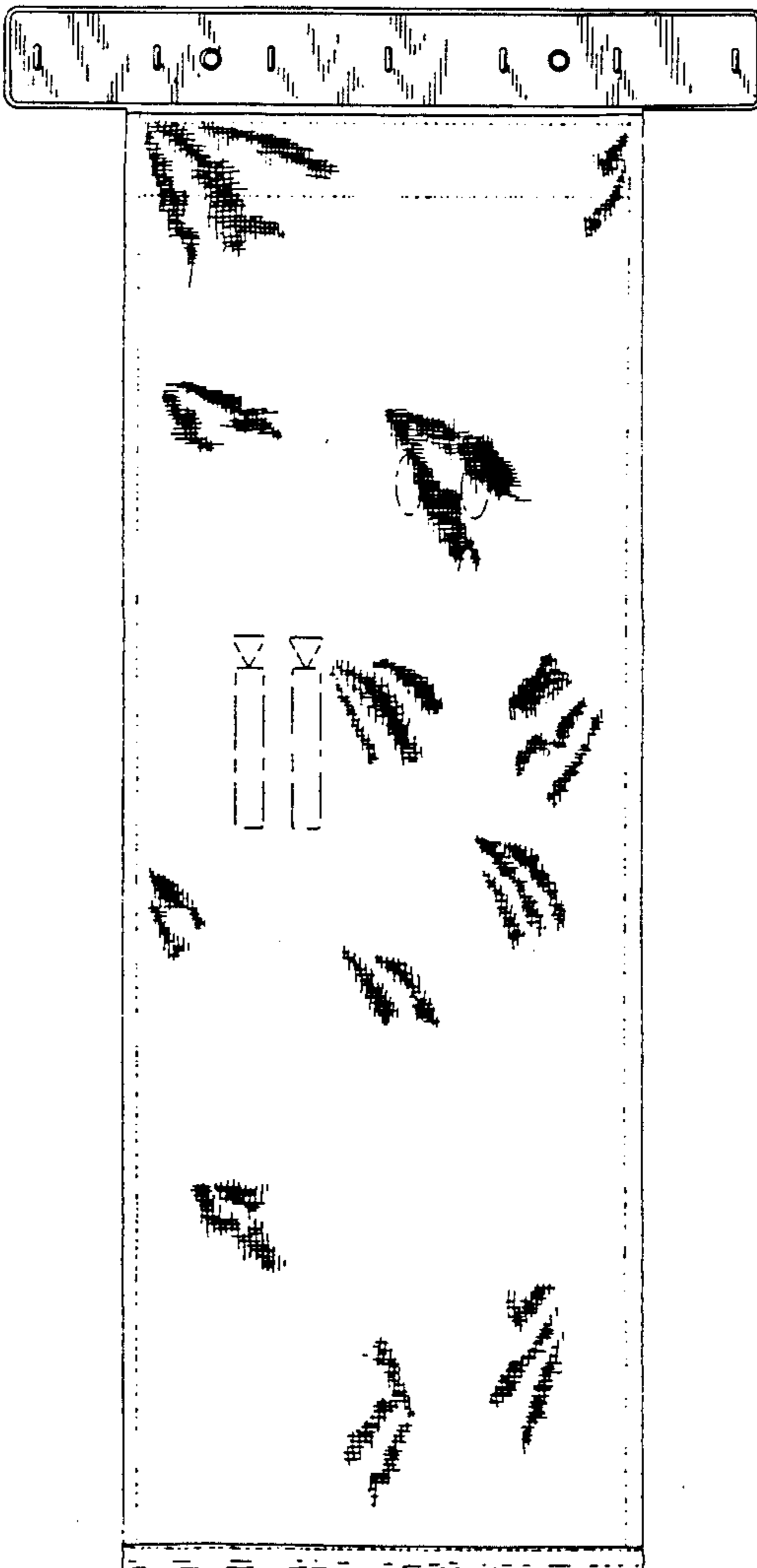

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a holder for display and storage of jewelry, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a holder for display and storage of jewelry showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; The broken line showing of jewelry is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



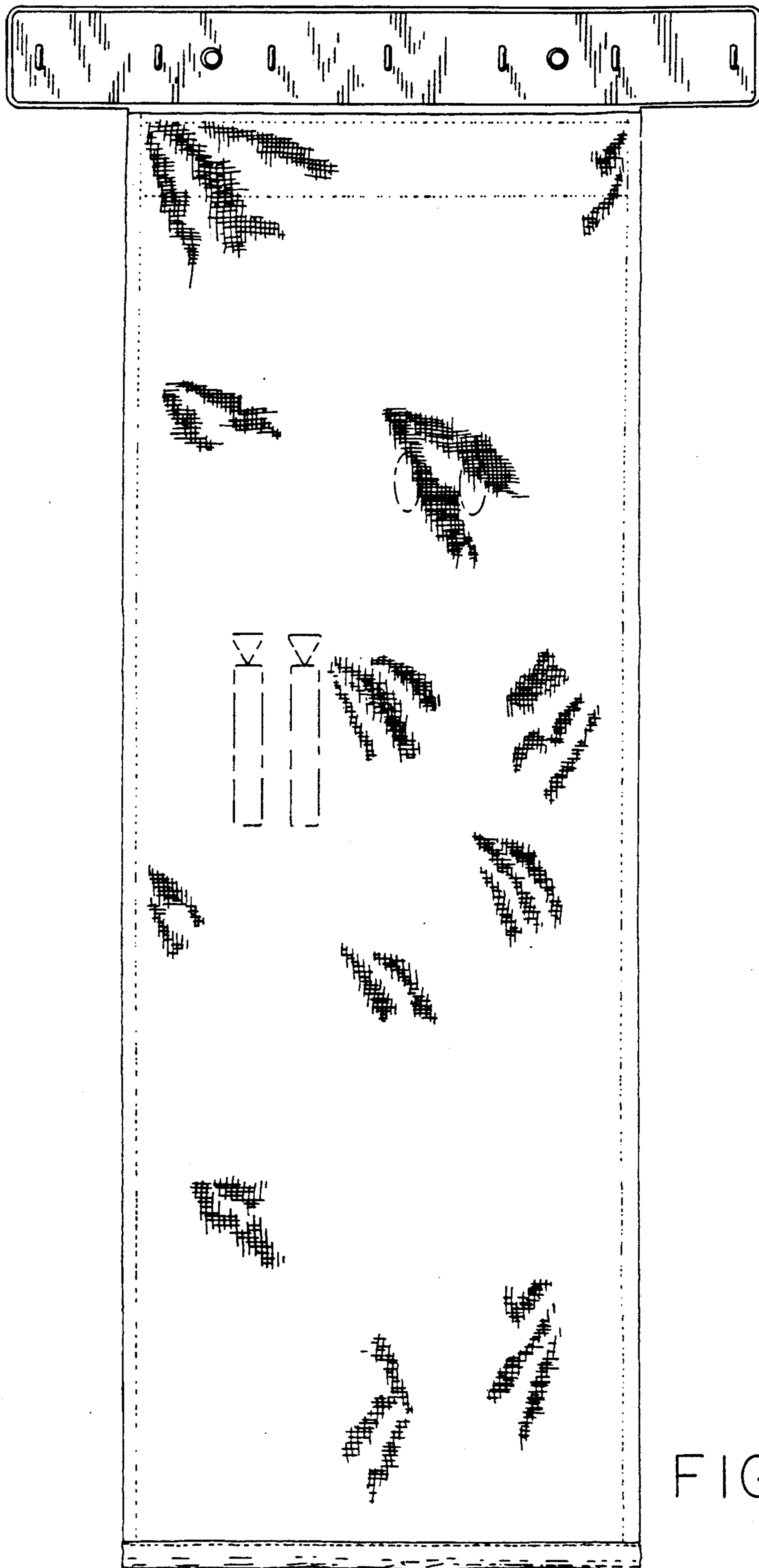

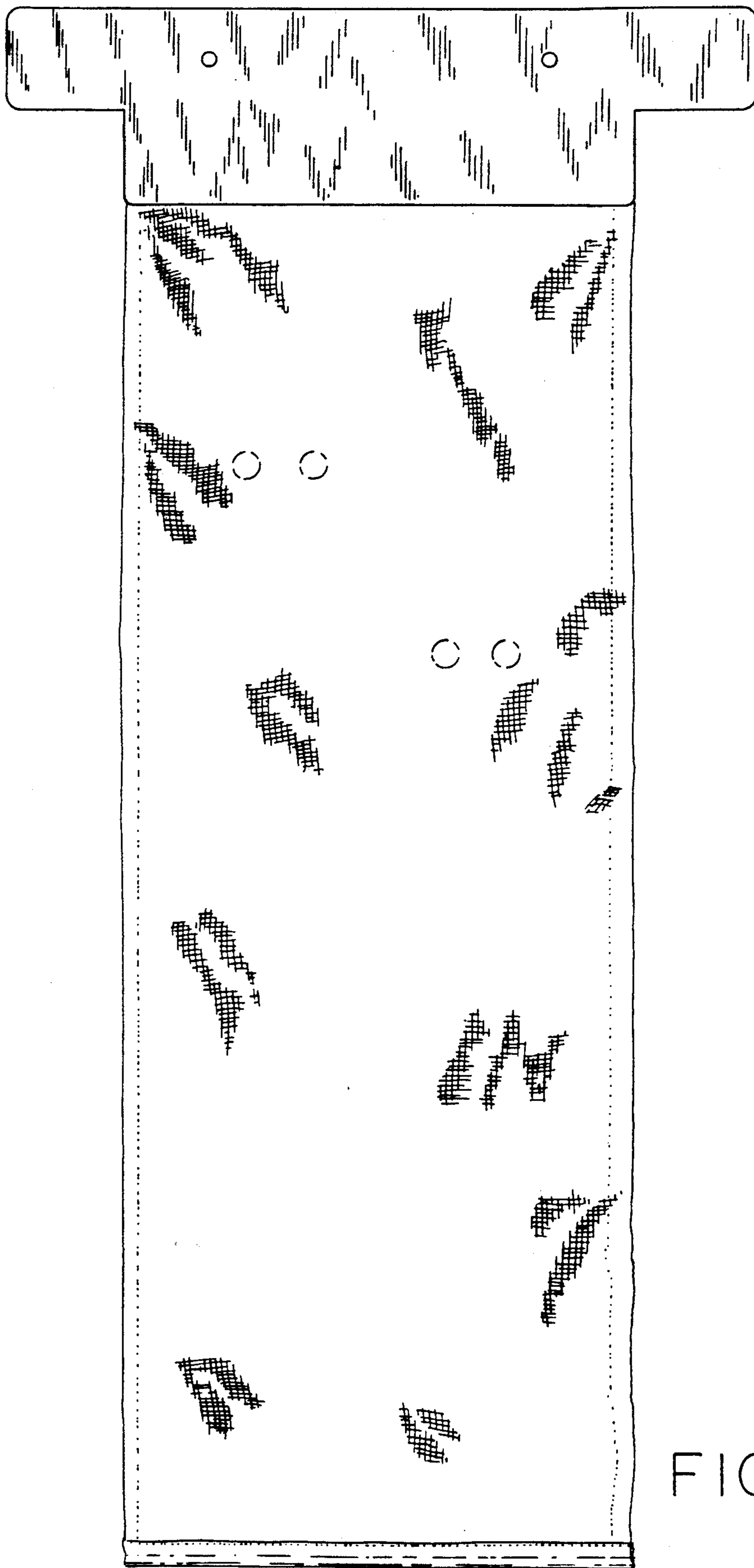

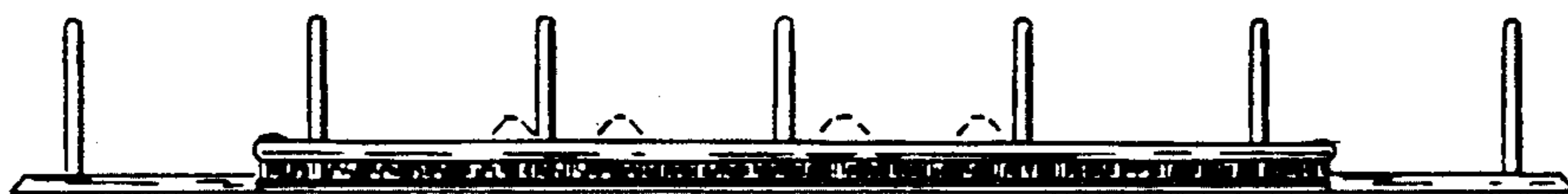
