[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a two-way radio or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a two way radio or similar article showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof with the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

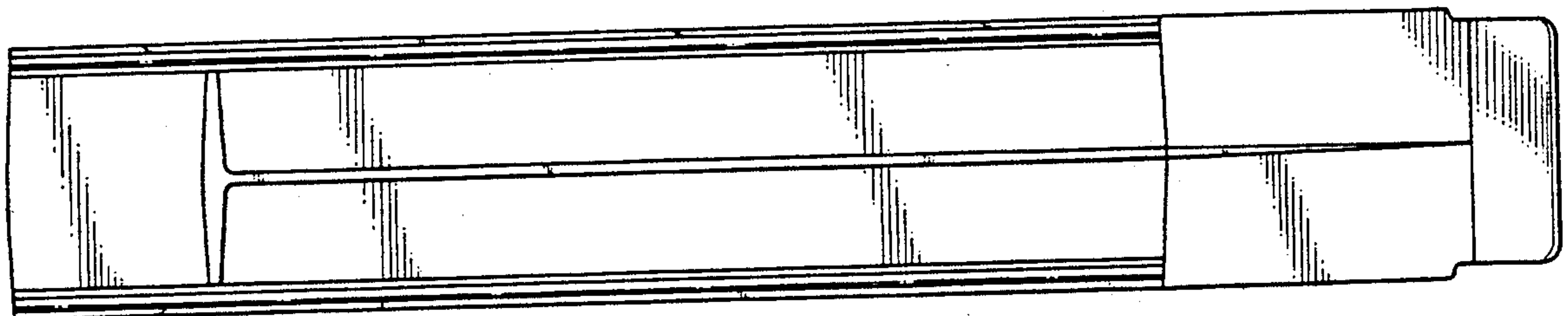
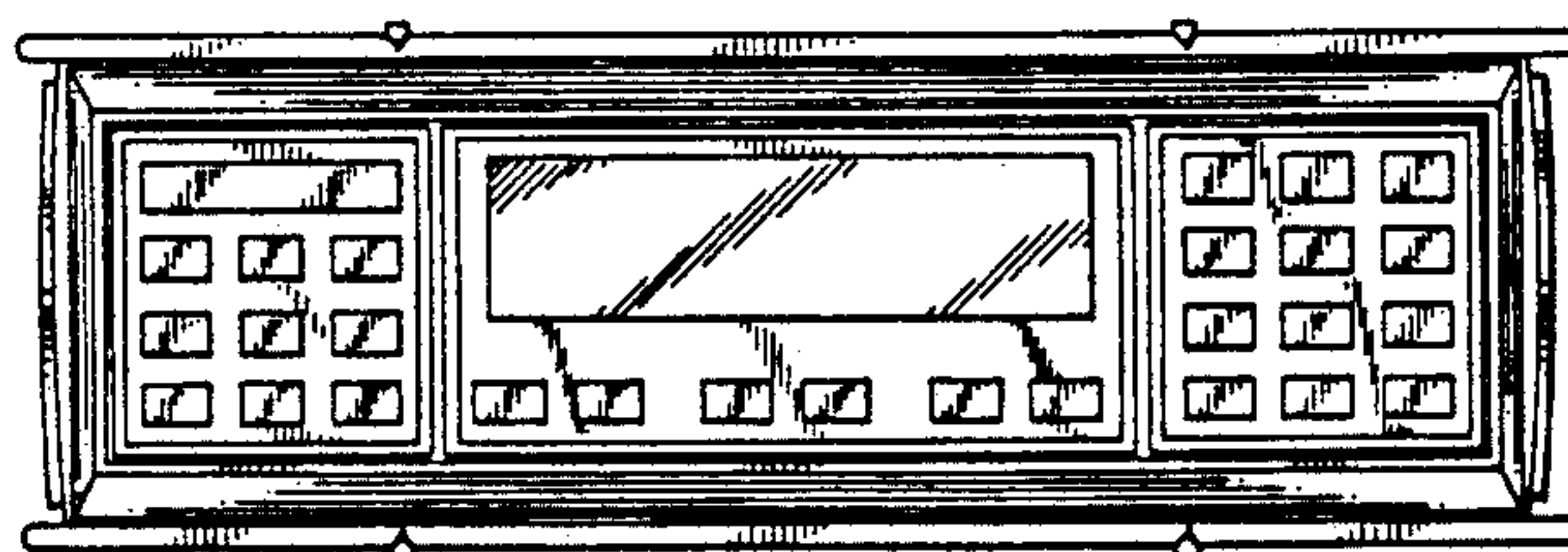

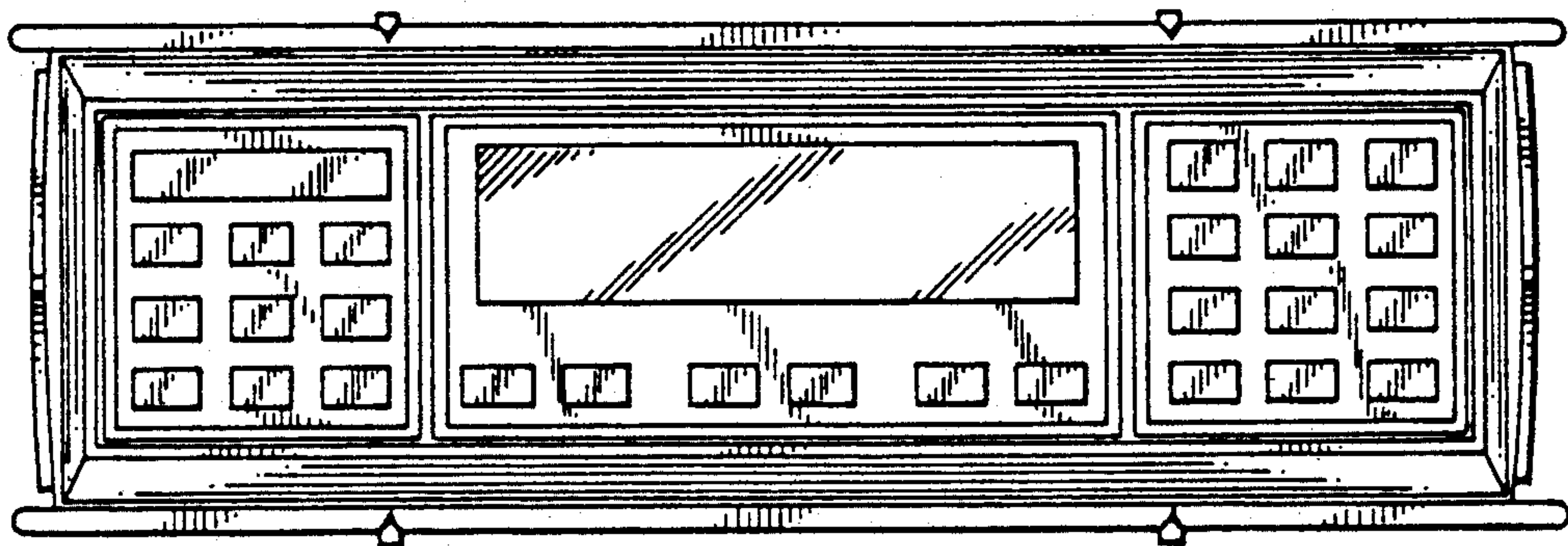

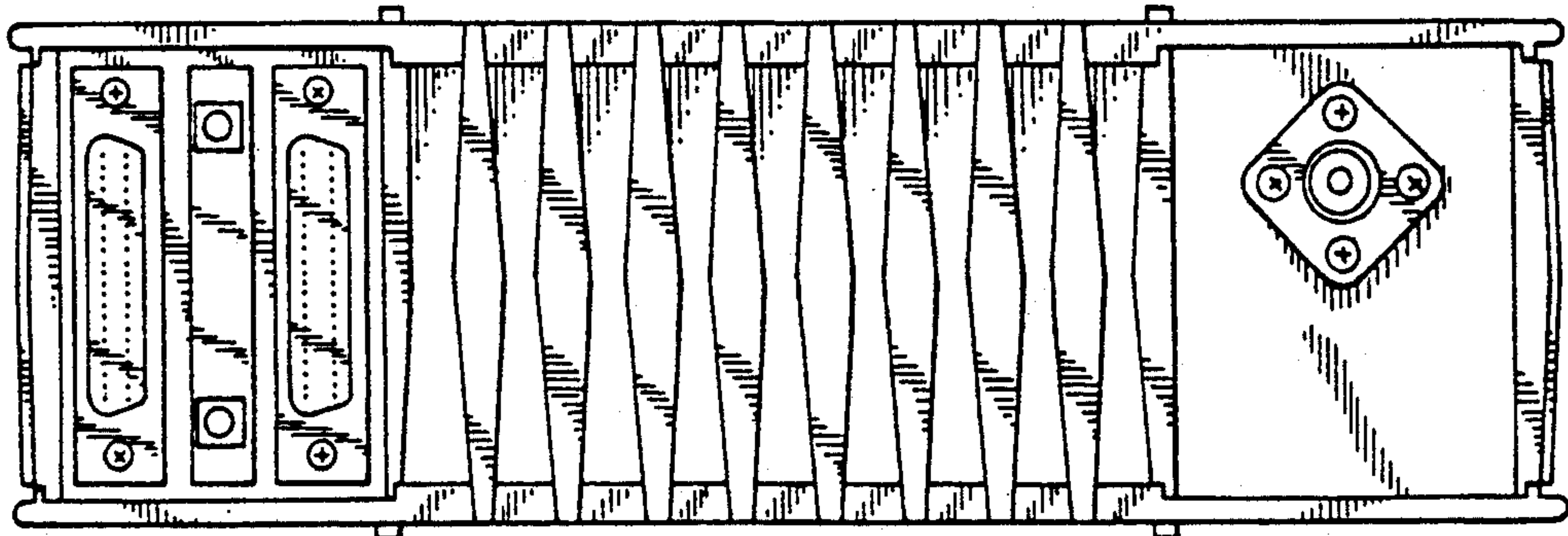

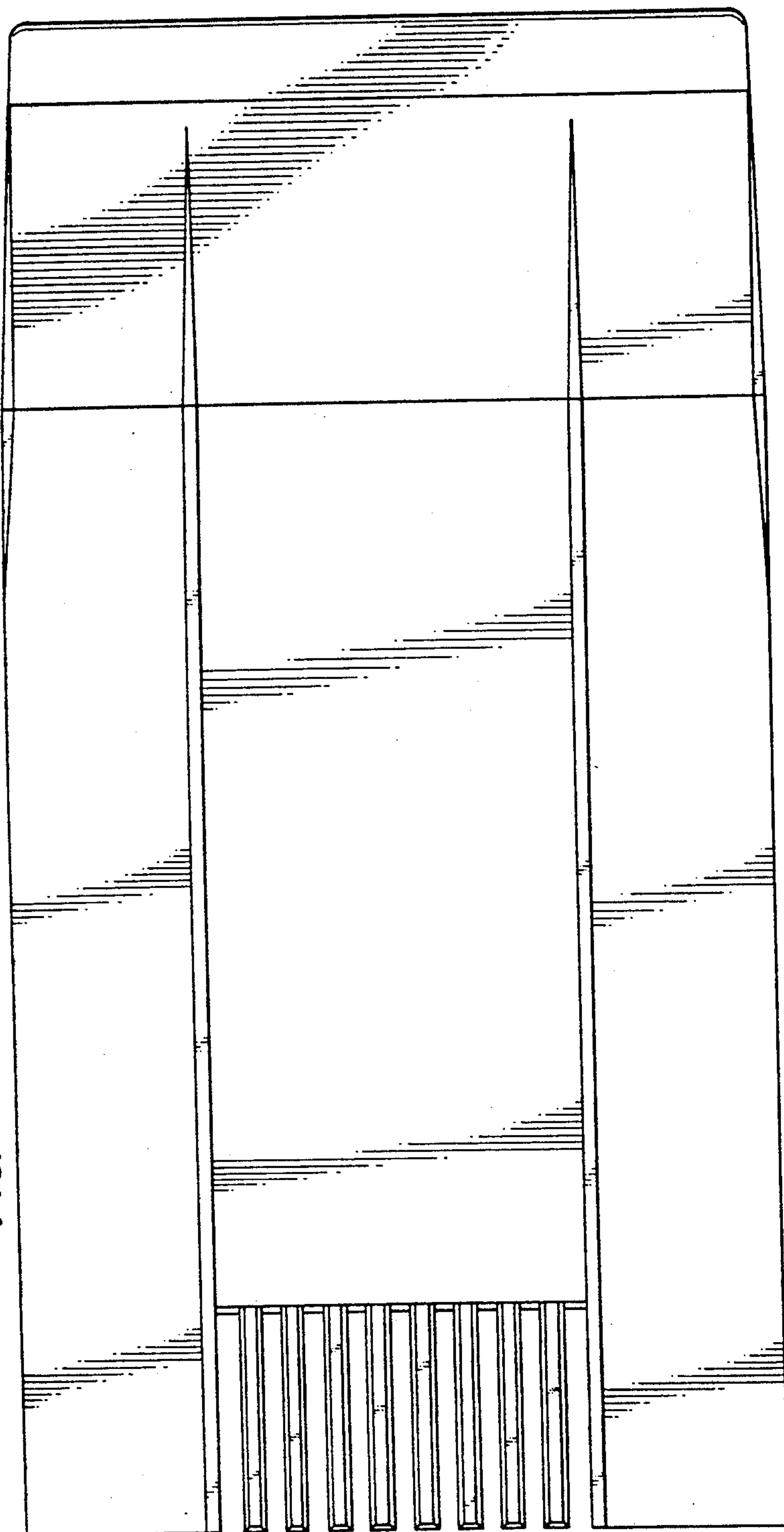
