The ornamental design for a combined tuner, amplifier, record player and tape player, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a combined tuner, amplifier, record player and tape player showing our new design, with the tape holders in an open position;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
















