DESCRIPTION

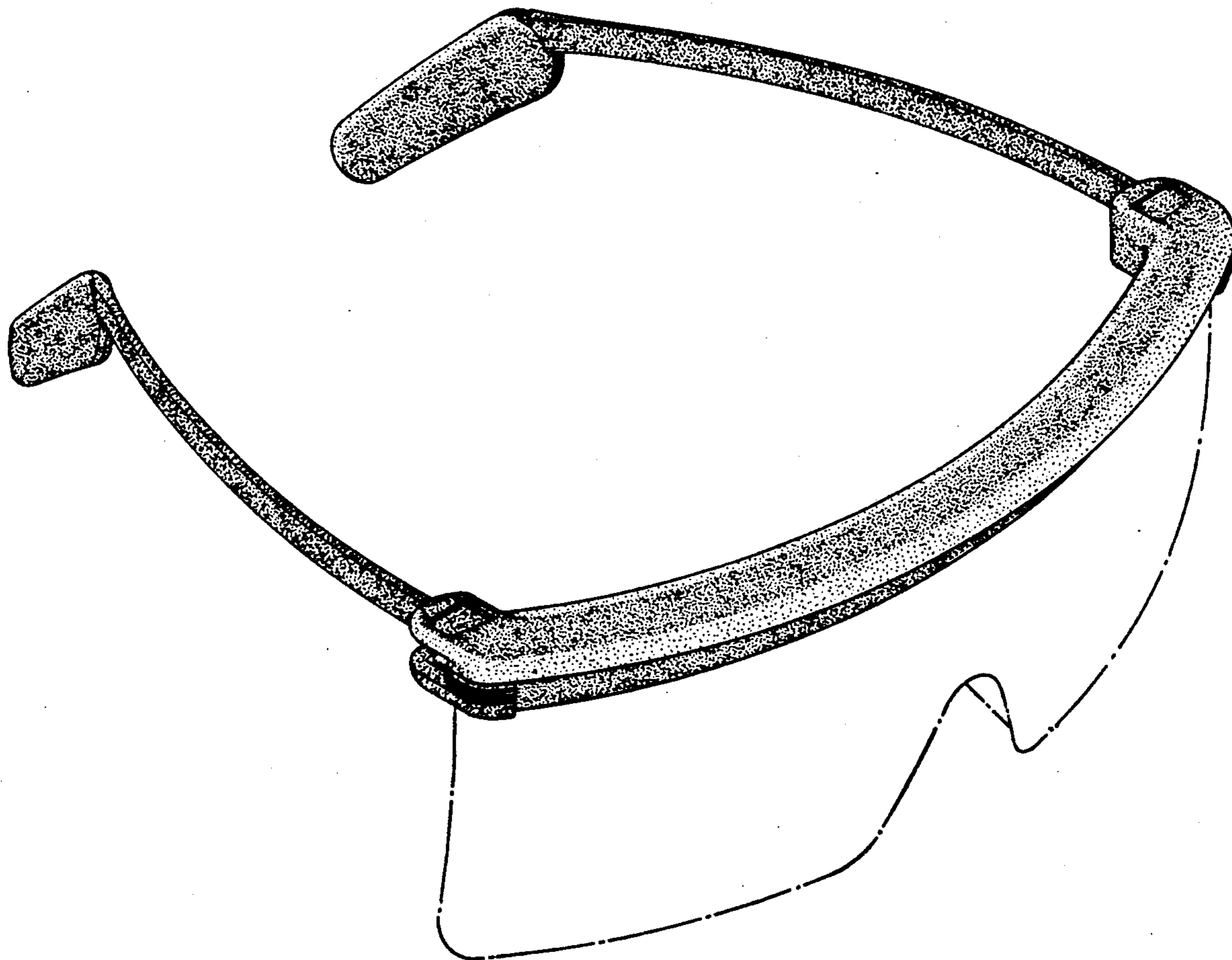
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the eyeglass frame
showing our new design, stipple shading having been
used to indicate textured surfaces;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view of one side thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a front perspective view thereof showing the
top and other side of the eyeglass frame, the broken line
showing of the lenses being illustrative of environmen-
tal structure only and forms no part of the claimed
design.



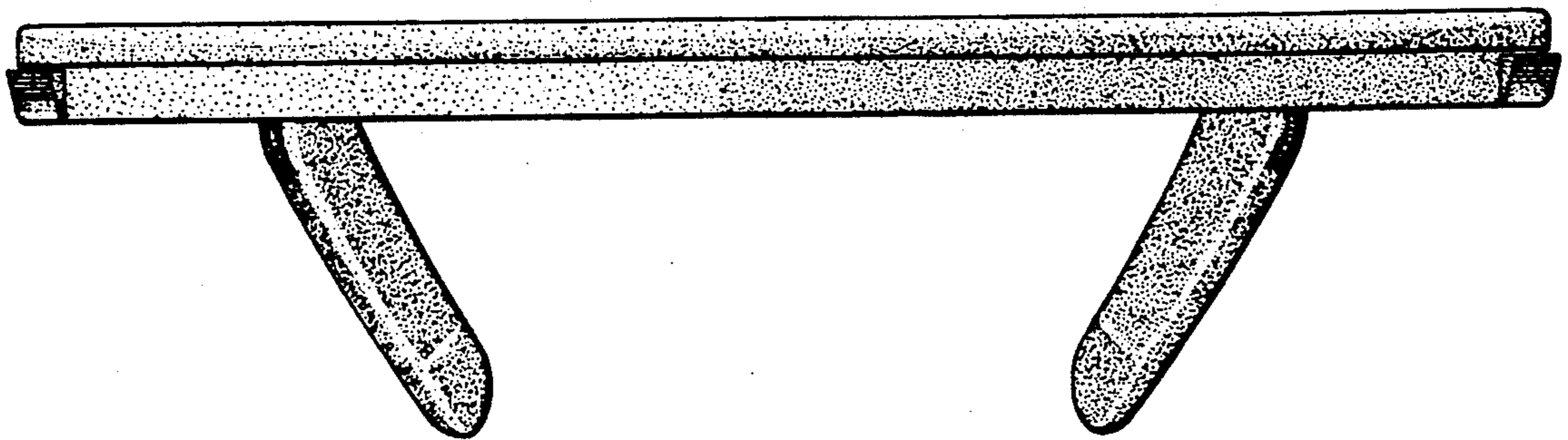

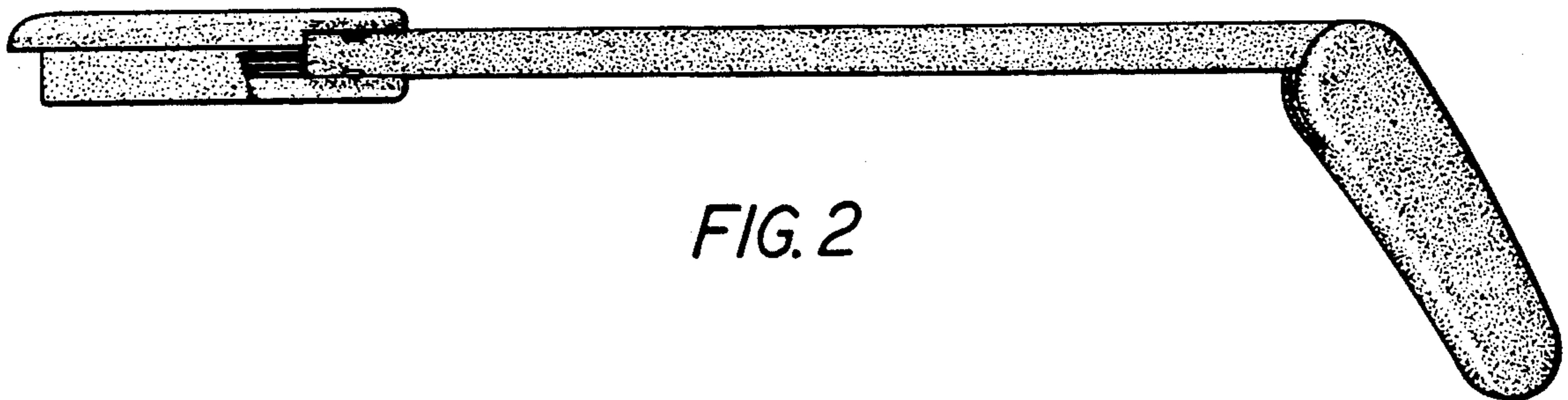

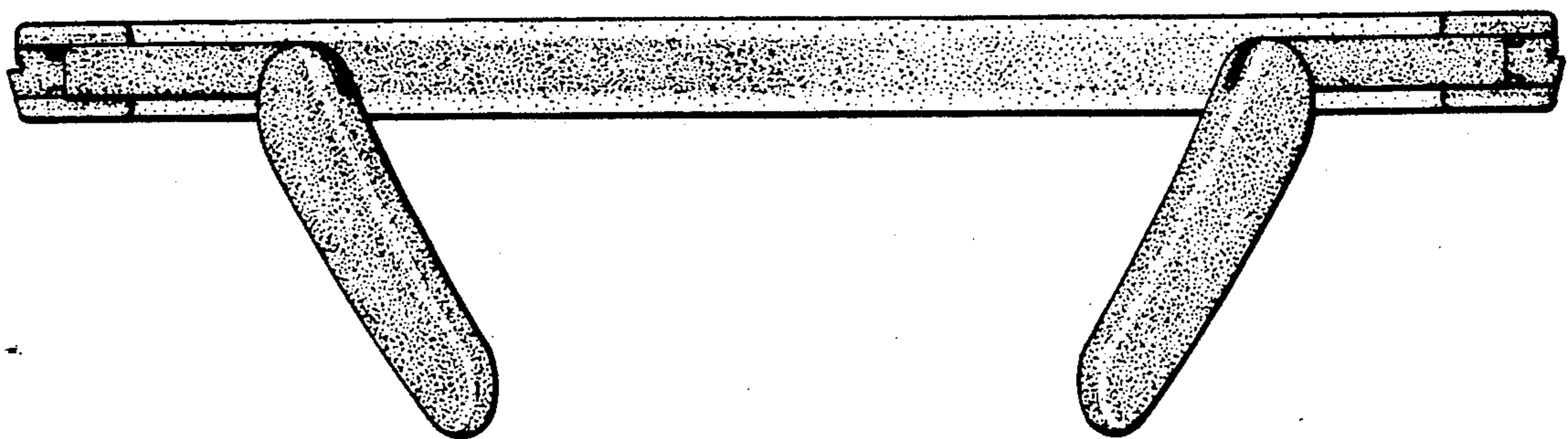

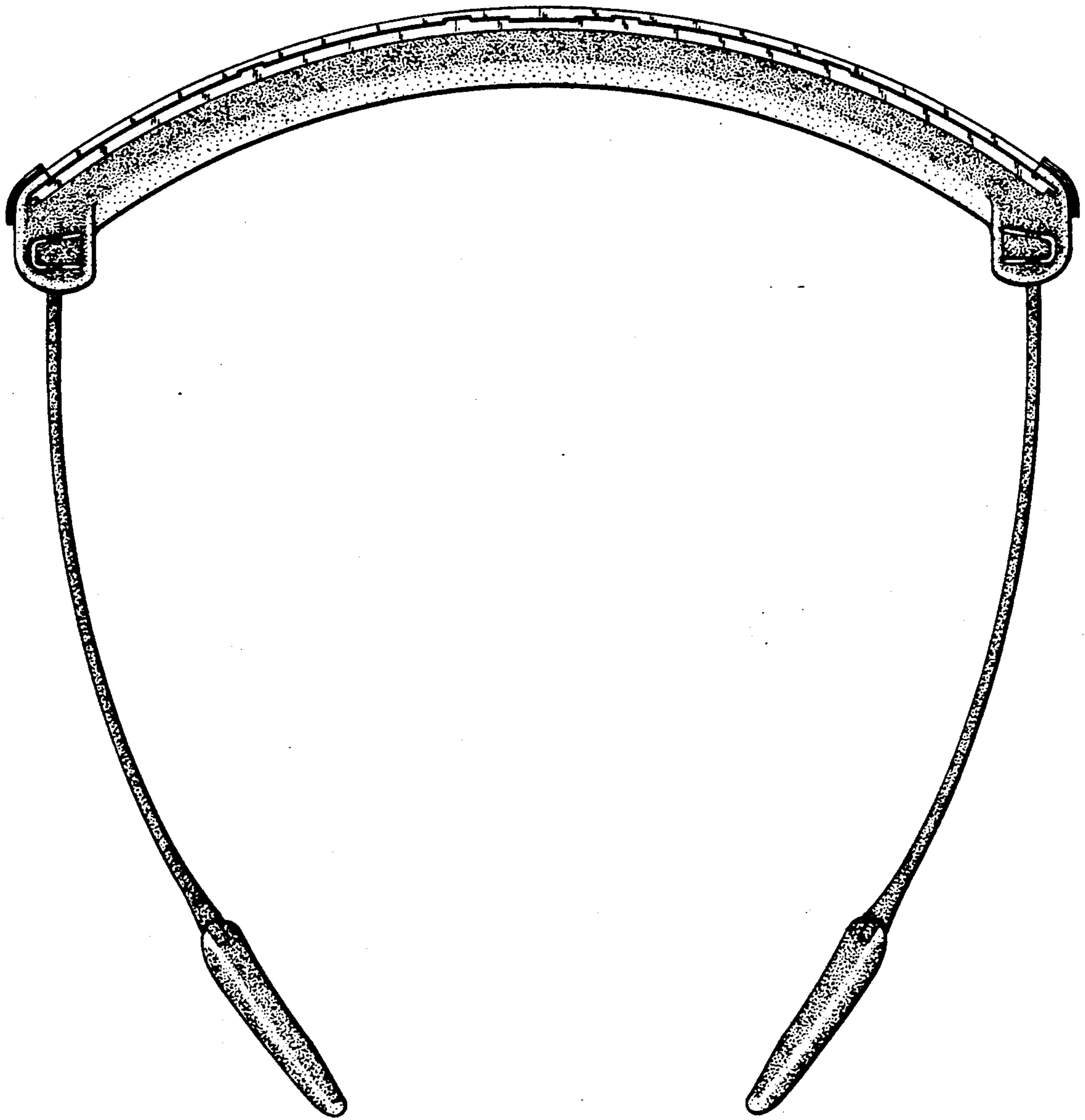

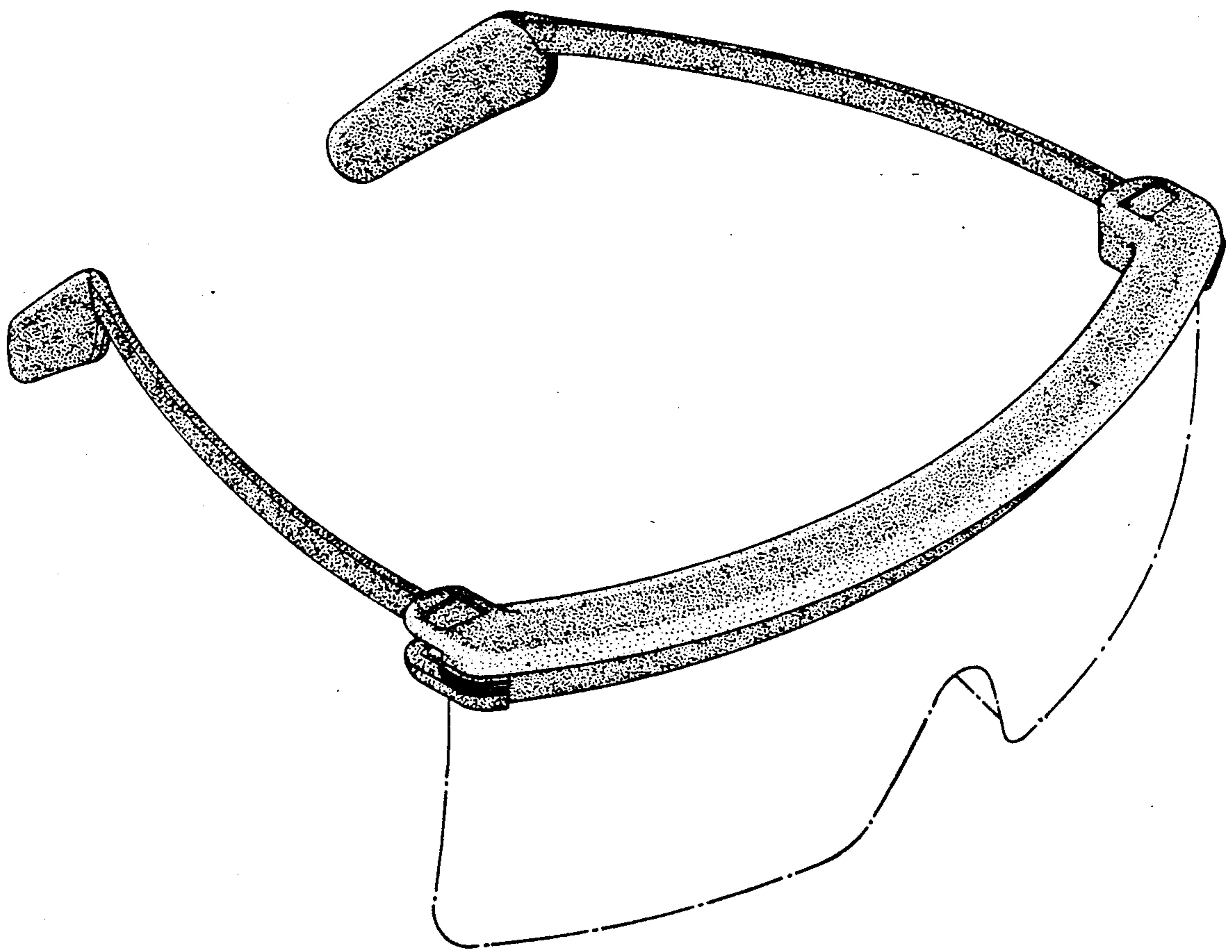
