only.

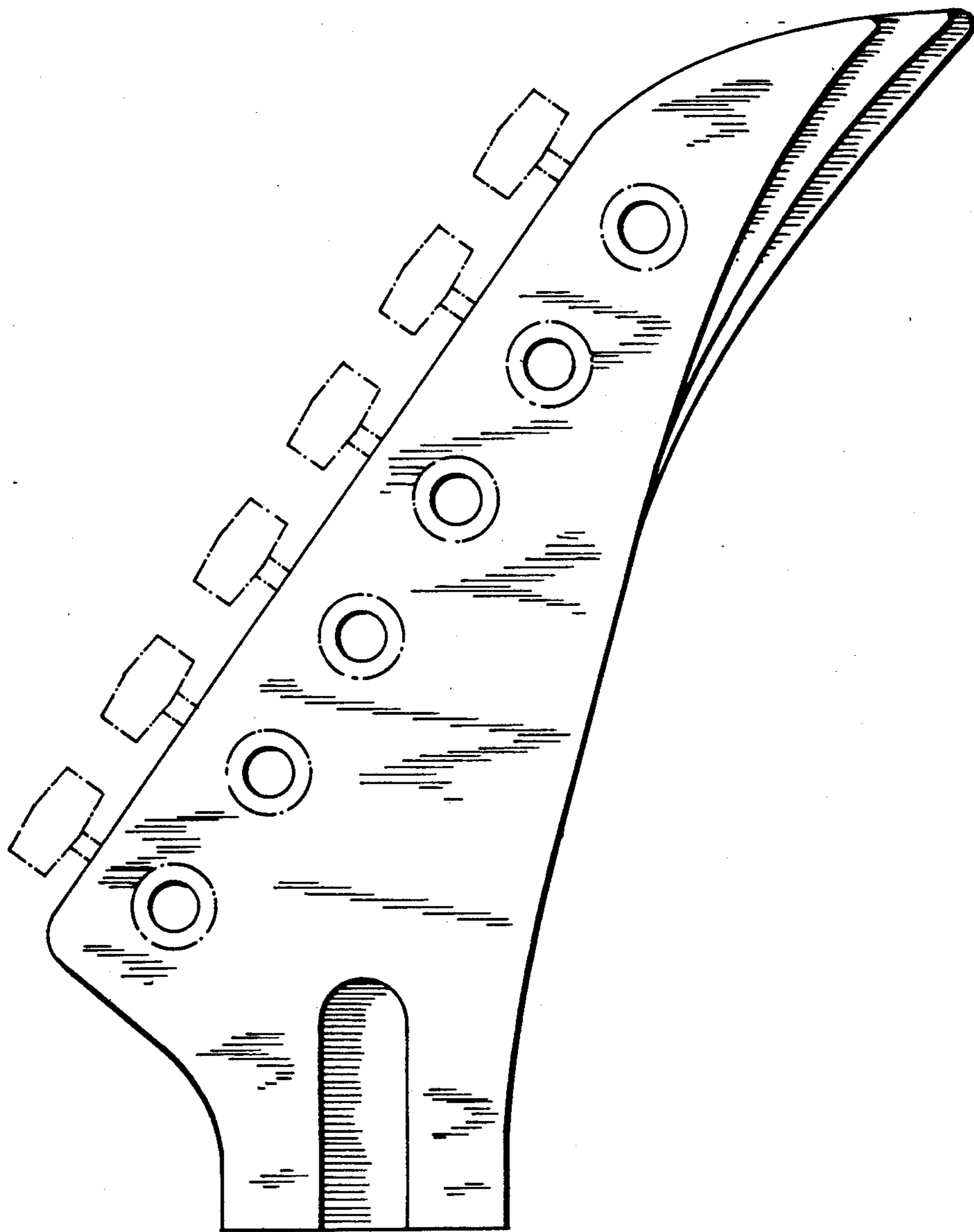

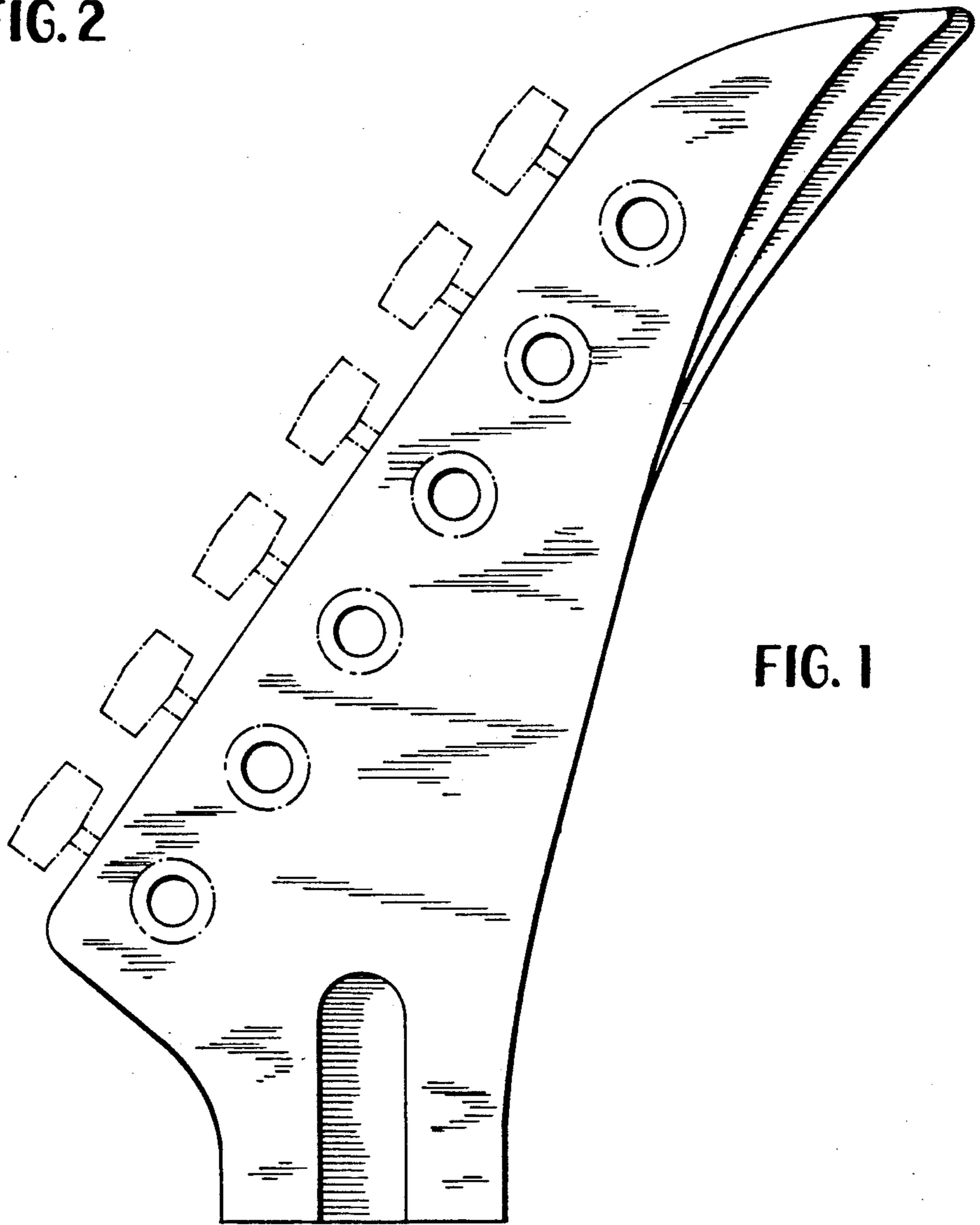
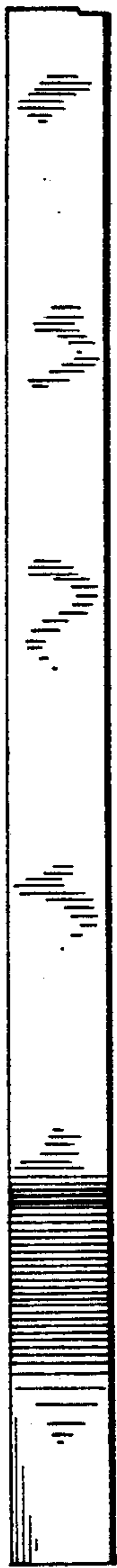

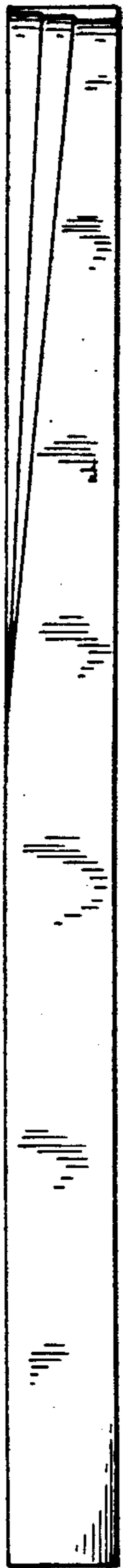

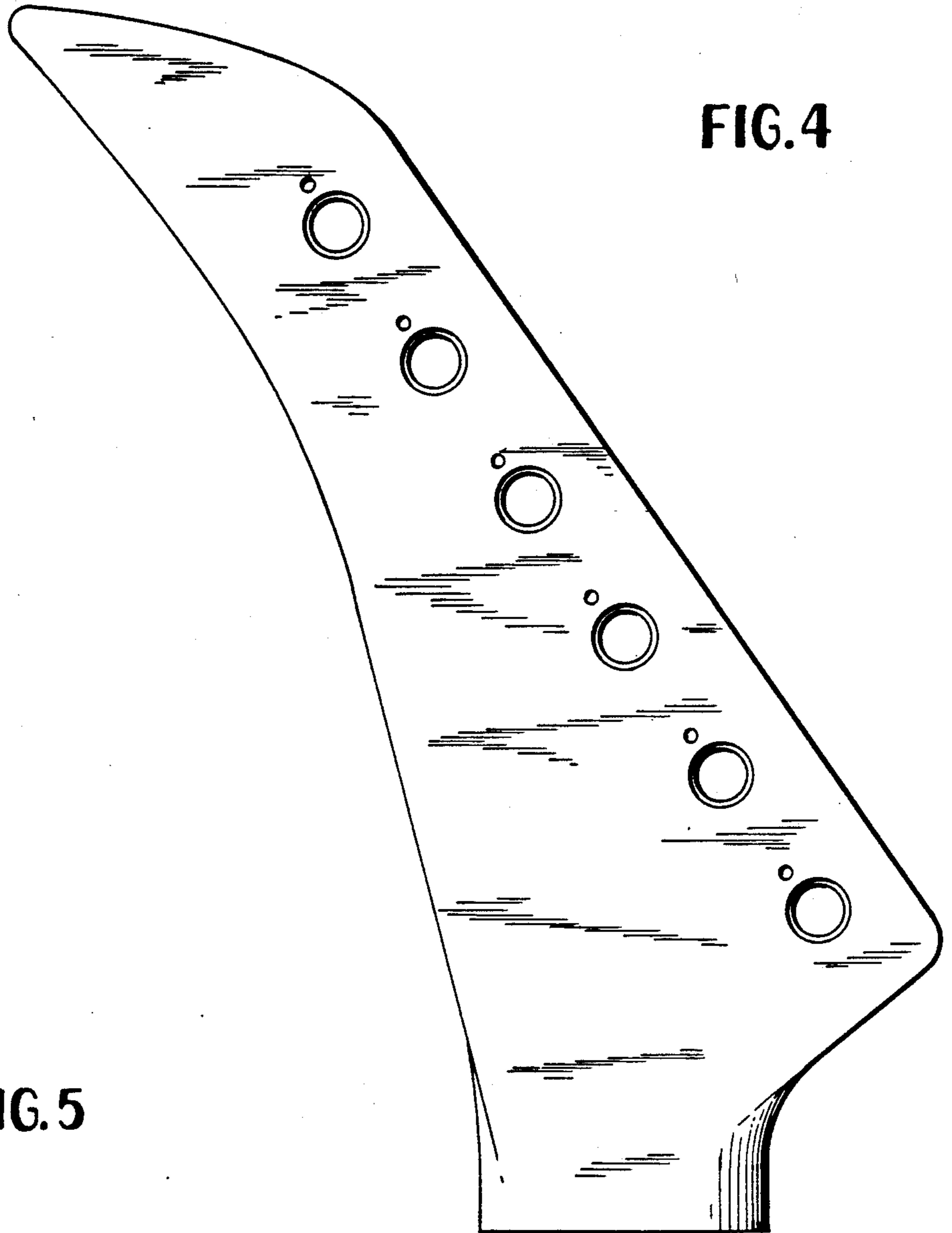
