DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a sanitary napkin, showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side view being identical.

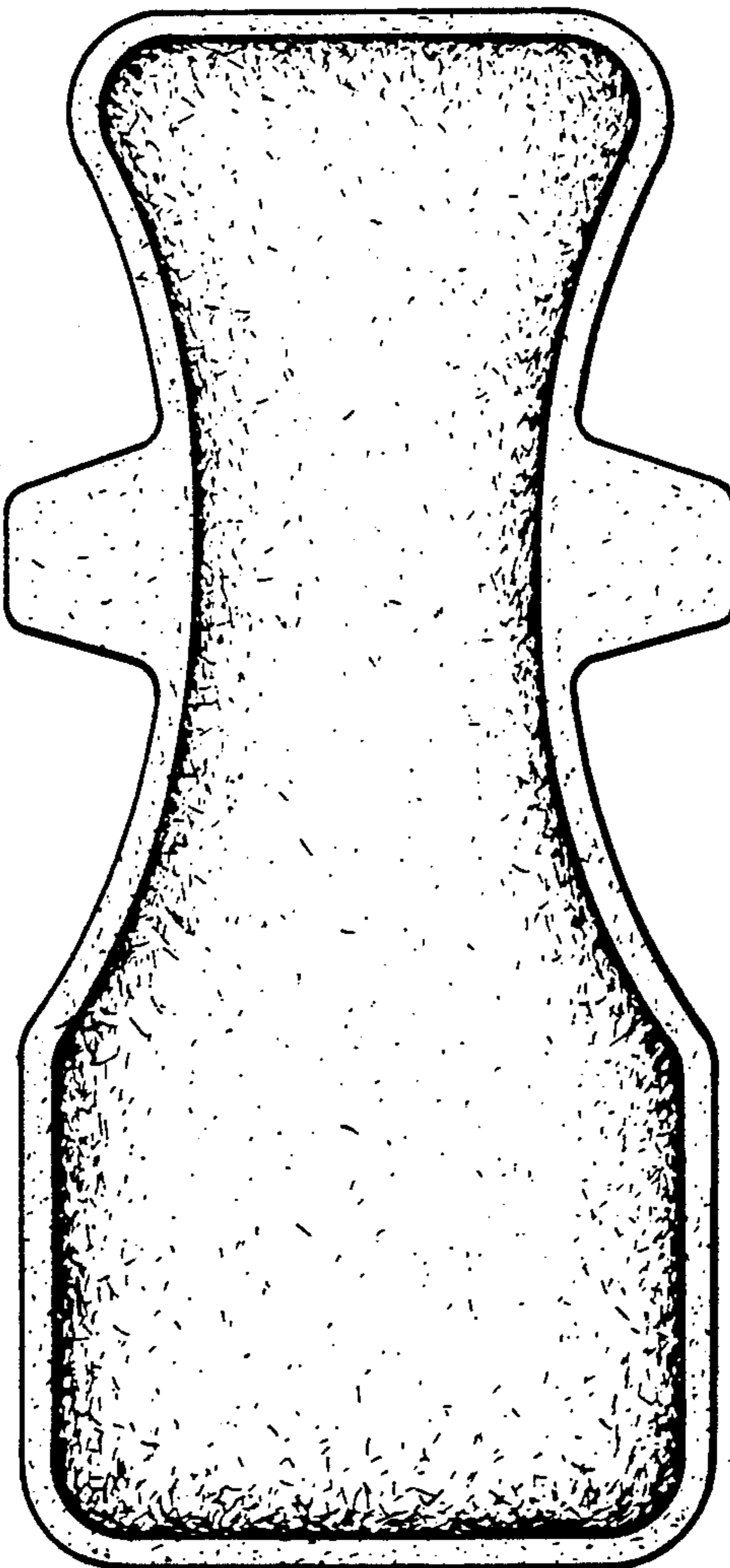

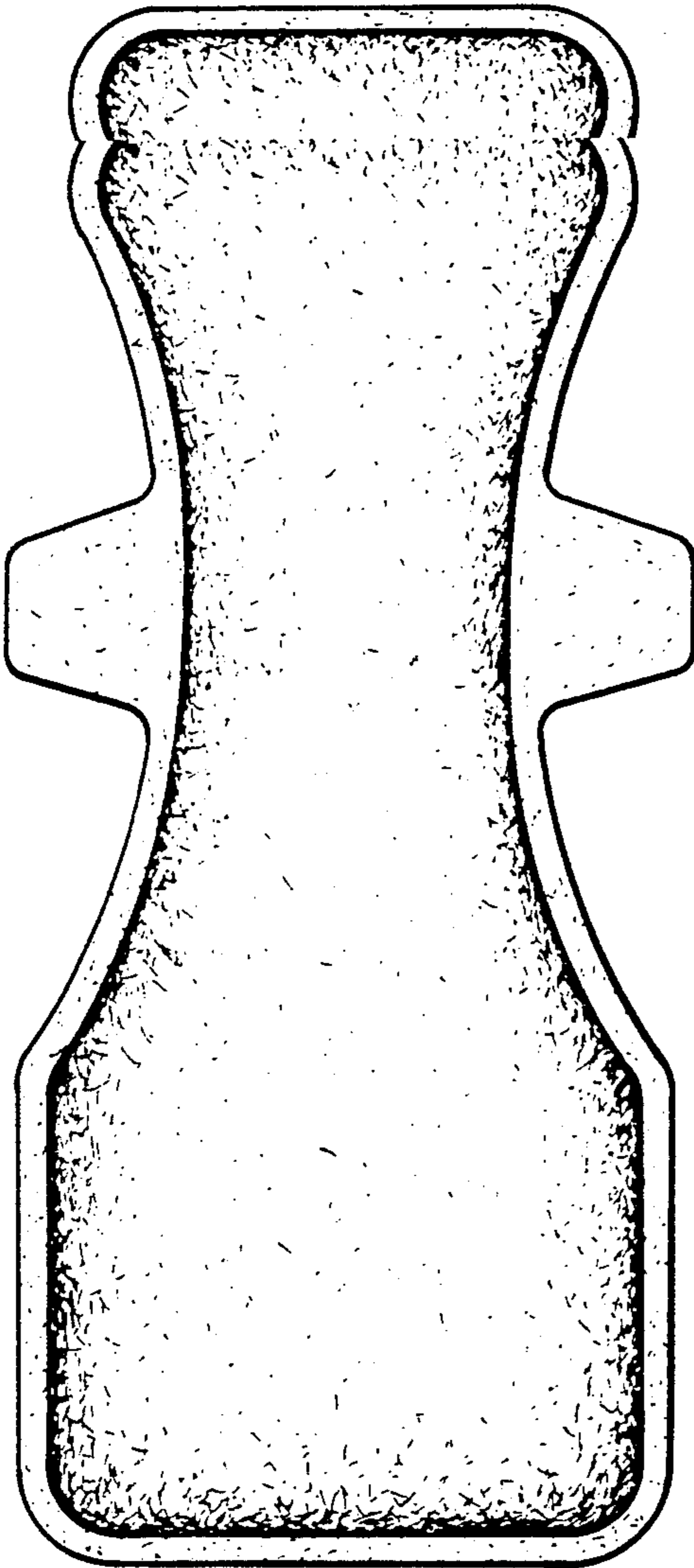

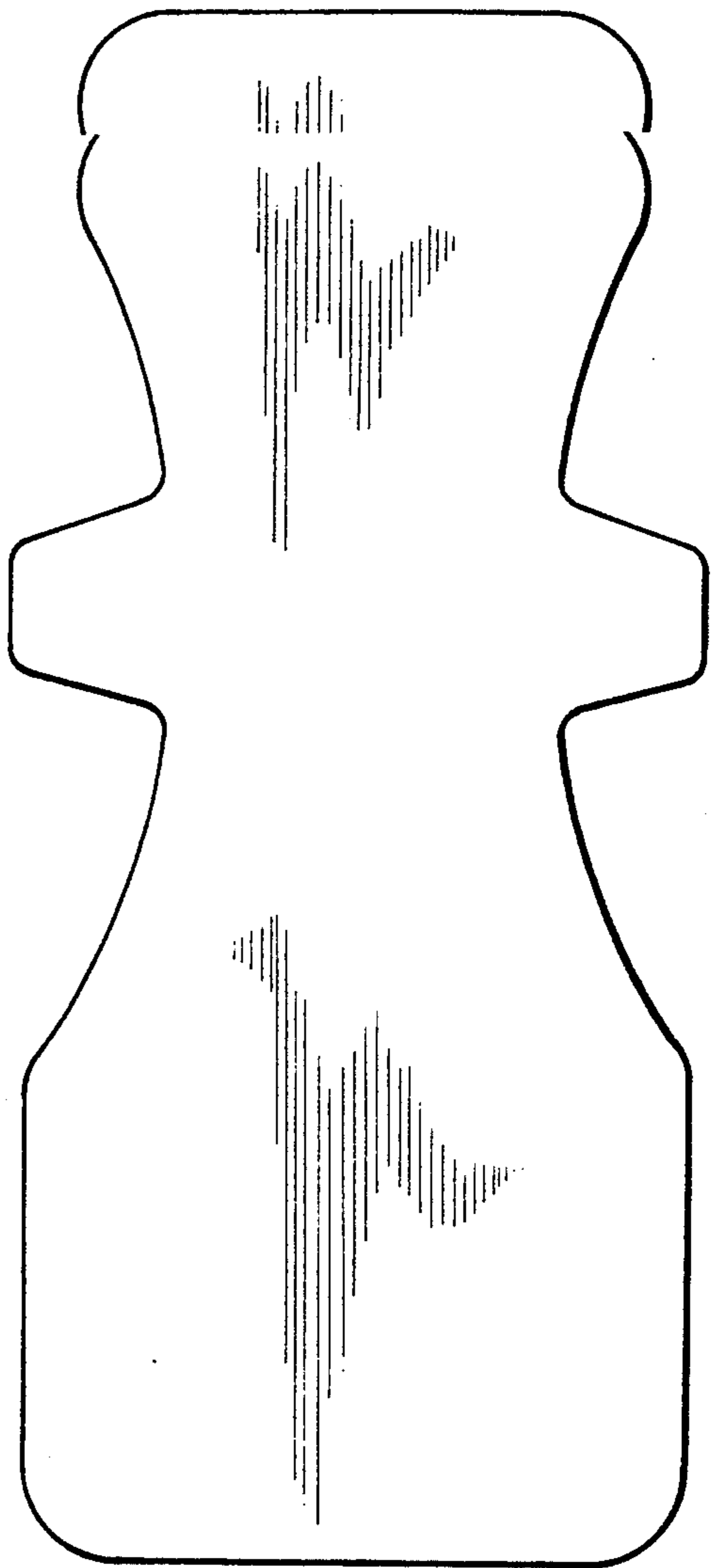
