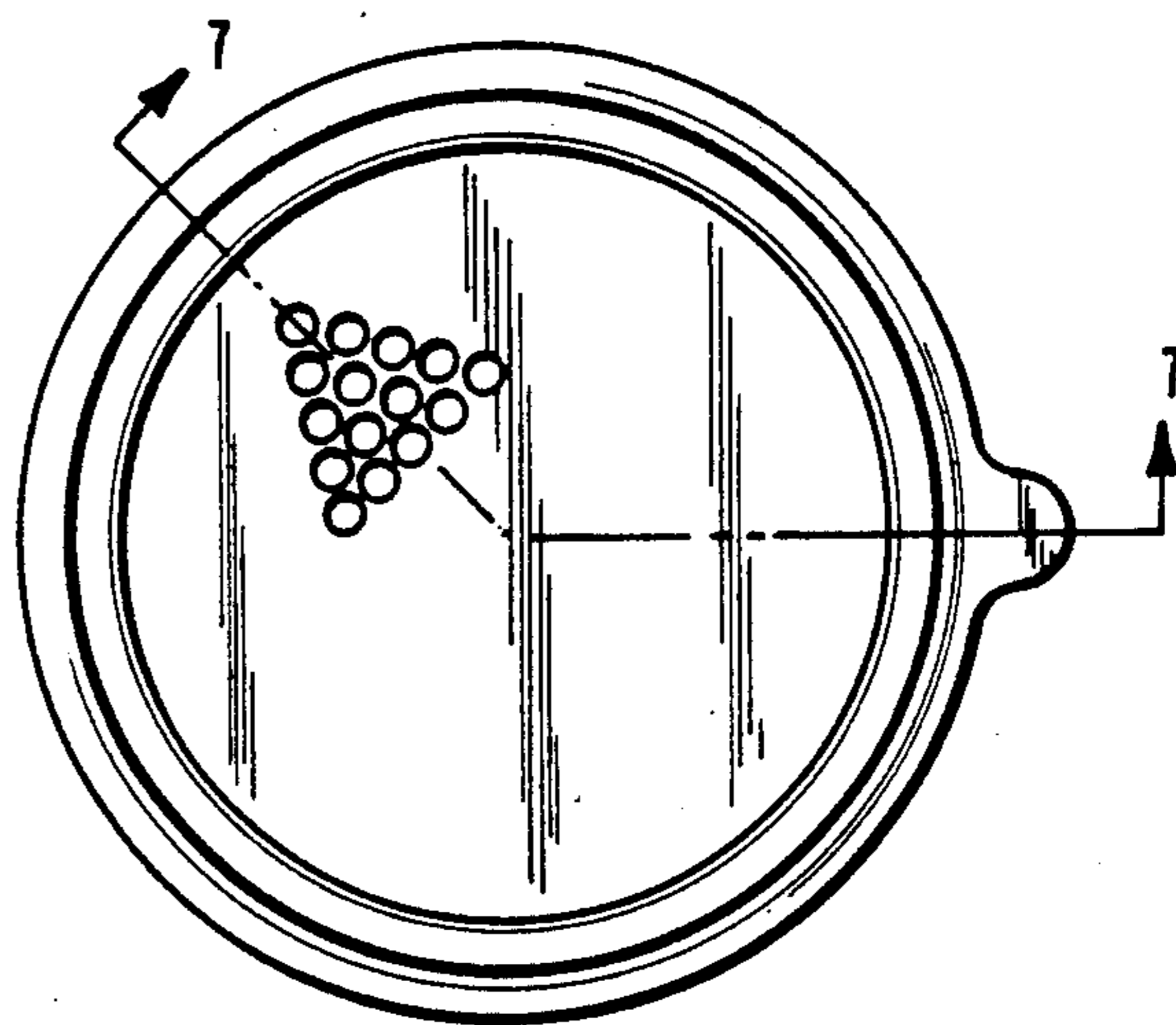
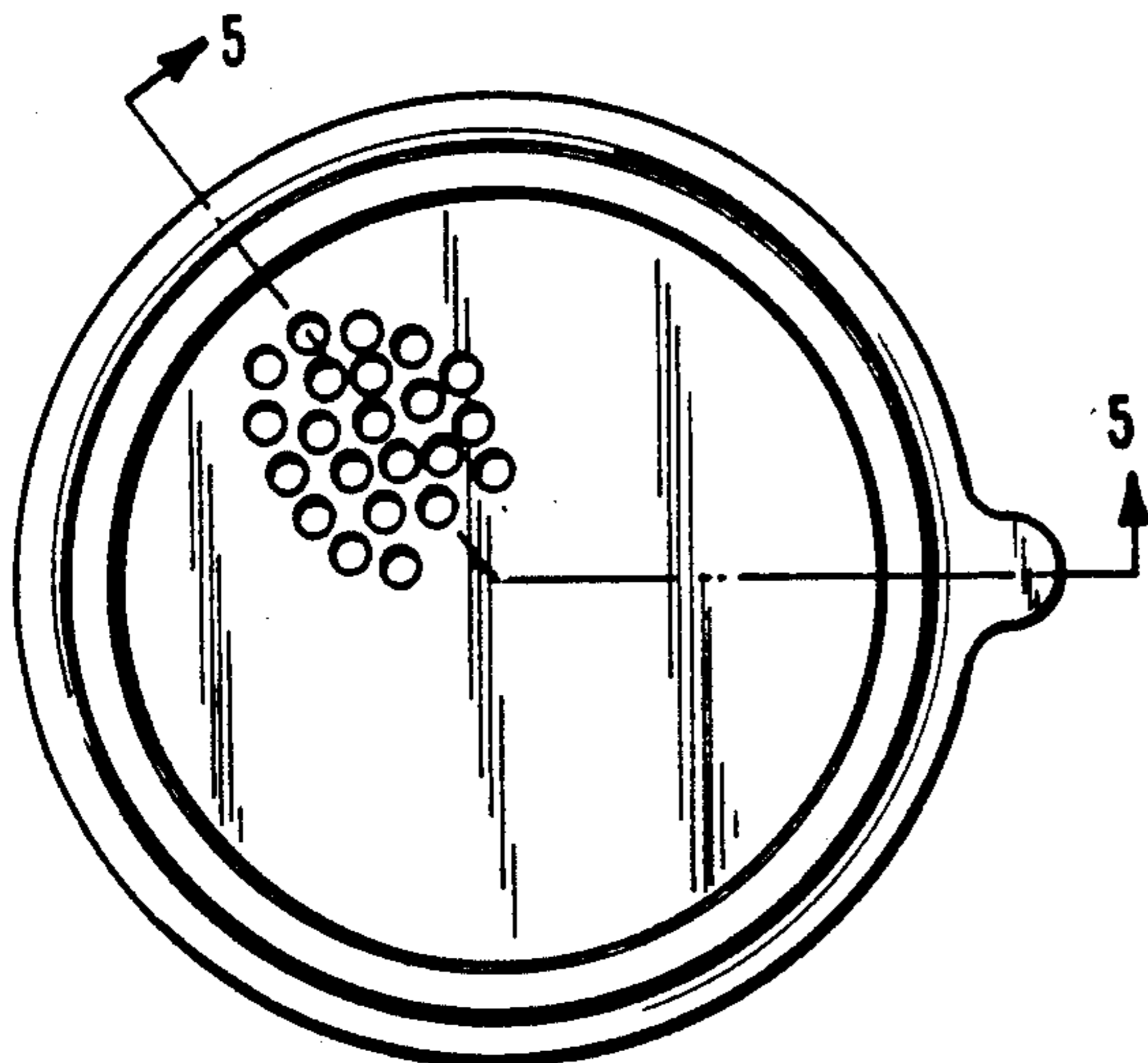

The ornamental design for a closure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a closure showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken in the direction of the arrows on line 5—5 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1, the only difference being the number of apertures and their arrangement;
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view of FIG. 6, taken in the direction of the arrows on line 7—7 of FIG. 6;
FIG. 8 is a bottom view of FIG. 6.



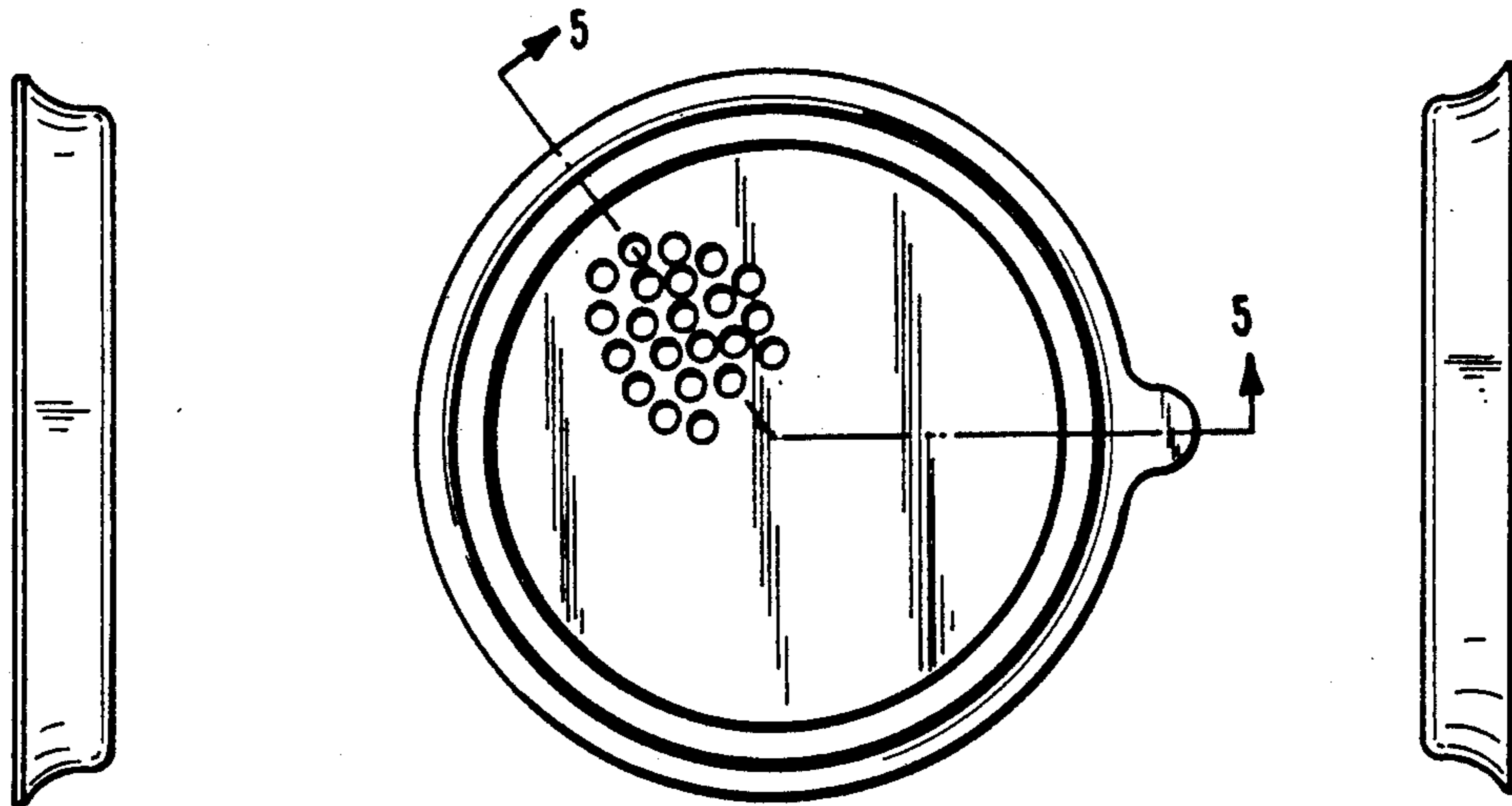

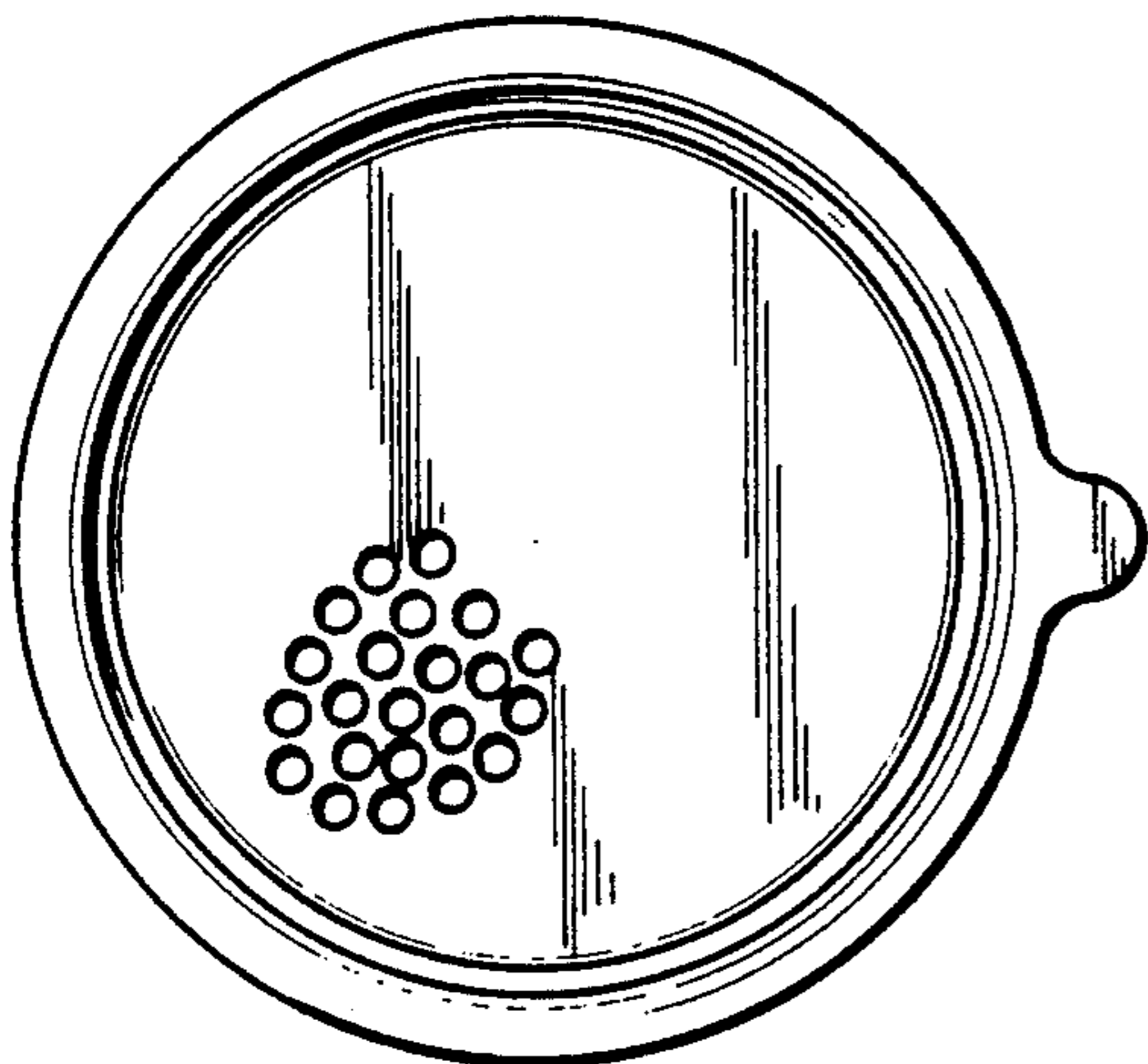

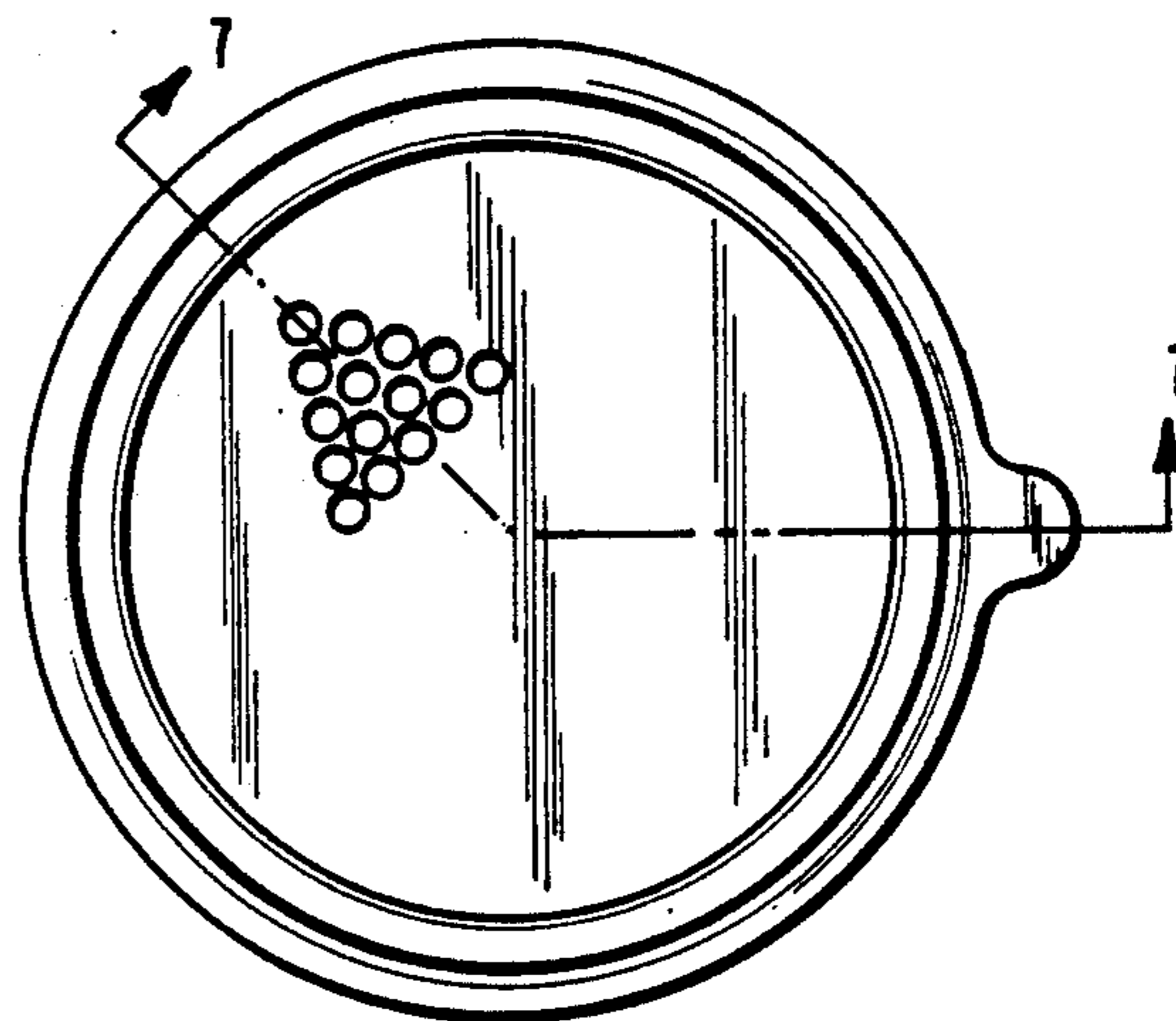

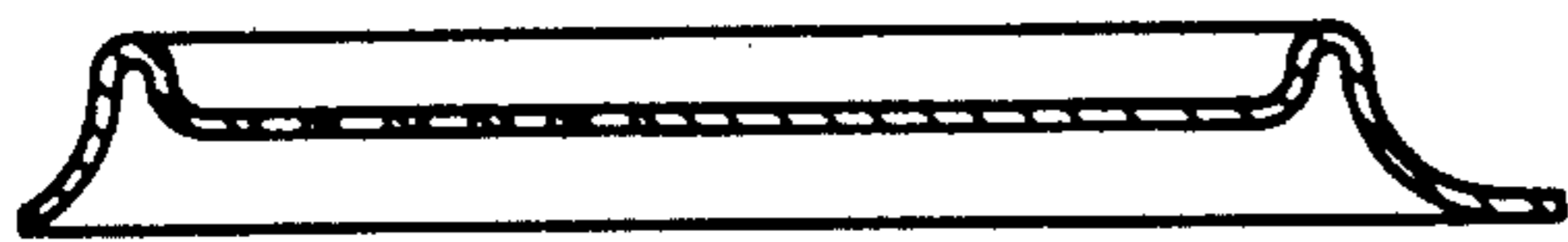

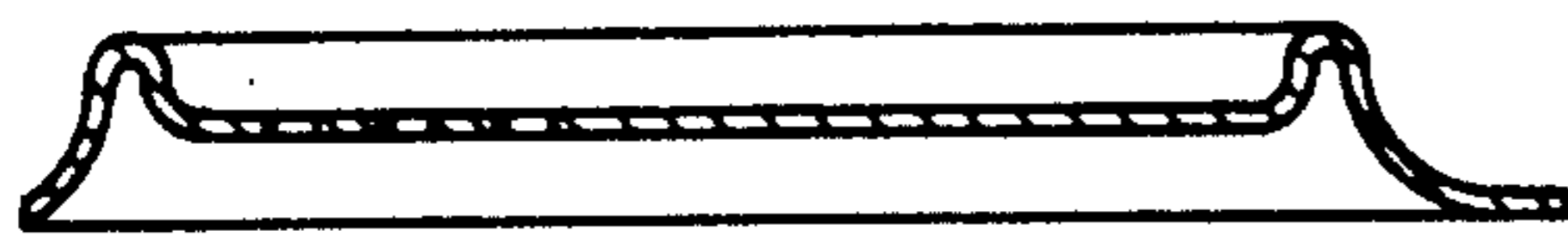

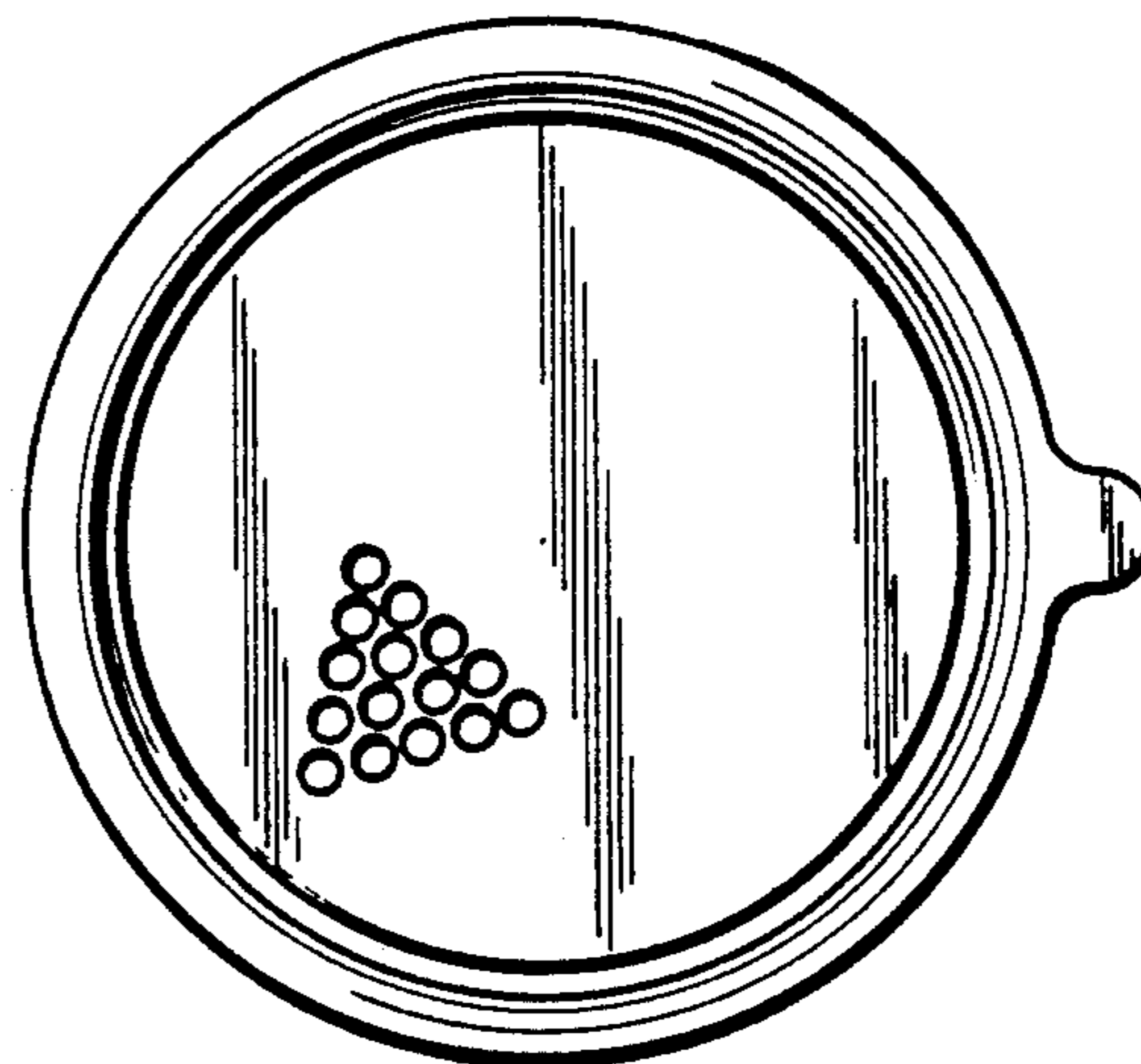
