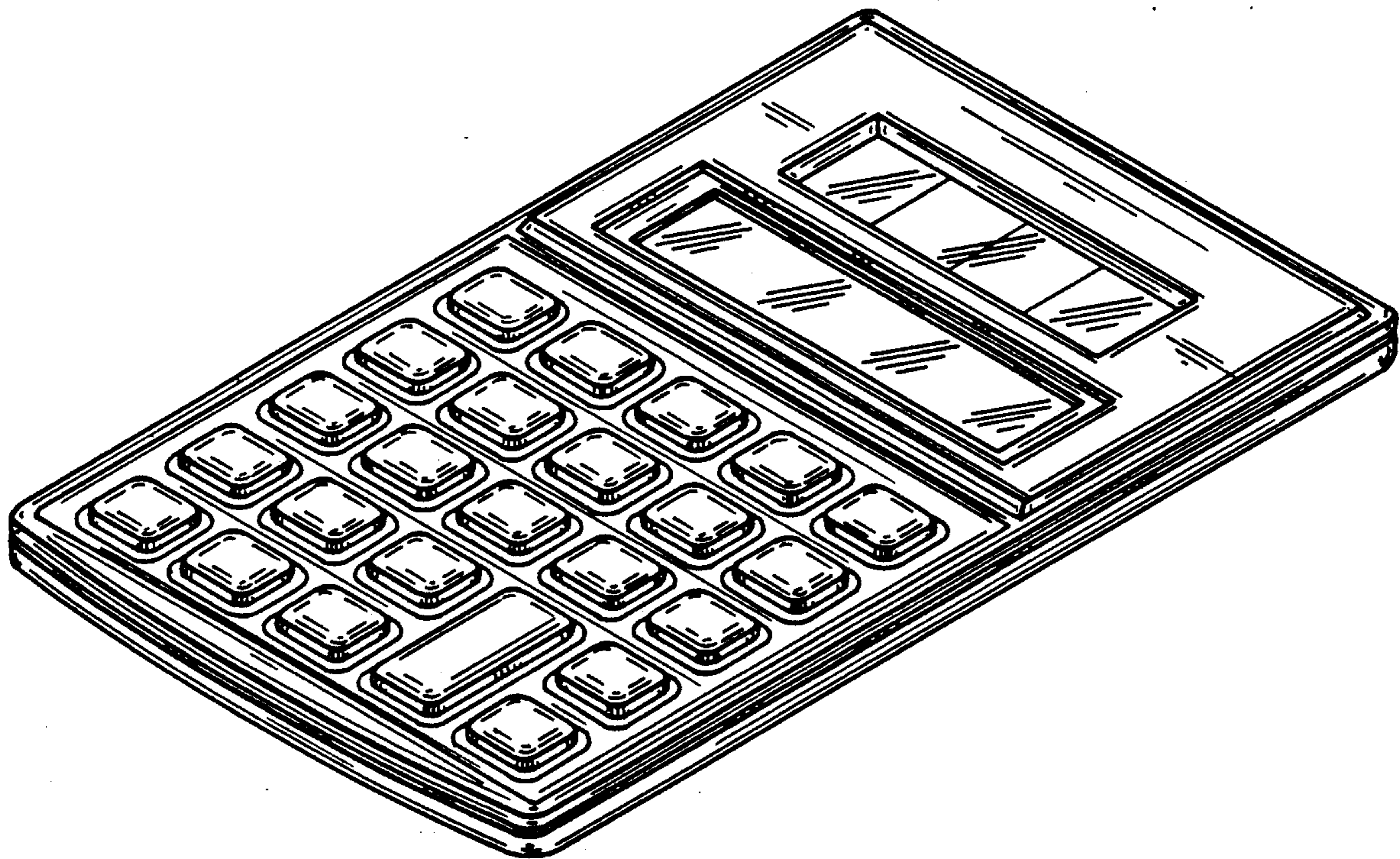

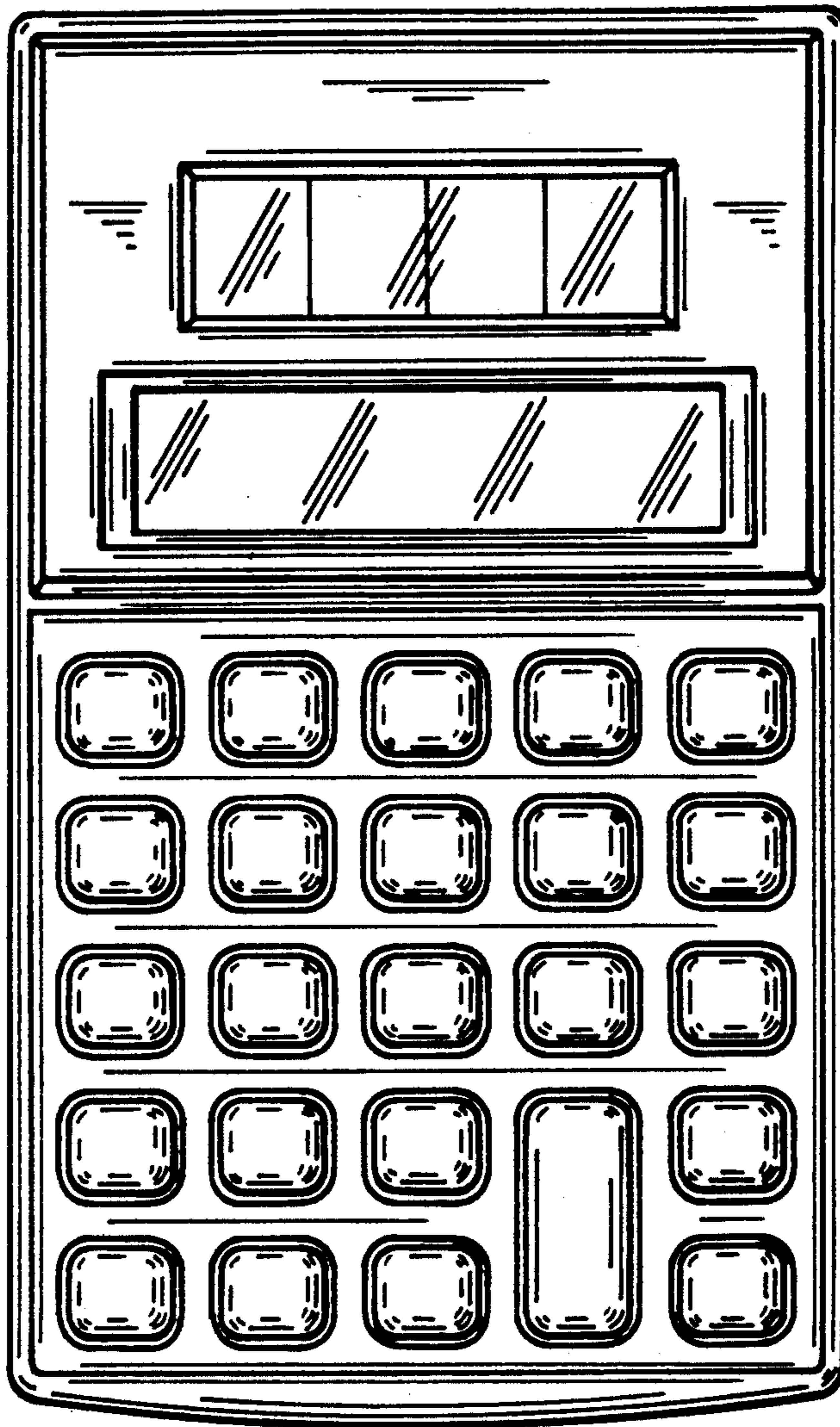
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the electronic calculator with solar cell showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a right front perspective view thereof.





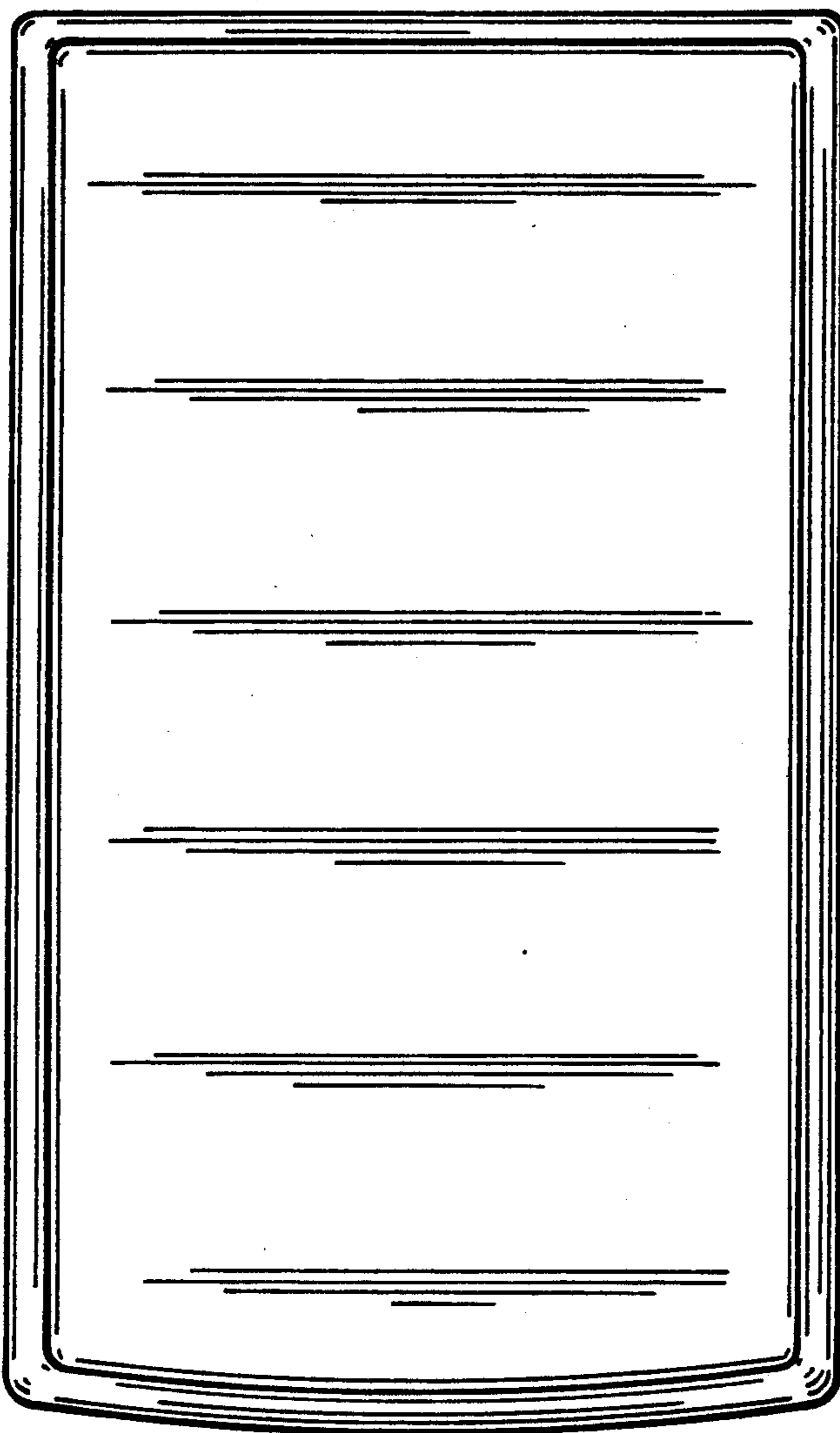

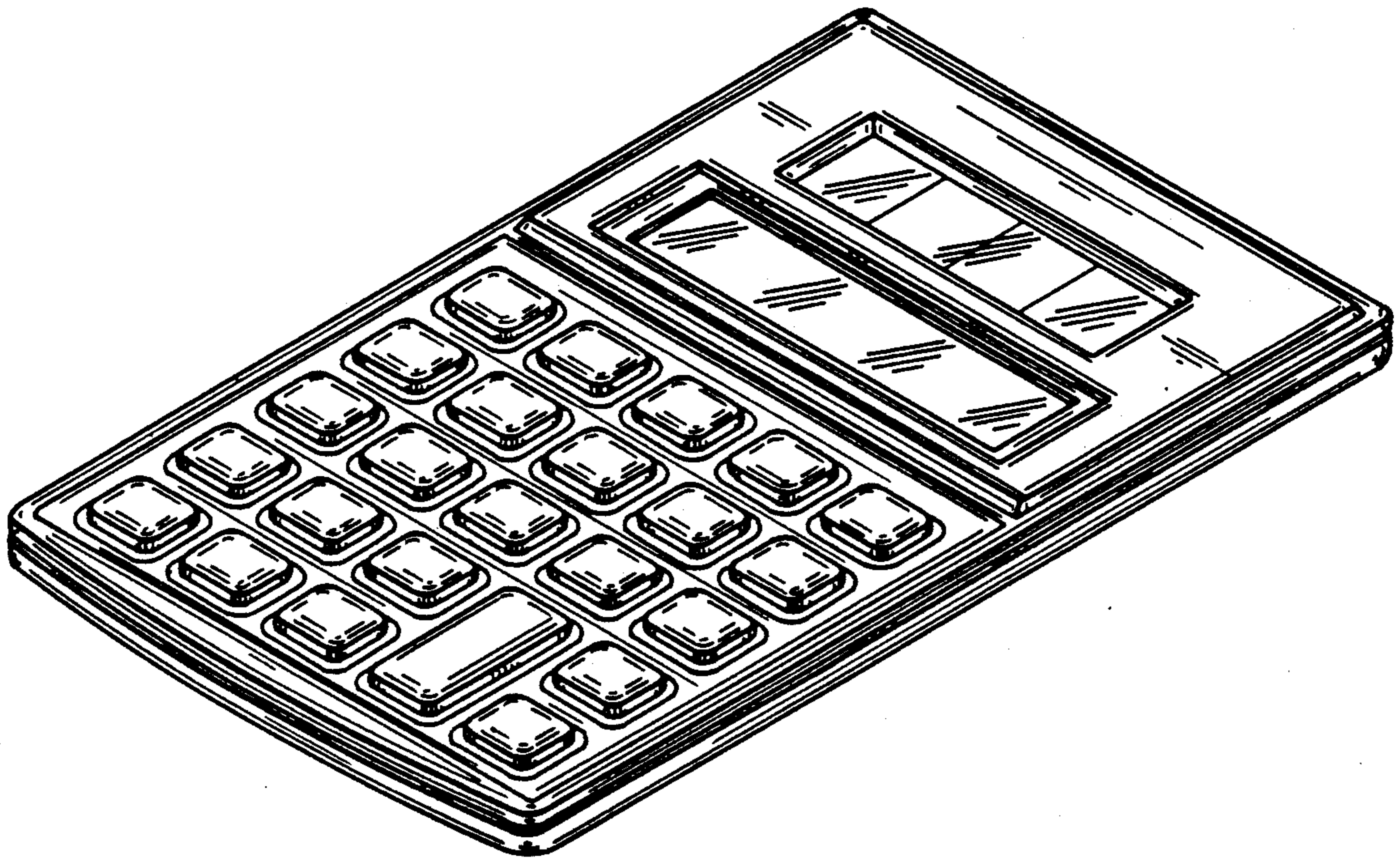
