DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined holder and visual stimulator for infants embodying the design of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed side being a mirror image; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

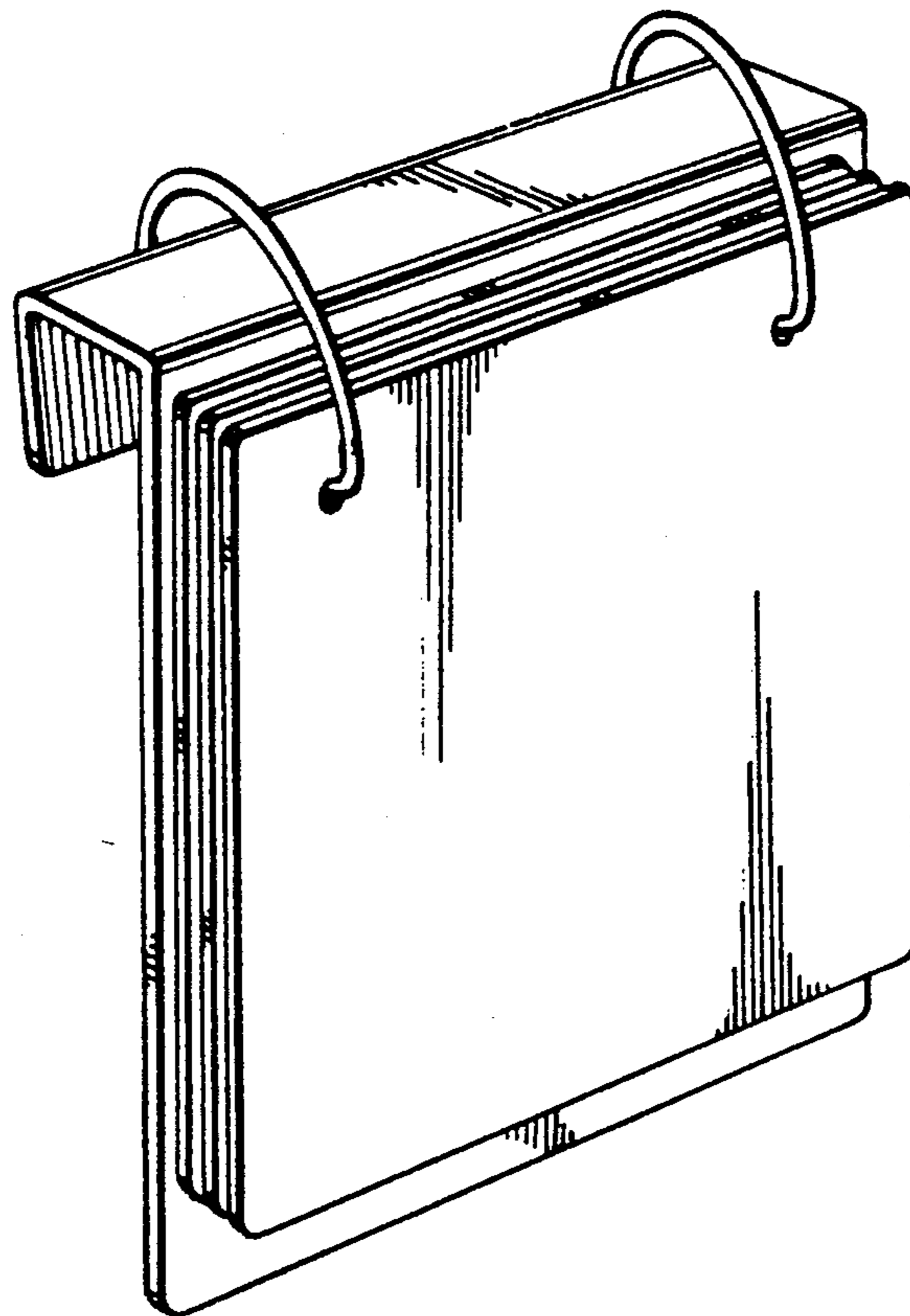

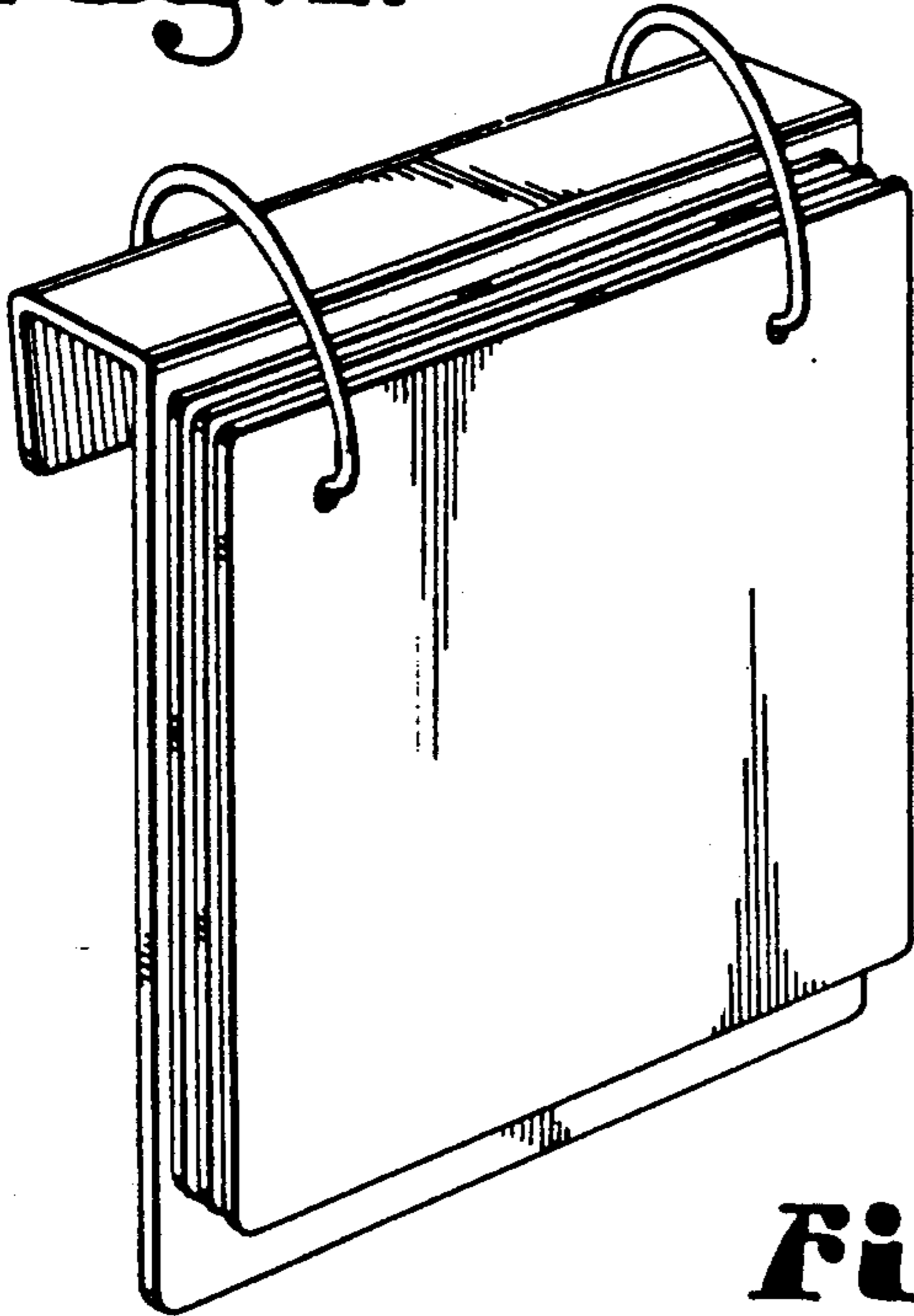

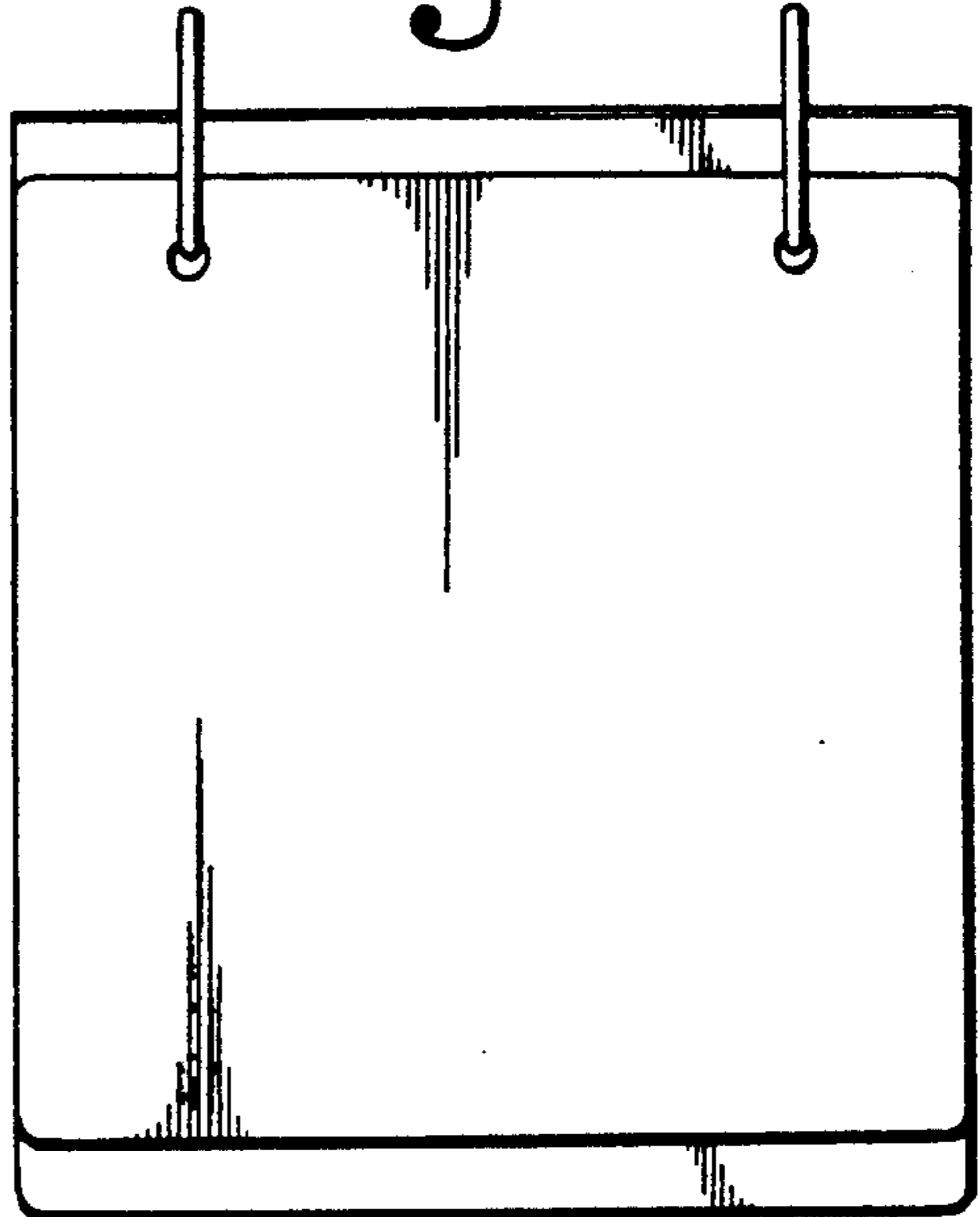

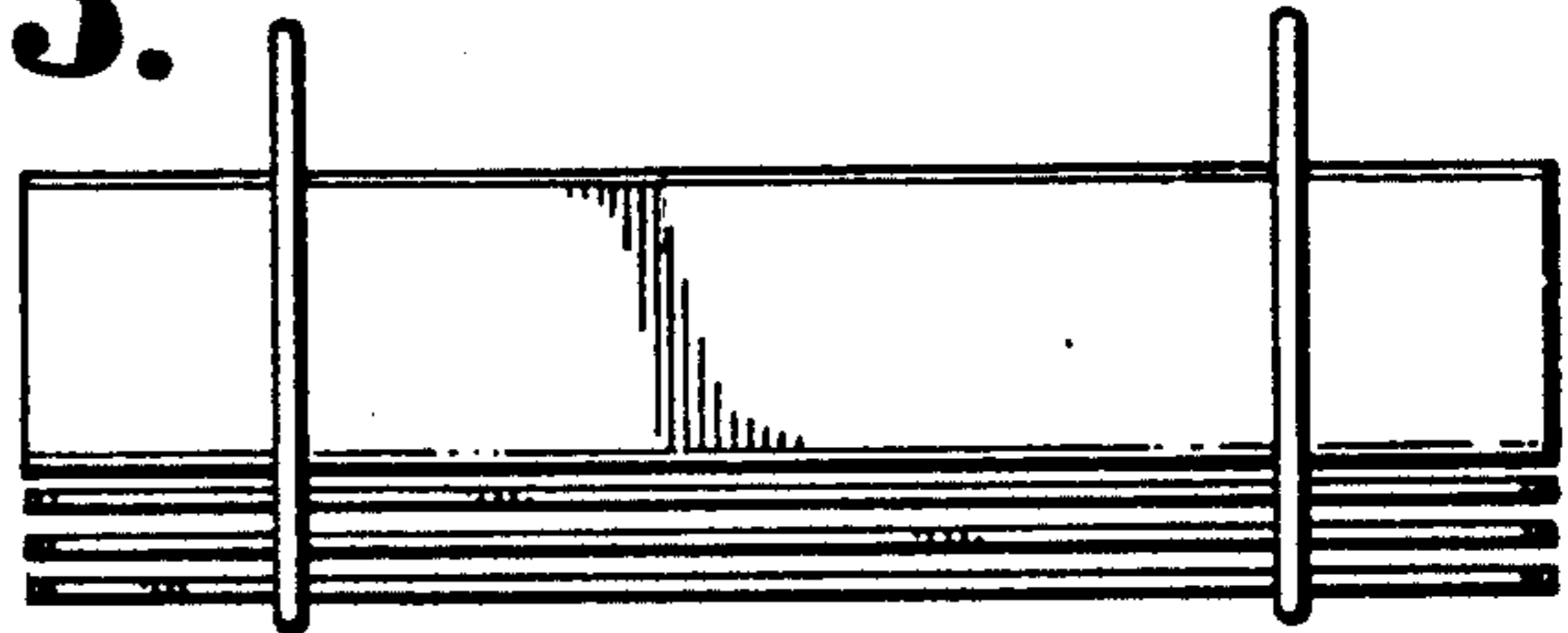

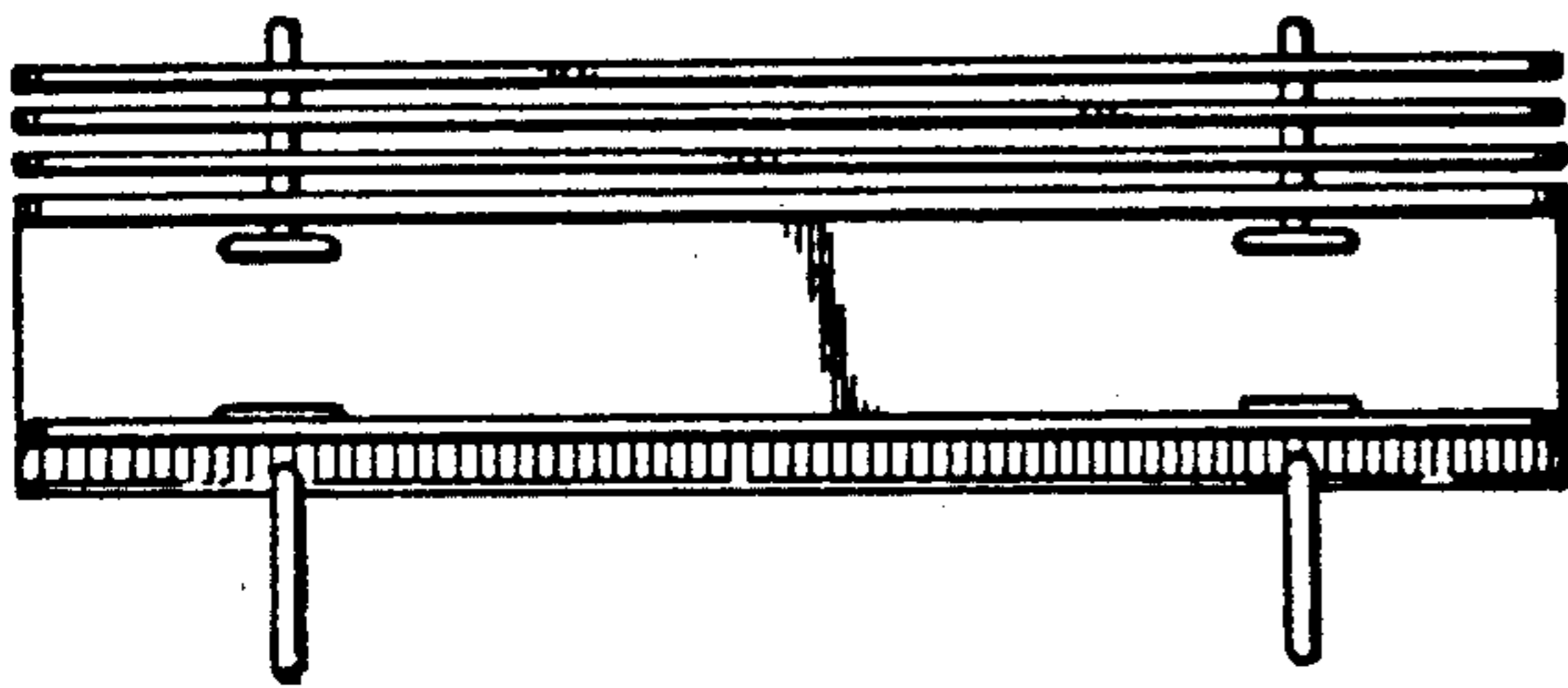

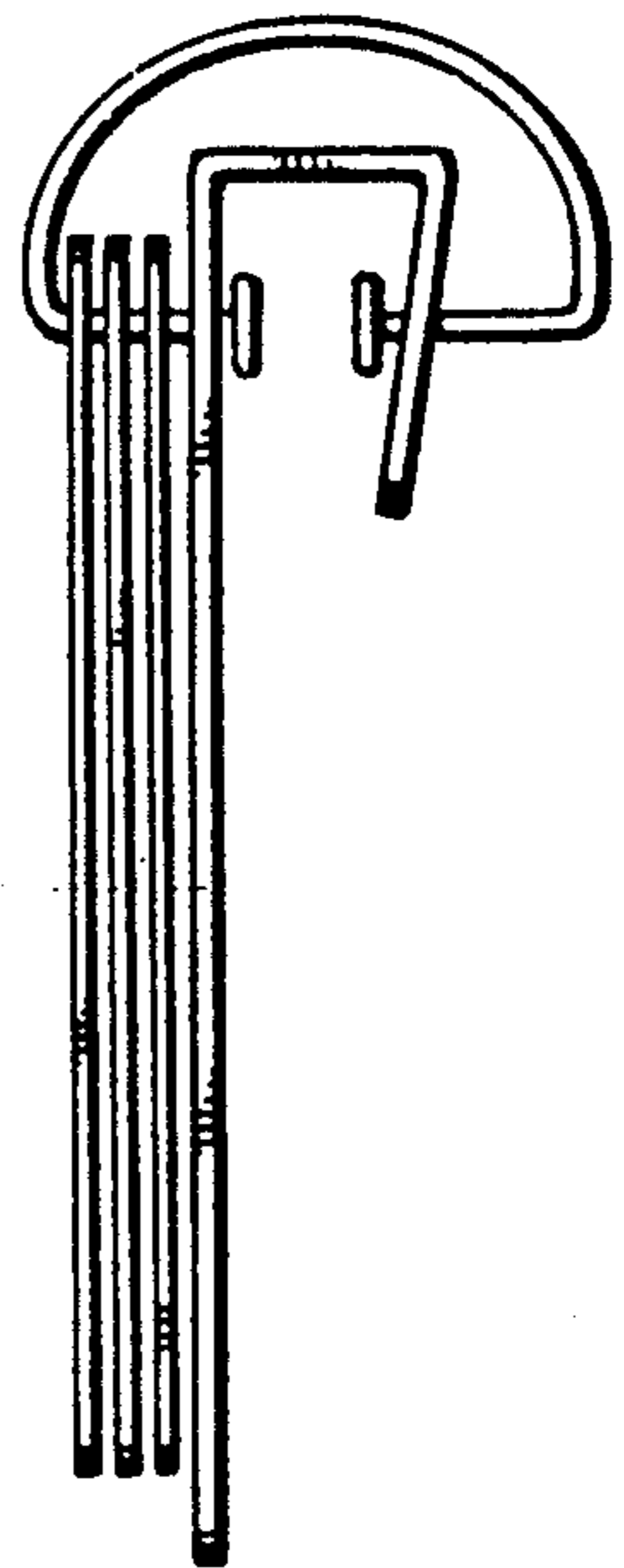
