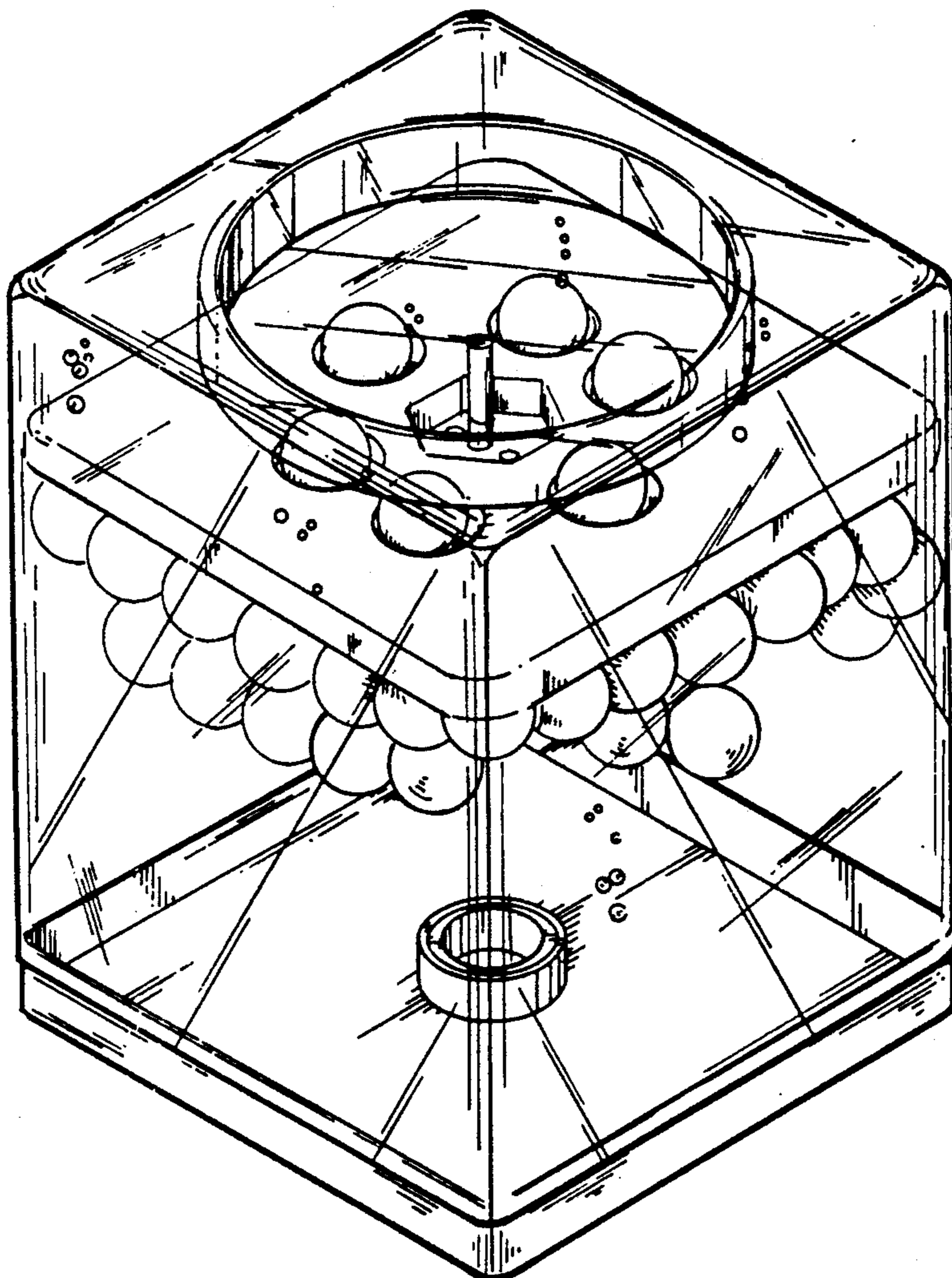

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a liquid filled random number ball tumbler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a liquid filled random number ball tumbler showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof. In FIG. 2, a number of balls are not shown for ease of illustration.



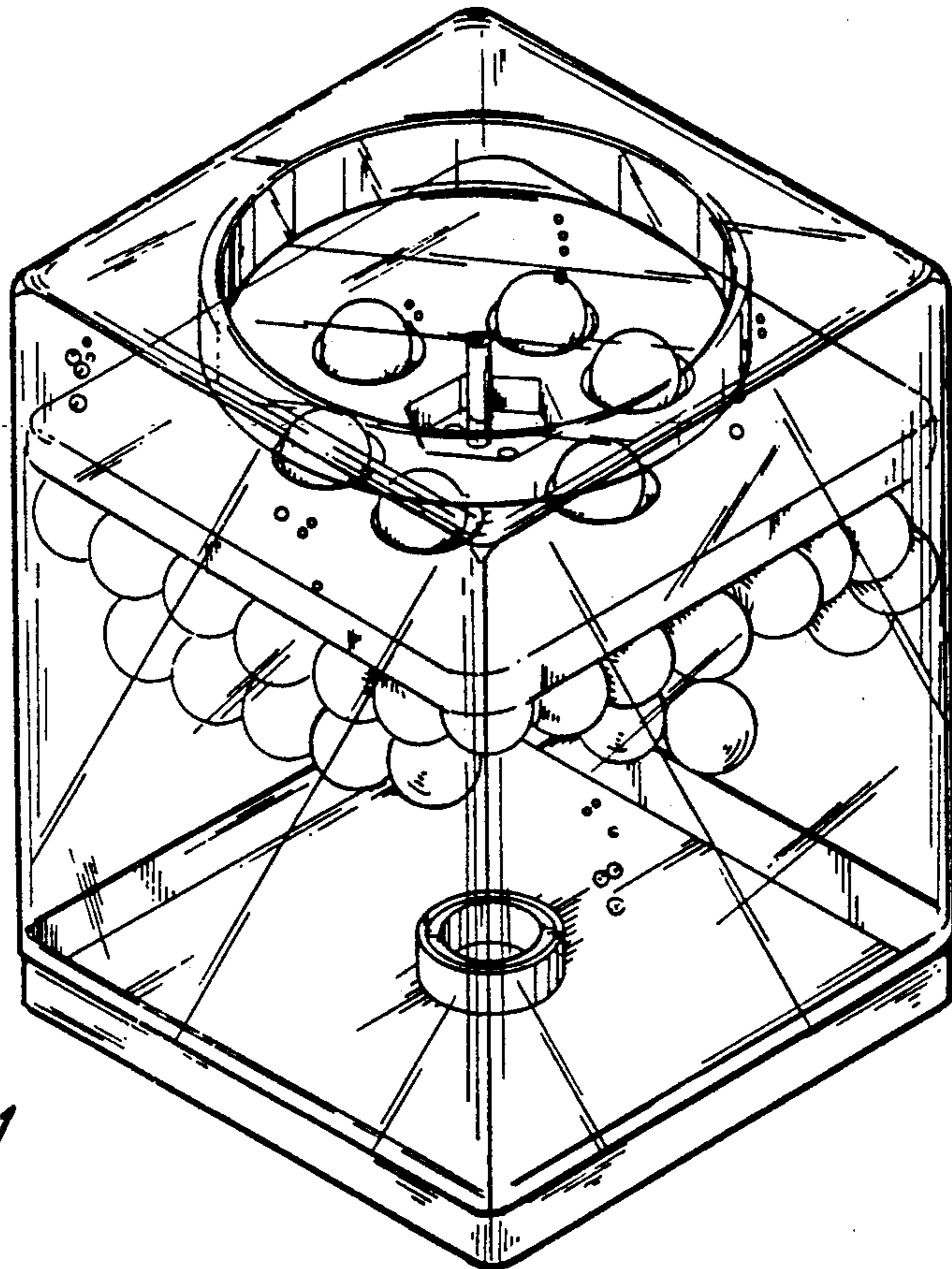

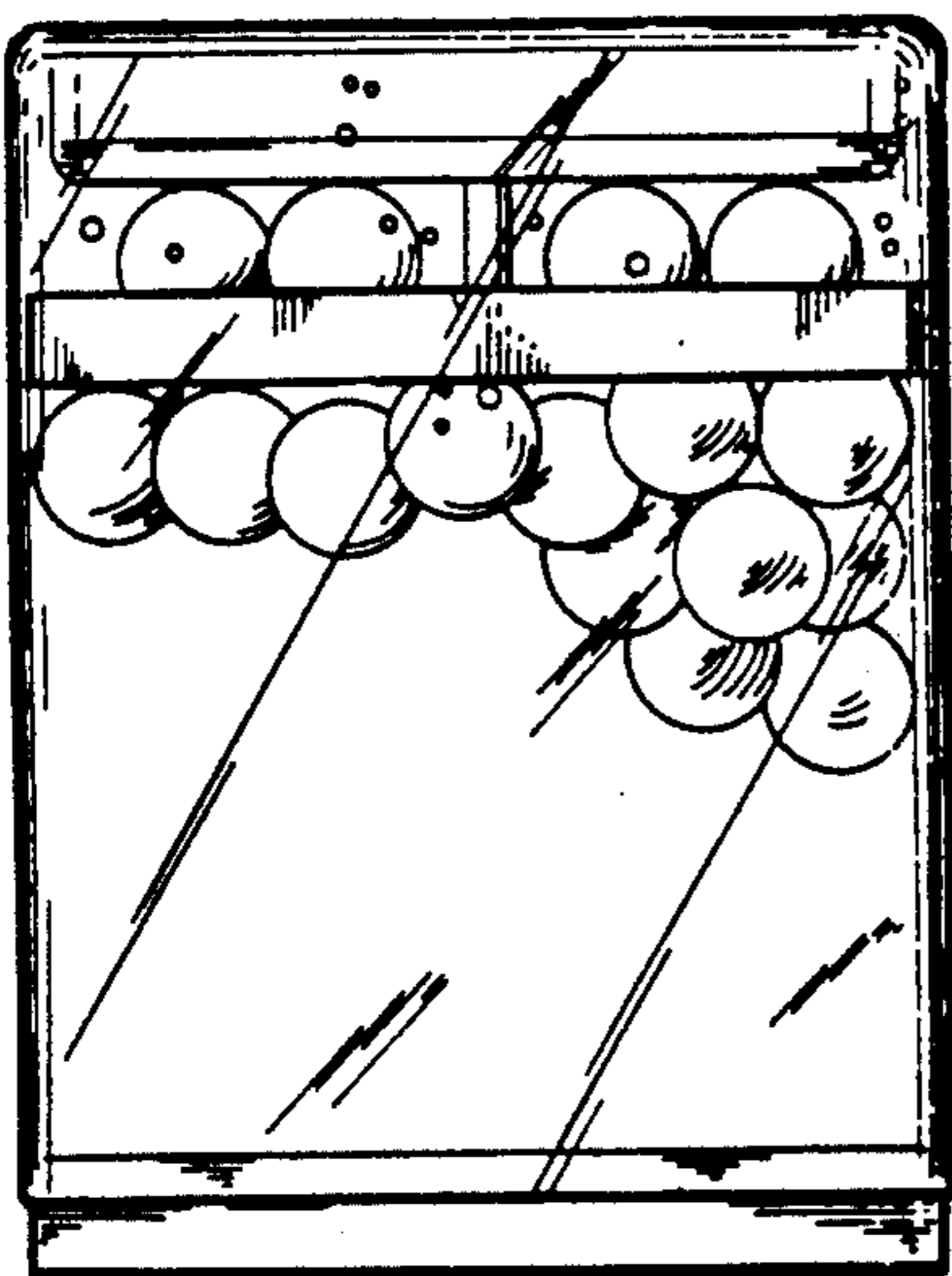

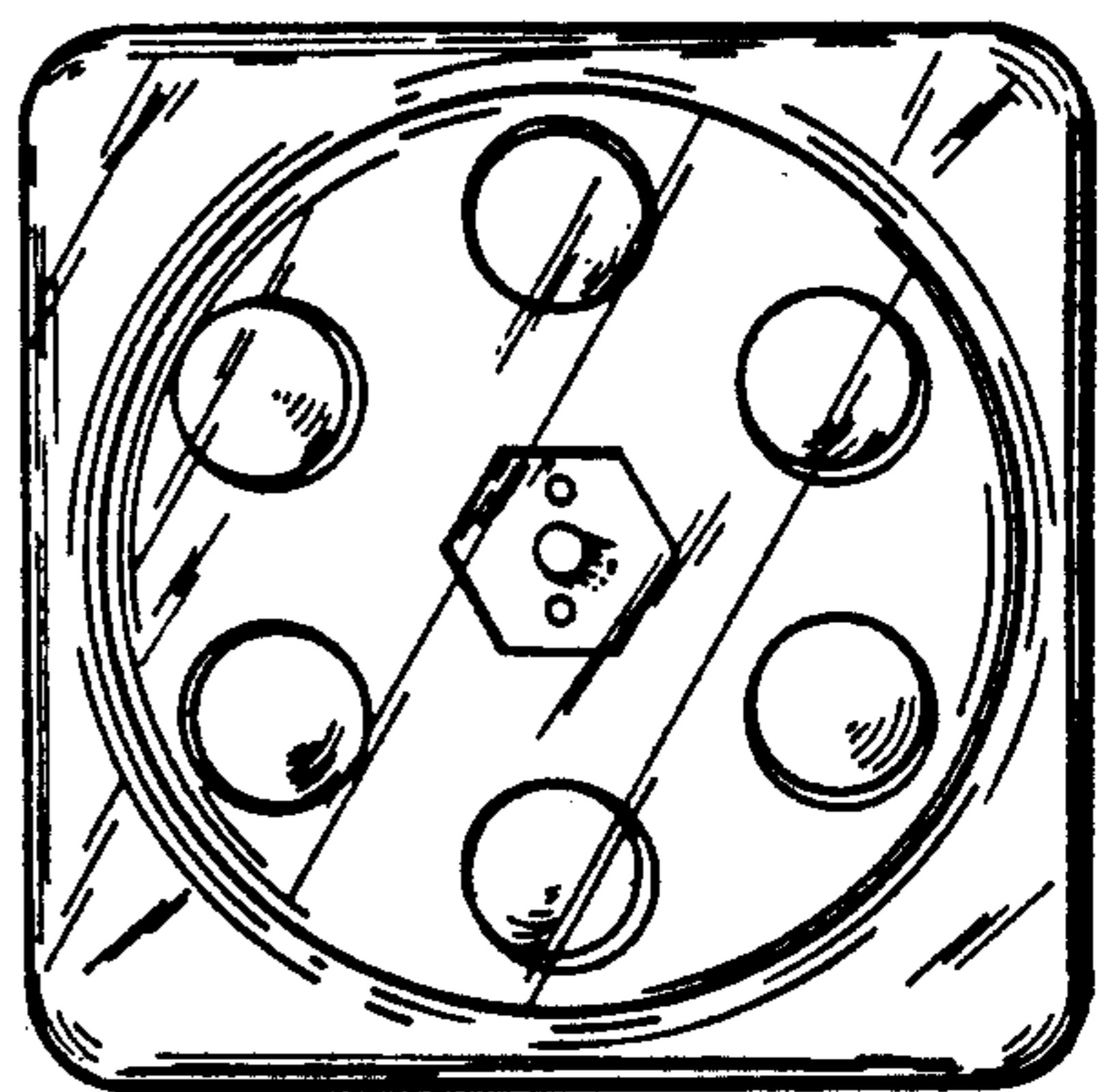

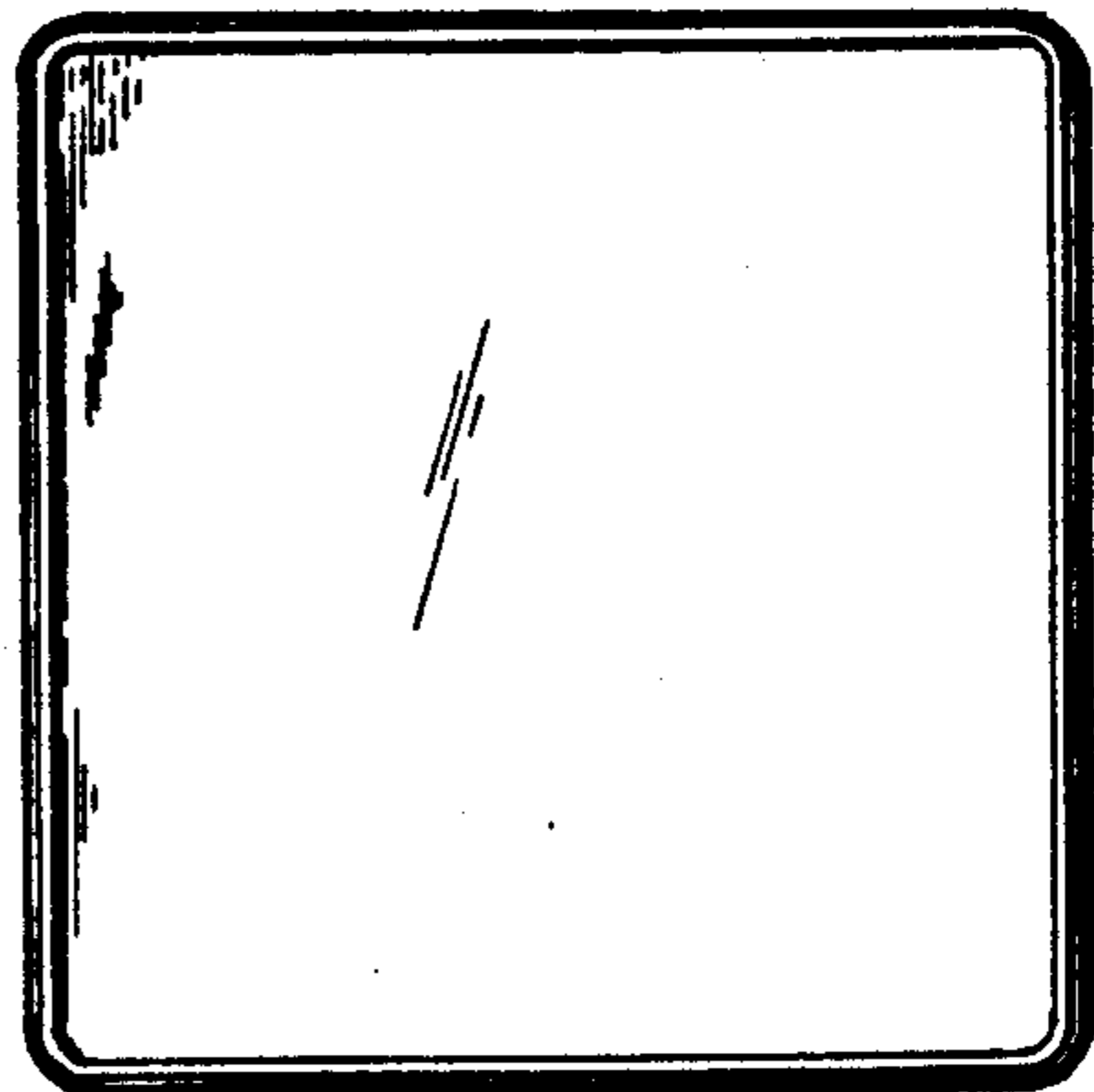
