The ornamental design for a toy hippopotamus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toy hippopotamus showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;

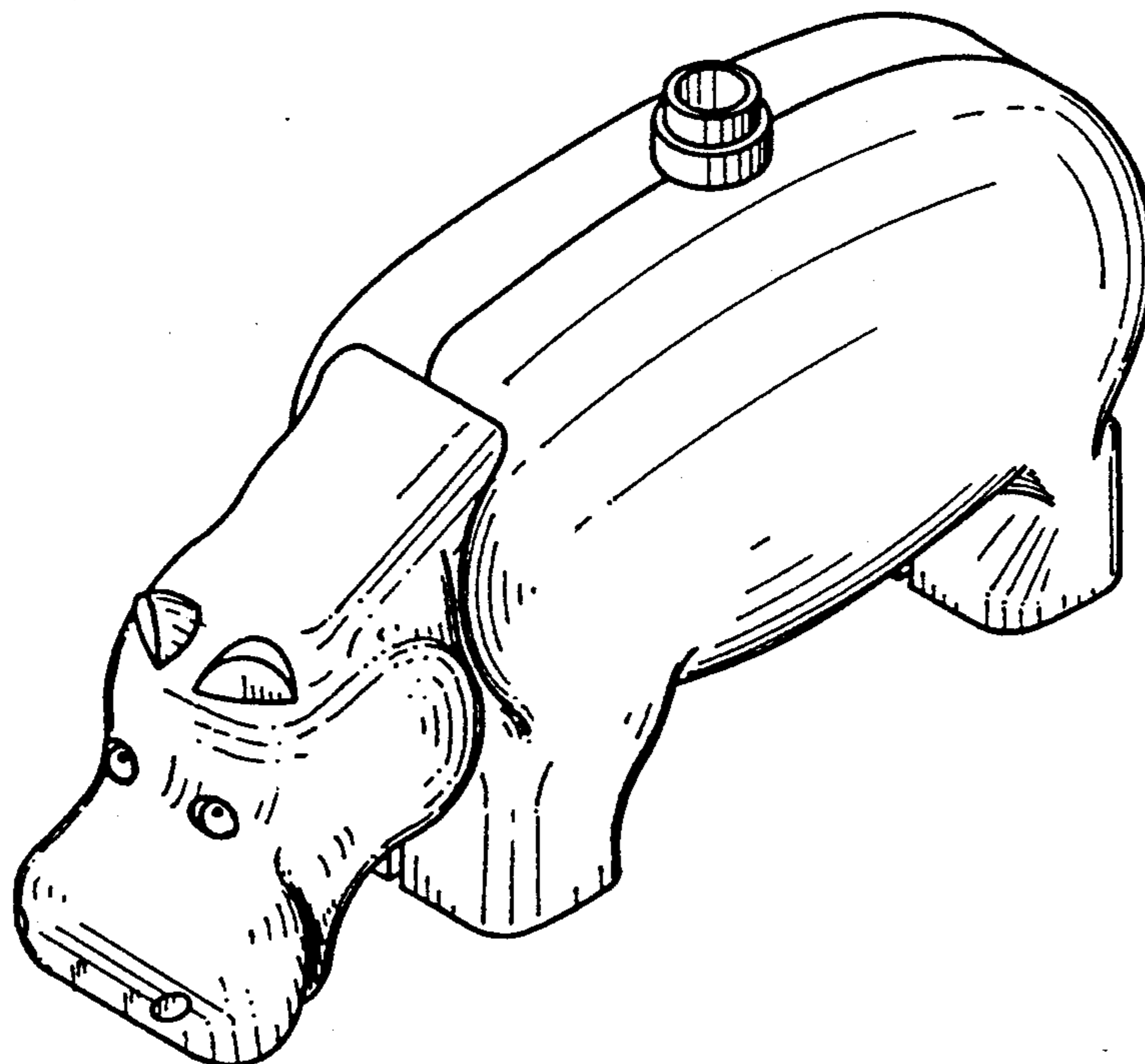
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top perspective view thereof with the head turned upward.



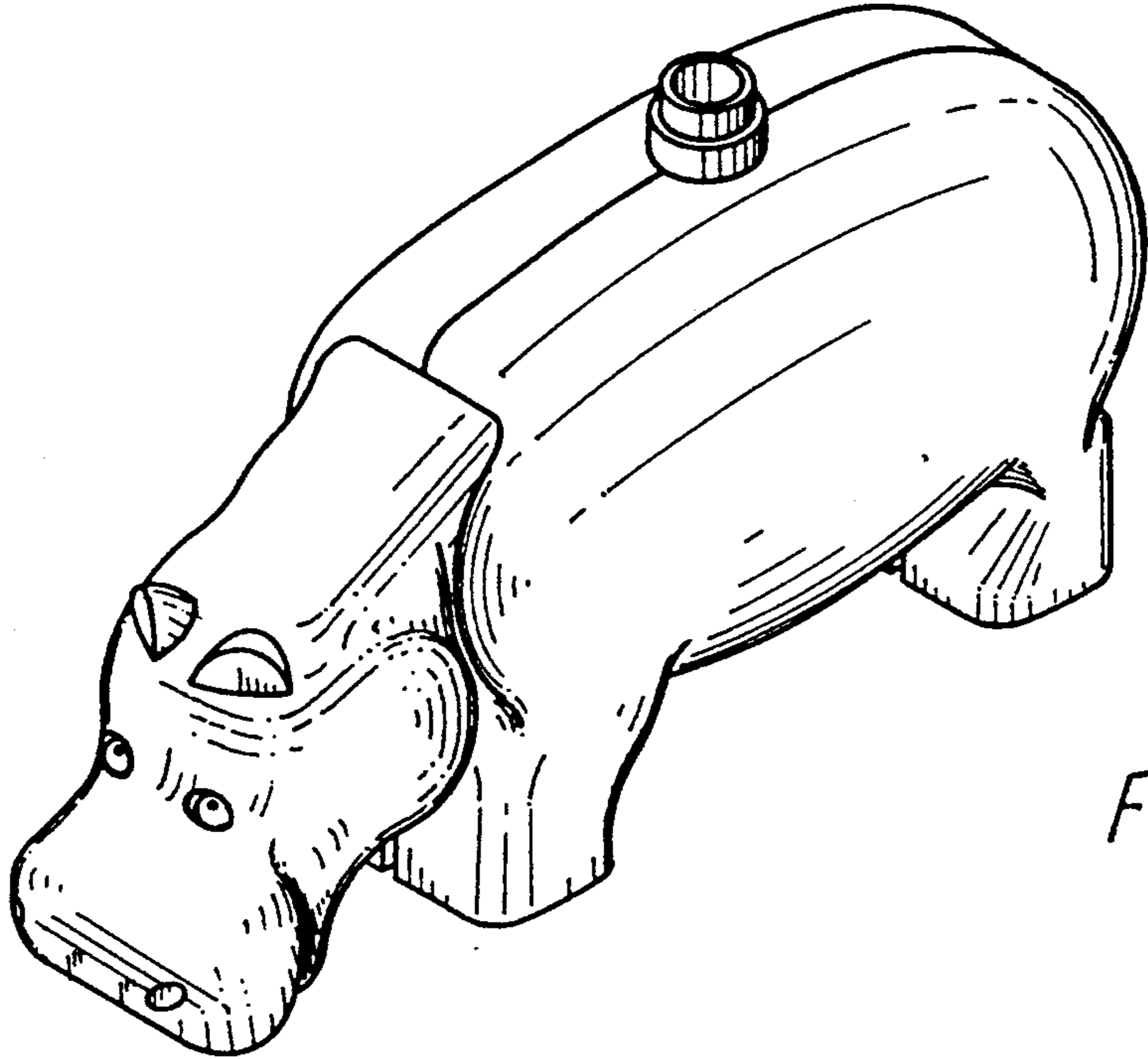

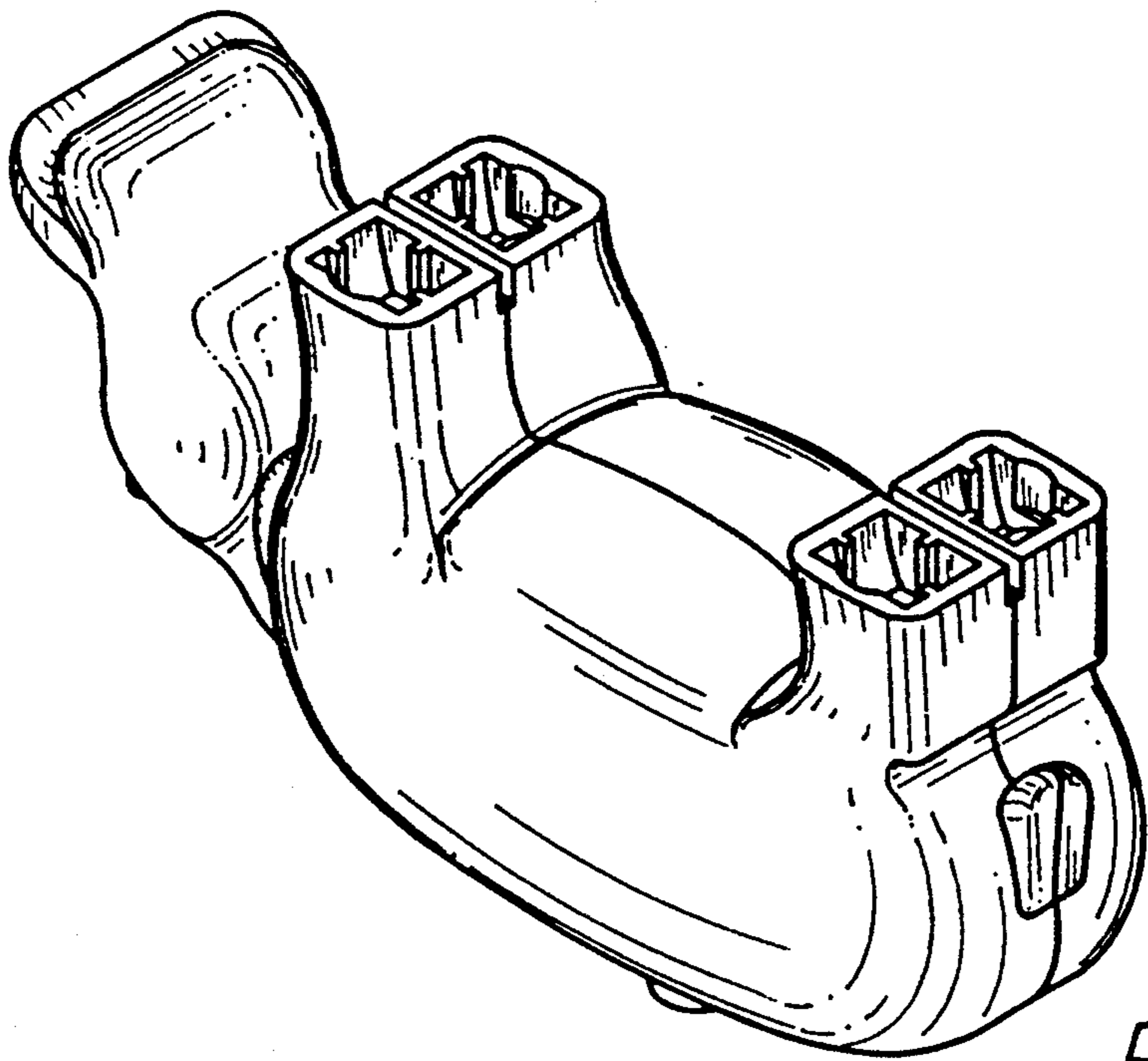

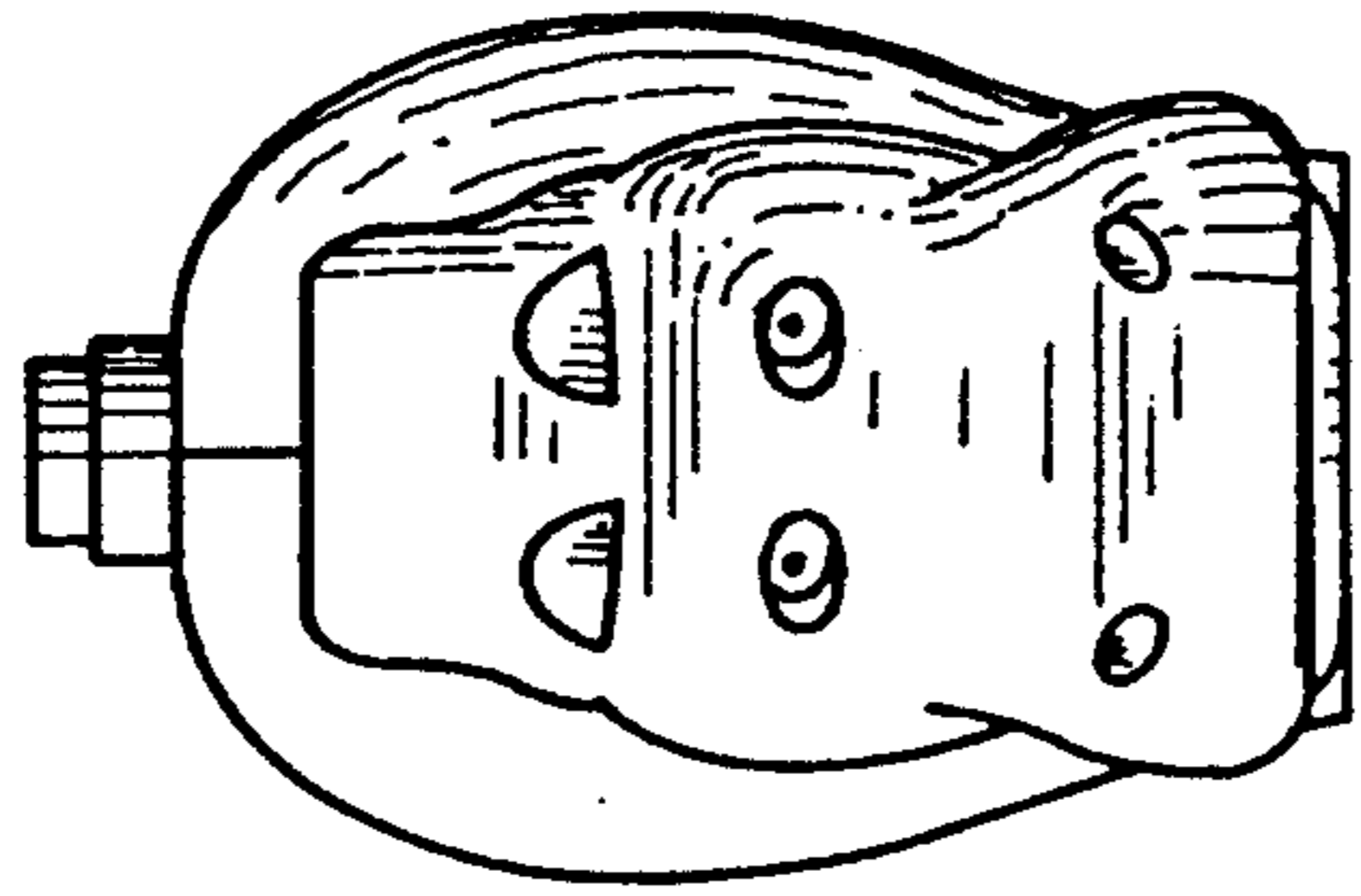

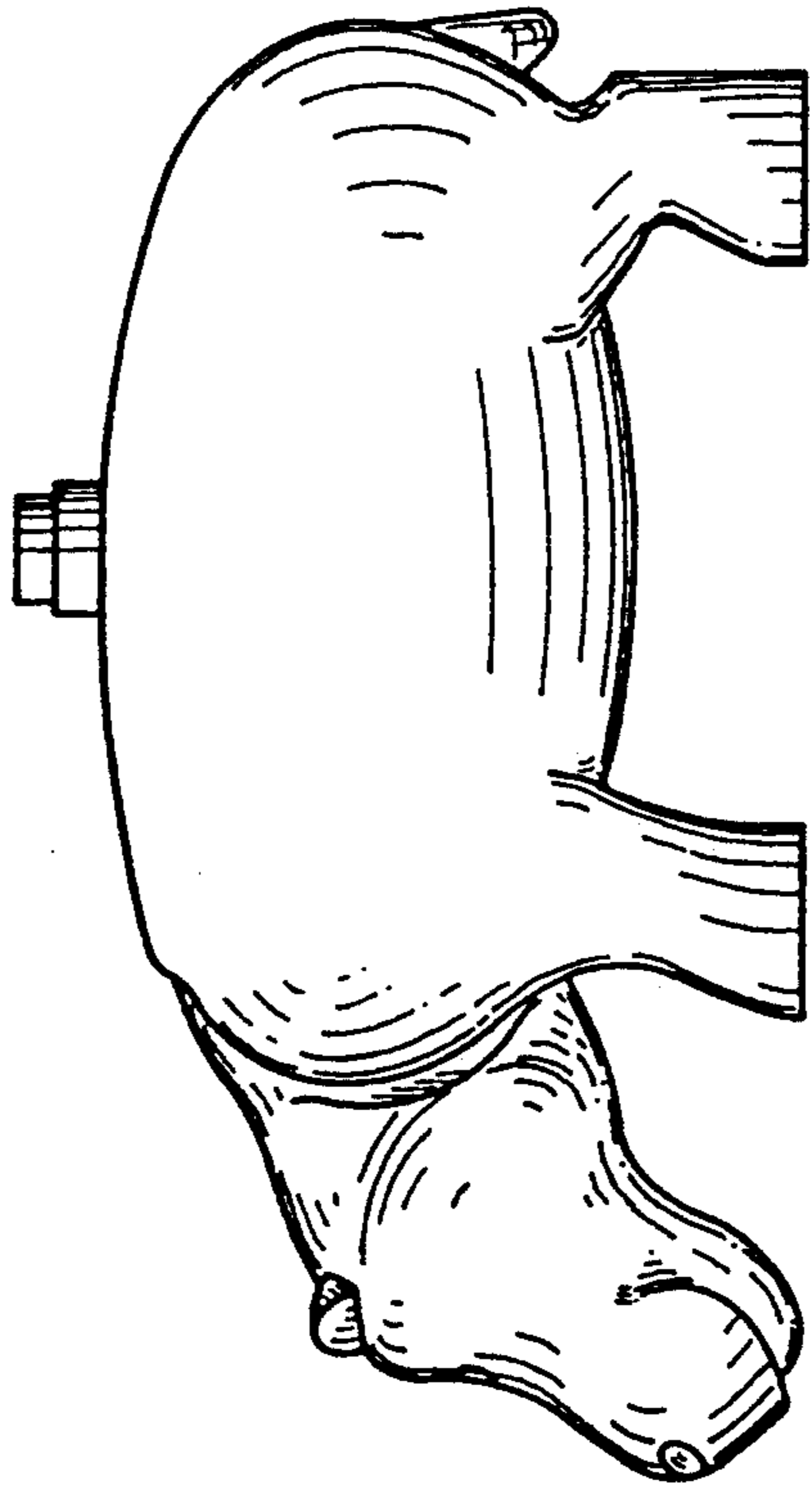

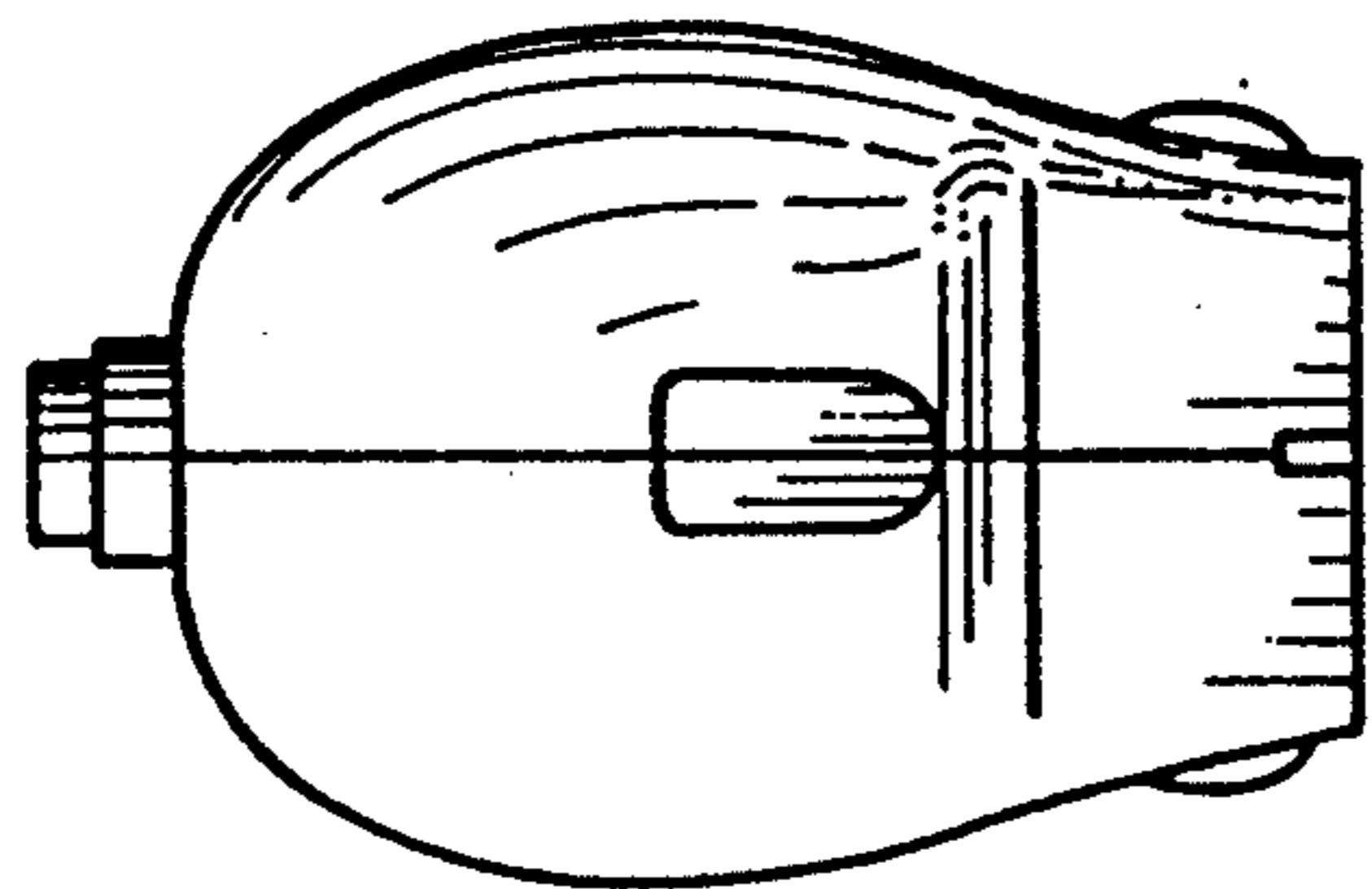

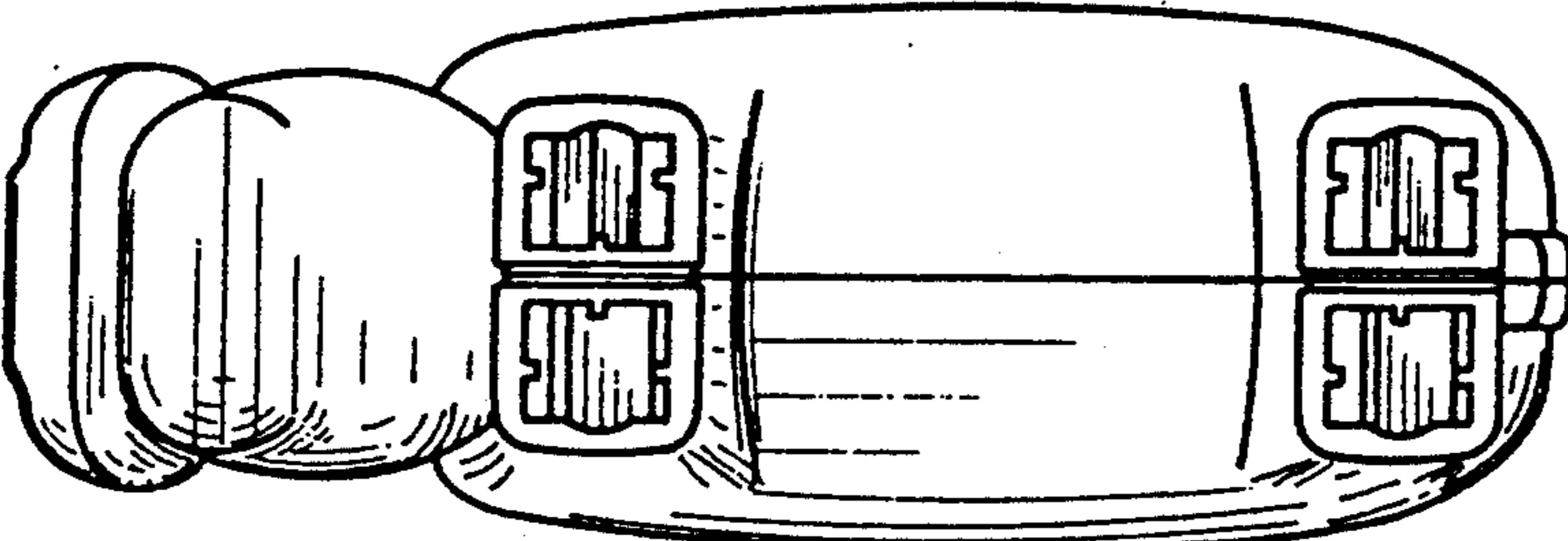

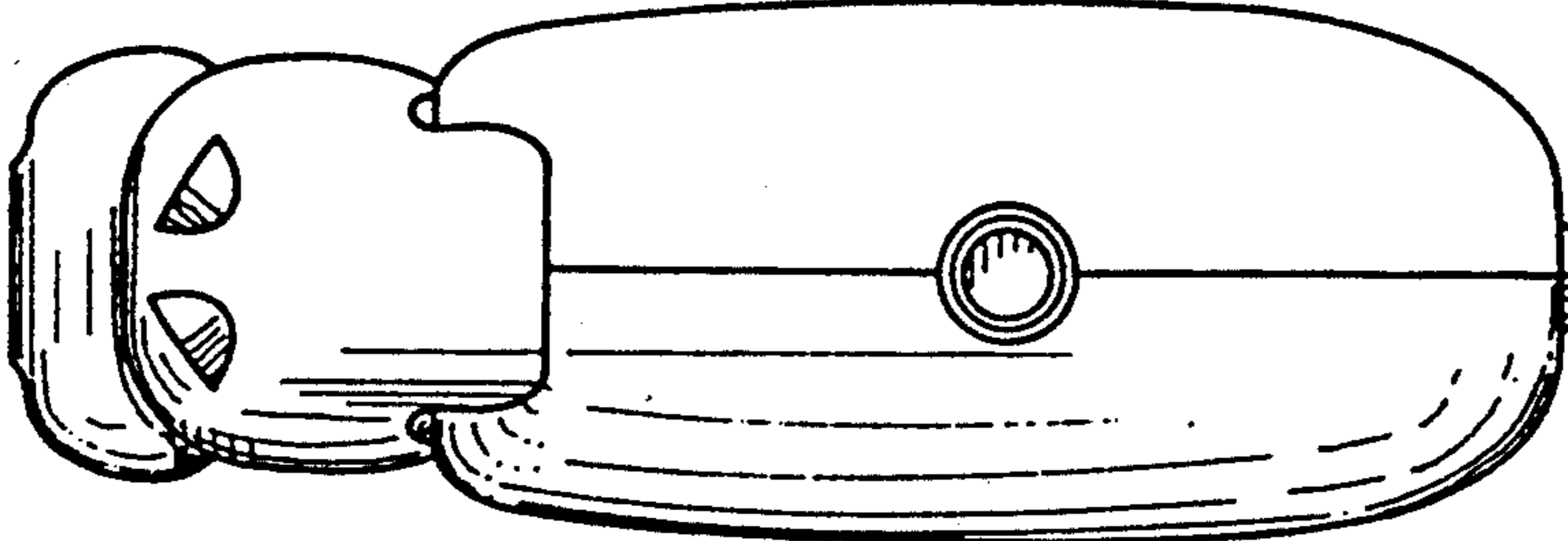

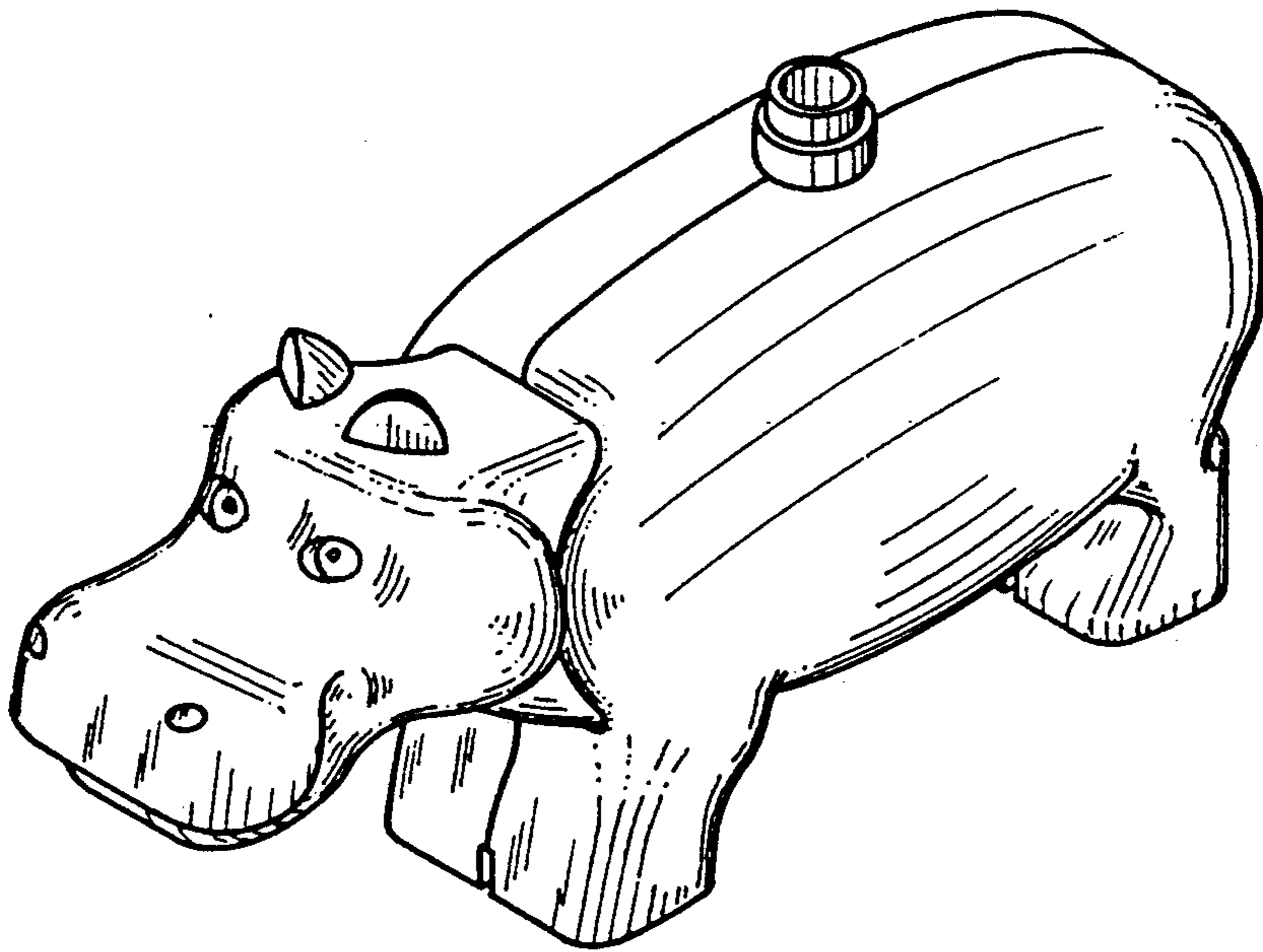
