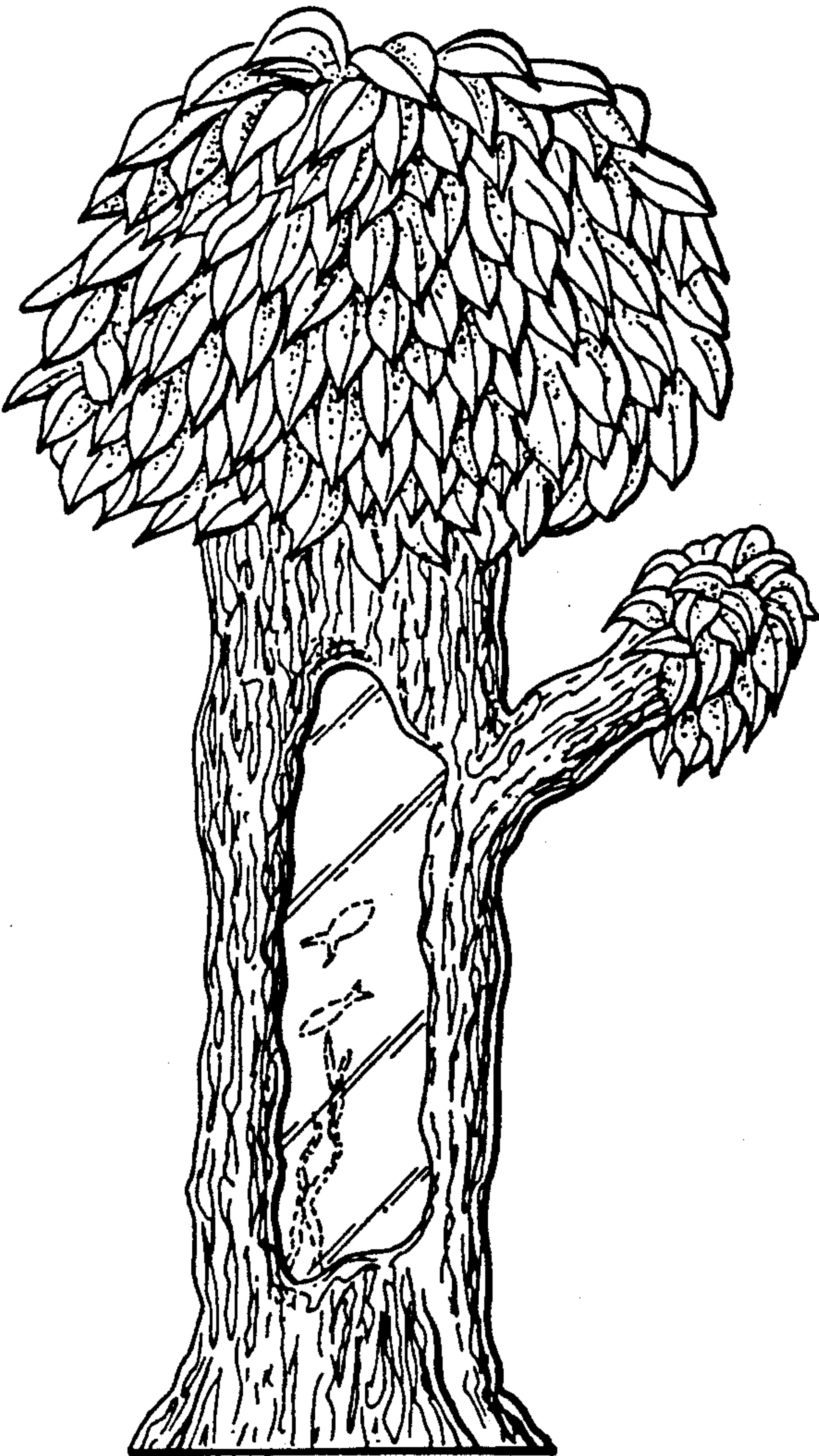
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an aquarium showing my new design;

The broken line representation of fish and plants in FIGS. 1 and 4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



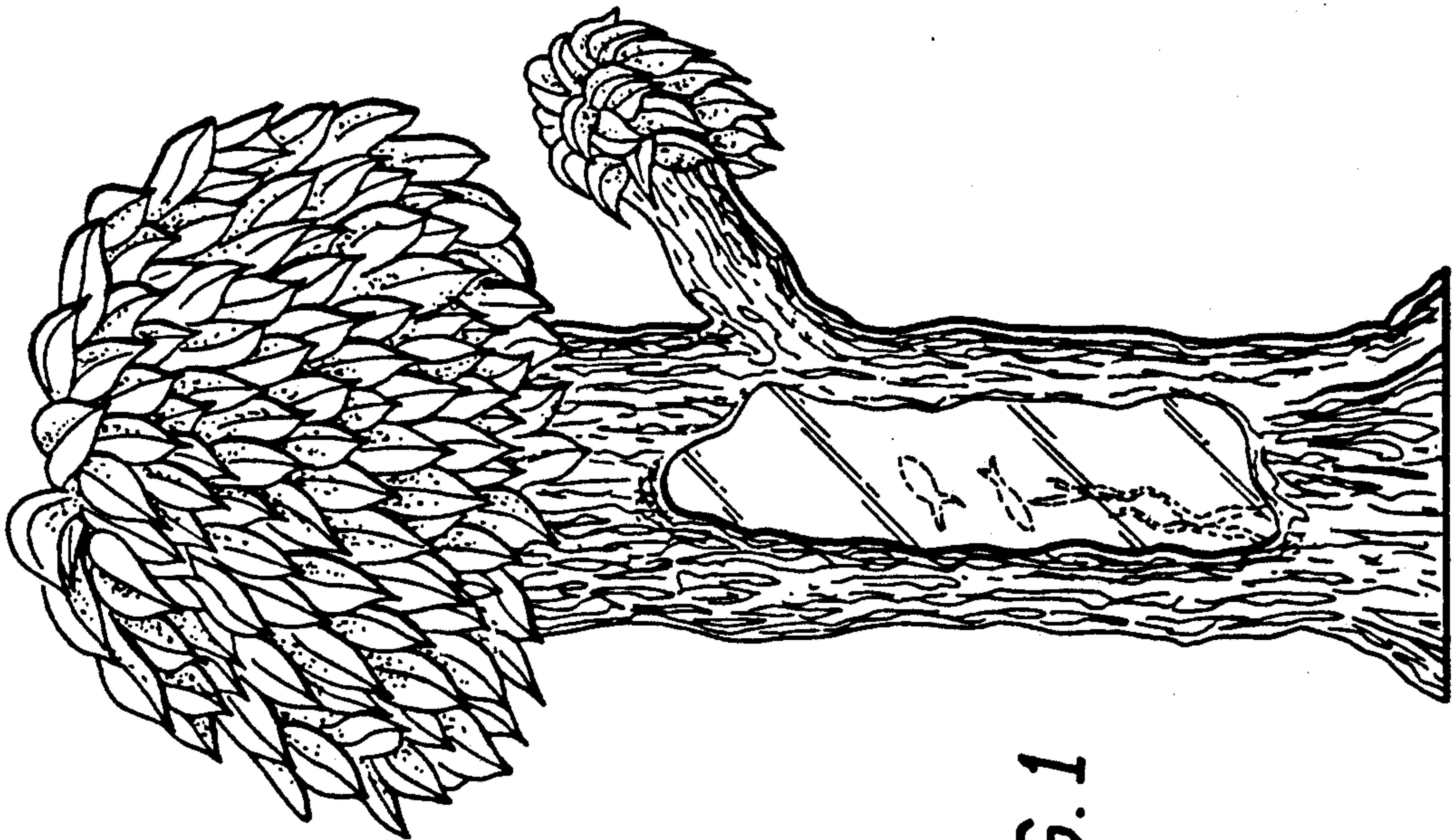

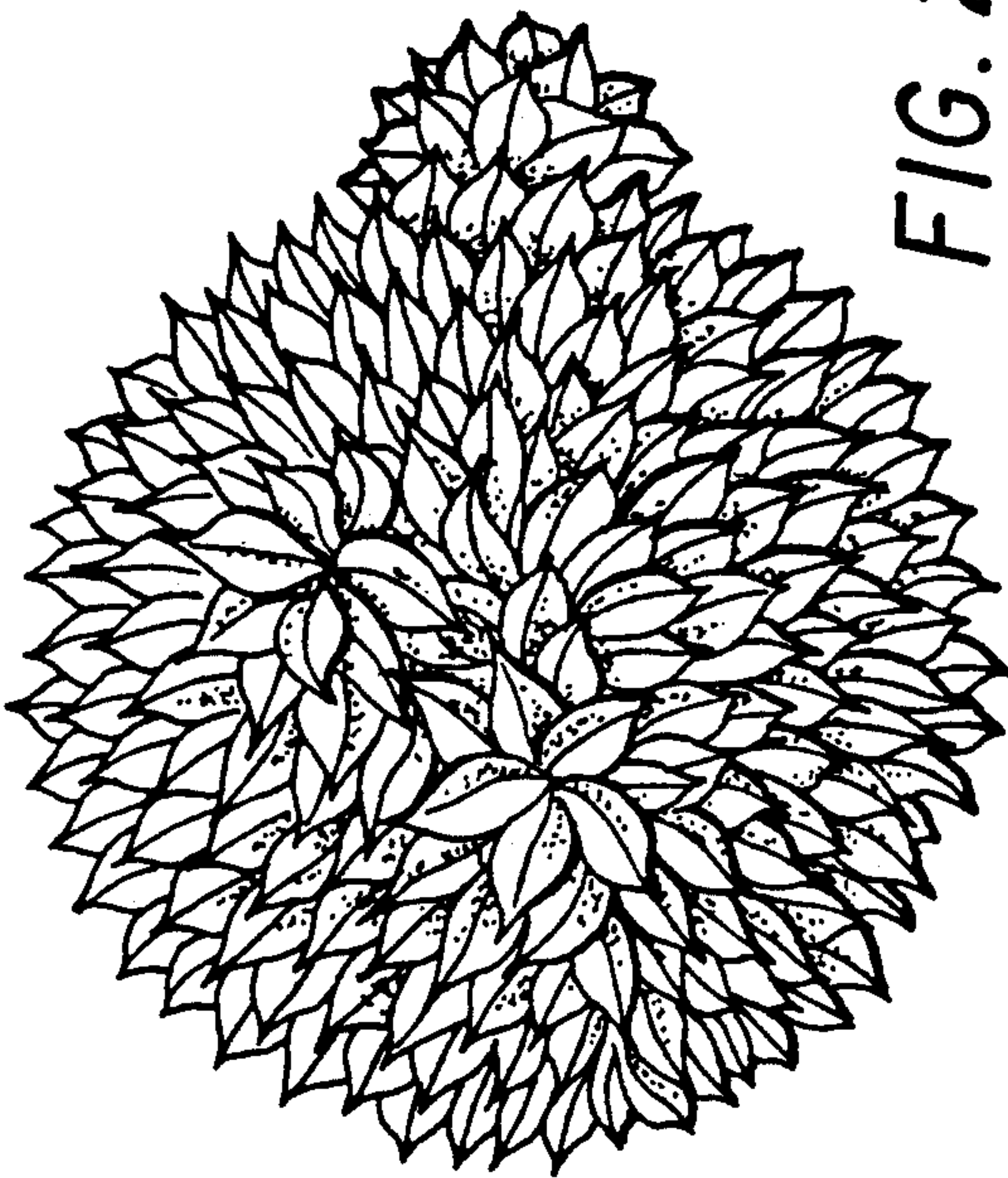

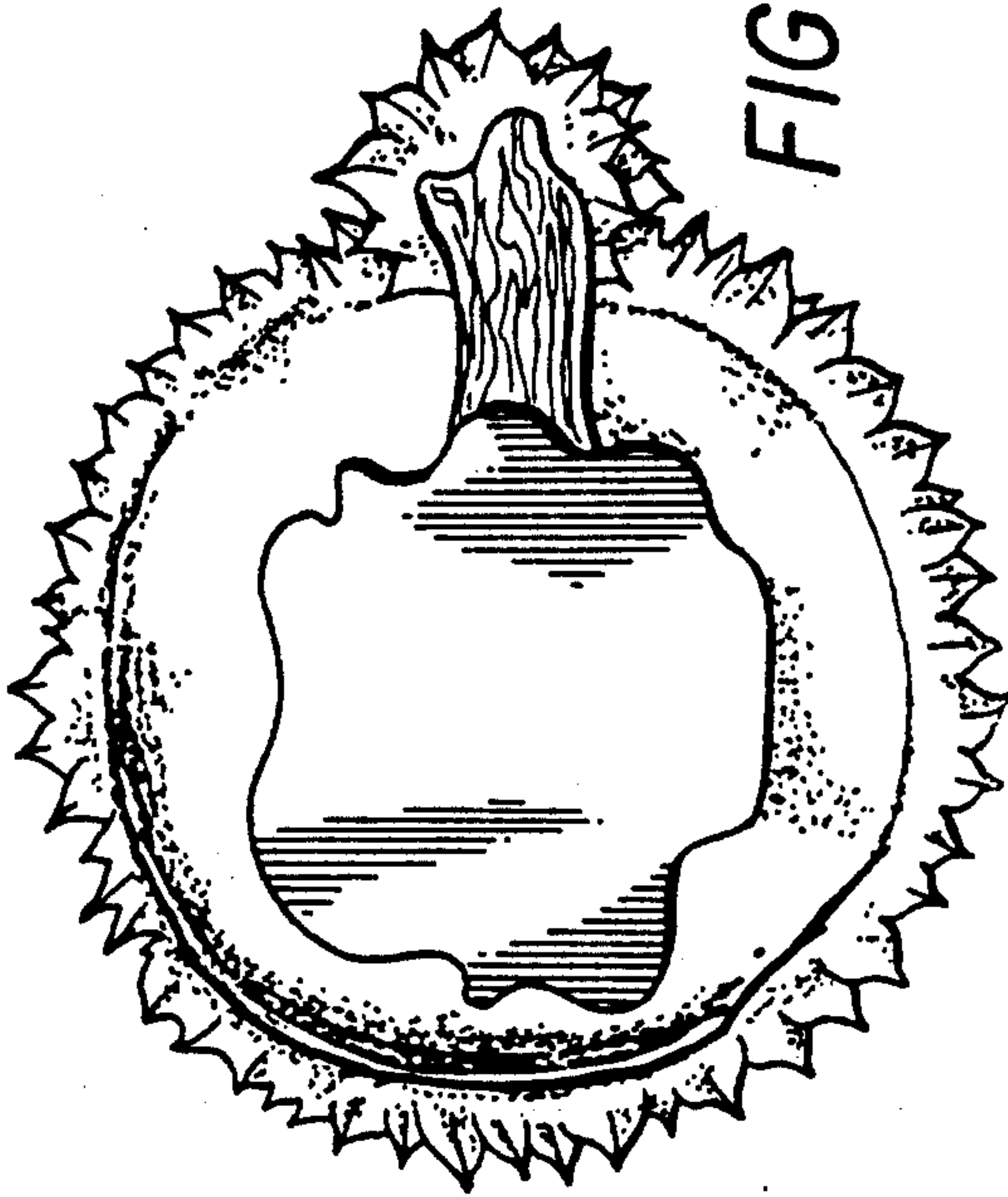

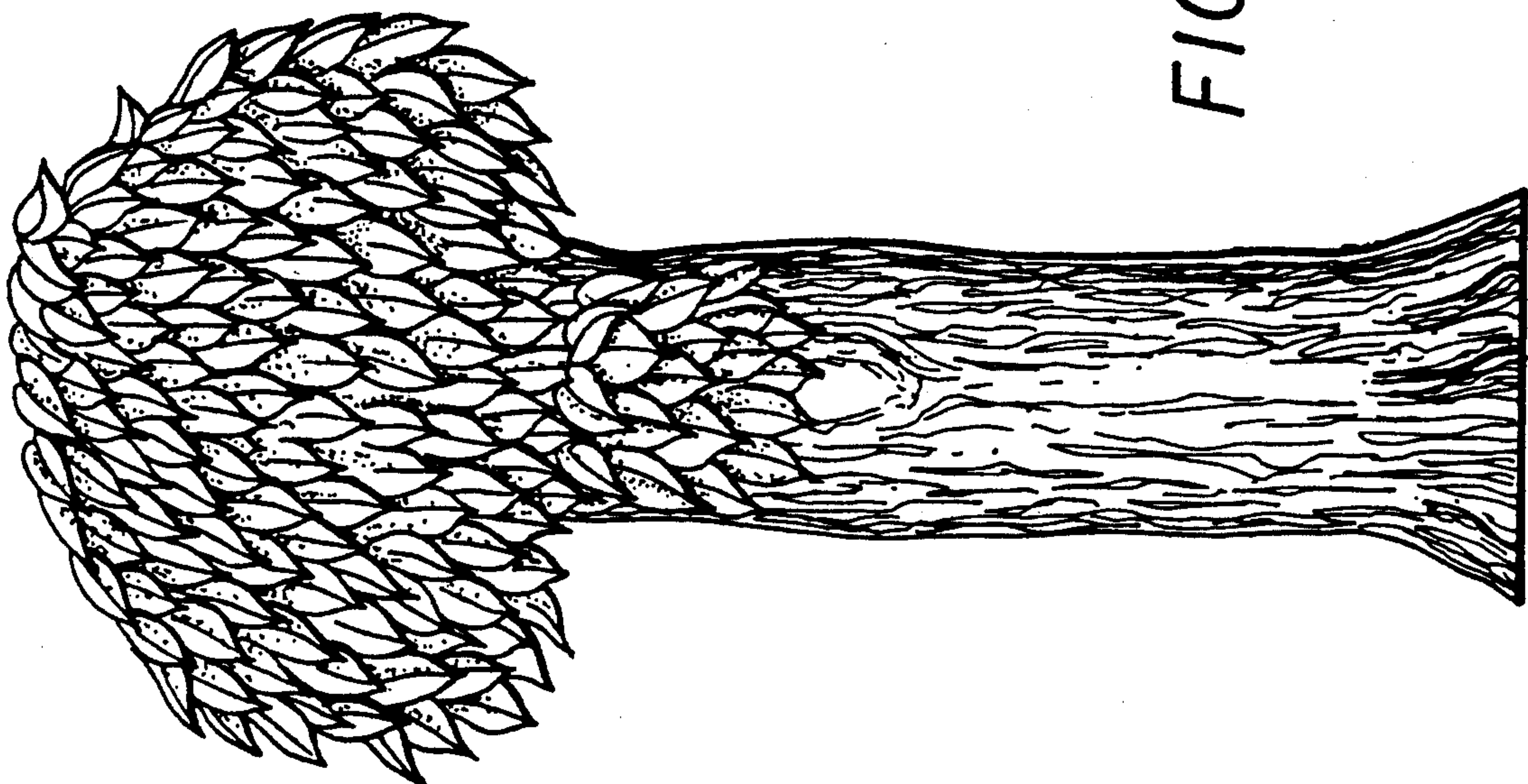

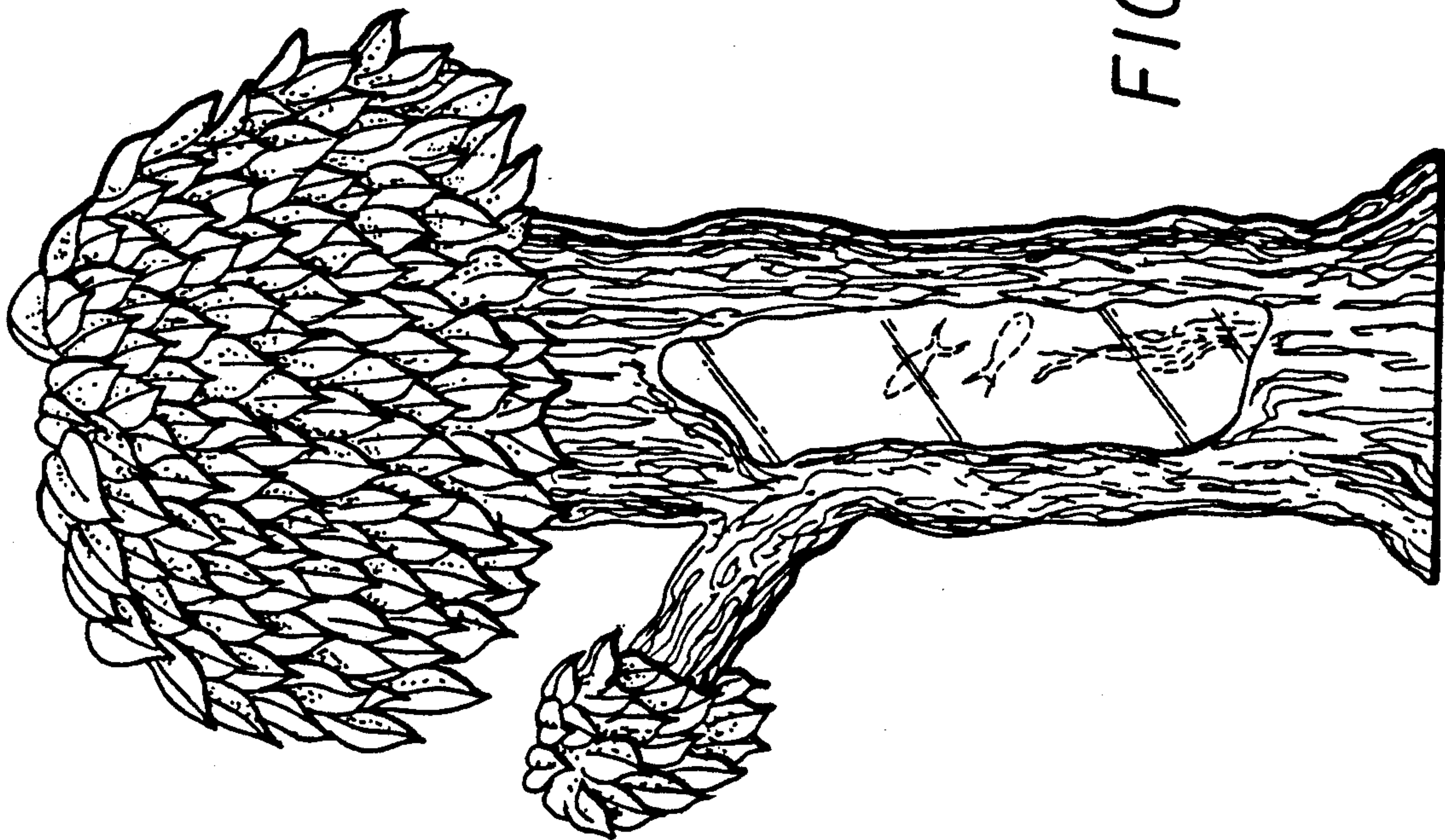
