DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a carafe showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

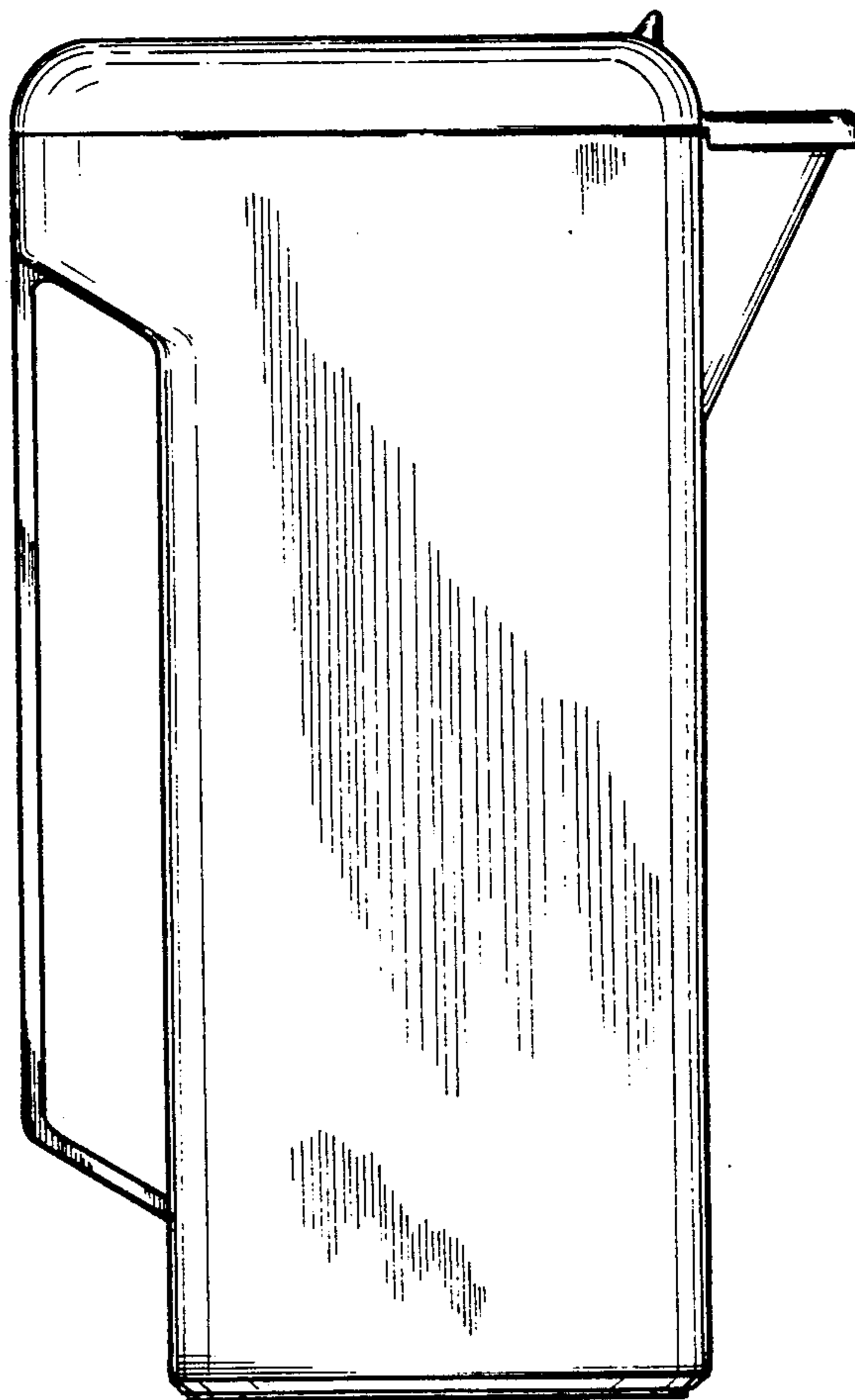
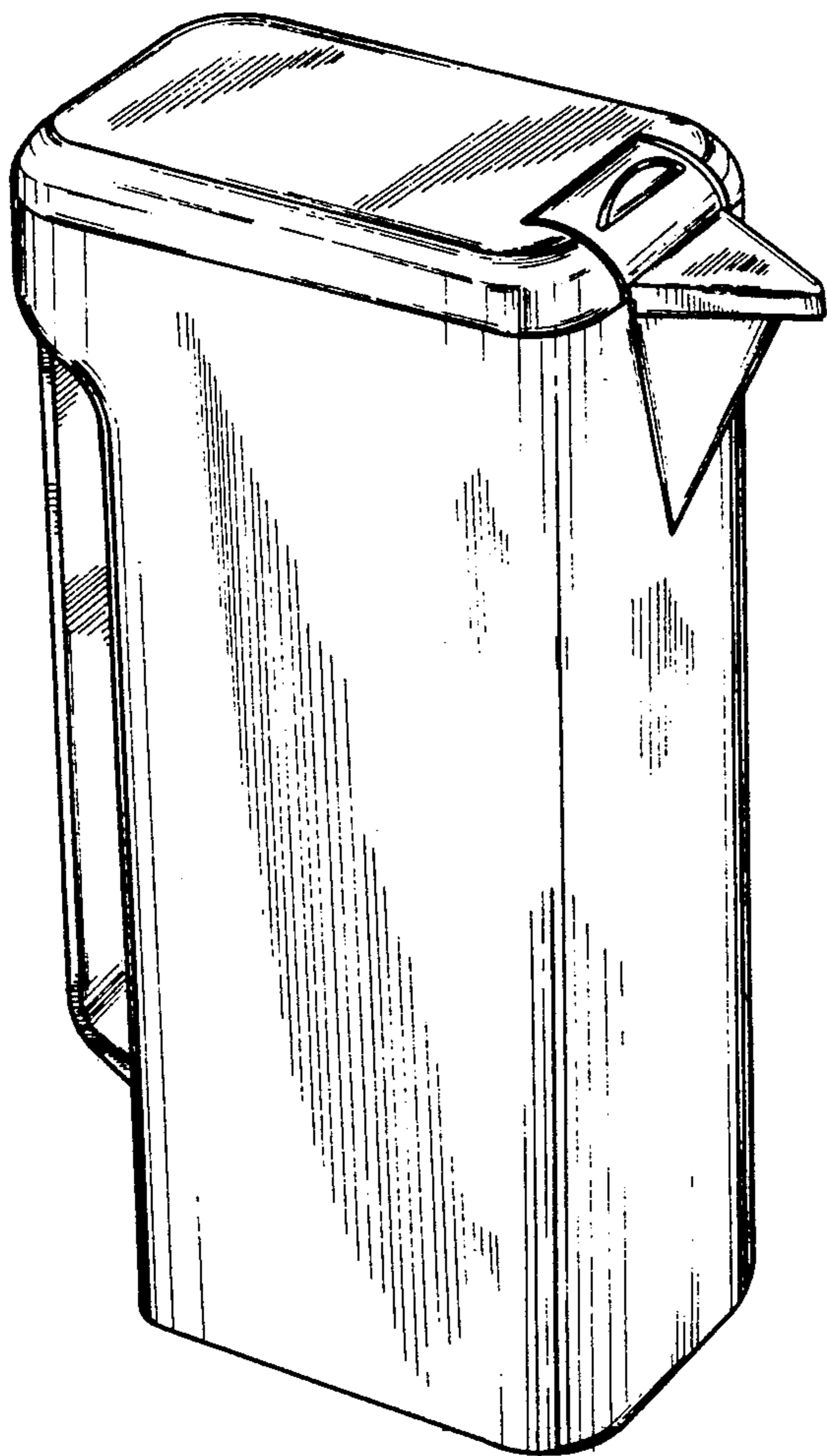

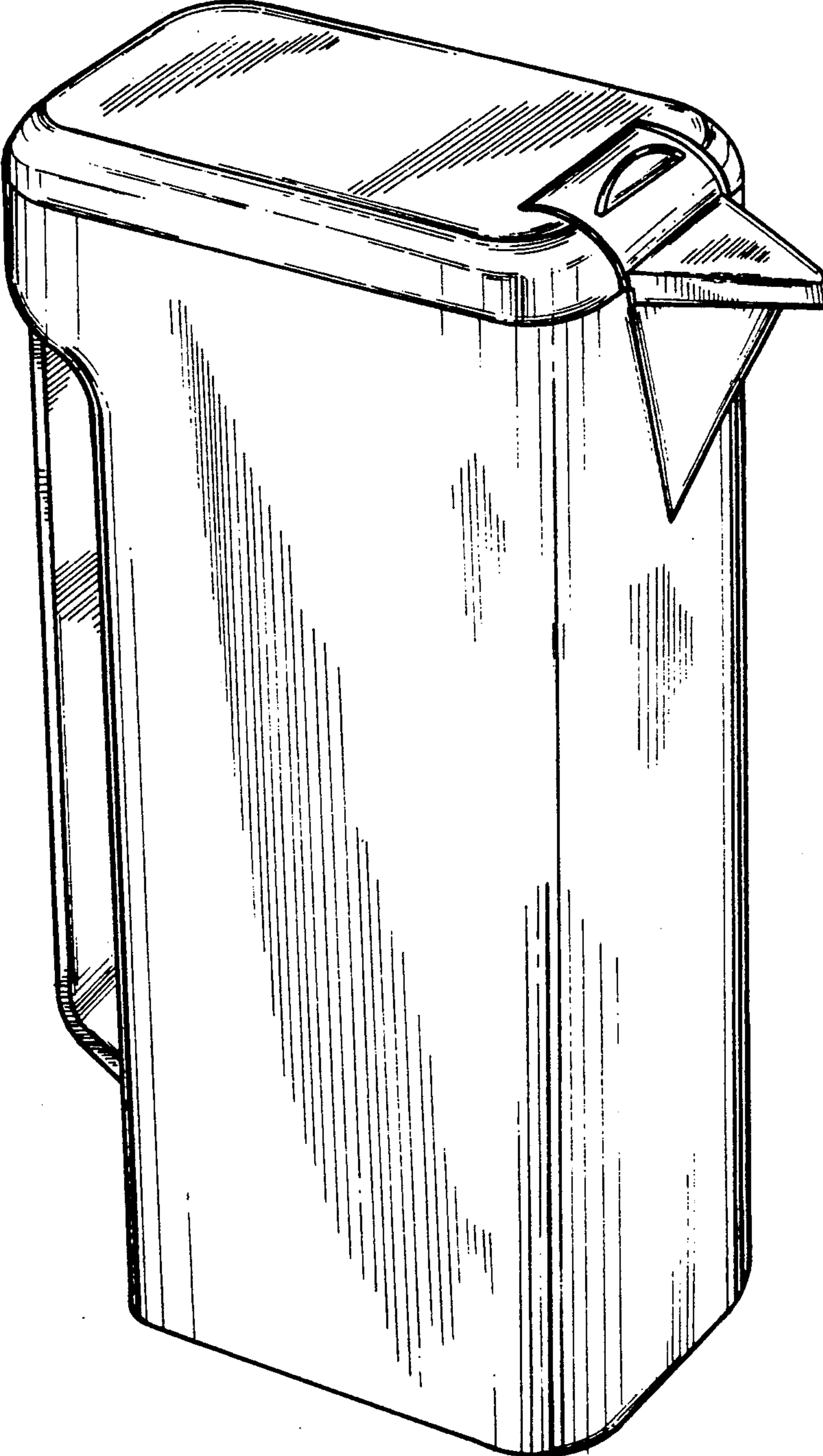

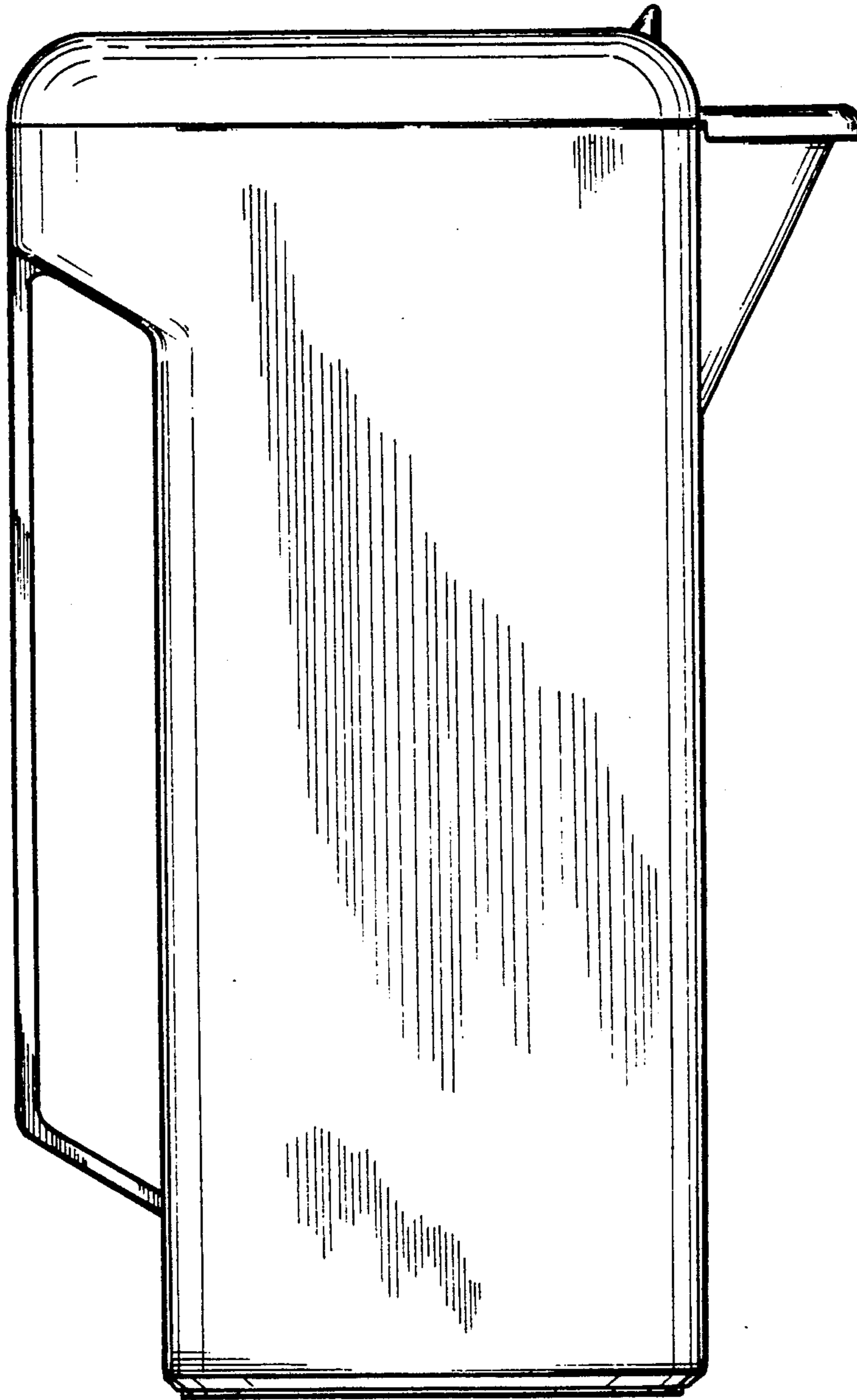

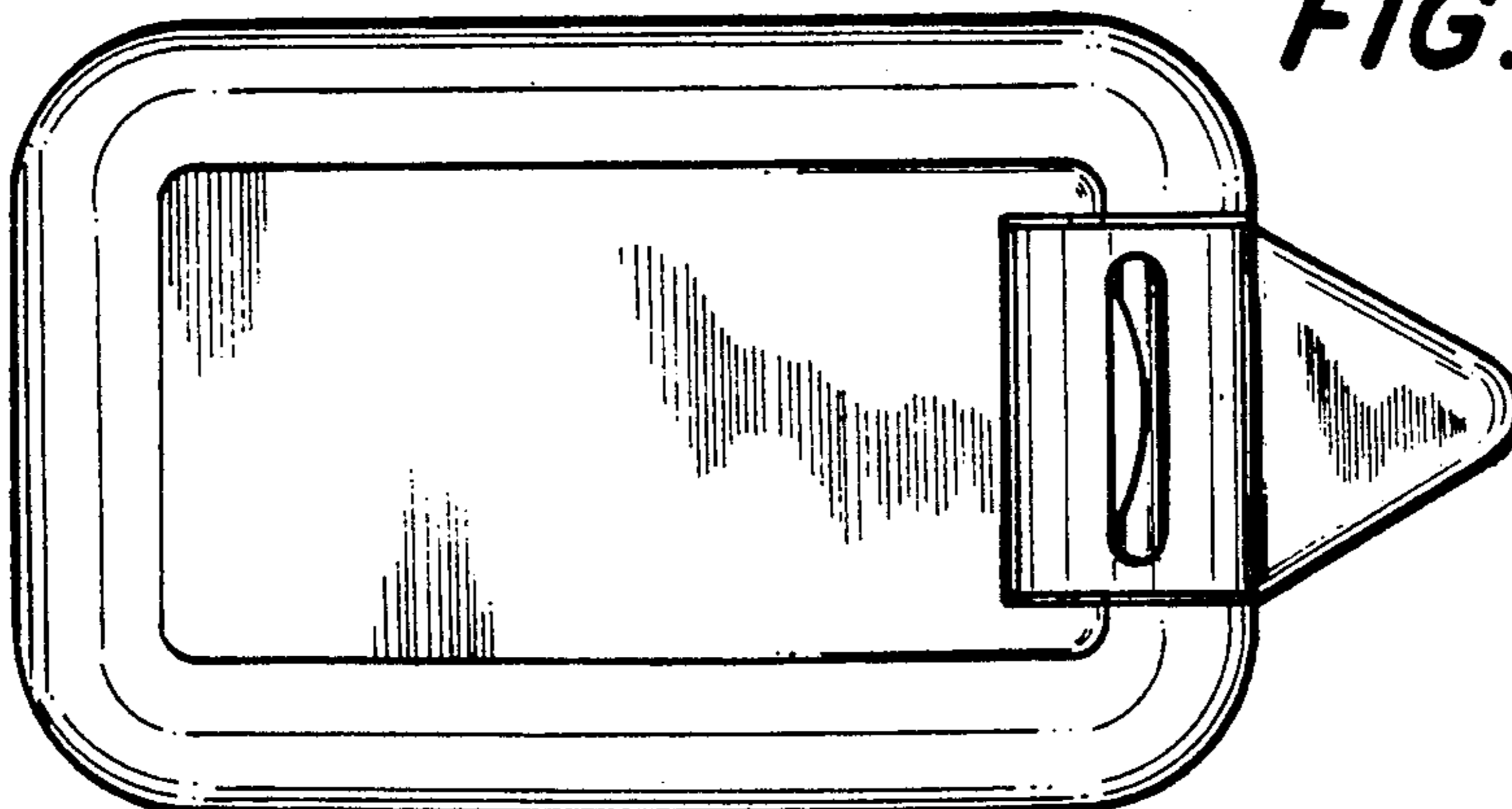

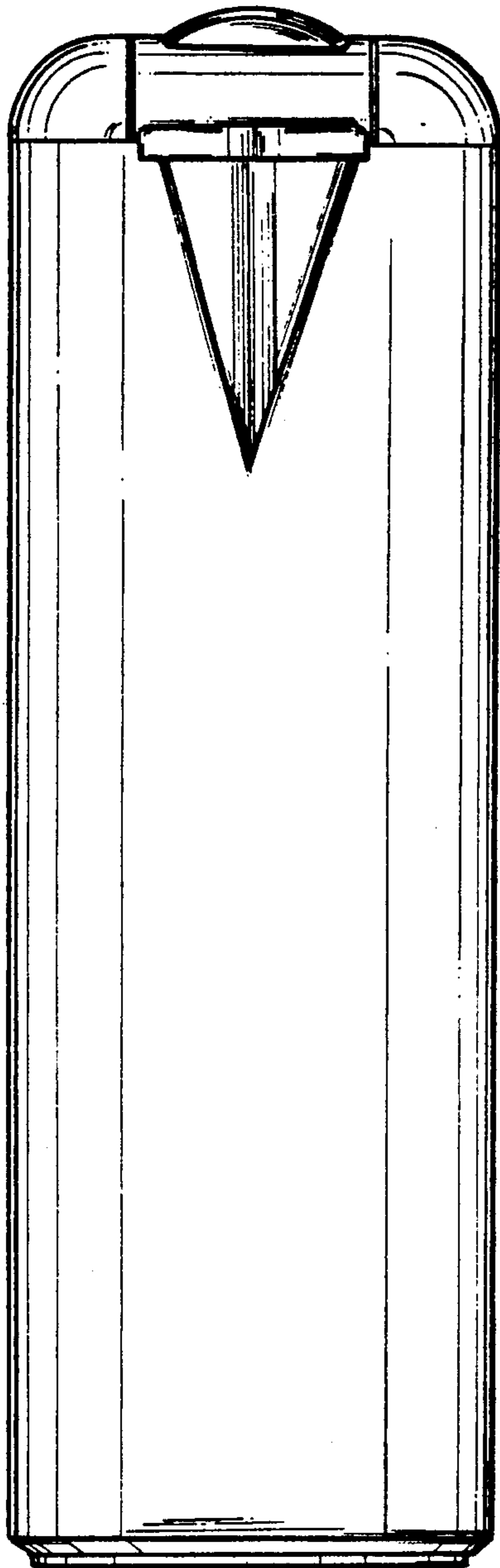

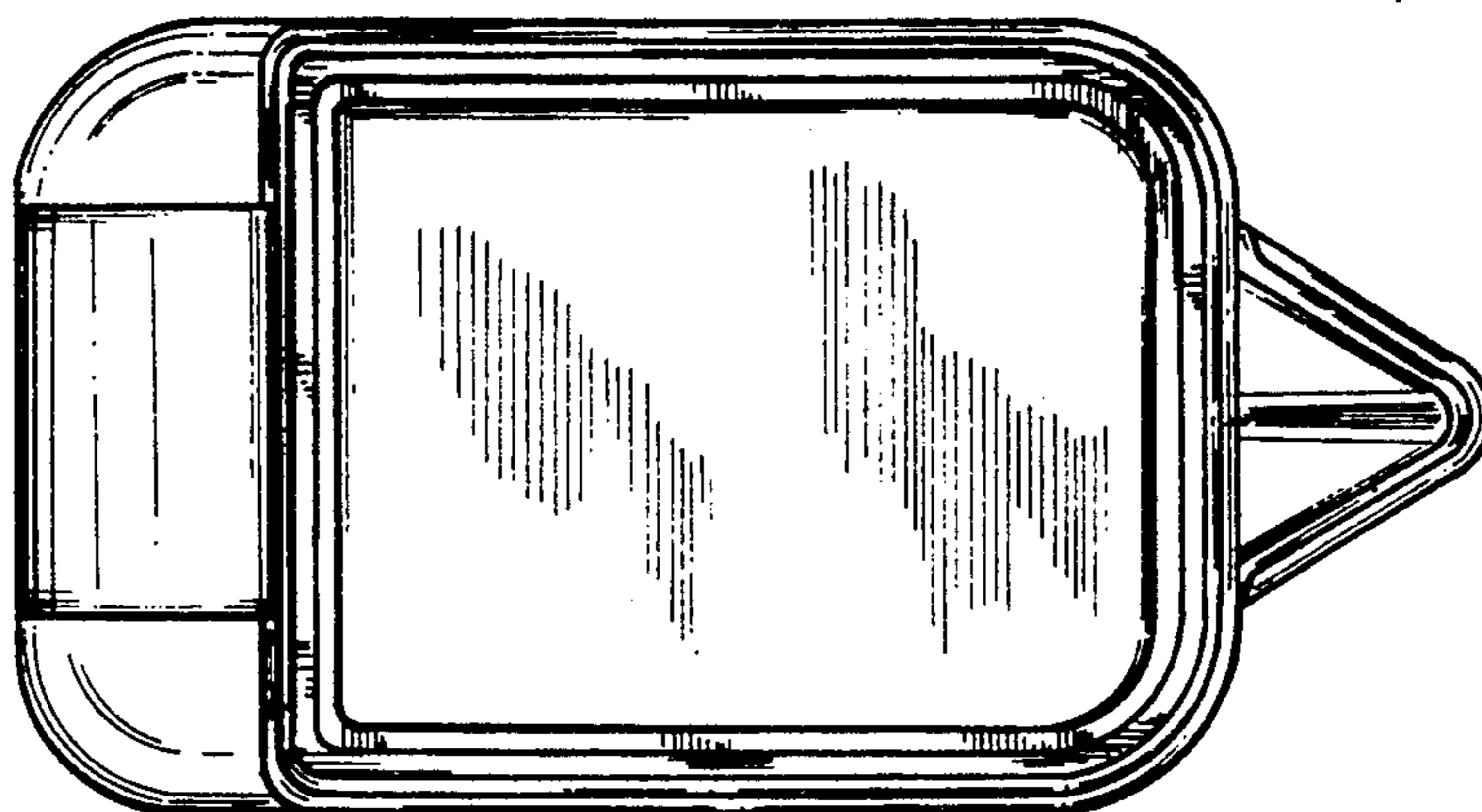
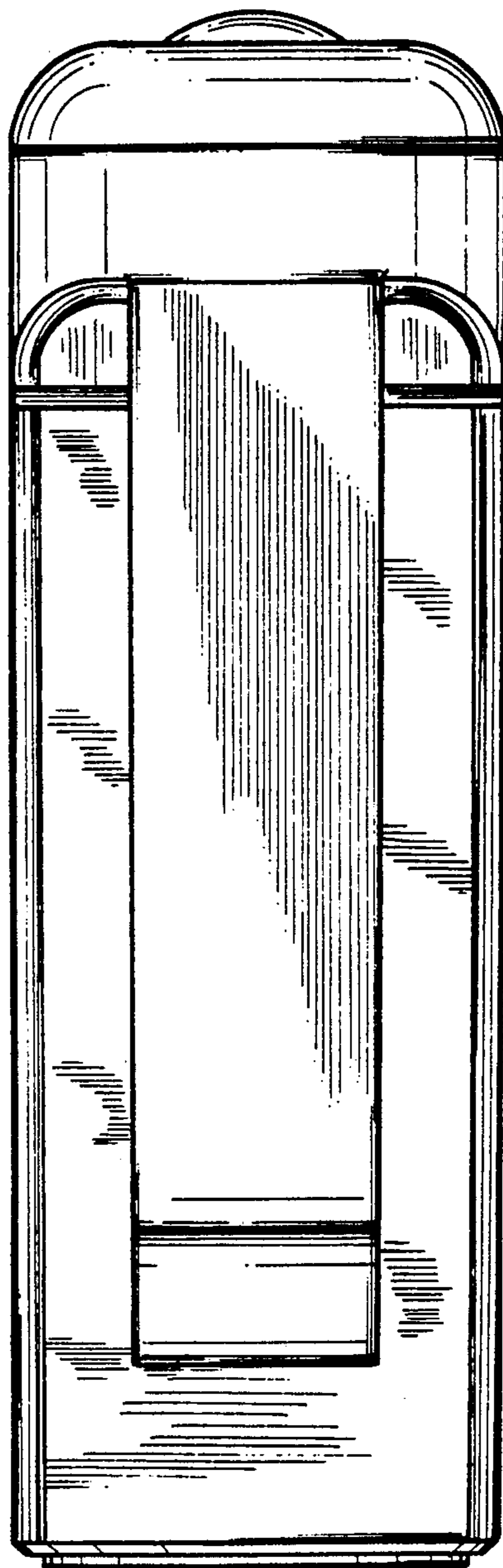
