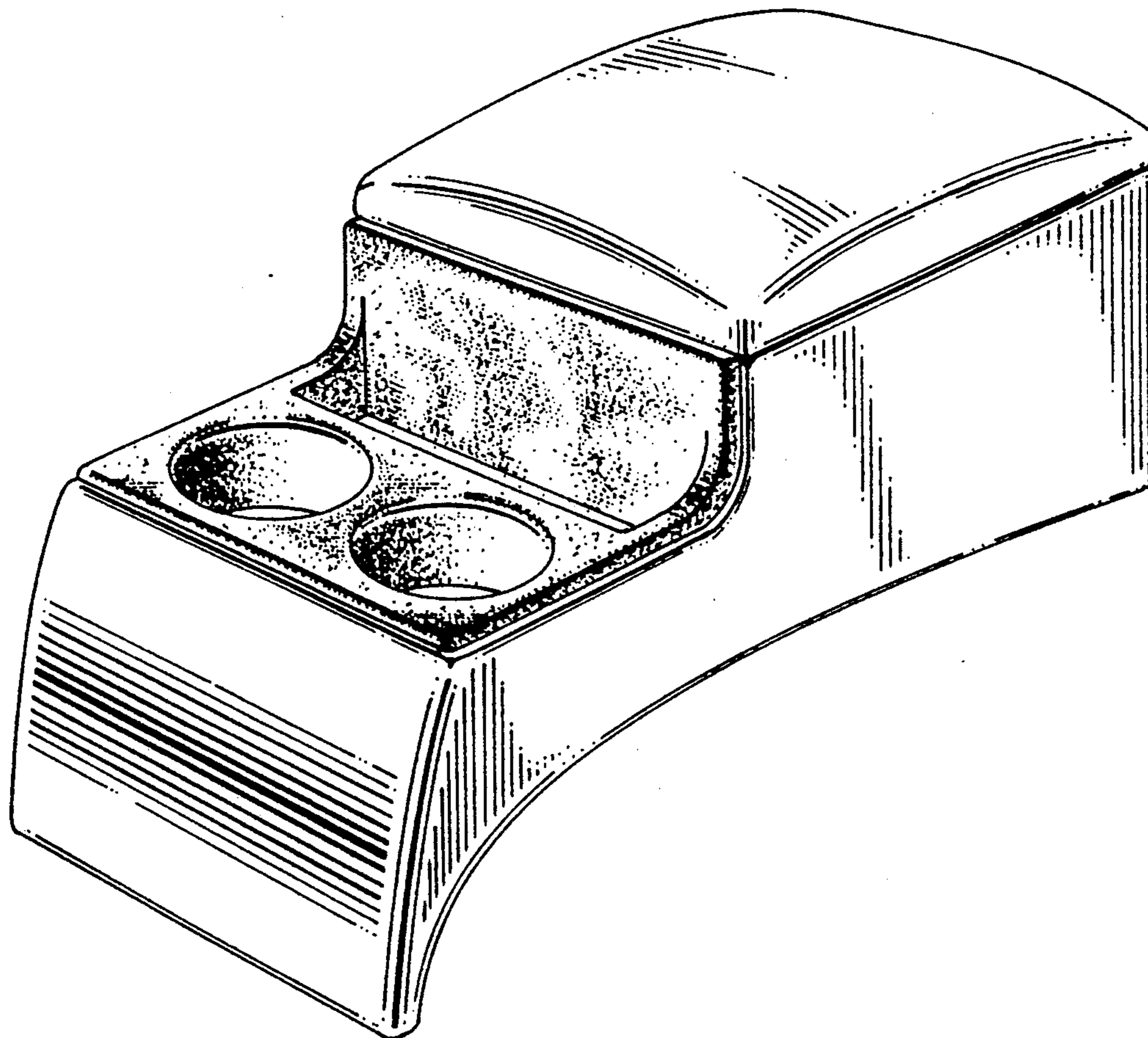

The ornamental design for a seat caddy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a seat caddy showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof the right side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a top perspective view in use on a reduced scale.
The broken line showing of a vehicle seat and seat belt in FIG. 7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



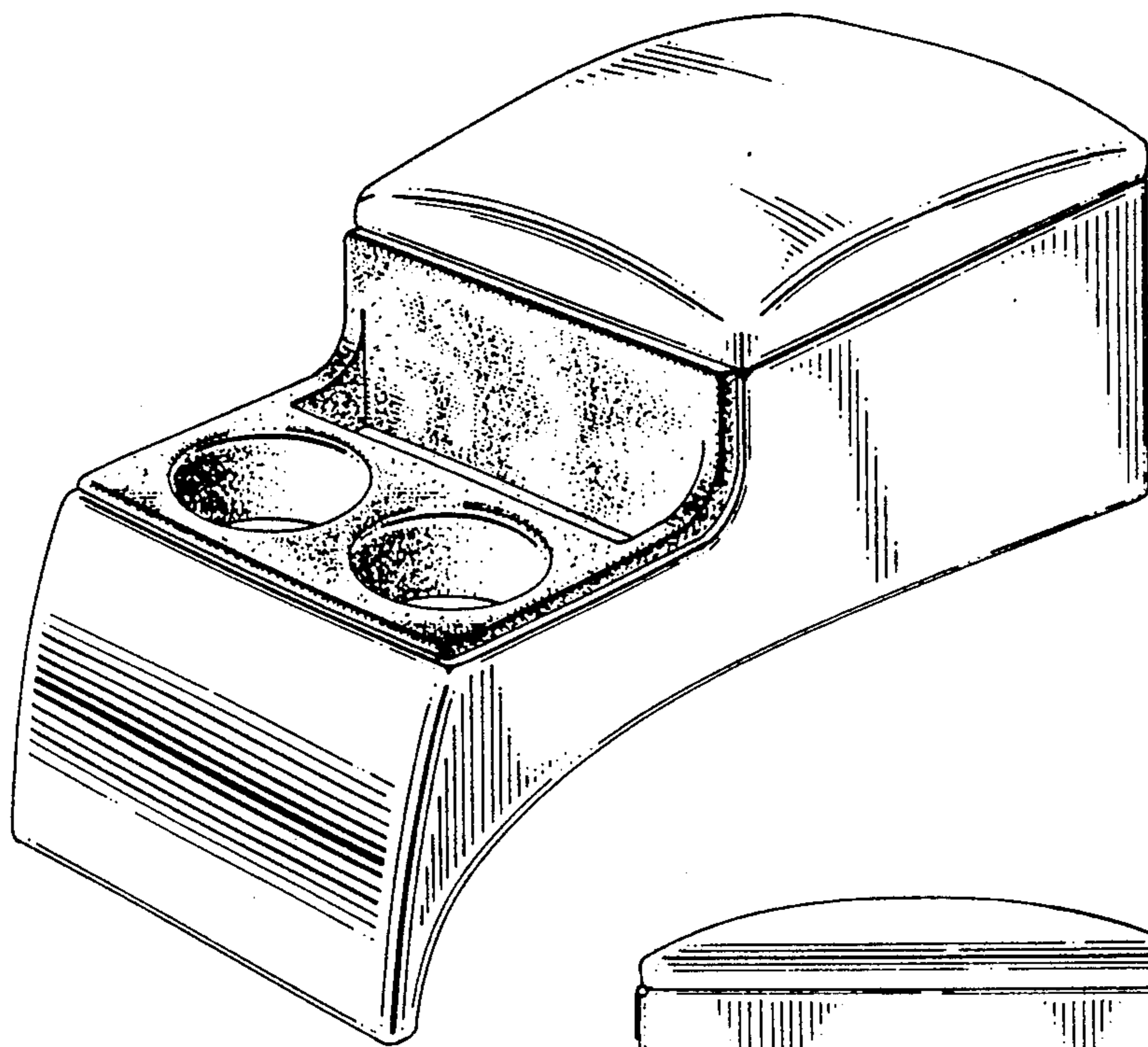

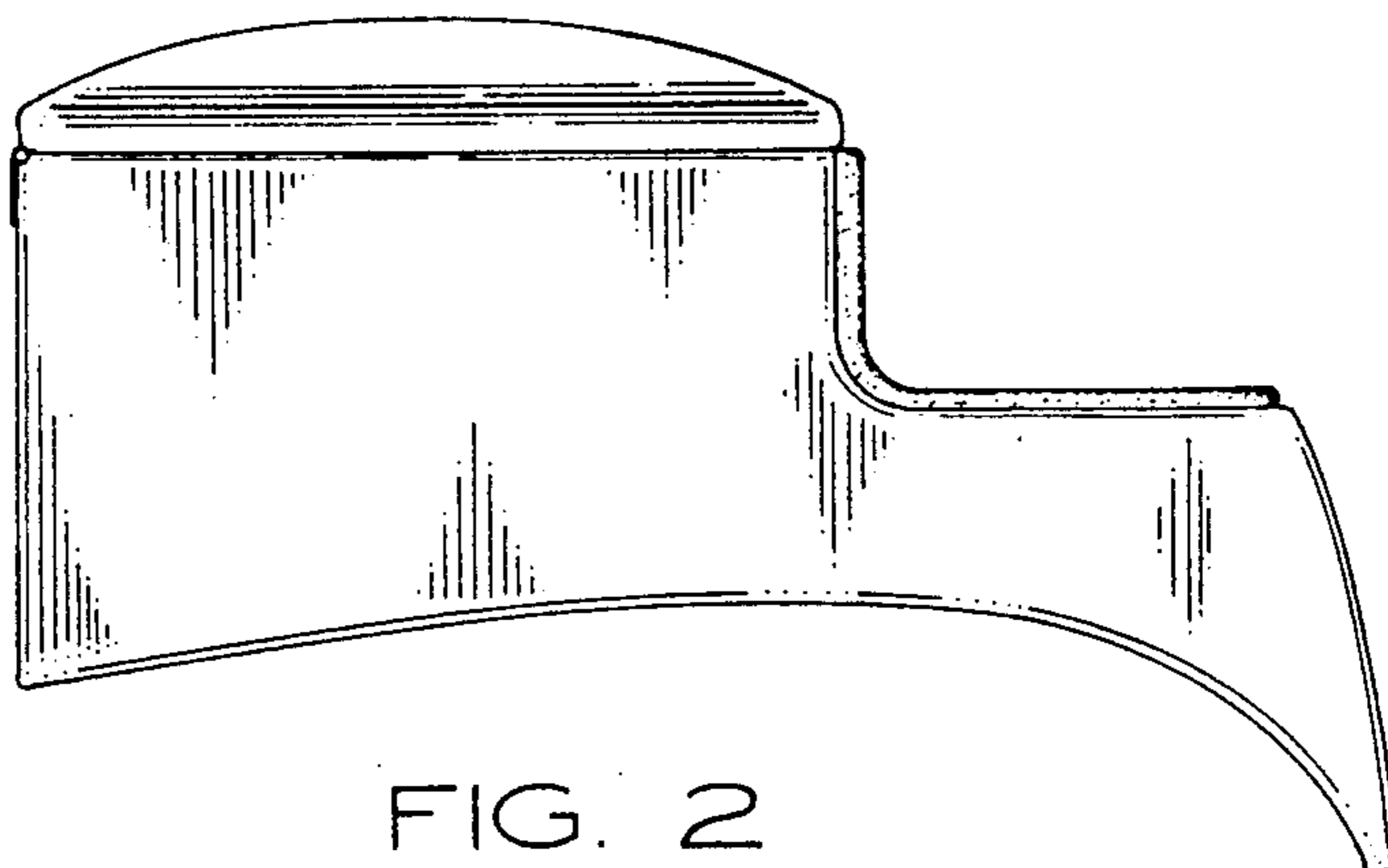

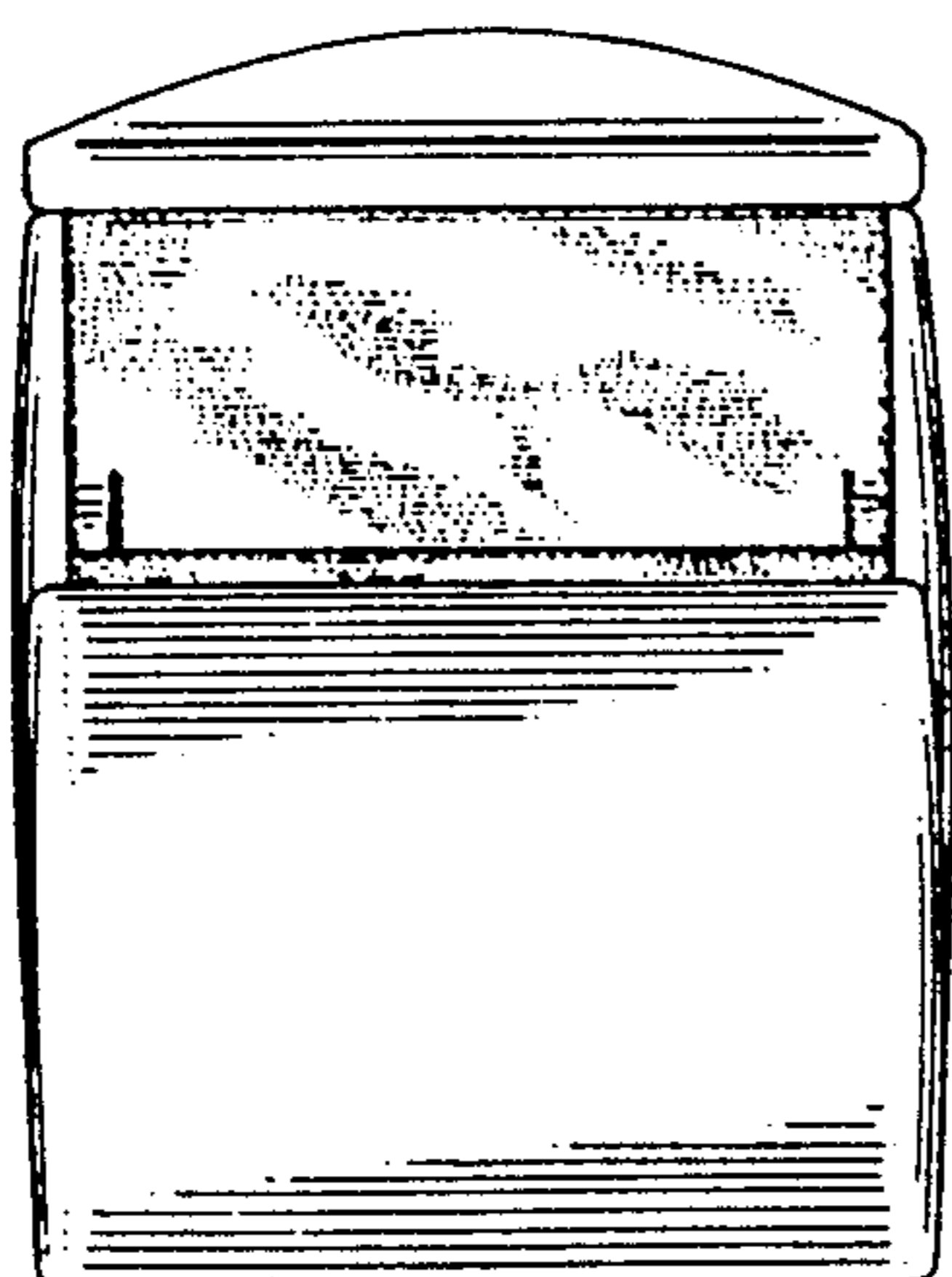

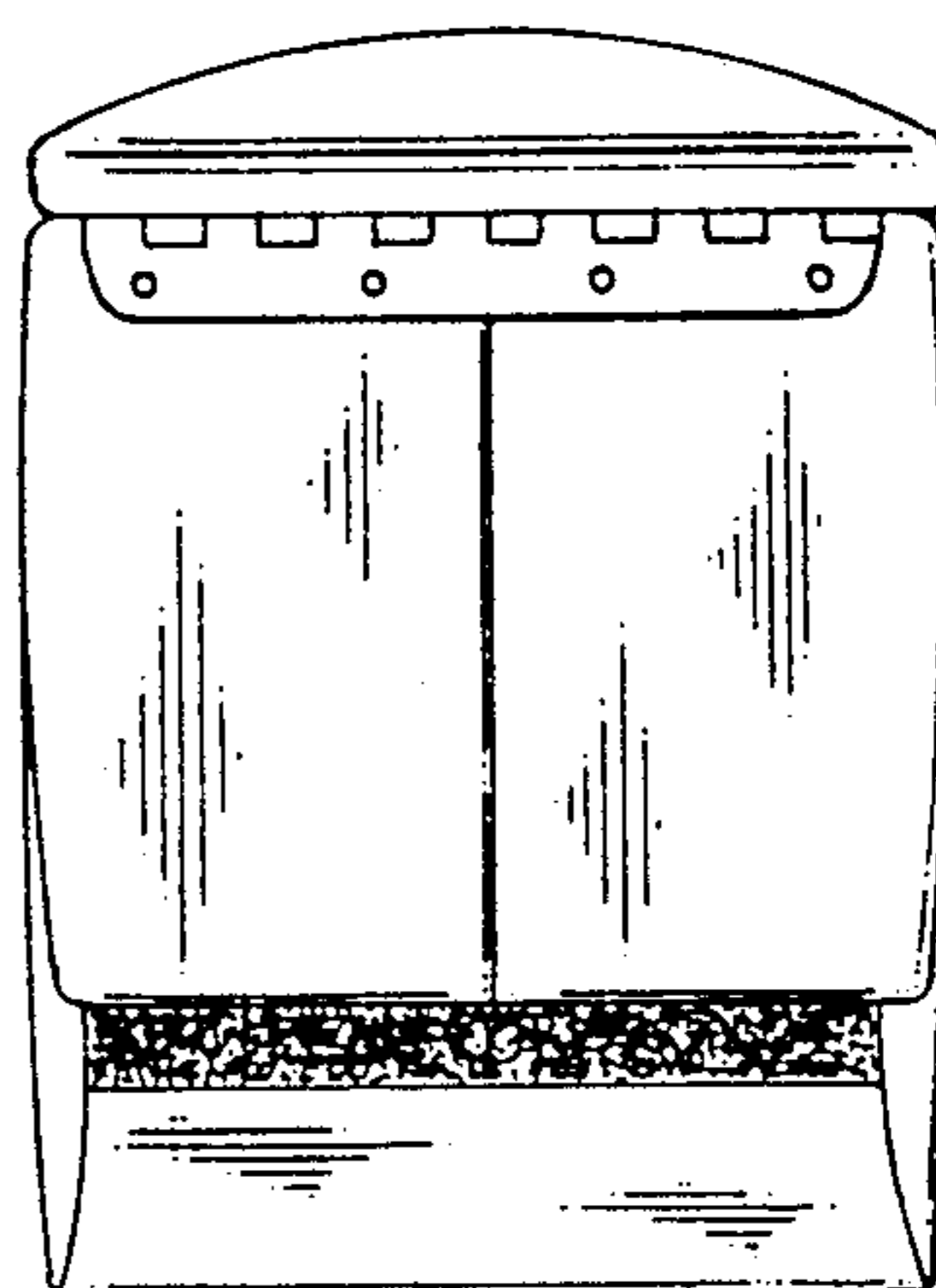

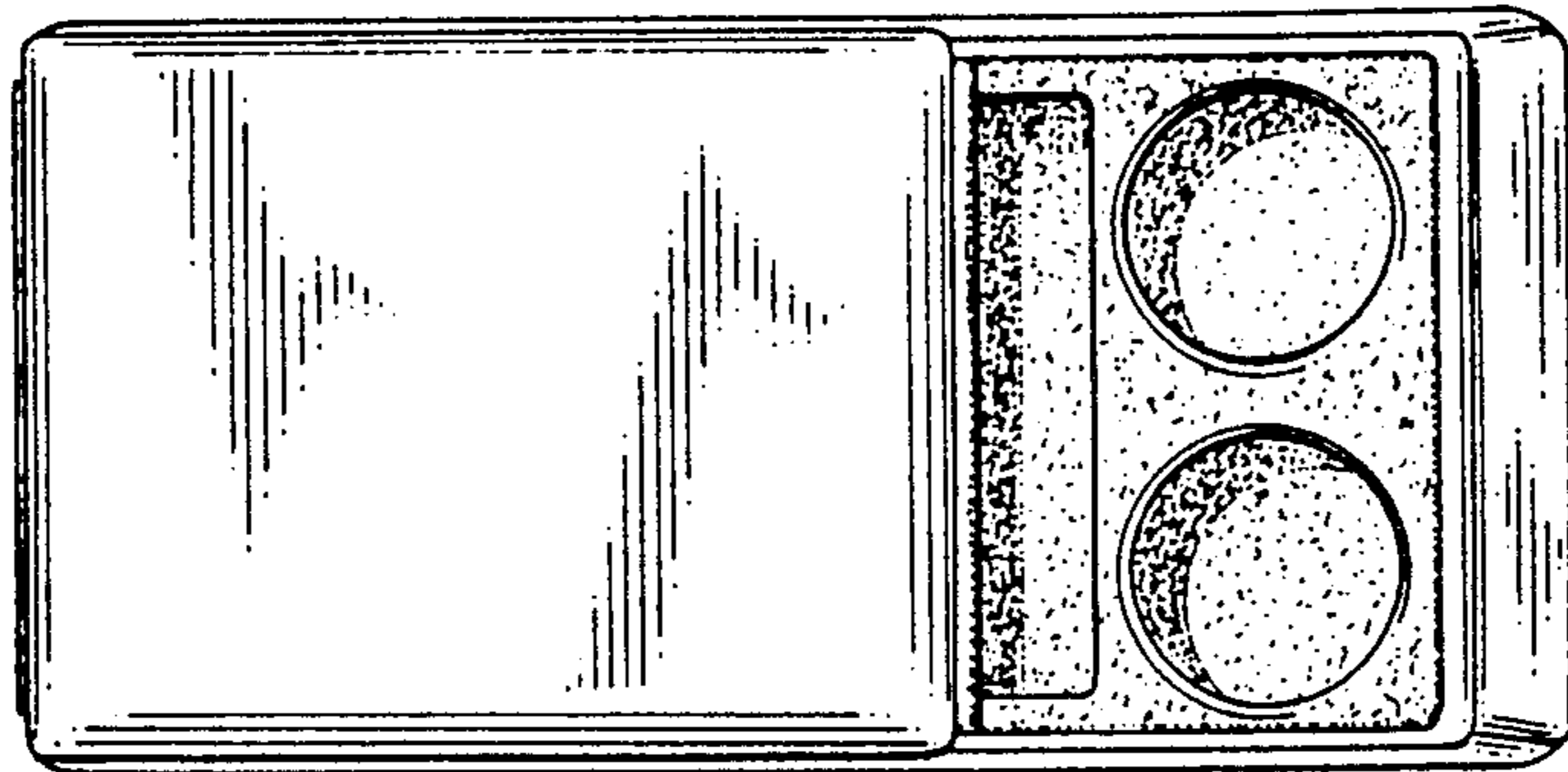

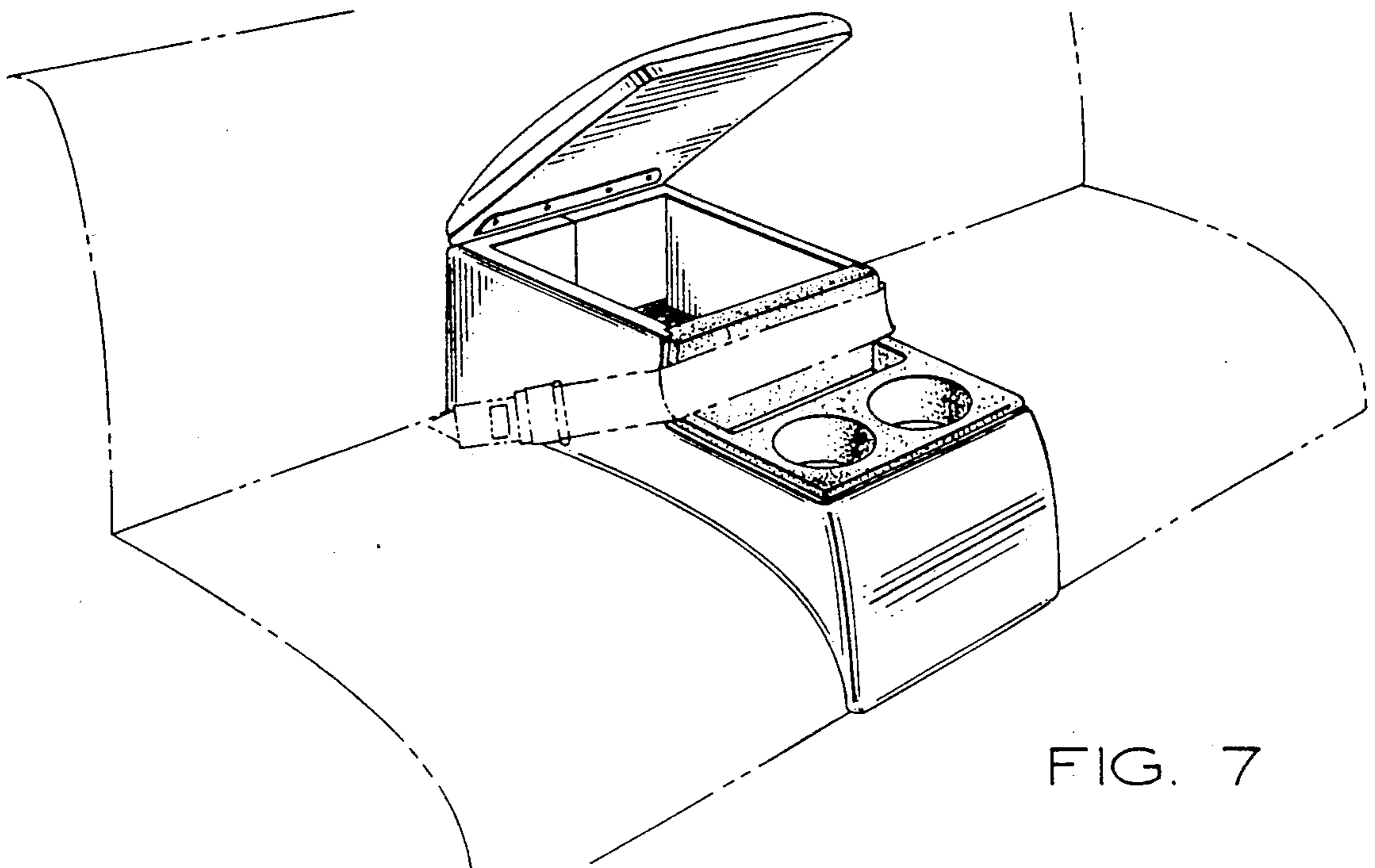
