FIG. 7 is a right, front and top perspective view thereof.

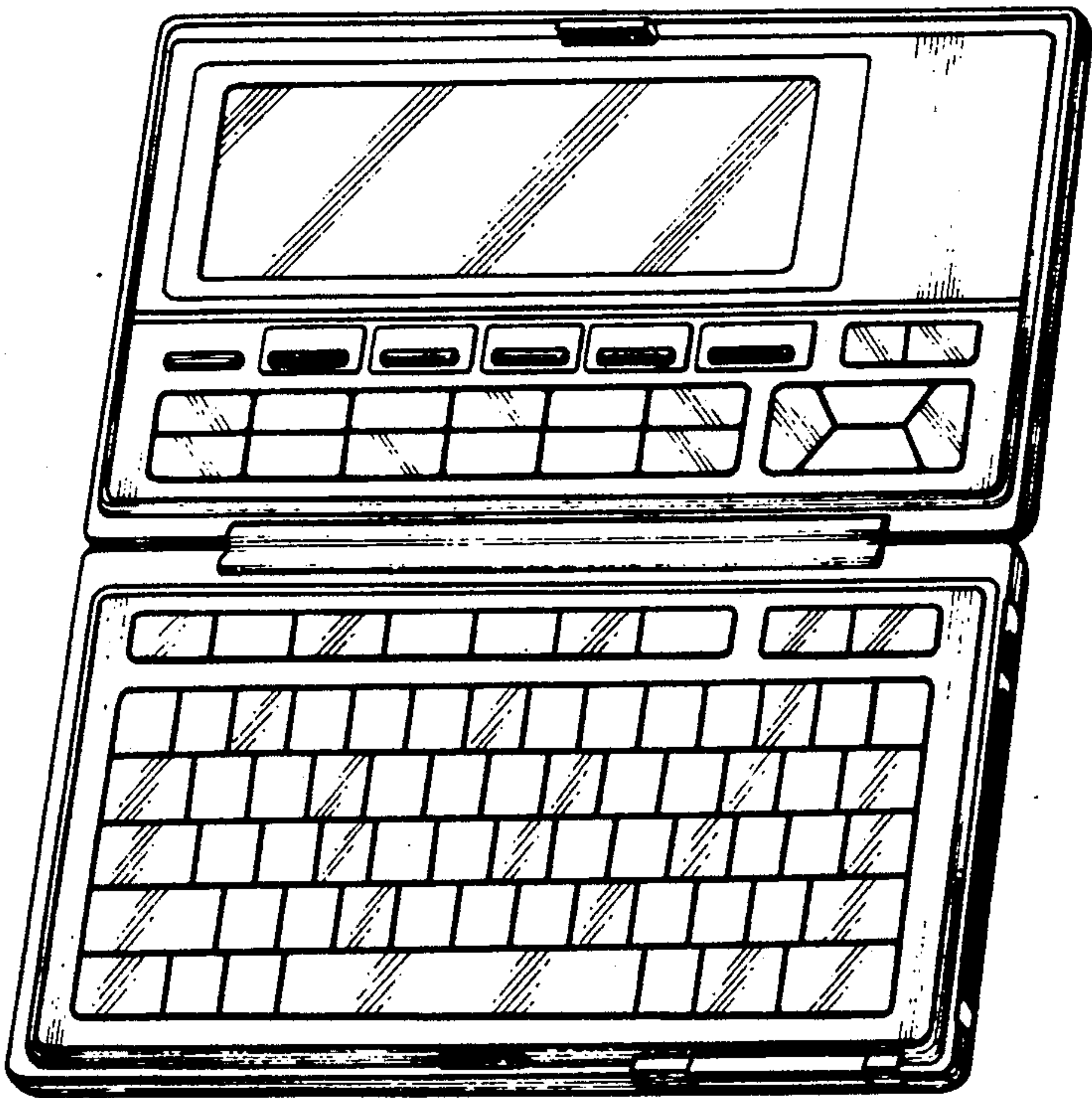

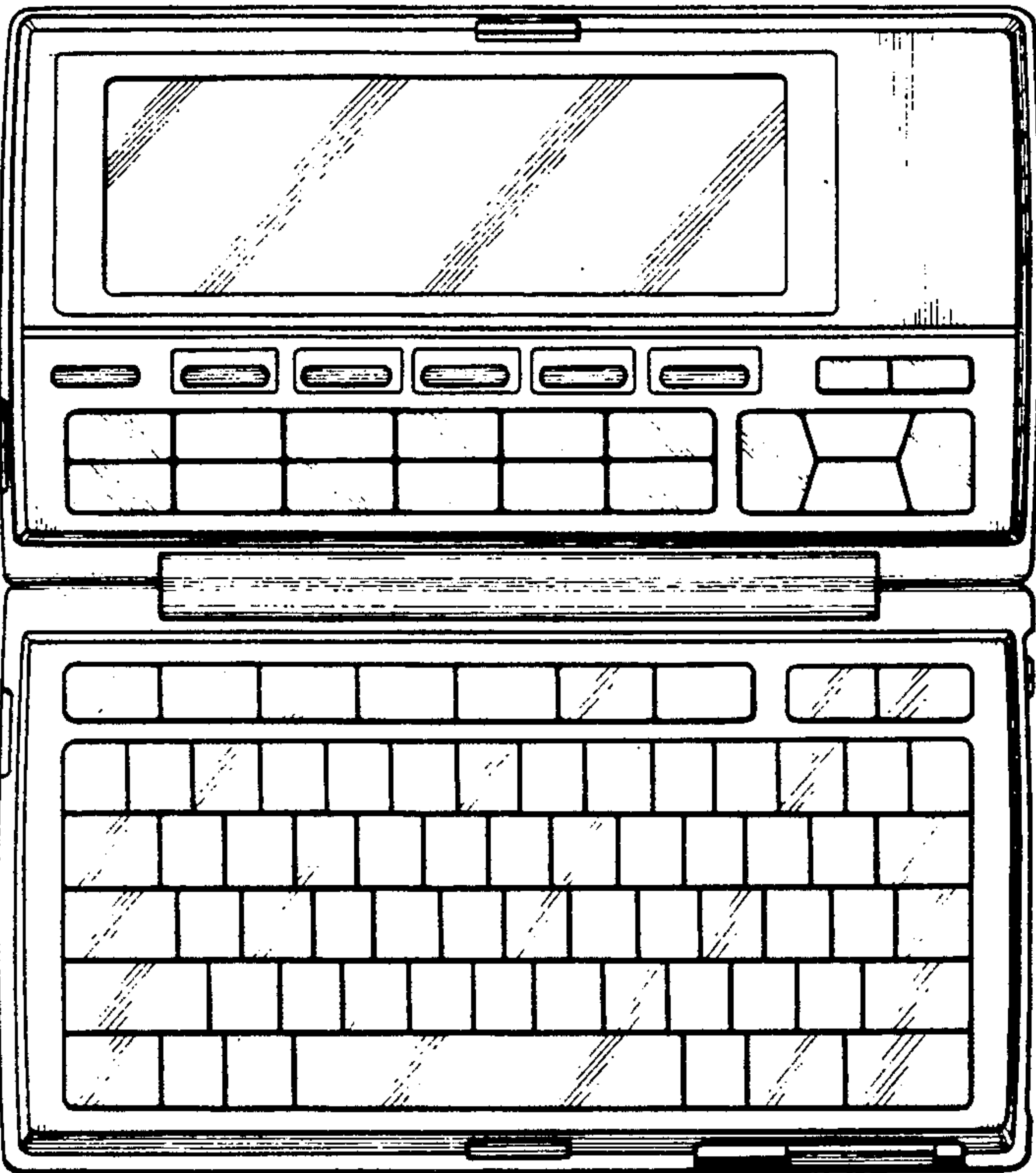

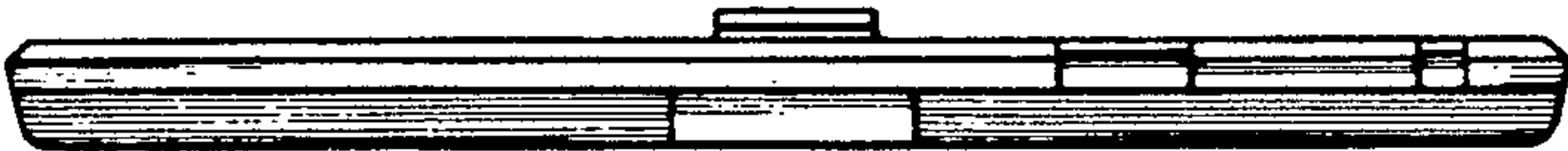

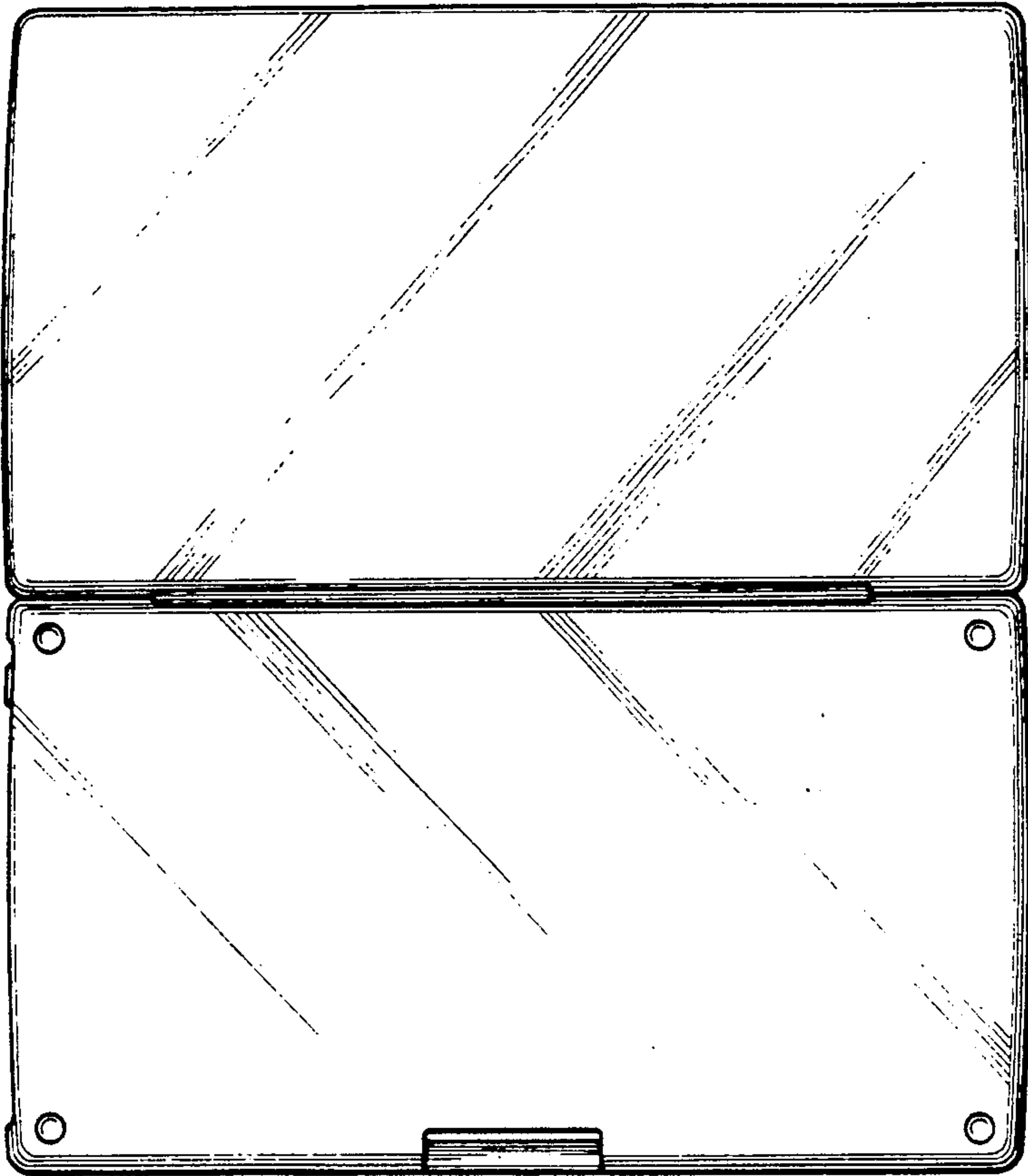
