The ornamental design for a cup shaped sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a cup shaped sole showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one side of the cup shaped sole shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the other side of the cup shaped sole shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken along section 4—4 in FIG. 3;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the cup shaped sole shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the cup shaped sole shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of one side of a cup shaped sole showing a second embodiment of my new design, the bottom being the same as FIG. 1;  
FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of the other side of the cup shaped sole shown in FIG. 7;  
FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view taken along section 9—9 in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view taken along section 10—10 in FIG. 1.  
The broken line showing of a shoe upper are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

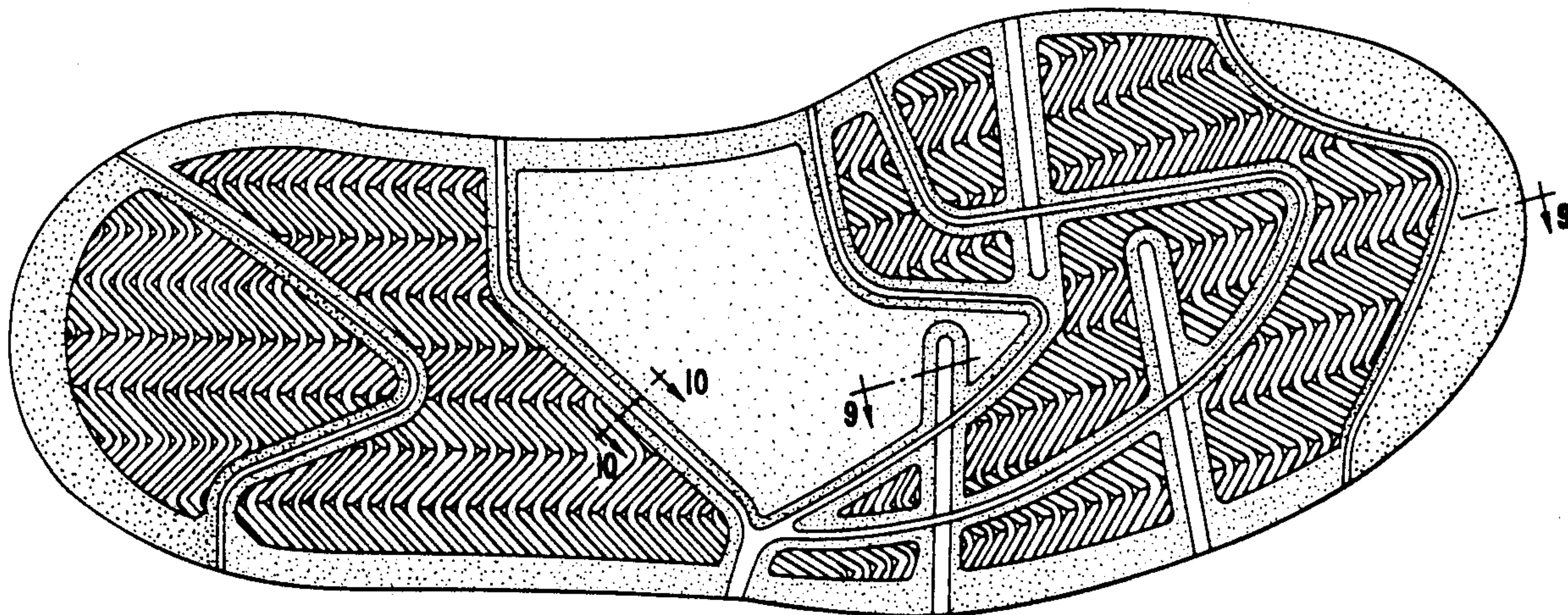

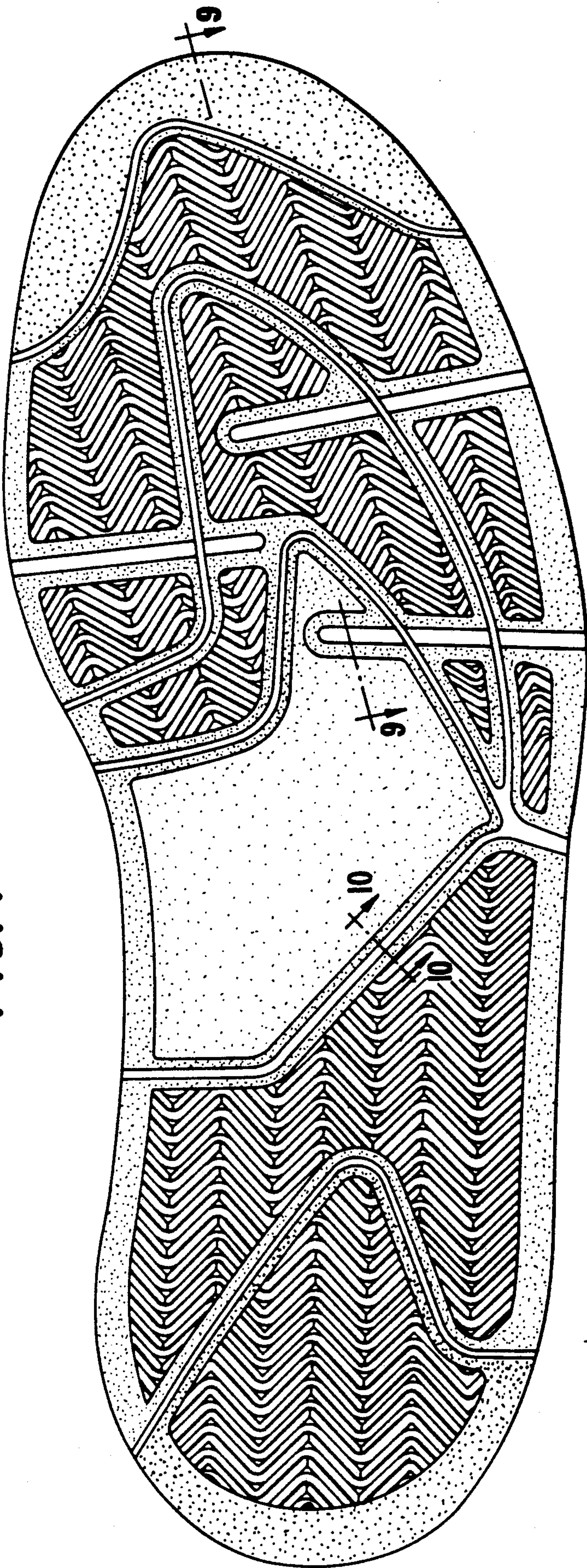
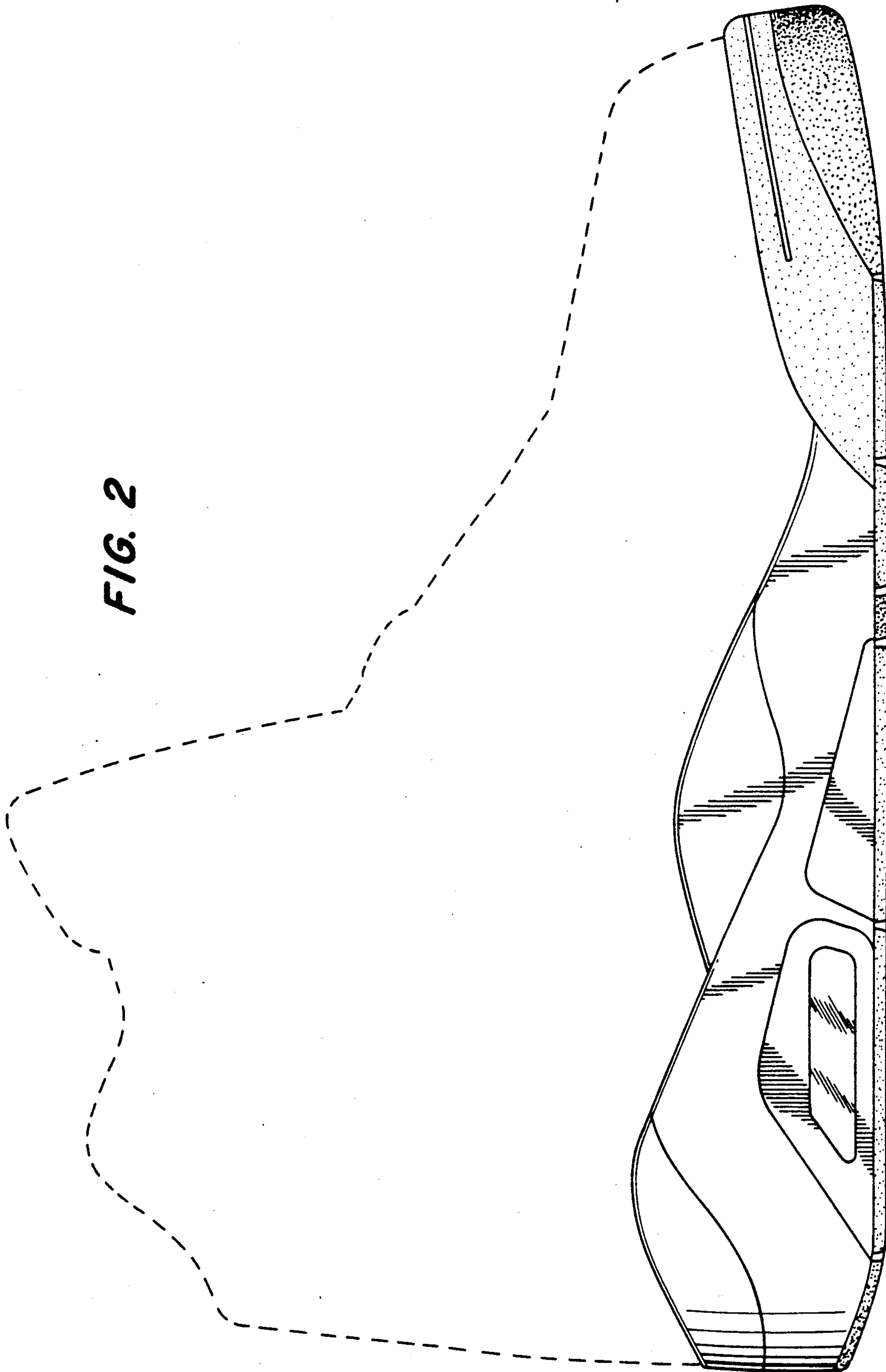

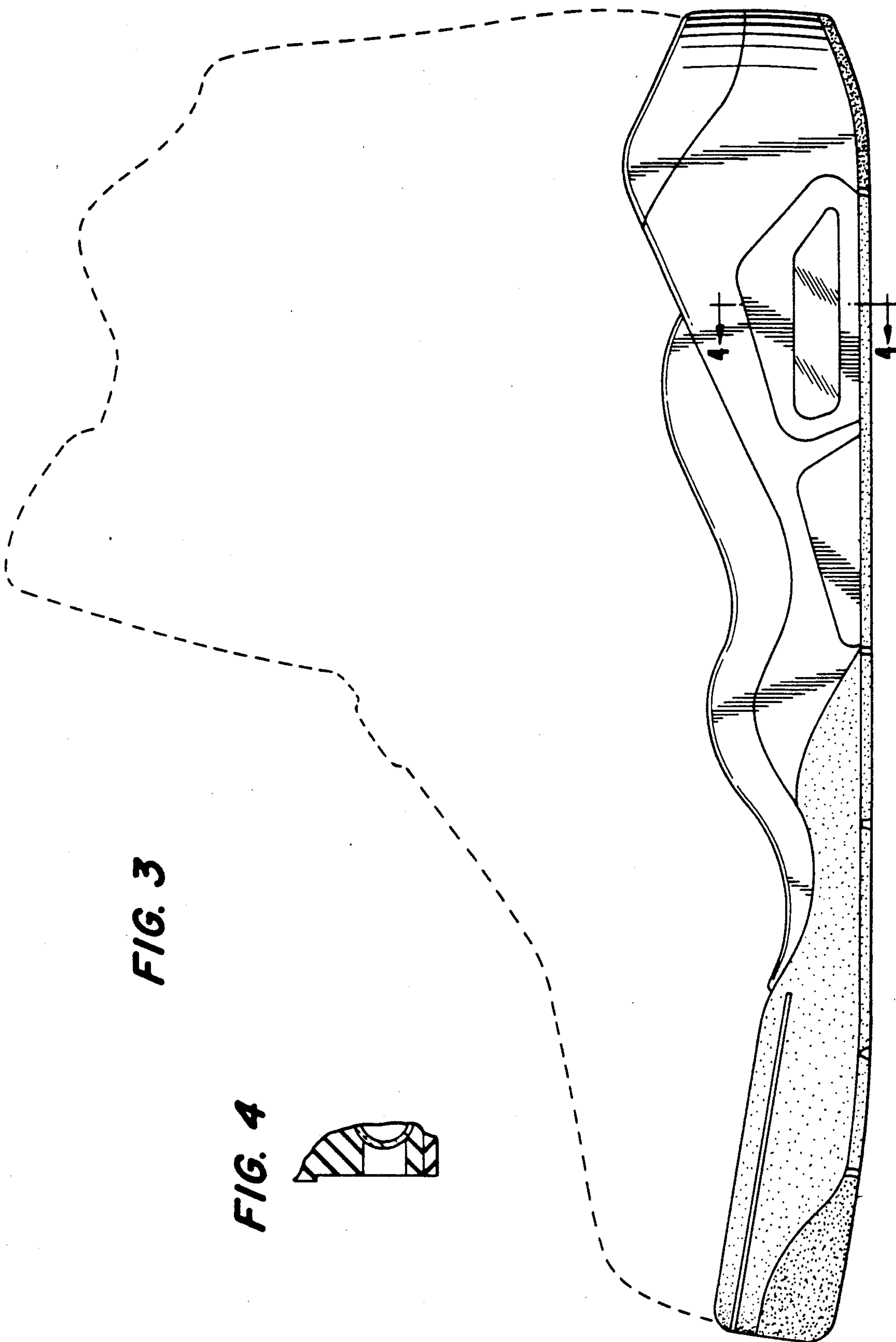

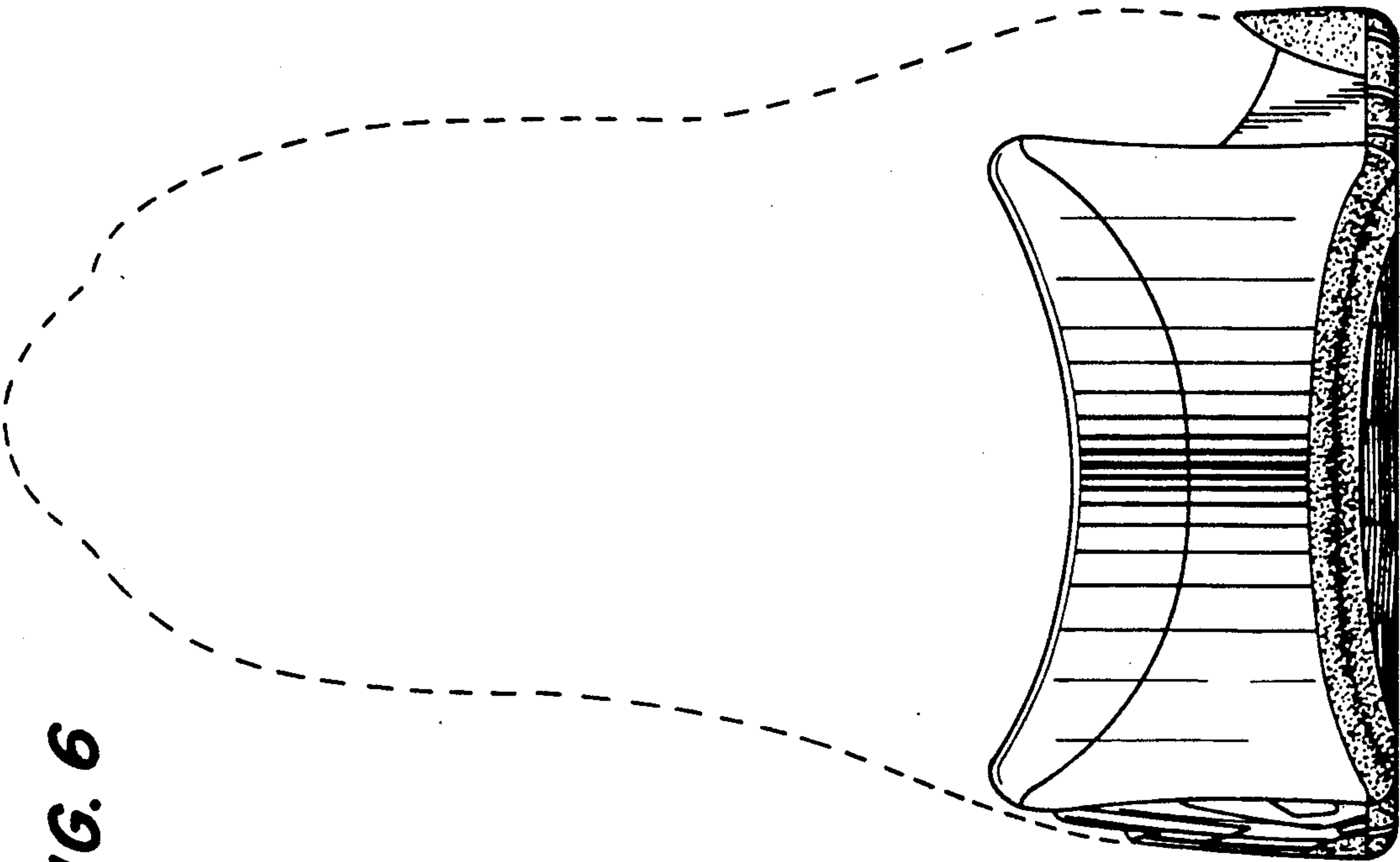

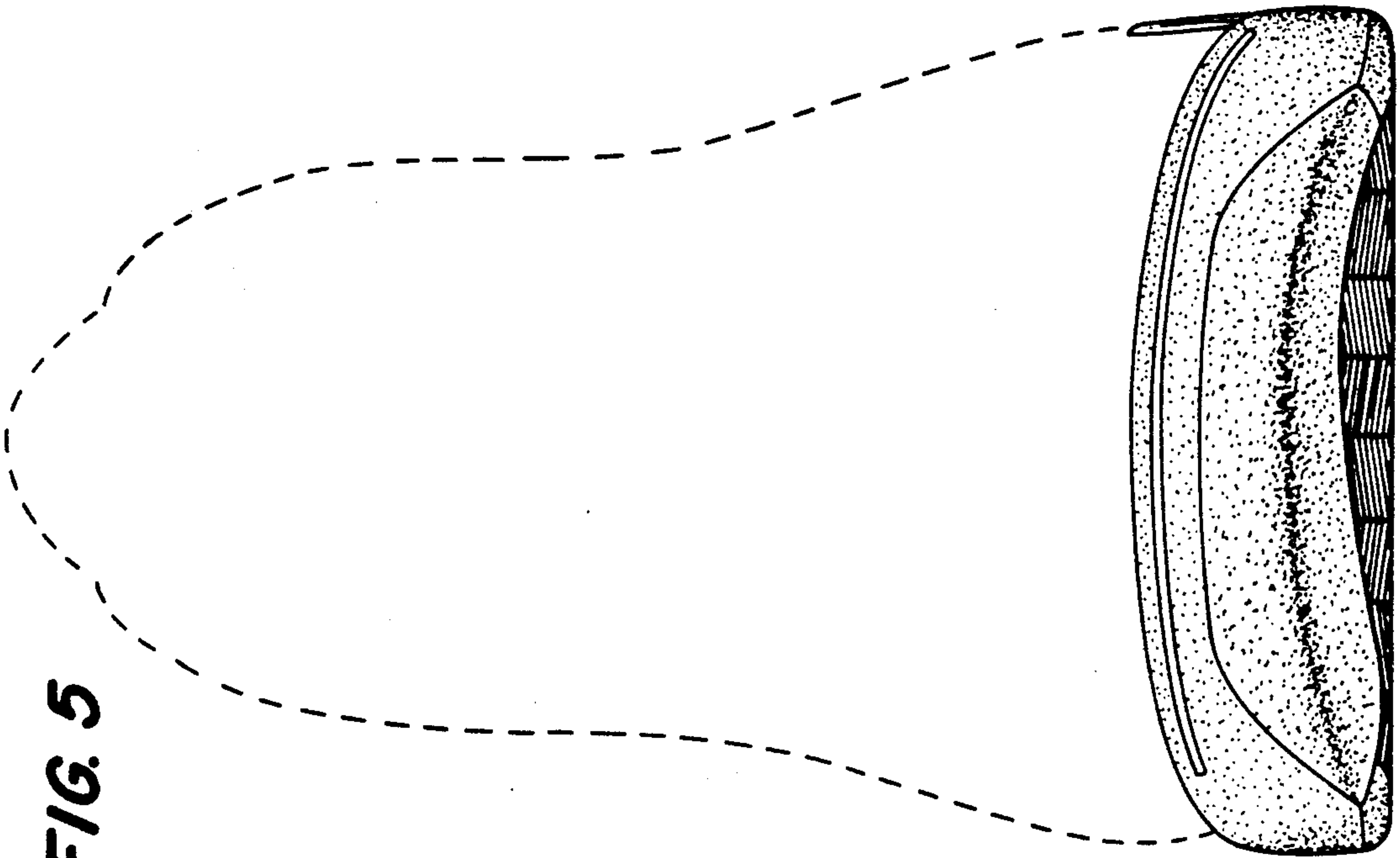
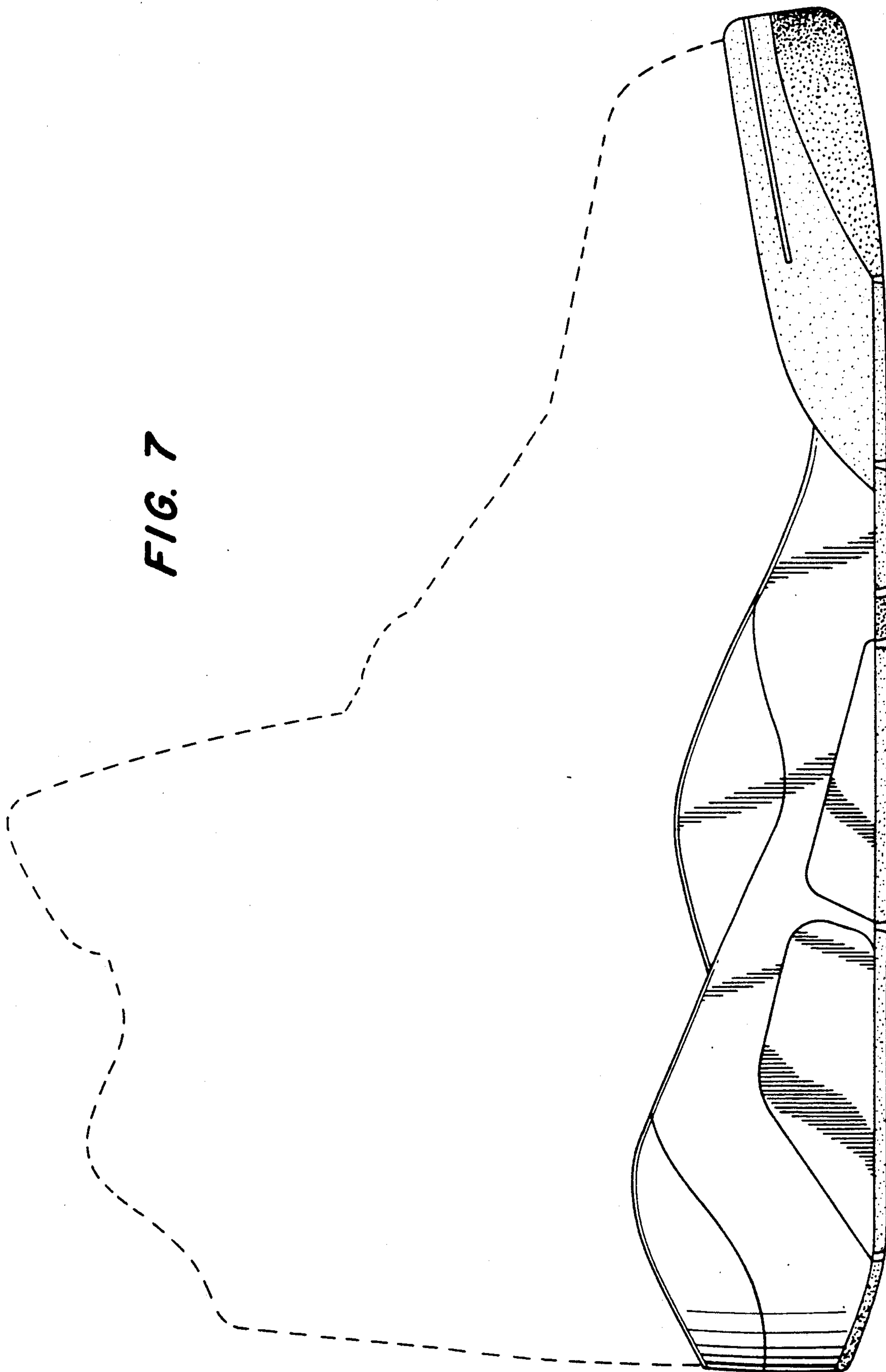


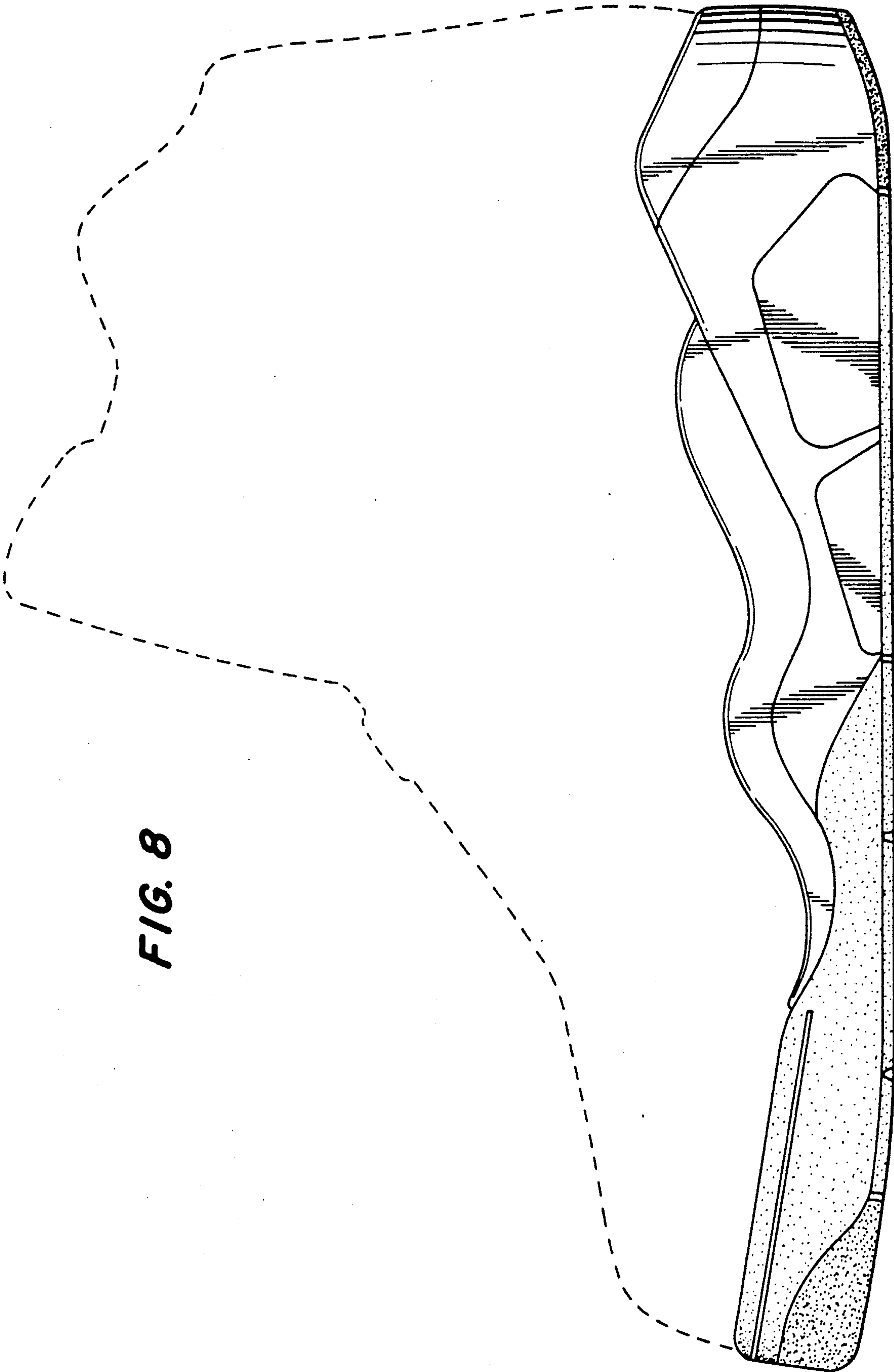
