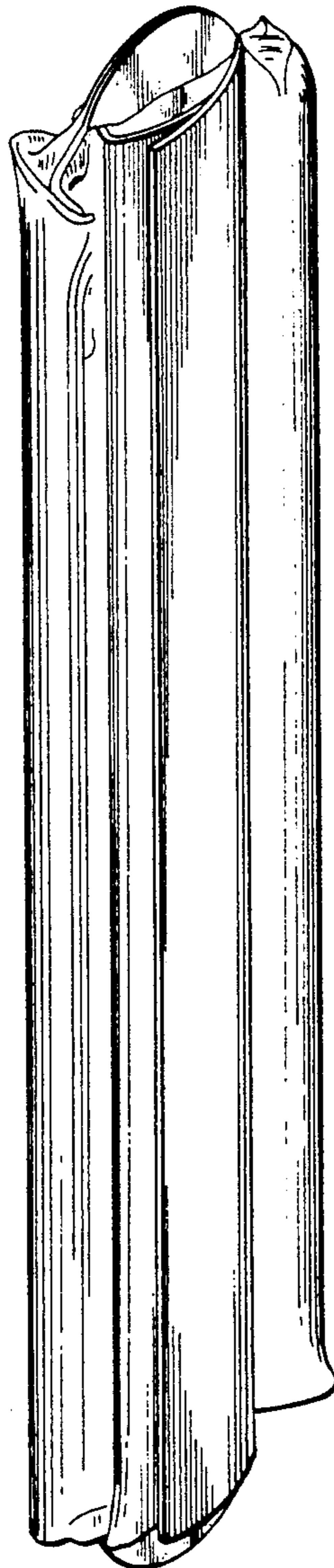
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 5 is a top plan view.



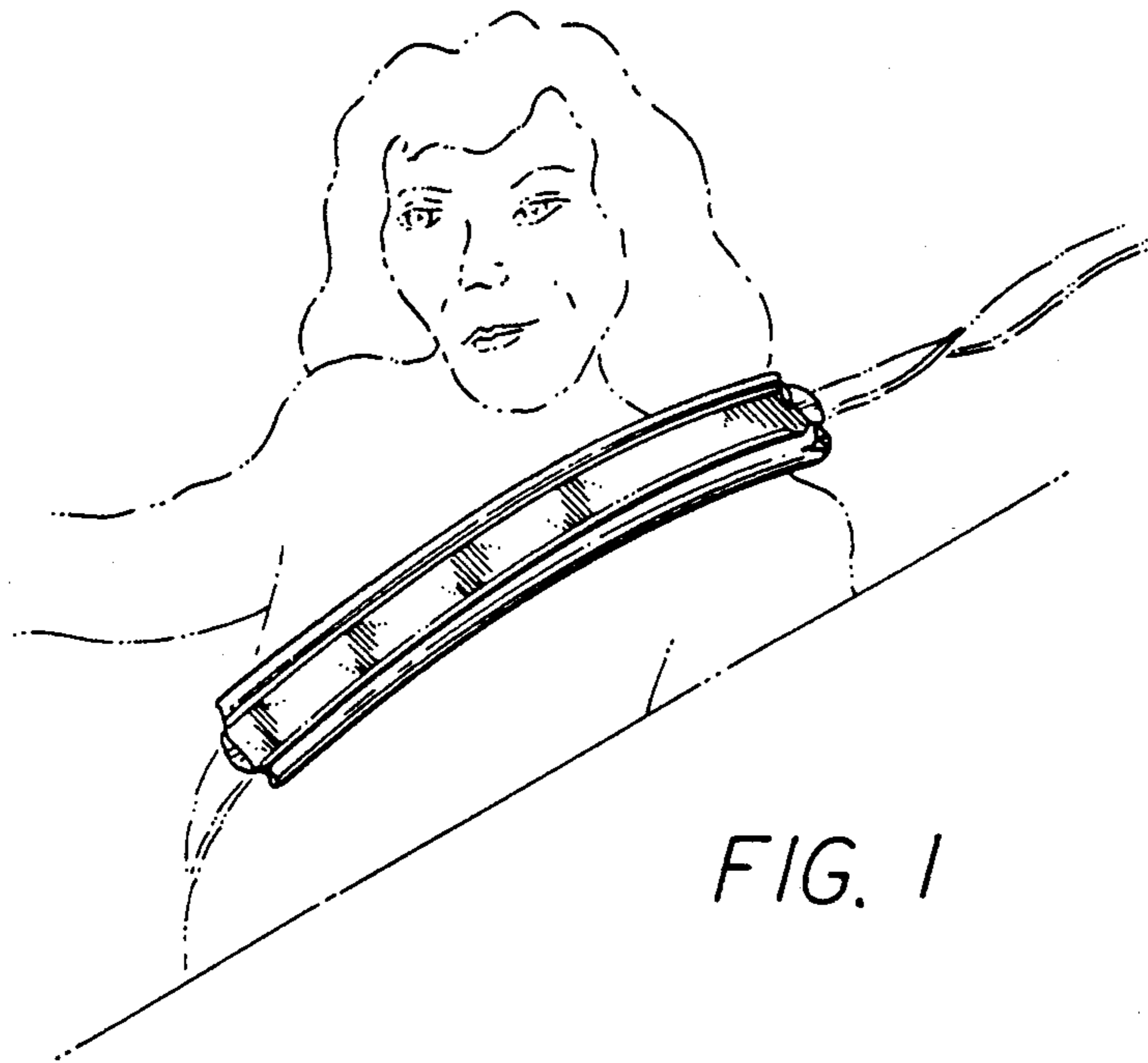

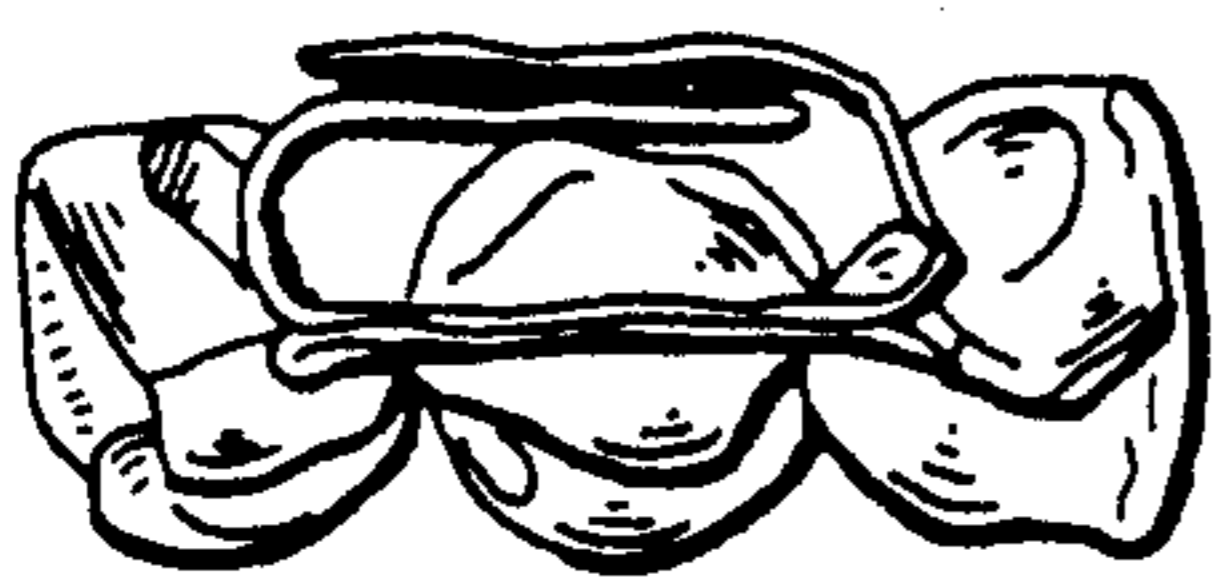

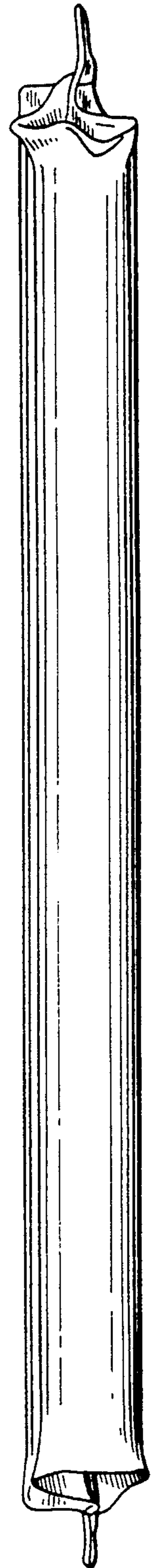

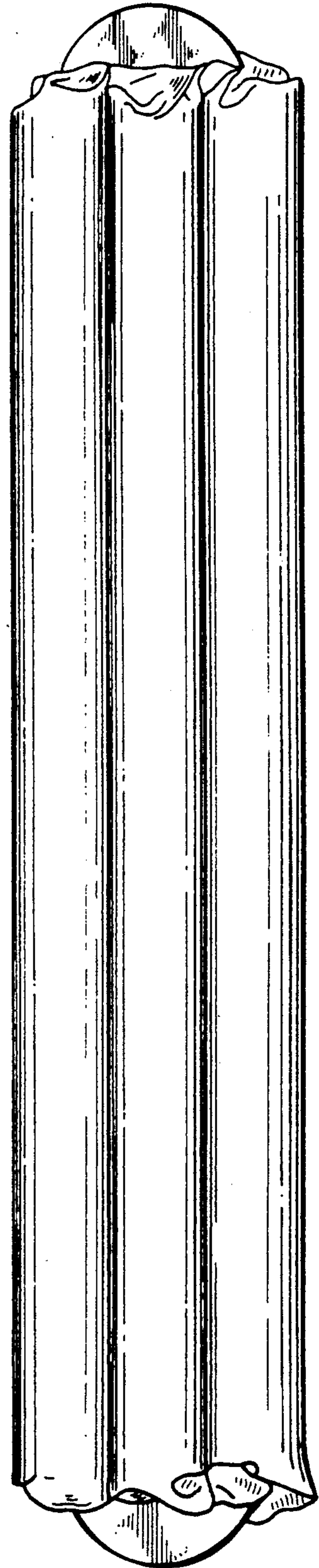
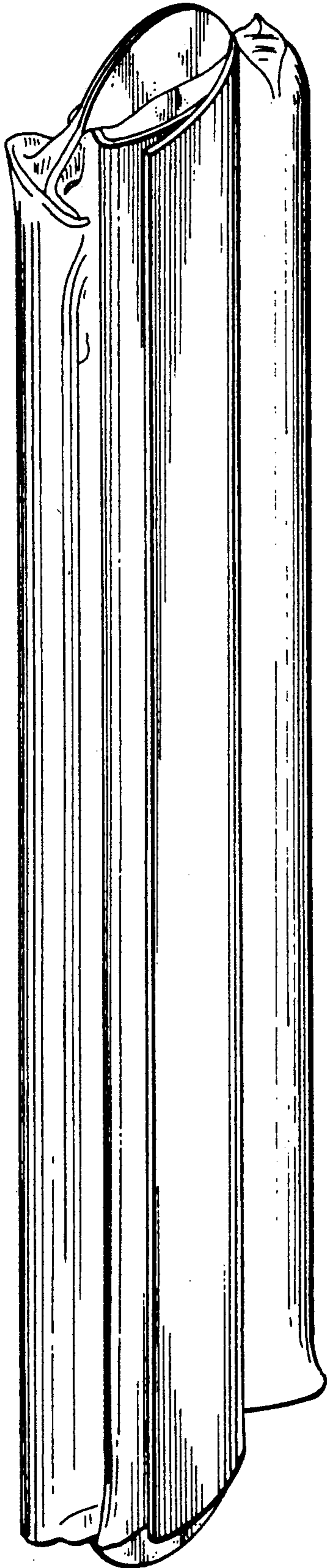
