 FIG. 8 is a top, rear, left side perspective view thereof.

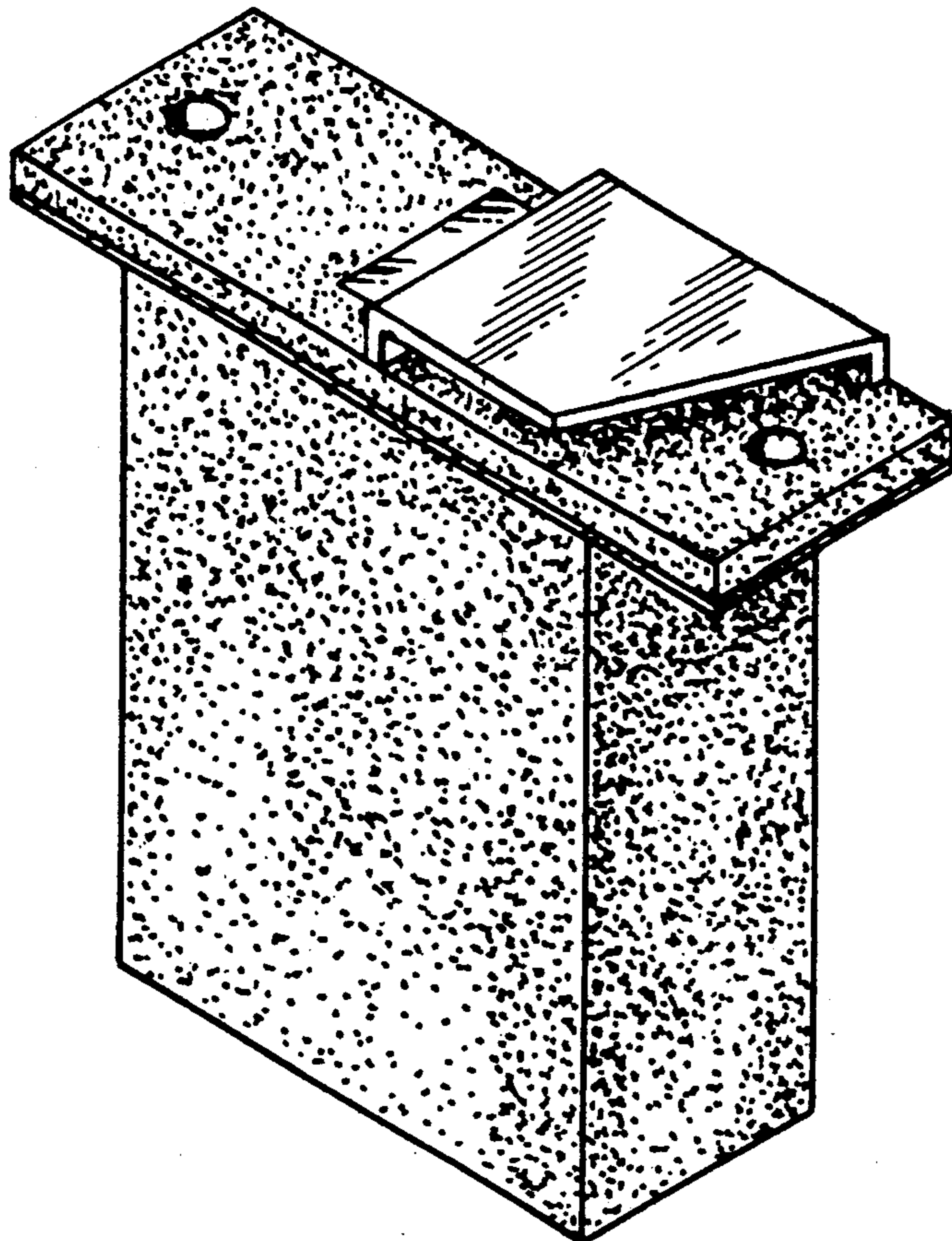

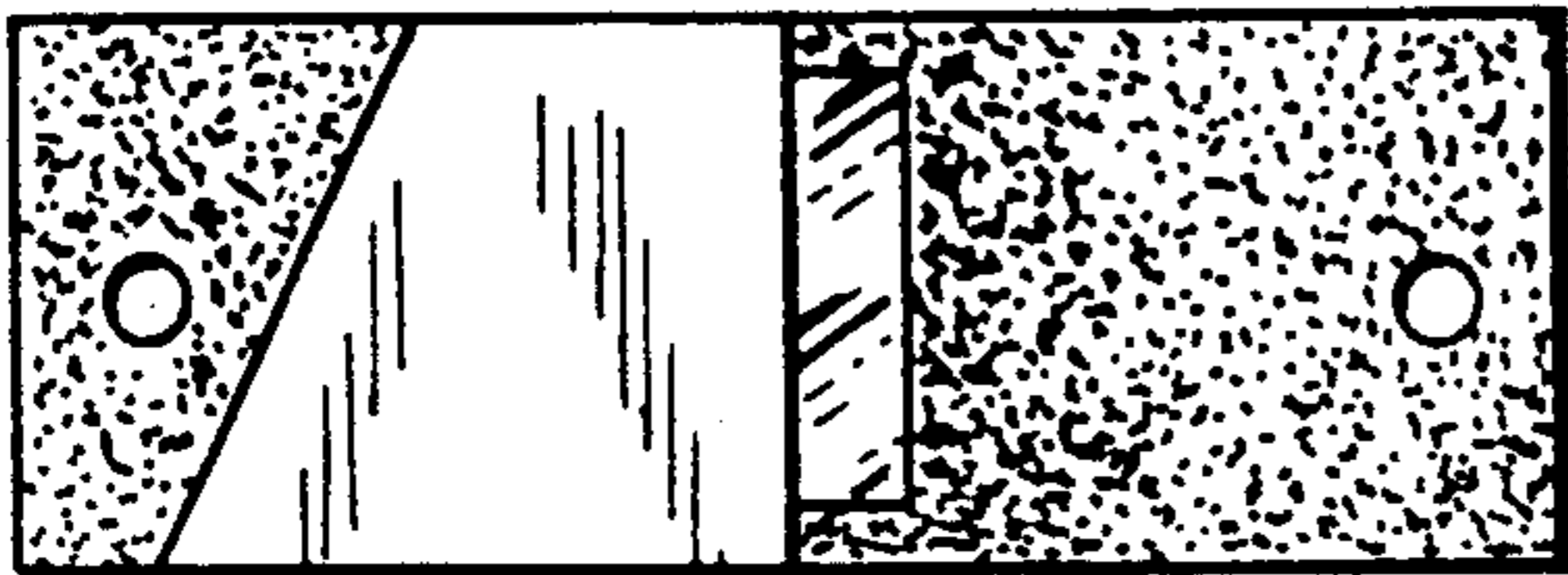

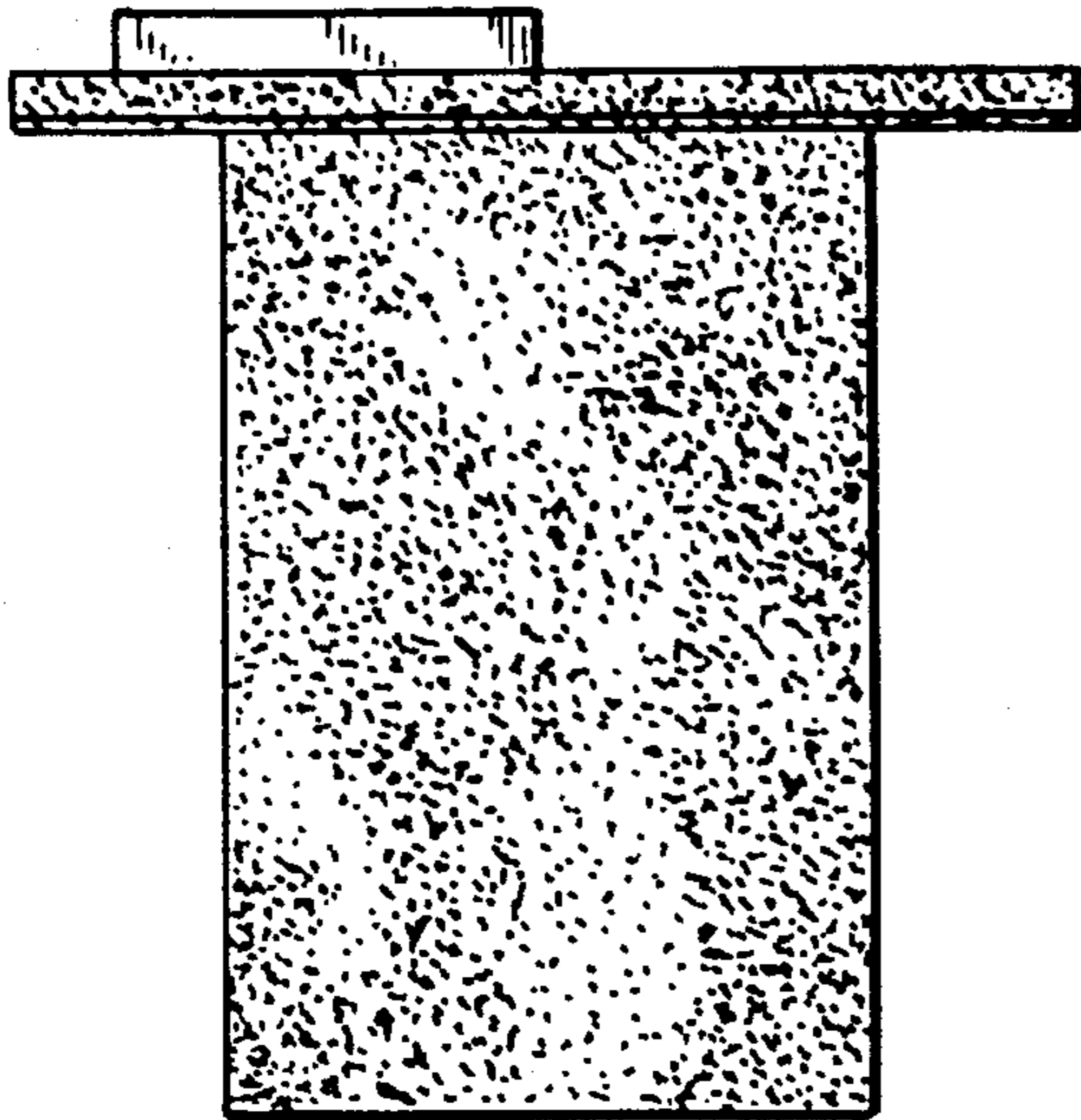
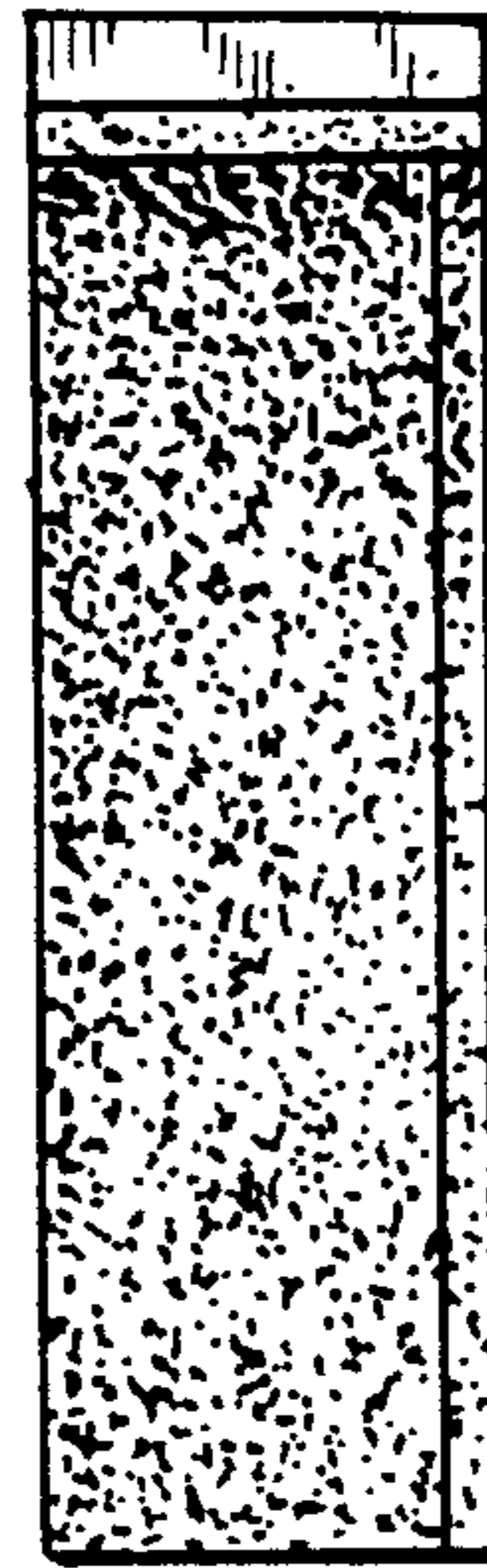

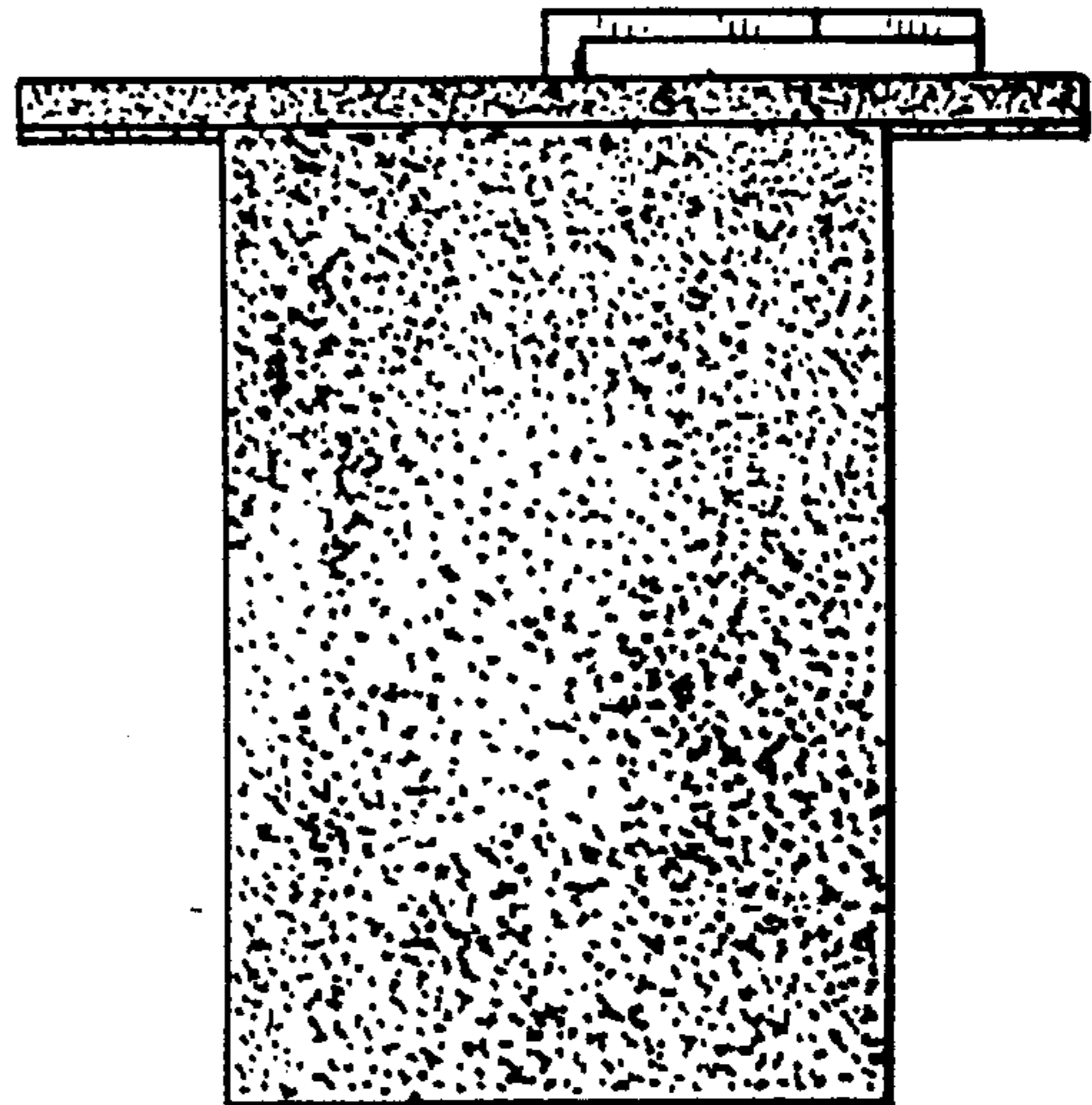

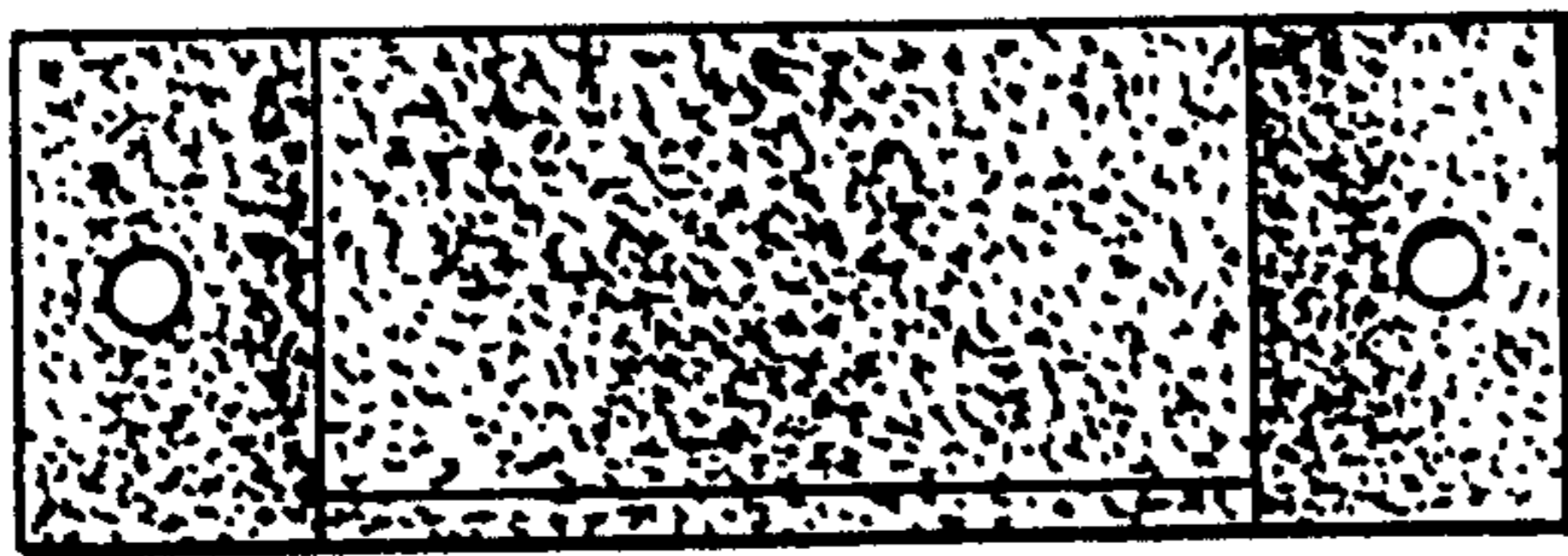

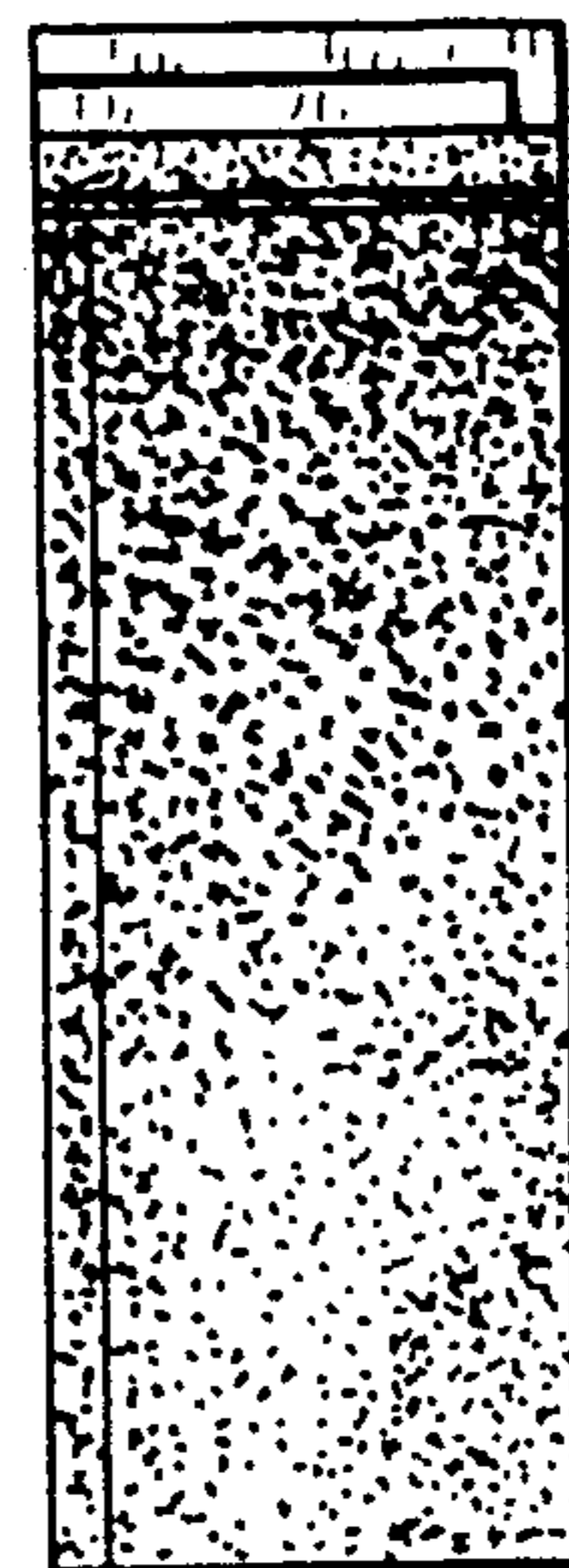

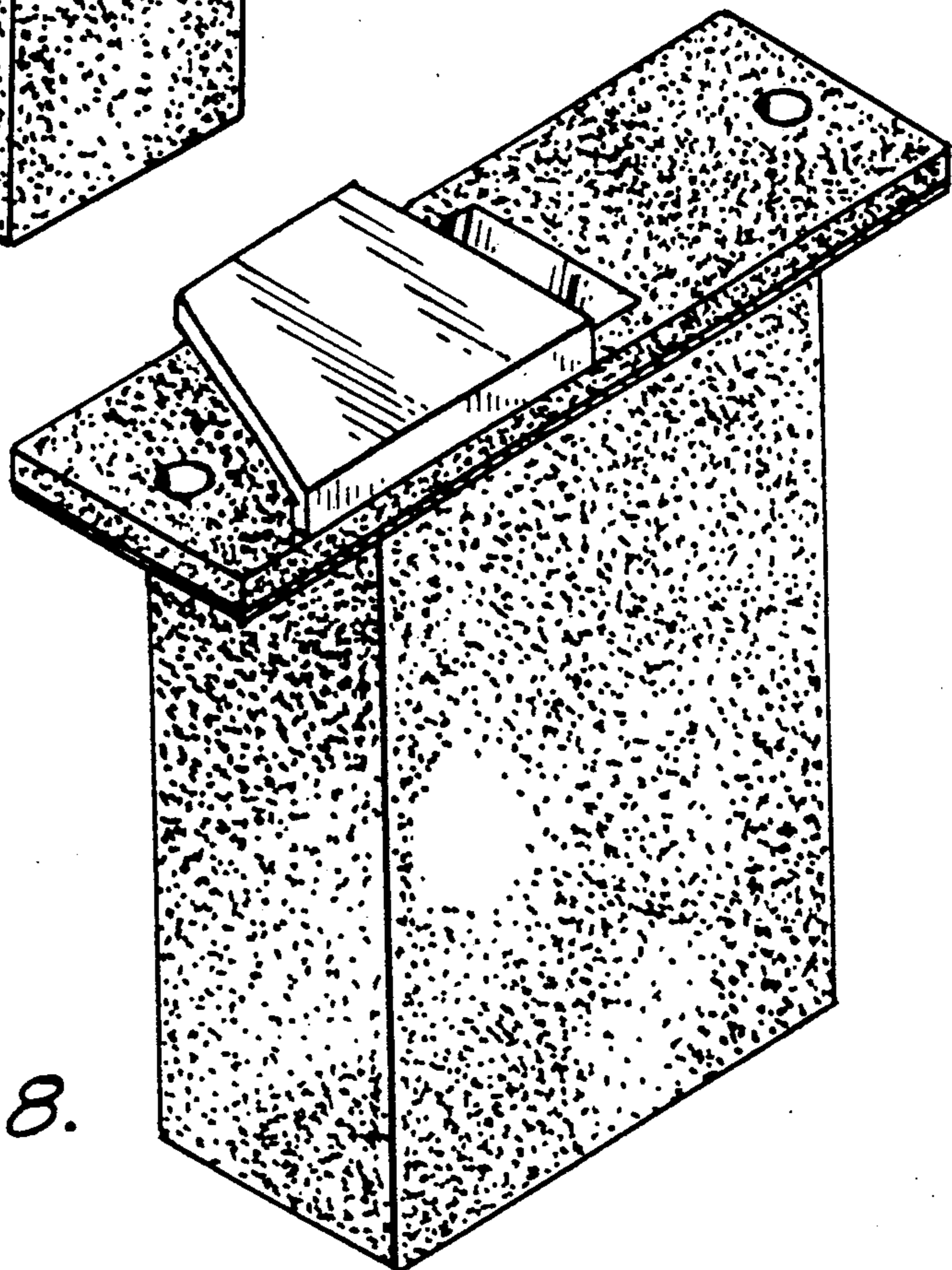
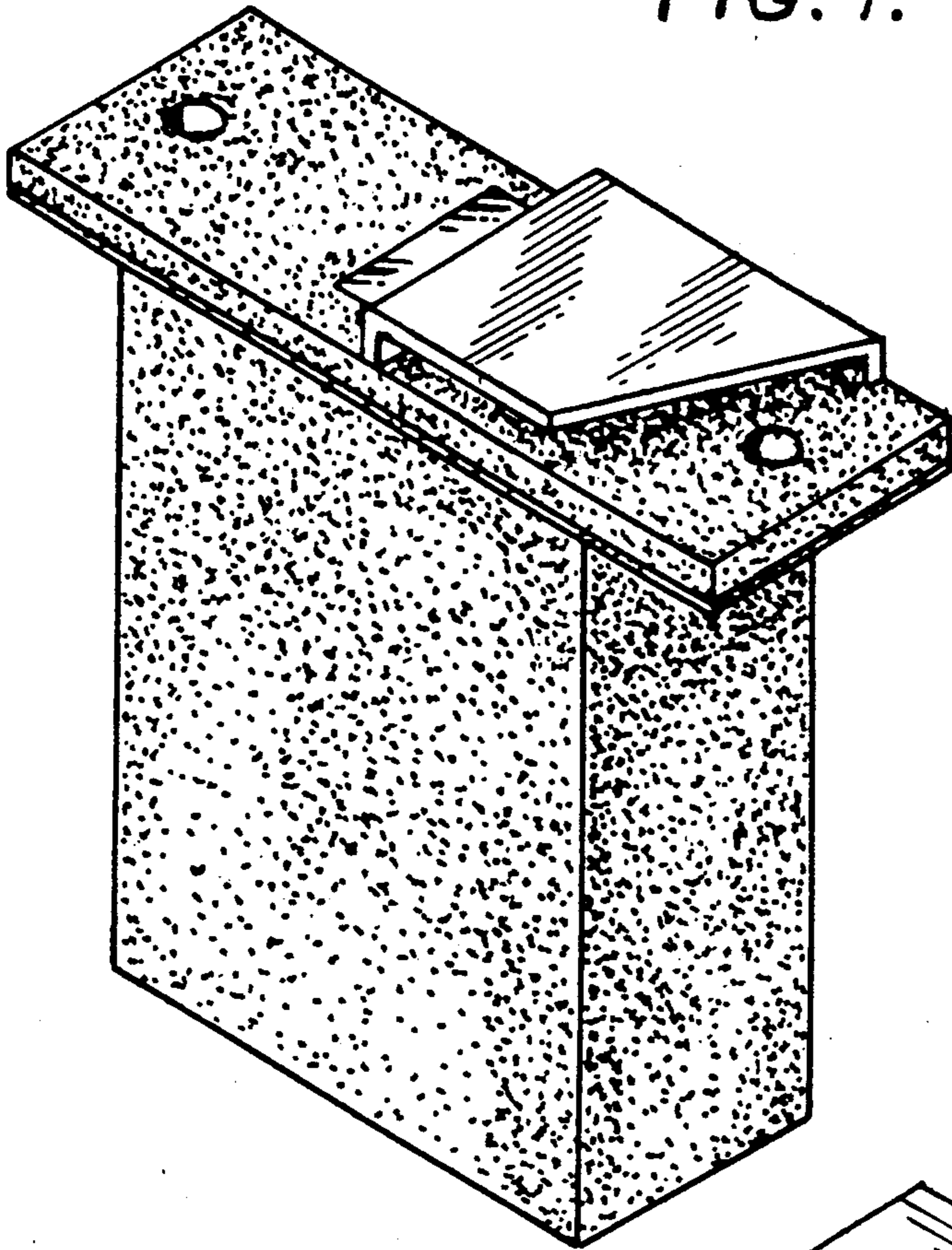
