DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a beverage infusion device showing our new design;

 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed opposite side being the same.

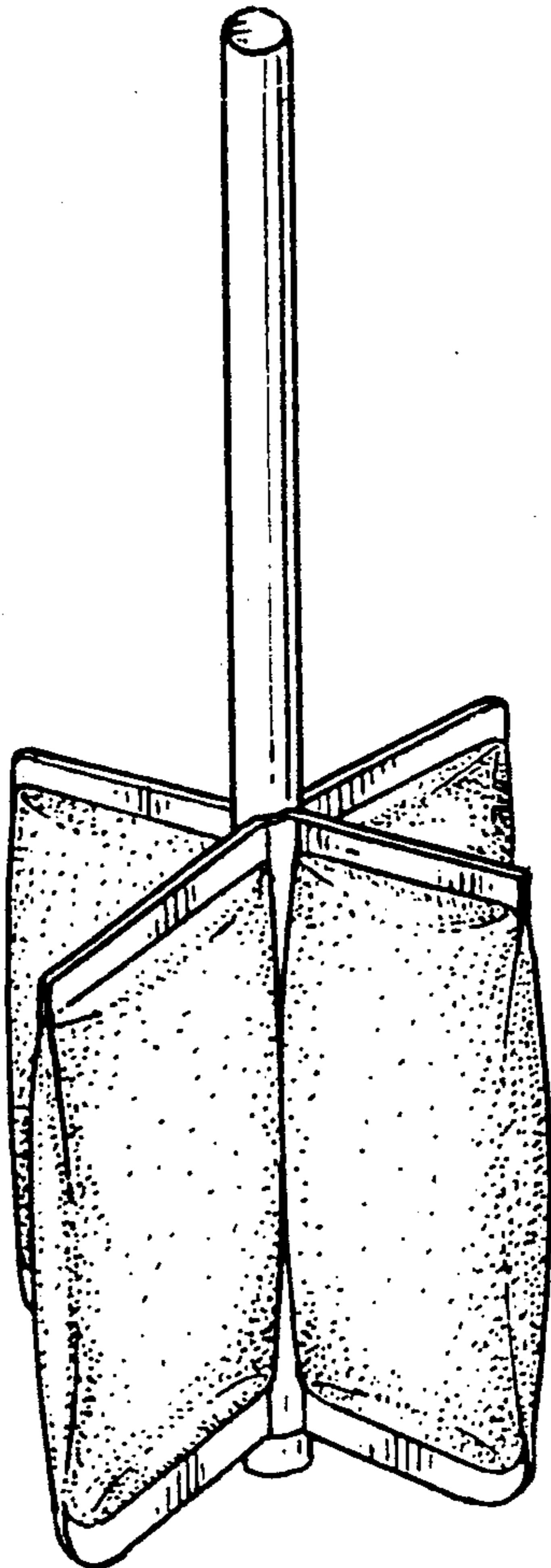

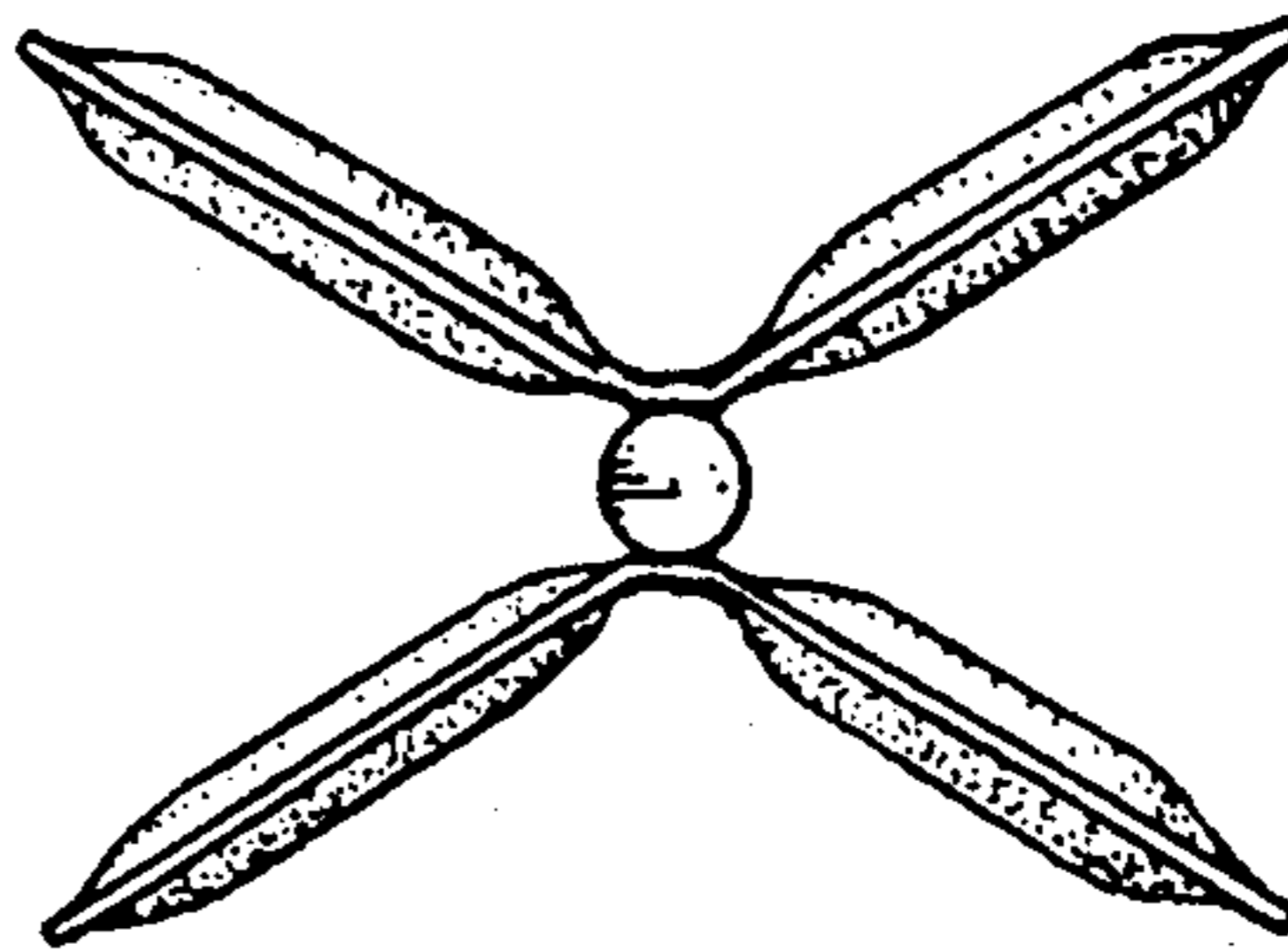
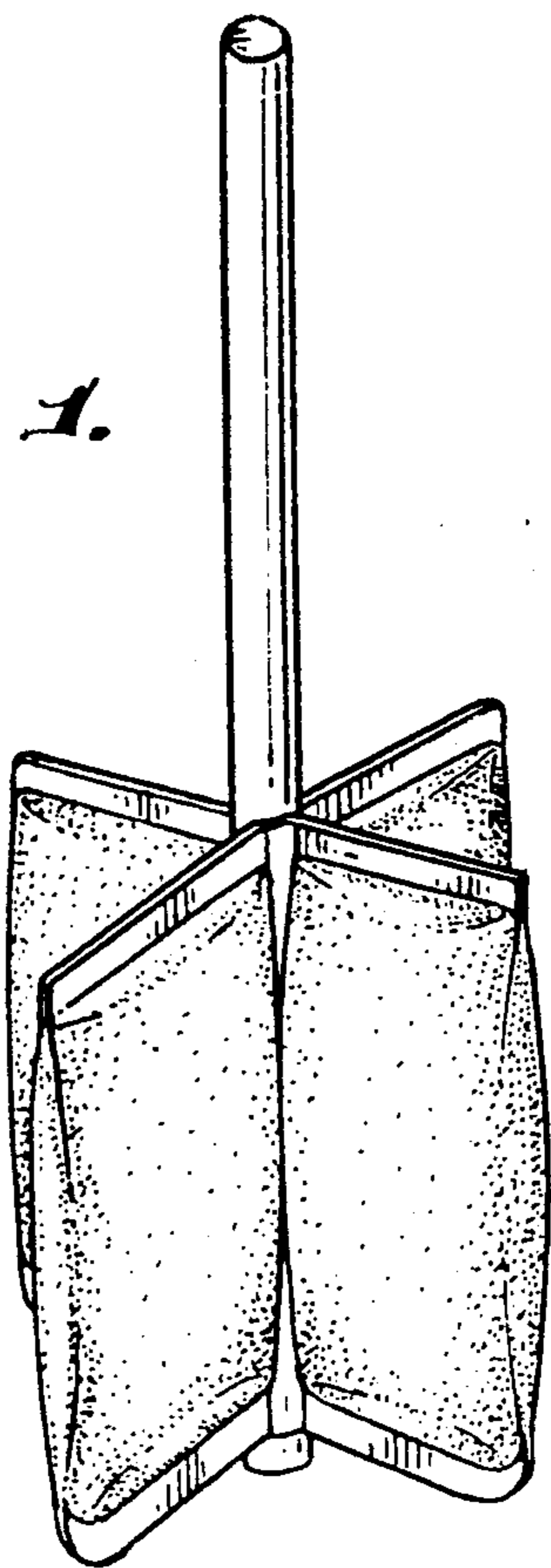

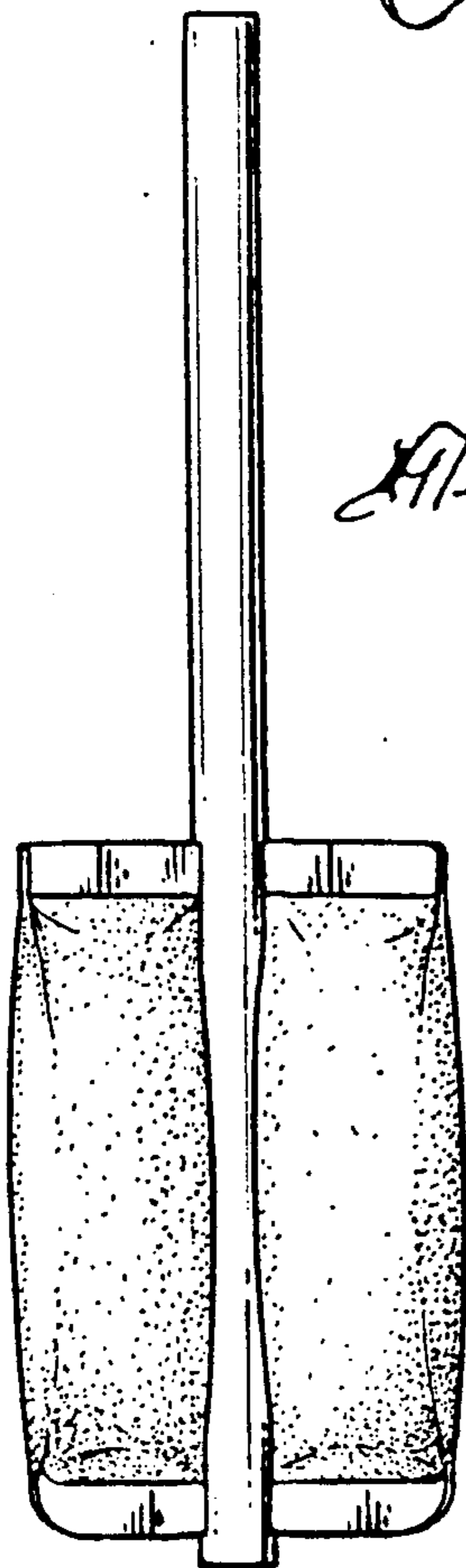
