The ornamental design for a vending machine or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and left side perspective view of the vending machine or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken lines showing of the indicia in FIGS. 1 and 6 inclusive is for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

The bottom of the machine of my new design is substantially plain and unadorned.

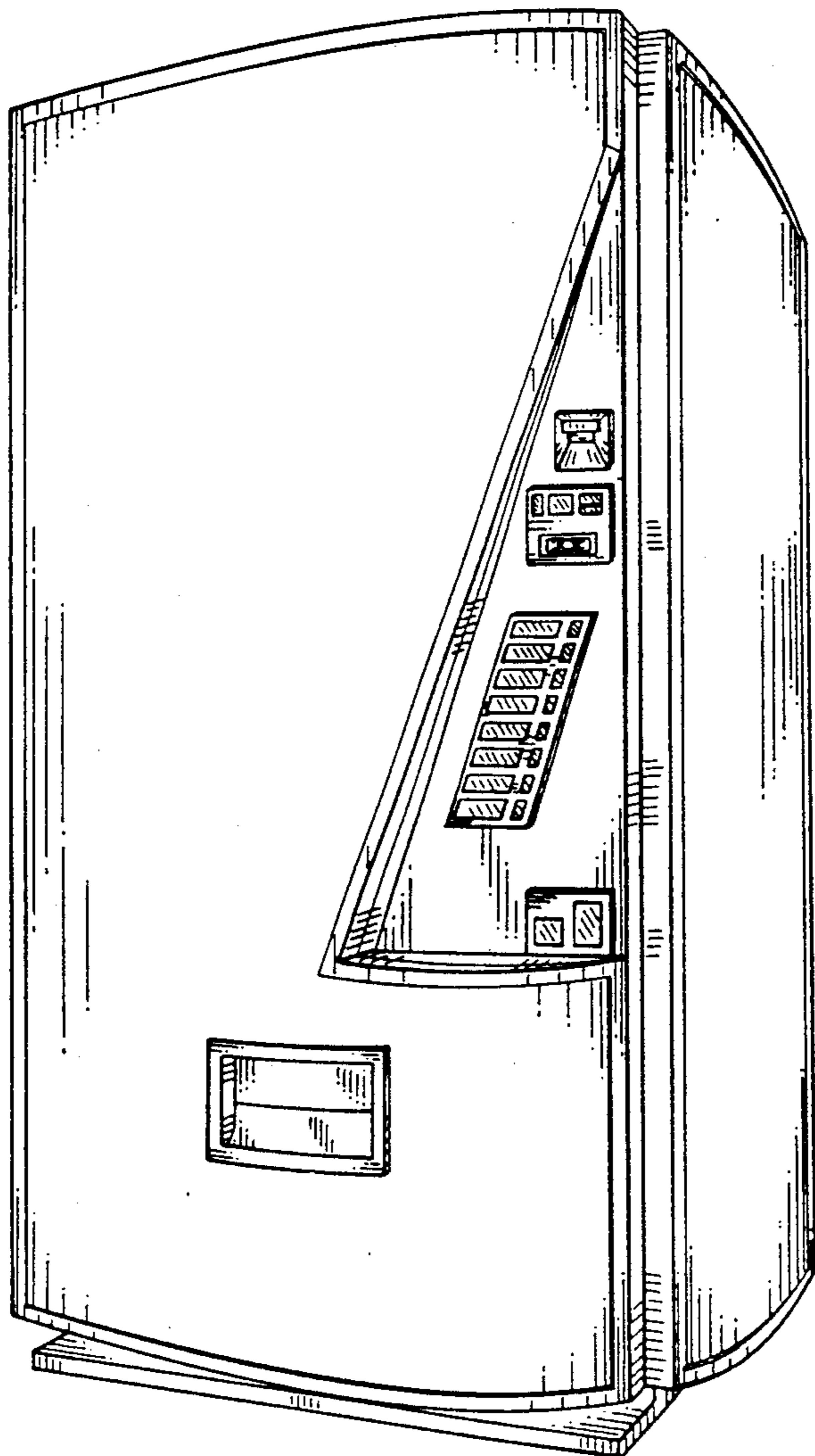

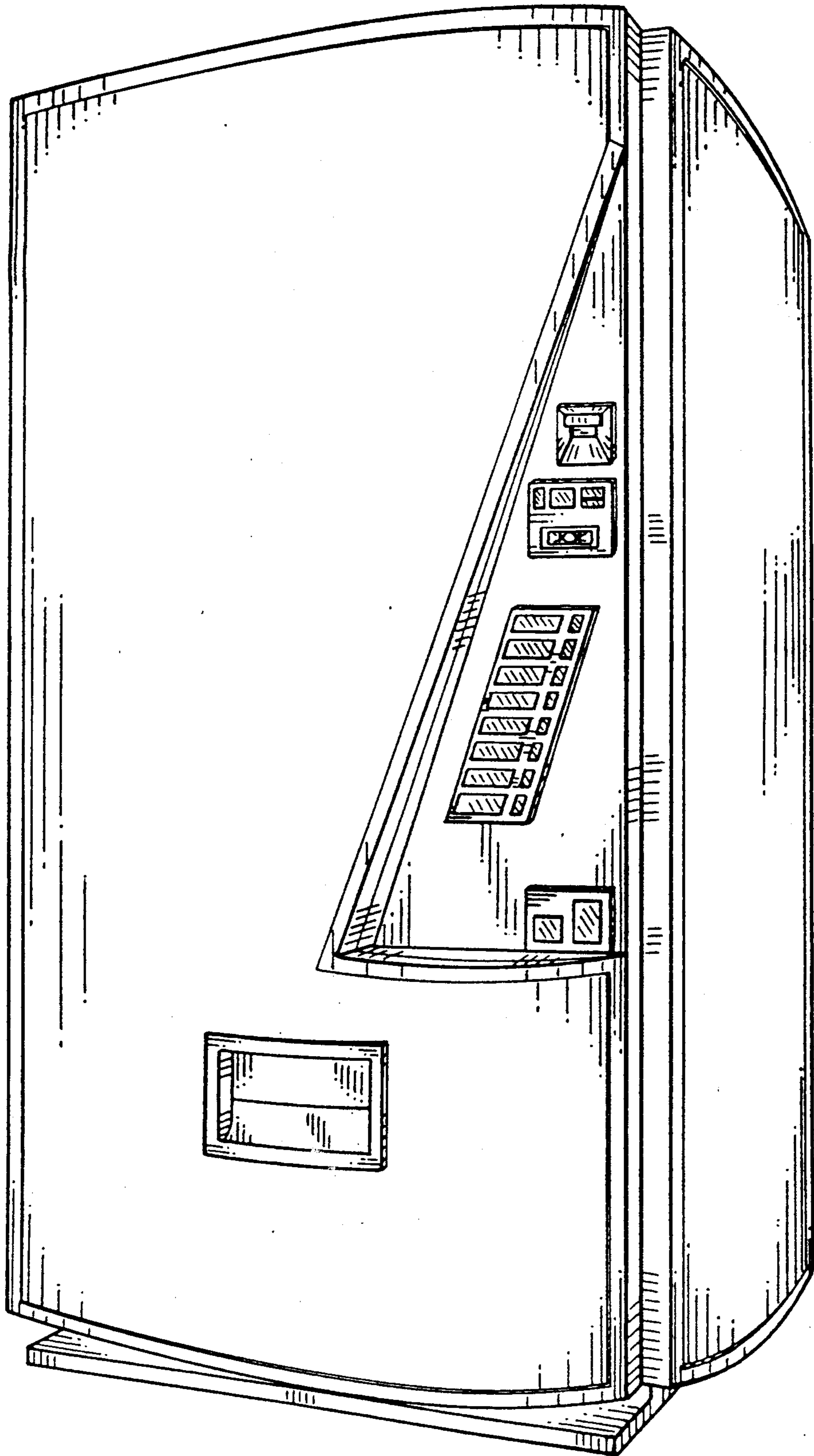

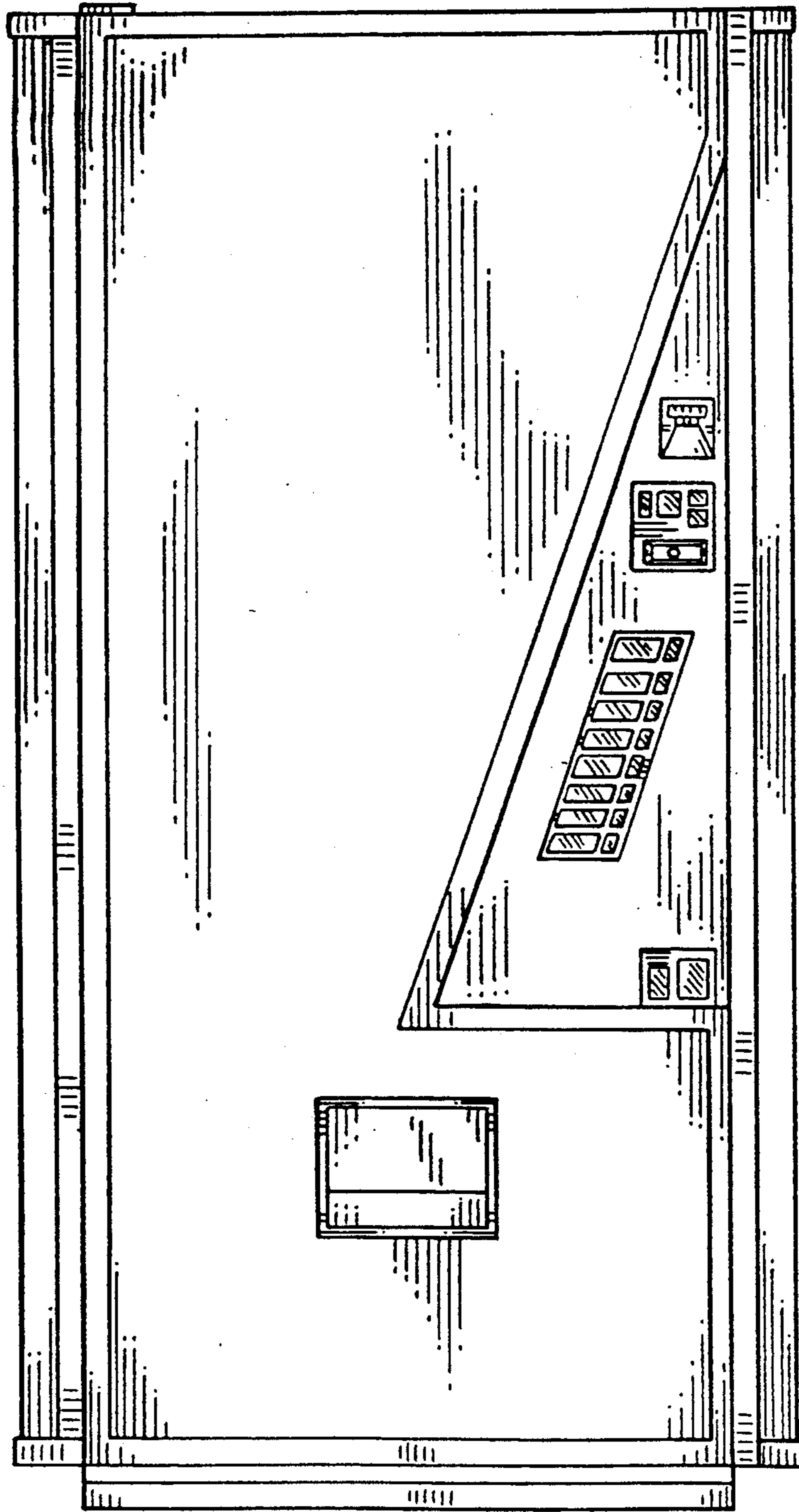

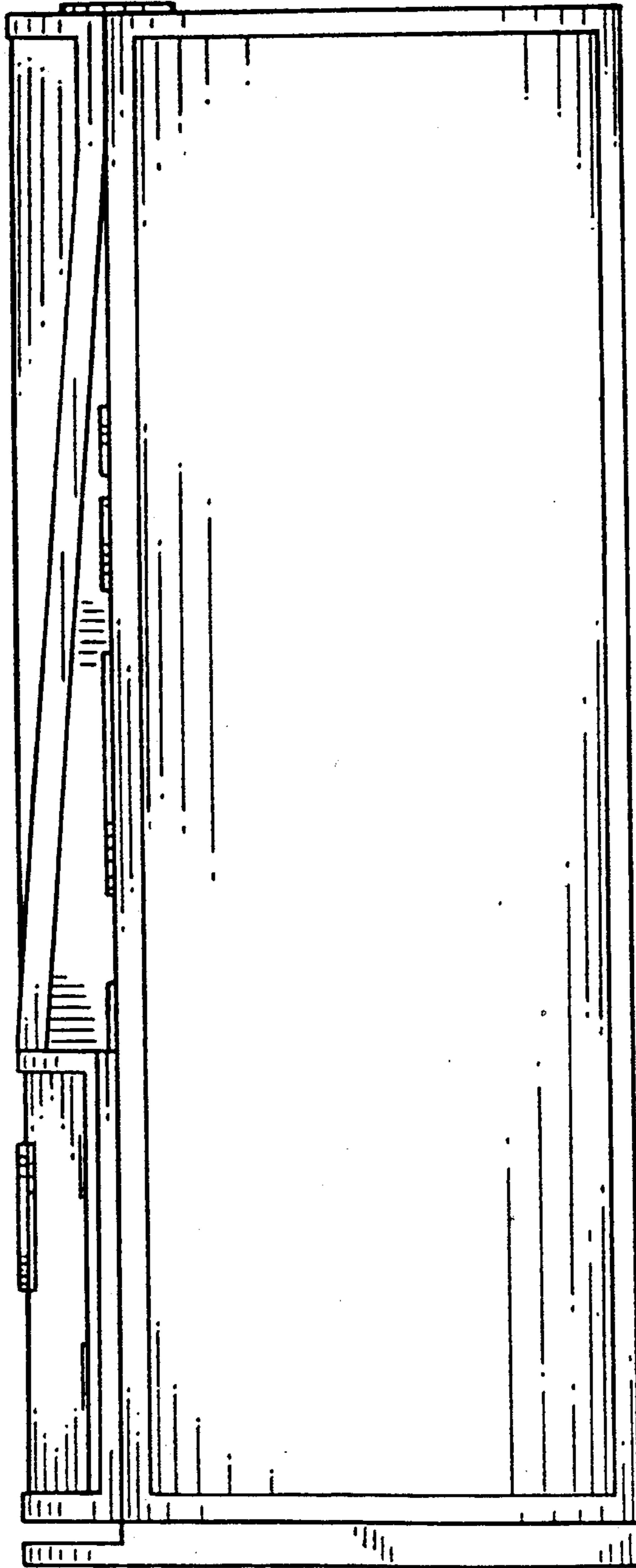

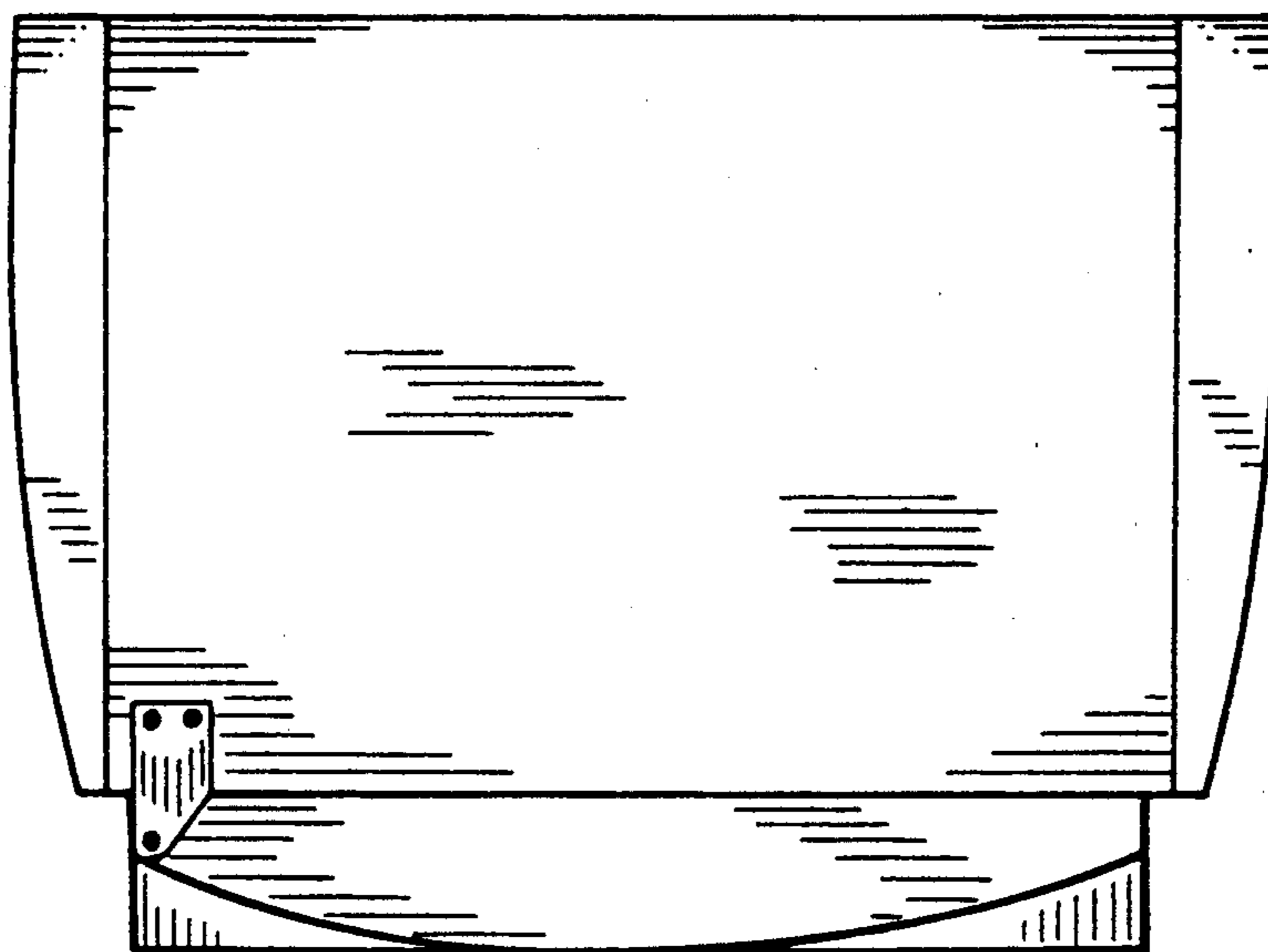

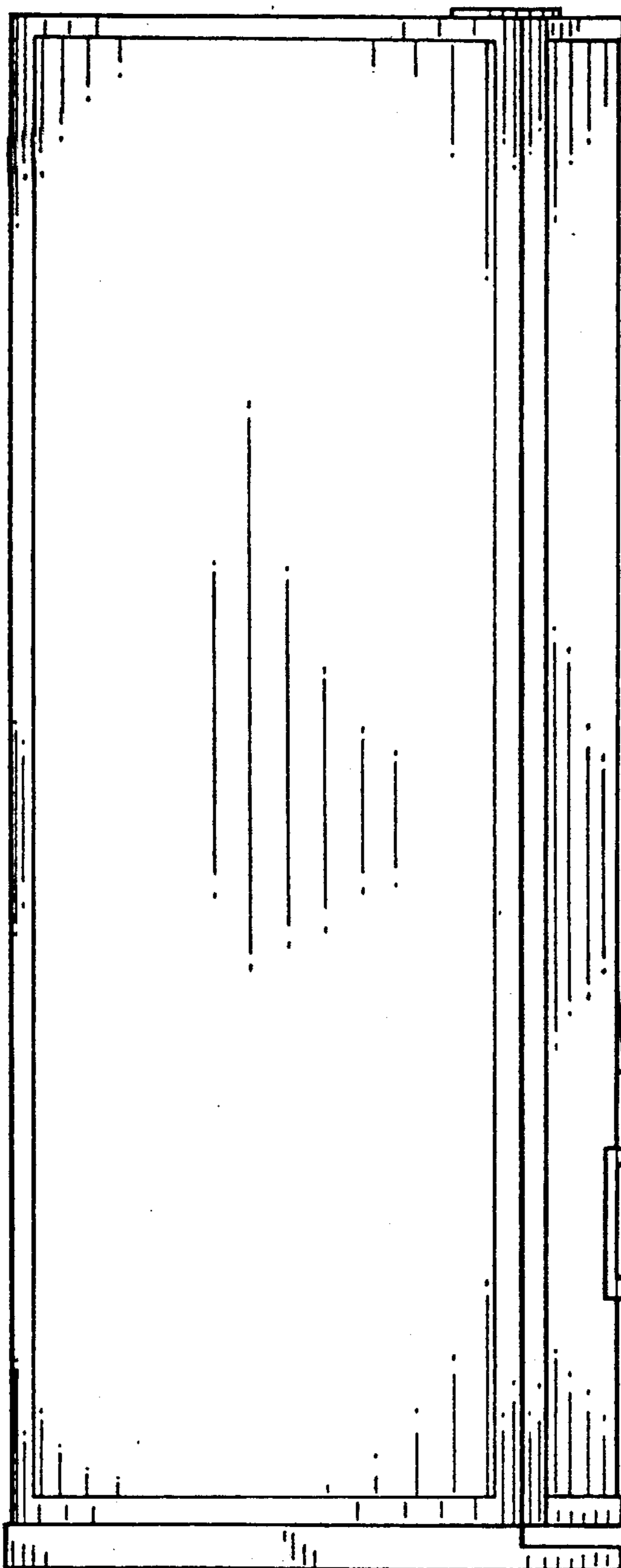
