DESCRIPTION

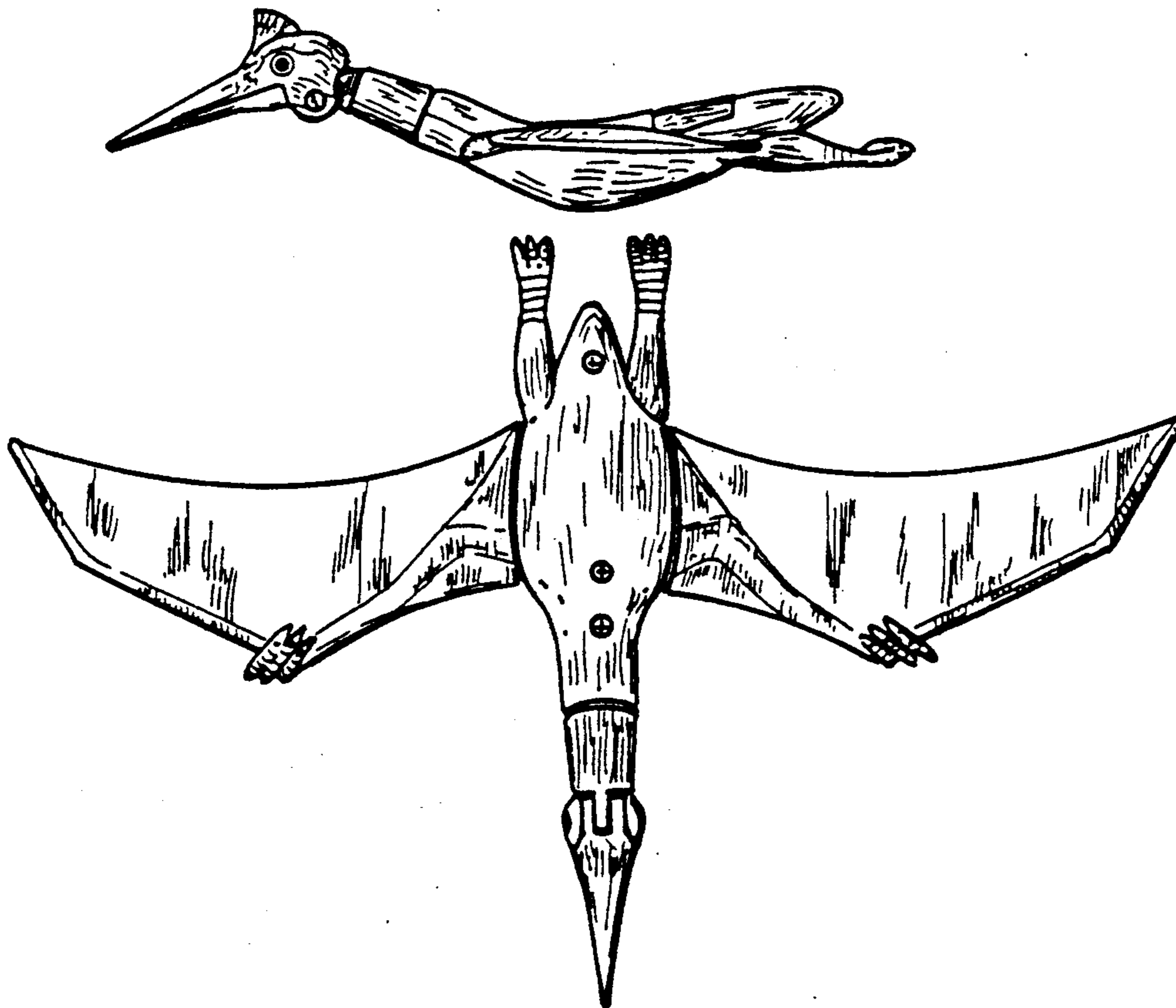
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toy figure showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



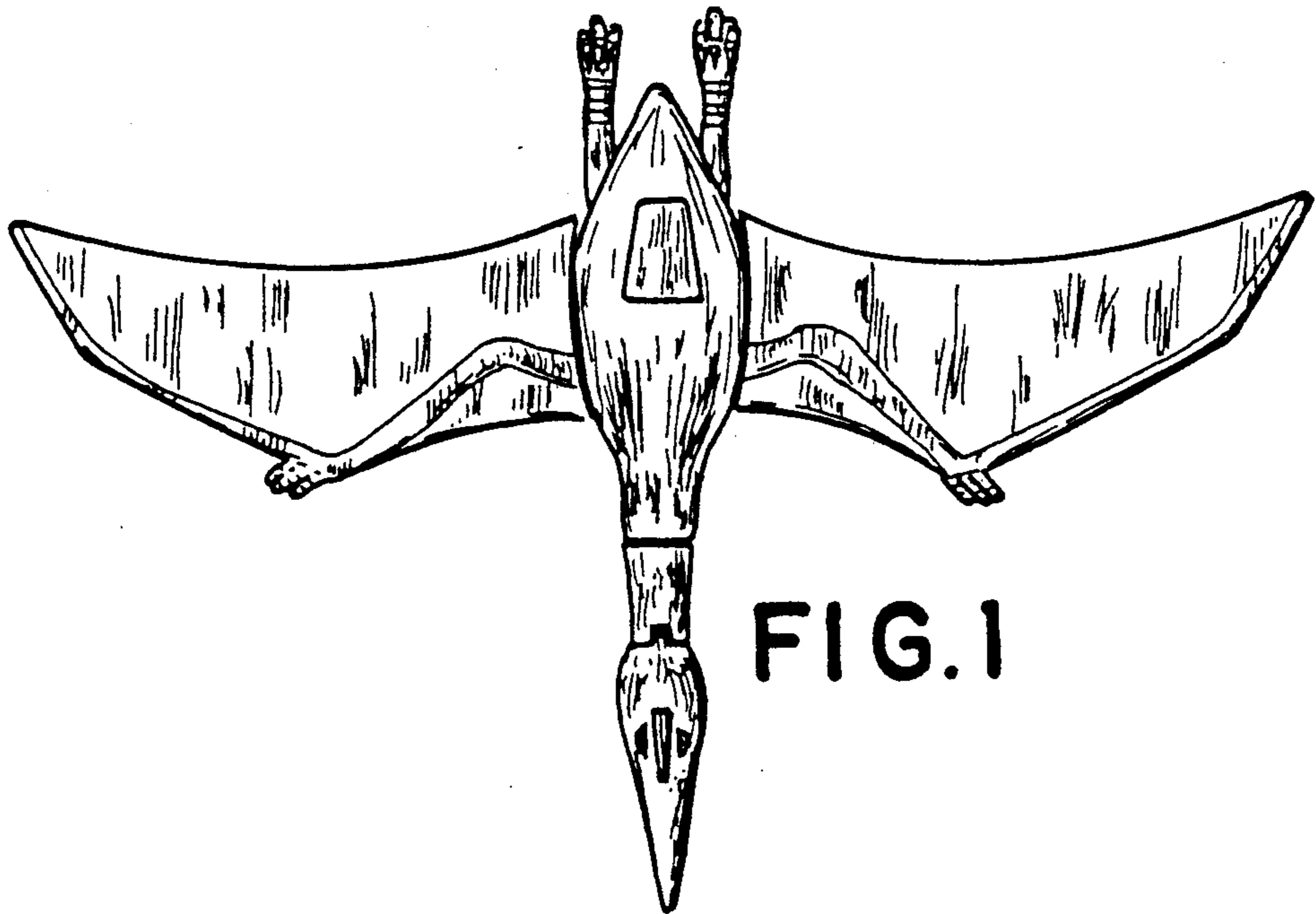

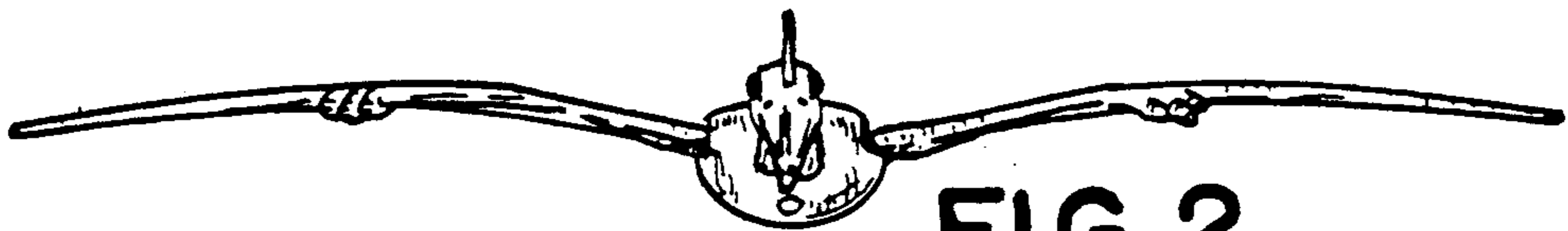

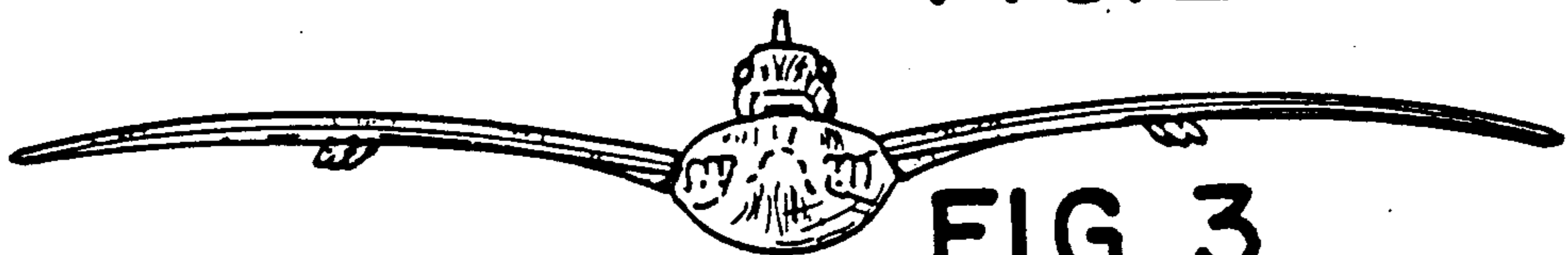

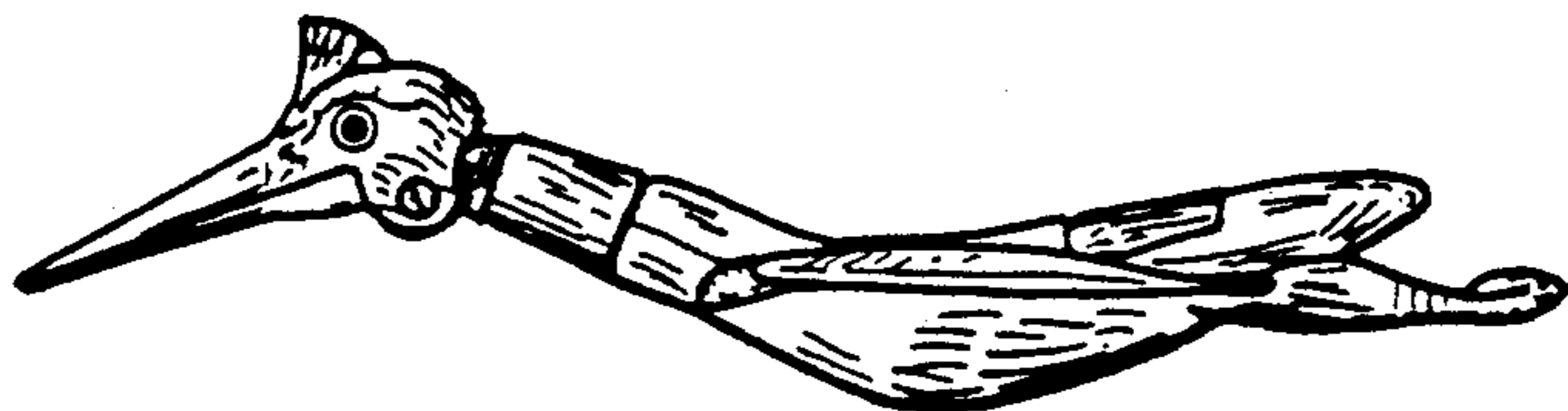

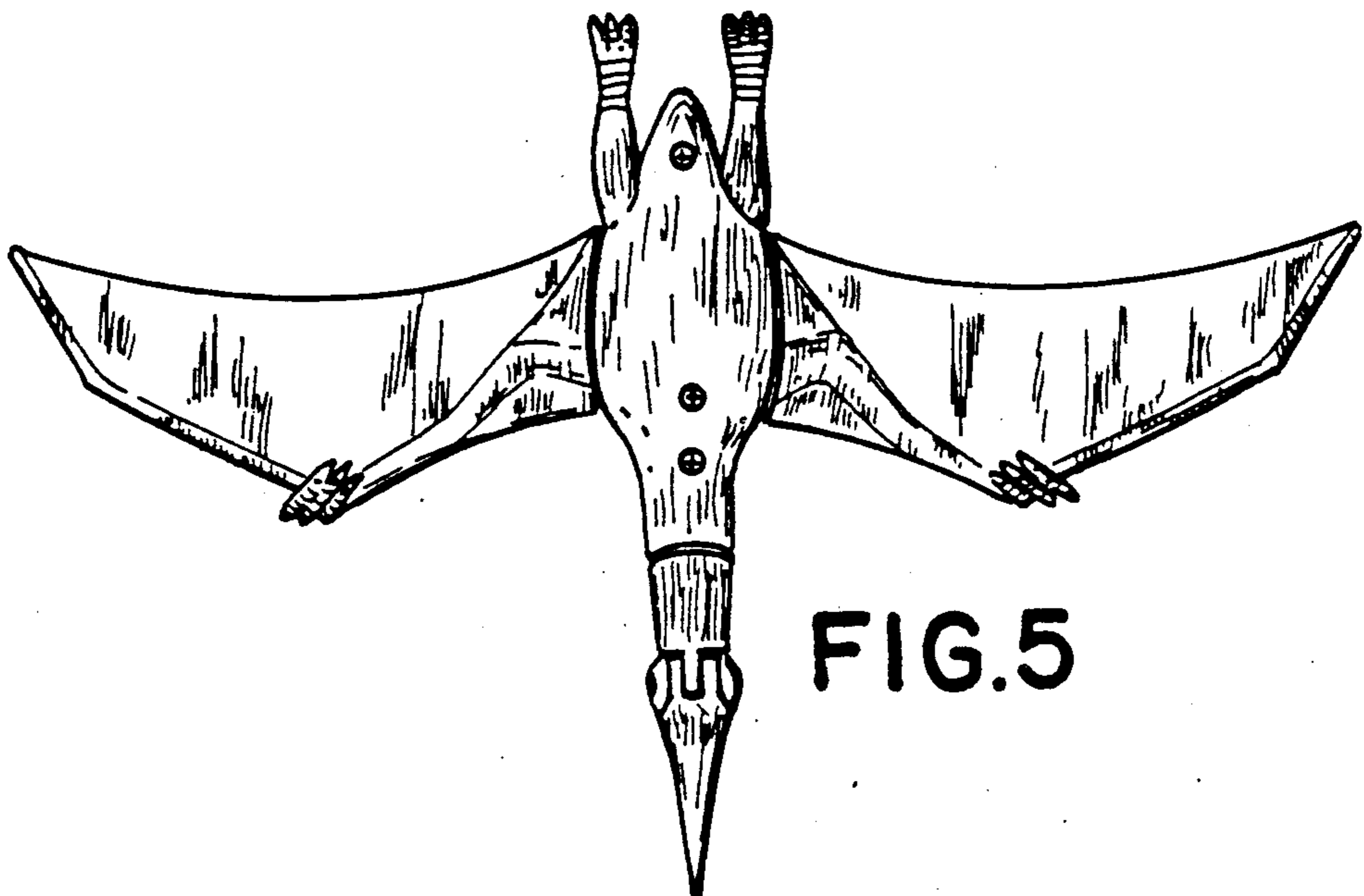
