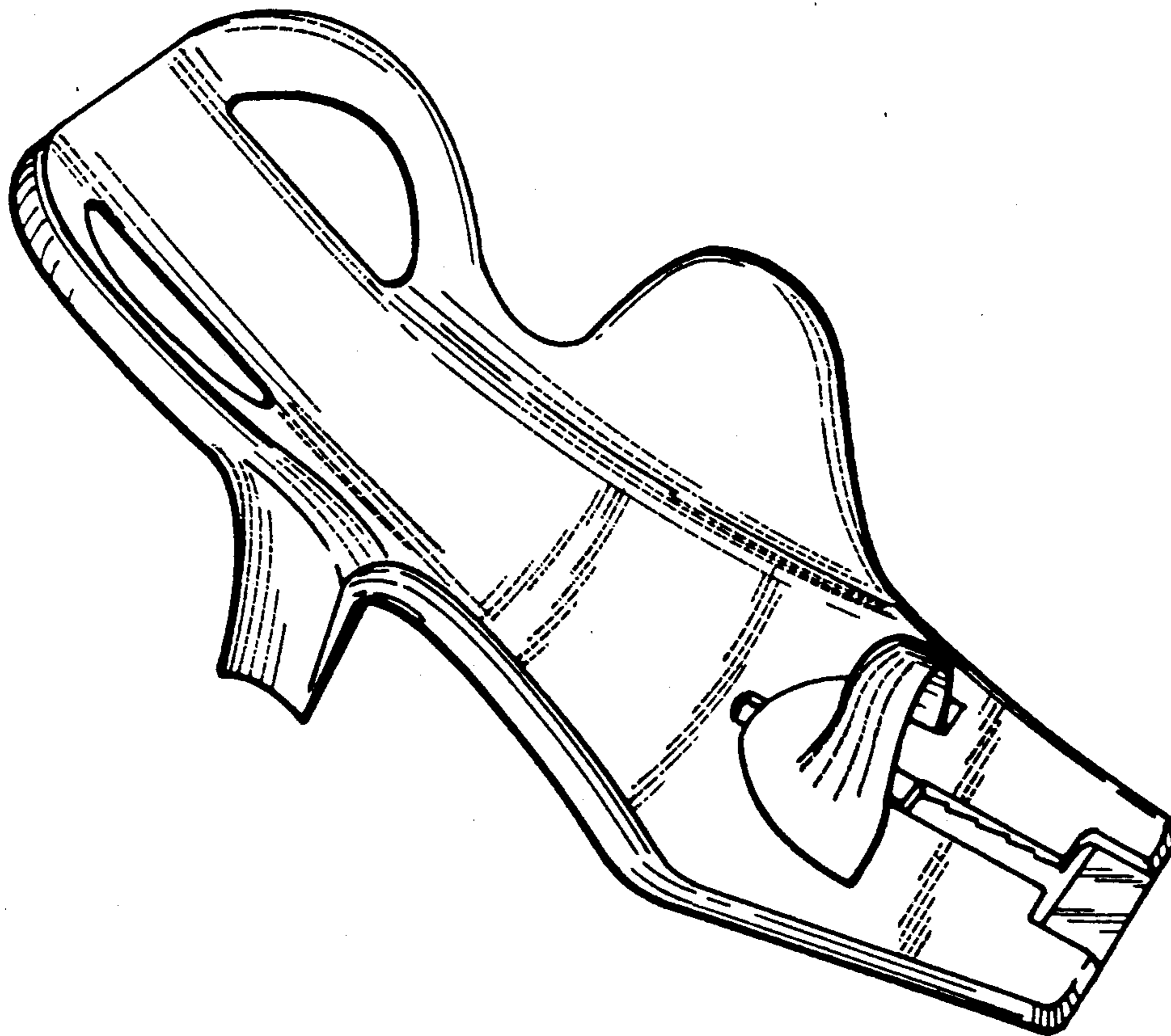

FIG. 7 is a top right perspective view.



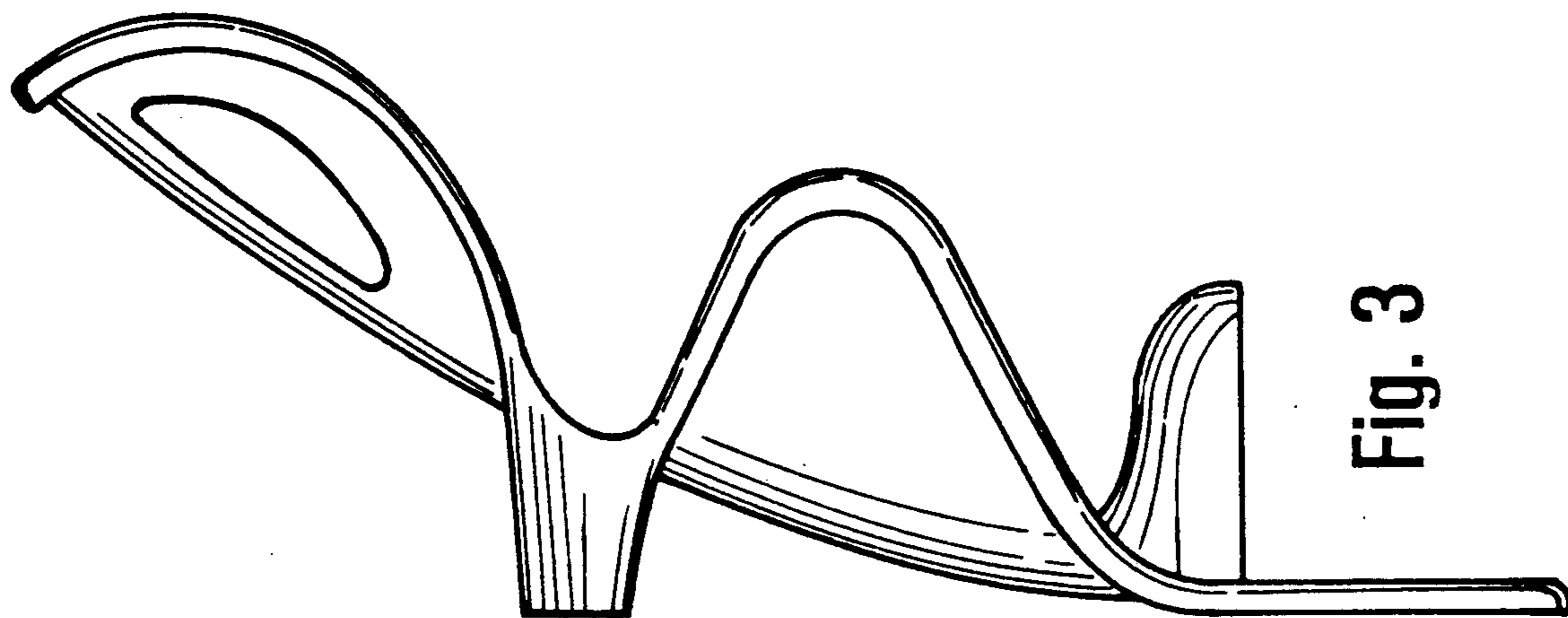

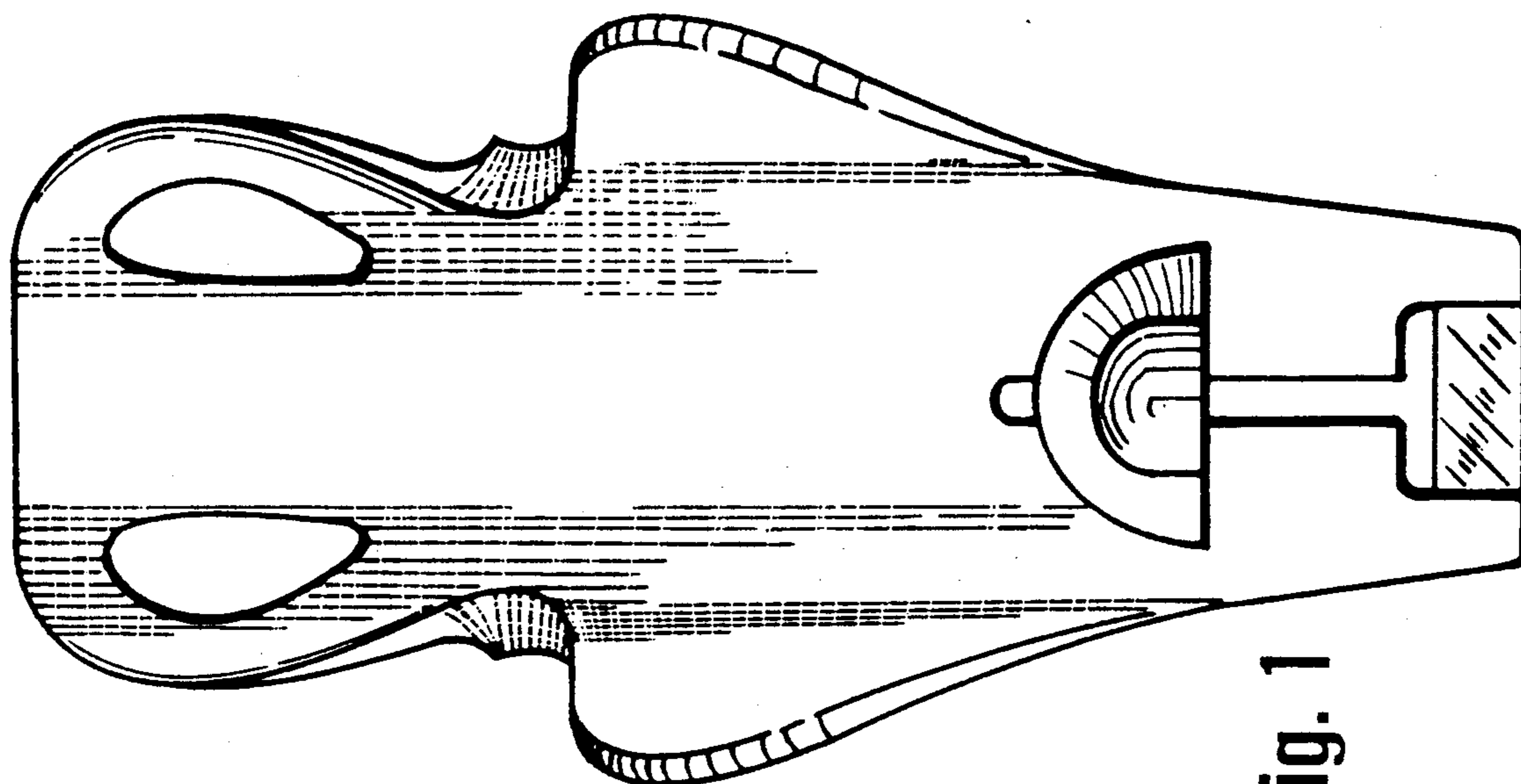

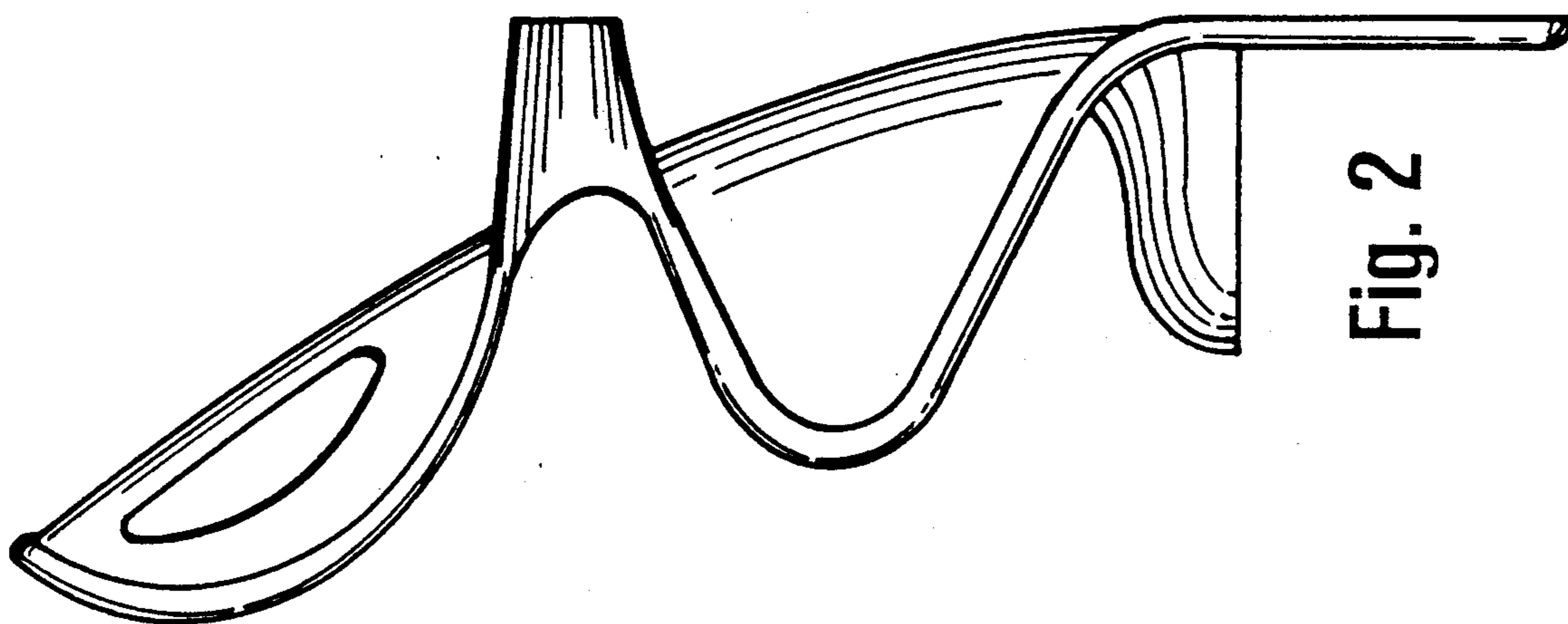

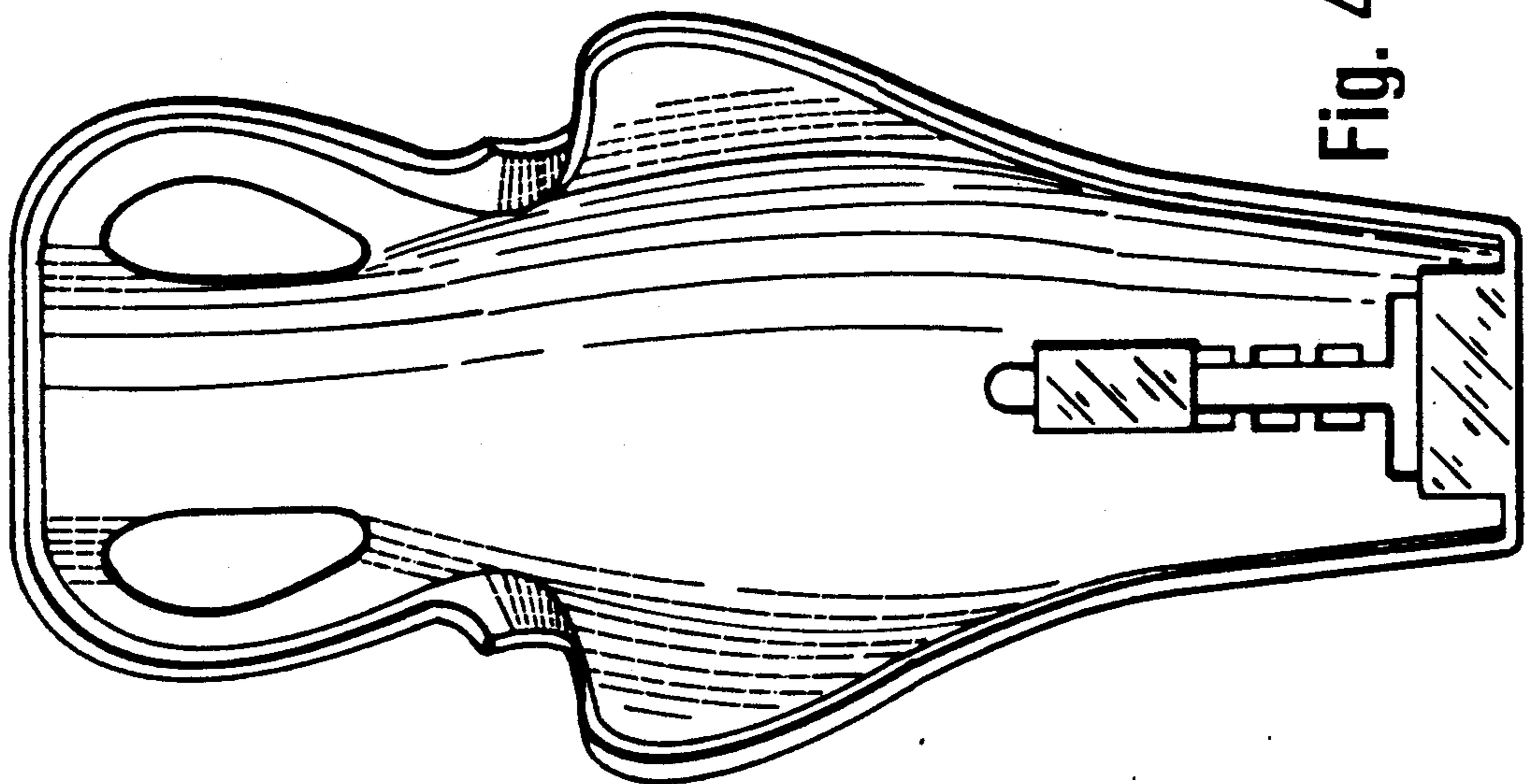

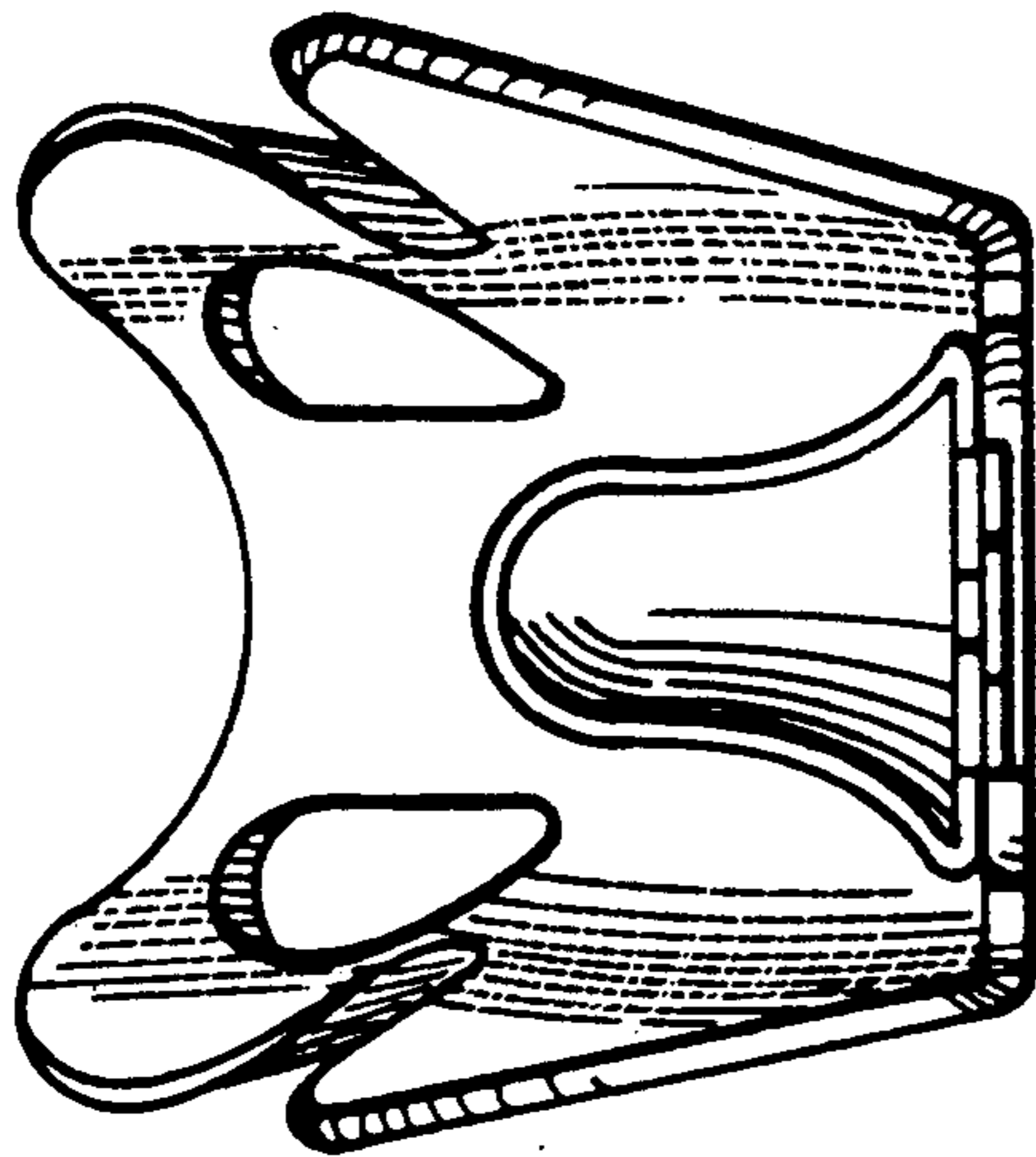

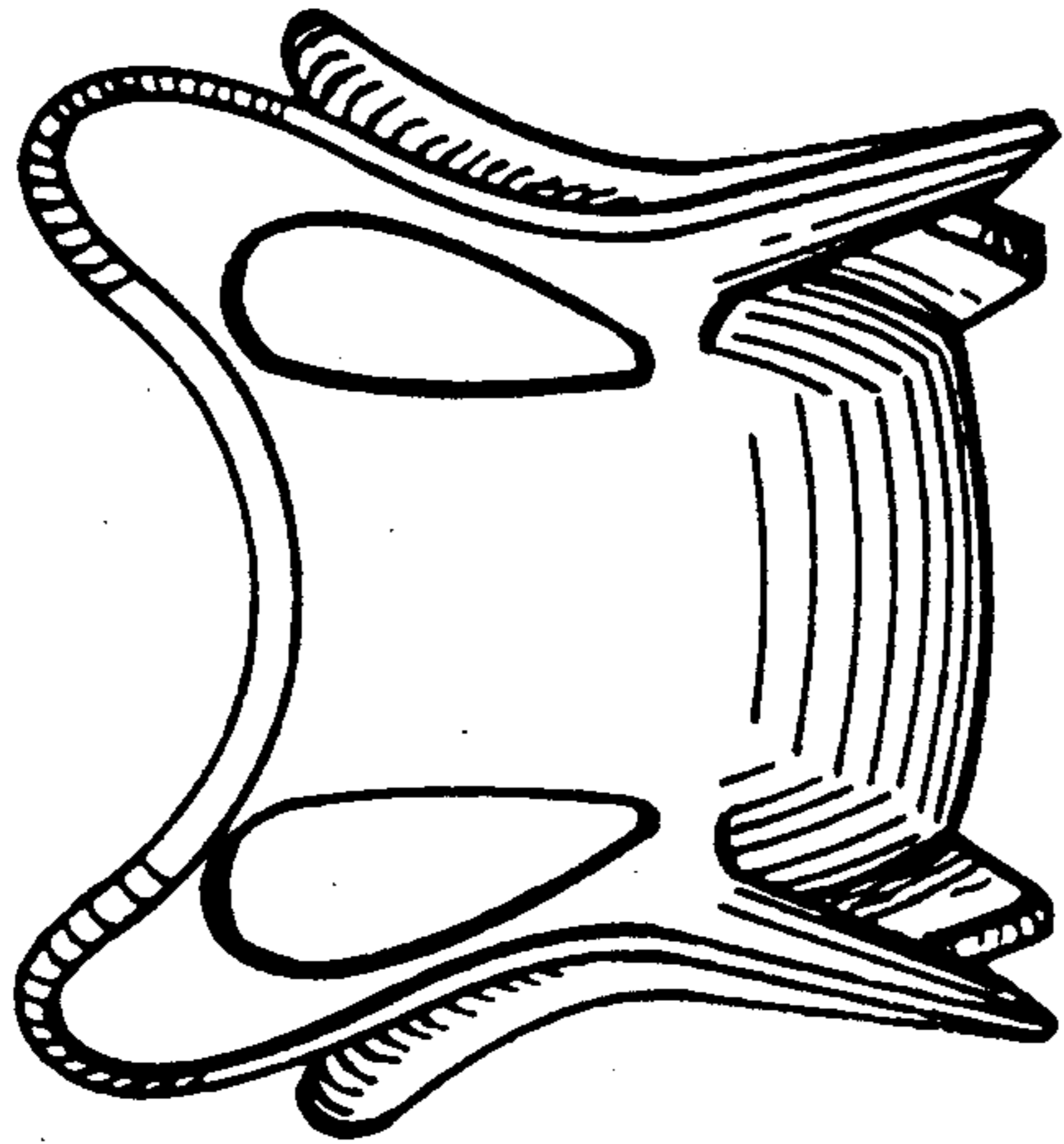

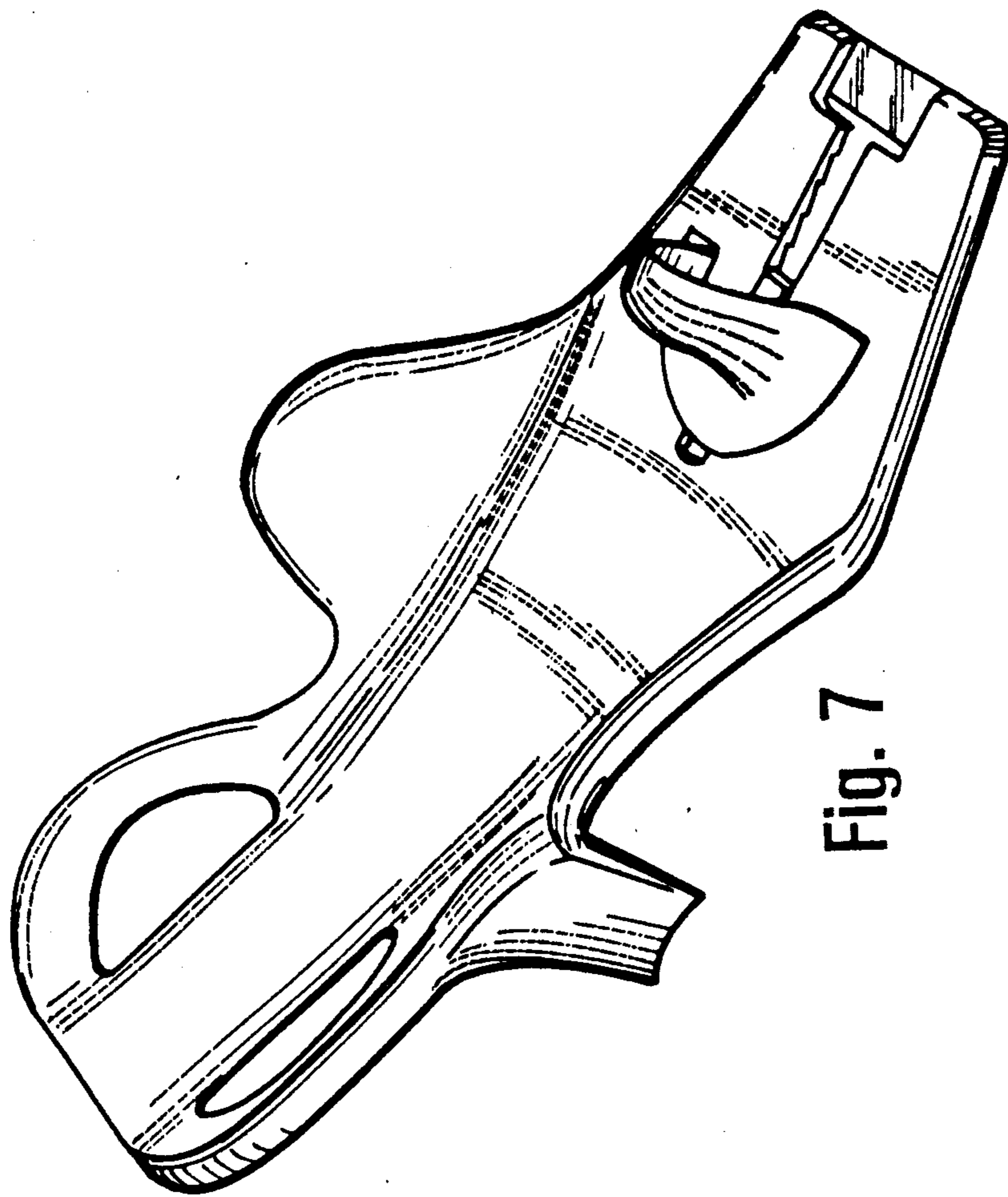
