[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an aquatic headgear, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of an aquatic headgear, with the front brim turned up, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view with the entire brim turned up;

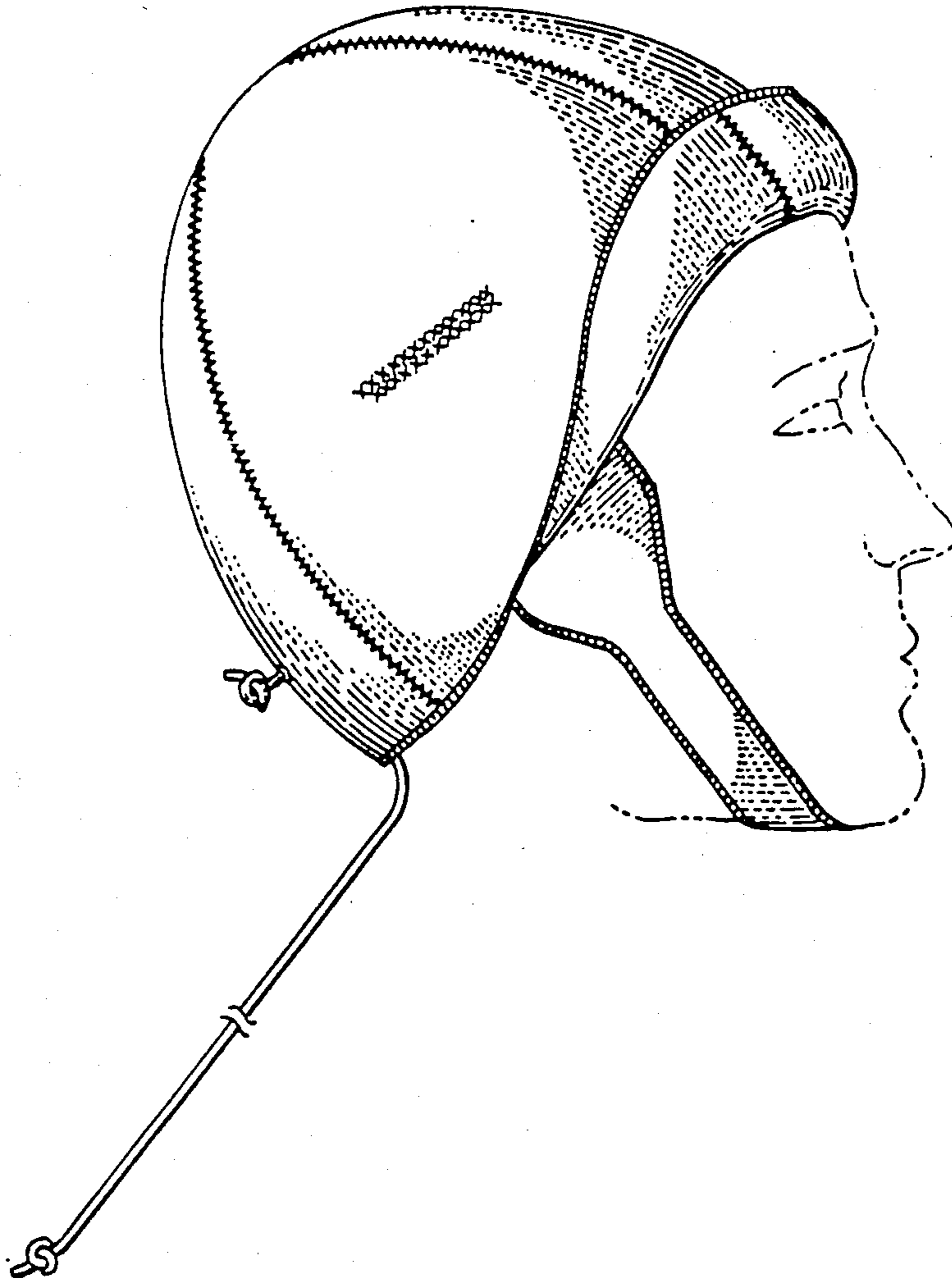
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view the left side being a mirror image thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view with the front brim turned up.

In all views, the cord has been broken away for the convenience of illustration.

The face shown in broken lines in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



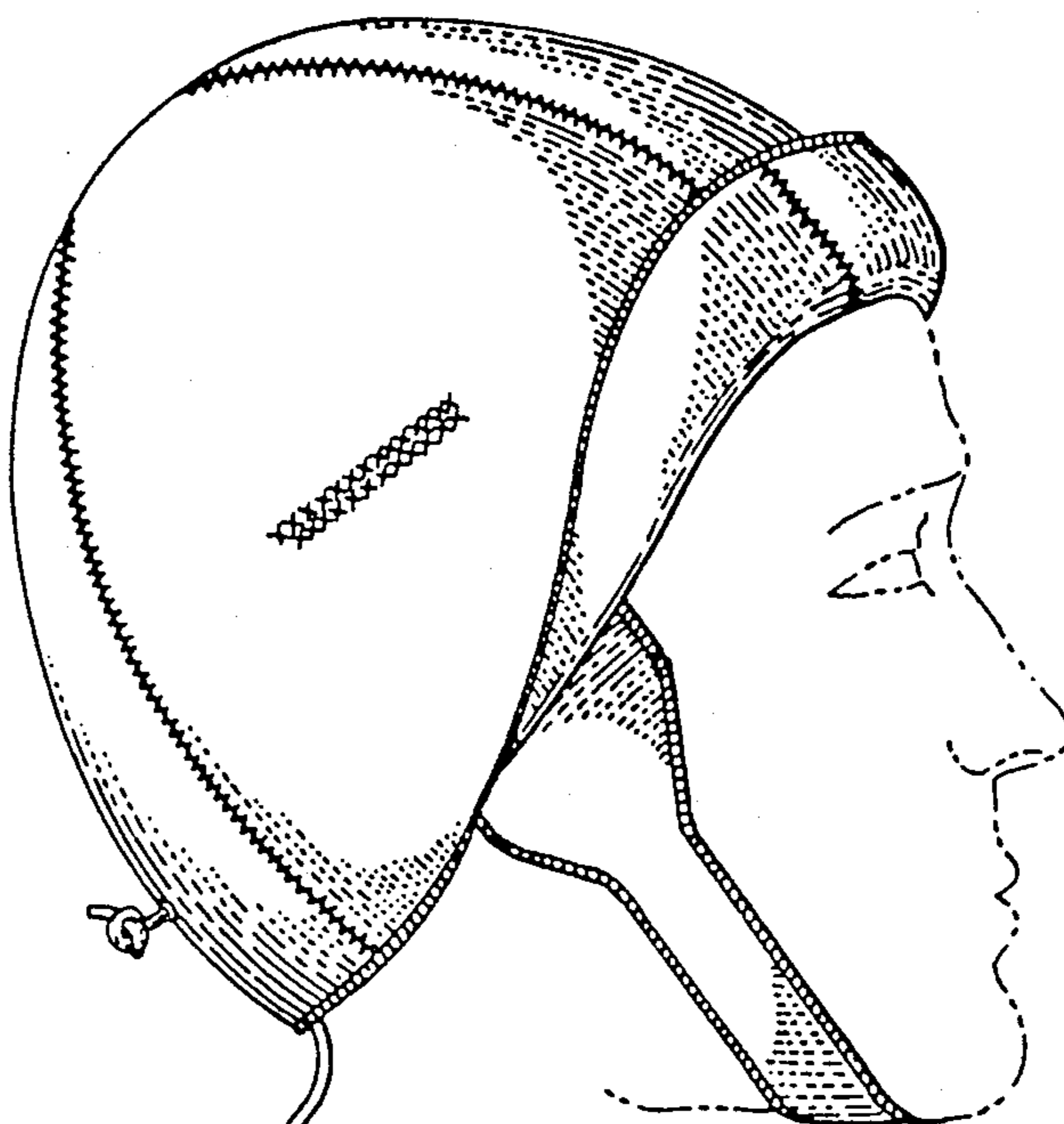

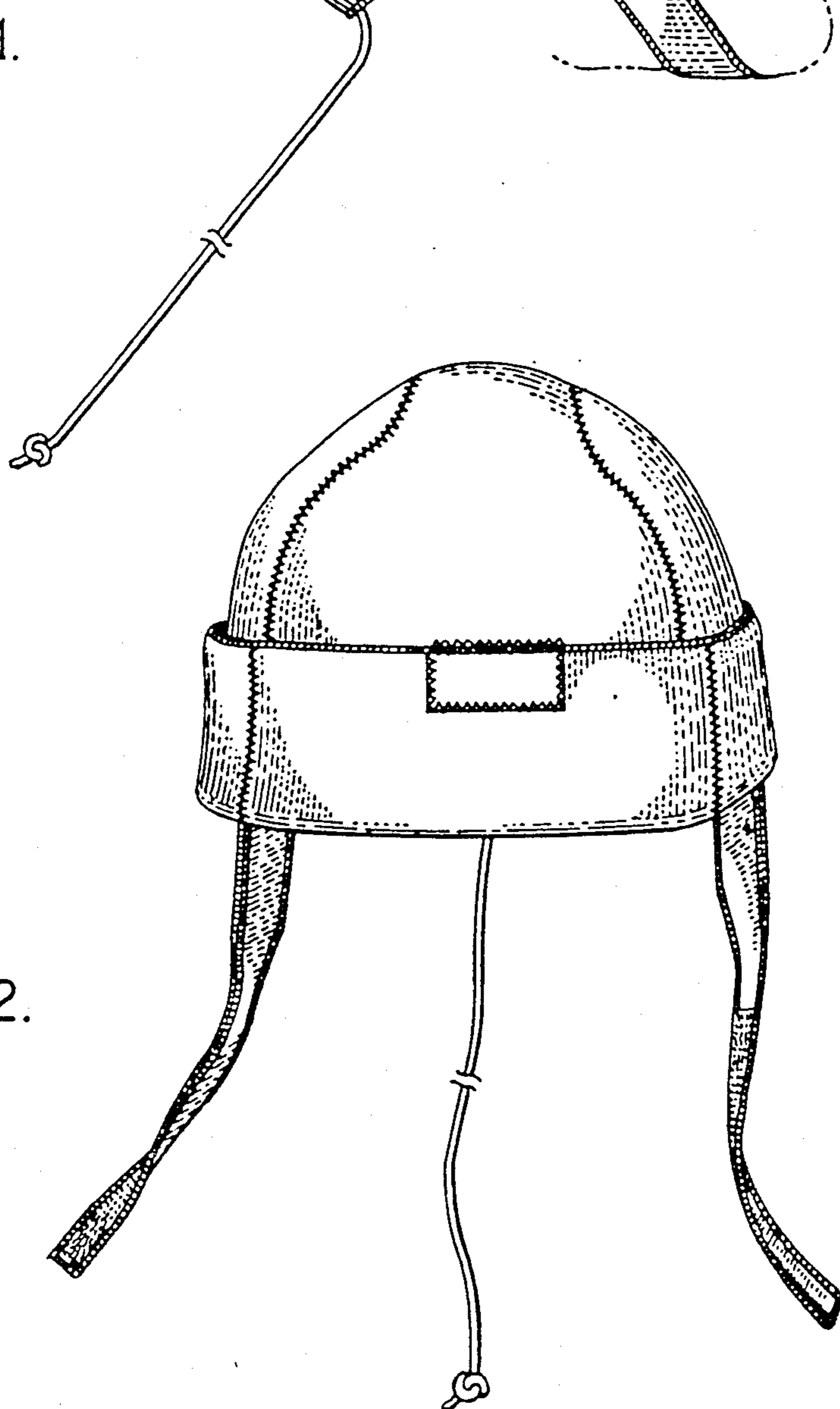

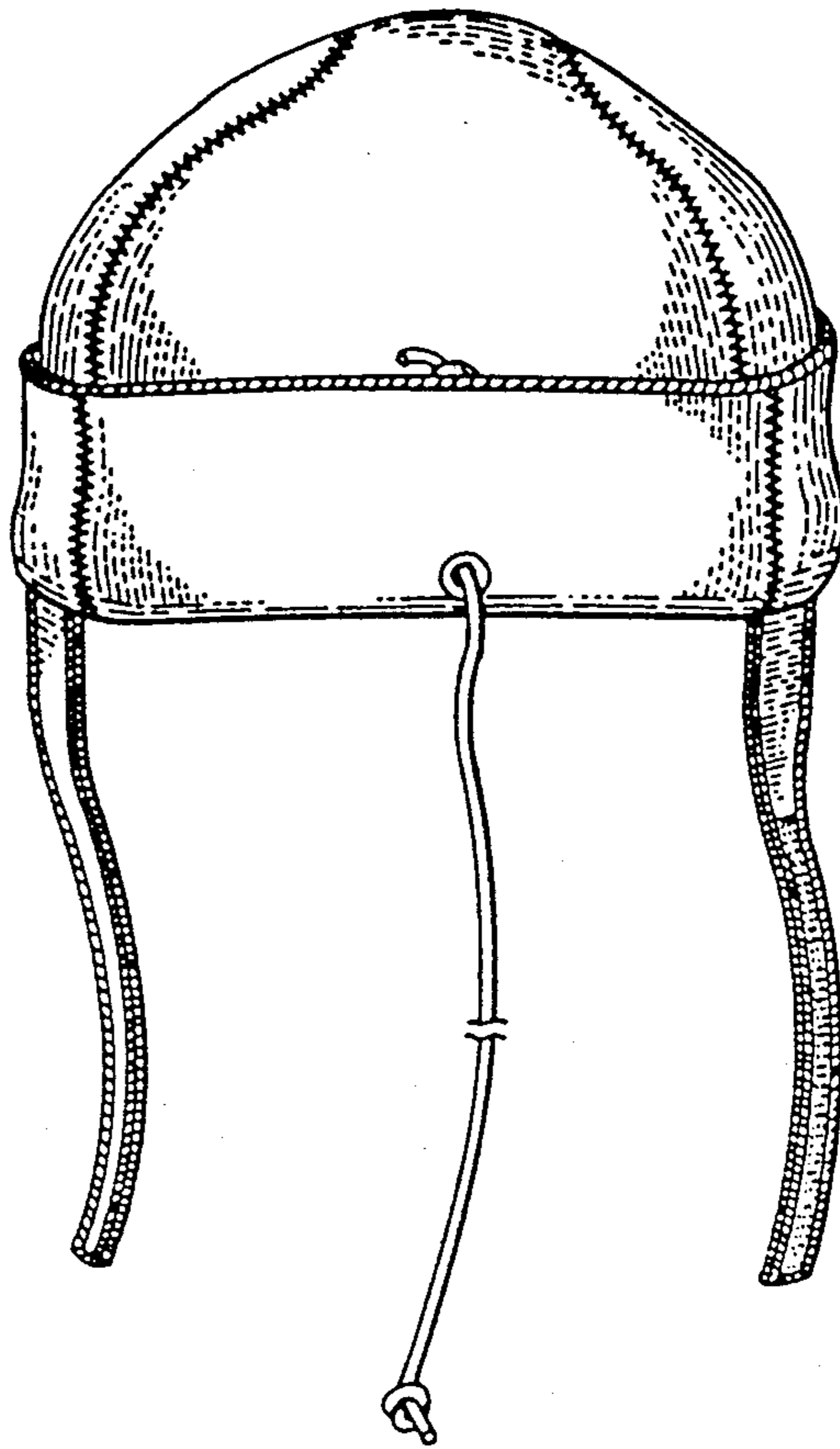
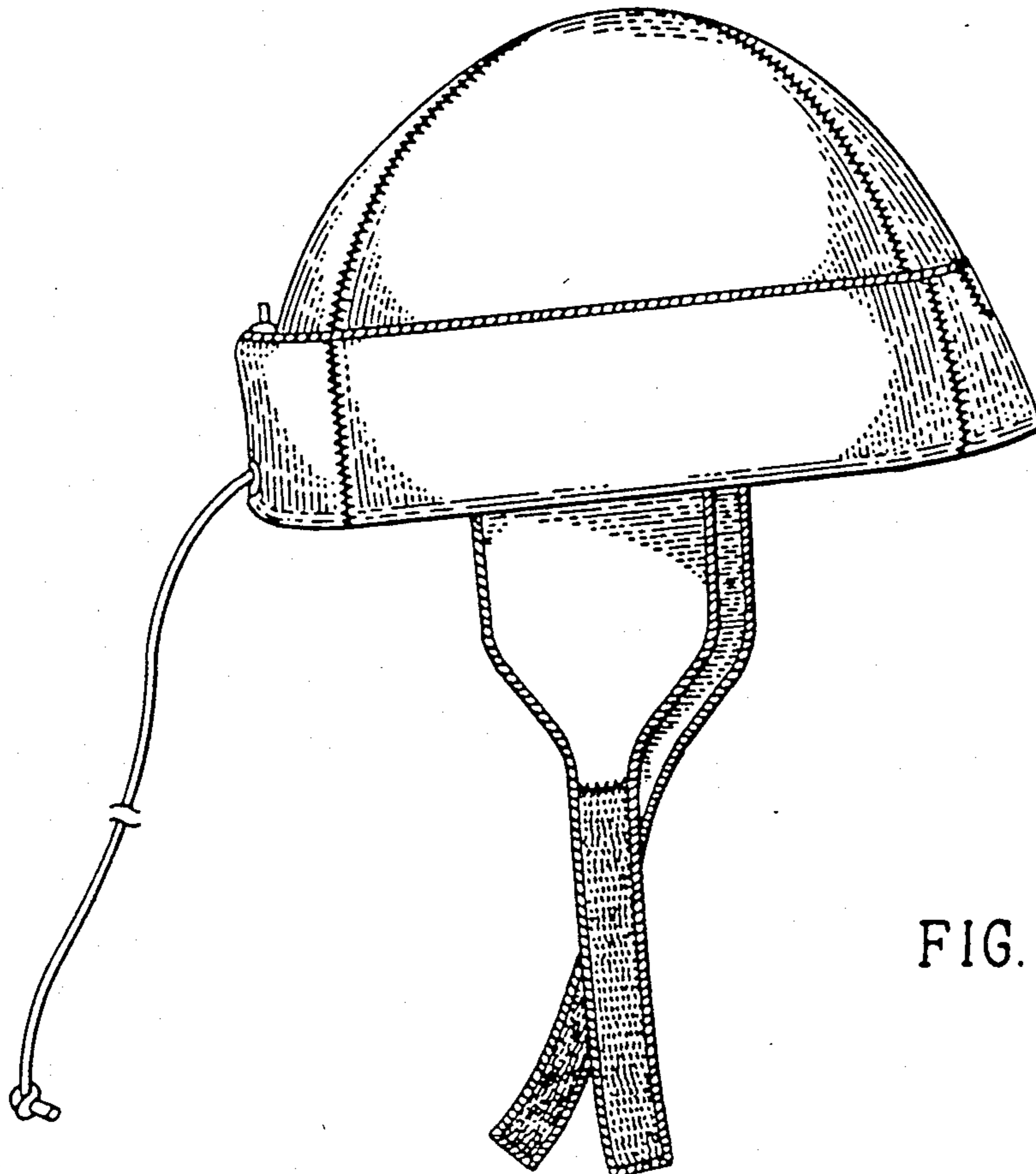

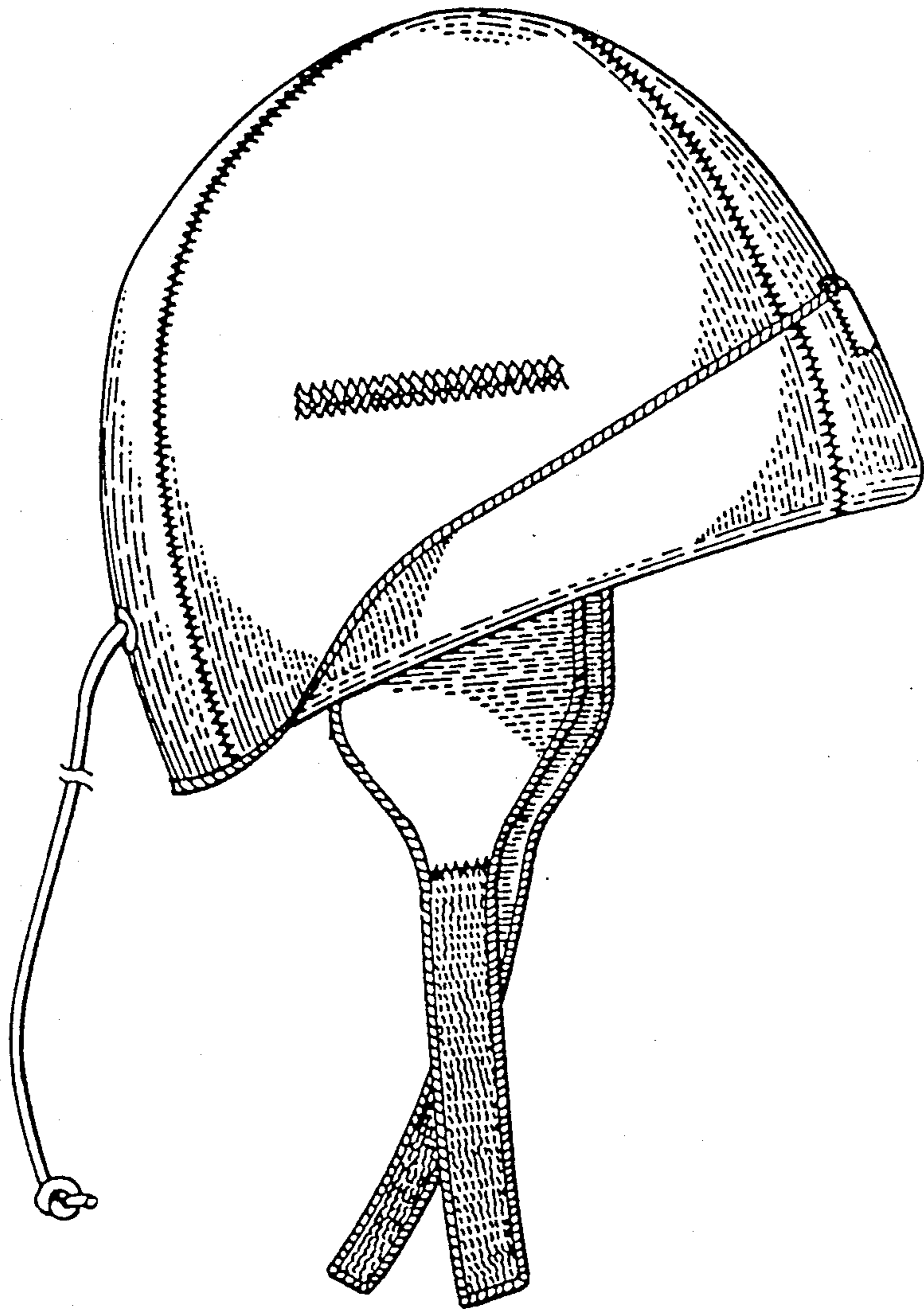
