DESCRIPTION

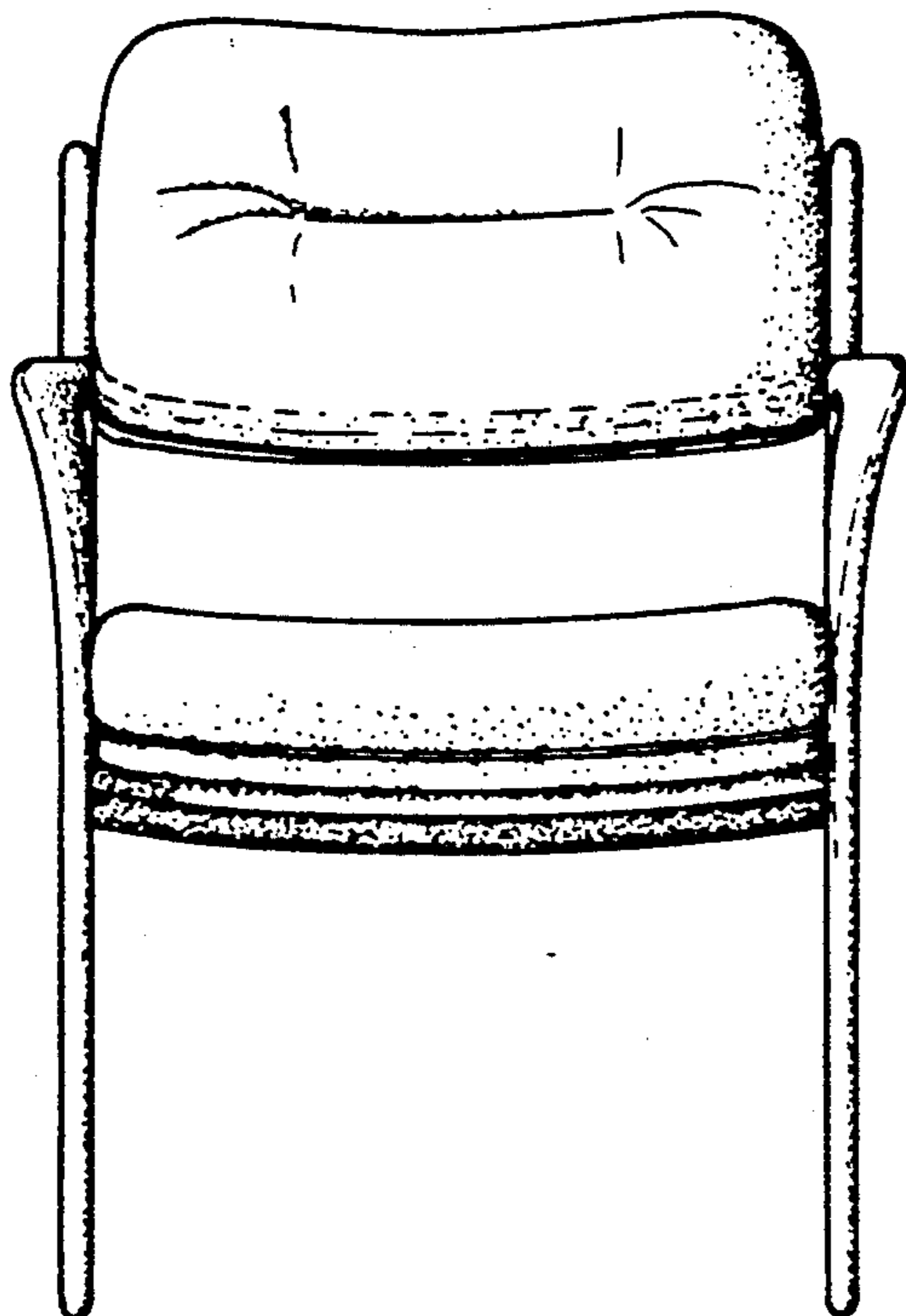
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the chair of the present invention.



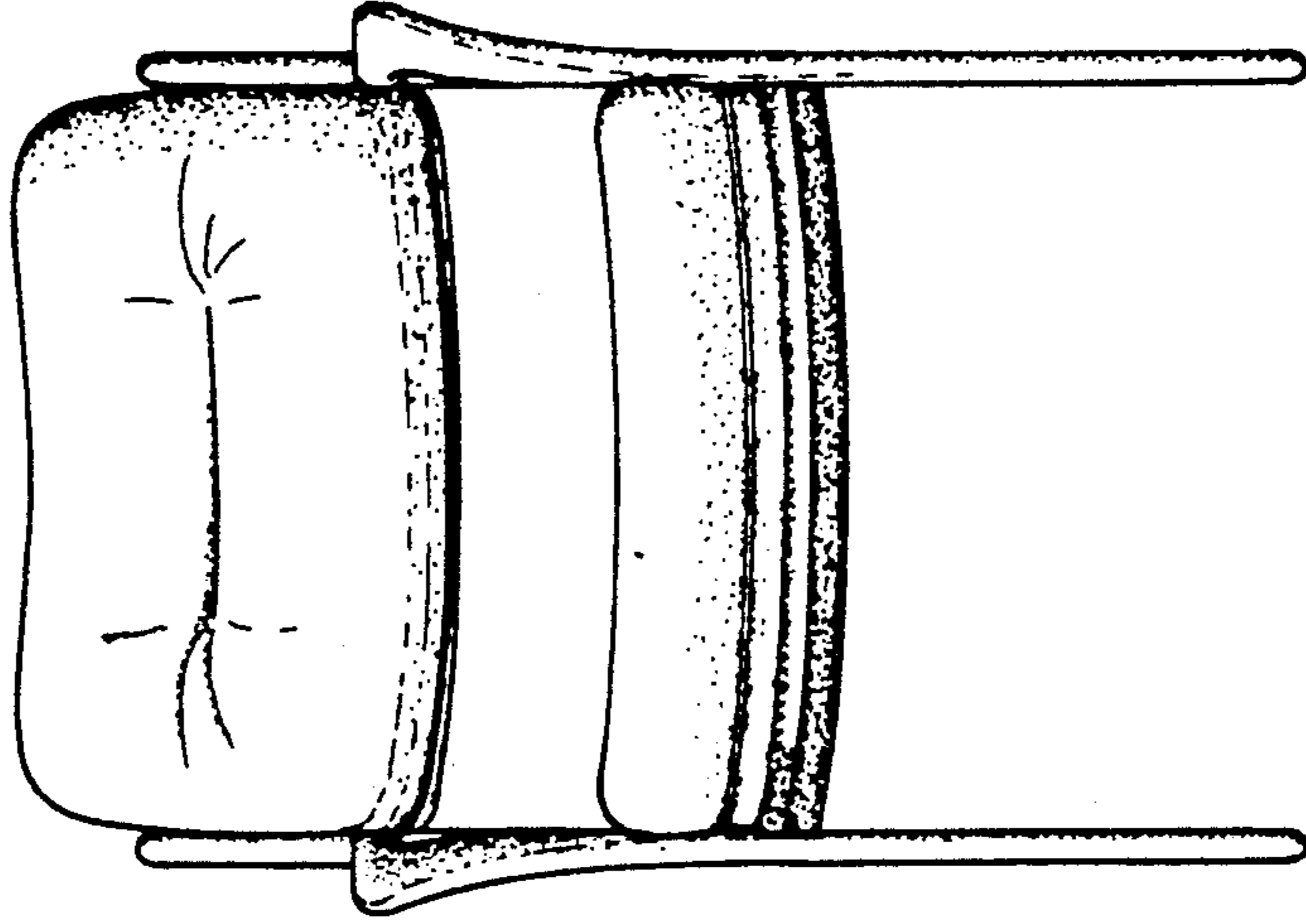

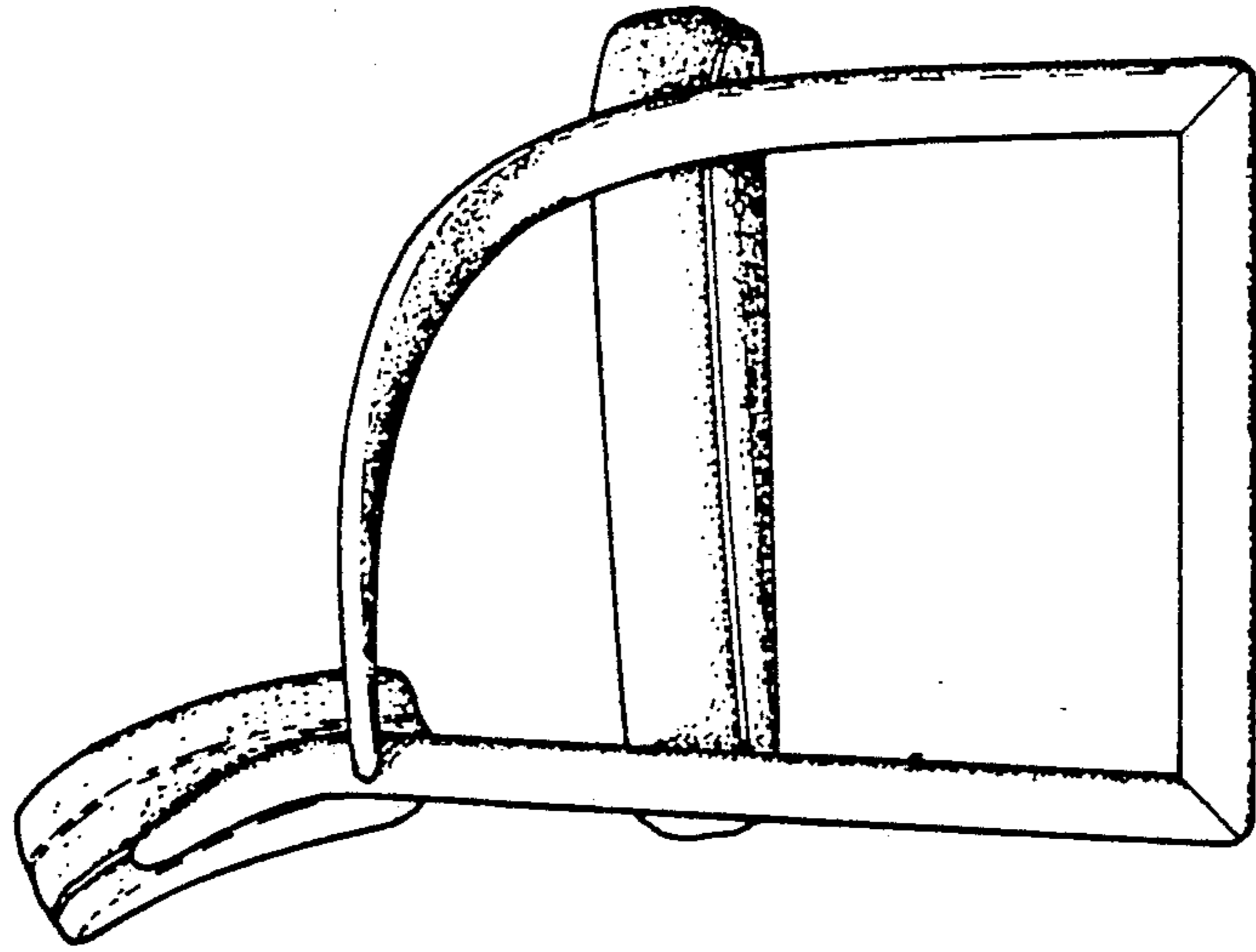

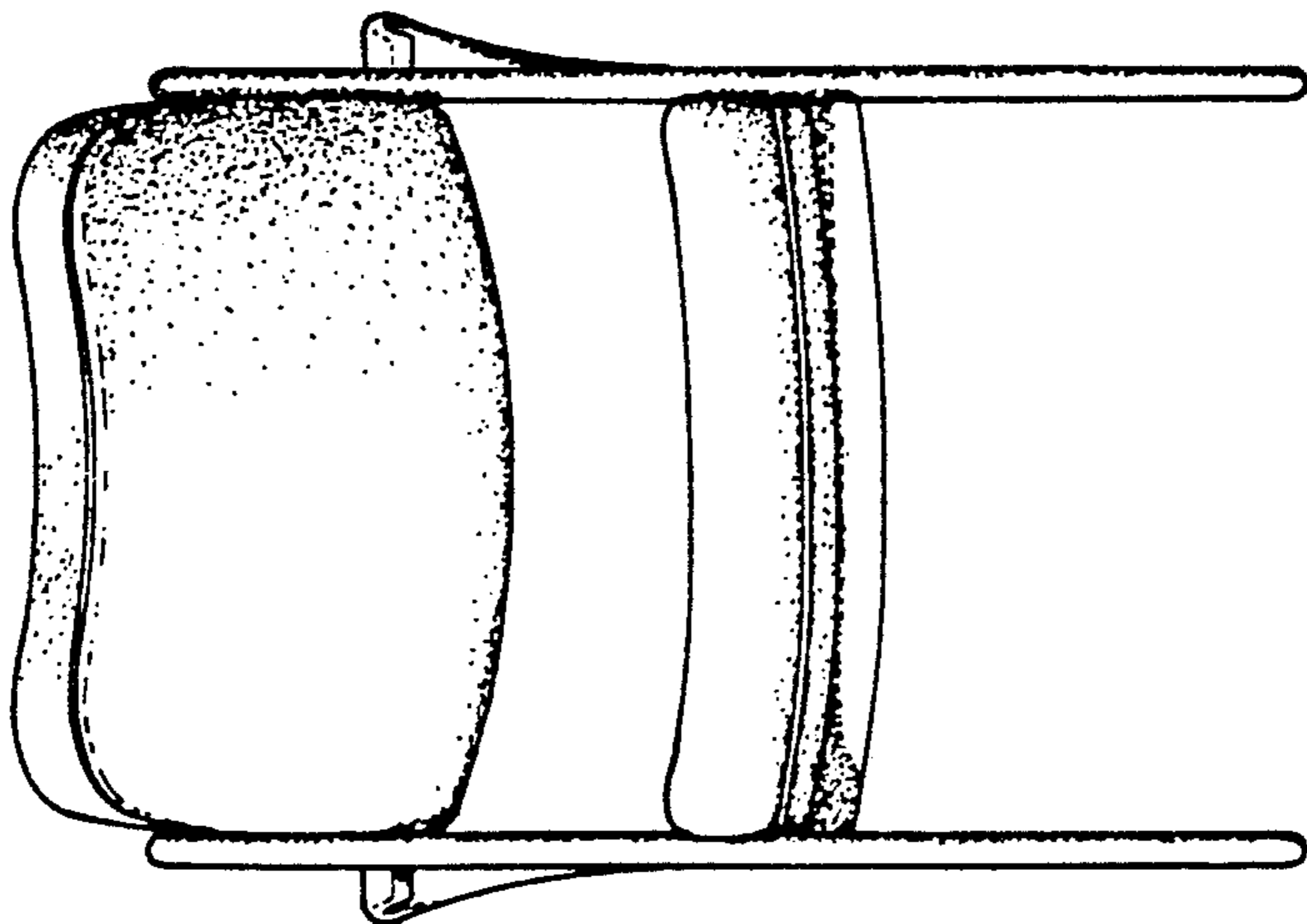
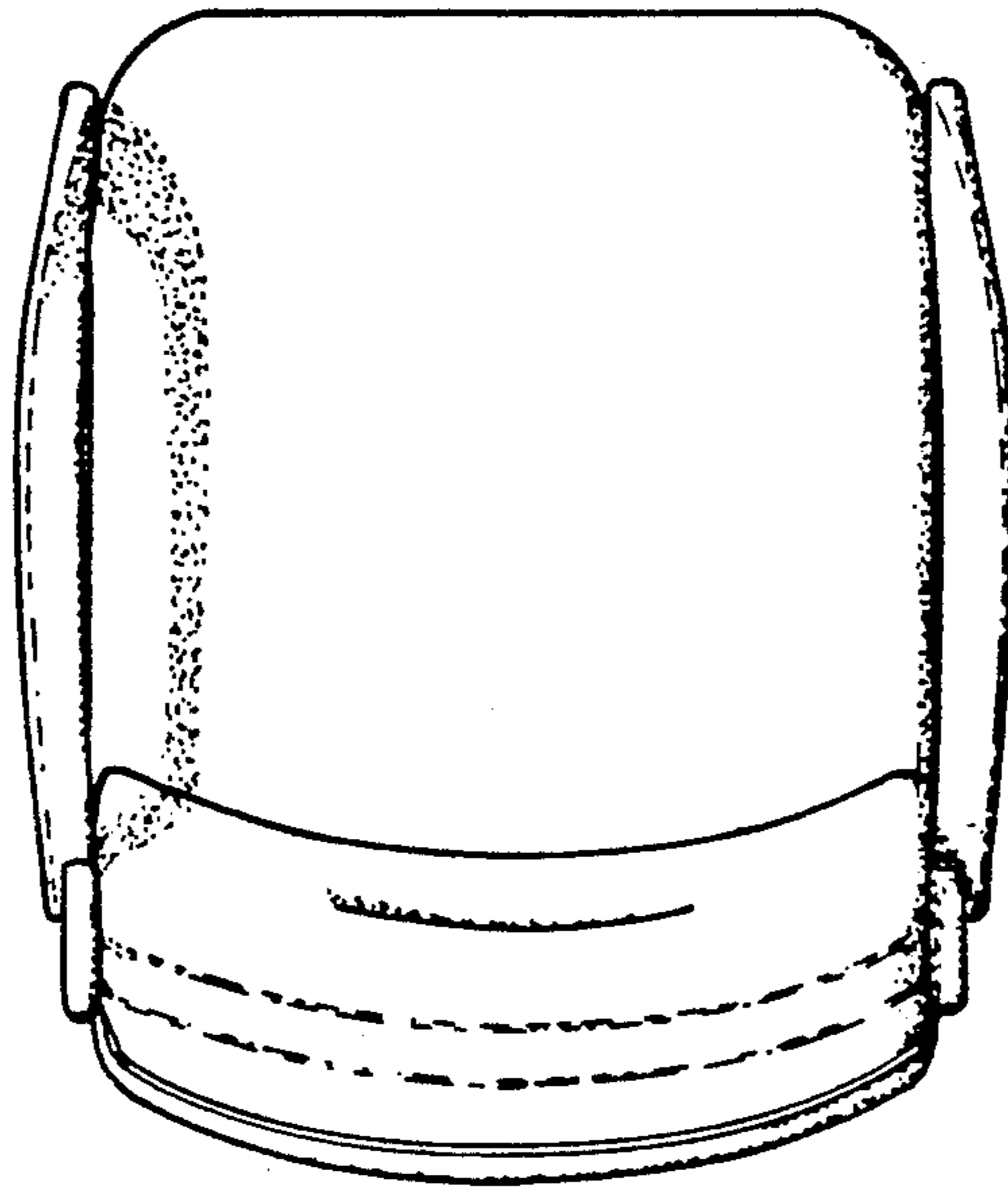
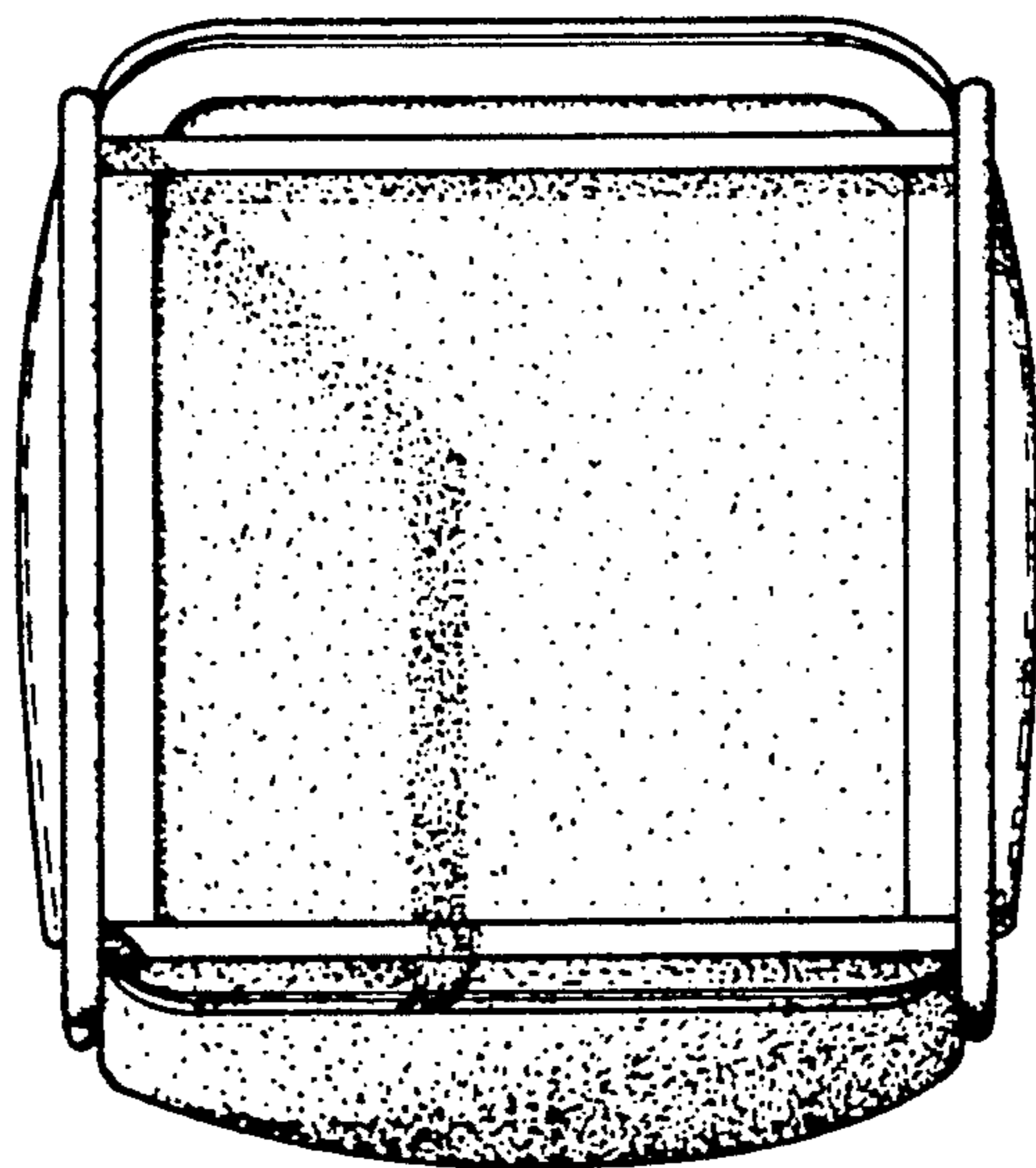
